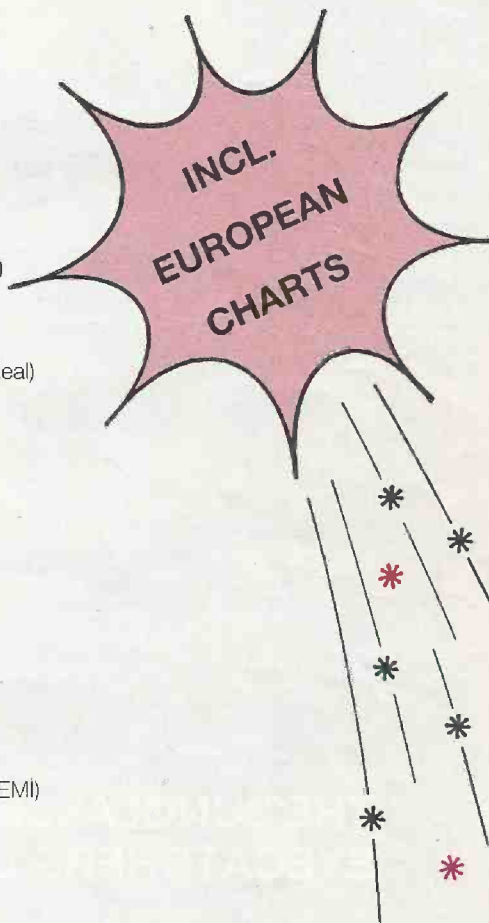

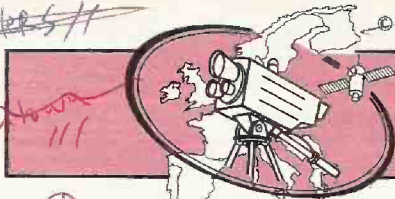

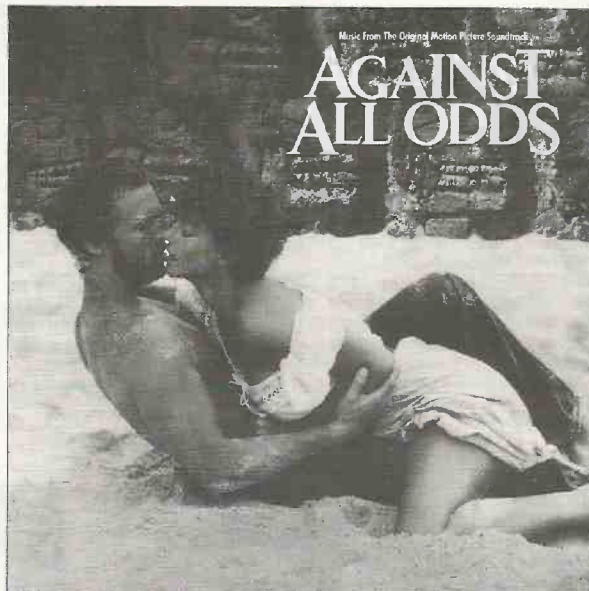
Annabel Lamb - The Flame - A&M

ABOUT THE CHARTS....
THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):
In many European countries one chart is recognised by the
music industry as the "OFFICIAL" hitparade and is therefore
used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP100. However
there are other countries where various charts are in existence
and often equally important. For these countries we have
compiled a number of these charts into one representing the
sales in that market.
Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to
that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied
by a factor determined through the latest known sales
percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country
holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different
percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly
provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such
as IFPI-BPI-Gallup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc.A European
Chart-Committee, with experts from a number of these
industry-organisations will overlook the calculation system and
will decide on improvements, changes and updates.
For the EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used
from 16 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20
charts are used from 15 countries. Since the sales
percentages of a few countries are too small to get their hits
into the EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not
charted in any other territory), we are so printing a TOP 3 IN
EUROPE list: each week.
The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 60 is compiled through all our
correspondents tips received this week. (*)Records of the week
receive extra points. The airplay lists of the airplay report
organisations within some of the European countries are also
used in the calculations, as well as playlists of major radio
stations. (*)Please note that not all received tips appear in
Eurotipsheet but they are all used for the calculation of the
Airplay Top 60.
THE EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on
televs on throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It
includes video-t.v.programs and other t.v.shows partly using
video's from 14 European countries.
For more detailed information on any of the chart-systems
please contact our chart department.

CHANGING THE CHARTS

As from this week, we have some major changes in our chart calculations for both the European Top 100 singles and albums. This is due to new updated sales figures as provided by the various industry organizations such as IFPI, BPI and Deutsche Bundesverband. They include sales for the year 1983 and have a quite strong effect on our calculations. Firstly we are very thankful to these organizations to have given us these figures because it will make our charts even more in line with what's happening saleswise in the different markets now. As you know we are using the percentages of total sales on both singles and albums of one country in relation to the other countries of Europe for the compilation of the European Top 100. The main changes show us that single sales in France and Germany went up in 1983, while they went down in various other markets, mainly the U.K. and Italy. This automatically means that French and German singles have more chance to reach higher positions in the European Top 100 singles. There was one other country where singles actually improved their sales picture and that is Sweden. Basically the strongest single country is still England but with a very small margin over France. Germany is third. These countries are followed by Italy, Holland, Ireland, Spain and Belgium, while the other markets have considerable less sales on singles.
On the album side things look different, as England in fact has slightly improved its sales, while in France and Germany albums sales (including cassettes) have gone down. They also dropped in many other territories including Holland, Switzerland, Austria, Belgium and some of the Scandinavian countries. Sweden improved, as did Italy. The new percentages are used as from this week onwards, and of course they will be updated as new figures become available.

**EUROTIPSHEET,
A NEW FACE.**

There are more changes in our magazine this week, starting with the front page. This is now becoming a very important page where you'll find the major tips and fastest moving records in Europe during the previous week. The Euro-Airplay-Smash is of course the record most played in Europe during the week of publication and is also nr. 1 on the European Airplay Top 50. Hot Radio Adds show us the records which normally entered the Airplay Top 60 between positions 50 and 60 as well as latest additions to playlist as given by the major radio people in Europe just two days prior to publication. Watch out weekly for these Hot Radio Adds as these singles might enter the European Charts soon after. Records of the week, sure hits and newcomers as tips given by major radio people as well as the Review team of EUROTIPSHEET. Albums of the week show the most added albums on European Radio as well as the most important releases of this week. As usual Euroclips show the most programmed videos on European Television this week including program listings of 38 television shows in 14 countries. The European Airplay Top 50 (note it's now a Top 50) now also includes publishers information and is down to only 50 titles to give a more accurate picture of what has been played in Europe. This Airplay Top 50 is compiled with the help of various media report organizations, such as Media Control Germany, Switzerland, France and the playlist of Stichting Top 40 Holland, as well as through the tips given by our correspondents. You will also find this chart now on a different page in order to give those that are hanging our charts on the wall the chance to use all charts (so far the Airplay Charts was on the back of the European Top 100 Singles). Very regular features you will continue to find are Alexandra's News Corner, the Chart Chat article which gives details about the various charts and background on the artists and of course Media Talk, the news section from the major radio and television personalities in 17 European countries.

There are a number of very respectful tipsheets around the world. We already work together with Kent Report Australia, and are using from time to time information as provided by this most reliable source. We are happy to announce that we will also work in close association with Rockpool, the Dance Report in the States, as well as the informative New On The Charts, Leonard Kalikow monthly update on chart information in the USA. Furthermore we also welcome The Record, the most influential tipsheet in Canada, published by David Farrell.

Members of the Club can also vote for the best music videos to be used in Veronica's new television program Club Clips broadcast each monday afternoon. Their Rockprogram Countdown will from now on be presented by Adam Curry, former deejay of Amsterdam's Pirate Decibel. SWF, the influential station in Baden Baden Germany has it's annual open air festival on June 6th in Ludwigshaven. The show, produced by Bernd Morhof and Promotor Frits Rau, will be on the air live and includes performances by Elton John, Joan Baez, Depeche Mode, Gianna Nannini and Howard Jones. DRS Switzerland is broadcasting the Golden Rose Pop Festival 1984 on 2 nights, May 26 and June 20. It includes a string of world famous artists and will be seen by many countries.

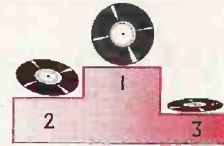

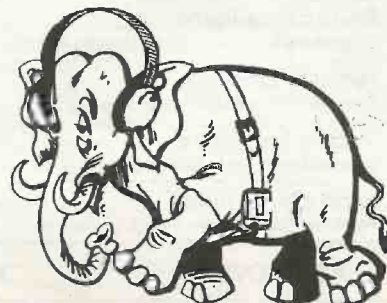

CHART CHATTING ON THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES

A lot of new entries this week. Highest entry this week of course for Swedish Eurovision Songcontest winners **Herrey's** with their **Diggi Loo-Diggi Ley** (a title which in the Dutch language easily can be transformed into something dirty). The swinging guys from **Wham!** are back into the charts with their follow up for **Club Tropicana** at nr. 28 due to a high entry in the UK at nr. 4! Speaking about ex- Jam members...while **Bruce Foxton** is new this week at 171 with his album **Touch Sensitive**, **Paul Weller's Style Council** comes in at 35 with the double A sided single **Grooving/You're The Best Thing**. Stage personality **Howard Jones** is new this week with **Pearl In The Shell** at nr. 50 (this is already the fourth single from the album **Human's Lib**, after successes with **What Is Love**, **New Song** and **Hide And Seek**). Due to Germany, Denmark and Holland **Fun Fun** comes in at a nr. 60 position. And well...what else could we expect after the tremendous amount of tips that came in last week for **Bruce Spingsteen's Dancing In The Dark?** The single is nr. 67 this week but will definately go up next week. Meanwhile we're all anxiously awaiting his new album. **Sade's** **When Am I Going To Make A Living** ('what a question after her international success with "Your Love Is King"??) is new at 85, while the new **Rod Stewart** single **Infatuation** makes a chart entry at 87. Another old time rocker from the early days, **Elton John** (**Sad Songs**), must be cautiously welcomed at 96. His recent concert tour was one of the best since long, according to some of our correspondents. Speaking about sad songs, **R.A.F.** comes in at nr. 93, their version of **Self Control** is picking up more response than **Laura Branigan's** version. The Top 10 European Singles doesn't differ that much from last week apart from a very fast move (22 to 9) for **Duran Duran's The Reflex**. Credits should not only go to the fantastic video (the most programmed video this week in Eurotipsheet) but also to **Nile Rodgers** who did the remixing. The very first single for German band **Nena** **99 Luftballons** is rising again due to high positions in a.o. France, Spain and Sweden. In Germany and Holland there is already a third one released and picking up a lot of airplay. **Lass Mich Deine Pirat Sein** (**Let Me Be Your Pirate**-whatever they're alluding to). Twenty one places gain for French artist **Claude Barzotti**, his **Je Ne T'ecrirai Plus** (**I Won't Write To You Anymore**) moves up from 51 to 29 thanks to France and Belgium. Some more French artists making big jumps this week are **Johnny Halliday** (his **Mon P'tit Loup** moves from 62 to 48) and **Gilbert Montagne** who is charted in both Italy and France

though with different singles (**On Va S'aimer** for France and **Just For Tonight** for Italy). Unbelievable but true, **Paul Young's** first single **Come Back And Stay** is moving again thanks to the rather late discovery (if you'll excuse us) in France for this record. **High Energy** (and that's what it exactly is, **High NRG**) from 69 to 53, 16 places up for **Evelyn Thomas**. Interesting to note that Dutch CBS group **V.O.F. De Kunst** is very successful in Greece (nr. 1) and the UK at the moment, though under the different name **Art Company**. Single is called **Suzanne**. Also worth mentioning this week is **Helen Terry's Love Lies Lost** (from 90 to 74 this week). She was known through her work with **Culture Club**. Another successful production for the ZTT label (**Trevor Horn** and **Paul Morley**) with **Propaganda** at 76 (from 93). The new **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** single (**Two Tribes**, a protest song so they say) will be released very soon, for the moment they are still nr. 1 with **Relax**. At 54 we find **Everything But The Girl** (yes, that's the name of the group) with the lovely jazzy **Each And Everyone**. This deserves to be big elsewhere but until now none of our correspondents outside of the UK have even mentioned it. Such A Shame...Jazz music seems to be rediscovered lately, **Joe Jackson's** album was dedicated to **Sonny Rollins**, **Style Council's Cafe Bleu** is a direct return to the existentialist days with all it's black and combo jazz (especially the beautiful new version of **Paris Match!**) and not to speak about **Carmel's The Drum Is Everything** with it's basic jazz line up and material.
