PAN EUROPEAN TAPES-LEVY BATTLE CONTINUES

Pan-European efforts to secure home taping legislation took a step forward when IFPI staff met with EEC Commission officials in Brussels recently to press for a Community-wide levy. The Commission's long-awaited Green Paper on copyright issues is expected shortly and will include a recommendation for all national governments to introduce levies, IFPI says.

But British plans to introduce a home taping levy on blank audio and video tapes, which were expected to be detailed in a government White Paper within a few weeks, are still in doubt, according to various apparently well-informed sources in London.

Although a consultative document on copyright reform pub-

lished earlier this year recommended a 25 pence levy on video tapes and a 10 pence levy on blank audio software, Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher and some of her advisers are apparently fighting shy of introducing what would amount to a direct new consumer tax with general election only a couple of years off.

Industry minister John Butcher reflected the government's attitude to video when he told parliament recently that the vast majority of taping was for time-shift purposes only. And where an audio levy is concerned, the British Phonographic Industry's case has been weakened, strangely enough, by a sustained upturn in record sales since 1983.

LASER 558 STRANDED RADIO CAROLINE STEALS FREQUENCY

Pirate radio ship Radio Laser is off the air. A combination of bad weather, dwindling supplies and total electrical failure forced the "MV Communicator" and its crew to limp into Harwich harbour, escorted by the British spy-ship vessel which has, at considerable expense, been tracking the U.S.-based broadcaster since August.

The spy-ship moored almost alongside Laser and offered help, but this was at first refused. When it was realized that nothing could be done aboard ship and that there was even a possibility of sinking, Laser's crew reluctantly accepted the ship's offer of help.

Disc-jockeys and technicians aboard said they'd suffered from lack of fresh food which had led to cases of scurvy and other ailments but this was later denied by Cap-

tain Patrick Paternoster. He said there had been no "mutiny" and that the sole problem had been generator failure aboard the 31-year-old ship.

Americans among the crew face deportation and the Britons could face charges under the Marine Broadcasting (Offences) Act of 1967, which carries penalties of hefty fines and imprisonment.

Police and department of trade officials who have interviewed the pirates say efforts to scupper the second pirate ship, Radio Caroline, would be stepped up. But even as Laser's general manager John Catlett arrived with a replacement captain and a lawyer, U.K. newspaper stories were unravelling Laser's chaotic finances. One writer said most of the station's income came from illegal payola.

EURO-ACTS FLOURISH CONTINENT PROVIDING INTERNATIONAL HITS

With the international breakthrough of Norway's A-Ha and Germany's Jennifer Rush the European Continent continues its string of international successes. 1985 has clearly been the best year yet for the European creators of pop/rock music and has delivered a string of international hits of which various became million-sellers.

For many years England has been seen as one of the creative world centres and it certainly was the focal point of European

creativity, but for a few years now the Continental European markets have stepped up their efforts to establish new international talent. 1985 has been an important year, showing that international hits are not just born in the major countries such as Germany and the UK, but can be expected from countries like Austria or Norway. Biggest hit of the autumn is undoubtedly A-Ha's 'Take On Me', which was already tipped in Eurotipsheet in issue 26 (July 1st). The record took a long time to break and there's no

UK MARKET UPTURN

Trade deliveries of records and tapes for the third quarter, July-September, in the UK were up 20% in value compared with the same period of 1984. It's the tenth quarter in succession that trade organization British Phonographic Industry (BPI) has recorded an upturn - and the first time that pre-recorded cassettes have overtaken LP discs.

Overall, the value of trade deliveries in the three-month period totalled 80.5 million pounds, up decisively on the 67.2 million pounds of July-Sept., 1984. That suggests, according to BPI, a full-year tally of around 580 million pounds against 329 million pounds last year.

In unit terms, cassettes showed a 20.3% increase over the third quarter of last year. But LPs held up well, too, says BPI, up 7.7% in 1984, despite the competition of tapes and Compact Discs.

The CD story, though, is the

main point. In this quarter, the unit figures were of 79,000 deliveries to the trade, up 309.8% on the same three months of 1984, and the value at manufacturers' realised prices excluding tax was 4.62 million pounds, up 275.5%. What's more, BPI is convinced that the CD explosion will continue throughout November, despite recent price increases. They'd predicted total CD sales of three million units this year. The first nine months produced 1.9 million and so the target figure should be reached over Christmas, perhaps very considerably.

The one weak spot. While the 12-inch format continued to perform well in the British marketplace, singles in general were down 4.5% to 17.9 million units, but with prices going up an average 8%, the actual value was up by 3.3%.

The Live-Aid concert in mid-summer had a notable effect on record sales in general in Britain.



Claudio Cecchetto is not only one of the most popular DJ's in Italy for Radio DeeJay and DeeJay Television, with his daily music video TV show, but also the creator and promoter of Ibiza Records. Ibiza Records was formed after the success of the single 'People From Ibiza' sung by Sandy Marton (pictured right of Cecchetto). Soon after, Sandy Marton with 'Camel By Camel', Taffy (on Cecchetto's left in the photo) with her 'Walk Into The Daylight' and Tipifini's 'Fever' all entered the Top 10 in Italy.

Ibiza Records' manager, Massimo Zucchelli, is increasing the output of the company and Sandy Marton and Taffy are expected to be out in Europe soon, with 'Exotic And Erotic' and 'I Love My Radio' respectively.

The latest group to be promoted by Cecchetto is Via Verdi with their first single 'Diamond'. Recently Radio DeeJay secured a contract with Eurotipsheet to use the European Hot 100 for a weekly TV presentation.

doubt that the strong video made a significant contribution. The record has topped the charts in the USA as well as all over Europe.

CBS Germany's Jennifer Rush has been a favourite amongst the Eurotipsheet editorial team for a long time and at first seemed only to break in her home country. But *The Power Of Love* is now rushing up the European charts and it has already sold over 1 million copies in the UK alone, making it the first single this year in the English charts with such a spectacular record. Ballads have always been the biggest sellers once they broke on the European continent. The German speaking countries (Germany, Switzerland, Austria) have had a terrific year with Falco (*Rock Me Amadeus*; incidentally written and produced by Dutch duo Bolland), Opus (*Live Is Life*; no. 1 in the European Top 100 Singles and, so far, together with *Tarzan Boy*, the only Euro-production to have reached such a feat), TXT (*Girls Got A Brand New Toy*), Bad Boys Blue (*You're A Woman*) and Michael Cretu (*Samurai*) all reaching good sales in a number of countries. During the last two months of '85 these will be supplemented with an enormous hit for Sandra (Maria Magdalena) originating from Virgin in Germany.

The other new international hit comes from Switzerland and is by a group called Double entitled *The*

Captain Of Her Heart. The major difference between hits produced in the UK and those coming from the Continent is the time it takes to become successful. In Britain new names can break through within two months while it can take up to five or six months for Continental European records to come up. Double was already tipped in Eurotipsheet 10 weeks ago and is just now starting to appear on international hitlists. In general the German market is a very healthy supplier of international hits: Nena, Alphaville and Peter Schilling peaked the international charts in '84 while Modern Talking, Sandra and Jennifer Rush are today's chart makers.

Another market which continues to come up with international sellers is Italy. Their biggest hit of '85 is undoubtedly *Tarzan Boy* by Baltimora, produced by EMI Italy. Earlier, they also had hits with Sandy Marton (*People From Ibiza*), Scotch (Disco Band), Raf (*Change Your Mind*), Den Harrow (*Future Brain*), Silver Pozzoli (*Around My Dream*) and Tullio De Piscopo (*Stop Bajon*). Spain provided a new CBS success with Ivan (two hits: *Fotonovela* and *Baila*), while Holland continues its annual range of single hits with sexy lady's trio Mai Tai (*History*), Time Bandits and *The Limit* (*Say Yeah*).

In general some of these European creations only appear in the international world of hits approximately three months after they've been first spotted in Eurotipsheet.

NEW FORMAT RIAS 2

The German Berlin based station Rias 2 started a new way of programming on the first of October. Modeled on American radio, Rias 2 is now a 24-hour music service with playlists, powerplays and only short news items. Every week a commission of five people choose 15 new records that are played at least 3-4 times a day. The emphasis is on new records from Germany, Europe and America and the rest consists of current

hits. Rias 2 has turned into a complete music station and the new format is proving to be a big success and the feedback it gets is enormous. The joining of the popular AFN disc-jockey Rik Delisle to the station has certainly helped in increasing the number of listeners.

The station's programmers are now anxiously awaiting the new radio ratings.

with record companies paying around 5,000 dollars for a package of 14 plays and 21 30-second commercials.

Catlett insists: "What we are doing is legally and morally correct. We do owe money, but hope to meet all our debts."

More high-seas pop radio drama came when Radio Caroline quickly moved in to take over the 558 frequency of its old Laser rival. This reportedly angered the BBC which was claiming that wavelength for its officially approved Radio Essex station when it starts in a few weeks.

Despite the rumours of a government re-think on the whole levy question, the BPI says it has been assured that the White Paper will be presented to Parliament on schedule, presumably before Christmas as originally intended, and that it will contain provisions for a software levy.

Even so, the various stages that have to be gone through before a bill becomes law mean that it could be at least a year, and probably longer, before a levy actually comes into effect in the U.K. France and West Germany are the only two Common Market states that already have audio and video software levies.

VIRGIN COMPANY OF THE YEAR

The Virgin Group, headed by Richard Branson, and taking in record production, an airline, retail outlets, a video division and book publishing interests, has been named British "company of the year" by the Confederation of British Industry.

The Business Enterprise Award was formally handed to Branson at a charity lunch in London. The group now employs more than 1,700 and in the last four years has increased turnover from 30 million pounds a year to a projected 200 million for 1985.

MR. MISTER : WELCOME TO EUROPE !

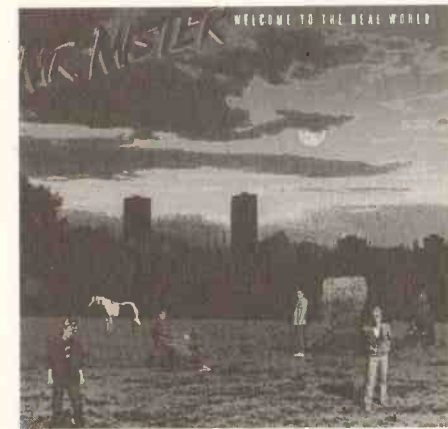
Mr. Mister's album *Welcome To The Real World* on RCA has already been out for a few months but is only recently beginning to create impact on European radio. At the moment the German market seems very receptive to their sounds and *Broken Wings* was bubbling under the European Airplay Top 50 last week. Hopes are very high that eventually it will break on Euro radio.

Currently the single is no. 7 in the US Billboard chart and the band is in the middle of a big US Tour as support act of Tina Turner.

The band's principles Richard Page (lead vocals and bass) and Steve George (keyboards, vocals) have been song writers and back-up singers for years, writing for and singing behind artists like Al Jarreau, Donna Summer, Quincy Jones and Rick Springfield. Recently they wrote 3 songs for the Pointer Sisters' current album *Contact*. The other 2 members of the band are Steve Ferris (guitar) and Pat Mastelotto (drums) and all the compositions on the album *Welcome To The Real World* are written by the 4 band members.

The band's basic songwriting is a powerful combination of AOR material with modern and colourful arrangements. Their composi-

tions bear a sort of urgency that immediately grabs. The opening cut *Black/White* carries a good guitar riff set against an energetic rhythm section and a good chorus. *Uniform Of Youth* continues this direct line of action and the synthetic sounds are very effective

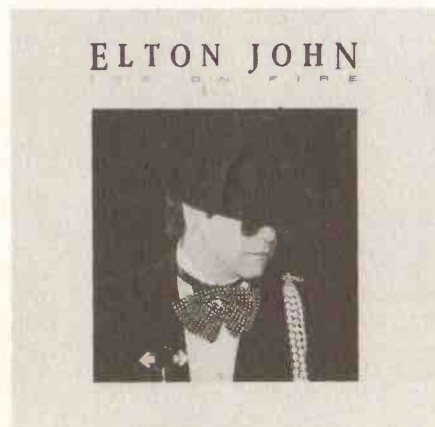

and inventive. Side 1 closes with *Into My Own Hands*, very catchy and up-tempo.

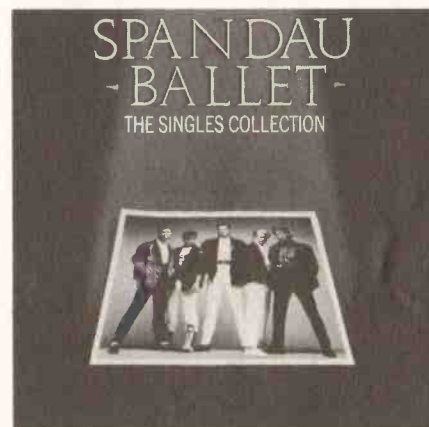
Side 2 is a further proof of the band's strong potential and its ability to write instant Top 40 material. *Is It Love* is the most poppy song so far injecting traditional pop elements into their AOR base. Other key cuts include *Kyrie*, the single *Broken Wings* (a dramatic and subtle ballad) and *Tangent Tears* (with its persistent and danceable overtones).

Mr. Mister know exactly what they want and they are a definite force to be reckoned with. A crystal clear musical concept and the right songs to get 'welcomed into the real world' of European radio!

TURNTABLE TIPS



Elton John - *Ice On Fire* - Rocket/Phonogram
The songwriting team of Elton John and Bernie Taupin have come up with yet another set of good hooks and good tunes. The album has a strong opener in *This Town*, rocky up-tempo with a sharp and punctuated horn section and backing vocals of Sister Sledge. Elton John is in a very up-tempo energetic mood considering tracks like *Wrap Her Up* (George Michael on vocals), *Satellite* and *Tell Me What The Papers Say*. But those in favour of the softer romantic spots should definitely check out the ballad *Cry To Heaven*, Elton in his most intimate moments.



Spandau Ballet - *The Singles Collection* - Chrysalis
UK band Spandau Ballet have a long and successful chart history and this sampler gives a good impression of all their highlights. Their first successful single was *To Cut A Long Story Short*, reaching no. 5 in the UK charts. Other hits followed like *Chant No. 1* and *The Freeze*, but Europe gave in with singles like *Gold*, *Only When You Leave*, *True* and *I'll Fly For You*. The *Singles Collection* is a very commercial compilation that will have no trouble making the charts.



Sade - *Promise* - Epic
With her first album *Diamond Life* still charted in the upper half of the European Hot 100 Albums in its 67th week (!), Sade Adu keeps up the cool and restrained stance on her latest album *Promise*, this week's highest entry in the European Hot 100 at 13 (together with *Tears For Fears* 2nd best entry this year after Alan Parsons- new at 12). Tracks like *Is It A Crime*, *Maureen* and *Tar Baby* continue the sophisticated line of her first album, although her voice sounds more delicate than before. Night-time programmers would welcome the sultry and undisputable highlight *Jezebel*.

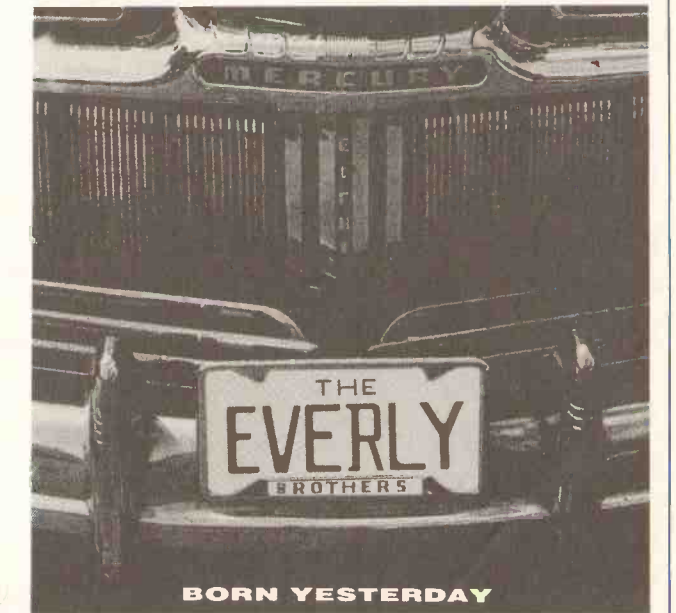
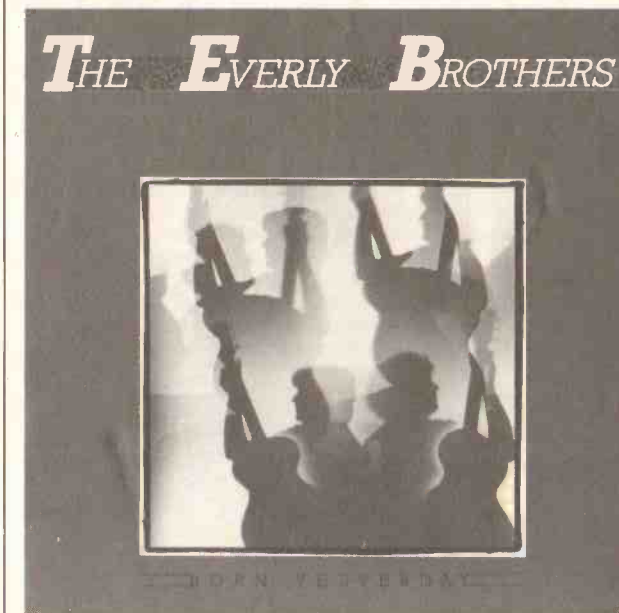

Dennis King - Rias/WDR
Dennis King is dj/producer for the Berlin station Rias where he has a four and a half hour programme on Monday night and a two hour programme on Saturday. Further to that he also presents the American Top 40 on WDR in Cologne.

"My Saturday-evening programme 'Euro-sound' (from 14.00 till 16.00 hours) is a chart programme in which the first hour concentrates on the American Top 30 and in the second hour I play the popular records in the different European markets for which Eurotipsheet is of great help.

I started programming the American band Starship quite early in the game, even before the record company released the single (We Built This City). I dare say we 'built' this record and the feedback we get is enormous. Starship is a good example of a specific type of music, AOR, making good impact in Europe now. Other more obvious examples are Bryan Adams, Don Henley, Glenn Frey and Bruce Springsteen. The latest boom of movie soundtracks like Miami Vice and St. Elmo's Fire were instrumental in introducing these sounds to Europe as well.

The latest Sade album Promise is fantastic and gets good coverage on Rias too. I'm also very fond of the new Ray Parker album Sex And The Single Man and the ABC album How To Be A Zillionaire proves the band's capacity for writing strong material. Jan Hammer's Miami Vice Theme also gets good plays in my show although I'm very surprised it was no. 1 in the States and top 5 in the UK. I think this was only on the basis of the popular TV series, because the song itself is in fact very simple and monotonous. More power-plays include Kate Bush's single Cloud-busting (just beautiful, what else can one say), John Cougar Mellencamp's Small Town (it is about time he really breaks in Europe), Mr. Mister's Broken Wings (a beautiful, slow track), Arcadia (Election Day) and ZZ Top (Sleeping Bag). I'm a bit disappointed about the album of Eddie Murphy, I expected something far funnier and the stuff on this album is very flat and uninspiring disco.

Singles Guide

It is already the 4th week that Norwegian A-Ha stays on top of the European Airplay Top 50. After it entered 6 weeks ago at 23 it moved up to no. 10 the week after and after 4 weeks at the no. 1 spot there are still no serious competitors as the difference with Grace Jones and Elton John is still unbridgeable. In the European Hot 100 the single even moves up to no. 2 with top positions in 9 European markets.

UB 40's duet with Chrissie Hynde, I Got You Babe, has left the European Airplay charts after 15 weeks but simultaneously the new UB 40 single *Don't Break My Heart* gets a number of major additions on European radio and jumps from 30 to 15. Swiss act Double, one of Eurotipsheet's prides, moves further up to 17 (from 21) due to new playlist appearances in the Benelux and some parts of Italy. No doubt in the weeks to come the single will enter various national hitparades and it only confirms the fact that so many Continental Euro-productions take weeks and weeks to finally make an impact all over Europe (this in contrast to the productions coming from the UK).

The most notable airplay movers this week include Level 42, Olivia, The Communards, Queen and Lloyd Cole. Wham! has not only just won a law suit issued against them by Barry Manilow about supposed plagiarism of the 1984 charity single *Last Christmas*, but their new single *I'm Your Man* is also this week's highest entry in the Airplay Top 50. Although the single is not yet charted in the UK it was the obvious pick for many European stations this week and the single is therefore highest entry at 28.

We are very happy to see the anti-apartheid single *Sun City* as second best entry at 32; an album of the same name is on its way and this star-studded single deserves your utmost attention.

Third best entry for American band Starship and while *We Built This City* (RCA) is this week no. 1 in the States, the single is one of the major additions on European radio and enters the European airplay at 42.

As you can read in a separate article on page 1, the climate for Euro-productions is

flourishing. With Maria Magdalena still at no. 21 in the European Hot 100, Virgin Germany releases the follow-up entitled *In The Heat Of The Night*, one that continues the Euro-disco line of the former. The single comes from a forthcoming album entitled *The Long Play*, arranged and produced by Michael Cretu. Further to that it is good to see Italian artist Den Harrow at no. 77 in the European Hot 100. *Future Brain* (Baby Records Italy) was one of our Crossover tips end of June this year: it is another example of the long route that Euro-productions sometimes have to take before making an impact on a wide European scale. Our Euro hit tip for this week is Heinz Rudolf Kunze and you can read in a separate review

under the Highlights section why we like this particular record so much. Yet one other successful Euro-production is Frank Farian's *Far Corporation*. *Stairway To Heaven* is a remarkable cover of the Led Zeppelin classic, already no. 8 (from 16) and not even charted in its home country Germany.

Watch out for the forthcoming single of Paul McCartney, on your desk very soon! *Spies Like Us* (Capitol) is a heavy-weight production over a rather repetitive beat, not quite what we expected and a deviation from his usual releases. It is the title song from the Warner Bros. Motion Picture of the same name.

Other strong airplay movers for Sun City, Mr. Mister, Hooters (*And We Danced...*) other countries have released *All You Zombies* and Dionne & Friends.

The two local singers, Jennifer Rush and Sandra are both doing particularly well with 2 singles each in the charts. Rush's *Destiny* is still climbing fast (6-10), while her *Power Of Love* has re-entered straight in at 32. Sandra's new song *In the Heat Of The Night* has come in at 34 and her *Maria Magdalena* continues to rise steadily (17-26).

FRANCE

Carrere act Century stays on top with *Lover Why* while Tina creeps up one notch to 2 putting back Eros Ramazzotti to no. 3. This week

Ramazzotti will receive a golden record from Pianola France for having sold 500,000 copies in the French market of his single *Una Storia Importante*. The Italian artist has already received golden records for a single and an album in Italy and Switzerland and his total European sales exceed more than 1 million copies.

Further strong selling singles in France include Madonna's *Groove*, Ariola act Monte Kristo (*The Girl Of Lucifer*, Eurythmics (*Angel*), the new Jean Jacques Goldman single *Je Te Donne* and Stevie Wonder.

BENELUX

The Benelux Top 10 remains static, with a fixed Top 5 (Simple Minds, Nana Mouskouri, Sandra, Grace Jones and Madonna) and only 2 new entries in the Top 10 (A-Ha: 6-15 and Jennifer Rush 9-20).

Airplay-wise it is good to see the Sun City single (*Apartheid*) as best played in Holland. The sales on the *Cloudbusting* single by Kate Bush still have to start, but the airplay on this one is very good (5th best played single).

ITALY

While Madonna stays at the top with *Groove*, Simple Minds move up further one place and the Duran Duran splinter Arcadia moves to no. 4 (from 9). New in the top 10 are: Cocciante & Mina with *Questione Di Feeling* (8-14) and Simply Red's *Come To My Aid* (9-17). Strong upcoming singles include Sade, Matt Bianco (*Yeh Yeh*) and Madonna's *Gambler*.

SWEDEN

Two Euro-productions hit the Swedish Singles Top 20 chart, Falco's *Amadeus* and Sandra. Every country nowadays ought to have its own African charity project but they don't all become as successful as the Swedish Metal-Aid

with their single *Give A Helping Hand*, currently at no. 3. Other Top 10 chartmakers for John Parr, Baltimore (2 singles, one at 5 and one at 6), Bad Boys Blue and Stevie Wonder.

DENMARK

And the African Aid-saga continues... The local charity single *Afrika* is still no. 1 while yet another charity single with the same name (though by another artist: Sebastian) is at no. 3. Shakin' Stevens (*Lipstick*) is highest entry this week at no. 12 and the other 2 entries in the Danish chart include Tears For Fears (*I Believe*; 27) and Jennifer Rush (29). Madonna has 4 singles charted with *Gambler* at 5, *Dress You Up* at 16 (with a bullet), *Holiday* at 19 and *Groove* at 28.

FINLAND

As the Finnish chart appears on a monthly basis the results are always a bit behind the other European countries. And erratic jumps are inevitable: Baltimore's *Tarzan Boy* from 30 to the no. 1 of the Suosikki charts. Last month's no. 1 (Madonna's *Groove*) falls back to no. 13 and new at no. 3 is Sandra. Other good selling singles in Finland for Modern Talking (*Cheri*), local act Sielun Veljet, Tina (*Hero*) and Stevie Wonder.

AUSTRIA

The no.1 in the Austrian Musikmarkt charts is taken by Norwegian A-Ha but local productions occupy the numbers 2 and 3, including Austrian production Joy with *Touch By Touch* (on the OK label, the same label that earlier had such a success with Opus) and Falco's *Vienna Calling*. Other good selling singles for John Parr, Laura Branigan (Spanish Eddie) and Patricia Simpson (*Dreams In The City*). Modern Talking, Sandra, Kool & The Gang and Michael Cretu remain with top positions



Jean-Jacques Goldman - Non Homologue - Epic France
 One of France's most popular artists with an album also released outside France. Included are his previous smash *Je Marche Seul* and more good up-tempo tracks such as *Compte Pas Sur Moi*, *La Vie Par Procuration* and his latest single *Je Te Donne*. English sung lyrics could help charting outside France.



Roberto Vecchioni - Bei Tempi - CGD Italy
 Album currently high in the Italian charts. A smooth polished album, combining cheerful catchy songs with staid ballads and carrying a careless, casual atmosphere. Most tracks lend themselves very easily for night-time play. Highlights include the title track, *Living Stone*, *La Mia Ragazza* and *Fata*.



Heinz Rudolf Kunze - Dein Ist Mein Ganzes Herz - WEA Germany.
 Album is about to enter the German charts and the title track (we can't get the chorus out of our heads!) will probably enter this week or next. Other tracks like *Fallensteller* and *Vertriebener* are contemporary hit radio tracks and the album definitely deserves a release outside Germany.

RUSH MOVIN'

With only a minor difference in points Madonna again interrupts the row of consecutive no. 1's for Dire Straits (see also last week's Albums Guide).

Half of this week's Album Top 10 is occupied by relatively new albums. Simple Minds have only been in the Top 100 for 3 weeks and have already landed at 6, Iron Maiden in its 4th week at 7 and even more impressive, ZZ Top in its second week already at no. 10 (last week no. 20). All this makes the Top 10 a dynamic one in which the flow of new albums is continuous.

The success of Jennifer Rush is now happening all over with her first CBS album already charted in UK, Germany, Sweden, Norway and Holland and making a jump from 35 to 12. The path it followed is rather erratic. It remained for more than a year in the second half of the European Hot 100 and in its 55th week it moved up to 43, a week later to 35 and now in its 57th week to no. 12. This makes her the only artist in the chart history of Eurotipsheet who needed more than a full year to reach the top. Meanwhile her second album *Movin'* (containing the hit *Destiny*) is at 39 and is so far charted in Germany (no. 1 for 2 consecutive weeks) and Switzerland.

Sade's new album *Promise* is this week's highest entry in the Hot 100 and the new position at 13 is together with *Tears For Fears* the second best entry made by an album this year in the European charts (the entry of Alan Parson's Project at 12 remains unbeatable so far). The album hit the English charts straight after its release at no. 1 and in Germany the album

is new at 7. Other good positions in Holland and Denmark so far. Further to that *Promise* is also best played album in Europe at the moment. Her smooth and sophisticated sounds do fit European radio very well and album programmers have plenty of good tracks to choose from. And although there isn't much of a change in musical style compared with the *Diamond Life* album, this is not seen as a disadvantage and is in fact only welcomed. Tracks like *Is It A Crime*, *Never As Good As The First Time* and *Maureen* reach the most consensus on Euro-radio. More details about this remarkable album on page 4 in a separate review.

Elton John proves to be a reliable chart performer, his new album *Ice On Fire* is this week's second highest entry at 31. The album carries a sense of urgency that is almost fanatic; many up-tempo tracks, driving rhythms and energetic arrangements in tracks like *Wrap Her Up*, *This Town* and *Tell Me What The Papers Say*. The soulful ballad *Cry To Heaven* is however a good step back from the hurried feeling of the other tracks. See also page 4.


The Singles Collection of Spandau Ballet is third best entry this week at 65 and a review can also be found on page 4.

Norwegian A-Ha move in their second week up to 25 (from 50) and the *Hunting High And Low* album is so far charted in UK, Germany, Sweden and Norway. We are getting very good reports of the track *Train Of Thought* and this one would have a good chance as the follow-up to the successful *Take On Me*. Other strong tracks include *The Sun Always Shines On TV* and *The Blue Sky*.



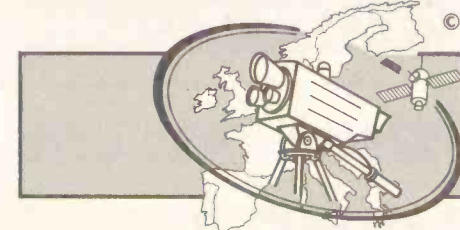

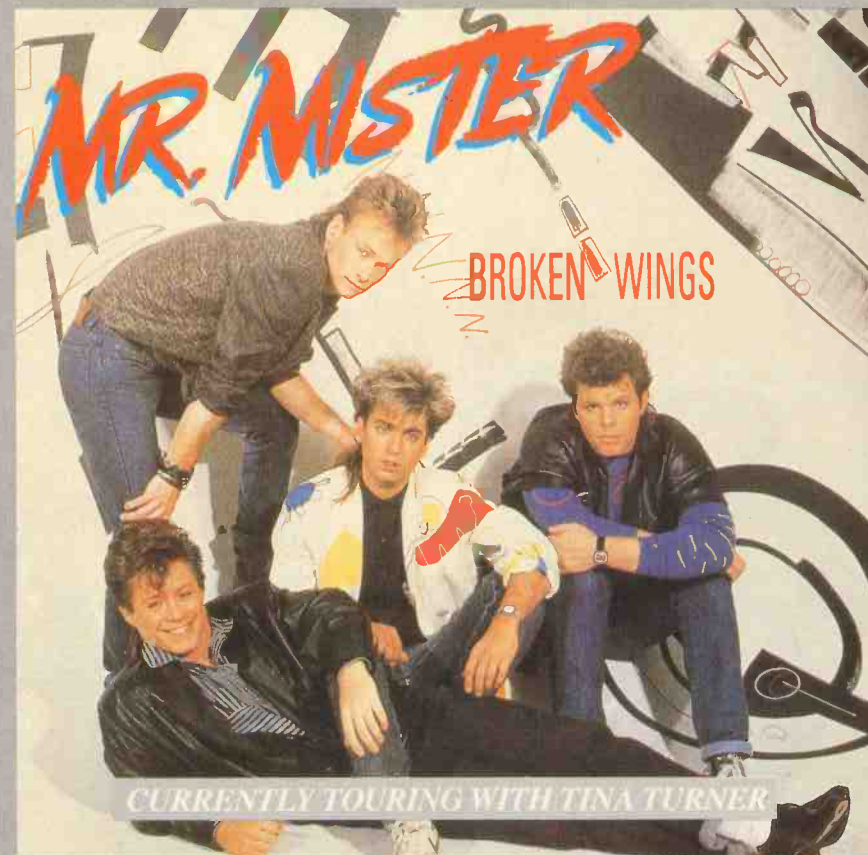
