UK RECORD/TAPE SALES DISAPPOINTING But CD's Double In Only One Year

The January-March quarter was "fairly flat" for British record/tape sales, according to British Phonographic Industry (BPI). Value of sales was up by a modest 3.4% to £71.9 million, compared with £69.5 million posted for the same period of 1985.

BPI says sales in the upper reaches of the charts suffered particularly badly. Volumes for best-selling singles were 20%-25% lower than at the same time last year. The proportion of 12-inch singles in the market place rose to 29%, compared with 27% in the January-March period of 1985.

After holding fairly steady for two

or three years, LP volume fell by 8% to nine million units. Value fell by the same percentage to £23.8 million.

Cassette sales continued upwards, though at a slower rate than last year. But the gap between cassette and LP sales widens, with tape deliveries to the trade up 13.6% in the quarter to 10.6 million units.

The Compact Disc role continues to throw up remarkable statistics in the UK. CD shipments by UK companies doubled over the 12-month period and stood at 1.2 million units for the quarter, indicating a year-end figure of some six million, in line with long-term forecasts.

PLEA FROM BERLUSCONI FOR EURO CONSORTIUM "Commercial TV Inevitable"

Amsterdam - The Italian entrepreneur Silvio Berlusconi is currently on a business trip covering many European countries to promote his views on commercial television. He visited Holland, Belgium, Germany, Spain, Portugal and Greece where he spoke to members of parliament, media specialists and the press. The establishment of commercial tv, although in happy co-existence with the public broadcasters, is inevitable, he says and he forecasts a commercial tv channel for every European country within the next 2 to 3 years.

In Amsterdam he was invited by the multinationals Heineken, Philips,

Unilever, the insurance company Agon and the advertising company FHV/BBDO. "Our formula is a blessing for Italy. Thanks to commercial television we escaped recession, we were able to raise the investments, to lower the prices and consequential unemployment figures decreased as well."

Not everybody shares Berlusconi's views and many fear that Europe will be dominated by Italian product: 'spaghetti-tv' as some call it mockingly.

But according to Berlusconi, spaghetti tv works. Despite the fact

IFPI FAVOURS UK TAPE LEVY Restrictions On Playing Length Rejected

The International Federation of Producers of Phonograms & Videograms (IFPI) has said that it welcomes the British government's proposal to introduce a levy on blank audiotapes as a form of compensation to music creators for the effects of home taping.

But the trade group cannot agree with the restriction of the levy to tapes of 35 minutes playing time or longer. Says IFPI: "The limited application of the levy and the basis on which it will be calculated are in striking contrast to the private copying provisions already in force elsewhere in Europe.

"And the decision not to levy

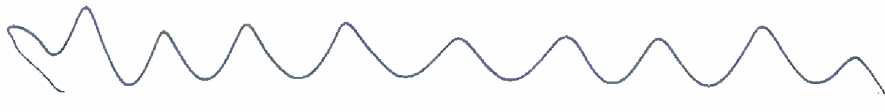
royalties on audio equipment or blank videotape is shortsighted, since the ability to copy with ease is now a central feature of all new sound and video equipment, and the distinction between audio and video tape is becoming eroded with the introduction of the new 8mm videocassette."

London-headquartered IFPI welcomes the government proposals for tightening up the law against parallel imports, bootlegging and other forms of copyright infringement. But it is against the intended abolition of the statutory licence system for musical recordings in favour of commercial negotiation.

UNITED KINGDOM

The **Chicken Song** already for the third week at no. 1, again followed by *On My Own* and no. 3 is this week **Dr. & The Medics** with *Spirit In The Sky*. The re-issue of *Holding Back The Years* by **Simply Red** really took off as the single, in its third week is already up to no. 6 (from 19). Also new in the Top 10 are **Jaki Graham** with *Set Me Free* (9-20) as well as **Robert Palmer** with *Addicted To Love* (10-16). All last week's entries make significant moves this week. **AC/DC**, last week new at 27, now already no. 16 with their new single *Who Made Who*, coming from the album of the same name, the official OST from the Stephen King film *Maximum Overdrive*. The Cameo produced *Mine All Mine* by **Ca\$hflow** moves up after its high entry last week (18-30) and other records that move up in their second week include **Rod Stewart** with his theme to the motion picture *Legal Eagles*, *Love Touch* (27-34), **Nu Shooz** (21-35) and **The Real Thing's** *Can't Get By Without You* (22-37). Highest entry for the new **Tear For Fears'** single *Everybody Wants To Run The World*, a re-recording of their big smash *Everybody Wants To Rule The World* to help support Sport Aid. Second best entry for **Genesis** (25) and other entries for **The Smiths** (*Big Mouth* new at 28), the re-issue of the first **Pet Shop Boys** single *Opportunities* (29) and yet another **Falco** single, *Vienna Calling* new at 35.

GERMANY

What hasn't happened for ten years, now occurs twice in a period of five weeks: a record entering the German chart straight in at no. 2. Five weeks ago it happened with **Chris Norman**, this week it is **Modern Talking** that enters straight in at no. 2 with *Atlantis Is Calling (S.O.S. For Love)*. This makes Dieter Bohlen the most successful writer and producer in Germany at the moment as he was responsible for no. 1, no. 2 and no. 10 (**C.C. Catch** with *Strangers By Night*) of the German chart. Further to that, a cover of *Midnight Lady* is shooting up the German chart (17-75!) in a German language rendition by **Roland Kaiser**.

New in the Top 10 is **Johnny Nash** (9-14) with *Rock Me Baby* and **Real Thing** (13-18) moves up as well. **Cock Robin** continue the big success they had in Germany with their latest *Thought You Were On My Side* leaping to 21 (from 27). Highest

entry for **Big Country** (38) and other entries include **Limahl** (40), Euro Vision winner **Sandra Kim** (50) and **Five Star** (55).

FRANCE

Stephanie, who recently went on a European promo trip, sticks at no. 1 for the 5th consecutive week, topping an unchanged top 5. **Jeanne Mas'** *En Rouge Et Noire* moves into top 10 after being charted for only 2 weeks. Also climbing are **Billy Ocean** (*When The Going Gets Tough*; 6-10), **Madonna's** *Live To Tell* (19-25), **Queen** (20-29) and **Cock Robin** with *The Promise You Made* (21-41). Highest new entry for **Marc Lavoine** with *Le Parking Des Anges* and only 2 other new entries: **George Michael** and **Jean-Luc LaHaye** with *Lettre A La Vielle*.

HOLLAND

Sam Cooke already for the 2nd week at no. 1 and again followed by **George Michael** (who scored platinum last week: over 75,000 copies sold). **Falco** creeps up one further notch to 3 and **Miami Sound Machine** with *Bad Boy* follow straight after. A good move for **Billy Ocean** (10-14) as well as for **Sandra Kim** with *J'aime La Vie* (13-24). The **Jimmy Jam/Terry Lewis** produced *What Have You Done* by **Janet Jackson** is already up to 15 (coming from 23) and **Cock Robin** are on their way to have another no. 1 hit after *The Promise You Made* (platinum award for having sold more than 75,000 copies) with *Thought You Were On My Side* (18-30). Holland loves sophisticated ballads: as expected **Patti Labelle & Michael McDonald** have highest entry with *On My Own*. Other entries for **Jermaine Stewart** (*We Don't Have To Take Our Clothes Off*), **Whitney Houston** (*Greatest Love Of All*), the new **Mai Tai** single *Turn Your Love Around* and **Sade's** *The First Time*. The best contender for a next week entry is the re-issued *What A Fool Believes* by **Doobie Brothers**.

SPAIN

Already for the 3rd week at no. 1 **Sigue Sigue Sputnik's** chart crashing single, *Love Missile F1-11*. But sweet sounds are on their way to battle for chart domination: **Modern Talking's** *Brother Louie* from 6 to 2 this week. Hardly no change in the top 10 apart from **Eartha Kitt** with *This Is My Life* moving from 12 to 10. **Bowie** is

something more than an *Absolute Beginner* (17-23) and local **Georgie Dann** swings to 18 with *Macumba* (coming from 26). Highest entry for **Falco's** remix of *Rock Me Amadeus* (23).

SWITZERLAND

The 3 weeks charttopper *Midnight Lady* by **Chris Norman** is this week followed by the fast running *Touch Me* by **Samantha Fox**. **George Michael** and **Queen** stick at resp. 3 and 4 while **Madonna** is a fast mover as well (5-11). Two more newcomers in the top 10 include **Bruce & Bongo** with *Geil* (7-12) and the latest **Alphaville** single *Dance With Me* (9-14). Highest entry for the pop reggae song *Rock Me Baby* by **Johnny Nash** (new at 16). Other entries for *Princess* (22) and *Animation* (24).

ITALY

After five weeks a new no. 1 as **Madonna** replaces **Joe Cocker** from the no. 1 spot. Good moves in the top 10 for **Rolling Stones** (7-10) and the Ibiza/CBS artist **Tracey Spencer** with *Run To Me* moving from 20 to 8. Highest entry for German singer **Sandra** with the third single from her debut album *The Long Play*, entitled *Little Girl* (new at 17). **Bryan Ferry** is also new at 25 with *Is Your Love Strong Enough*.

SWEDEN

Alpha Records trio **Style** remain at no. 1 with *Dover-Calais* and local CBS act **Professorn** stick at 2. Straight in at no. 3 follows yet another CBS act, the popular hard rock outfit **Europe** with *The Final Countdown*. Straight in at 7 are local act **Imperiet** with *Var E' Vargen* (see also New talent 2 weeks ago). **Cliff & The Young Ones** move into Top 10 (9-13) and **Samantha Fox** climbs steadily as well (10-16). One of our New Talent tips (see issue 14) is entering the Swedish charts this week: Danish duo **Laban** come in at 19 with the smooth pop single *Caught By Surprise*.

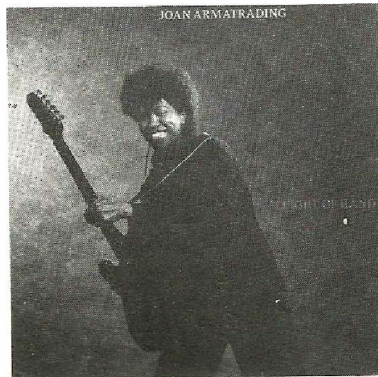
PORTUGAL

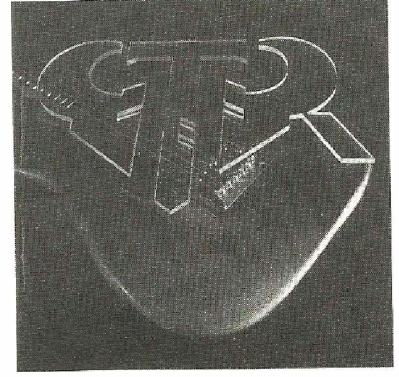

Nu Shooz - Poolside - Atlantic
Debut LP from an American group whose musical career seems to depend on the grace of remixers like Dutch Pieter Slaghuis and Shep Pettibone. Nevertheless we absolutely love it. They make delicious funky disco and our favourite single I Can't Wait has reached no 5 in the USA and already top 40 in the UK.



Annabella - Fever - RCA
The former visual and vocal centre of Bow Wow Wow now tries to conquer the world with music totally different to BWW's. Unexpectedly easy digestible poppy disco and in general not boring at all. First (not the best) single and title track is a cover version of the old Peggy Lee song. Annabella (co-)wrote most of the songs herself.



Lovebug Starski - Lovebug Starski - Epic
This bright voiced Lovebug is a relatively new star at the rap firmament. Electro rhythms, funky rap and roll, some gogo beat: the Bug has it all. Duet with Pam Russo 'Baby Tell Me' is a better track than the single Amityville (charted in the UK). Produced a.o. by Steve Loeb, Rod Hui and 'King' Kurtis Blow.

Oliver Cheatham - S.O.S (Champion) UK

First single for a long time from the guy renowned for his dance-classic 'Get Down On Saturday Night'. This new one is less exuberant, even a bit contradictory, because Cheatham's 'non frantic, no panic', cool voice doesn't fit the subject very well. Nevertheless it's a nice up-tempo ballad for which Munzubaï and Morales were approached to do the remix. From his forthcoming album that features a.o. Saturday Night part 2.

Sylvia Smith - Don't Wanna Be A Sometime Lover (Qwest) USA

Relaxed funk with a "Cameo bass touch" and vocalized with a smooth soul treat.

Silent B.C. - Master Eyes (Zyx) Germany

A fatalistic record with a slow and mysterious beginning. The rest is sung in a new wave style and the music is a mix between Art Of Noise and Depeche Mode (synthesizers, vocoders). Strange and pompous but meritorious.

Cognac - Don't Bother To Knock (Rush Records) Germany

Very nice tune from a 'spiritually' named black girl. An enjoyable mid-tempoed dancetrack, a bit in the same calypso vein as Phil Fearon's Galaxy.

Whodini - Funky Beat/Whodini Megamix (Jive) UK

The new routine rap Whodini single has a flip that's far more interesting than the A-side. It gives the group (biggest LP seller so far in the rap scene in the USA) the opportunity to finally reach a wider audience on the Continent. A (Bryan 'Chuck' New) mix of their most successful tracks from the past that are new anyway for most of Europe's record buyers.

The Jets - Crush On You (MCA) UK

MCA UK's decision to release, came about this time much quicker compared to the previous good, but born loser 'Curiosity' which we reviewed back in April.

Anyway they really stand a chance in the UK this time because of the strong US disco/dance interest over there. Again a very catchy, electro rhythm body mover but with a much fuller sound.

Sound Of Music - Eldorado (Alpha) Sweden

Typical continental disco, chanted in Swedish with a cheer that one could only expect in a (Eurovision) contest. Unfortunately they were dropped in the national pre-selection, but the summer-sounding single was yet to be picked up and went to 6 in their homecountry.

Forrest - She's So Free (CBS) Holland

New single from the Dutch based American Forrest M. Thomas Jr. who once had a mass solo Eurocross over hit in 1982 with 'Rock The Boat' and who also gained some international fame as participant in the Band of Gold's 'Love Songs Are Back Again'. The days of ballads are over, now he is trying with a complex speedy and funky eurobeat composition, more in the vein of his earlier work like 'Feel The Need'.

Grand Master Funk - Who Messed Up The World (Palladium) Sweden

Master available excl. USA. Contact: Torbjorn Sten at Palladium, tel.8- 540695.
A rare thing, a New York rapper debuting on a Swedish label. This record is an electro rhythm rap combining all kinds of noises from things such as a dustbin used as a drum and a plastic squeak doll for babies. Even Reagan's voice is fit in to suggest the answer to the question posed in the title. Great fun.

Fehlmann's Ready Made - Ready Made (Mercury) Germany

Extremely clever mix of various great film music themes like John Berry's Bond-tune and Ennio Morricone's 'Once Upon', all linked and wrapped up in a fashionable dancebeat. A noteworthy instrumental.

Rocky M. - Disco Lady (Arrow/EMI Electrola) Germany

Germany is still being washed over by Modern Talking clones and sound-a-likes (who can blame new talent for trying? all MT's singles went to No. 1). A boy who comes very near is Rocky M.; his soft-sweet voice over this Patrick Cowley-like (131 BPM) could make the Germans go for it.

Gibson Brothers - Party Tonight (Julisa/Carrere) France

The men renowned for mass hits like 'Cuba' and 'Que Sera' are trying to make their comeback. This time their vocal share has been diminished and replaced by females to support the chorus in a carnivalesque sing-a-long.

Candi Mc Kenzie - Turn Me Up (Adventure/WEA) UK

A Swain & Joley production, not at all the stuff we're used to hearing from them. It sometimes reveals similarities with Frank Arian's Eruption. Dark timbered female voice in a floorfilling groove. Already a club fave in Amsterdam.

Precious Wilson - Jewel Of The Nile (Jive) UK

After Ruby Turner's 'I'm In Love' and Billy Ocean's Eurohot no. 1 'When The Going' this could be the third winning single from the OST Jewel Of The Nile. A moody and exotic uptempo ballad almost breathing an oriental atmosphere. But that might be on purpose.

Centerfold - Dictator (Injection/CNR) Holland

Another (sexy) Dutch female trio with much potential to crossover. This new single is even given airplay on the less commercial stations in their homecountry. Trendy floor filler in a very funky mood that really deserves to do well. Who wouldn't want to get in touch with this kind of Dutch ? Dance Mix by Rutger Kroese who usually remixes records of the Star Sisters and Mai Tai (all on the same label). Top 10 In Holland.

GABRIEL AT FACE VALUE

The highest entry in the European Hot 100 Albums is for **Peter Gabriel's** *So*, his first studio album for four years. With high positions in the UK, Germany, Belgium, Italy, Norway and Finland, the album enters at 14 in the Hot 100, making it, together with Prince, the 2nd best album entry of this year (Stones had highest, entering at 11). Nearly all our European correspondents are reporting favourably on the LP and it is already the second best played in Europe (Prince still has best played). It is Gabriel's most accessible and streamlined album ever and it is no coincidence that the cover shows Gabriel at 'face value' (yes, also the debut lp of Gabriel's Genesis partner Phil Collins) without make-up or mask. The album will undoubtedly bring him more fans than ever and it is one of the best albums released this year, both commercially and artistically. Apart from the single *Sledgehammer*, (the third best played single in Europe at the moment), other album tracks receiving very good airplay include *In Your Eyes*, *Don't Give Up*, (a lovely fragile ballad together with Kate Bush), the hypnotic *Red Rain* and the moody *Mercy Street*.

The 2nd best entry this week is for the new **Cure** album *Standing On A Beach*, new at 50. A very strong 13 track compilation including their latest re-issued *Boys Don't Cry*.

It doesn't happen too often that a Dutch artist enters the Hot 100 Albums. This week the singer/cabaret player **Robert Long** does with *Achter De Horizon* ('Behind The Horizon'), charted in Benelux and Germany.

After the one-off co-operation with producer Mike Howlett (on the 1985 album 'Secret

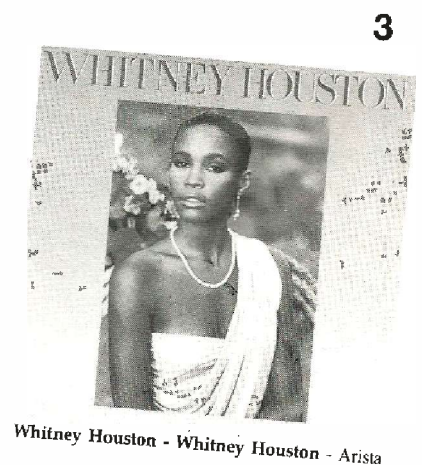
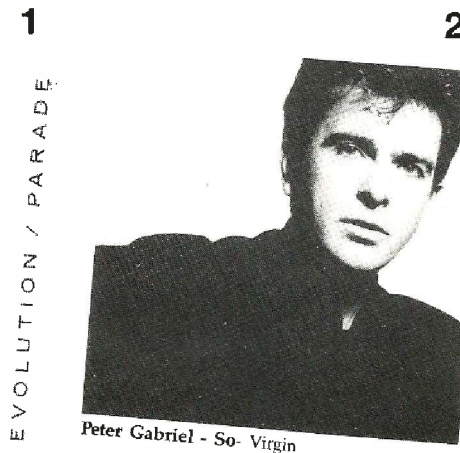
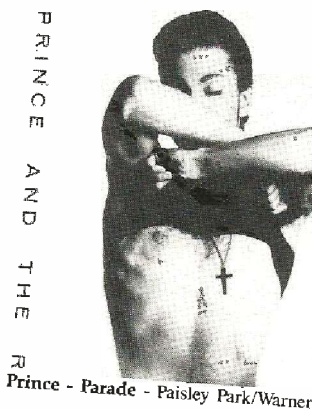
Secrets'), **Joan Armatrading** rejoins with Steve Lillywhite for her 11th A&M album *Sleight Of Hand*. The new orientation that she first set in on the album 'Me Myself I', has never appealed that much to the old Armatrading fans. This album is a complete materialisation of that change and most of the songs are solid synthesizer backed rock tunes, that have nothing in common with her earlier moody and intimate works. The only really slow song on this LP is *Don Juan* and the rest is completely mid or up-tempo. However it is her best shot for a long time and our faves include *Reach Out*, *Angel Man* and *Jesse*.

The English band **The Fixx** somehow never reached any real acclaim in Europe. Things were different though in America where the album 'Reach The Beach' went platinum and the single 'One Thing Leads To Another' hit top 5. Their follow up album 'Phantoms' reached gold in 1984 and then things were rather quiet for the band. Hopefully their latest MCA album *Walkabout* will change their low profile in Europe. Again a collection of melodic compositions enwrapped in the sophisticated and atmospheric production by Rupert Hine. Apart from the strong single *Secret Separation*, we absolutely love the follow up track *Build For The Future* as well as *Walkabout* and *Sense The Adventure*.

The new **AC/DC** album *Who Made Who* is the soundtrack to the Stephen King movie *Maximum Overdrive* and it features the new title song plus 2 new instrumentals. The rest of the album is filled with classic AC/DC tracks.

BBC Television will axe its daily lunchtime magazine programme Pebble Mill at One when it ends its current run at the end of May. A great shame really, because the show was a vehicle for five acts a week to plug their current single.

Terrific programme for BBC Television recently called Video Jukebox. The show was hosted by Radio One jock John Peel, and his radio producer, and Peter Ustinov lookalike at Radio One John Walters. There were some great classic videos from the early days of the Stones and Beatles. Also a great interview with David Bowie.

Capital Radio have announced the lineup for their annual music festival to be held in and around London during the month of June. There will be a concert at Wembley Stadium featur-

ing Queen, The Alarm, Status Quo and Australia's Inxs.

The Sunsplash festival which usually takes place at Crystal Palace, will now take place at Wembley Arena. There will also be big names from the World of Jazz, such as Lionel Hampton and Buddy Rich. Spyro Gyra and Stanley Jordan will also be playing.

Well done Channel 4, the station that brings us so much music, showed a documentary on the excellent South American Salsa star Ruben Blades. He will be in London for concerts in June.

If you haven't had the chance to check out the excellent series on Capital Radio called Ebony & Ivory, you really should take the time out on a Sunday to listen. The programme is hosted by Alan Freeman, and put together by John Pidgeon, and traces the influences of black music on white musicians.

At Radio One, producer Kevin Howlett is working on some new series for broadcast later in the year, more information as I get it. He will be working with ace writer and researcher Pete Frame.

Radio London held one of their very successful Soul Nights Out in Essex recently, which will incidentally be the home of the new BBC local radio station Radio Essex. This is not to be confused with commercial Essex Radio. It will be interesting to see if the BBC station follows a policy of playing soul music as does the commercial station. While down in Essex that night, I bumped into my old mate Dave Gregory from Essex Radio who I have not seen for years. He and I used to jock in the same West End club.

Eireann, said that deregulation legislation had been pending in his country for eight years. In the meantime a number of pirate stations were operating mostly with a pop music format, but some in the MOR field and some

broadcasting predominantly folk and Irish music.

Much of the money that comes into the coffers of the pirate stations from advertisers tends to go out of the country," he said. "But I believe the revenue is not as large as the stations had hoped."

He said that the pirate stations did not pay performance fees and, were not, in fact, allowed to pay. In his view the pirates were both parasites and pioneers because while they failed to compensate rights owners, at the same time they had forced "establishment" radio "to reconsider its programming philosophy.

Monsey endorsed this point by recalling that when Radio Caroline was first launched in 1964, the BBC had no pop music channel. Many albums were broken by Caroline and are still being broken. And when the BBC restructured its programming, it borrowed a lot from the pirate stations."

Speaking from the floor, Dave Price, executive producer with BBC Radio 1, insisted that the pirate stations were parasitic and criticized the attitude that there was some "romance in illegality". He attached Monsey's "weak denials of illegality". He also observed that Laser 558's policy was to programme oldies - records whose popularity had already been tested and which had been broken by the legitimate stations.

In another comment from the floor, Rik de Lisle, music director of RIAS Berlin, said that the East German's regarded RIAS as a pirate station because its transmissions reached listeners in East Berlin. "The East German stations tape the records we play and then play them back at us," de Lisle said. "How do you programme against that?" The panel was moderated by Machgiel Bakker, managing editor of Music & Media.

PIRATE STATIONS PIONEERS OR PARASITES? IMMC Panel On Illegality Vs. Innovation

Montreux - Europe's pirate radio stations have made a significant contribution toward the advent of livelier pop music programmes on radio - but some of them have operated with an unfair advantage over public service stations by not paying performance fees or neighbouring rights.

This was the consensus of the animated debate, "The Pirate Stations - Pioneers Or Parasites?" at the 1st International Music & Media Conference here May 8 & 9, organized jointly by Billboard and Music & media in association with the Golden Rose Festival.

John Catlett, president of Overseas Media Inc., spoke of his involvement with the now defunct UK pirate station Laser 558 and admitted that the operation had broken the law, had "stolen money from the BBC" and had selected its operating frequency without consultation with the European Broadcasting Union.

"Had we tried to play by the rules," Catlett said, "we could not have survived." As it was, the station got considerable advertising support and in its final six months of operation was making enough money to keep going. Adverse weather conditions and substantial mechanical problems, however, made this impossible. The ship and its equipment were ultimately confiscated by the British Government and put up for sale.

Catlett said that one of the major problems faced by private radio stations in the UK, apart from legal difficulties, was the lack of confi-

dence advertisers seem to have in radio as a medium. Only 2 1/2% of total UK advertising expenditure went to radio - compared with the figure of 8% in the United States.

Vincent Monsey, president of Radio Caroline, took exception to the description "pirate radio" in Caroline's case. "We need no licence to operation in international waters", he said. "We have never signed an international radio regulations agreement.

"The public hung the term "pirate radio" on the offshore stations in the sixties and Caroline led the way. We were broadcasting around the clock and within three weeks we had seven million listeners. After seven months we had 21 million listeners."

Monsey recalled that, after the "disastrous sinking" of the Caroline ship, he went to New York in 1979 to study the radio advertising situation with a view to applying some of the ideas to Europe. But the concept of pan-European radio advertising was still undeveloped because advertising agencies in Europe were too decentralized.

Lex Harding, programme director of Veronica, Holland, recalled his background as a disk jockey on a succession of pirate stations, including the highly successful - and now legitimate - Radio Veronica. He maintained that pirate radio stations had been responsible for some important changes in the radio landscape.

Speaking of the situation in the Republic of Ireland, Ian McGarrigle, a TV director with Radio Telefis

In addition, Suisse Romande are to compile exclusive programmes based on the festival which will be sold worldwide to other TV channels.

Claude Nobs who founded the festival 20 years ago is as actively involved as ever. When asked about his views on this year's festival, he echoed Charlie Parker's words on the

issue, that: "Music speaks louder than words."

Numerous special themes are to take place over the 16 days of the Festival, including a New Orleans Parade through the town, a Blues Night with Otis Rush & His Band and Eric Clapton, and a Blue Note Night featuring guest artists Freddie Hubbard, Woody Shaw, Joe Henderson and the Wayne Shorter Quartet. Other acts performing are Simply Red, Talk Talk, Sade, Ruby Turner, Al Jarreau, Chaka Khan, Anita Baker, Miles Davies, George Duke and George Benson. The festival will close with an impressive array of artists including a.o. Tania Maria, Spyro Gyra, Chris Rea, Herbie Hancock with Branford Marsalis, Ron Carter and Al Foster.

Ten Acts Signed For Parkpop '86

The Frankie Miller Band, INXS, Madness and the Bangles are topping the bill of the Parkpop Festival, which will be held in The Hague, Holland June 29th. Six other acts will also perform at the festival: DoReMi, I've Got The Bubbles, Ten Ten, Troeckener Kecks, Gill Scott-Heron and Kissing The Pink. All acts have been signed

by John van Vueren's Columbus Management (Rock In Waterland).

The Parkpop Festival '86 - with two stages - will last from 1 p.m. till 9 p.m. The event will be featured in various Dutch radio programmes. The festival is being held for the sixth time. Last year it attracted more than 100,000 popfans.

UK CABLE SUBSCRIBERS RISING

by Peter Jones

The number of cable television subscribers in the UK went up by 12.8% to a total 143,877 in the first three months of the year. The figures represent "positive news for cable," according to Jon Davel, director-general of the Cable Authority.

These new figures, from the joint industry committee for Cable Audience Research, are the first to be collected by the Cable Authority. Previous data, from the Cable Televi-

sion Association, is believed to have understated the number of subscribers.

The number of British homes which have access to cable, but which are not yet connected, rose by 2% in the January-March period to 994,822. Additionally, the proportion of homes connected to cable services has risen from 13.1% to 14.5%, further cause for optimism according to the Cable Authority.

that Berlusconi is not allowed to broadcast his programmes live, his Fininvest Group reaches an audience of 47.6%. For the three Italian channels Canale 5, Italia 1 and Retequattro Berlusconi produces 12 of his own programmes and average advertising profits are already up to 1 billion dollars.

He made a strong plea for a European consortium of commercial tele-

vision stations able to compete with state owned television, in order to have a lively exchange of programmes. As is well known, Berlusconi was recently granted a concession on the France channel La Cinq and this channel will also take capacity on one of the four scheduled transponders on the French DBS-satellite TDF-1. Together with UK media magnate Robert Maxwell, he has also formed a consortium that will occupy the two other transponders on the French satellite.

RAVERA'S DEATH SHOCKS ITALY

The media world learnt with sorrow last week of the death of Gianni Ravera who passed away on the 15th of May from cancer at 66 years of age. Ravera will best be remembered and respected as the organiser of 24 of San Remo's Festivals, ranging between 1962 and 1986.

Ravera was born in 1922 in Chiaravalle Di Ancona. His musical career began as a singer in 1943 and eleven years later he was himself to participate as a singer in three of the festivals of San Remo (1954, 1955 and 1957).

Although San Remo was undoubtedly Ravera's piece de resistance, he was also music consultant to the national TV RAI. His organisational abilities were also put to good use in the Castrocaro Festival, a talent scout festival dedicated to the discovery of new emerging talents. It was in these festivals that Ravera discovered such prominent artists as Eros Ramazzotti, Lena Biolcati and Gigliola Cinquetti. He was also involved in the St. Vincent festival, the 'disco per l'estate', which chooses a 'song for the summer' in Italy. Ravera's successor is cur-

rently unknown, but it is certain that his place will be a difficult one to fill.

Gianni Ravera's epitaph could best be summed up in a few words he quoted in an interview to Sorrisi Magazine last year ... "My greatest distinction? Having made of San Remo a phenomenon that the whole world envies".

■ Ravera died just 1 week before the start of the San Vincente Festival held last week (May 22-23-24). The festival was broadcast live by state owned RAI and 8 local artists competed for the 'Disco Per L'estate '86' ('Record Of The Summer') award. More than 49% of the Italian audiences watched the spectacular closing gala on May 24 when the final winner, Lena Biolcati with 'Io Donna Auch'Io' ('Me, Woman And I') was announced. Apart from the Italian performers Fiorella Mannoia, Toto Cotugno and Eros Ramazzotti, international artists playing at the festival included Pet Shop Boys, Hipsway, Cock Robin, Amii Stewart, Blow Monkeys and Spanish singer Michel-Bose.

BLUE SUEDE SHOES

To celebrate the anniversary of Carl Perkins' Blue Suede Shoes first entering the UK charts 30 years ago, Carl Perkins & Friends gathered together for 'A Rockabilly Session'. Perkins contacted some of his fellow rock legends and asked them to help him produce the 'best rock 'n roll spectacle the world's ever seen'. The line-up included George Harrison, Ringo Starr, Eric Clapton, Dave Edmunds, Earl Slick, Rosanne Cash and former Stray Cats Lee Rocker and Slim Jim. Virgin are to release the 58 minute video at the end of this month.

★ Sigue Sigue Sputnik have a new video out for their latest single, 21st Century Boy. Hugh Symmonds of Keith Co directed the clip and it is basically a continuation of S.S. Sputnik's last single, with a backdrop from Japan and the US. ★ Due to public demand the Sport Aid video has been released. Directed by Carina Camamile of Jump productions, it is a remix of Tears For Fears Everybody Wants To Rule The World, the title being changed to Everybody Wants To Run The World. The video features numerous British superstars including Duncan Goodhugh and Frank Bruno.

★ Midnight Films have made a promo clip to accompany the Housemartins latest single, Happy Hour. It is a combination of animation and live performance, the latter taking place in an East London pub. The clip features models made of clay which are then animated. ★ The juxtaposition of animated models with live performance also forms the basis of the clip to Pete Shelley's On Your Own. Directed by Pete Bishop of Film Garage, it features numerous strange happenings such as a Frankenstein appearing from an industrial fridge and a piece of bacon and a cactus playing the guitar. ★ The clip to the Rolling Stones latest released single One Hit To The Body was directed by Russell Mulcahy of MGM at Elstree Studios.

MIKULSKI OPENS IN USA

Bernhard Mikulski Ltd., a leading German independent record company, specializing in disco/dance pop music has decided to build up its distribution in the USA. The move came following the increasing demand for European dance and disco music.

Bernhard Mikulski formerly of CBS formed his own company in 1966, opening a record shop chain

throughout Germany, thereby laying the foundation stone for an active import/export record company. Five years ago the company expanded and saw the birth of the house label ZYX. Mikulski Records now represents international labels such as Record Shack, Memory, Cruisin, Pablo, Storyville and GNP.

FRENCH VCR LICENSE LIFTED

In what is seen as a positive move to help boost the domestic video market, the French government is to end the annual licence fee of 600 francs (around £55) it has imposed since 1983 on videocassette recorders.

The tax, widely criticised, was devised as part of a series of trade protection measures to slow down what the then Socialist government believed was a Japanese "invasion" of the consumer electronics business.

A peak in that period came when the government forced all VCR imports to pass through the central city of Poitiers for customs clearance, leading to massive delays. The VCR licence was set at roughly the same as that for colour television sets. Its abolition is a further sign of the new government's deregulation of broadcasting and of the state aim to help general video development.

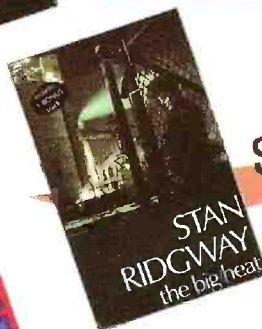


Carl Perkins and Friends in the Virgin Music Video 'Blue Suede Shoes: A rockabilly Session With Carl Perkins'.

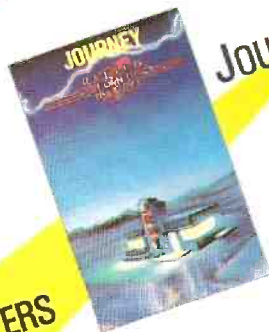

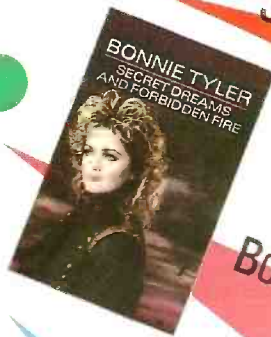

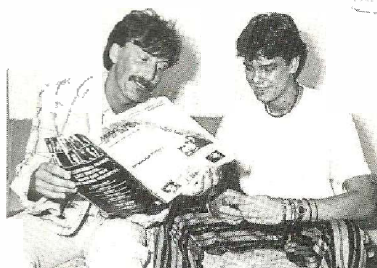

Singles Guide

The hottest record in Europe at the moment is Genesis' *Invisible Touch*. It entered the Airplay Top 50 last week at no. 40 and now flashes straight to the top spot. That makes this single the second best top Airplay runner of this year (Rolling Stones with Harlem Shuffle have best, with their move from 23 to 1 in 2 weeks). On nearly all European stations the new Genesis single is an immediate add-on and therefore the single got an enormous increase in airplay points over last week.

And the remarkable fact occurs that two other Genesis-related records appear in the Airplay Top 10. Straight after *Invisible Touch* follows Peter Gabriel's *Sledgehammer* while Mike (Rutherford) & The Mechanics stick at 5 with all 7 *Need Is A Miracle*. It would have been even more complete if the new Arista super formation GTR would join up the ranks as well, as this band includes former Genesis guitar player Steve Hackett.

After the Miami Sound Machine broke big in Holland, Belgium and currently in Spain with *Conga*, the band now begins to break all over Europe with the follow-up *Bad Boy*, already no. 8 in the European airplay. It might well be that *Conga* gets a renewed chance in England after the *Bad Boy* success. After all *Conga* is the most commercial of the two.

Last Sunday (May 25), more than 5 million Americans joined hands from Los Angeles to New York in the biggest event ever in the history of the USA, *Hands Across America*. From the East to the West coast people formed an almost unbroken chain, a line stretching more than 4,000 miles, to take a stand against hunger and homelessness in America. So far the project has raised an estimated 50 million dollars. The single is already getting tips from our correspondents in Europe and it stands a good chance of entering the European Airplay Top 50 next week.

In the same vein is *Sport Aid*, a worldwide event that has already raised 56 million dollars. *Tears For Fears* have re-recorded their world smash *Everybody Wants To Rule The World* and changed the word 'rule' to 'run'. For the good cause, support it.

Scandinavia continues to be supplier of potential Euro-crossover hits. One only has to look at the New Talent sections the last few months to see that we are right. The latest proof is the CBS Sweden act *Trance Dance* whom we already spotted in the Scandinavian spotlight in issue 17. An energetic, Thompson Twins-like pop single of which the video is already played on Music Box and the German Musik Laden.

New singles out by *Matt Bianco* (*Dancing In the Street*, another smooth cocktail pop tune), *Prince* with the second single from the Parade album entitled *Mountains* (featuring the previously unavailable Alexa De Paris on the B-side), and *Bananarama* came up with a surprising rendi-

tion of the Dutch Shocking Blue hit *Venus* (one of the very few Dutch hit singles that went to no. 1 in the American Hot 100). *David Bowie* is always in for the unexpected as his new single *Underground* shows him in a very lively and gospel-like setting (from the movie *Labyrinth*, in which Bowie plays a major role). And if there's any room left on your playlist, consider the singles by the Irish duo *The Fountainhead* with their single for China Records, *Feel It Now* (solid dance pop), the Swedish singer *Carola* with a Maurice Gibb produced pop single (hi-tech, assertive pop) and last but not least the ex-Go-Go's lead vocalist *Belinda Carlisle* with the Bangles-ish *Mad About You*.
