## CAPITAL RADIO HOSTING MUSIC FEST 60 London Concerts

The fourth Capital Music Festival, to be staged in various London venues June 20-July 20, has almost 60 concerts and events scheduled, with many big names from all popular musical genres taking part.

There's superstar rock, via two Wembley Stadium concerts featuring Queen, Status Quo, the Alarm and INXS; jazz featuring Buddy Rich, Lionel Hampton and Stanley Jordan, among many; gospel; a cappella; hip hop; nostalgia (the Searchers and the Tremeloes); reggae; popular classics; and many showcase appearances by up-and-coming bands.

Running alongside the music performances there is a "fringe" festival

with top comic artists working with musicians. The Capital Music Festival provides hours of programming for Capital Radio and the Independent Local Radio network and also for export.

The event has evolved from what started as a couple of open-air weekend jazz concerts. The first two were held at Alexandra Palace but a fire later virtually destroyed the venue. The 1981 concert in south London was beset by riots, so it was decided to move the 1982 event to Knebworth, a vast outdoor site.

Then director John Burrows decided to extend the event to a whole

## SSS SELL LP ADS

### EMI Group Fill Record Gaps

The silent gaps between tracks on lp's might well be relegated to history from now on. Sigue Sigue Sputnik have started a trend which could revolutionize records of the future. Tony James, leader of Sigue Sigue Sputnik, has arranged to sell the few seconds of traditional silence between each song to advertisers. Eight 20 to 30 seconds slots on the band's forth-

coming lp Sigue Sigue Sputnik Flaunt It, have been sold.

However the group's record company EMI also wishes to fill this potentially lucrative gap in the market. The company's lawyers are therefore attempting to establish who owns these portions of a record, whether it is the artist or the record company.

## BOOM GERMAN VIDEO YEAR

### Government Convention Support

The German video industry went through a period of consolidation last year but all the signs are that 1986 will see it play an even greater part in the context of the national economy. And that's why there's powerful government support for the 2nd. German Video Convention, to be held in Wiesbaden, Sept. 12-15, with Martin Bangemann, minister of trade and commerce patron of the event.

There are now some 4,500 video

dealers in Germany, and the total video retail-level turnover last year was 180 million, or roughly three-quarters of the total cinema market box-office take. Video provides 20,000 jobs in its various different sectors in Germany. There are around seven million VCRs in domestic use.

Minister Bangemann understands that Germany's film producers accept that video has become an indispensi-

## BELGIAN SALES UP

### CD - main factor

Belgian record industry turnover was up by 4.9% in 1985 compared with the previous year, mainly due to a predictably strong performance by the Compact Disc, up 80% while singles slumped and LPs were disappointing.

Total turnover was just over 2.2 billion Belgian Francs, as against 2.1 billion the previous year, according to the newly released figures from

SIBESA, the Belgian branch of IFPI.

In the CD success sector, a total 429,920 units were sold last year, as against the 238,000 posted for 1984. Sales of musicassettes were also good, up 12% to 1.634 million units as compared with the 1.45 million of 1984.

But singles were down 17.5% on the 1984 return, to 8.85 million units

### UNITED KINGDOM

A new no. 1 in England this week as **Dr. & The Medics'** *Spirit In The Sky* displaces the *Chicken Song* from the top. This is followed by **Simply Red** whose  *Holding Back The Years* has reached no. 2 in only four weeks. **Tears For Fears'** contribution to Sport Aid, *Everybody Wants To Run The World*, is new in the top 10 this week (5-13) as is **Nu Shooz** whose *I Can't Wait* rises 11 notches to no. 10. Nu Shooz was founded by John Smith in 1980 and was one of M&M's tips in the New Talent Disco section. It is now no. 4 in the Billboard Hot 100. Also steadily climbing up the charts are **Pete Wylie** with *Singul!* (13-20) and the re-mixed version of the **Real Thing's** *Can't Get By Without You*. This has risen to 11 from 22 and their *You To Me Are Everything* is also the highest re-entry in the UK charts. Highest entry for **Sigue Sigue Sputnik's** latest single *21st Century Boy* in at 22. And other entries for **Big Audio Dynamite** with *Medicine Show*, **Midge Ure** with *Call Of The Wild* and **Marc Almond** with *A Woman's Story*.

### GERMANY

Although shooting straight in at no. 2 last week, **Modern Talking** has not succeeded in replacing **Chris Norman** whose *Midnight Lady* tops the charts for the sixth consecutive week. However Dieter Bohlen. Modern Talking's successful writer and producer should not be disappointed since Modern Talking's new LP *Ready For Romance* has gone straight in at 2. Highest new entry for the Jimmy Jam/Tony Lewis produced *What Have You Done For Me Lately* by **Janet Jackson** (14) and other entries for **Rod Stewart** (*Love Touch*- 29), **Engelbert** (*The Spanish Night Is Over*- 42) and **Mike & The Mechanics** (*All I Need Is A Miracle*- 43). **Sam Cooke** this week rises two notches to no. 3 and the only newcomer to the top 10 is **Depeche Mode** with *A Question Of Lust* (8). The follow-up to **Den Harrow's** *Bad Boy*, *Charleston* is also doing well in Germany (22-33).

### FRANCE

**Stephanie** already for the sixth week at no. 1 and again followed by **Sabine Paturel** with *Les Betises*. **Jeanne Mas** rises five notches to reach the third spot with *En Rouge Et Noir* and new in the top 10 are **Daniel Balavoine** with *Sauver*

*L'Amour* and newly entered **Whitney Houston** with *Saving All My Love For You*. In all seven of the top 10 are this week local products with the exception of **Sandra**, **Billy Ocean** and **Whitney Houston**. Good moves for **Marc Lavoine** with *Le Parking Des Anges* (18-33), **Alisha** with *Baby Talk* (24-41) and **Prince** with *Kiss* (31-45). Apart from **Whitney Houston**, new entries for **Alphaville** (*Dance With Me*), **Diana Ross** (*Chain Reaction*), **Nicole** (*Don't You Want My Love*) and **Alain Souchon** with *Ballade De Jim*.

### HOLLAND

**Sam Cooke** remains at 1 for the 4th consecutive week and is followed by **Miami Sound Machine** whose *Bad Boy* this week rises 2 notches. At 3 comes **Falco** with *Rock Me Amadeus*. Two newcomers to the Top 10 are **Sandra Kim** and **Janet Jackson** with *What Have You Done For Me*. Highest entry is **Marvin Gaye** with *I Heard It Through The Grapevine*. This is the 2nd record along with **Sam Cooke** to be charted following the jeans 501 commercial. Following **Patti Labelle & Michael McDonald's** successful duo, *On My Own* (11-23), the **Doobie Brothers** are now receiving renewed interest. Their *What A Fool Believes* this week enters at 30. Local product **Mai Tai** with *Turn You Love Around* is climbing fast up the charts (19-39). The best contender for an entry next week is **Level 42** with *Lessons In Love*.

### SPAIN

**Modern Talking's** *Brother Louie* replaces **Sigue Sigue Sputnik** in the no. 1 position and at 3 comes **Billy Ocean** with *When The Going Gets Tough*. At 4 comes the popular duo **Victor Manuel & Ana Belen** with *La Puerta De Alcalá* (see New Talent). In addition to **West End Girls**, **Pet Shop Boys** now have a 2nd single charted in the Top 30. Their *Love Comes Quickly* this week enters at 14. Another Euro-beat group with 2 singles in the Top 30 are **C.C. Catch** whose *I Can Lose My Heart Tonight* is at 8 with a new entry, *Cause You Are Young*, in at 28. Also new are Spanish acts **Miguel Bose** (who at time of press has just been signed to WEA International on an exclusive worldwide recording contract) with *Mena* and **Hombres-G** with *Marta Tiene Un Marcapasos*.

### SWITZERLAND

**Chris Norman** tops the charts for the 4th consecutive week and his *Midnight Lady* is again followed by **Samantha Fox** and **George Michael**. Two newcomers this week to the Top 10 are **Frank Duval** with *Liebe Und Tod* and **Prince's** *Kiss*. The highest new entry is **Modern Talking's** *Atlantis Is Calling*; their latest album is also the highest new entry in at 10 in the Swiss charts. Other entries for **Whitney Houston** (*Greatest Love Of All*) and *The Art Of Noise* by **Peter Gunn** which won the IMMC video award for Best Story-line Shortform in Montreux last month. Good moves this week for **Sigue Sigue Sputnik** (10-17), **Stephanie** (11-15) and **Cock Robin** (13-18).

### AUSTRIA

As in Germany and Switzerland, **Chris Norman** tops the charts having shot up from 26 this week. He is followed by *Absolute Beginners* and *Geil*. Highest entry at no. 4 for the pop/reggae song *Rock Me Baby* by **Johnny Nash**. This song was first charted in Benelux and has now gained popularity throughout the GAS countries. Four other newcomers to the Top 10 include **George Michael**, **Samantha Fox**, **Hansi Dujmic** with *Ausgeliefert* and **Stephanie**. **Muenchener Freiheit** which must be one of the most successful German singing bands out has another entry in the Austrian charts with *Tausendmal Du*. Rising rapidly is **Peter Gunn** with *The Art Of Noise* (15-28).

### ITALY

**Madonna** remains at no. 1 followed by **George Michael** and **Joe Cocker**. **Tracy Spencer's** *Run To Me* is rising up the top 10 reaching no. 4 from 8 and two newcomers to top 10 include **Taffy** with *Once More* (9-15) and **John Taylor** with *I Do What I Do* (10-11). New entries for **Hipsway's** *The Honeythief* in at 18. **Novacento** with *Excessive Love* and **Sandy** with *Modern Lovers*.

### SWEDEN

**Europe** with *The Final Countdown* moves to no. 1 followed by **Style's** *Dover-Calais* and **Profesorinn** with *Den Makalosa Manicken*. **Whitney Houston** is extremely popular in Sweden at the moment, having 2 singles charted in the Top 20.

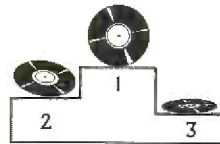

## JUNE BOOM

Contrary to the norm, the next two months will be reversing the usual summer trend of a slowdown in LP releases. Major new albums are due out this week and in the near future from **Madonna**, **Genesis**, **Queen** and **Lionel Richie**. Madonna's album entitled *True Blue* will feature the current no. 1 single *Live To Tell* from the Sean Penn starring film 'At Close Range'. Genesis' *Invisible Touch* has had incredible pre-sales in the UK and it is strongly tipped as a speedy contender for the top, as is Queen's *A Kind Of Magic* which features tracks from the movie *Highlander*.

Albums are also due out later this month from **Rod Stewart**, as are several soundtracks, including *Labyrinth* which features five songs by **David Bowie**.

**Peter Gabriel** predictably moves into the top 10 this week, reaching number 4 after having been charted for only two weeks. His *So* LP is indeed receiving the most favourable comments from our correspondents. Another artist who is attracting many tips is **Chris De Burgh** for his new LP *Into The Light* which is no. 8 in the UK this week and is highest new entry in the Hot 100 Albums at 22.

The second best entry is for the new **Modern Talking** album *Ready For Romance*, at 34. The LP is already no. 1 in Belgium, new in at 2 in Germany and is charted in Switzerland. The new **AC/DC** album *Who Made Who*, the soundtrack to the Stephan King movie *Maximum Overdrive*, comes in at 64.

The Nile Rodgers produced **Philip Bailey's** *Inside Out* also enters this week. This is Bailey's third solo LP since leaving *Earth Wind & Fire* (who are currently charted at 68 with *The Collec-*

tion). He last appeared in the Hot 100 in March '85 with his *Easy Lover* duet with **Phil Collins**. This reached no. 1, remaining there for 6 weeks, whilst his **Phil Collins** produced *Chinese Wall* LP shot straight in at 50, attaining highest position of 27.

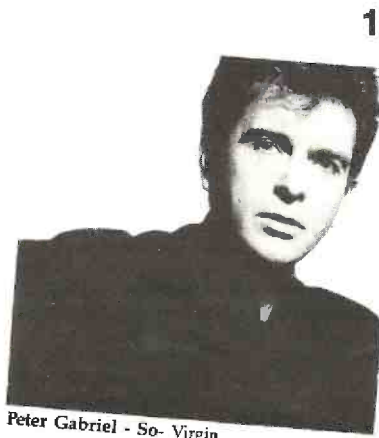
Spanish acts are not renowned for their crossover appeal, but a duo that deserves to do well is **Ana Belen & Victor Manuel**. Their double album, *Para La Ternura Siempre Hay Tiempo*, is already no. 1 in Spain. The two singers complement each other beautifully and one of the most striking aspects of the album are the lyrics, some of which are sophisticated poetry in their own right. Check out *La Puerta De Alcalá*, the first single to be released in advance of the album (currently number 4 in Spain). **Gira Carrusel** and **Nada Sabe Tan Dulce Como Su Boca** ('Nothing tastes as sweet as her mouth').

Another new continental release worth checking out is **Fra Lippo Lippi's** latest album. The Norwegian duo have previously had 2 LP's out on **Uniton**, a local independent, and *Songs* is their first out on **Virgin UK**. **Kristofferson** and **Sorin-sin**, under the production of **Dave Allen** (who also produced the **Cure's** latest album), have come up with a collection of reflective and soothing songs. The LP contains the hit single *Shouldn't Have To Be Like That* and their latest *Everytime I See You*. *Come Summer* will be the next release from the album.

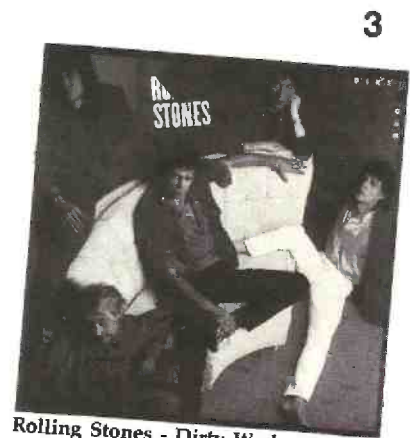

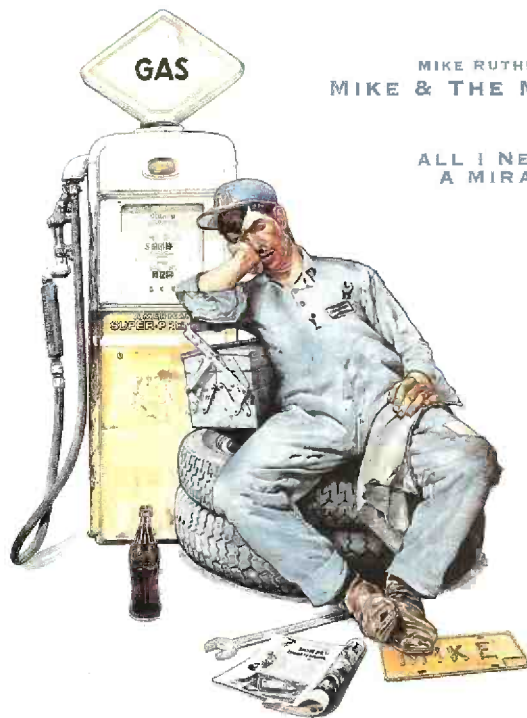

## TECHNICS SPONSORS QUEEN GIGS

### Sponsor Increase In Euro Pop

by Willem Hoos

Japanese electronics company Technics is sponsoring the three Dutch concerts of English popgroup Queen, which will be given in the framework of a European tour. The concerts scheduled for June 11, 12 and 19th are taking place at the Groenord Hall in Leiden, a city some 30 miles southwest of Amsterdam. The venue has a 11,000 standing capacity.

Haagtechno, the company, which imports the Technics products in Holland since 1967, made the sponsor deal with the Queen management through Mojo Concerts, the leading pop concert agency in the Netherlands. How much money is involved in the deal has not been revealed.

The sponsorship contract includes nine 30 second radio commercials on Radio 3 (Holland's national pop music radio channel), advertisements in daily newspapers, music magazines and broadcasting guides and display material in various record and hifi shops. The Technics products include tuners, Compact Disc players, cassette decks and hifi systems.

The three Queen concerts are being sponsored under the banner of "Technics Hifi Presents World Stars In Concert". Under the same banner Technics sponsored the two Dutch sold out Elton John concerts, which were held at the Rotterdam Ahoy Hall (8,500 seats) in the last week of April. That deal was also made through Mojo Concerts.

According to Mr. E.H.W. van Erne, Haagtechno's public relations boss, the results of the sponsor deal for the two Dutch Elton John concerts were "very good". He says it's highly likely that Technics will go on sponsoring major pop concerts in Holland.

According to Leon Ramakers, one of the managing directors of Mojo Concerts, sponsoring pop concerts is an upcoming phenomenon in Holland. He thinks it's highly likely that his company will be involved in more sponsor deals in the near future.

Sponsoring pop concerts is also becoming a big thing in other Europe-

an countries. In Denmark the world-noted brewery Tuborg sponsors several of the events on the national music calendar, its soft drink line is linked with the rock tours and its lager beer for the jazz and harder rock promotions.

In Belgium, tobacco company Belga has become interested in sponsoring pop music events. That's also the case with national brewery Stella and various banks.

In Finland sponsoring of pop concerts has increased to a remarkable extent in recent years. This includes various jeans manufacturers, soft drink companies (Pepsi Cola, Coca

Cola and local brands), banks and electrical firms. Finnish top band Dingo is sponsored by TDK tape company and in Tampere there's a firm specializing in sponsorship deals for local touring acts.

In Spain advertisers and agencies have only recently begun to realize the benefits of sponsoring pop and rock shows.

However, in the United Kingdom sponsorship of tours has grown in a prominent way. Multi-national see straight advertising exposure (and, as important, artist association) as essential in establishing their brand in

## RUSSIAN ROCKERS AID CHERNOBYL VICTIMS

Russian rock artists last week performed in front of 30,000 people at the Lenin stadium in Moscow, scene of the 1980 Olympics. The event was organized to benefit victims of the Chernobyl nuclear reactor incident and peace was the principal theme of the night.

Russia's top rocker Alla Pugacheva, who performed with Sting in Italy

early this year, was the star attraction. "Money is money, but we want to give our heart" said Pugacheva.

In addition to Alla Pugacheva, other Soviet rock artists involved included Cruise, Bravo and Autograph, all of whom performed a mixture of hard-rock, ballads and punk. The latter appeared in the Moscow segment of the Live Aid concert.

## GERMAN GERIG CELEBRATES 40TH

Gerig, the German music publishing company, celebrates on 18th June its 40th anniversary. Over the years Gerig has established itself as one of the major independents in Germany. The

company began with national acts but soon expanded to the international scene and their label, Papagayo, distributed by EMI/Electrola, currently has a wide range of international acts under its wing.

Guenter Ilgner who took over the company after Hanz Gerig's death in 1978, enjoyed the discovery of both BAP and Spider Murphy, two German rock bands which were originally signed to Gerig and sold more than 6 million albums. In addition over the last four months Papagayo acts such as Lady Lili and Fritz Brause have been sold to Scandinavia, Canada, Belgium, France, Italy and Portugal. New acts Nile Thompson and Figo also have strong Euro potential according to Cliff Roles, international manager Northern Europe.

Ilgner says of the philosophy behind the company: "If you want copyrights to succeed, then you have to produce them on the records for yourself. There is a risk potential, but there is also a fair chance of success." Gerig represent many international copyrights including product from Do Piano (France), Novecto and Lucerne (Italy), Lasser Holm and Ratata (Sweden), Dollie De Luxe (Norway), Bryan Ferry, Pete Townsend, Erause and David Knopfler (UK).

## Panelists Deny That Clips Are 'Killing Music'

Despite recent criticism of videoclips as both an art form and a marketing tool, the medium will survive "special effects and irrelevant visuals," provided the relatively new format is allowed to mature and develop without the pressure of unrealistic industry expectations. This was the collective opinion of the panel at the International Music & Media Conference (IM&MC) here called "Are Clips Killing Music?" The panel also acknowledged that the makers and marketers of clips are still learning how best to approach their tasks.

"Our industry," said producer/consultant Michael Von Winterfeldt, "has a tendency to take new marketing tools and overexpose them. Clips are not killing music, anyone, or anything. But videoclips may be wrongly marketed. "Video music does risk fading," he continued, "but we must learn to eliminate the risks. Maybe every artist doesn't need a clip. Perhaps we should improve and increase the long form and limit use of the short form.

But let's not praise or condemn clips until we hear what the kids have to say." John Martin, director of music programming for Canada's Much-Music Network, cited a recent interview with Warner Bros. Records creative marketing director Jeff Ayeroff (Billboard, May 10) in which he maintained that "to say that video doesn't work for us is foolish, because it can and does." Martin also said that Journey's refusal to do any videos for its new album may be one of the biggest music industry publicity stunts in recent years.

Geoff Kempin, managing director of Picture Music International U.K., the video production arm of EMI Records, contended that clips are analogous to film soundtracks,

"which are hardly killing movies." Unfortunately, he added, some artists are unable to make the transition to video, much as certain movie actors couldn't adapt to "talkies" in the late '20s and early '30s. But music video can make money, he maintained, and should be viewed as solid exposure for selling records despite the risk of some "visual fatigue" burnout from overplaying the product.

G. Evan Todd, a film director with Munich-based Creative Image Entertainment, also advocated a longer "incubation" period for artists and video makers. He likened the director's role to that of the record producer, in that he should act as a conduit to help an artist's ideas coalesce, and not develop concepts without artist input. Reducing production costs is essential, Kempin said. If costs can be brought down, he suggested, then clips- and even long-form video "concept albums" can be made more quickly, thus eliminating the time lag between the music and the video.

During a question-and-answer session, panelists were asked why sex and violence still play a major role in many clips. Martin maintained that the use of those elements is far less prevalent in clips than it was a few years ago. Kempin attributed the reliance on sex and violence to a "bankruptcy of ideas," while Von Winterfeldt said it's not always possible to leave such elements out. Sometimes, he said, their inclusion in a clip is artistically relevant. Responding to a question about the "ephemeral nature" of music clips, Kempin said he disagreed with that notion.

Billboard's video music editor, Steven Dupler, moderated the session.

## POSSIBLE CLIP BATTLE IN UK

The BPI is standing firm on its decision to introduce payment for the use of clips. So far music videos have been supplied free and the BPI now demands payment. Negotiations have now reached a deadlock and the BPI members were advised to stop supplying free clips.

Thames TV has already refused to pay, however the BBC is more optimistic in its dealings. Full report on the ongoing clash will appear in M&M next week.

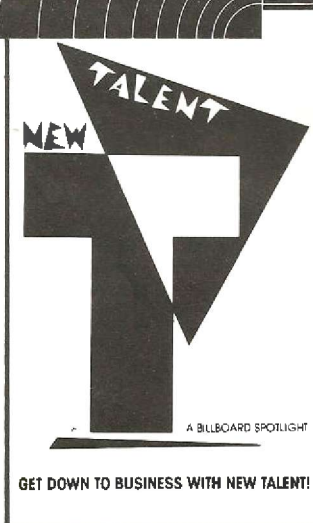
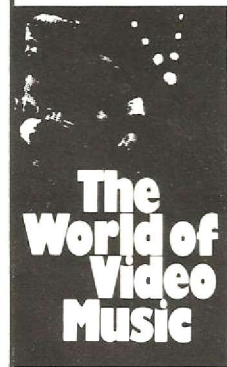
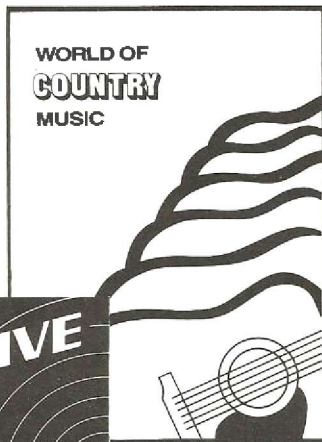

## POLISH LAW DEMANDS REGISTRATION OF DISHES

### Satellite TV Set For 1990's

by Peter Jones

The Polish government has pushed through a law which means compulsory registration of the dish television aerials which enable satellite broadcasts to be received.

Though no official statistics are available, it is estimated there are about a thousand dish aerials in private homes so far but the authorities are seen as moving in fast to try to control the situation as Western television companies, such as the European Satellite Television Broadcasting Corporation, plan to beam programmes visible in Warsaw and the regional areas of Poland.

Government officials say the regulations are designed to control loca-

tion of aerials nationwide in advance of the introduction of Polish satellite television, scheduled for the early 1990s.

A few weeks ago the Salora company from Finland staged an exhibition in Warsaw of satellite television equipment in a bid to stimulate possible cooperative efforts with Polish industry.

ble part of their way of life, with use of feature movies making up around 90% of the video action. Without video, they would not be able to cover investment and box-office risks.

But new figures show remarkable differences in the age-group pattern of cinema and home-video fans. About 67% of Germany's cinemagoers are in the up-to-24 year age group, whereas film videotape users in that group total only 68%. Some 18% of cinemagoers are in the 24-34 group, but 42% of video fans are in that group. Only 15% of cinemagoers are over 35, but 42% of video addicts are of that age.

where there were 10.7 million 45s sold the previous year. However maxi-singles did unexpectedly well in Belgium last year, up 27% on 1984 to 905,362 units and with further room for increases. However LP sales disappointed, with a total 5.5 million sold in 1985 against 6.3% in 1984, down 12%.

Two other salient points made by SIBESA: sales of national repertoire was up 6.8% last year, giving this product a 4.7% share of the total market turnover; and classical music sales were 18% better than in 1984, the genre now representing 11% of total recording music sales.

## IFPI INVITES EURO-PARLIAMENT

The international recording industry organisation IFPI has invited members of the European Parliament for a meeting which will be held at the Hilton Hotel in Strassbourg June 11.

They will get all kinds of information on the various aspects of the recording industry. The main issue will be the threads of homotaping. One of the side lines activities will be a concert by Dutch folk/pop group Flairck.

## UK RADIOS DEMAND FREQUENCY SPLITS

Britain's commercial radio companies are to seek permission from the Independent Broadcasting Authority (IBA) to be allowed split frequencies so they can each broadcast two programmes instead of one.

Their aim is to open up space for more advertising revenue which they say is vital if they are to survive. At present 20 of the 46 stations are running at a loss or just about making break-even point.

Programmers are explain to the IBA that the bigger stations, like Capital Radio, could run a classical music operation as well as pop music if frequency splits are allowed. And the smaller stations would, it is claimed, benefit from a split between pop and speech/news features.

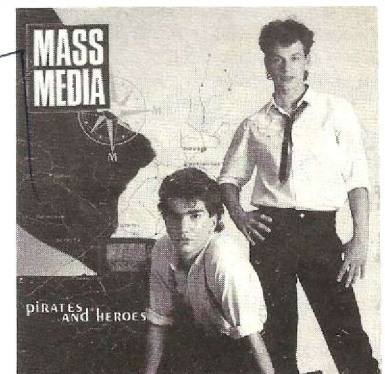

Instead of the usual singles guide, we present you this week with the most successful Euro productions of 1986 so far. Please note that the mentioned countries only indicate the territories in which a particular record charted up on receiving its highest position in the European Hot 100 Singles. It does not mention those countries that are added later on, while the record was already downgrading the charts. For instance, **Double** reached a highest position of 19 and was charted in the UK, France, Italy and Austria. However upon its re-entry in the Hot 100 it was charted in Germany and Belgium as well, countries in which the record did not appear anymore when it reached no. 19 in the Hot 100. In the same vein, countries like Portugal, Spain and Norway were later added, although by then the record was already much lower in the Hot 100.

**A-Ha** are so far the definite winners when it comes to crossover. Although they had the advantage of being signed to a major, it is astonishing

to see them appear no less than three times out of the five best crossover records. Their debut *Take On Me* was already a hit in 1985 where it stayed for five consecutive weeks at no. 1. This success stretched into 1986 and the single occupied the top of the Hot 100 the first four weeks of 1986. Their second single *The Sun Always Shines On TV*, is the third most successful production and their third single *Train Of Thought* the fifth.

So far only **A-Ha** have hit the no. 1 of the Hot 100 while last year this happened three times: *Life Is Live* by **Opus** (six weeks at no. 1), **Baltimora's** *Tarzan Boy* (eight weeks) and **A-Ha's** *Take On Me* (five weeks).

The second best Euro production comes from France, *Ouragan/Irresistible* by the Monacan Princess **Stephanie**. The English will loathe it but the French, Belgian, Swiss and German audiences love it: the second best selling single in Europe.

**Modern Talking** are unquestionably the

most successful German formation since Boney M. In 1985 they had three hit singles reaching the top 20 of the Hot 100 (*You're My Heart, You're My Soul* reaching a highest position of no. 3, *You Can Win If You Want-* 16 and *Cheri Cheri Lady-* 19). This year they already have two top singles in the Hot 100: *Brother Louie* reaching no. 9 and their latest *Atlantis Is Calling* entered the Hot 100 last week at 54 but they'll definitely improve on that position the coming weeks.

The German speaking countries continue to be the supplier of Euro hits, all in all eight German productions, three Austrian and one Swiss have crossed over.

Three Italian productions did very well this year including two productions by Baby Records (**Den Harrow's** *Bad Boy-* 12 and **Andrea's** *I'm A Lover-* 21) and one by Memory Records (**Ken Lazlo's** *Tonight*).
