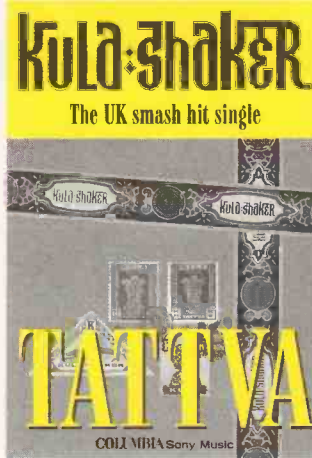

Sony Builds New Image For Epic, Columbia

FRANKFURT - Building a stronger local roster and providing better targeted services to retail and media. These are the main motives behind Sony Music Germany transforming its Columbia and Epic labels into separate divisions.

The move, effective August 1, brings the German company in line with the UK, France, Holland, Italy and Spain where Epic and Columbia are already operating as stand-alone units.

Sony Music deputy MD Hubert Wandjo has been appointed as MD of the new Columbia company while his counterpart at Epic is Jörg Hacker. Both will report to

senior vice president GSA Jochen Leuschner.

The driving force behind the split is a changed domestic market where artists and producers are exercising more control over the recording and marketing process. "The German music market has become more transparent," explains Leuschner. "Producers and artist managers have a much clearer idea of what the individuals behind different labels stand for. It is vital for us to be an attractive business partner to the creative forces in the market."

A large number of parallel

trends in the music market call for small, specialised units. The split into Epic and Columbia gives Sony space to profile key staff members as competent partners to handle specific music genres. "Our aim is to put the person into the foreground," says Leuschner. "Artists will know exactly whom they deal with in our new structure."

Sony Music's step towards the artists is

accompanied by stricter quality control measures. "The number of releases has never been higher than today," observes Leuschner. "The market will not be able to handle this amount of product for an indefinite period." In the long run, Leuschner intends to curb release levels and sees the label split as a step in the right direction. "The split brings us, as a major, back to the pioneering days of the record business," muses Leuschner, "a small number of label professionals dealing intensively with a handful of artists."

From August onwards, Epic and Columbia stand in direct competition with each other. Following the integration of Dancepool into the Columbia division, Epic announced the launch of its own dance label, Epidrome, which will be headed by Bela Cox, formerly head of A&R at Logic Records.

Swedish Sales Fall By 20%

STOCKHOLM - Record sales in Sweden fell by a dramatic 20.8% in the first half of 1996 compared with the same period last year.

Skr565 million (app. US\$90 million) worth of CDs, cassettes and vinyl were sold in the first half of this year, compared with sales worth Skr 713 million in 1995. Sources within the industry say the situation is worsening, with the decline during June even greater. Calle Isakson, sales manager at BMG Records, says his company has seen sales fall by some 15% this year.

Campaign and Producer of the Year.

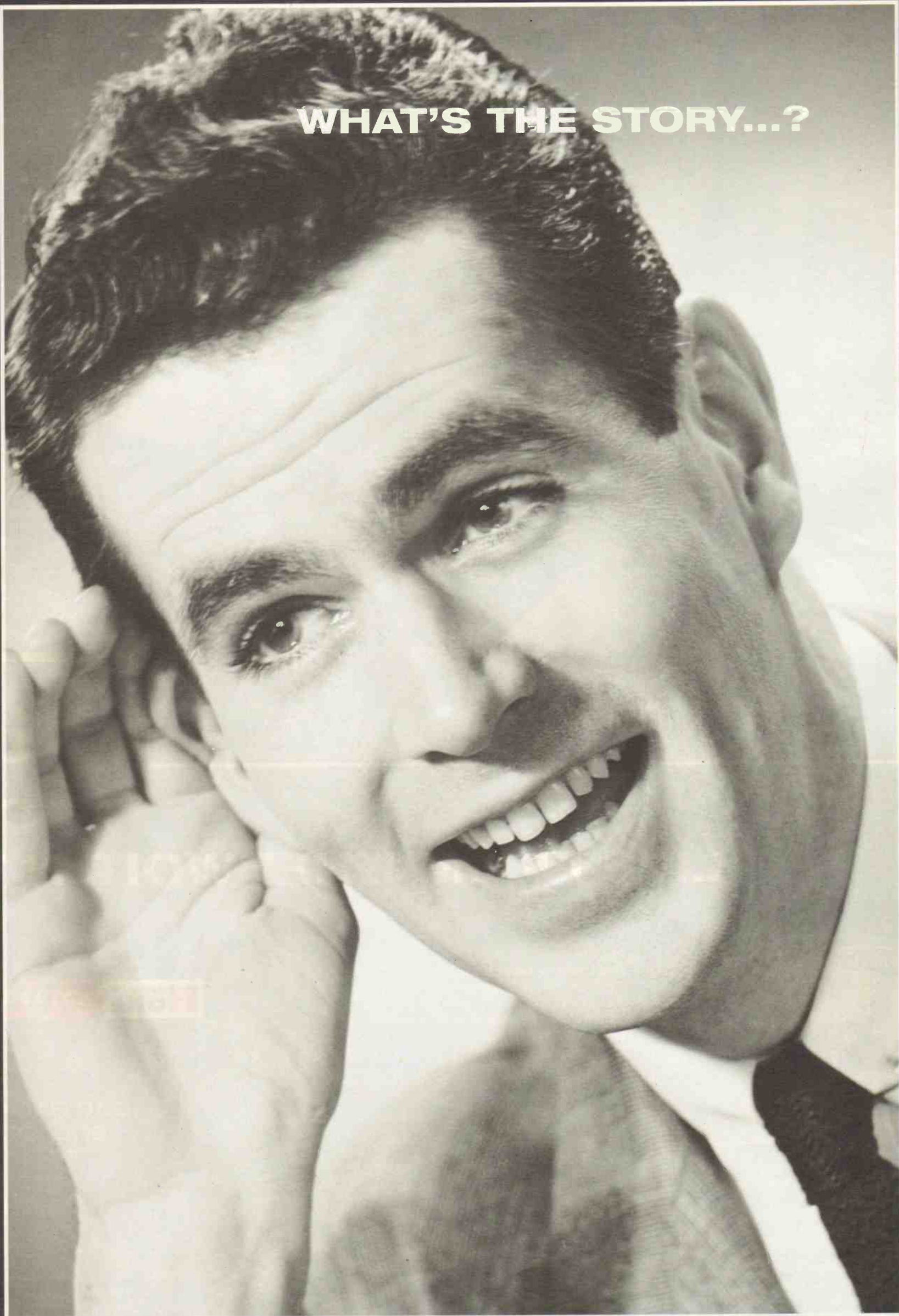

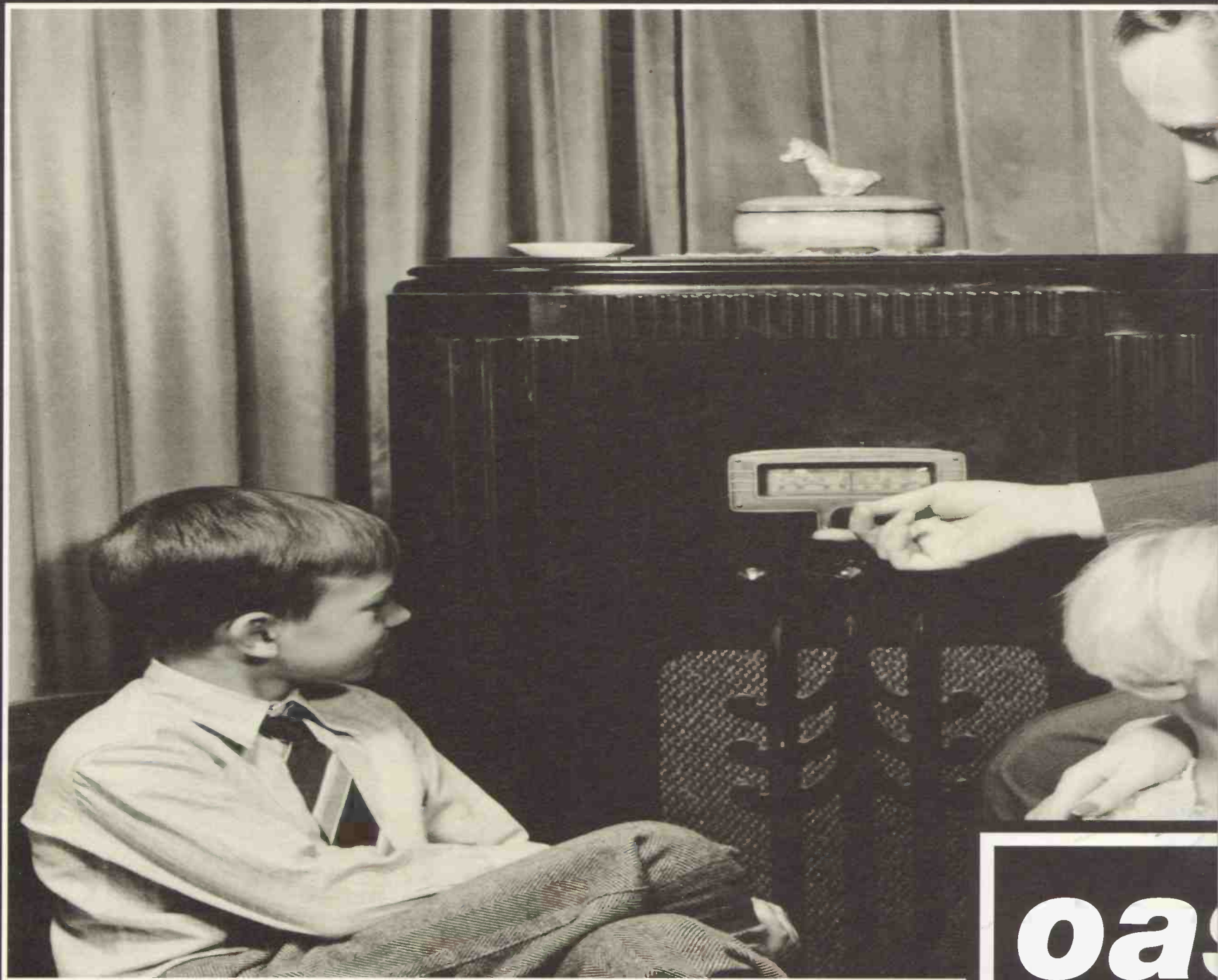

Variety Is The Spice Of Life

Between The Lines

It's heartening to see German music TV station Viva acknowledge the influence of radio. In their newly styled Comet Prizes, there's space reserved for the best Radio Show of the Year and although it's only one out of a total of 20 awards, radio has found its deserved niche. The category Station of the Year has been scrapped in favour of a programme related award as the organisers felt there has not been a significant new station launch in the German market.

Very true indeed, Europe's largest record market does not yet breed new radio formats. To hear new styles of

music one has to tune in to specific programming slots, mostly with the nation's pubcasters; finding around-the-clock programming of anything that's not of an EHR or ACE slant can be difficult. The recently published ratings figures of the Medienanalyse (Music & Media, June 15) clearly demonstrate German radio's conservative nature. Out of the top 20 German stations, ranked by millions of listeners per hour, there's not one with an alternative music format. No rock, no dance, nothing. In fact, the German radio market operates three basic music formats: national music, ACE (including MOR/ACE hybrids) and good old EHR.

Although the UK market, in particular the London region, is also criticised for not offering enough variety with (commercial) top London players like Virgin, Heart FM and Capital showing much programming overlap, it's a far cry from Germany's situation. At least the Brits have a rock-slanted station (Virgin), a pubcaster who tries to be different (Radio 1), and all hopes are pinned on an "indie" format winning the race for the last available London-wide FM radio licence.

It's also telling that of the five radio-related Comet awards only one deals with music (HR 3's Club Night). This should change. If Viva wants, as its says, "to emphasise our role as a partner for the music industry," the definition of music radio should be clarified. The record industry is not directly served by comedy and talk show prizes. The Comet radio awards should identify more stations and shows that programme non-mainstream music. These stations should then be put firmly in the spotlight with all the publicity that such prizes usually attract. This would facilitate the interaction between labels and music radio, and bring Viva even closer to the music community.

Italian Radio Advertising Boom Forecast To Continue

ROME - Italy's radio sector can expect the current radio advertising boom to continue, according to the country's advertising industry.

Felice Lioy, director general of Italy's advertising agencies association UPA says that radio revenue grew by 25% last year and can be expected to grow at the same rate this year. "Indications for 1996 show that the radio advertising boom is sustaining, with exponential growth continuing," says Lioy.

Lioy is also president of Audiradio, the official radio survey sponsored by the advertising industry, public service Radio RAI, Italy's 15 national private networks and 400 of the country's 2,000 local radio stations. The latest results from Audiradio covering the second quarter of this year show total radio listening approaching the 40 million mark on an average daily listening basis. "Radio advertising growth is comparable with the private TV advertising boom here in the early-mid '80s" says Lioy. He notes that "The principle reason for radio's new found popularity with advertisers is its steady audience growth in the past few years. That combined with Audiradio supplying reliable listening statistics on a regular basis, advertisers now have

an accurate tool for measuring not just daily listening, but also the demographic characteristics of listeners, and the spread of listening throughout the day."

According to statistics compiled by market research company Nielsen, the total radio advertising spend in 1995 reached 400 billion lire (app. US\$263.2 million) in 1995, just under 4.5% of the total advertising spend in Italy. Public service broadcaster RAI's three radio networks accounted for 139.7 billion lire last year, an increase of 26.1% from 1994, whilst private stations billed 260.3 billion lire.

However, radio consultant

Andrea Rivetta says that the boom is benefiting only the principle national and regional networks, "Only public service network RAI, the top national networks and the top one or two local stations in each region are really profitable" said Rivetta. The turnover for Italy's leading private network Radio DeeJay reached US\$18 million last year compared with just US\$3.2 million in 1991. Revenue for Alberto Hazan's two national networks Radio 105 and Radio Montecarlo last year reached US\$24 million, up from US\$21.5 million in 1994.

Summer Stations Swap Shows

BRUSSELS - Under the banner "Le soleil sur la radio" (The sun on the radio), RTBF full service channel Bruxelles Capitale, has opened its airwaves to "sunny" stations.

The public station has invited a number of private and public stations in holiday resorts all over the world to submit sample programmes. "The idea was to have a daily programme between 19.00 and 20.00 hrs, five days a week, produced by our colleagues abroad, to underline the holiday feeling on our station" explains Bruxelles Capitale station manager Marc Vossen. "We've specifically asked stations to send us original material as it's broadcast in the country of origin, including commercials and announcements."

Stations including RNE's Radio 3 (Madrid), the Los 40 Principales Network, Radio France International (Dakar), Radio France Outremer (Ile de

Réunion-St. Denis) and Portugal's RDP-Antena 1 have each sent five one hour shows to Brussels. "We still expect reactions from Italy before the end of the holiday" says Vossen, "and in a next phase we'll think about inviting perhaps a Flemish station as well."

The idea to transmit programmes abroad was well received with Cadena SER in Spain, where international communications manager Elena Puech asked partner network Los 40 Principales to provide the programmes. "What we appreciated is that the Belgian station wanted exactly what we broadcast in Barcelona" explains Los 40 Principales Barcelona MD José Luis Marti.

Marti believes there are certain parallels between the cities of Brussels and Barcelona. "Young Europeans have a lot in common and urban stations undoubtedly have a role to play—musical tastes may differ but the approach is very simi-

lar." Programmes supplied by Los 40 Principales include a 50/50 mix of Anglo-American hits and Spanish pop. Marti notes that Los 40 Principales is targeting the 14-22 age group—distinctly younger than Bruxelles Capitale's audience, but according to Vossen, the "holiday atmosphere is younger anyway". The station has asked Marti to send five more hours for use in its programmes.

Budget Boost For P2

Sveriges Radio's national classical channel P2 has received a seven million kronor (app. US\$95,000) boost to its 1997 budget to maintain its coverage of classical, folk and jazz music. The channel's budget had been affected by government-ordered 11% budget cuts for the entire Sveriges Radio concern in recent years. P2 chief Christina Mattson has conducted a long campaign for financial relief for the channel, which she says has been hardest hit by the cuts. She is quick to point out that the decision does not mean any new funds for P2, merely a cut in previously-decided cuts.

Radio 3 Delights In 'Plaisier' Plaisier! is the name of a new

NCRV pop programme on Dutch pubcaster Radio 3FM to debut on September 2. Presented by Peter Plaisier, the two hour weekday show will represent a mixture of music, news, games and entertainment. Targeted at the 12-35 age group, Plaisier!

will also feature the ITV top 3, based on listeners' most popular current records, sent in by Internet or phone. On Fridays, from 14:00-18:00, Plaisier will host the first half of the interactive Top 50 with NPS presenter Corné Klijn presenting the last two hours. On Thursdays and Fridays, Plaisier also presents the one-hour evening Paperclip programme.

UNITED KINGDOM

BBC To Launch Asian Station

The BBC is to launch its first ever full-time Asian language radio station. The service will broadcast 18 hours a day on the AM frequencies of BBC Radio WM/Birmingham and BBC Radio Leicester, which will both become FM-only stations. The move, however, has upset the owners of two commercial radio services aimed at the Asian population, Birmingham's Radio XL and Leicester's Sunrise Radio, who argue that a dedicated BBC station aimed at the Midlands' Asian population was not in the BBC's publically stated plans when they originally applied to the Radio Authority for their licences.

Karaoke Royalties Agreed

Lyricists and composers are to get back royalties for works used on karaoke machines thanks to a temporary agreement reached by the Association Of Musical Electronics

Industry. This deal, which is estimated to cost AOMEI members £58 million covers commercial use of songs up until September 1995. A permanent deal is planned to cover home karaoke use.

DENMARK

Ministry Rejects Performing Rights Agreement

Denmark's Ministry of Culture has rejected a performing rights agreement that went into effect from January 1. The agreement was between KODA, the organization that administrates performing rights and FAEM, the council for broadcast media, but the ministry said the agreement was not favorable to smaller radio operators in urban areas. It wants a ceiling on rate hikes and better assurances for stations that broadcast fewer than 2,000 hours annually. FAEM said that it expects an adjustment to the agreement to be finalised in September.

Capital Go For Comic Touch

LONDON - Capital Radio has hired a stand-up comedian to help boost ratings at its oldies outlet 1548 AM Capital Gold.

Mike Osman, who has been presenting some trial shows at Capital's South Coast Radio/Fareham, has been signed up to host the Capital Gold mid-morning show from September 9. The programme will have its own specialist production team and will feature comedy/personality presentation alongside Capital Gold's usual mix of "classic golden hits" from the '60s, '70s and '80s. Osman will also present a Saturday morning show which will feature football-orientated comedy as an appetizer for the station's Saturday afternoon football coverage.

Group programme controller Clive Dickens denies, however, that there has been a major change of programming strategy at the gold station. "When some of our longest-established personalities departed last year, it was assumed that we were moving towards a music-orientated

policy. In fact, it was the end of an era—we had merely come to the end of a highly successful working relationship with those personalities. We have never decided to dispense with personality presentation."

Dickens also scotches rumours that, with the recruitment of Osman and the recent signing of "shock jock" Caesar The Geezer, Capital is starting to put into practice plans for the kind of service it would run on 1548 AM should the Radio Authority permit the transfer of Capital Gold to FM (Music & Media, July 20). He does confirm that the company has developed "some interesting and radical [programming] ideas for the future."

Capital has also announced that it has signed Key 103/Manchester breakfast presenter Steve Penk for its 95.8 FM London service. Penk, who was voted local/regional broadcaster of the year in this year's Sony Radio Awards, will carry on hosting the breakfast show at Key 103 until his contract expires next summer, although he is expected to start presenting a weekend show for Capital

FM shortly. Capital has emphatically denied, however, that Penk is being lined-up as a replacement for star breakfast show presenter Chris Tarrant.

Radio Montecarlo Resumes Broadcasts

MILAN - Radio Montecarlo Italy has resumed full programming on its Italian FM network from their Milan studio.

This comes five days after being shut out of their Monaco base for failing to pay long-standing debts estimated at over US\$1 million, to the French RMC Group (Music & Media, July 27). Jingles and station idents have been changed to "RMC - Monte Carlo", as the French RMC Group own the "Radio Montecarlo" trademark. French programming from RMC is being rebroadcast on the Italian service's Monaco-based repeater.

The resumption of programming from Milan is a temporary measure whilst RMC Italy's Alberto Hazan attempts to transfer his licence from one which permits the relay of a foreign station (i.e. based in Monaco) to a normal domestic licence, or finds a buyer or partner to clear his debts to RMC France or renegotiate their contract.

Alberto Hazan, president of the 105 Group which owns RMC Italy and national EHR network Radio 105, is optimistic of resolving his dispute with RMC France and returning the station to its Monaco base in the near future. "Our problem is not one of liquidity, but of disagreement over our contract" says Hazan.

"Since 1992 when RMC France, shut down our AM relay we have been trying to renegotiate our contract. However, instead of reducing the charges to reflect the loss of the powerful AM signal, RMC France, because of their own large trading deficit and subsequent restructuring, wanted to increase our rental costs even more. This caused an impasse in the negotiations, and their rigid stance lead to them interrupt our operations from the Monte Carlo studios. However, we are still negotiating new terms which should see a resumption of a renewed collaboration between us and RMC France."

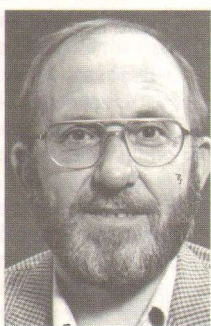

Face To Face With Europe's Newsmakers

WDR 2 music editor Adolf "Buddha" Krämer. News/Talk station WDR 2 produces *Olympiawelle*, a night time radio show featuring current updates from the Olympic Games in Atlanta. *Olympiawelle* is broadcast daily by 12 pubcasters in the German ARD network.

Q: What sort of music did you select for *Olympiawelle*?

A: *Olympiawelle*'s core audience are listeners over 35. The majority of the 12 stations prefer international pop music with strong melody content.



broadcast the whole show, music and all, straight from rented studio in Atlanta.

Q: How do you programme *Olympiawelle* in Atlanta?

A: On my laptop! We have put the 1,000 selected titles onto 90 CDs which I brought with me in a suitcase.

Q: Would it not be cheaper to add the music to WDR's *Olympia* reports at your Cologne headquarters?

A: For the whole ARD network it is actually cheaper when the whole show comes over the Atlantic as one signal. *Olympiawelle* is then transferred to the 12 stations via the Astra satellite.

Q: What rotation are WDR's *Olympia* tracks on?

A: The library of WDR 2's programming software Broadcast Commander includes 10,000 different titles. I selected roughly 1,000 titles for Atlanta. At a rate of eight titles per hour every song is played 1.4 times on the average.

Q: Are all titles on WDR's regular playlist during *Olympia* '96?

A: No, it's actually more complicated than that. We

Mercury Music Prize Shortlist Announced

LONDON - The official shortlist for the 1996 Mercury Music Prize has been announced.

Chair of the judging panel, professor and journalist Simon Frith, was suffering a temporary loss of voice, but senior music critic for *The Times* David Sinclair substituted for him at the press conference. Reading from Frith's remarks, Sinclair said, "If anyone still doubts that music is Britain's most creative

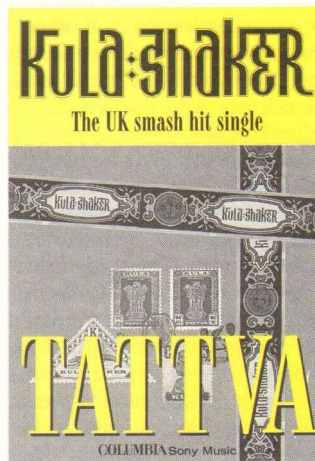
pride in the diversity of the shortlist.

There are significantly fewer debut releases this year, but more albums with proven commercial potential. Oasis, also nominated last year, is the odds-on favourite although Pulp, previously nominated in 1994, is thought to be second most likely to win. The relative merits of all ten are undoubtedly going to be compared right up until the winner is announced on September 10.

The Prize, open to contemporary artists from the UK and Ireland in any musical genre, is a prestigious award backed by extensive promotional activities and fully supported by both the British Phonographic Industry and the British Association Of Record Dealers. As evidenced by the surge of interest Portishead's debut *Dummy* (Go! Discs) enjoyed after winning last year, the Prize is an increasingly credible tool particularly for crossing artists over into the mainstream.

Nearly as important as winning is the national coverage every one of the ten shortlisted albums gets in the media. The sampler compilation will get widespread trade and retail distribution, and special themed promotions will be running in over 2,000 record retailers. The Mercury Music Prize itself carries with it a £25,000 (app. US\$40,000) endowment and is sponsored by the telecommunications company Mercury Communications.

Catalonia's Radio 4 Survives Threat

BARCELONA - New Radio Nacional de España (RNE) director Javier González Ferrari has travelled to Barcelona to promise that the Catalonia-only net Radio 4 will not be scrapped.

"Some changes will be necessary to strengthen the company, but for the time being we are going to celebrate the 20th anniversary of Radio 4, the leading network in Catalonia. Its continuation is guaranteed," says Gonzalez.

During the socialist administration, Radio 4 was closed down in Spain except in Catalonia, where it had become more securely rooted as a Catalan-language net. Gonzalez was in Barcelona to take part in the swearing in of RNE's new Catalonia director, Ramon Mateu Llevadot.

RNE's classical net Radio Clásica is broadcasting from all the major European classical music festivals this summer,

including the Salzburg, Bayreuth and Flanders festivals in Bruges and the London Proms, as well as a cycle of Olympic concerts from the Spivey Hall in Atlanta.

On July 28, Radio Clásica (formerly Radio 2) transmitted a concert of 'Suite de Atlántida' by Manuel de Falla from London's Royal Albert Hall, conducted by Spain's Rafael Fruhbeck.

College Radio Looks To Graduate

In the US, college radio is an enormously influential medium, which consistently helps to break new bands and new genres of music. Yet in Europe, there is virtually no college radio scene to speak of. But in Denmark and Germany, at least, there are signs that things could be about to change. Charles Ferro and Christian Lorenz report.

IN THE DANISH capital of Copenhagen, Universitetsradioen created its own radio format when it took the airwaves back in 1987. They billed it as "education radio," not to be confused with educational radio.

"The focus was on the world of education," says Michael Larsen, chairman of the non-profit making organisation behind the station. "It was unique in comparison to other stations, a new concept. Now there are four or five similar stations. I believe that we differ from US college radio in the sense that we broadcast more journalistic programmes, as opposed to mostly music." The success of U-Radio, as it is popularly known, has been used as a model for other university stations in Denmark.

U-Radio defines itself as a service for users of the University of Copenhagen. It offers a roughly 50/50 mix of music and talk. "We provide a service by broadcasting news about events, speakers, and other happenings either at the university or of interest to persons connected to the university," says Larsen. "Part of this includes adding depth to domestic or international stories from the media. We can take an item and provide a more in-depth analysis, or reflect its relevance to the university. We also conduct our own interviews with relevant people."

Shared Frequency

U-Radio broadcasts every weekday from 08:30-11:30, and again from 18:30-19:30. It shares the 95.5 FM frequency with a number of other stations in Copenhagen, including what could be described as its "sister station," Radio Energy. The two are independent of each other, but have common interests. Radio Energy is run by Denmark's technical college, and broadcasts eight hours a day, before and after U-Radio's morning programme, and just before U-Radio's evening show.

U-Radio has around 50 employees—all volunteers, all connected to the university and most of whom are pursuing media studies. The station gets its funding from the university itself, and from the Ministry of Culture's pool of money for non-profit making grass-roots radio. The station has around 15,000 listeners, although listener surveys are rarely done because of the costs involved. "We hope to extend our programming," says Larsen.

"We want to begin night broadcasts [from 00:00-02:00] this September. It will be the same 50/50 mix of music and talk."

Larsen is also U-Radio's head of music, and compiles the playlist, a top 20 chart, and a rotation list. Artists on the current playlist include Sleeper, Moloko, Beck, Pulp, Oasis and Metallica. There is no station rule for the amount of Danish music to be played, although three Danish tracks are in the station's current Top

20. "It was difficult to get music in the beginning, but the record companies have seen the potential in providing us with records," Larsen reports. "As a rule, we can get whatever we want, that is if it doesn't come in automatically by itself."

Sony promotion manager Marianne Søndergaard confirms this. "We send records to those [stations] who have a good target group. There's a good chance they will play what other stations won't play—essentially rock, a little bit harder than mainstream, but relevant to the target group. They may not have so many listeners, but they have the right listeners. They are very enthusiastic—that's

why they are so good to work with. Many of them put their heart and soul into their work."

More Stations

Within the past year, the universities in Aalborg, Odense and Aarhus have started up radio stations, using the U-Radio and Radio Energy formats as a model. The other main university centre, at Roskilde, has gathered information from the existing stations, and has talked about founding its own station. Says Larsen, "We [U-radio and Energy Radio] can see potential for expanding, which may be aided by the new media law. We would like to broadcast round-the-clock—we're growing in size and in people's consciousness."

In neighbouring Germany, the first generation of college radio stations will be launched later on this year in the state of Northrhine-Westphalia (NRW). After two years of negotiations, the SPD (Social

The regulations have been designed by the government to appease the state's commercial broadcasters. Conservative opposition party CDU voiced concern prior to the amendment that local radio would suffer economically from competition by university stations. However, the SPD (NRW's governing party) is confident that the allowance of commercial sponsorships to campus radio will be an effective compromise. The party is convinced that, in the long run, NRW's industry will show interest in supporting campus radio.

Educational Objectives

Apart from limiting financial resources and transmitter reach to protect the state's local broadcasters, NRW's media law is relatively vague about the issues surrounding student radio. There are no concrete programming regulations, for example. Explains Hildebrandt, "The only guideline is that all programming has to stand in a functional context with the educational objectives of the university running the station."

But the new campus stations in NRW are unlikely to serve as key promotional outlets for progressive pop and rock music. "Music can generally be part of campus radio," says Hildebrandt. "But programmes with a dominant music share are not desirable in our eyes, since they have no direct relevance to university activities."

Hildebrandt expects the first four-year licenses to be handed out in the autumn. "Initially, the licenses will allow universities to broadcast two to four hour test programmes each day. We want to give the universities a chance to organise their broadcasting activities and to develop programming experience." When the LfR and NRW's politicians are satisfied with the way campus radio develops in the trial phase, the licenses are likely to be extended. "Ultimately, 24 hour programming will be possible for campus radio," she predicts.

The campus radio project might take a back seat to local radio in NRW, but it is nevertheless a definite step on the way to a German college radio—although experiments in the past three years with university radio at Ilmenau technical college in Bavaria and the universities of Bochum (NRW), Leipzig (Saxony) and Münster (NRW) have yet to result in dedicated college stations.

To succeed in Germany, campus radio needs to distinguish itself clearly from local radio formats. But if campus radio finds the necessary sponsors and establishes the kind of programme autonomy which can accommodate creative concepts, it could become an important player in the radio landscape.

Massimo Di Cataldo: Good Image & Good Songs

MILAN - "Massimo il Buono" is how the Italian press has nicknamed Massimo Di Cataldo, the country's latest heart throb and singer/songwriter. This easy-going charmer is another star to have received a springboard start from the 1995 edition of the Sanremo Song Festival. His second album for Epic, *Anime*, released in Italy last spring, is getting a Europe wide July release. *Libres Como El Viento*, a Spanish version of the first album (*Siamo Nati Liberi*) was released in Spain last March.

The inspirational title of his first album indicates one of the principle qualities that has appealed to his wide fan base of both teenagers and adults. Rome-based EHR network Radio Dimensione Suone music director **Carlo Mancini** says that the parallel rise to fame of another Italian teen idol, Gianluca Grignani has in fact enhanced Di Cataldo's profile. "Grignani is Di Cataldo's opposite, because he presents his fans a rebellious, hedonistic way of life with songs of fleeing and travelling. Di Cataldo has a more sentimental and optimistic approach" says Mancini.

Italian teenagers have their favourite, males usually preferring Grignani with females usually going for Massimo. This has created the sort of comparative promotional opportunity usefully exploited in the recent marketing battles between Take That/East 17 and

Oasis/Blur. Whilst Grignani won the first round last year in sales terms, Di Cataldo has so far been more successful in consolidating his career with constant touring and TV appearances. *Anime* has so far sold double platinum (200,000 copies). Epic Italy MD **Massimo Bonelli**

says that Di Cataldo's clean cut positive image appeals to both young girls and their mothers. "At his concerts about 60% of the crowd are young girls between 15 and 24, the rest are young guys and adults. Massimo and his team have put a lot of effort into creating an exciting live show," he says, emphasising the importance of his live appearances in expanding his fan base. "The shows have

been consistently well attended and many doubters [boyfriends] have left his shows converted. His simplicity is very appealing, he's very down to earth and natural," adds Bonelli.

Di Cataldo will be taking his striking friendly face with curly locks and designer stubble not just around Europe but also to America and Asia. Epic Italy international promotion director **Enrico Nuti** says that after his Italian summer tour, Di Cataldo will embark on a lengthy international promotion schedule. "The Spanish version of the first album is now being released in Latin America and the US, whilst *Anime* is being released in Europe and South East Asia." Di Cataldo will play four showcases in Zurich, Amsterdam, Brussels and Paris in October before going to South America in December.

He did a promotional swing through Spain where he guested on a series of syndicated TV shows and radio interviews. He also appeared on a national talk show and guested in front of a 14,000 strong crowd for a live concert sponsored by Spanish language music national network Cadena Dial. Epic Spain assistant international repertoire director **Joanna Haslinghuis** said that the 6,500 sales of *Libres Como El Viento*

is a respectable figure. "The album came out last March and we are still working it before Massimo records a Spanish version of his second album. Its sales are good for the first release of an international artist here. He already has his own fan clubs in Madrid and Barcelona, which is a very promising base from which to expand his popularity. We have received very strong promotional support with the TV, radio and concert appearances in the past few months."

Meanwhile back in Italy, radio is ready for *Qualunquesia*, the fourth single of the second album. Carlo Mancini will definitely play it. "Di Cataldo is a very important artist for us: his songs are melodic and his friendly image appeals to a wide audience. All of the singles from the new album have received high rotation and we are moving on the new single next week."

The debut single for Europe-wide release next September is the title track of his second album *Anime* and Massimo Bonelli says the song's light samba rhythm could merit a special duet version to help introduce non-Italians to Massimo Di Cataldo and his music. "Anime demonstrates the depth of Massimo's songwriting and lyrics. To maximise his initial acceptance with European audiences we are working on a duet version with a well known international [but as yet unconfirmed] artist."

Girl Groups Reach Way Beyond Boy Fans

They have both achieved a great sales base in Japan and they both challenge the strong command of male teen idol pop acts—*Spice Girls* and *Shampoo*. Is Europe ready for the new wave of girl groups? *Thessa Mooij* and *Chris Marlowe* report.

AMSTERDAM - The energetic raps and sweet harmonies of the Spice Girls' first single *Wannabe* (Virgin) have propelled it to the number one spot in the UK singles chart, challenging the persistent domination by boy groups. Europe is getting ready to succumb to the sassy Spice Girls. At presstime, *Wannabe* is a Sales Breaker in the Eurochart Hot 100

Singles chart at number 7 and a new entry in the EHR Top 40 at number 32.

But whereas boy groups have a clearly defined, teenage female audience, Spice Girls' appeal is not specifically aimed at young males. As Virgin international marketing manager **Bart Cools** explains, "It's not yet clear to us who buys the single.

We're aiming at the pop market in general." Head of international marketing **Lorraine Barry** adds that, "They're not strictly a teen act. They all have different personalities, but they blend together well. They have already finished recording an album, which will include some really sophisticated ballads as well. The glossy life style magazines are already interested in them."

Barry has more than one reason to delight in the girls' success. "Spice Girls and Kavana broaden the perception of Virgin. It's wonderful for two debut pop acts to prove themselves, after a few years of not having young acts. Last September, the Spice Girls presented *Wannabe* at our conference, which generated a global interest in them." She sees the current number 1 spot in the UK chart as a sign of things to come in Europe. "The UK chart structure makes it easier for new releases to go straight to number 1, but that doesn't mean Europe is behind."

A cute image and poppy melodies have always done well in Japan, where the all-girl quintet is number 2 in the Orcon singles chart. According to Cools, the Japanese office is treating it as they would a domestic release. As a result, they have done an extensive promo trip during the last couple of months. "It was a good exercise for their August promo trip to Germany, Spain and the Benelux," he says. Prior to the release of the second single *Say You'll Be There* in late September, the rest of Europe will follow.

LONDON - Nobody is forcing an image on Shampoo. Given that band members Jacqui and Carrie are self-proclaimed "girls with attitude", they probably wouldn't accept one anyway. EMI Music senior international marketing manager **Carol Baxter** remarks, "You can't really put an angle on them. In some places they're considered alternative, some see them as they're girls with attitude, for others they're straightforward pop." Her own approach is to present the two attractive young performers and let each territory go with what works for them.

Girl Power (Food/Parlophone) is the first single from *Shampoo Or Nothing*, and Baxter believes it will be mainly radio driven. "Its best marketing tool is that it's a great fun single," she says. Video is important, and she will be servicing the summer clubs, adding rhetorically, "It would sound pretty good by the beach, wouldn't it?"

Baxter is feeling the effects of the August industry doldrums, however. "This is the perfect time to get *Girl Power* out there—maybe not the perfect time to release an album though," she observes. Advertising and promotions will begin with teen-oriented media, but will continually bear in mind that both boys and girls like Shampoo.

Another single will be released in late August, just in front of the album. Baxter declines to specify any one of the three possibles under consideration. It will definitely not be *Don't Call Me Babe*, the song Shampoo contributed to the film "Barb Wire", however. "We're not aware that "Barb Wire" is going to be

particularly storming Europe," she explains. "We are keeping it for those territories that do feel they can use it, later on when the film comes out."



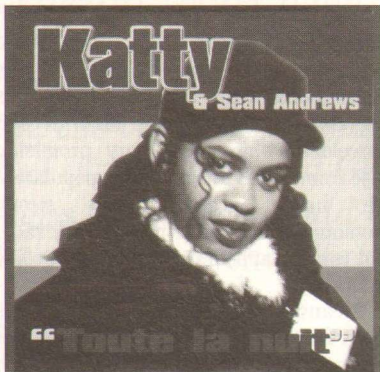

Similarly, Shampoo's first hit single *Trouble* was on the soundtrack to "Power Rangers" but the pop description of teenage misbehaviour achieved more success than the film did. Baxter can already tell that Shampoo's new release is destined for massive media coverage. She points out that this time out there's even more to talk about, thanks to massive Japanese and South East Asian sales. "Before it was mainly two girls from nowhere singing these great little pop songs." In the UK, there's even interest in the mere fact that the cute pop duo is still together. "I think people originally weren't sure they would be," Baxter admits. "But they're not going away, they've got another great pop song!"

Breakin' & Entering

A weekly Eurochart analysis by Ramon Dahmen

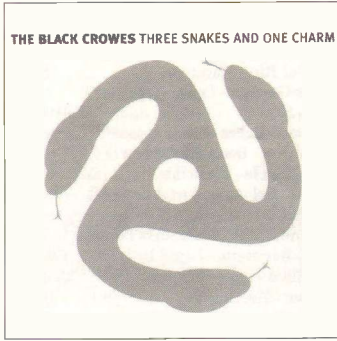
As the European record markets are still suffering from their annual attack of summer lethargy both the European Top 100 Albums as the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles remain more or less stable.

The Sales Breaker award in both countdowns are based on chart performances in the act's homecountry. On the singles front **Ocean Colour Scene's Moseley Shoals** (MCA) receive the award strictly on the basis of chart positions in Ireland (no.26) and the UK (2). At the album side **Worlds Apart** snatch the award with their top 10 hit in France (no.3) *Je Te Donne* (Arista).

The **Fugees** sustain their hat-trick for a third week, but lose their bullet for *The Score* (Columbia) in the album chart due to the loss of strength in three markets; Finland (no.2 > 3), Ireland (6 > 7) and Spain (21 > 27). With *Killing Me Softly* (this week double platinum) the band still reigns the countdowns in ten territories and positions in the top 10 of five others (see Top National Sellers).

This weeks highest newcomer is **Neneh Cherry's Woman** (Hut) with chart positions in Holland (no.42), Switzerland (26), The UK (11) and the Czech Republic (28). If we include the singer's collaborations, *Woman* is the tenth single to position in the Eurochart. Four singles have made it into the top 10. Except for the big solo hits *Buffalo Stance* in 1988 (peak 3) and 1989's *Manchild* (peak 4), she scored a top 2 hit in 1994 with *Seven Seconds* — a duet with **Yousou N'Dour**. In 1995 Cherry was part of the **Comic Relief** trio together with **Chrissy Hynde** and **Cher**, for the charity song *Love Can Build A Bridge* (peak 7).

Highest new entry in the Top 100 is the new **Black Crowes** album *Three Snakes And One Charm* (American) with chart positions in Finland (no.22), Germany (66) and the UK (37). The 12-song album — entirely written by Chris and Rich Robinson — is the rockband's fourth effort after *Shake Your Money Maker* (1991), *The Southern Harmony Companion* in 1992 (peak 14) and *America* in 1994 (peak 29).



The Spanish chart organisation AFYVE has decided to reduce the national singles chart from 20 to 5 positions. Therefore Music & Media's Top National Sellers page will list 5 singles and 15 albums.

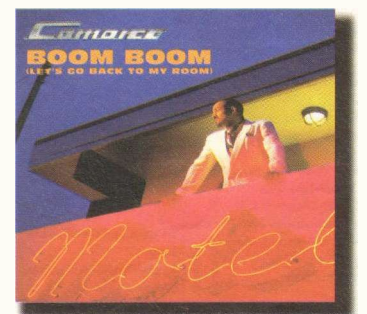

Radio 105 Defies Trend

MILAN - Radio 105 has defied the general downward trend for Italy's top 10 networks by showing continued growth in the latest Audiradio survey covering the second quarter of 1996.

Whilst all the top networks lost listeners, Milan based EHR network Radio 105 registered a 3.4% increase over first quarter results with 3.35 million average daily audience. Radio 105 station manager Guido Monti says the latest result consolidates an upward trend over the past 18 months. Since Monti's appointment as general manager at the end of

1994, Radio 105 has gained over 700,000 listeners on an average daily basis. "We have instigated a process of continuous evolution, and we are still working hard to target our young audience better," comments Monti.

The downturn for most of the other networks has largely been attributed to seasonal factors, with total average daily radio listening falling 2.6% to 33.8 million compared with the first quarter of this year. Notable for more sizeable downturns are public service news/talk network RAI Radio Uno. Since their switch from a

more generalist format to a rolling news network last April they have lost almost 400,000 listeners. National music formats also fared badly with Radio Italia SMI dropping over 5% and Radio Latte E Miele (Radio Milk & Honey) shedding almost 10% of their audience. Italy's newest network, Claudio Cecchetto's Radio Capital Music Network launched last January fell back even further from their disappointing opening figures. The network fell back 8.5% registering an average daily audience of 638,000 placing them 19th in the listening table.

In the spirit of Sony's new philosophy, Epidrome will compete with Dancepool for new signings and marketshare.

"Sony's labels never had to fight each other over a signing before," admits Leuschner. "But I am confident that sporting competition will be an incentive to our staff."

The label split represents a considerable investment in human resources. Sony Music Europe president Paul Russell is positive that the time is right to introduce the structural changes now. In a pre-prepared statement Russell declares that the label split, "allows for a much greater flexibility to meet the upcoming demands and developments we face together in the future."

Sony Music Germany employs 430 people and had a turnover of DM433 million in the 1995-96 financial year. According to estimates by German trade magazine *Musikmarkt*, over 1995 the company had a 13.7% share of the albums charts. Apart from Epic and Columbia, Sony Music Germany operates four other divisions:

- Sony Music Media: strategic marketing, classical repertoire and the Portrait label (formerly called Herzklang), headed by deputy MD Uwe S. Fendt
- Sales, headed by VP Herbert Krambo
- Finance, Operations & Administration: senior VP Peter Corbett
- Mambo, the independent label acquired by Sony in 1994, headed by Jürgen Thürnau.

"The Comet is an award for the industry as well as for the kids," explains Viva MD Dieter Gorny. "We have extended the original concept of the awards to emphasise our role as a partner for the music industry."

With the Radio Show of the Year, Viva acknowledges the importance of radio as a medium for the music industry. Last year Berlin-based dance radio Kiss FM won a Comet as Station of the Year. This year Viva decided to change this category into a programme related award since there have been no spectacular newcomers on the radio scene in the eyes of the Comet committee.

Only one of the five nominated radio shows is based on music. Launched during the

heyday of the Frankfurt techno scene in 1990, Club Night is Germany's longest running DJ-mix show. Originally featuring the late Thorsten Fenslau, the show's DJ pool now includes Sven Väth and Mark Spoon as well as five local DJs. HR 3 music editor Markus Hertle explains the long lasting popularity of the show with its club oriented programming. "We have club DJs spinning their regular sets in Club Night. It's all about brand new records, not proven chart hits."

Hertle observes that home recordings of Club Night are much in demand with techno fans. "We heard of specialist record shops selling the track-listings for DM50 a piece," says Hertle. In the meantime, HR 3 decided to put the listings on the Internet to avoid commercial exploitation of Club Night.

He blames a poor economy and the strong Swedish krona, which has hit exports. But he is philosophical. "Our industry has grown tremendously here in recent years, and things were bound to slow down sometime. It's just that they've slowed down a bit too much."

Jonas Holst, product manager at the Stockholm Label Group says music is being squeezed out by other forms of entertainment. "Look at restaurants, they're going through a boom at the moment," he says. But this is not the only setback. "For record companies, the commercial radio stations are a major problem. They concentrate on guaranteed hits and classics, and they're simply not playing enough new material. The newspapers are also having an effect by trying to persuade the public that CDs are too expensive, which puts people off buying."

Many are placing some of the blame on a perceived lack of quality in this year's releases. Others are content to point to the growing competition from other entertainment media such as PCs (Sweden has one of the highest computers-per-household levels in the world). Jonny Jergander, manager of Sweden's largest record store, Mega Skivakademin in

Stockholm, agrees that people are looking for other ways to spend their money. "Records are no longer seen as a cheap product," he says. Although Mega has not been hit as hard as many other smaller record shops, Jergander thinks the Swedish record companies are making one strategic error. "They seem to think the answer is to push more and more new artists onto the market. I think there are too many debutantes, often with similar images and sounds. The public are confused. They should invest more in artists we know we can sell."

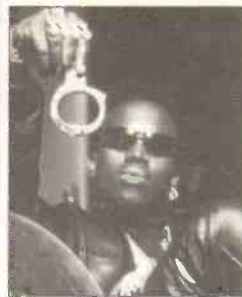

The highest new entry in this week's EHR Top 40 belongs to the fourth single by British R&B artist **Mark Morrison**. In fact the new offering is a 1996 remix (the 'Phil Chill Radio Edit') of the artist's 1995 single *Crazy*, which was also included on his debut album *Return Of The Mack*. This album has recently been nominated for the Mercury Music Prize, which will be awarded in early September (for details on the nominations, see page 5). The album has spawned one EHR hit before—its title track, which is still charting at number 23 after a nine-week stay in the top 10, including four consecutive weeks at number 3.

The new single, another example of accessible, streetwise R&B, kicks off at number 32 with a 24-station roster. This encompasses eight European countries in total, but two countries particularly stand out—Holland and the UK. The song is already number 5 in the UK (see Major Market Airplay).

The fastest mover on European Hit Radio this week is *Wannabe*, the debut single by UK quintet **Spice Girls**. This pure pop song scales up 20 places, landing at number 12 in Radio Active form during its second charting week. Its roster is boosted by 14 new adds in

10 countries, including key stations in Spain, Holland, Denmark, Germany, France, Poland, Portugal and Switzerland. Its total EHR roster now counts 49 stations, spread out over 15 countries, the highest penetration ratios being registered in the UK, Switzerland, Denmark, Poland, Italy and Holland. For more details on the act, see page 7.

Another single that deserves our attention is **Belinda Carlisle's** *In Too Deep*. The radio-friendly mid-tempo rocker is the taster for her forthcoming album *A Woman And A Man*. Interestingly, the CD single also includes a cover version of the John Lennon classic *Jealous Guy* (from *Imagine*, 1971), also covered by Roxy Music in 1981, earning them their first and only UK number 1 hit.

In Too Deep climbs to number 16 with a 62-station EHR roster and, with 15 new adds by its side, it is the most added single on the format this week. Carlisle

encounters playlist support in 18 countries, Switzerland, the UK and Denmark producing the best penetration figures as yet. It is the fourth EHR hit for Carlisle since the inception of the chart in December 1990. Of her previous hits on the format, 1991's *Live Your Life Be Free* went highest, peaking at number 8.

On The Road

Border Breakers commentary by Pieter Kops

Just like German pop band **Fool's Garden**, Italian crooner **Eros Ramazzotti** is now enjoying two simultaneous top 10 hits in the Border Breakers chart. His new single *Stella Gemella* leaps up to number 8, following its attainment of the highest new entry last week. In addition, Ramazzotti walks away with the newly installed Road Runner award, as *Stella Gemella* has registered the biggest chart point gain of the week.

The single's crossover roster has mounted to 20 (a 100% increase), thanks to 10 additions in five countries. No less than five of these adds have emerged in Switzerland, while the remainder includes key stations in Germany, Sweden and Russia. Its total crossover roster now encompasses nine European countries, Switzerland and Spain standing out as most supportive. *Stella Gemella* has also entered the EHR Chartbound section this week, due to 19 EHR stations across Europe (see page 17).

The highest entry in this week's Border Breakers run-down belongs to German dance act **Beat System**. Its cover version of **Kool & The Gang's** 1984 hit *Fresh* re-enters the chart just one week after it left the chart following a five-week stay. The single's second round starts at number 12, only two notches below its peak three weeks ago. Its re-entry is due to new reports from Hungary, Italy, Poland and Slovenia. The single enjoys an eight-country, 13-station crossover roster, with Hungary, France and Slovenia leading the pack.

The highest new entry—at number 14—belongs to German act **No Mercy**, whose *Where Do You Go* has crossed over to 14 stations in

nine countries outside GSA. Especially in Poland, Hungary and Slovenia, the single fares well on the airwaves.

Another new entry—at number 23—comes courtesy of Italian dance act **Alexia**. Produced and written by Robyx, *Summer Is Crazy* has found support on the playlists of 10 stations in six countries, Italy excluded. Spain, Poland and Switzerland lead the list, while

the Spanish contribution particularly stands out, as it includes a playlist position at mammoth network Cadena 40 Principales/Madrid.

The charts on this page track the border-crossing movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their country of signing (airplay achieved in the original country is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful Non-European artists according to airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Country Of Signing" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M aims to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.

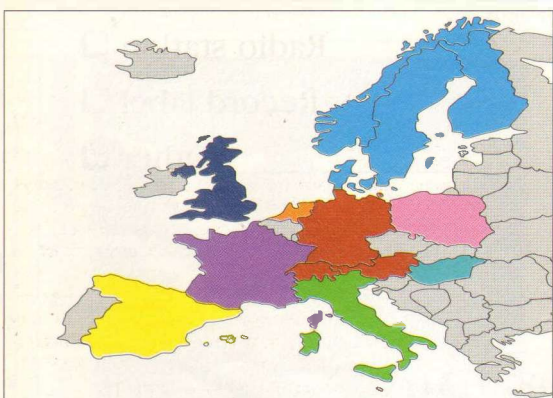

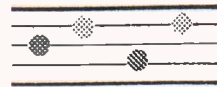
