BT Severs Chart Ties With Danish IFPI

Denmark's official record industry charts are not being published following a decision by *BT*, the country's second-largest daily

newspaper, to drop the **IFPI** charts. *BT* is now producing its own charts based on sales figures from the retail chain **Fona** and several supermarket groups.

BT editor **Peter Dall** says the

newspaper has had "a lot of problems" with IFPI and the current charts. "There have been a couple of records recently which should have made it into the singles chart and which didn't because the companies who released them aren't IFPI members," says Dall.

IFPI Denmark chairman and **PolyGram Records** Denmark MD **Stefan Fryland** says IFPI, which was already in the process of making changes to the chart, is now talking with **Gallup** and plans to launch a similar chart system to that working in the UK and Ireland in Denmark on January 1, 1993. The Danish charts are currently compiled using ship-

EMI Leads 2nd Quarter Euro Album Chart Shares

EMI's purchase of **Virgin** boosted the company to the top of the hill with a 22% album share in

Europe during the second quarter, according to an *M&M* analysis of the **European Top 100 Albums** chart. Virgin added 8.4% to EMI's 13.6% chart share, a slight lead over Europe's tradi-

tional album chart leader **PolyGram**.

EMI's top position is largely due to the continued sales of the back catalogue of **Queen** on the **Parlophone** label and current product from **Genesis** and **Gary Moore** from Virgin.

PolyGram follows with 20.8%, powered by strong sellers from a wide variety of artists on different labels, including **A&M** (**Chris de Burgh**, **Bryan Adams**), **Fontana** (**Tears For Fears**), **Fiction** (**Cure**) and **Vertigo** (**Dire Straits**, **Metallica**).

BMG is next with 17.6%, thanks to good performances

Russians Say Oui In Radio Poll

French-backed private commercial radio stations are conquering Russia if the first **Mediametrie** poll of Moscow and St. Petersburg is any indication.

In Moscow, the biggest mover was AC-formatted **Europa Plus/Moscow**, which came in third

with 10.2% audience come, behind **Radio Russia** (45.1%) and **Mayak** (27.5%), both state-funded music and news channels. **M Radio**, backed in part by the Paris-based FM EHR net **Skyrock**, debuted in fifth place with a 5.2% come share, while Paris-based **Nostalgie**-backed

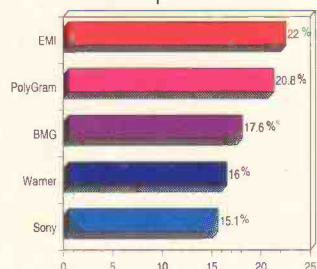

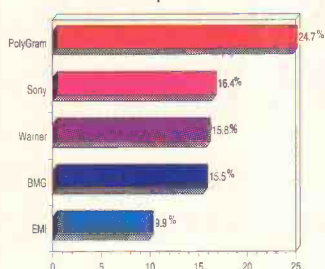

Authority Awards Tristar ILR Licence

The **Radio Authority** has awarded **Tristar Broadcasting** the independent local radio (ILR) licence for the Slough, Maidenhead and Windsor area from a field of nine applicants. The FM station will cover an area with a potential audience of nearly a half million adults.

Tristar has proposed a "mellow" AC format, says spokesperson **Mike Powell**. "We will be targeting the 25-54 year-old age

group, more specifically the 25-to-44-year-olds. This group is by far the largest in that market."

Powell says it was vital to offer a service that is not found on the dial since Tristar will be competing with 18 other stations, including several in London which overlap. "A true AC format is one that is being overlooked in this country," he adds.

The type of music will include artists such as **Michael Bolton** and the **Bangles**, as well as some gold repertoire. "But it won't be crushing gold. It will be post-1966 and will really have to fit the format," he adds.

Tristar, a consortium formed to bid for the franchise, is backed by Swedish satellite TV company **ScanSat**, publishers **Blackwell Group** and **Infinity Radio**, a management investment concern in which Powell is a principal.

The station will have 21 full-time workers including a seven-person sales force and five journalists. The licence will run for a period of eight years from the commencement of broadcasting. The new station plans to be on air early next year.

Giant Launches Medicine Label For New Acts

Giant Records has set up the **Medicine Label**, a new subsidiary label for new and emerging music, to be run from offices in both London and New York. The new label's first president will be A&R veteran **Kevin Patrick**.

As director of A&R for **Elektra Records** (1984-88), Patrick worked with **X**, the **Georgia Satellites** and **Screaming Blue Messiahs**. Most recently he has been working with the **Pogues**, **Marianne Faithful** and **PJ Harvey**, at **Island Records**. He was also instrumental in bringing **Gee Street (PM Dawn & Stereo MC's)** to **Island**.

SACEM Announces Record Rights Revenues For 1991

Revenues from French performing rights society **SACEM** reached an all-time high in 1991 at Ffr2.691 billion (app. US\$507 million), representing the use of more than 500,000 different works. A sum of Ffr1.825 billion was distributed to more than 50,000 French and foreign authors, composers and publishers.

SACEM says management costs were reduced from 17.7% of the turnover in 1990 to 16.14% in 1991, at Ffr434 million.

According to a **SACEM** statement, "Of each Ffr100 collected from music users, Ffr84 was allocated to the benefit of creators and publishers."

The society is eager to publicize these results, as management costs have been a critical issue in the past few years, both in France and before the European courts. Critics had complained that **SACEM** was too expensive to run.

SACEM's main sources of income came from audiovisual

media (TV and radio), accounting for 24.9% of the revenues, followed by mechanical rights, video and proceeds from the blank tape levy (24.72%), the use of prerecorded music in public places (21.94%), foreign rights (increased to 18.65%), live music (7.15%) and cinema (2.64%).

SACEM president **Jean-Loup Tournier** is expected to comment on these results next week during a press conference in Strasbourg.

Davoust Appointed CSDEM President

Jean Davoust, president of **Warner Chappell France**, has been unanimously elected president of France's music publishers association **CSDEM** (Chambre Syndicale de L'Édition Musicale) for a one-year term.

Former president, **Peer Music MD Rene Boyer**, did not seek re-election after four years at the helm. Boyer will

remain VP and says he will closely assist Davoust in his task.

Davoust says he will "pursue the policy already adopted by the **CSDEM**, especially with regard to the questions concerning Europe."

He adds that he will also put his efforts into the development of French repertoire played by radio stations. Davoust says he is "satisfied" by the recent deal

between music industry body **SNEP**, **EHR** network **NRJ** and other FM stations or networks that "will give Franco-phone acts exposure they didn't have." Davoust hopes this is a first step and that other stations will follow. Davoust is also in favour of seeing all French radio stations paying performing rights to **SACEM**.

Dutch Welcome Foreign Cablers

The Dutch Ministry of Culture is expected to begin handing out licences for Holland-based commercial cable radio stations for the first time in history this month. Cable regulations which conform to the new Media Law passed last December in the Dutch parliament were expected to be published at presstime, enabling interested parties, both foreign and domestic, to start up commercial radio or television outlets on Dutch soil.

The new regulations allow any media company or investor based in an EC country to apply for a licence to broadcast commercially in Holland. Foreign media companies with no EC subsidiaries are not eligible.

Ministry spokesperson **Mirjam Otten** reports that although there are "no real candidates" for TV commercial cable stations, there

are "a number of serious candidates for commercial cable radio stations." She adds, "This is not surprising. The difference between radio and television is enormous. TV is very expensive. Radio is very cheap." Otten declines to name the applicants at presstime.

The new regulations also give cable station candidates one year to prove that they have acquired 60% of potential cable subscribers throughout Holland, easing up on a former cable regulation "Catch 22" which required that potential applicants prove they could come up with that 60% figure before they were granted the licence.

Ironically, foreign-based broadcasters are not required to come up with the 60% figure, opening the Dutch government to possible charges of violating EC broadcast regulations by discriminating against Dutch-based companies in favour of foreign outlets.

Radio Donna Takes 8.1% Market Share

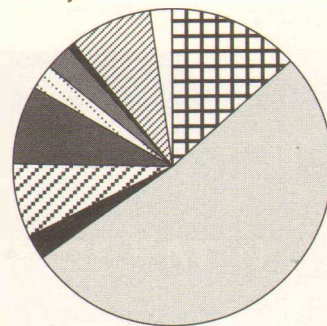
The new BRTN radio station **Radio Donna** (EHR), launched March 28, has already captured a 8.1% share of the Flemish market—much better than the planned 5%—according to the results of the BRTN's March/April ratings research (carried out by survey company **Sobemap**). These figures cover one month of Radio Donna.

BRTN's **Radio 2**, **Radio 1** and **Studio Brussel** all lost audience in the last survey, suggesting that BRTN's plans to capture a number

of "undecided" listeners had succeeded.

Says BRTN director of general radio **Piet Van Roe**, "We have now proven that Donna's profile catches 8% of the market in Flanders. This is very important for BRTN's position on the market."

With an 83.5% share of the Flemish market, BRTN has boosted its share by 2.6% since January/February: **Radio 2** is still leading with a comfortable 51.9%, followed by **Radio 1**. *MM*

VPRT Wants Radio Spectrum Study; Seeks More Frequencies For Privates

The private broadcasting trade group **VPRT** has called for a survey of the national radio spectrum by the German postal authorities to determine which frequencies the public service radio stations could relinquish. The move is the latest tactic by the private stations and the **VPRT**, who have been fighting for several years without success, to change German broadcasting to one closely modeled on the UK system in which public stations exist solely on the public licence fees.

Says **VPRT** chairman of the radio committee and **Radio Victoria**/Baden Baden MD **Christian**

Frietsch, "Public stations own about 75% of the FM frequencies in Germany, often covering a single area with four to eight different frequencies for a single station programme. We demand that the German postal authorities, who control the distribution of these frequencies, make a thorough nation-wide test which will prove that public stations could give up many terrestrial frequencies to private stations and completely maintain their coverage of their areas."

Frietsch was reacting to comments made by head of the public broadcaster **ARD**, **Friedrich Novotny**, during a recent trade meeting. **Novotny** called for more advertising time for public stations

to help them recoup the over DM550 million (app. US\$339 million) loss in revenue over the past year.

ARD deputy head of research and marketing **Dr. Gerhard Franz** agrees with some of the **VPRT** points. "The [dual] system certainly has not functioned in states where local frequencies were awarded to stations in under-populated areas, such as Bavaria and Baden-Württemberg," he says. "The allocation of those frequencies was a misjudgment and not the fault of the **ARD**."

"Our public radio mandate is to provide information, cultural and minority programming along with the entertainment that most of the

listeners want to hear. Our popular programmes are not actually that expensive. The advertising income from those programmes is used, for the most part, to help to fulfil our mandate as a public service. With less ad income we would either have to cut the quality of our programmes and service or receive a much higher licence fee than at present."

He defended the number of frequencies run by the publiccaster by saying, "In this day and age of narrowcasting and target group programming, we have to segment our programmes and have several stations in each area to fulfill our obligations. One or two programmes can't possibly cover all our goals."

PolyGram Launches Zuccherò Vid Single

PolyGram Video Italy staked a claim to its own piece of domestic music history on June 29 with the release of *L'Urlo*, a video single by major artist Zuccherò Sugar Fornaciari.

This is the first time an Italian act or artist has released a single on the format and *L'Urlo* acts as a prelude to Zuccherò's new studio album *Miserere* slated for release in September.

The video was shot in France and directed by Phil Joanou who was also responsible for directing the U2 film *Rattle & Hum*. *L'Urlo* has a running time of fifteen minutes and also includes footage of making the video, backed by the music of another new song from the artist.

Comments head of PolyGram Video Franco Carcassi, "*L'Urlo* has not been released either on CD or vinyl formats and it could be the first time at an international level that a video-single-only strategy has been used." *L'Urlo* retails at L9.900 (app. US\$8), a little more than a CD single.

The radio sector played its

part in the launch. On June 13 at 13.30 EHR nets RTL 102.5 Hit Radio, Radio Italia Solo Musica Italiana, Radio DeeJay, 101 Network, StereoRai, Radio Verde Rai, Rete 105, Radio Dimensione Suono, Radio Arancia Network, Radio Studio Sicar, Radio Norba and Radio Lina all previewed the single. DS

Radio Dimensione Offers Exclusive Olympic Coverage

Rome-based national EHR network station Radio Dimensione Suono is running to be the first through the winning tape with its exclusive coverage of this year's Olympic games staged in Barcelona from July 25-August 9.

Competing Italian athletes Stefano Cerioni, Stefano Tilli, Renzo Furlan, Andrea Zorzi, Angelo Peruzzi, Walter Magnifico, Gianni Minervini and Alessandra Sensini will act as the station's correspondents. Their comments on the usual and not so usual happenings at the Olympics will be coordinated by a journalist from Radio Dimensione Suono and transmitted five times a day in three-minute bits.

The Olimpiadi 1992 slots will start fifteen days before the event and continue through until the end of the Games. DS

Erasure, Bjorn Again Spark ABBA Re-Arrival In Europe

ABBA, the legendary Swedish group which spawned 18 consecutive hit singles, nine of them number ones, is enjoying a revival in several European territories.

Erasure's EP of four ABBA covers, *Abba-esque*, released on Mute and featuring *Voulez Vous*, *Take A Chance On Me*, *SOS* and *Lay Your Love On Me*, is number 1 in the UK charts for the fourth week running and ABBA

has now topped the charts in homeland Sweden. It is also number 1 in Finland and Greece and number 3 in Denmark.

Meanwhile, Australian ABBA cover band Bjorn Again has been attracting hoards of screaming ABBA revivalists to their concerts across Europe over the last year, fuelling the demand for ABBA material. And it's not just nostalgia-seekers who are queuing

for tickets; most are in their teens and too young to remember the Swedish quartet at the height of their popularity in the late '70s.

PolyGram International has now decided that the time is right to release a greatest hits album. Director of catalogue marketing Chris Griffin says that *Dancing Queen* is to be re-released in early August, followed by a new ABBA hit compilation in September, which will be released worldwide on CD, cassette and DCC.

However, contrary to rumours, he says that the company does not plan to release an ABBA boxed set later this year.

Says Griffin, "The success of Erasure's *Abba-esque* has heightened awareness of ABBA; you have U2 performing *Dancing Queen* [joined at a concert in Stockholm last month by ABBA's Benny Andersson and Bjorn Ulvaeus], which I find totally

amazing. Then there's the success of Bjorn Again." Griffin says that depending on the success of the single and album releases, more ABBA projects are likely next year, including a possible "rarities" album.

PolyGram Sweden is releasing a tribute album this autumn, in the same vein as the Elton John/Bernie Taupin *Two Rooms* project. Featuring 12 covers in all, the album will be sung by Swedish artists and is rumoured to include a rendition of *Hasta Manana* by Army Of Lovers. PolyGram's Swedish publishing affiliate Polar Music GM Jonas Hildeland declined to reveal any further details about the project.

In Germany an album of ABBA hits released by the Munich Symphony Orchestra sold over 130,000 copies. Polydor Germany product manager Jens Geisenmeyer comments, "ABBA sales here have been amazing. Germany is one of the most important markets for ABBA now after Australia."

At the San Remo festival Fargo contributed with the lovely ballad *Come Una*

Turandot. This single is something else; it's a dance tune in a Sandra vein.

PREFAB SPROUT

The Sound Of Crying - Kitchenware/Columbia EHR/AC
PRODUCER: Stephen Lipson

Immediately recognizable because of the distinctive harmony vocals, this is vintage Prefab Sprout. The big difference is, however, that it's more "beaty," thus more "meaty." It's an automatic for Radio Forth/Edinburgh head of music Colin Sommerville. "Given that it's taken from a *Greatest Hits* compilation, you can say it's a very good ad for the album. It's thoughtful pop music, melodic without being bland. It adds a good dimension to programming when charts are dominated by dance and pop. This band is a pleasant alternative to American rock with an adult appeal."

GALLIANO

A Joyful Noise Unto The Creator - Talkin' Loud D/EHR
PRODUCER: Mick Talbot

Is it *Stand by Sly & The Family Stone*? No sir, it's *Jus' Reach*, the new single by UK retro funkateers/acid jazz cats Galliano. Their second album marks the rehabilitation of the word "swing," so often abused in this dance era. If you play the track *Skunk Funk*, people will be twisting the night away again, and you'll be responsible for zig-zagging cars in the road.

THE STAIRS

Mexican R 'N' B - Go! Discs R/EHR
PRODUCER: Peg Majoly

No high fidelity here; this is the sound of the rehearsal room. Since Dr. Feelgood's *Down By The Jetty* in 1975, this is the best deliberately mono-recorded album for a major label. The single *Woman Gone And Say Goodbye* is an excellent Creedence Clearwater Revival-like retro-rock gem. In the good old days, this was called dance music, so make your listeners sweat on the transistor sound of *Mary Joanna*.

S'EXPRESS

Intercourse - Rhythm King D/EHR

PRODUCER: Mark Moore

The sexy dance outfit is still ahead of every trend. Whereas everybody seems to jump on '70s disco, Mark Moore and his people have already left this era behind looking for new challenges. The title *Nothing To Lose* speaks for itself. The use of bleeping sequencers makes you wonder if they have expanded their musical territory to outer space. The single *Find 'Em, Fool 'Em, Forget 'Em* shows that they haven't lost their souls out there.

Finally there is justice for world's most underrated singer/songwriter. Although warmly recommended by the great Dylan himself for years, this compilation album by the Indian political activist marks his first national release in the US. The man is a poet who sings/talks his lyrics like Lou Reed. This album almost makes you forget about the latter's *Magic & Loss*. Featuring the late great guitarist Jesse Ed Davis this is a timeless document. Listen to the rocker *Bombs Over Baghdad* and the bluesy track *Rich Man's War* and shiver.

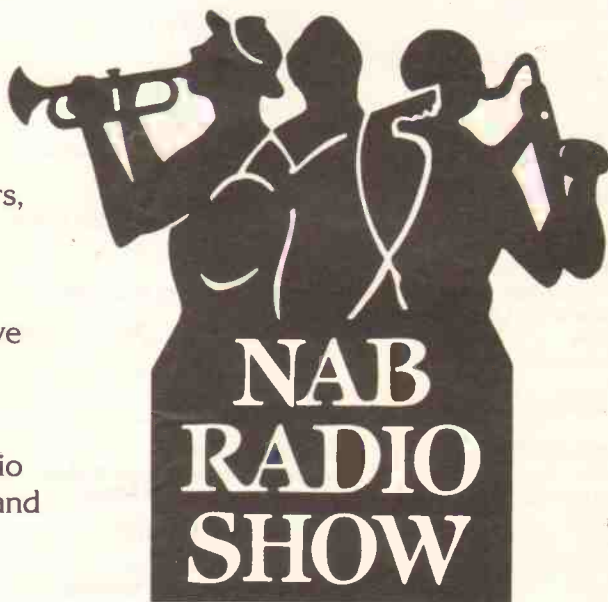

Unified Notes From A Divided Country

by Terry Berne

In early June more than a hundred musicians from all over the world gathered in newly re-christened St. Petersburg, Russia to celebrate for the third year one of the most unusual and ambitious festivals of classical music anywhere.

Founded by American pianist **Constantine Orbelian**, the 10-day, 30-concert event, known as the **Palaces Of St. Petersburg International Chamber Music Festival**, opened the doors to 15 of the city's grand palaces, most built during the 18th century during the reigns of Peter The Great and Catherine II. From the theatre of the **Hermitage** on the banks of the river Neva, to the throne hall of the **Grand Peterhof Palace** in a park on the city's outskirts, an unparalleled view of this former royal capital was enjoyed by both performers and visitors to the festival.

Founded in part to promote the much-needed restoration of a lot of St. Petersburg's architectural patrimony, artists donated their time and talent to the privately funded event. The festival's allure resides not just in the rather special circumstances the city is experiencing with the dissolution of the former Soviet Union, but in the opportunity for western performers to work and forge alliances with artists who

Despite such obstacles, the orchestra has a heavy touring schedule, with concerts in Finland, Sweden, France, Japan, and South and Central America, as well as the St. Petersburg festival. Organizing the festival itself was a matter of confronting chaos and bureaucracy with persistence and imagination. "Before, the

Ministry of Culture would have to sanction everything," Orbelian explains. "Now, nobody sanctions anything. But they still find it hard to understand that someone can have an idea to do something, and then just go ahead and do it. We did all the organizing ourselves; if we had gone through the ministries nothing would ever have gotten done. The key was never taking no for an answer, and always looking for different ways to get them to do what we needed."

Orbelian's recording on the **Chandos** label of **Khachaturian's Piano Concerto** with the **Royal Scottish Orchestra** under **Neeme Jarvi** won the **M.R.A.** award for the best concert in 1988. He is involved on several fronts with the recording industry in Russia. "The recording situation is fantastic," he enthuses. "It's still on vinyl, but they record digitally and have a fabulous CD factory with the latest and most advanced technology. In addition, we have access to one of the finest acoustic spaces in the world—the big hall of the **Moscow Conservatory**."

Apart from an anticipated five to six recordings annually with the **Moscow Chamber Orchestra** itself, he has also signed an interesting contract with **Russian Disc**, an offshoot of the former state-run **Melodya** label, to

release 110-120 archival recordings every year, exclusively on CD and distributed in the west by **Koch International**. Says Orbelian, "I'm going through the archives at the state radio and at **Melodya** and choosing among unreleased recordings made within the last few years, as well as older treasures, such as unheard **Van Cliburn** sessions, vintage **Tchaikovsky** competition recordings, the first performance of the **Shostakovich Violin Concerto** with the **Leningrad Symphony** and even some German recordings captured during the war that have never been heard before. Our first release will be in August on the newly formed **Russian Disc America** label.

"Every day is like a year here now," he reflects, "in terms of how rapidly things are changing. The more this east-west type of mythology is dissolved the sooner we can have a really good musical and cultural scene. These people are very open to all kinds of ideas—that's the name of the game. It just shows that if you really want to do so something, you can do it."

How Do Summer Festivals Benefit Jazz?

The phenomenal growth and success of jazz festivals in Europe poses an interesting problem when pondered from the point of view of sales. As far as sales go, jazz is a marginal, specialized market. It manages somehow to thrive, due in part to the loyalty of its fans, in part to the efforts of record companies on behalf of their acts, and in even greater measure to the hard work and nearly constant touring of jazz artists themselves.

But come summer, all that uncertainty and consternation dissolves in the glow of lights illuminating an ever-burgeoning roster of concerts and festivals well attended by a supposedly (from a sales perspective) indifferent or reluctant public.

Several conclusions can be drawn from this often repeated scenario. The first and most obvious is that jazz is primarily an art whose special qualities reveal themselves best during live performances. There is much truth to this. Jazz is preeminently the art of improvisation which derives its vitality and inspiration almost entirely from the creative resolution of musical problems posed by an open-ended and continually evolving repertoire. Its passionate response to life, its constant exploration of its own methods and roots, and the fact that it is an emotion-driven music, means that direct communication between audience and performer is the ideal to which all jazz strives.

This holds for jazz recordings as well. The surprising thing is that so many recordings by jazz artists actually do achieve this apparently unattainable goal, or at least a satisfactory approximation. Thanks to technology, intelligent production and the effort of the artists themselves, recorded jazz in its totality is one of the greatest cultural achievements of this century, and one of the most influential, not to mention widespread. So why the discrepancy?

Another conclusion that can be drawn from the festival phenomenon is simply that the industry itself is simply ignoring a huge potential, even actual, audience for jazz music. This also has some truth in it. Exposure and

education are the biggest problems facing any art form. All art, even pop music, needs both these elements to survive and prosper. It can even be argued that jazz, with its appetite for ethnic rhythms and styles, is a more universal musical language than any other. The explosion of world music, with its mixture of ethnic, pop, and jazz strains, is strong evidence of this. The current dance/jazz craze also supports this claim of its potential popularity, given the chance, the means and the outlets.

The festivals prove that jazz is economically, not just aesthetically, healthy. Radio, ever more stratified and narrow, which can be a necessary tendency when it serves its listeners, is missing the wagon when it comes to jazz. The record companies are signing more acts, working them better, supporting the festivals, and releasing the product. Radio must take up the challenge from there and try to reach the people. The radio and music industries must work together if the audience is to be catered to as it should be.

Another interesting question raised by the festivals is if, in order to accommodate an ever increasing number of venues, it will become necessary to sacrifice the variety of performance and the uniqueness of some of the festivals themselves. Though there is still plenty of variety, the summer jazz scene in Europe is starting to look like one monolithic tour moving from one festival to another for a three-week period in July. And with so much competition, how will the economics of presenting a festival be effected?

And what about the limits on growth? Festivals seem to have a way of getting ever larger and longer. To what extent can this continue? And finally, the acts presented at so-called

"jazz" festivals are often quite distant from what we normally think of as jazz. Is that an important development? Is it necessary or desirable to preserve jazz music's special identity, even given its own sweeping, not to say all-inclusive, embrace? These are all problems which will become more prominent as jazz continues to evolve and as the industry attempts to consolidate its very real gains in this area.

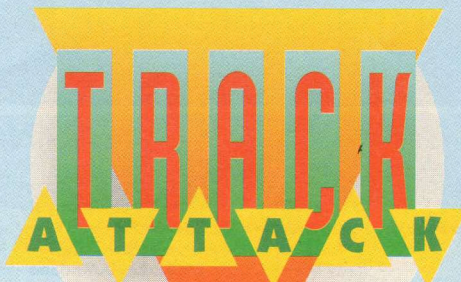

officially step down, along with associate director general **Javier Gimeno de Priede**, from **Antena 3 TV** on July 2, but is currently staying on as head of the radio section.

Antonio Herrero, who hosts the news/talk morning show "El Primero de la Manana," has declared his support for **Ferrand**, as has top sportscaster and radio per-

sonality **Jose Maria Garcia**, whose programme "Hora O" consistently tops the audience ratings. Both have threatened to exit **Antena 3 Radio** if **Ferrand** leaves. **Garcia** has renewed his contract, which includes a clause stating he would stay as long as **Ferrand** remains director general. Asked about eventual attractive offers from rivals **COPE** or **Onda Cero**, he says his eyes and ears are shut, but adds he will abandon **Antena 3 Radio** "a second before or after

Ferrand."

The news comes on the heels of publishing company **Grupo Zeta** president's **Antonio Asensio** assumption of more executive powers at the broadcaster. This followed the buy-out of **Antena 3 TV** by **Renvir** (a company formed with **Rupert Murdoch**) in June (**M&M**, July 4) with the financial help of **Mario Conde's Banesto Banking Corporation** and **Grupo Zeta**. **Murdoch's News International** owns 25% of **Grupo Zeta**.

Nostalgie/Moscow grabbed eighth place with a 1.8% cume share. The poll, based on a survey of 7.2 million **Moscow** residents, measured audience reach from April 27 to May 17 of this year.

In **St. Petersburg**, **Europa Plus/ St. Petersburg** slid into fourth place with an audience cume of 13.5%, behind **Radio Russia** (25.9%), **St. Petersburg** (22.3%) and **Mayak** (15.3%), the latter three all state-funded. Based on a survey of 3.7 million **St. Petersburg** residents, the poll measured audience reach from April 30 to May 20.

The French media invasion is expected to continue, especially following passage—possibly as early as late August—of the new

radio/television media bill, which sets up a regulatory body modeled largely on the French **CSA**. Head of the media section of the Russian embassy in London **Anatoli Danilitski** predicts the French will corner the market in the next two to three years, saying he's heard there is at least one French

group applying for a licence in **Russia** every week. **Maverick Europa Plus France** president **Georges Polinski** plans to prove him right. He reports the French/Russian joint venture **Europa Plus** will expand by some three to four stations by the end of this year alone.

Technical problems arose in mid-June which seriously affected the final results of the data compiled by **Nielsen** for **Top No. 1**, chart operator and subsidiary of radio station **Europe 1**. The bar-coding system in some stores failed to identify some items (mainly those with a code starting with 0), therefore failing to report them as sales.

PolyGram and **Warner** were the two companies most affected by these errors. Albums from these labels either failed to enter the charts or were simply dropped from the charts (such as **Stefan Eicher's** and **Johnny Hallyday's** albums). **PolyGram Records** president **Paul-René Albertini** was one of the strongest critics of the way the new system was handled by **Nielsen**. He says he has evidence that **PolyGram** sales were not taken into account in various

stores.

"This new chart answers the needs of the industry," says **Albertini**. "I know every new system goes through a period of adaptation. But when too many errors start to hurt us commercially, my responsibility as manager of a record company is to make my voice heard. The results that came out from the POS system simply didn't match our sales information. Even if there is only a 10% error margin, it can create a distortion. And we all know that an album that is not charted has a lot of difficulties getting exposure in some stores such as hyper-markets."

Top No. 1 GM Jacques Clément acknowledges that "there was a bug," but minimizes the extent of the problem. "It has only affected a small number of stores for a couple of days, he says. "It was a problem of computer programming that has been quickly solved. By now the system works well and no further problems have

been reported."

Gilles Paire, president of industry body **SNEP** and president of **PolyGram France**, believes "the defects were corrected rapidly" by the operators. **Paire** says the new system is overall more valid than the previous one [records were hand-counted], which was tipped as "unreliable and full of mistakes." He believes it "will be fully reliable after a short period."

Paire says the next step to enhance the reliability of the charts will be to increase the number of stores surveyed, mainly by adding **FNAC** outlets which have reportedly agreed to be part of the panel. A code approved by the industry is also needed.

Paire also praises **Europe 1's** quick reaction. "They used to be considered very slow to react to our needs. But I must say that they have been very dynamic and have implemented the new system in a short time. They have also reacted very quickly to correct the bias."

ment figures from distributors to retailers. Figures are gathered over a cumulative five-week period from **IFPI**-member distributors. There have been many complaints within the industry that the charts are too exclusive and that being an **IFPI** member should not be a factor in being able to get into the charts. A recent Danish hit album from non-**IFPI** member independent company **Elap Music** which never reached the official charts was **Shu-Bi-Dua's** *Shu-Bi-Dua 13*. This finally made **BT** decide to withdraw its support from the chart. The album has now sold 160,000 copies, is number one in **BT's** new chart and has also topped the radio **Top 20**.

Says **Elap MD Verner Bach Pedersen**, "I think a change has been needed to the chart for years. **BT** has finally decided to do something to make the system fairer." **Pedersen** says the most important charts in Denmark are the new **BT** chart and the radio chart. "They are both important because they tell us what product is actually going out to the consumer, rather than shipment figures between distributors and retailers."

BT's new chart isn't without critics, who point out that there is no small retail outlet representation. As a result, critics say, only blockbuster product will chart.

However, **BT** says **Fona** and the other outlets represent 75% of all sales in the country.

Fryland says **BT's** decision "will not have much impact" on the industry. "At present we have about six different charts available to the consumer, including a radio airplay chart and a retail chart," he says. "**BT** has been complaining that hit records from non-**IFPI**-member companies should be included in the chart for some time and we have always said no. The fact is this chart is based on shipment figures, so it's not really relevant to the consumer anyway. When we launch the new chart next year, it will be run on Danish radio and TV and newspapers and magazines like **BT** will have to pay to publish it."

from **Geffen**, **RCA** and **Arista** product. Registering 5.55%, **Geffen** has been **BMG's** best-faring label in the second quarter thanks to **Nirvana** (on the **DGC** imprint) and **Guns N' Roses**. (The **MCA/Geffen** chart points are attributable to **MCA's** licensing partner in Europe, **BMG**, excluding the UK and Germany where it markets its own repertoire). Other **BMG** artists that accomplished good chart results include **Annie**

Lennox (**RCA**), **Curtis Stigers** and **Lisa Stansfield** (both on **Arista**).

Although **Sony** as a company ranked number fourth, its **Columbia** label is 0the top-ranking album label with 11.2% share, a comfortable lead over runner-up **Virgin** label's 7.7% share. The two new albums by **Bruce Springsteen** propelled **Columbia** to the top spot, with *Human Touch* taking 4.4% of total album shares, the highest of this quarter. (Queen's *Greatest Hits II* and Genesis's *We Can't Dance* follow, respectively).

On the singles front, **PolyGram** earned the number 1 position as a company. Its 24.7% share is for a large part due to the **Polydor** label which scored well with releases by **U96** and **Vanessa Williams**. Other artists contributing to **PolyGram's** top ranking include **Shakespears Sister** (**London**), **Def Leppard** (**Bludgeon Riffola/Phonogram**) and **Ce Ce Peniston** (**A&M**).

Sony won the number two spot on the strength of the biggest mainland European crossover of 1992: **Ten Sharp's** *You* (**Columbia**). The track scored an

impressive 3.4% of total singles shares—the second largest of this quarter; **Mr. Big's** *To Be With You* was the most successful single of this quarter with a title share of 4.7%.

Other **Sony** singles that have charted well include **George Michael & Elton John's** *Don't Let The Sun...*, **Bruce Springsteen's** *Human Touch* and **Kris Kross's** *Jump*.

Warner follows with 15.8% thanks to **Atlantic** (Mr. Big) and the **PWL Continental** label (**2 Unlimited's** *Twilight Zone*).

Blockbuster Entries On EHR

Elton John remains on top for the fourth consecutive week with *The One* and has managed to increase the total number of reporting stations to 106, the highest ever.

Although leading with a wide margin, John will be facing competition soon as there is a great number of new releases by blockbuster artists that are all vying for a top 10 entry. All new entries in the EHR Top 40/Chartbound this week originate from established acts who all had a Top 20 hit record before. This is also the reason why there is no "New Top 20 Contenders" category published this week.

Madonna leads the way with the new Shep Pettibone-co-produced single *This Used To Be My Playground*, featured in the movie (but not the soundtrack album) *A League Of Their Own*. Entering at number 16, the track is enjoying great reception in Italy, Norway and the UK. It is also this week's Most Added with 31 new showings—the highest this year. Expect a major breakout next week.

Next in line is Sting with *It's Probably Me* (A&M), co-written with Eric Clapton for the *Lethal Weapon 3* film (OST released by Reprise). Again Italian and Norwegian stations set the trend, followed by promising airplay in Denmark and Holland.

Michael Jackson follows close with the fourth single from *Dangerous*, *Who Is It*. Penetration in Belgium has reached 100%. Other markets where the track is beginning to flourish include Denmark, Holland and the UK.

Bruce Springsteen's *57 Channels (And Nothin' On)* is the fourth entry in EHR this week, due to good airplay in Spain, Norway, France and the UK. EHR programmers in doubt about the viability of the song to include in their playlist should check the powerful remix by Steve van Zandt.

It is interesting to see the great reception on EHR by Erasure's *Abba-esque* EP. All four tracks are being featured—two in the Top 40 (*Lay All Your Love On Me*, *Take A Chance On Me*) and two in Chartbound (*S.O.S.*, *Voulez Vous*). MB
