READ ALL ABOUT IT

Lots of news from MIDEEM this week of course. One of the most interesting announcements came from Billboard who will launch a unique airplay monitoring service—something that will certainly attract major attention from European broadcasters. Called BDS (Broadcast Data Systems), this sophisticated piece of software can monitor radio play automatically. To be launched first in the US, it is expected to hit Europe by the end of the year.

One of the most entertaining panels at MIDEEM was titled "Getting The Music To Market" (full report next week). Willem Van Kooten, President of Holland's Nada Music, was one of the speakers and, as usual, he was good copy. He dismissed John Waller's (Marketing Director Phonogram UK) presentation on the success of the Dire Straits compilation LP *Money For Nothing* as "it's all a matter of money." According to Van Kooten, Dire Straits did not even have an album deal in the UK and were first turned down by Phonogram. "In fact, it all started in Holland. It proves to me that the record industry is one chain of accidents."

In that same panel, Helmut Fest, Managing Director EMI Electrola, made a plea for the inclusion of airplay in the West German charts. "It helps breaking new talent and it's a hot item within the West German recording industry at the moment and one that's taken very seriously."

Manfred Kuhn, Senior VP of Bertelsmann Music Group in the US, called for one single European collecting body at the MIDEEM meeting of the International Federation of Popular Music Publishers. "Why not create a joint working committee between the record groups and collection societies throughout Europe to discuss the future system of central licensing including new solutions and answers to meet the requirements of 1992?" He was rightly applauded.

And finally, moving away from MIDEEM, watch out for major staff announcements from both MTV and Sky. MTV has finally selected a replacement for Mark Booth—she'll be named at any moment. And could it be that record industry veteran Stewart Till is about to accept an upper management position at Sky?

# Russian Rock For Earthquake Fund

Deep Purple, Bonnie Tyler, Joe Cocker and Tangerine Dream are among leading Western acts set to play a three-day rock festival at the 45,000-seater Olympic Hall in Moscow, February 11-13. Rick Astley, Robert Plant and The Hollies are also likely to appear.

The package is banner'd 'We All Together' and is in aid of the Armenian earthquake fund. The show will be broadcast live three hours a night by nationwide Soviet television and videotaped and fed to around 100 countries worldwide within 48 hours.

The entire programme is being released on CD, cassette and vinyl by Atlantic Records in the

US is sponsored by major companies such as Pepsi Cola, Kodak and MacDonald.

The event is organised by Arta Film and TV Productions of Munich and Soviet state agency Gosconcert. Raisa Gorbachev is patron of the project.

Announcing details at a conference in London, Verdges Petrosyan, of the USSR Supreme Soviet, confirmed that more than 26,000 died in the earthquake. Funds raised by the concerts and sponsorship will be used to rebuild a section of Leningrad, including schools and hospitals. The township was hit hardest by the quake.

# The Germans Strike Back

London-based independent Strike Back Records has started a new label solely for German acts. Called Deutschland Strike Back, artists signed to the label include Liedracker, 2-Wacht, Andy Gorbino and 2-Kut.

Strikeback's Maurice Bacon sees the new label as a way to raise awareness in the UK and continental Europe of West Germany as a source of cross-border hits. Bacon: "Liedracker has been signed to Strike Back since 1984. He has had virtually no recognition in the UK, yet went to no. 3 in the US *Rockpool* Chart and made it into the top 20 in the *Billboard* chart in 1988."

Deutschland Strike Back aims to release two records a month as from this month. The label's first album releases, on January 30, were Liedracker's *Sea Metal*, Wasch's *Meat Goes Mountain* and *The Art of Letting Go* by Andy Gorbino. A 2-Kut single, *Beatboy*, came out on the same day.

# RDS - Radio Of The Future?

MIDEEM Radio Data System (RDS) is "the most exciting and dramatic development since the invention of the transistor", said Johnny Beerling, Controller of BBC Radio 1, in a presentation at MIDEEM last week.

The computerised push-button system, already available on some car radios, features an eight-digit display that shows the

name of the station the listener is tuned to. This is picked up from an additional data stream broadcast with the FM signal. An RDS radio can therefore tune in automatically to the transmitter broadcasting the clearest FM signal for any given station.

According to Beerling, BBC radio already covers 80% of the UK with RDS signals and the system, which has the full backing of

"In its drive to sell advertising, radio winds up competing against itself," said Norm Patitz, CEO of top US syndicator Westwood One. Patitz was talking at the first session of "Radio '89" at MIDEEM last week.

Patitz sees a great potential for European broadcasters and emphasises the uniqueness of radio compared to other forms of media. "It's a very stable medium and it has a unique target audience. There are things about radio that cannot be duplicated by any other medium. It wakes you up, it tells you how to dress, how the weather

# Radio Nova Closes

The UK's first satellite-delivered radio station, Radio Nova, finally closed down last week (January 22) after stopping its daytime service a few days earlier.

The station, owned by Chris Cary, has never had an easy ride and its attempts to provide a pan-European service have shown that advertisers are not yet prepared to accept the medium.

Rumours that Nova might sign a deal with Virgin's nighttime service, Super Station, have died down following a statement from Managing Director Rob Jones who told Music & Media that although there had been some discussions, no announcement was pending.

Nova was carried by three of the UK's independent stations

overnight. Paul Stevenson, Managing Director of Aberdeen-based NorthSound, has now opted to take Virgin's Super Station service, as has Ayr-based West Sound, although Severn Sound in Gloucester will originate its own programme.

Contact 94, a French-based station broadcasting to the Channel Islands, is now taking Sky Radio for its night-time service.

Although Radio Nova has trimmed its costs recently, Cary denies a lack of advertising caused the shutdown. "Talks of the company being in financial difficulties are ridiculous, but of course one just can't keep going forever when the medium is taking so long to build up a strong listener base."

# EMI To Expand Further

EMI plans to use income generated by its acquisition of SBK to fund other major investments, EMI Worldwide's President and Chief Executive Officer, Jim Fifield, told Music & Media at MIDEEM.

"There are no more catalogues of the size of SBK's available, but we'll continue to look at all possible investments in publishing and the record business. We'll try to make the company stronger worldwide through internal growth and acquisitions, which will be pursuing aggressively," he said.

Fifield said one single company will remain under the name EMI Publishing, to regroup the two catalogues. The integration will be smooth, he added, because EMI and SBK both use the same software systems.

On the subject of management staff, Fifield said: "EMI recognises SBK's management strength in exploiting their catalogue. So we're going to take a hands-off attitude at the two managements to make sure that going forward, we have the best music publishing company in the world."

# IFPI Wants More Help In Piracy War

IFPI President Nessuhi Erguden has used the MIDEEM forum to repeat complaints about lack of industry support for IFPI's anti-piracy drive.

Speaking with Jean-Loup Tourneur, Managing Director of French authors' society SACEM and President of the international mechanical rights body BIEM, Erguden said he was disappointed that "apart from some European publishers, we are not getting much support, especially in the US. And we receive zero support from artists."

Tourneur commented on the

new BIEM contract for mechanical rights signed by IFPI and BIEM. "This contract is balanced and was made possible by mutual concessions," said Tourneur, adding that a total of more than \$ 500 million over three years was at stake for authors and composers. The next step will be to negotiate CDV rates.

Erguden and Tourneur also highlighted the risks of new technology, like DAT, CD-R and CD-E and called on the EC to take measures like a blank tape levy to protect the music community's assets.

# BSB Wants DBS Music Channel

London - British Satellite Broadcasting (BSB) will launch a 24-hour music channel if its application to operate the UK's two remaining Direct Broadcast Satellite (DBS) channels is successful.

The channel, to be called The Power Station, would air "pop and rock music" and a few pay-as-you-view concerts, according to John Gao, Director Of Programmes at BSB.

The Virgin Group has also said it is interested in bidding for one of the transponders, which it would use for a music channel.

BSB already holds the contract to transmit three satellite channels to household dishes across the UK from September. These will be a subscription film service called The Movie Channel, a Galaxy, a general entertainment channel, and the Sports Channel.

The Sports Channel replaces the Now Channel, a news and current affairs service which will now only be launched if BSB obtains the additional transponders. BSB says if its application for the two extra channels succeeds, these could be on air by next January.

Last November the UK government announced it would tender the two remaining DBS transponders which are carried

on the same satellite as the existing BSB channels. The International Broadcasting Authority (IBA) formally advertised the contracts last month and the franchise is set to be awarded by Easter.

## Jarre Concert Promoter Bust

London - The promoters of Jean-Michel Jarre's much publicised 'Destination Docklands' concerts in London's East End have gone into voluntary liquidation with debts of around £1 million.

The two concerts are said to have cost £5 million to stage, though Jarre was not paid a fee. The promoters were RGE (JMI),

## CN-FM 103 Announces Music Schedule

Cambridge - Cambridge and Newmarket's new commercial FM station, CN-FM 103, which goes on air next week plans a broad range of music programming and features some well-known DJs, says Station Manager & Programme Controller Andy Gillies.

Programming includes a weekly morning rock show hosted by Dixie Peach (formerly BBC Radio 1) featuring chart material and oldies. David Hamilton (also ex-BBC Radio 1 & 2) will host a Sunday oldies show including a special 'Music Game Challenge' competition. Nicky Horne, formerly of Capital Radio and Channel 4 TV will present rock shows on Friday evening and Saturday morning.

Mike Souza, formerly with commercial radio in Hong Kong, will present a breakfast show, and on weekday evenings Nino Pirrello (ex-ITV and Music Box) plays music aimed at the teenage market.

### Diesel Park West - A Big Sound

## 4 More IR Stations Spit Frequencies

Hastings' Southern Sound, Kent's Invicta and Birmingham's BRMB are the latest Independent Radio (IR) stations planning new FM or AM offshoots in line with the current trend to split-frequency broadcasting. And Liverpool's Radio City is set to follow suit.

Cliff Richard opens a new classic hits radio station, Southern Sound FM, for Eastbourne/Hastings on February 5. The station will broadcast to 450,000 people across Sussex and Kent, complementing the existing Brighton-based station. The launch will be backed by a £250,000 promotional campaign.

The station's classic hits formula will be scheduled by computer, according to Head Of Music Jeremy Scott. All music will be on CD for non-stop quality sound. A state-of-the-art commercial production studio has been installed, plus a computerised new/information system to provide three separate localised news services.

Listeners to Invicta Radio's new AM service, Coast AM, launching on March 27, will hear

a "totally new service", according to the station's Managing Director Nigel Reeve. "Invicta has established itself as Kent's number one radio station - the split will offer more choice."

Coast AM's Programme Organiser Kerry July says the station's exact music format is not yet decided, but it "won't be patronising or parochial. Coast AM will pitch it just right".

BRMB's new XTRA-AM service will go out on BRMB and Mercia Sound's AM transmitters from April 14. According to Station Manager Phil Riley, the permanent playlist will be "a thousand all-time hits that people always remember, plus a short current list which will change with the charts but only represent one or two plays an hour".

Specialist music shows will be slotted into evening and weekend schedules. The station is aimed at a 35 to 50-year-old audience.

## Bid To Block Piccadilly & BRMB Mergers

Birmingham - The Miss World entertainment and leisure group is trying to block the merger of independent radio stations Piccadilly Radio in Manchester and Birmingham's BRMB. It was announced at the end of December.

In a surprise move, Miss World acquired a further 7% of stock in Piccadilly - bringing the group's holding to an estimated 30%. But the shares do not carry voting rights and Miss World chiefs Owen Oyston and Eric Morley are trying to persuade other shareholders to oppose the merger, which is scheduled for

approval by February 6. The merger is seen as a way of blocking a reported attempt by Oyston and Liverpool's Radio City to take over Piccadilly.

Miss World bought the extra Piccadilly shares from Crown Communications which still has about a 14% holding in the station. Crown said the sale was part of a general restructuring, including the sale of its holding in Beacon Radio (Wolverhampton) and an increase in its stakes in Mercury and Southern Sound in the South.

## CRA Protests Copyright Rule

The Community Radio Association (CRA) claims that music copyright arrangements for the UK's 20 new community stations amount to "blackmail".

The CRA objects to a rule whereby successful applicants must obtain a licence from the Performing Right Society (PRS) and Phonographic Performance Limited (PPL) before they can get a contract from the Independent Broadcasting Authority

(IBA). A CRA spokesperson said the rule gives the PRS and PPL "a substantial negotiating advantage".

The spokesperson went on: "This is an invitation to these powerful monopolies to blackmail new entrants, claiming also that the rule is against the recommendation of a recent Monopolies & Mergers Commission report to keep such regulations to a minimum."

## Teldec Takes Over MCA Catalogue

Hamburg - The MCA catalogue has been transferred from WEA to former West German independent Teldec, as part of the restructuring of Teldec following its takeover by WEA in early 1988.

According to Teldec's Managing Director Jurgen Osterstein, the MCA catalogue, which contains some 600 titles and was

handed over officially on January 1, will automatically give Teldec an additional 1.5% market share.

MCA artists, which include Tiffany, Nik Kershaw, Holly Johnson, Jan Hammer, Tom Petty, Diana Ross and Charlie Sexton will account for approximately one-third of Teldec's pop repertoire turnover. ■

## Rock Summit At Frankfurt Fair

Frankfurt - A 'rock summit' on January 29 featuring West Germany's Udo Lindenberg and the Soviet melodic rock group, Sojus, is part of the record-breaking programme of concerts planned for the 10th International Frankfurt Music Fair from January 28 to February 1.

The mainly hardware Fair is expected to host 905 exhibitors from 38 countries, with an attendance of 500,000. State broadcaster Hessischer Rundfunk

(HR) will televise the event.

The 'rock summit' is sponsored by West German musicians' magazine 'Soundcheck' which, with other leading national music magazines Fachblatt, Musiker and Keyboard, has also co-organised an extensive seminar and workshop programme. Similar topics during the last two days of the Fair will include marketing questions and the impact of the emerging single European market. ■

## Bremen Makes Way For Privates

Bremen - Bremen's recent media law establishes the legal framework for private broadcasting from within the small northern state. Two new regional TV frequencies will be shared by public and private broadcasters.

From 18.00 to 24.00 hours, these will be reserved for the nationwide state broadcasters ARD and ZDF's satellite channels Eins-Plus and SAT 3. The remaining airtime, together with a third frequency to be made avail-

able in the future, will be allotted to private broadcasters.

But private radio broadcasters will have to wait until 1996, when a fifth radio frequency is allotted, before being allowed on the air. The four existing frequencies will continue to be used by public broadcaster Radio Bremen.

Private radio and TV broadcasts from the neighbouring states of Hamburg, Schleswig-Holstein and Lower Saxony can already be received in Bremen. ■

## New Hope For Radio Korah

Hamburg - Hamburg-based private Radio Korah may be back on air within a few months (see Music & Media issue 4). The station's management, which declared bankruptcy last autumn, has indicated that it has finally found a financial backer willing to support the original concept of a non-profit station.

Former DJ Jan Peters says the

backer comes from outside the media industry. There is speculation that Hamburg millionaire Jan-Philipp Reemtsma, whose tobacco company is known for its sponsorship role, may be behind the move. But with or without backing, Radio Korah must apply to the Hamburg Media Authority to renew its licence, due to expire on January 25. ■

## DRS Launches 'Barock'

Zurich - This week (February 4) sees the launch of the new weekly rock show 'Barock' on the German-speaking TV channel of Swiss broadcaster DRS (see issue 2). The 45-minute programme will be based on excerpts from around 10 clips with music styles from pop to trash metal.

As Frank Senn, Editor and DJ of 'Barock' is careful to point out,

"not all the clips presented are featured in the charts. We want to create a platform for unknown Swiss bands and for indie acts, with clips that do not have to be technically perfect".

Every show will have a theme or emphasise a particular trend and one Swiss band will be selected to present a song. 'Barock' replaces 'Tiparade'. ■

## Zueri West - Stretching Limits

Zueri West recently grabbed the national limelight by being voted Switzerland's most popular rock band in 1988. National success came with their debut LP, *Sport Und Musik*, on their own Black Cat label, co-produced with independent distributor Sound Service. With another album due in May, the five-piece from Bern look set to remain in the spotlight.

Formed in 1984, Zueri West made their name through their energetic live performances. Their sets include their own material plus cover versions of songs written by The Jam, Joe Jackson and Bruce Springsteen. Zueri West sing in their local Bernese dialect and their success has

prompted renewed interest in 'dialect rock'.

Currently in the studio recording an LP under the working title *Buenitz - Casablanca*, the band are developing further musically. "They are stretching their limits, broadening their approach," says Producer Hugi Heilingler, at the Powerplay Studios near Zurich where they are recording. Lead singer Kuno Lauener adds that there "will be more ballads this time".

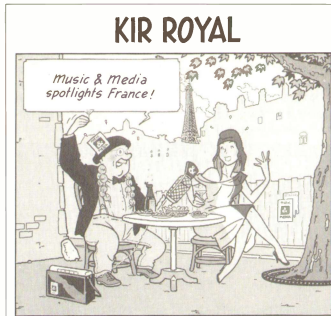

# SACEM Revives Call For Music TV

by Emmanuel Legrand

**M** French authors' society SACEM has renewed the call for a French music TV channel on cable or satellite, claiming this is vital if the domestic video clip industry is to be successful.

While it saw 1988 as very productive for France's video clip industry, a SACEM report released at MIDEM said the current broadcasting situation in France threatens the video industry's economic viability. The report complained of a lack of support from channels like private TFI and La Cinq and state TV Antenne 2.

Over 220 clips were produced on French labels in 1988, according to the report. PolyGram took

the lead with 59 videos, followed by CBS (39), EMI (22), WEA (18), Virgin (14) and BMG (13).

The French video industry is financed from various sources, including specific funds. The CNC, the National Centre Of Cinematography, gave over Frf 7 million to 100 clips last year. Two private channels, Canal Plus and M6, together broadcast 85% of all clips and have become a major source of financing.

Each screening of a video earns between Frf 715 (M6) and Frf 4,500 (TFI). Total revenues from broadcasters reached Frf 46.5 million in 1988, of which 50% was paid by M6 and 34.8% by Canal Plus. ■

# 'Les Enfants Du Rock' Dropped

Paris-Style TV channel Antenne 2 has dropped 'Les Enfants Du Rock - Planete Rock', its weekly rock magazine show of clips, live performances and interviews.

The station says viewing figures for 'Les Enfants', one of France's most popular music shows, have declined drastically since the programme switched in September from a weekly Saturday night slot to one Sunday evening a month. "The Saturday night audience has failed to materialise on a Sunday," a spokesperson said.

The originator of 'Les Enfants', Patrice Blanc-Francard, who predicted a drop in ratings

when the show lost its Saturday weekly slot, was unavailable for comment. ■

# Trema Celebrates 20 Years

**M** France's leading independent production company, Trema, is celebrating a record turnover in 1988 and its 20th anniversary this year. To mark the occasion the company announced a string of projects at MIDEM.

This year's most important marketing campaign will be for Michel Sardou's entire catalogue, to be released for the first time on CD. A Charles Aznavour campaign will follow.

At least 13 new albums are slated for 1989. Trema has already signed artists like Catherine Lara.

Toure Kunda and Charles Aznavour and from new bands like Animo, Garçons and Le Cri De La Mouche. A special marketing drive on Trema's back-catalogue is also planned, as well as a series of compilations.

Trema's turnover for 1988 reached an all-time high of Frf 180 million, a 60% increase over 1987. The company sold 1.5 million singles and 2 million albums. Trema's market share is 2.8%.

Created in 1969 by Jacques Revaux (composer of *My Way*) and Roger Hanin, Trema has always focused on French talent. ■

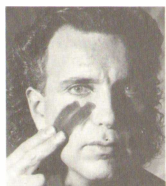

# Dutch PM Opposes Commercial TV

The Hague - Dutch Prime Minister Ruud Lubbers has spoken against setting up a commercial TV station in Holland, despite a 10-month-old government agreement with media organisations to the contrary.

"The situation has changed and I don't believe we should have commercial television," Lubbers said. "The only thing I want to talk about is increasing commercial airtime on the existing stations - though not on Sundays." The move contradicts a deal sealed last year whereby the ATV/EPTV group (broadcasters AVRO, TROS and Veronica with four other publishers) was planning to set up one commercial TV station and several radio stations.

Liberal Party (VVD) media spokesperson Loek Hermans: "We've got this agreement and Lubbers can't just push it aside. As far as I'm concerned he spoke as a personal bias and not as

Prime Minister, because he was not representing the view of the entire government."

And a spokesperson for the ATV/EPTV group said: "We're a major force in the Dutch media landscape. We want to be seen as such and our plans should be taken seriously, which the Prime Minister obviously isn't doing."

Meanwhile, Media Minister Elco Brinkman has started talks with the group to try and resolve the dispute. Two major problems are how to finance public service broadcasting and the control of revenues earned from commercials on both private and public networks. The ATV/EPTV group proposes that all money earned should be handled by one organisation, which ATV/EPTV would control. But broadcasters which want to stay in the public sector are heavily opposed to this plan. ■

# Revelation Time Go It Alone

Amsterdam-based reggae band Revelation Time have gained fame through their friendship with the internationally famous Dutch footballer, Ruud Gullit.

When Gullit was transferred to Italian football club AC Milan in 1987 he organised a concert for the band there, which was a great success. Last May, they signed to Red Bull Productions in Haverstrum and their first single, *South Africa*, which featured vocals by Gullit, shot to no. 3 in the Dutch chart.

The group released their first LP, self-titled, towards the end of last year and a new single from the album, *Yes Are*, is scheduled for end-January/early February release. Red Bull spokesman Edu Van Hasselt: "We expect the new single to

match the success of *South Africa*. No, Gullit is not involved in this single. They must now go ahead on their own."

"Revelation Time have definite international potential. We will be aiming to distribute the album and new single abroad following the success of *South Africa*. The single did well in West Germany, Norway and Sweden and is still selling in Italy." ■

Amsterdam - For the first time, solo vocalists can feature on Dutch broadcaster NCRV's renowned radio talent show for new acts. Under the title 'Popslag '89', the Saturday afternoon show replaces last year's 'Paperclipband '88'.

NCRV says that last year's show sparked off "countless new

quests" from solo acts to be allowed to take part. 'Popslag '89' is open to groups and soloists who have not yet had a record in the Dutch charts. Selection is by demo tape, but all performances on the show, aired from 12.00 to 14.00 hours on Radio 3, are live. ■

## Portuguese Sales Down

Lisbon - Portugal's third-quarter record sales for 1988 fell 15% compared with the second quarter, according to figures released by the association of video and

audio publishing companies, UNEVA.

Singles and maxi-singles were hardest hit, falling by 41%, and cassette sales were down around 23%. But vinyl album sales grew by 5.5% and CD sales improved slightly less - CDs still represent just 6% of the current total market.

A total of 1.46 million records, cassettes and CDs were sold compared with second-quarter sales of 1.674 million. ■

A very similar, unauthorised version of the song, from the band's recent hit album *Caminos Soria*, was used in a TV commercial for book publisher Gran Angular. A judge suspended the advertisement after EGO Musical complained.

Parties involved include the advertising agency Leit Motiv RSCG, producers ADV Production Co. and Gran Angular Publishing. ■

## Solana Won't Change Programming

Madrid - Luis Solana, the new Managing Director of Spain's national radio and television network RTVE (see issue 3), said he will leave major programming decisions on the radio and TV networks to the media professional-

ists. He plans to focus on technical and economic changes rather than programming decisions, he said. His plans include contracting out more services to external production companies. ■

### Private TV Makes Fighting Start

Athens - Though it has not yet been made legal in Greece, private TV is getting off to a determined and controversial start.

On January 1, the Mayor of the Port of Piraeus, Andreas Andrianoopoulos, started up his own municipally run private TV channel amid state attempts to jam the transmissions. ERT also blocked free channels by transmitting

satellite programmes. And at the same time, the Mayor of the northern Greek city of Salonika, Sotiris Kouvelas, started his own TV service called TV100.

The state networks claim such moves are unconstitutional, but lawyers from the municipalities disagree. No police move has yet been made to stop the transmissions.

Media analysts believe the government will continue to outlaw private television programmes until national elections in June at least, when some public commissions are expected. They point out that Greece is now the only EC country where commercial TV is still against the law.

In December last year Andrianoopoulos started Greece's first subscription-TV service, Piraeus TV Plus. But in this can only be received in the Athens area. ■

## More Music At TVE 2 Catalonia

Two new music shows are being added to Catalonia regional programming on national station TVE 2.

The first show, called 'Plas-tic', presented by Tinet Roviera, started on January 16. From 18:00 to 19:00 hours on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays, with a recap on Saturdays, it is targeted at a teenage audience and contains videos, pop performances and contests.

The second, which will probably be called 'La Lluna' (The Moon), is scheduled to premiere on February 6. 'La Lluna' will be a talk show featuring one act each week. The show will be aired Mondays from 22:45 to 23:45 hours, and will be presented by Julia Otero, the popular host of national show '3 X 4'. ■

## £2 Million Worth Seized In Piracy Raids

Milan - Over £2 million worth of illicit cassettes, blank tapes, counterfeit labels, bootlegs and recording equipment have been seized in a spectacular series of anti-piracy raids throughout Italy. The first raid, co-ordinated by the Guardia Di Finanza and Italian copyright society SIAE, was on a duplication plant at Pero, near Milan. Some 22,000 bootlegs, 10 presses and 108 masters were confiscated. Four

more raids in northern Italy followed, then four separate actions in Naples.

And in a raid in Rome, 30,000 counterfeit labels bearing the SIAE stamp were seized. Several arrests have been made and legal action is set to start in a month.

The international trade body IFPI has reacted to the raids by saying they were "encouraging" because Italy has long been a major piracy problem area. ■

## Jazz On Radio Uno

Milan - A three-hour live special launched a new jazz series, 'Giovedì Jazz', on state broadcaster RAI's Radio Uno. There was a jam session, interviews and the complete RAI orchestra of Rome played. 'Giovedì Jazz' is broadcast every Thursday at 20.30 hours and runs until July. ■

## Italy Gets Blank CDs

Blank CDs will be available in Italy in the next few months. Under the brand name That's, the CDs are manufactured by Japanese company Taiyo Yuden and will be distributed by Italy's Ntc company.

To combat pirating and protect artists' rights, the CDs, initially at least, will only be made available to recording studios, radio and TV, record companies and those involved in information technology. They will cost between L 10,000 and L 15,000, against L 25,000 for pre-recorded ones. ■

## City Square Opens

Milan - Roachford, Chicken Shack, Kool & The Gang, Boogie Brothers and Pablo Moses are among the international acts booked so far for Italy's first 'music hall', City Square, which recently opened in Milan.

City Square works closely with local radio; Kool & The Gang are already being featured on Radio Milan International and other acts are booked for Rete 105.

Milan-based company Kono Music is behind the venture. The company also manages singer Sabrina Salerno, owns the record label Durium and acts as tour agent for artists like Vasco Rossi and Pino Dancini. ■

## Massimo Priviero - A Definite Rock Man

Massimo Priviero, whose debut album *San Valentino* has just come out on WEA Italy, comes from a new breed of Italian rock stars - like Alessandro Bono and Bangaro.

Priviero, a self-confessed perfectionist, is 90% happy with the LP. The title track has been lifted as a single and the accompanying video has a gutsy, urban feel. Priviero sees himself as a definite 'rock man' and, although he writes all his songs, he hates the term singer/songwriter.

Seven of the album's songs were recorded at London's PRS Studios while the tracks *Non Ho Giu* and *Ambarino Di Strada* were laid down at the Chez Billio Studios in Milan. Mark London and Pierre Forlan produced and London, with Elio Fabro, was also responsible for the arrangements.

There's a strong UK presence on the LP; Priviero is joined by ex-patriate guitarists Dave Paton and Andy Park, with Charlie Morgan on drums, Jody Linscott on percussion, Miriam Stockley on

backing vocals and Jamie Talbot on saxophone.

When Priviero first turned up at WEA the company was not immediately impressed but, after a period of getting to know each other, he was signed. WEA is now planning a tour to promote the LP and with the right kind of exposure, WEA's claim, 'I've seen the future of Italian rock', his name is Massimo Priviero', might just come true. ■

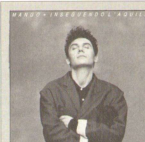


### SINGLE OF THE WEEK

#### 'Til Tuesday

(Believed You Were) Lucky - Epic  
A good example of the American band's style and their authoritative way with songs. This is well produced, atmospheric folk-rock complete with attractive, intriguing melodies supported by a semi-acoustic sound. It is no secret that

Aimee Mann's fanciful vocals are one of the most attractive things about this up-and-coming band. Maybe 1989 will see them finally break through after months of being widely tipped as contenders.



### ALBUM OF THE WEEK

#### Mango

Inseguito L'Aquila - BMG/Ariola  
Poetic, dramatic and melodic are the keywords concerning this gifted Italian's work. On the lyrical side he could be compared with the likes of Angelo Branduardi whereas his melodies lean more towards Matta Bazar. The singer's high-pitched, crystal-clear voice is well supported by tastefully arranged synthesizer backings. Anyone who is interested in first-rate Continental songwriters should check out this charming album.

### The Reggae Philharmonic Orchestra

#### The Reggae Philharmonic Orchestra - Mango

Partly a band and partly a small orchestra, this act combine the features of both reggae and classical styles with country-oriented colours on the strings. A really challenging and inspired fusion, produced and arranged by guest vocalist Mykaell S. Riley. Check out *Minnie The Mocher*, *Love And Hate* and the instrumental *Sharpeville*.

### The Jazz Devils

#### Out Of The Dark - Virgin

The debut album of a British threesome who make a mixture of blues, soul and pop. Singer Andy Taylor should not be confused with the guitarist of the same name from Duran Duran. The title track is a wonderful, melodically wealthy R&B song. Have a listen to *It's A Crime* and *Back In Town*.

### Neil Diamond

#### The Best Years Of Our Lives - CBS

The 70s king of mainstream is back with 10 dramatic, tear-jerking songs, 10 of which are co-written by himself. The remaining track is a cover version of Tracy Chapman's *Baby Can I Hold You*. David Foster produced and arranged.

### Tangerine Dream

#### Optical Race - BMG/Private

The usual stuff. Loads of synthesizer sounds melting together to form a huge blanket of symphonic texture. They are masters in the genre and if that is your thing then this LP will appeal to you.

### Christine Lidon

#### Avalance - Phonogram

This is a fairly strong collection of sub-Blondie songs sung in a dreamy, typically French style. Largely up-tempo stuff with a sprinkling of potential singles in

cluding *Une Etoile Egaree* and *Remener*.

### Havana Warriors

#### Indian Warriors - EMI

This ex-Talent Track tip from Finland seem to be crossing over at last. Their music varies from the atmospheric pop of *Indian Warriors* to the Zeppinesque raunch of *Needs Must* and *Hoo Myself*.

### Earth, Wind & Fire

#### All The Myths On Sunday - Ford

Not quite as packed with hits as its predecessor but nevertheless good listening. Includes tracks from as far back as 1974 (*Mighty Mighty* and *Devotion*) alongside more recent material such as *Turn On* (The Beat Box).

### Overload X

#### Weapon Is My Lyric - Mango



A slice of UK rap from a member of X Posse, the London-based raphip-hop collective. The lyrics are powerful, backed up by a weird collection of bleeps, squeals and scratches. Check out *Kickback*, *Now My Day Begins* and *Brutal Bass*.

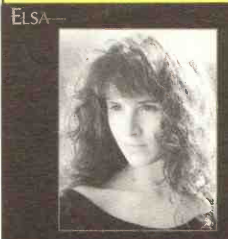

# Cannibals Take The Raw With The Cooked

"I like the mixture in life," says Fine Young Cannibals vocalist and front man Roland Gift. After a varied three years, the band are back with a new album, *'The Raw And The Cooked'*, out this month on London Records.

Appropriately enough, Gift discusses *The Raw And The Cooked* over a Japanese lunch. In the three years since the first self-titled LP, all three members have been busy outside the band and only returned to the studio last year. "It was partly because we did a second tour of the US when we knew we should really get writing," explains Gift. "Then I did the film 'Sammie And Rosie Get Laid,' which set us back again; and we did some music for Barry Levinson's film, 'Tin Men'."

Three of the songs from 'Tin Men' are on this LP. "We like the

songs and even though we wrote them for the film, they fit with us. We can see ourselves performing them." Gift does not admit the film launched his career as an actor. "It was just like a pop video; we recorded our bit in Wembley, everything else was done in Baltimore and they spliced it to make it look as if we were there. I don't call that a film role, really."

His real film roles in 'Sammie And Rosie' and 'Scandal,' which opens in March, allowed the other two Cannibals, guitarist Andy Cox and keyboards and bass player, David Steele, to do more work together. Both ex-Beat

members, they had done some producing before the first LP. But their production careers took off when they invented Two Men, A Drum Machine & A Trumpet, whose single *Tired Of Getting Pushed Around* was a UK top 20 hit early in 1988. "Then we just got loads of offers to produce," says Cox, listing Wee Papa Girl Rappers, Pop Will Eat Itself, Hugh Harris and Two Nations among their recent projects.

They also produced much of *The Raw And The Cooked*, with some help from David Z, who has worked with Prince. Cox admits they enjoyed the 'Prince'

experience: "We used the actual room that he records in. It has purple carpets so you get the full feeling." The result of this session is the distinctive pared-down sound of the current single, *She Drives Me Crazy*, a UK top 5 hit and no. 22 in Music & Media's Hot 100 at press time. "It's good to have space in music," maintains Cox, "what you leave out is as important as what you leave in."

What Fine Young Cannibals are leaving out this time around is the tour. Gift: "We just want to get another album out. By the third album, we will really want to tour." Meanwhile, the band will project their image through video - *She Drives Me Crazy* uses the striking visuals of Philippe De Couffle, who directed New Order's award-winning *True Faith* clip.

But if variety is the spice of life, Fine Young Cannibals are definitely Gift's bread and butter. "It is good to work with other people," he says, taking another mouthful of lunch, "but we like the music that we make together most of all." ■

Swiss duo Yello think their latest album, *'Flag'*, out on Fontana/Phonogram, is closer to their real identity than some of their previous work. Meanwhile both the LP and the second single from it, *'Tied Up'*, have slipped into the European charts.

Yello's Dieter Meier explains what the title, *Flag*, means. "When you are successful, there is this little devil at the back of your head. It makes you think about what you must do to get there, instead of just thinking about doing what you have to. *Flag* has to do with holding on to your identity. Our last album, *One Second*, was a bit too slick and smart. It had nice songs, but it was not as much Yello as this one."

Yello's thematic, cinematic sound has certainly brought them a long way since 1979, when Mei-

er and Boris Blank started recording their musical ideas on two cassette recorders. Their major breakthrough came with the album *Stella*, released in 1985, followed by *The New Mix In One Go*, a compilation double album with remixes of tracks from albums released between 1980 and 1985.

Then in 1987 came *One Se-*

*cond*, featuring ex-Associate Billy McKenzie and a superb duet with Shirley Bassey, *The Rhythm Divine*. And the duo composed music for fashion shows by designers Thierry Mugler and Azzedine Alaïa. Meier also did the video for Alphaville's *Big In Japan* and directed several films. As far as performing live goes, Meier says Yello plan one

show this year. It will be filmed for cinema distribution. Yello feel their real place is in the studio, where they work like painters on their soundscapes.

Meier writes all Yello's lyrics and Blank deals with the music. Meier: "I do not see the lyrics as important philosophical statements. I am more like an actor who says certain words in certain scenes." How do they start working on a song? Meier: "We always start by just creating sounds. This is Boris's part. He works alone in the 48-track studio, just sculpting sound out of everything. It could be a spoon against a glass of water with a microphone in it."

"Normally out of that, the painting grows like a mushroom in the rain. Then I write the script. I invent a character that walks through sound pictures. I give this character words and even a name and I play this character. I do not have one identity as a singer, I play different characters." ■

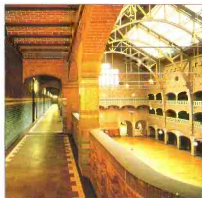

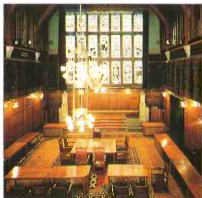
