**The Fixx - Phantoms- MCA**  
 With their 2nd album Reach The Beach, The Fixx broke the American market last year. Both the album as the singles from it One Thing Leads To Another and Saved By Zero were fixed for the charts. Despite a lot of media attention they never achieved such a status in Europe. Their style is hard to pinpoint. They combine spare swinging parts with sophisticated imaginative arrangements. With Jamie West-Oram's raw guitar sound, Cy Curnin's distinctive vocals and lyrics plus an inventive production of Rupert Hine, this album is a logical extension to their last one. Strongest tracks: *Less Cities, More Moving People, Woman On A Train, Wish, I Will and Are We Ourselves.*



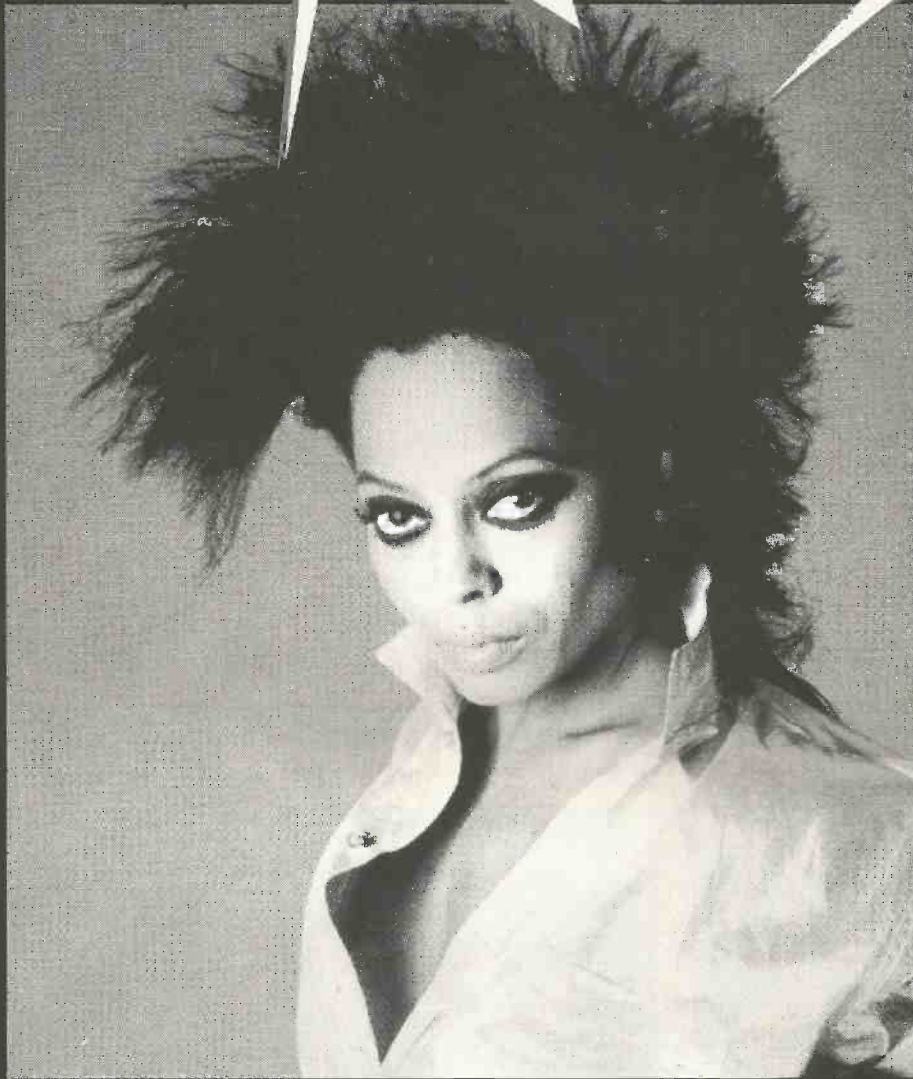
**Peter Wolf - Lights Out- EMI-America**  
 For his first solo effort former J. Geils Band singer Peter Wolf collaborates with Michael Jonzun, leader of the electro street funkband Jonzun Crew (hit: Pack Jam). Quite an unexpected combination but it definately works. The marriage of hard funk with hot R & R and R & B comes off without compromise to either side. From rap (*Oo-Ee-Diddley-Bop!*) to Motown (*Baby Please Don't Let Me Go*) to a rendition of Billy Holiday's *Gloomy Sunday* (with a beautiful solo of Adrian Belew). Even Mick Jagger shines on a track called *Pretty Lady*. A very commercial cross-over album appealing to both pop/rock fans as fans of the modern funk genre.



**Herbie Hancock - Sound-System- CBS**  
 The area of musical styles that Herbie Hancock has touched upon is impressive. Started as keyboardist with Miles Davis, Hancock later applied himself to fusion, disco, funk & rock. His most recent explorations are into the urban contemporary street music and although the opening track *Hardrock* continues in a similar vein to the smash *Rockit*, Hancock has enough maturity to prevent himself from mere repetition. Apart from hard electro funk (*Sound-System, Metal Beat*), he flirts with Brazilian and Japanese music (*Karabali vs Junku*), while *People Are Changing* is a standout soulful dance track aimed at Top 40 format.

**ABOUT THE CHARTS....**  
**THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):**  
In many European countries one chart is recognised by the music industry as the "OFFICIAL" hit parade and is therefore used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP100. However there are other countries where various charts are in existence and often equally important. For these countries we have compiled a number of these charts into one representing the sales in that market.  
Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied by a factor determined through the latest known sales percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such as IFPI-BPI-Gallup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc. A European Chart-Committee, with experts from a number of these industry-organisations will overlook the calculation system and will decide on improvements, changes and updates.  
For the EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 18 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20 charts are used from 15 countries. Since the sales percentages of a few countries are too small to get their hits into the EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not charted in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 IN EUROPE list each week.  
The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our correspondents tips received this week. ( ) Records of the week receive extra points. The airplay lists of the airplay report organizations within some of the European countries are also used in the calculations, as well as playlists of major radio stations. (P) Please note that not all received tips appear in Eurotipsheet but they are also used for the calculation of the Airplay Top 50.  
The EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on television throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It includes video-t.v. programs and other t.v. shows partly using video's from 14 European countries.

## MEDIA TALK

In England, Jill St. Clair exchanged her producing job for 'Pop Quiz' to one with the increasingly popular 'The Tube'. At radio level, Capitol Records' Kid Jensen takes over Michael Aspel's spot, while Chris Tarrant fills the programs previously held by Mike Allan. John Sachs has an early afternoon show, while Richard Allinson does the 10 - 12 evening program. Mike Allen now does a weekend show. Gary Crowley has a magazine type show four nights a week, and Michael Aspel might return on sunday mornings.  
The big change at BBC 1 is that Tony Blackburn has left and will concentrate more on his 'Radio London Soul Show'. Further important new programs include Peter Powell who does the weekend morning show, Tommy Vance has a thursday A.O.R. and heavy-metal program, Richard Skinner does Saturday live Round Table and the Top 40 on sundays, while Janice Long has an evening show 4 nights a week. Some more announcements are expected.  
Somewhat more up North, Leif Wiwatt, who used to do the Poporama show for Sveriges Riksradio in Norrkoeeping will from next week on return to the Swedish Television to work for a 'Video Top List' program, to take off the 21st of October. Producer of this new program will be Gunilla Friis. Every sunday a Video Top 10, including 5 new contenders, will be presented to a jury of listeners. Together with a video list, live concerts will be featured for which Leif Gothlund and Urban Lasson will be responsible.

## FREDDIE MERCURY?

The Poporama show however will cease to exist and replaced by a new program called "Tracks", under the supervision of Kalle Oldby who used to do the Poporama show before Leif took over for the summerseason. The program will have a monthly spotlight on a local European act.  
According to an investigation by the British paper The Standard a BBC journalist seems to be one of the mystery people behind the setting up of the powerful pirate radio station in the North Sea Laser 558. Laser 558 is at the moment one of the most advanced pirate stations ever floated and has already a strong signal over a large part of Europe.  
During the Hi-Fi exhibition in Zurich (the Ferra), the first private TV station in Switzerland will be launched in a joint cooperation between Radio 24, the Ringier organization (publishers) and Radio Rediffusion. The fare will take place from August the 29th till September 3rd and this will be a trial period for the new station.  
After the allowance of the Swiss government the station will start to run in full operation in '88. Thanks for the exciting news Clem, but is it true that Roger Schawinsky now looks like Freddie Mercury?

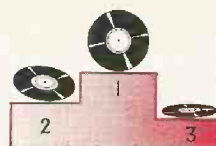
