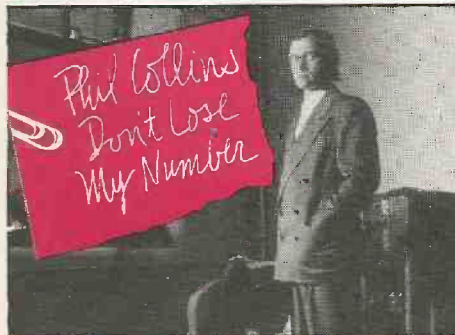

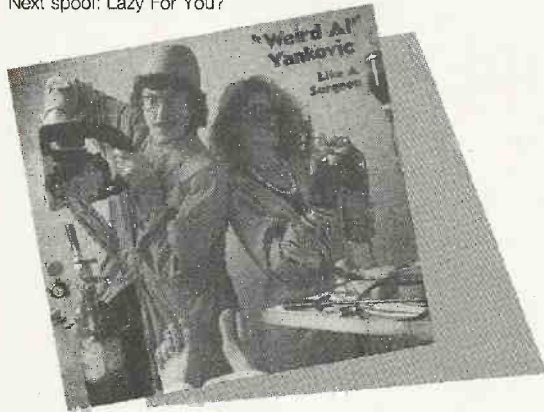

PRIVATE PARTY

Not only has Tina Turner one of the most successful come backs in the Eighties, she'sFDHalso the most successful female artist in the history of Eurotipsheet. It is exactly one year ago that her album entered the European Top 100 Albums (at 87); two weeks later it landed at no. 10 and after wandering for 10 weeks in the Top 20, it re-entered the Top 10 and with the exception of one week (position no. 11), it never left the Top 10 until now, and even made the no. 1 spot for 5 weeks of which 4 consecutive times. The only serious female competitor is Sade, she is charted for the 46th week.

On the male side, it is surprising that it is the English troubadour Roger Wittaker who has the longest running album until now (61 weeks) solely due to Germany. Of course Lionel Richie and Michael Jackson hit higher spots in the Top 100 but not such long running albums (Richie 59 weeks, Jackson 45 weeks). Other long

running albums for Prince (46 wks), the German singer Herbert Groenemeyer (55 wks), Billy Idol (45 wks) and ZZ Top (49 wks).

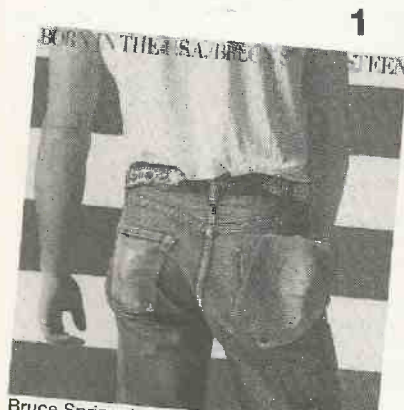
The new Marillion album is this week's highest entry (at 42) and so far charted in Germany and Holland but the UK will most probably follow next week. The *Misplaced Childhood* album is a concept album and this brings back memories of the early Seventies when it was common mode for bands like Little Giant, Genesis and Pink Floyd.

Your sample parcels this week should contain strong new releases from Sting, OMD, Beach Boys and Men At Work. Apart from the single *Spread A Little Happiness* in '82, the *Dream Of The Blue Turtles* is Sting's first solo outing.

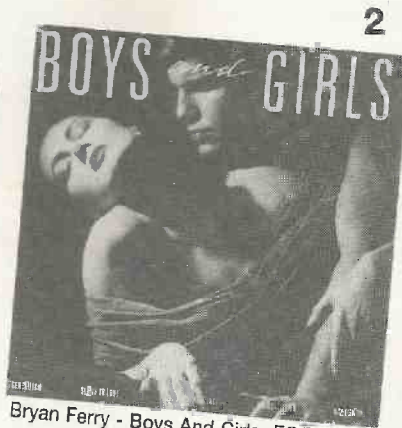

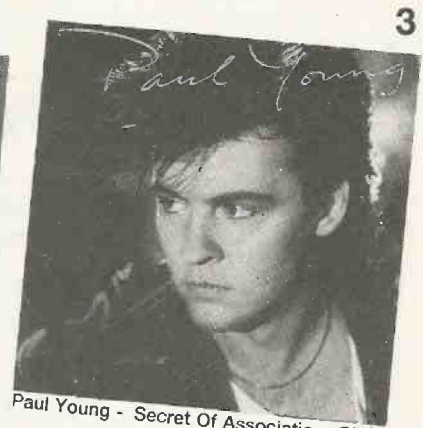

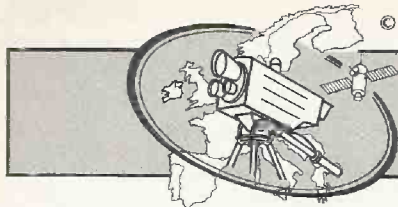

Good to see a number of our earlier Euro Crossover tips making it with their videos too. Even in the UK Euro acts such as MODERN TALKING, UDO LINDENBERG, STAR SISTERS, MAI TAI and TIME BANDITS have their clips shown ★ For those of you who would like to know a bit more about great video producers such as *Tim Pope, Russell Mulcahy, David Mallet, Annabel Jankel and Julian Temple* and also read about the rise of promo videos could order *The Rolling Stone Book Of Rock Video* written by Michael Shore and published in the UK by Sidgwick & Jackson ★ FINE YOUNG CANNIBALS, the new English band (consisting of two ex-Beat members), may not have the most extravagant clip, but the terrific energy of the song Johnny Come Home translates very well into the video images. One of this weeks favourites! ★

Bernard Chevry's VIDCOM will happen the third week of October (21-25) in Cannes. The emphasis will be centered totally on programming. Meanwhile it looks like the 1985 St.Tropez Video Music Festival will be much more reduced this year ★ PAUL HARDCASTLE's video clip for "19" has caused a lot of angry reactions in the USA for their graphic "Vietnam" footage. Not only did major networks ABC and NBC protest the use of their original footage mixed into the clip, but there were also many calling the use of this original non fiction war footage into a rock video "unworthy". In the meantime, back here in Europe two different versions are both being aired ★

MTV is presenting a teaser video campaign for PHIL COLLINS upcoming single Don't Lose My Number where the audience can actually select the direction of the clip ★ With many of the lavish high-tech video productions so well featured on TV the past year, it is refreshing to see a number of acts opt for a much more "basic" kind of production. It results in sober clips such as the natural looking NEW ORDER and the ones by U2. These clips often give a much better idea of the image of the act and may reflect a growing tendency towards "roots" as also seen on the audio side ★ Music Box's presence at IMIC was almost overpowering with all hotelrooms connected to the program and a heavy marketing presentation presented by *Marcus Bicknell*.

PAY FOR PLAY

Pay For Play, the campaign to get the TV Music programs to pay for the use of the clips is continuing and it especially in the US it stirred a lot of emotional reactions. Many new popular TV shows are likely to go off the air as they will be unable to come up with the extra finances. With CBS leading the way and Warner Bros expected to follow soon, Pay For Play will become the operative reality by the end of 85. In Europe the picture is not different with most countries already having some sort of arrangement between video producers and the broadcasters. Although many labels are expected to drag their feet on the issue, secretly providing major shows with free clips, it is anticipated that even in the countries without a negotiating legal industry body, the practice will be adopted by all labels eventually ★

Other headline news from across the Atlantic is the imminent, long anticipated sale of MTV. It would mean the split between Warner Communications and American Express. Insiders expect a leverage buy-out by MTV's key personnel *Dave Horowitz* and *Bob Pittman*. Such buy-outs are not unusual in America as was recently proven again by the sale of Billboard Publications to a group of investors (The Boston Venture Group) together with in house officers *Jerry Hobbs* and *Sam Holdsworth*. Best sales on music videos are for Wham!, Madonna and Tina Turner, but undoubtedly they will be surpassed this month by the *We Are The World* Video Event. New interesting clips this week: FREDDIE JACKSON *Rock Me Tonight*, a boy meets girl clip, a first for THE BEACH BOYS with *Getcha Back*, which shows childhood sweethearts who are separated and meet again years later. Then there is the new clip from Big BOB DYLAN and an entertaining one from the TALKING HEADS. Plus new ones from STYLE COUNCIL, HIGHWAY CHILE (directed by Dutch film maker Dick Maas, also known for his works for GOLDEN EARRING's promo clips, for the track *Christine*; only available in the US so far) and DEAD OR ALIVE ★ A new addition this week to our Euroclips (and no doubt it will shoot up!) is the STING clip for *Set Them Free* ★

The BPI sees a profitable future for the record companies when it comes to video. In their annual report to the membership of BPI, Director General *John Deacon* predicts these videos to become "real profit centers" ★ Will the special Anti-Alcohol clip "Don't Drive Drunk" with a song written and performed by Stevie Wonder ever been shown in Europe. In the USA this specially designed clip is used to point the younger public to the dangers of excessive use of alcohol. Is there anyone out there using this good initiative? We hope so!

The masters of 'thinking man's rock' have chosen for a looser approach. The maniacal tension that marked their earlier releases has gone and is replaced by accessible and fresh pop songs. There is so much to enjoy like *Creatures Of Love*, *And She Was* and *Road To Nowhere* (with its a-capella intro).



Elisa Waut - Elisa Waut - Mega Disc
One of Belgium's upcoming new talents creating a very atmospheric and nostalgic sound on their debut (mini) album. They combine influences like the French Chanson, New Wave and acoustic folk into a very convincing unique style. Our faves are *Growing Pain* and *Russia*.

John Cafferty & The Beaver Brown Band - Tough All Over - Scotti Brothers
A band already very popular in the US and operative in much the same vein as Bruce Springsteen; big city rock, intermingled with softer spots. Check out tunes like *Strangers In Paradise*, *More Than Just One Of The Boys* and *Voice of America's Sons*.



Mink DeVille - Sportin' Life - Polydor
Mr. Romantic himself, returns with a new album for a new label. Musically spoken, not much has changed though: a balanced set between latin, blues and rock mixed with his passionate vocals. Tracks like *When You Walk My Way*, *In The Heart Of The City* and *There's No Living*, deserve backing on Euro-Radio.



Fiorella Mannoia - Momento Delicato - Ariston
Our favourite Italian singer at the moment. Miss Mannoia has a beautiful and warm voice which fits the restrained arrangements perfectly well. Best moments include *L'Aiuola* (no. 1 Euro-Crossover this week), *L'Anima Lo Sa* and *Viva La Vita*.



Bon Jovi - 7800 Degrees Fahrenheit - Mercury
This second album (produced by Lance Quinn) shows the band's great potential to become real big. Brilliant guitar solo's and sophisticated arrangements. The current single entitled *Only Lonely* is a definite favourite!



Scritti Politti - Cupid & Psyche '85 - Virgin
Brilliant second album containing their current single *The Word Girl* and their 3 earlier single releases. Tracks like *Perfect Way*, *Small Talk* and *Don't Work That Hard* are more than strong examples of the band's (i.e. Green) unique way of song writing.



Midnight Oil - Red Sails In The Sunset - Sprint/CBS
Very promising Aussie band with already strong following Down Under and in the the US deserving to get more attention in Europe. A strong militant collection of songs (listening pleasure extends to more than 50 minutes!).

IN OUR COMPACT ROUTE

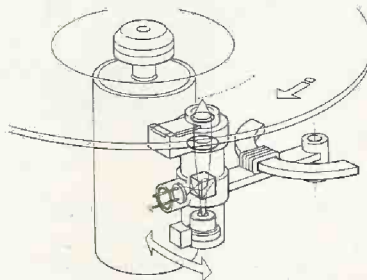
With the enormous combined campaign from Philips and Polygram it comes as no surprise that the Dire Straits CD is the best played CD around Europe and so heads our Route. But next month it may well be replaced by Bruce Springsteen as he completes his triumphant tour. Special mention should be given to West Side Story which sounds brilliant. Alan Parsons Ammonia Avenue, which is digitally mixed and mastered sounds great, due also to its fine production and an overzealous use of new technology. And by the way, we would like to see more CD's containing extra tracks, like with Phil Collins and Tears For Fears latest albums. CD provides room for 60 minutes of perfect reproduction and it is a pity that labels and artists are not yet using this possibility to its maximum. But in the meantime, let's have your news fast!

SPECIALITY SHOPS & PROGRAMS

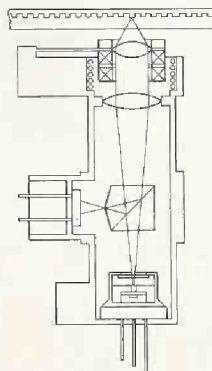
In most countries around Europe as well as in the US an increasing number of specialty stores are springing up for CD. Obviously these shops carry a much broader repertoire than the normal outlets and are doing good business. They are able to make a much more attractive offering to customers using design and layout effectively. At radiolevels the picture looks the same with many CD- only programs starting to become increasingly popular. These shows not only play the new best-quality releases, but often also give some technical CD info regularly.

But at the same time the major labels more and more use CD as just one extra form of sound carrier in their marketing campaigns and are not separating the medium from the normal singles/albums promotion. The only distinction they seem to make is in the offering of promotion records. CD's are not given free of charge to radio stations even if they carry special CD programs. COMPACT DISC: HOW IT WORKS



Laser light is focussed into the disc's bright, reflective surface where it reads the microscopic pits as either a high reflected light level or a very low level since light is scattered in the pits. These signals are converted into electronic digits by the illustrated photo diode. Note the tracking arm, which moves from the inside to the outside with a progressive speed change from 500 to 200 revolutions/minute.



The CD laser beam pickup: one milliwatt of power is all that is needed by the tiny light beam. Yet it reads every last detail of the digital information on the disc.

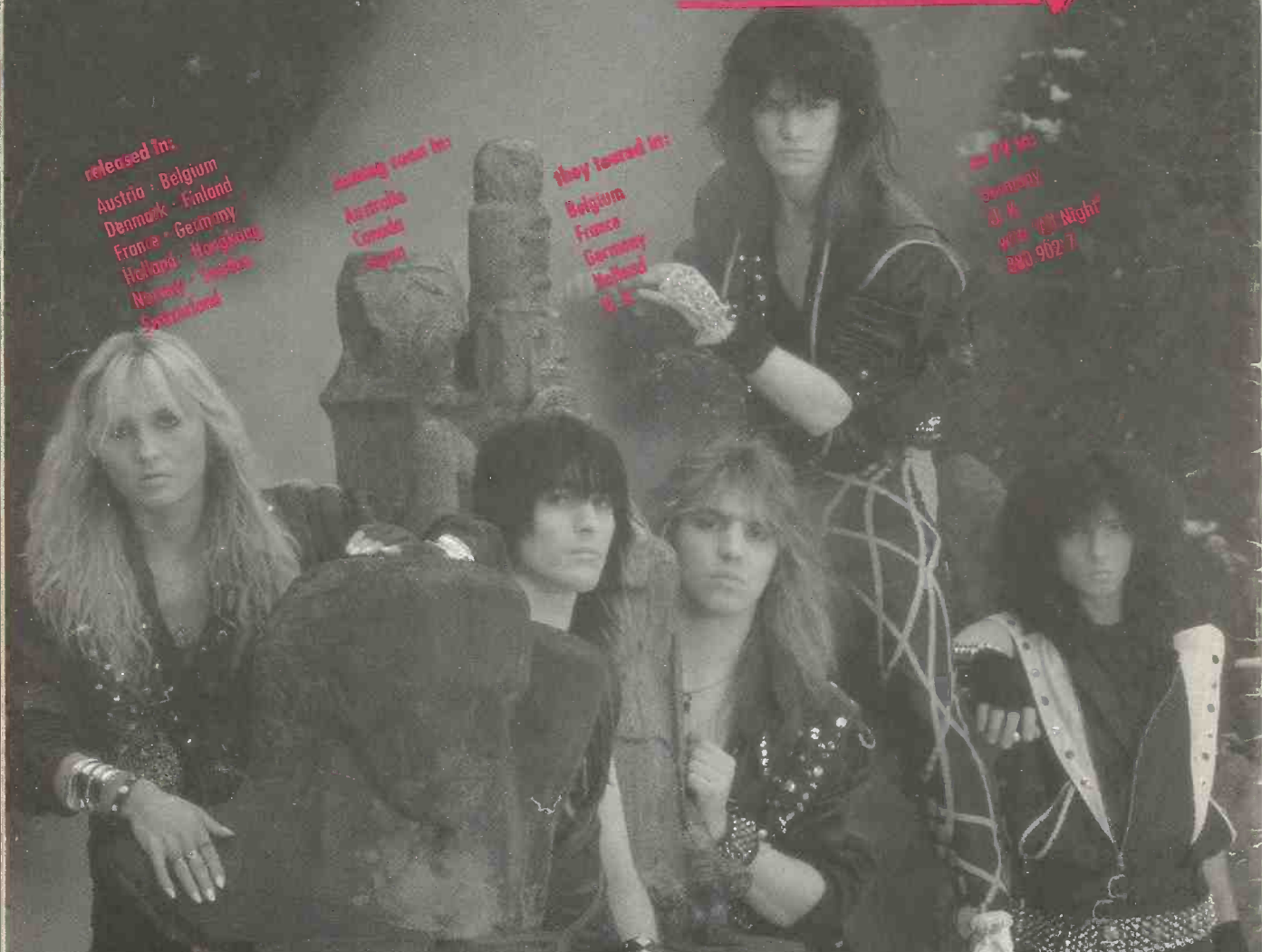

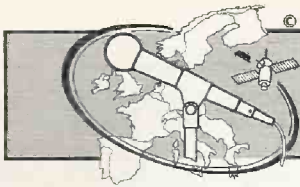

Singles Guide

No less than 5 records are this week's favourites for Euro-Crossover, 4 from Southern Europe and one from Germany. *Fever* by Tipinifini is another Italian delight produced by our correspondent Claudio Cecchetto; a fine uptempo dance tune, already climbing the Italian charts. Den Harrow delivers with *Future Brain* a nice sing-a-long track with an effective electronic backing. The Spanish 3-piece band Mecano come up with a great song entitled *Hawaii Bombay*, a fresh and modern approach with a sunny and laid back Caribbean tinged production. More crossover from the 15 years old Mexican singer Luis Miguel; his song *Noi Ragazzi Di Oggi* (We, boys of today) is an Italian production on EMI and has that typical summer feel; the romantic vocals over a full orchestral backing. And moving up North, Germany brings us the formation **Bad Boys Blue** with the easily appealing *You're A Woman*: "Hitverdaechtig" (looks like being a hit) as

the Germans call it...

If you only have room to add one record this week, it should be *Good-bye Bad Times* by Philip Oakey & Giorgio Moroder. The distinctive voice of Oakey set against the recognizable MOR disco production by the illustrious Moroder, makes it ready to attack the charts. Radio would also be wise to program Peabo Bryson's *Take No Prisoners* (about to be released in Europe through WEA Int.); a lively dance track, excellent produced by the ubiquitous Arif Mardin.

SERIOUS WARNING

The re-united Squeeze come up with a beautiful and moving ballad entitled *Last Time For Ever* deserving to get strong backing on Euro- Radio! Before we go over to some chart action, we still want to point our finger to those stations who haven't picked up on the amazingly good and demanding single by **Fine Young Cannibals**. Don't say we haven't warned you! The most successful Euro-Crossover act at the moment is the Austrian band **Opus** who hit Top 5 this week, as the single is suddenly moving up in the UK and France (as last markets in Europe). The

other successful Euro act in the Top 10 is the original version of *Around My Dream* by **Silver Pozzoli** (although this one does not get the support of the UK and is only charted in France, Germany, Benelux and Denmark). And Euro-talent continues to hit the charts with **Scotch** (20-55) and **Baltimora** (35-42) (both Italian productions) further moving up.

BALLADS

Madonna has two singles charted in the European Top 100 this week. *Crazy For You* is her first ballad hitting our charts (from the Vision Quest Soundtrack on Geffen) and jumps to 13 (from 27). The 3rd single release from the Like A Virgin album, *Angel* (the second ballad after a string of dance hits) is the other one sgd is new at 87, due to good positions in Germany, Belgium and Denmark. It is interesting to see that the B-side of *Angel*, *Into The Groove* gets heavy airplay in some European markets as well (notably Italy). This track comes from the forthcoming motion picture *Desperately Seeking Susan* in which Madonna plays a leading part. Talk107g about building a superstar!

Because Steve has not been on air, *Mark Page* has been sitting in for him, *Grahame Bannerman* has been sitting in for Mark at weekends, and *Janice Long* has been sitting in for Grahame. Confused yet!!!! I certainly am.
Bruce mania hit these shores recently, and Bruce even made the National television news recently. Bruce incidently gave £16,000.00 away to the families of miners who were affected by the recent strike. Even if he never sells another record, the prs money from recent airplay will do very nicely for Bruce.

Recently in the UK for promotion was *Hugh Mascokela* who appeared on the *Terry Wogan* show and *Arena*. *Thereza Bazar* also appeared on *Wogan* and *Wide Awake Club*. *Nick Heywood* has been on the *Saturday Picture Show*, *Breakfast Time*, *Gary Crowley Show* at *Capital Radio* and *Timmy Mallet Show* on *Piccadilly Radio* in Manchester. *Sting* has been

on *Whistle Test*, *Terry Wogan Show*, *Good Morning Britain* for TV-AM, and the *Kid Jensen Show* over at *Capital Radio*. *Big Sound Authority* were on the *Wide Awake Club*. *Bucks Fizz* have been on TV-AM's *Good Morning Britain* show and BBC Television's *Saturday Picture Show*. Over at *Radio One* *Dixie Peach* fresh from his first television appearance interviewed *Nightranger*, and various members of *Reo Speedwagon* for his Saturday night *Radio One* show. *Vince Clarke* and *Paul Quinn* popped in to *Radio One's* Saturday Live, as did *The Damned*, and even James Bond himself, *Roger Moore* was interviewed by *Richard Skinner*. The greatest non-event in the history of broadcasting was *Andy Batten/Foster's* interview with *Nick Cave*.

New jock to *Radio One* will be *Paul Jordan*, he has worked for *Radio City* up in *Liverpool*, and also in *Hospital Radio*. Paul will be doing relief work to start with. Leaving *Radio Two* is *Steve Jones* who has been with the network for a couple of years. Steve will be joining *LBC*. Leaving *LBC* to concentrate more on his television work is *Bob Holness*.

A couple of sad events in broadcasting both occurred recently. One which I originally decided not to mention, and the other one which happened just recently. The first unhappy event concerned *Radio Trent* dj *Grahame Neile*. Some weeks ago Grahame was arrested by the police under suspicion of murdering his girlfriend *Lynn Goldingay*. Sadly Grahame committed suicide in his prison cell after hearing of the suicide of the man that Lynn was going to leave Grahame for.

Another great loss in the world of broadcasting has been a man that many people under the age of twenty have probably never heard of. However, in the days of pirate radio, in the early Sixties when *Radio London* ruled the airwaves, a man named *Tony Windson* was a household name. He helped so many young dj's such as *Keith Skues* and *Tony Blackburn*, and later when the pirates ran aground TW, as he was known by all, found himself working for *Radio Luxembourg* on the programming side. His famous deep voice and catch phrase of 'Hello' saw me through the days of school homework but sadly TW never really made the big time in the UK radio business. He even discovered *Noel Edmonds* while working at *Radio Luxembourg*. Many people will miss this great man.

Anyway, enough sad news. A couple of trivia facts for you, back in the early Sixties, *Gerry & The Pacemakers* were the only UK band to have their first three records go straight to number one in the National charts. No one has ever beaten that record, although *Frankie Goes To Hollywood* almost equaled it. Now *Gerry*, has achieved a new record. He becomes the first ever UK artist to take the same song to number one in the charts twice, even though there is a twenty two year gap in the middle. While on the subject of that record by "The Crowd", I do believe that another record has been set too. Both *Capital Radio* dj *Grahame Dene* and *Radio One* dj *Dave Lee Travis* sang on the record. Possibly the first time that two dj's from rival radio stations have sung on the same record, and I could be right in also saying that it is the first time a radio dj in the UK has sung on a number one record too. Thank god *John Sachs* has never made a record, he would get a show on Saturday too apart from all the other days of the week (only joking John, really). Finally, it's great to see *Channel Four* rerunning Sixties greatest pop show *Ready Steady Go*. The rights to the show are owned by former pop star *Dave Clark*, and well worth watching.
