M6 Share In Chante France Hoped To Boost Expansion

PARIS - Pierre Bellanger is hoping to use a new financial injection to expand all-French music station Chante France.

Bellanger, who is president of EHR net Skyrock and 50%-owner of Chante France, is selling 48% of the latter's operating company Telefun to French TV channel M6, with a view to developing it into a national network.

M6, which is partly owned by CLT and already owns 10.5% of Fun Radio, is set to acquire the share in Telefun for a sum believed to be in the region of tens of millions of francs. The acquisition is now awaiting approval from French broadcasting authority the CSA.

Skyrock is part of a separate operating company Vortex and remains unaffected by the deal.

Spokespeople for M6 have made it clear that the music

TV channel has no intention of playing an active role in Chante France, but the move will strengthen the group's

activities in French music.

For Bellanger the arrival of a new partner will give Chante France the backing it needs for expansion. "We needed a partner that would allow us to expand into a national network," he says. "Of all the TV channels M6 is the most involved in music and is really behind French chanson."

He adds that synergies between the stations are likely in terms of promotion and cross marketing activities.

Bellanger stresses his hopes for a go-ahead from the CSA, underlining the importance of Chante France as "the only station playing nothing but French music. And not oldies but mostly contemporary repertoire."

NRJ Buys Into First Finnish Station

HELSINKI - French radio group NRJ has acquired a 33% share in the Finnish capital's newest radio station FM96.8, which has now been renamed Radio Energy Helsinki.

The move marks the group's first interests in Finland, and a further expansion of its northern European activities, following the creation of Radio Energy Stockholm in 1993.

The former FM96.8, which is a subsidiary of Capitec, was established in July this year and is targeted at listeners aged 20-35.

Ingmar Bergman Joins P2 Campaign

STOCKHOLM - The celebrated Swedish film director Ingmar Bergman has joined the battle to stop cutbacks at Sveriges Radio's classical music channel P2.

In an announcement in the national newspaper *Dagens Nyheter*, Bergman is joined by more than 40 of the country's leading cultural figures in attacking planned reductions in the channel's services.

All have been upset by proposals to save at least 11% of P2's budget, with rumours suggesting that certain sections within the channel will be hit much harder.

The letter says P2, with its mixture of local, regional and national interests, its own production facilities and its range of musical broadcasting, has become an indispensable hub of musical life in Sweden.

■ GERMANY

Successful TV Show Yields Radio Spin-Off

Antenne Bayern is the first client for the one-hour music show JAM, which features interviews with artists, exclusive live tracks and coverage of current trends. Antenne Bayern was scheduled to begin broadcasting JAM every Saturday from 20:00-21:00 from September 2. The JAM radio programme is a spin-off of the popular TV programme broadcast by music channel Viva. Televised twice weekly for about a year now, the show has won various awards for its visual form and content. Produced by Berlin-based syndication house On-Air, the radio programme is sponsored by German jeans brand Mustang.

Radio Salü On Internet

Regional EHR broadcaster Radio Salü has established a site on the Internet. Listeners who call up the Salü site—<http://www.spring.de/salu.html>—can access detailed information on the station. Communication with the Saarbrücken-based station is also possible via e-mail. Salü plans to make studio guests available for interviews over the site by the end of the year. Games offering attractive prizes have been installed to provide an extra incentive to enter the site.

■ UNITED KINGDOM

Linnell Joins Radio WM

Stuart Linnell, recently ousted as MD at Mercia FM/Coventry has left the GWR Group to return to life behind the microphone at BBC Radio WM/Birmingham. He will present the station's breakfast show from September 11. Linnell, 48, started his career at Pebble Mill in 1970, when WM was still known as Radio Birmingham. He then moved into the commercial sector with Radio Hallam/Sheffield and Mercia Sound.

Manifesto Bursts Onto Dance Scene

Mercury Record's new dance label Manifesto had an auspicious start with the release of the Rollo/Masters At Work remix of Donna Summer's *I Feel Love*,

which entered the top of UK dance charts. Next out will be TWA's *Nasty Girls* with Hardfloor/Rollo/Keith Litman/ TWA mixes, and long term album signings include Cindy Jo Finn, Original ME and The Essential Mix produced by SNAP. The team behind Manifesto includes Mercury head of dance A&R Eddie Gordon, DJ Judge Jules and remixer/producer Paul Dakeyne. **Blur/Oasis Battle Rages On**

The rivalry between Britpop bands Blur and Oasis is continuing in the UK. Oasis has agreed to model sports-wear on behalf of its favourite football team Manchester City, while Blur is publicising the fact that award-winning controversial artist Damien Hurst has produced its latest video.

Artists Unite To Ease Bosnian Suffering

Many of the UK's hottest artists are contributing their talents to a charity album. Radiohead, Suede, Paul Weller, Blur, the Stone Roses, Portishead, Noel Gallagher from Oasis, Manic Street Preachers, the Chemical Brothers, the Boo Radleys, the Charlatans and the Levellers have all agreed to record a song each on September 4. The resulting compilation album, to be released on September 9, will benefit the Bosnia relief agency War Child.

■ BELGIUM

BRTN Sees Radio Advertising Rise

Advertising on BRTN radio continues to grow, according to figures issued by Mediamark. The 1995 half-year figures reveal a 17.4% boost of advertising income for the BRTN's radio channels. Over the same period, Flemish private radios witnessed a drop of 13.9% in their advertising revenue.

Radio 2 Names The Summer Hit Of 1995

Wendy van Wanten's single *Verborgen Verdriet* was named this year's "Zomerhit" (Summer Hit) during Radio 2's Zomerhit 1995 event on August 4. Sabien Tiels was named best debut and veteran Eddy Wally was awarded the "Best Belgian Production" prize for his dance hit *Chérie (is in da house)*.

FFH Joins In Protests At French Nuclear Plans

FRANKFURT - EHR station FFH has joined the Greenpeace fleet to protest against French plans to resume nuclear testing at Mururoa.

The station, Germany's third largest commercial net, has chartered a sail boat and dispatched reporter Andreas Kohl to the Pacific Ocean.

The FFH ship *Fai Manu* carries a sail emblazoned with the names of the thousands of listeners who have donated money to make Kohl's attendance at protest rallies around Mururoa possible. FFH has so

far raised a total of DM150.000 (app. US\$98.000).

Kohl is reporting on the Greenpeace-organised protest actions from live on board the *Fai Manu*. FFH head of promotions Jutta Lamy explains, "The reports are broadcast daily between 06:00 and 09:00. During this time we reach more listeners than at any other time of the day."

The station is committed to covering all protest actions on the Pacific Ocean. "We will stay on the spot without any deadlines," says Lamy.

According to Lamy the station has not received any feed-

back on its involvement from the French embassy. "On the other hand, our listeners have reacted very positively," says Lamy. "It's impossible to say how many actually back us up since many donations are made by groups of individuals."

Other stations are also making their own protests against the French government's plans. Berlin-based EHR station Energy 103.4 has collected more than 6.000 signatures from listeners objecting to the tests.

In co-operation with national weekly magazine *Stern* the signatures will be submitted to the French government.

Meanwhile, in France reactions have been few, with most FM networks seeing political comment as beyond their editorial responsibility.

Many of the full-service stations have invited guests into the studio to discuss the issue of nuclear testing, but none have expressed a station standpoint. Predictably enough, the most outspoken station has been the non-commercial anarchist station Radio Libertaire in Paris, which has opened up some of its volatile talk programmes to strong-minded opposers of the nuclear testing.

GWR Outlines Plans For Chiltern Relaunch

LONDON - GWR is set to relaunch the former Chiltern Radio Network's FM services on September 16 in a move which will see five stations move away from their traditional EHR "Hot FM" format to GWR's well-established ACE formula.

The only exceptions to the relaunch will be Galaxy 101/Bristol (which GWR is having to sell) and the recently-launched St Albans station, Oasis Radio, which will reviewed after the FM relaunches.

The stations to be relaunched in September are Chiltern Radio/Dunstable, Chiltern Radio/Bedford, Severn Sound/Gloucester, Horizon Radio/Milton Keynes and Northants Radio/Northampton.

The GWR Group rubber-stamped its take-over of the Chiltern Radio Network in July (Music & Media, July 29).

GWR Group PD Steve Orchard explains that the ex-Chiltern FM stations will all be moving in the direction of adult contemporary, although the pre-

cise mix of ACE and EHR music will vary according to the local preferences.

A further key element of the relaunch will be to introduce what Orchard describes as a "tighter presenter discipline", although in most cases the presenter pack will be re-shuffled rather than cleared out.

Orchard pays tribute to the

high standards of presentation developed by Chiltern, which has nurtured the likes of Paul McKenna, Martin Collins and Neale James. "Presentation standards are very high; they have a good pedigree," he says.

Orchard adds that none of the former Chiltern stations will change their core names for the relaunch.

Los 40 Previews El Ultimo de La Fila's New Album
EHR net Los 40 Principales gave listeners a sneak-preview of the new album by El Ultimo de la Fila last month. Entitled *La Rebelion de Los Hombres Rana* ("The Rebellion Of The Frogmen"), the album is the group's first

since February 1993 and is tipped for chart success—an initial ship-out of 150,000 units to mark the September 4 release was expected to sell out immediately. El Ultimo de la Fila is currently on a 44-concert tour of Spain, which will last through November and is expected to draw some 350,000 fans.

■ HOLLAND

Windham Hill Records To Close

The Hilversum branch office of California-based Windham Hill Records was due to close on September 1, with all activities split between its own international department and the New York offices of BMG, its joint venture partner. The move is a decision by Windham Hill's general manager for European and Latin American operations Frank van Houten, who has accepted a position with Roadrunner International in the Netherlands as vice president special marketing.

Italia Network Confirms Search For New Investors

MILAN - Undine-based national web Italia Network has revealed that it is negotiating the buy-out of two regional stations to expand its existing coverage.

The company has also confirmed rumours that it has been negotiating with several parties interested in buying into the operation.

However, Andrea Gandolfi, president of Italia Network's holding company Finworks, denies that an agreement has already been signed to sell a large stake of the company to record producer Claudio Cecchetto, who is also proprietor of the Milan-based regional Radio Capital.

"According to rumours, so far this year we have sold out to the BMG, Media, Dig It and Expanded record companies," comments Gandolfi, adding, "I can confirm that we have met with Cecchetto on one occasion regarding an eventual collaboration. However, nothing developed from this meeting

and we are not up for sale."

Cecchetto, who is looking to expand his Lombardy-based regional stations into a national network following his departure from Radio DeeJay last January, was unavailable for comment.

Industry sources, however, claim that Cecchetto has met with Italia Network executives on several occasions, and that they are also in negotiation with other interested parties.

The dance/EHR formatted Italia Network currently covers 70% of Italy and the company is negotiating to extend its signal.

"This winter we hope to add the southern region of Puglia, and improve our signal in Lombardy through the buy-out of two regional stations in those areas," Gandolfi says.

In the past four years Italia Network has been one of the fastest-growing networks in Italy, registering a 1.6 million daily average audience in this summer's Audiradio ratings.

The only web to be based in Italy's north-east region, Italia

Network has been the first national operation to significantly specialise their output. While the mornings are turned over to a generalist EHR format, from 14:00 each afternoon Italia Network specialises in dance music.

Radio, A&R Battle For Artist Control

COLOGNE - Record promoters have hit out at tightly-formatted German radio stations, accusing them of stifling new talent with rigid views on song structure and content.

Speaking as part of the Pop-Komm panel on music research, the promotion teams claimed radio was attempting to tell artists how to arrange their songs.

But, as emotions ran high, radio programmers bit back, arguing that A&R managers control the development of young artists and tunesmiths more than any form of media.

BMG Ariola Munich head of promotion Biggi Hamer told the panel she was bewildered by the fact that radio stations are not content to accept finished releases. "Programmers ask me to take out guitar solo, replace intros and change fade-outs."

However, Radio NRW head of music Jeff van Gelder replied, "We have an audience to serve. If our experience tells us that our listeners prefer a certain sound, we naturally want to communicate that to the industry."

Why should radio refrain from comment on artistic output, he asked, when A&R departments already control which artists and what songs are recorded and how?

Hamer and Sony Music Germany central promotion manager Bernd Weiss criticised radio's music research, which often sees new titles tested with listeners before they are ever used on air.

"Testing new singles for audience approval even before the song is ever played on air is a slap in the face of the artists," he feels. "What we end up with

in Germany are over-aged playlists which are not in tune with the actual trends in the music scene."

Dutch radio consultant Ad Roland agreed and warned against relying too heavily on the results of these tests.

"Take 104.6 RTL in Berlin and OK Radio in Hamburg, for instance. Both stations had sophisticated test routines for new songs. Nevertheless, both have lost serious numbers of listeners over the past year."

Radio NRW reacted to this danger at an early stage. The most popular commercial broadcaster in Germany now tests titles which have been playlisted for more than a few weeks. New additions to the playlist are made by programmers based on their professional feel.

"We only test for burn-out," says Van Gelder. "And we don't believe in anonymous telephone tests."

The panel failed to answer the question of who exercises more control over Germany's musical output—the labels which finance recording and production, or the media which distributes the product to the consumers.

However, one conclusion drawn was that listening habits have changed over the past 10 years and many radio insiders believe label executives have not realised the full extent of this phenomenon.

"The time spent listening to music on the radio has stayed fairly constant," observes publisher SWF's head of music research Walter Klingler. "But music now plays a different role than before. The MTV generation sees music as a soundtrack for other activities—listeners no longer focus their full attention onto the music."

Authority Throws Out Plans For Nazi Station

COPENHAGEN - The local radio authority governing four small towns south of Copenhagen has rejected an application for a broadcasting licence from the Danish National Socialist Movement (DNSB), the local Nazi organisation.

The authority says the information on the application conflicts with statements about programming made by the DNSB leader to the press, during which he said the station would contain music with racial purity themes and debates from which Jewish persons would be excluded.

According to the authority, the proposed station would break laws prohibiting racism. An earlier application had been tentatively rejected and sent back to DNSB for revision (Music & Media, August 12).

Kurt Hockerup, mayor of one of the towns and also a member of the authority, told the Danish media, "If our decision is overruled by the ministry of culture [the highest body governing broadcasting] then we will give the Nazis a licence to broadcast for 15 minutes at 04.00.

"We cannot give free rein to such extreme opinions."

The issue of refugees and immigrants in Denmark has been a subject hotly debated for several years.

When it emerged earlier this year that the Nazis planned to start a radio station there was some opposition, but the official explanation was that the group had the same rights to freedom of speech as other citizens.

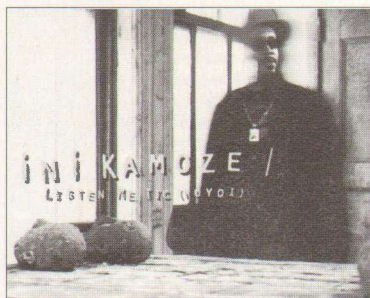

DANNY RED

Rolling Stone - Columbia **d/ehr**
 PRODUCER: Sly & Robbie
 Different from the version on the album *Riddimwise*, the radio edit is dancehall extended with a ragga contribution from a guy called **Banton**—not Pato, nor Buju, but **Starkey**.

DIANA ROSS

Take Me Higher - EMI **d/ehr**
 PRODUCER: Narada Michael Walden
 Seated on a Harley like Whitney in her early days, La Ross shifts to a higher gear, the pop dance speed. With potent remixes even trained clubbers will have problems keeping up with her.

ST. ETIENNE DAHO

Jungle Pulse - Virgin **d/a/ehr**
 PRODUCER: St. Etienne
 Mutual fans British pop trio **St. Etienne** and French singer **Etienne Daho** team up for a "français" record, a French rap on a trip hop kind of foundation. Formidable!

STEVEN VILLE

Loving You Is Really Something - Daco **ace/ehr/d**
 PRODUCER: Steve Mac
 First you think it's a woman, but then you realise it's a gentle giant singing this satin love ballad. And that's really something!

SWAY

Yum Yum Gimme Some - MCA **ehr/a/r**
 PRODUCER: Sway
 Sometimes dance and rock blend. In fact, what Norwegian Sway is doing here isn't very different from the '70s funky stuff by KC & The Sunshine Band. But wah guitar and remixes are '90s hip.

THE BATES

Pleasure + Pain - Virgin **r/a/ehr**
 PRODUCER: The Bates/Andi Jung
 If the millions of kids who purchased Green Day's *Dookie* were to break open their piggy banks again for another great punk record, it should be for Germany's the Bates' second album *Pleasure + Pain*. In just three quarters of an hour, they bang out 18 three-chord songs full of teenage rebellion. The Ramones would be proud of so much endurance. Anyone put on hold by reception at Virgin's office in Munich this summer may have heard a brilliant punk version of **Michael Jackson's Billie Jean**. Well, that's them! So much sing-along potential is simply irresistible, go for it!

THE JACK OF HEARTS

Get A Life! - Mercury **r/a/ehr**
 PRODUCER: Jack Of Hearts
 Like fire or the wheel, good rock will always be reinvented, and why not? While the Americans are redefining punk, a mission that will eventually bring them to an all-round kind of roots rock, Amsterdam's Jack Of Hearts are already in that phase. So if you want to know what it's like to be five years ahead of new punk, here it is. In spirit and lyrical content *Catholic Boy* and the single *Shot In The Back* are nothing less than any Epitaph band kicking against the pricks. *Never Surrender* with its lovely drum and harmonica pattern, however, shows that the Dutch rockers outdo their US peers when it comes to subtlety. Suggested follow up single: *Follow The Wild Man*.

MATT BIANCO

Gran Via - Multi **ehr/ace/d**
 PRODUCER: Matt Bianco
 Reduced to a duo—the two Marks, Reilly and Fisher—Latin-flavoured pop is still what makes them tick. New is the unmistakable influence of jazz dance which surprisingly makes their music relevant to a new generation of listeners. *Lost In You* with a guest appearance by dance diva **Kym Mazelle** among others is as much an invitation to dance to hip clubbers as to the 35-plus demo with a preference for Level 42-ish funk.

SUPER CAT

The Struggle Continues - Columbia **d/ehr**
 PRODUCER: W. Marach/E. Sermon/R. Kirkpatrick/Muggs
 Top Cat is overruled by an even bigger mouth, named Super Cat. He speaks his rhymes faster than you can open your mouth. Although ragga is still very much a left field thing, our man definitely has mainstream appeal. Introduced by his majestic dancehall version of **Fats Domino's** New Orleans R&B classic *My Girl Josephine* as included on the *Pret-A-Porter* soundtrack too, the album holds more nominees for a commercial release as a single. What about 'A' *Class Rub-A-Dub* based on the **Temptations'** 1966 hit *Ain't Too Proud*

Too Beg for instance? Lovers of roots-reggae-with-dub-and-toast should pick *Too Greedy*.

TOWER OF POWER

Souled Out - Epic **ace/ehr**
 PRODUCER: Emilio Castillo/Jeff Lorber
 Not everybody is desperately trying to be hip. Over 20 years now T.O.P. has stuck to its laidback funk style with a full-blast horn section. And in another 20 years time the big band will still sound the same. In a way it's very reassuring as they make the process of aging much more tolerable. ACE stations should play that sultry swing—like *Keep Comin' Back* and *Soothe You*—in the nighttime.

URGE OVERKILL

Exit The Dragon - Geffen **a/r/ehr**
 PRODUCER: Butcher Bros.
 Britpop bands might be stealing the limelight, but that's no excuse for overlooking the interesting guitar-driven US counterparts that preceded them. Don't expect the same Urge Overkill you've come to know from "Pulp Fiction." Their Neil Diamond cover *Girl, You'll Soon Be A Woman* was rather tongue-in-cheek. Only three out of the 15 tracks (*Monopoly*, *View Of The Rain* and *Digital Black*) are more or less in that sensitive mould, all the rest is hard pop by a band which sounds bigger than the trio it is. Evil CD opener *Jaywalkin'* is almost like an intellectual take on the Sweet. Give 'em a break if your playlist is alternative-coloured. Remember *The Break* is our hit tip.

LEVELLERS



Zeitgeist - China **a/r/ehr**
 PRODUCER: Al Scott
 Keeping the spirit of Robin Hood alive, the Levellers unite the desperados and give them new hope. Whereas others follow vague ideals or a flag, these "crusties" share a lifestyle that borders on what either Christianity or communism once were meant to be. The word *Zeitgeist* captures this principle of people looking for an alternative to consumer society. Love it or hate it, it's a sign of the times underlined with modern folk hymns—aggressive like *4 AM* or tender like *Maid Of The River*. Wherever these political troubadours march, the road turns into *Hope St*, just as the lead-off single seems to say.



Suggs Wakes Up After An Eight-Year Hibernation

LONDON - Hey you! He's only one step beyond. **Suggs** (a.k.a. **Graham McPherson**), the ex-idiot-in-chief of **Madness**, has finally got out of bed to start his solo career on **WEA UK** with a happy ska version of the **Beatles' 'I'm Only Sleeping'**. He can go back to bed again without worrying, as in week 35 it was the highest entry in Music & Media's EHR Top 40 at number 29.

In the UK the news of Suggs' sudden resurrection incited an instant radio summer hit. "What a good song Suggs has chosen, not just the obvious Beatles track," expresses **Forth RFM/Edinburgh** head of music **Jay Crawford**. "It fits him like a glove, as it has a touch of Madness by nature—it almost could've been one of their songs."

For **96.4-FM BRBM/Birmingham** ham head of music it was an easy decision to go with the track. "Madness songs have gone consistently well with our audience, and we spotted the mass appeal right away. You'll find anybody of any age group or demographic humming along to it."

At the end of its existence Madness was desperately trying to shake off its

ska/rocksteady stigma in favour of pure Beatle-esque pop, and see what happens as soon as Suggs goes solo? Indeed, you guessed it: it's a ska record and a Beatles cover at the same time! "To accuse him of selling out is pointless,"



says Sadler. "Madness was too prolific a band for that. I wouldn't call it a step back, rather a return to form!"

Recording this song as his solo debut single was a concept thought out by **Warner Music UK** chairman **Rob**

Dickins who personally signed him. "Yeah, that was just me. I always liked that song, especially those lyrics 'please don't wake me, no don't shake me, leave me where I am.' I thought those tongue-in-cheek words suited Suggs even better.

Before he cut it, you could already envision him singing it. It's an easy opener for somebody who has been away so long. It's very much him and the song is familiar to a certain generation." Mission accomplished, as Suggs on his own is already established with a UK top 5 hit single.

Dickins is one of those old-style record industry executives who still like to be involved in A&R-ing now and then. "I take the corporate side very seriously, but the A&R side of business is what really excites me. I love music, but as I couldn't play an instrument, I did the next best thing."

Signing Suggs was the climax of a mutual friendship that dates back to 1979, when Dickins, in his role of publisher, gave the band a £200 (app. US\$317) loan to record their first single *The Prince* after which they signed to **Stiff Records**. The rest is history.

In between Madness' split and now, Dickins and Suggs remained on speaking terms. "I tried to get him back into music, because he was too young to

retire. It would've been a waste not to do it," Dickins looks back.

Once signed the real work began as Suggs is a perfectionist. He rejected a whole list of candidate producers with great reputations, until "big brother" Dickins bought him the famed Jamaican tandem **Sly & Robbie**—an offer he couldn't refuse. "Those were the only producers he was willing to listen to," Dickins laughs.

All in all the "Taxi Gang" has only produced half of the album *The Lone Ranger*, to be released on October 16. The other half has been handled by Mr. McPherson himself, who also (co-) wrote the nine originals on the 11-track album. One of these will be the second single *Camden Town*—out on October 2—about the part of London he hails from and so many others wish they did. To shoot the video Suggs had to go on a "dreadlock holiday" to Jamaica.

Not all of the album is reggae-tinged. The Beatle-esque sound of the last Madness albums returns on a few tracks, like the closing track *She's Gone*, featuring a string quartet. The remaining cover, a strikingly different version of **Simon & Garfunkel's** 1970 hit *Cecilia*, will be the fourth single.

Dickins describes the album as "very English with Jamaican influences. The reggae element is tougher than on Madness albums. Also, using samples, it's more modern."

Veronica Flies Free Again

On September 1 the Veronica story came full circle. The broadcaster's switch from a time-share on the public system to operating as an independent station marks a return to the spirit of independence which launched it 35 years ago. With an FM frequency on cable and two nationwide terrestrial AM frequencies on 828 kHz and 1224, Veronica is "back on the air and on the water" according to its Dfl 5 million advertising campaign. And, true to its sea-faring history, one of the transmitters is located on the MV Communicator, once the home of off-shore station Laser 558.

"Young, passionate and rebellious" is how many of the Veronica pioneers describe the atmosphere on the original pirate ship, which was one of the earliest of the North Sea pirate broadcasters to start broadcasting on April 21 1960.

Veronica was a child of the early '60s. It was driven from the heart and the guts, and nowhere was that more obvious than in the studio. "The team putting together the Veronica show was like a large family," recalled shareholder Bull Verwey in 1974. "Quite often flaming rows would break out over programming. But they soon blew over."

The brainchild of transistor radio importers "Bep" Sloomans, Max Lewin and Henk Oswald, Veronica began life as the VRON, an acronym for "Free Radio Broadcaster of Holland."

The consortium was inspired by the activities of Scandinavian pirate broadcasters Radio Mercur and Radio Syd. Once outside national waters a radio station was untouchable, beyond national jurisdiction. Although clearly visi-

ble from the Dutch coast, the station could broadcast what it wanted!

The VRON was to provide a combination of popular music and radio advertising—until then unknown in Holland—which would stimulate the sales of radio sets and provide attractive advertising possibilities for the consortium's network of business relations around Europe.

The concept was unprecedented, and a huge challenge. A ship was bought, fitted out with the necessary equipment, and before long a team of enthusiastic young DJs was working on a programming schedule. Excited by the possibilities, few of the presenters had radio experience and most were willing to work for as little as Dfl 150 (app. US\$90) monthly.

"When we started we had very few records," writes then-programme director Rob Out in his history of Veronica's pirate days. In fact the station started out with 50 singles and 50 LPs. Record companies were initially wary of being linked with an illegal broad-

caster, but CBS was the first to send product to the station—via an anonymous go-between.

The sales influence of Veronica's adventurous music programming soon became very clear, however, and record companies saw a benefit in supplying product. It did not take long before record plugging had become a phenomenon. Soon it was big business. For many listeners Veronica was the only way of hearing the wealth of young vibrant music coming out at the time.

On January 2 1965 Holland saw its first official chart—the Veronica Top 40—which was based on sales details phoned in from a handful of retailers. At number one was The Beatles with *I Feel Fine*, with Roy Orbison's *Pretty Woman* at number 3.

The chart reinforced Veronica's maverick image, with widespread rumours about it being open to "persuasion." However, Dutch record companies enjoyed Veronica's loyal support of home-grown talent, and the chart led to a period in which Dutch talent bloomed

at home, and sometimes internationally—with acts such as The Cats and Shocking Blue.

"Better Than In The States" was one of the favourite taglines given to Veronica at the time. And indeed, the station brought a new way of radio presenting to the Dutch airwaves. When Willem van Kooten was made programme director in 1964 he made a trip to the US and was struck by the relaxed style of presentation. DJs improvised rather than reading off their words, and presented sections of two hours rather than the 15-minute sections he had been used to.

Veronica's future seemed uncertain in 1974 when the pirate chapter ended. A new Dutch law forbade broadcasting from the sea, and the Veronica ship was hauled in. However, the pioneering spirit refused to die. A strong campaign succeeded in rallying enough public support to allow Veronica to join the public broadcasting system in 1975, where it has continued to broadcast almost uninterrupted for 20 years.

With DJs Jeroen van Inkel and Gijs Staverman among the most popular voices on Dutch public radio, Veronica has remained a favourite station among Dutch listeners with its broadcasting hours of 17:00-18:00 during weekdays and all-day Saturday. However, Veronica is and remains independent at heart. Although it leaves the FM for AM and a cable frequency, the challenge of the 24-hour open airwave was just too strong...

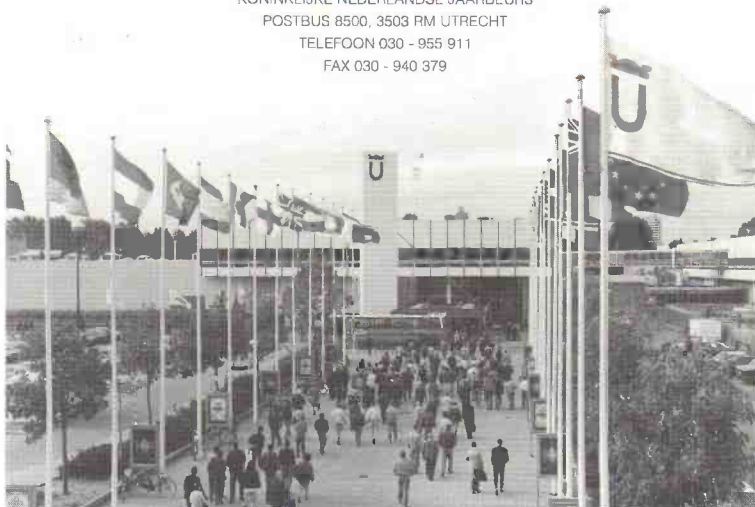

Jeroen van Inkel says, "The first time I became aware of US breakfast shows in the early '80s it changed my view of what was possible on radio."

"When I joined Veronica in 1983 Dutch radio was dry and sombre. Nobody dared poke fun at anybody. DJs never swore, let their hair down or really expressed themselves."

Hence his decision to give his colleagues a taste of how radio is made in the US. He asked Veronica's US correspondent to tape a variety of different morning shows and post them to Holland. "It helps to work for a big media network," laughs Van Inkel.

Together with fellow Veronica DJ Adam Curry he put some of the US-inspired ideas into practice during their Friday afternoon show on Radio 3.

"We had Friday, which was the best radio day of the week," remembers Van Inkel. "The weekend was just around the corner and Adam and I would go wild in the studio. With its sound effects, gags and hot music, our show was unique in Holland."

And the crazy antics of the two DJs received full support from Veronica's management. "[Then programme director] Lex Harding was a great help," says Van Inkel. "Only if we really lost it and started rambling on would he ask us to calm down. I am sure he saw the potential in the style we developed."

Curry moved over to Veronica TV in 1985, after which Van Inkel christened his new afternoon drive time show Rinkeldekinkel and one of Holland's most popular radio programmes was born. Ten years later the programme has finally received the day slot which suits it best—the breakfast show.

Rinkeldekinkel—Good Morning kicks off the weekday at Hitradio Veronica. "Right now the show still features 70% music and 30% talk," says Van Inkel. "But I will be slowly increasing the talk content. The optimal breakfast show mix is 60% music and 40% talk."

Van Inkel, who started his radio career at Amsterdam pirate station Radio Decibel in the early '80's, can live with Veronica's credo to follow trends and not to set them.

"We have to win a solid listener base first. That's why we avoid being too progressive or experi-

mental with our playlist. Once we have established ourselves we might start to extend our musical spectrum a bit." However, he points out, "We are explicitly launching Kink FM as a forum for more trendy styles like alternative rock and certain dance music genres. Hitradio is and will remain a pop station."

Hitradio Veronica's closest competitor will be [dance station] Radio 538 group. But, as 538 caters to a younger target, it does not pose a great problem, believes Van Inkel. A more pressing problem for him is the drop in audience from Radio 3—with its 22% market share—to Hitradio Veronica, which will start with a 0.6% market share.

"At a big station like Radio 3 everything you say has an enormous impact," he says. But the sheer excitement of setting up a completely new station with its own identity is stronger than marketshare-related worries. "I am not bothered by the fact that I make a show for fewer people than I reached through Radio 3. The kick I get out of being involved in Hitradio Veronica is simply too big."

Meanwhile, for budding new DJ Rob Jensen, Veronica's decision to go commercial gave him the break he was waiting for; the chance to try his DJ skills on Hitradio.

Jensen was discovered by Veronica while he was working at regional Dutch ACE station Radio

is brilliant," says Jensen, who has been tipped by station PD Unico Glorie as one of the hottest radio talents in Holland. "And each day brings a new challenge. It really helps that at Hitradio we are a team. Nobody tries to push a fellow DJ out of the limelight."

At Hitradio Jensen presents the 18.00-20.00 show "Jensen's Evening Romp". "My own show at

A Three-Pronged Radio Attack

THE strength of Veronica's new 24-hour station Hitradio Veronica will lie in its ability to offer a

clear-cut format, according to HMG/Veronica MD Unico Glorie. "There is as yet no station with a clearly distinguished format in Holland," he says, pointing to his hopes for the channel.

The path is clear, he believes, for a station with a format targeting 13-35 year-olds with up-tempo programming.

"To be successful we have to offer advertisers a clearly-defined target group and prove that we actually reach it. I believe this will work as we can adhere to a much stricter format after leaving Radio 3."

With other formats in the pipeline for the three stations in the HMG and Veronica group, the broadcaster is planning a three-fold attack on the Dutch radio market.

"We start with Hitradio Veronica—a young and brash pop station targeting 13-35 year olds. In October RTL Rock Radio will be transformed into Kink FM, an alternative rock format targeting 20-40 year olds. Finally, we will be going on air with news/talk station Nieuwsradio 1395 later this year."

DJ personality will be a vital element in Hitradio, which seems fitting for a broadcaster with Veronica's strongly independent image. "Our format is basically EHR, but the playlist very much bears the signature of our DJs," says Glorie, who aims to make Hitradio into Holland's most personality-based station.

A single Veronica group image is unlikely, says Glorie, who

emphasises that Hitradio will be creating its own image and listener expectations, separate from its TV counterpart.

However, resources will be opened up through corporate syn-

ergies with partners in holding company Holland Media Group (HMG). Kink FM will replace HMG partner RTL's Rock Radio nationwide on cable, for example, while Hitradio will be marketing its advertising time through the group's sales house IP.

With the stations in place, the main concern for Glorie is to ensure that contents and sound quality are optimal. With technical and musical limitations, this is going to be a challenge. But one he is willingly prepared to face.

All three stations are limited to cable and AM frequencies. While the news station will not suffer from being available only on mono, an EHR output in particular will be at a disadvantage. "We will continue to fight for an FM frequency," says Glorie.

Meanwhile, a musical obligation to play 50% Dutch language music

poses another limitation which has been easier to circumvent. "Between 06:00 and 20:00 we stick to the Veronica mix of international hits and brash presentation," says Glorie. "From 20:00 onwards we increase the share of Dutch language songs to fulfill the quota for the day."

HMG: Holland's Largest Single TV, Radio Operation

Veronica's new mother company HMG became a legal entity on September 1, and is the largest commercial television and radio network to come into being in Holland.

Negotiations were in progress for some six months before a deal was struck between backers Veronica, pan-European broadcasting company CLT, giant Dutch publisher VNU, and independent production company Endemol Entertainment.

On the television side, the agreement created a three-channel commercial network consisting of Veronica, Dutch commercial market leader RTL 4 and its sister channel RTL5. On the radio side it grouped together CLT-backed RTL Rock Radio and Veronica-owned

Hitradio Veronica, [formerly Endemol-owned Holland FM] to create Holland's largest radio operation.

But worries about the integration of the backers, some of Europe's most powerful players, ended with calls by Dutch legislators for an investigation. The question was whether Luxembourg-based HMG would create a powerful advertising and production cartel in Holland, cornering the market on rates and programming.

Late last spring the Dutch government asked the European Community to assess whether HMG was legal under European competition and anti-trust regulations.

A response came in July, saying

that the structure of HMG could be problematic. A hearing was held on August 7 in which HMG presented its case, but a final commission ruling on the matter is not due out until mid to late September.

Unico Glorie is adamant that "Whatever the outcome, Veronica's activities will not be affected." HMG, meanwhile, has publically stated that it will work with the Commission until it comes up with a solution which abides by EU regulations.

A spokesman for Endemol, one of the parties, has said that it is possible that HMG may be required to take additional partners in order to satisfy the commission's concerns.

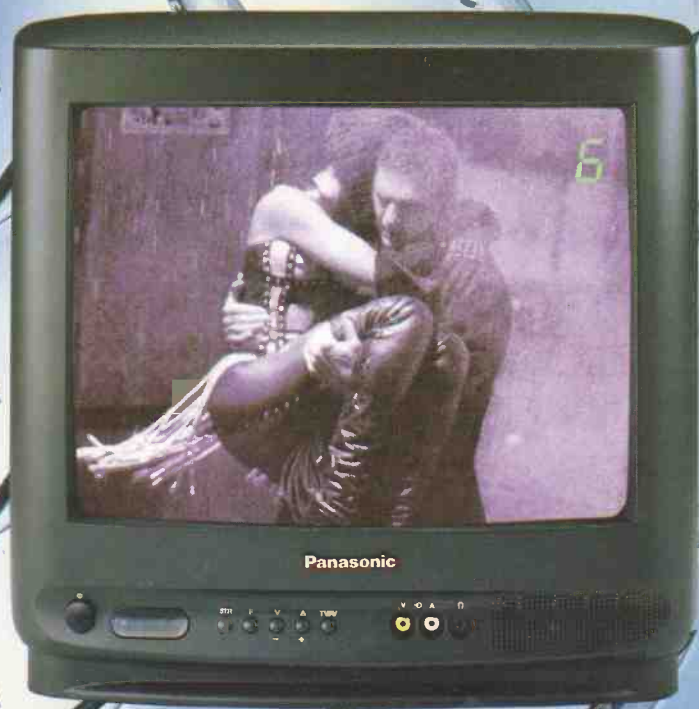

Breakin' & Entering

A weekly Eurochart analysis by Ramon Dahmen

After Scatman John, **Michael Jackson** is the second top act in a short period of time to snatch both Sales Breaker Awards in the same week.

With his single *You Are Not Alone* (Epic) appearing for the second week in the chart, Jackson climbs up 41 notches to number 5 in the Eurochart Hot 100. For the moment the song—written by R. Kelly and not Jackson himself—is selling in 10 territories with the following chart positions; Denmark number 4, Finland 10, France 15, Germany 41, Ireland 9, Holland 13, Norway 15, Sweden 33, Switzerland 7 and in the UK at number 3.

His double platinum album *History - Past Present & Future Book 1* (Epic) strengthens its hold on the number 2 slot and is approaching the three million sales mark across Europe. The double album is still climbing in six national charts out of the total 16 countries that contribute to the European Top 100. With such a strong following, the album is becoming a serious threat to **Bon Jovi's** *These Days* (Mercury) which loses its bullet and drops in the charts in eight of the 16 countries where it's currently listed.

Four positions further down the chart, we find one of the most successful German rockbands

Pur with its latest effort *Abenteuerland* (Intercord). Having sold more than 800,000 copies of the previous album *Pur Live*—most of these in German-speaking territories—the rockers now start a seven-month tour on September 26 to support the new release. The band's former European chart entries, apart from *Pur Live*, include the album *Seiltänzertraum* which stayed in the chart for 75 weeks from 1993-1995 (issue 9) peaking at number 13 and the single *Ich Lieb' Dich (Egal Wie Das Klingt)*, which had a seven-week Eurochart history and a peak position of number 60. The Dieter Falk-produced album is currently charting in Switzerland (no. 4) and Germany (no. 1) with Austria left to follow suit.

Meanwhile, entering the chart at number 13 is Irish teen act **Boyzone** with its debut album *Said And Done* (Polydor). With single successes like *Working My Way Back To You, Love Me For A Reason, Key To My Life* and *So Good*, the fivesome has proved to be a fruitful source of hits. The album—produced by Take That writer Ray Hedges—contains 11 original songs and two covers. The Dubliners presently appear in charts in three countries including Ireland (no. 1), Holland (96) and the UK (3).



Station Reports include all new additions to the playlist. Some reports will also include "Power Play" songs, which receive special emphasis during the week. All Power Play songs are printed, whether they are reported for the first time or not. Some lists include featured new albums, as indicated by the abbreviation "AL." Within each country, stations are grouped by ranking and listed alphabetically. Rankings include: Platinum (P), Gold (G), Silver (S) and Bronze (B). All playlists must be received by Monday at 13.00 h CET.

UK Sales Up 13%, Says BPI

by Chris Marlowe

LONDON - UK record sales continued to rise in the second quarter this year with a climb of 13%, according to figures released by the BPI.

Album unit sales rose by 17%, thanks to strong releases by major artists such as Michael Jackson, Wet Wet Wet, Take That, Bon Jovi and Pink Floyd.

The overall best-selling release, however, was the latest in the highly successful compilation series *Now 30*. All three formats showed unit growth, but discounts on cassettes and vinyl meant that the CD, now at almost 70 percent of the market, was the only for-

mat to enjoy an increase in value.

Singles sales rose by nearly 15%, thanks mainly to Robson Green & Jerome Flynn's ver-

sion of the classic *Unchained Melody*. A 53% rise in CD singles, meanwhile, balanced out poor sales of 7 inch sales—which dropped by 4%.

The station acts as a forum for jazz, folk, classical and experimental music and the announcement goes on to say that SR's board must consider the long-term implications of a reduction in services for Swedish music.

Since the '30s the company has documented all forms of Swedish music and has in its archives a goldmine of different styles and genres.

Employees of P2 have launched their own campaign against the cuts. Many freelancers have also warned that, without P2 acting as a free-

lance employer, many musicians would be forced to give up.

Sveriges Radio has been forced to make savings of 11% following a tough austerity budget by the country's Social Democratic government. The board will make its final decision on the scale of P2's cutbacks in early September.

The cuts come at a difficult time for P2, which is attempting to define its role in the face of competition from commercial classic stations, two of which are now operating in Stockholm. Both UK-owned Classic FM and Swedish-owned Classic Radio say they are aiming for a different audience group with their popular classical formats.

"The least I would expect from a government eager to protect French music through quotas, is support for the only service entirely dedicated to French music," says Bellanger. "And support for its plans to

become nationally available. We need frequencies to develop."

Chante France was launched in 1994 inspired by Radio Italia solo Musica Italiana. It reached a 1.4% audience in Paris according to the most recent Médiamétrie ratings.

The station will retain its broad EHR format, but the details of its programming will be similar to that of Radio Energy Stockholm.

"We hope that NRJ's involvement in our company will bring us additional know-how and allow us to participate in international cooperation agreements," says Harri Hämäläinen, MD of majority shareholding company Musiikkikersantti. Musiikkikersantti holds 66% of Capitec.

"Other media companies, both Finnish and international, have also expressed interest in acquiring shares in our company, but we felt NRJ was our

best choice," he adds.

Foreign involvement in the Finnish commercial media market has been increasing steadily over the past two years or so. Last year, three international media groups acquired interests in Finland—Swedish giant Kinnevik, the Nordic media holding Scandinavian Broadcasting Systems (SBS) and the American United International Holdings.

SBS was the first to take a stake in the Finnish commercial radio market last autumn; it now owns Turku-based Radio Sata (Radio 100), one third of Tampere's Radio 957, it has a 50% interest in Helsinki's Radio City and holds a third of the shares in Kiss FM.

Interestingly, both Millet and Lemaire worked previously with Fun.

Epic France Takes On BMG's Barret

We hear that Epic France will be taking on Stéphane Barret, former marketing and promotion director of BMG's Ariola label in France, who was let go by BMG before the summer as part of a global restructuring of the company.

Hauville Leaves Nova

Eric Hauville, founder of RVS, has left Paris-based station Radio Nova, where he was scheduling director. Hauville, who will remain advisor to the station's president Jean-François Bizot, is believed to be moving into record production.

Veronica Mega Top 50 Deal Angers TROS

In the same week that it went commercial (see special supplement), Veronica has surprised the industry by signing a deal to broadcast the Mega Top 50 chart on Hitradio Veronica. Presented by Gijs Staverman, the Mega Top 50, one of Holland's two existing sales charts, will be broadcast on Saturdays from 15:00-18:00. The move has angered pubcaster TROS, which claims to have an exclusive agreement with the Mega Top 50 foundation. TROS is considering legal steps against the foundation and broadcasts of the chart on TV and radio has been stopped. Mega Top 50 MD Sieb Kroeske, however, denies any exclusivity. "We negotiate with a lot of stations and have always intended the broadest possible exposure for our charts. The TROS has always known this."

Government Agrees Sales House Merge

PARIS - Competition within the French radio industry is likely to change radically following the merger of Europe 1's and RMC's sales houses, which has been given the go-ahead by French government.

In a letter dated August 25, the French ministry of finance gave its blessing to the merger

of the two sales houses, declaring that the newly created structure "is not bound to affect competition."

The decision came as a relief to the managements of both Europe 1 and RMC, who viewed the merger as a way to counter arch rival IP and to offer a wider scope of radio services and demographics to advertisers.

Once completed, the move will create Euro GEM, the most powerful sales house in France, with a market share of 46% of the total radio market—ahead of current leader IP, with 43%.

Europe 1 sales house Europe Régie, which has a 30% market share, sells ad space for full-service Europe 1, ACE Europe 2, EHR Skyrock, ACE RFM and the group of indepen-

dent stations Les Indépendants. RMC's sales house GEM, meanwhile, sells for full-service RMC, ACE Nostalgie and Radio Montmartre.

IP (which sells for RTL, Fun Radio, RTL2, Sud Radio) and NRJ (NRJ, Chérie FM, Rires) have strongly voiced their opposition to the merger, which comes just as the government is about to privatise RMC.

Simply Red's new single *Fairground* has been given a very warm welcome by European Hit Radio this week. Its high-calibre, 39-station roster includes no less than 31 new additions, which not only earn it the status of this week's **Most Added**

leader by far, but also catapult it to the 14th position of the **EHR Top 40**—the highest new entry of the week. This is the sixth EHR hit for **Mick Hucknall's** band since the chart was launched in December 1990. Their last one was 1992's *Your Mirror*, but their biggest success on the format was 1991's *Something Got Me Started*, which topped the chart for four consecutive weeks.

The new single, produced by Hucknall and Simply Red's regular producer **Stewart Levine**, serves as the taster for the band's fifth album *Life* (due for release on October 9)—their first to be issued in four years. *Fairground* is already playlisted in 14 European countries, while getting the best penetration figures in Austria, Switzerland and Ireland (75-100%). The UK, Germany, Spain, Denmark and Greece are next in line (33-41%), whereas Italy, Sweden, Belgium, Finland and Poland are well on the way with as yet less spectacular, but nonetheless significant figures.

Michael Jackson takes home the **Radio Active** award for the second consecutive time this week, as *You Are Not Alone* cracks the top 3 with 95 reporters by its side, including 22 first-timers. The ballad is getting spins in no fewer than 24 territories, the UK, Ireland and Switzerland being most supportive, with penetration ratios ranging between 82 and 100%. Italy, Holland, Denmark and Norway are next in line (67-75%).

Sister **Janet**, in the meantime, snatches the second highest new entry in the chart, as *Runaway* starts at number 25, boosted by 41 EHR stations (including 13 adds), spread out over 12 countries. The UK leads the way with a 76% acceptance level and is followed most closely by Sweden and Switzerland (50% each). On a major market level, the R&B songstress is already number 20 in Scandinavia (see **Major Market Airplay**, page 19).

On The Road

Border Breakers commentary by Pieter Kops



Caught In The Act

Half Dutch/half British quartet **Caught In The Act** enters the **Border Breakers** chart at number 23 with *Let This Love Begin*, a sultry ballad, produced and co-written by **Steve Mac**. It is the third single to be taken from the group's debut album *Caught In The Act Of Love* and the follow-up to the **Rick Astley** cover *My Arms Keep Missing You*, which charted for eight weeks earlier this year (with a peak at number 14).

The new single by the **HKM**-signed teen act has accumulated an 11-station roster, as it crosses over to four territories outside home base Benelux. Especially in Germany, *Let This Love Begin* meets with good initial radio support. In that country, five reporters are having it in rotation this week, including four new additions. These are heavyweights such as EHR outlet **Orb/Fritz/Potsdam**, ACE-formatted **Radio NRW/Oberhausen** and **Hundert 6/Berlin**, as well as national music station **Berlin 88.8**, also in Berlin. Key dance broadcaster **Hit Radio N 1/Nuremberg** has already been championing the track since it was a powerplay record at the station three weeks ago. Denmark is next in line with three stations (all adds), including Gold-ranked EHR's **Radio ABC/Randers** and **Radio Viborg/Viborg**. Austria and the Czech Republic complete the list with one station each—in Austria, public national EHR outlet **Ö 3/Vienna** has joined the club, whereas **Radio Dragon/Karlovy Vary** does the same in the Czech Republic. A detailed story on *Caught In The Act* appeared in *Music & Media's* August 26 issue.

Also entering this week is *Carnival* by 'alternative' easy listening act the **Cardigans**, from Sweden. The soothing and enchanting pop song—also the opening track from their album *Life*—enters at number 24, thanks to a nine-station roster. The best foreign support for the **Trampoline/Stockholm** act comes from Germany and Poland, both committed with four stations. In Belgium, Platinum-ranked public **BRTN Studio Brussel/Brussels** also pioneers the track.

The charts on this page track the border-crossing movement of product. The **Border Breakers** chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their country of signing (airplay achieved in the original country is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, **Channel Crossovers**, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the **Atlantic Crossover** chart, ranks the most successful Non-European artists according to airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Country Of Signing" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M wants to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.

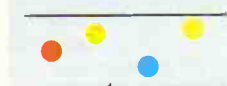

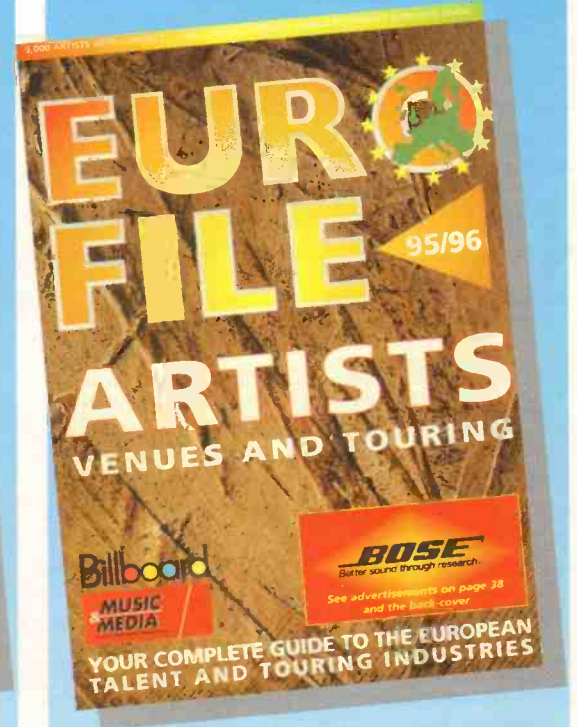
