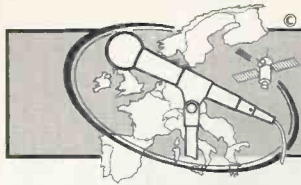

## Singles Guide

When you receive this week's Eurotipsheet, the leaders of the recording industry are gathering in Munich for IMIC 1985. Various panels will discuss the present state of the industry as well as future plans. One of the subjects that will likely attract a lot of interest is the *International Crossover Phenomenon*. If you look at Billboard of last week, you can see how well European productions are doing on the other side of the Atlantic. As mentioned in Paul Grein's Chart Beat: "The Top 8 Singles on this week's Hot 100 are all by acts from outside the US, pointing up the increasing importance of the international market as a spawning ground for new talent. Of the artist in the Top 8 this week, Wham!, Tears For Fears, Sade, Billy Ocean and Howard Jones are all English, Simple Minds is Scottish, Harold Faltermeyer is German and Bryan Adams is Canadian". The only American acts in last week's Top 10 were the Mary Jane Girls and Kool &

The Gang. This may be one of the reasons why Eurotipsheet is making more and more impact on the US Market. We welcome many A&R experts from the American labels currently subscribing to our magazine and promise to keep them fully informed about new European productions coming up!

### DOG HOWLING

So for those of you interested in local records with strong crossover potential, we have 3 new great candidates for you! First of all Germany's group Nena with their new tune *Feuer Und Flamme*, rocky and heavy but maybe lacking an immediately recognizable chorus marking their earlier releases. From Italy comes Tibor Levay with his weird and cheerful ditty, *Gipsy Boobie* (Baby Records Italy), filled with dog howling and a gypsy violin that leads into the melody. Could be a surprise hit on the Continent. Tracy Laurente's version of the movie song *Electric Dreams from Carrere France* is our 3rd tip for Crossover and a very good one too! The American born (but presently living in Paris) singer, delivers a quite interesting and well-produced MOR disco tune.

Mick Jagger's single *Lucky In Love* is being played very strongly although it looks like sales are not coming through as quick as expected. And talking about sales, various people were disappointed with the numbers on the David Bowie album, but with the current tremendous success for the re-mixed single *Loving The Alien* (this week's highest entry in the European Airplay Top 50 at 20), we have no doubt that sales on his lp will pick up considerably.

### IT DOESN'T !!

The beautiful slow love song of the American born Phyllis Nelson was already a no. 1 in the UK and is about to enter the Continental charts very soon. This no. 1 in England makes her the second woman who wrote as well as sung a no. 1 hit in the history of the British charts. (The other lady is Kate Bush with *Wuthering Heights* in 1978). Another remarkable feat is that the single reached the top of the English chart without the support of a video, which is one good argument for the IMIC panel discussing the topic "Does Video Kill The Audio Star?". Fortunately for you, our beloved deejays... IT DOESN'T!!

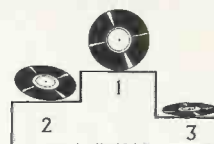

## EXPLICIT LYRICS

Both airplay-wise and on retail level Dire Straits' *Brothers In Arms* continues to be Europe's hottest album. The album makes a strong move this week to no. 9 (from 15 in its second week only) and that while the single *So Far Away* is not really taking off.

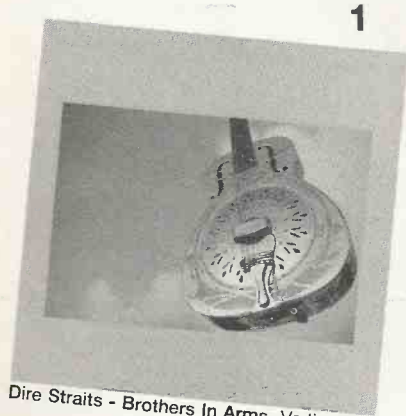
We continue to get strong reports on the Eurythmics album with various titles getting top priority. A lot of (especially Southern) stations are anticipating the new single release to be *There Must Be An Angel* by choosing this one as record of the week in favour of the current single *Would I Lie To You*. With the significant influence that disco and dance sounds have on the charts, it is not a surprise to see that a lot of other Euro-deejays are choosing *Sisters Are Doin' It For Themselves* (the duet with Aretha Franklin) as another of their favourites. Speaking about the Queen Of Soul, we are very much looking forward to the June release of Franklin's new album

*Who's Zoomin' Who*, produced by Narada Michael Walden for Arista. One more example of the current boom of disco material is the recent move in the European Top 100 Albums of Dead Or Alive's album *Youthquake*. This collection of one dimensional disco beats moves up to 22 (from 51) and has good chart positions in the UK, Germany, Belgium, Holland and Denmark. Other hot album releases for it will be most interesting to see how European deejays and programmers will react on Marvin Gaye's latest *Dream Of A Lifetime*. Tracks like *Masochistic Beauty* and *Savage In The Sack* contain some very explicit lyrical contents that might (as the album cover warns) offend some listeners. We weren't offended at all although the above tracks are not his strongest. The men's sensual voice shines best in tracks like *It's Madness* and *Symphony*.

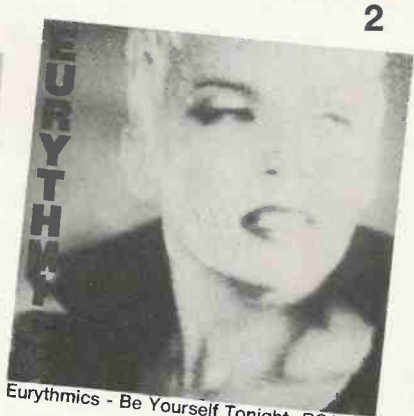
