CRAWOW 312-8 metres Closing signal, relayed from the famous St. Mary's Church.

POZNAN 335 metres. The trumpet call is sometimes used as interval signal.

CRAWOW 312-8 metres Occasionally used as interval signal

BEZIEFS 240 metres (Interval signal)

PRAGUE 488-0 metres (Opening signal)

HAMMER STROKES on ANVIL

KATOWICE 408 metres. In the intervals.

GRAZ 352-1 metres Letter K --- In the Intervals

HAMBURG 372 metres Letters HA --- Opening signal

HANOVER 566 metres Letters HH --- Interval signal

KIEL 232-2 metres Letters KL --- Interval signal

WARSAW No. 1 1411 metres Letter W --- Opening signal

CHIMES

CRAWOW 312-8 metres Bells of the historic St. Mary's Church as opening signal

KONICE 293 metres At 7 p.m., 4 and 8 chimes (different bells), and bell-ringing for five minutes

MADRID 424-3 metres Chimes from Home Office Building at 7 and 10 p.m.

POZNAN 335 metres (Sometimes gong instead)

METRONOME or CLOCK TICKING

BELGRADE 430-4 metres In the Interval

BERLIN (Witzleben) 419-5 metres 240 per minute. In the intervals

BRITISH STATIONS 60 per minute. In the intervals

BUCHAREST 394 metres 160 per minute. In the intervals

FRANKFURT 258 metres

GLEWITZ 253 metres 80 per minute (for opening and interval signal)

GRAZ 352-1 metres 200 per minute. In the intervals

HUIZEN 1875 metres (For K R O programmes)

KONIGSWUSTERHAUSEN 240 per minute, in intervals

LEIPZIG 349-6 metres

LWOW 381 metres Before the news bulletin

RABAT 416 metres 60 per minute

RIGA 525 metres 200 per minute, as opening signal

VIENNA 517 metres 270 per minute

ZAGREB 307 metres Opening signal, and during long intervals

GONG OR BELL

COPENHAGEN 281 metres Opening signal, 1 stroke

CRAWOW 312-8 metres Closing signal, 3 strokes

HAMBURG 372 metres Number of strokes indicates interval in minutes

HANOVER 566 metres Number of strokes indicates interval in minutes

ISTANBUL 1290 metres 77 strokes per minute in intervals

KALUNDBORG 1153 metres Opening signal, 1 stroke

KIEL 232-2 metres Closing signal, 3 strokes

LWOW 381 metres Gong strokes between the items

LYONS (La Doua) 405-8 metres Sometimes used as interval signal

PALERMO 542 metres Opening signal (on gramophone record)

RADIO PARIS 1725 metres Preliminary signal

POZNAN 335 metres (Sometimes clock or chimes instead)

SCHWEIZERISCHER Two notes like a clock striking

LANDESENDER (Beromunster) 459 metres

STRAUBOURG 345 metres Deep-toned bell strikes every five seconds as opening signal

TOULOUSE 385 metres Usually 1-second interval between strokes

WARSAW No. 1 1411 metres Clock-gong

SONG of the NIGHTINGALE

FLORENCE 500-8 metres (Interval signal given by musical box)

GENOA 312-8 metres (Interval signal given by musical box)

MILAN 331-5 metres (Interval signal given by musical box)

PALERMO 542 metres (Interval signal given by musical box)

TRIESTE 247-7 metres (Interval signal given by musical box)

TURIN 273-7 metres (Interval signal given by musical box)

Music

BUDAPEST 550 metres Nine-note phrase (G sharp, B A B G sharp, B A B G sharp)

COPENHAGEN 281-4 metres Old folk-song melody as interval signal

KONIGSBERG 217 metres The notes D flat A flat, three times in 41 seconds. Pause of 41 seconds

KALUNDBORG 1153 metres Old folk-song melody as interval signal

MADRID 424-3 metres Opening signal "Siegfried's" bugle-call theme, on piano

MARSEILLES 315 metres Few bars of old Provençal folk-song

MUNICH 533 metres Musical Box

OSLO 1083 metres Themes from the National Anthem (when opening and closing). Motif from "Sigurd Jorsalfar"

STUTTGART 360-5 metres The three notes C D G, on metal bars

VALENCIA 267-6 metres Closes down with "Hymn to Valencia" (gramophone)

WARSAW No. 1 1411 metres First two bars of Chopin's Polonaise in A major
