NRJ to launch ambitious new e-commerce division

PARIS — NRJ has become the latest media group to enter the electronic age, with an ambition to become a "European leader in the field of e-commerce."

The French radio group announced plans on September 8 to create a wholly-owned subsidiary—e-NRJ—which will develop a range of Internet activities, including

music and videos for download.

NRJ Group general manager Alain Weill says: "We have all the right assets to succeed. This is an important move because it is the first time in the 18-year history of the group that we are investing in areas other than our core radio business. e-NRJ will mostly be a financial holding which will take minority or majority

'Power rotation' at EMAP Radio

LONDON — Dave Lincoln has been appointed to the new position of broadcast director at the UK's EMAP Radio group, as part of a wide-ranging reshuffle which steps up the company's policy of regularly rotating its top management.

According to EMAP Radio chief executive Tim Schoonmaker, Lincoln—previously managing director of EMAP's

Manchester stations Key 103 and Magic 1152—will work alongside existing group programme director Paul Kavanagh. "Paul has excelled at having great, yet simple, visions for our brands," says Schoonmaker. "Dave, having been a managing director and with years of experience in the business, is very good at implementing ideas."

Lincoln has been replaced in Manchester by Phil Roberts, previously *continued on page 25*

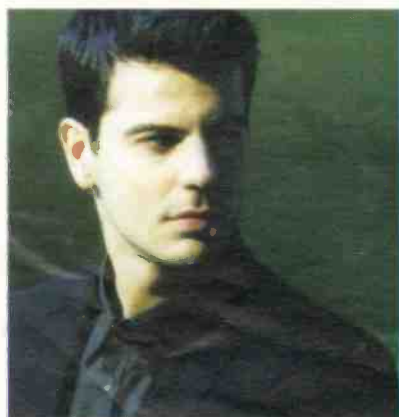
LONDON — Moloko's *Sing It Back* finally breaks into the European Radio Top 10 this week after a year-long buzz.

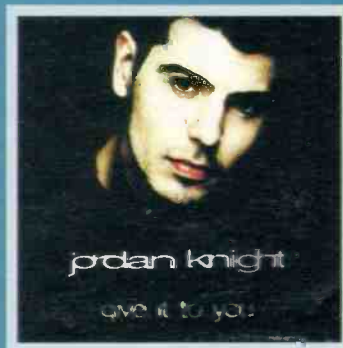

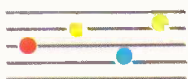

Upfront

Jean-Paul Baudecroux is no saint, but NRJ's president has certainly got a flair for business.

NRJ's foray into e-commerce is a significant move that moves the goalposts for both broadcasters and the music industry.

Baudecroux's strength has always been a firm understanding of branding. NRJ's brand is not only strong in France, it has a firm place in the heart of listeners all over Europe, especially 15-24 year olds.

NRJ reaches several million listeners, all of whom are potential consumers. With the power of its networks, NRJ can promote commercial propositions to its listeners/consumers and create a sense of community conducive to e-commerce.

As NRJ is first and foremost a broadcaster of music, it is no surprise that it targets record sales and downloads of music as its core Internet business. Record companies may initially object to broadcasters stealing their clothes, but they stand to gain if key players like NRJ start to sell music on-line.

Traditionally, people hear a track on the radio, then buy the single or album in a record shop. In the new media environment, the retail link disappears from the chain—listeners log into the station web site and instantly download the track seconds after hearing it on air—and buy other goods in the process.

If it's done by the book—in other words, if right owners are properly remunerated—this will no doubt boost sales of pre-recorded music and contribute to NRJ's bottom line.



A media giant is born

NEW YORK — Viacom Inc. and CBS Corporation have merged, creating a media giant which will have direct impact on the radio and music industries.

The new company—named Viacom—is described in a statement as “the world's leading company in the production, promotion and distribution of entertainment, news, sports and music with unmatched content and a portfolio of the world's most powerful brands.”

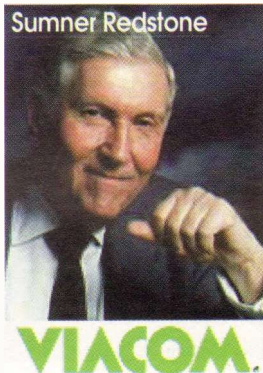
Viacom will combine the assets of both groups in areas such as terrestrial TV (CBS), cable TV (MTV, Nickelodeon, VH1, TNN, CMT, MTV2, Showtime, The Movie Channel, among others), film and TV production (Paramount), radio (Infinity Broadcasting Corporation, which operates 163 radio stations in the US), outdoor advertising (TDI), video distribution (Blockbuster Video), book publishing (Simon & Schuster), amusement parks and the Internet (cbs.sportsline.com, cbs.

marketwatch.com, mtv.com, SonicNet.com, vh1.com, and Nick.com).

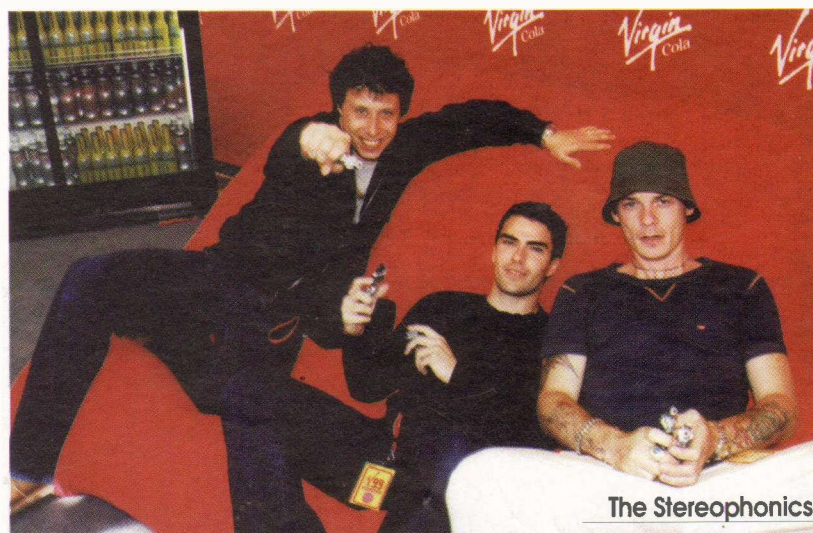
According to a company statement, Viacom will be “a pivotal player in the world of music. Through its Infinity Radio stations and the branded promotional power of MTV, MTV2, VH1, CMT, TNN and over the Internet, Viacom will reach more music fans than any other entity worldwide.”

The combined revenues of CBS and Viacom would have reached \$21 billion (euros 20.42bn) in 1998, second to Time-Warner and ahead of Disney, with profits of approximately \$4.0bn.

“The new Viacom will be the first 21st Century media company, with strong brands that lead the industry in all aspects of our operations,” commented CBS president /CEO Mel Karmazin, who will be president/COO of the new operation, reporting to 76-year old Sumner Redstone, who remains as chairman/CEO of Viacom. “The creation of this media giant marks the beginning of a new era of explosive growth domestically and around the world,” says Redstone.

CSA mixes messages

PARIS — It's been something of a schizophrenic week for CSA, the French broadcasting authority. CSA has been reprimanding stations for not respecting the 1994 quotas law while, at the same time, criticising the “rigid” law for not ensuring “the growing diversity of formats.”

The French authority cautioned three gold (Nostalgie, RFM and MFM) and two national AC networks (RTL 2 and Chérie FM) for not respecting the 20% quota for new talent and new production. Meanwhile, three CHR and dance stations (Ado FM, Paris, Voltage, Paris and Kiss FM, Nice) have not obeyed the 40% French-language content quota.

These cautions follow up a letter sent out in May, so if the stations choose to ignore this second warning, they face penalties ranging from fines to temporary licence suspension.

Marc Pallain, general manager of NRJ-owned Chérie FM, and spokesman for the radio group Bureau de Liaison de la Radio says: “It is hard to believe that the CSA will stretch to sanctions against us, although the ball is now in the court of the Ministry of Culture. But for now, we have no reason to change.”

Pallain says there is a need for a law that can incorporate AC and gold formats—such as Nostalgie's—which offers a healthy amount of French music but hardly any new talent.

Ironically, for almost a year, the CSA has proposed a slackening in the quotas and outlines in a statement: “The CSA can only regret the rigidity of the law on the growing diversity of formats, which is a source of richness and pluralism for the listeners.”

Sources say, the CSA is aiming to provoke reactions from the government, record labels and broadcasters and push for a change in the quotas laws. However, previous attempts to open up dialogue between labels and broadcasters under the aegis of the Ministry of Culture and communication in July were boycotted by labels.

EDEL PROMOTES PETRÉ

STOCKHOLM/HAMBURG — Michel Petré has been appointed to the new post of vice president international A&R at German indie edel, effective immediately. He will manage local A&R, liaising with A&R managers and local MDs. Petré will report to edel CEO Michael Haentjes, who says: "Michel has a passion for quality commercial music and has an excellent instinct when it comes to determining hits." Stockholm-based Petré moves from his position as senior European A&R executive for edel, where he signed Sash!, ATB and Funkstar DeLuxe.

REVERT PLANS SPAIN'S FIRST MUSIC FAIR

SEVILLE — Rafael Revert, director general of Todomúsica, is launching Spain's first international music trade fair. Taking place in Seville's Palace of Exhibitions and Congresses between September 30 and October 3, the Todomúsica fair includes music from Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, Turkey, Greece and Egypt. Revert, formerly director of Cadena 100, comments: "As the world's eighth largest music market, Spain needs its own major music trade fair." Debates include the challenge posed by the Internet and piracy and the role of independent labels.

BERLIN KEEPS KLASSIK ON AIR

BERLIN — The Berlin-Brandenburg media regulator (MABB) has renewed Klassik Radio's licence, following the Euromedia Group's take-over of the station earlier this summer. Under existing legislation, new owners must re-apply to the regulatory body for a licence. Some 15 applicants—with formats from hip-hop/R&B and country to rock—competed for the frequency (M&M, August 7, 1999). Klassik Radio is one of 12 national commercial broadcasters which also has a nationwide reach via cable or satellite.

300 LABELS SEDUCED BY CDUCTIVE

LONDON — Over 300 indie labels have signed up to a distributor of MP3 music on the Internet. Cductive.com, a US distributor which has just opened a European office based in London's Soho, has attracted labels such as Strictly Rhythm, Dorado, Filter, Beggars/4AD/XL and V2 Records. Managed by Ollie Buckwell, founder and MD of dance/alternative labels Dorado and Filter Records, the London office will manage the swelling roster of UK independent labels wanting to distribute their music digitally.



ON-LINE MUSIC SHOWCASE LAUNCHED

LOS ANGELES — Liquid Audio and The Hollywood Reporter magazine have joined forces to showcase music by composers for film, TV and advertising commercials. Using LiquidAudio's software and services for the digital delivery of music, the partnership is to launch "The Hollywood Reporter Composer Registry," a music auditioning service for the post production community, at the end of October.

SWR3 ANNOUNCES FESTIVAL LINE UP

BADEN-BADEN — This year's SWR3 New Pop Festival in Baden-Baden and Rastatt—organised by Radio SWR3—boasts a line-up which includes Alanis Morissette, The Fugees, Faithless, Savage Garden, Soraya, Xavier Naidoo, Macy Gray and Travis. Six out of the 10 shows are already sold out.

Sony UK to grow 'vibrant local roster'

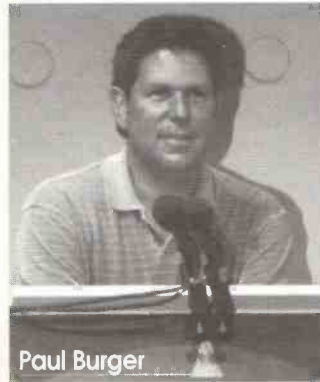
BOURNEMOUTH — "We have one of the most vibrant local rosters in the business and are looking to grow our local artists and market them internationally."

This was the cornerstone of the speech made by Paul Burger, chairman of Sony Music UK, when he addressed the company's annual sales convention in Bournemouth, England on September 4.

Burger also outlined Sony's plans for the "the best Christmas line-up" Sony has ever compiled. He is hoping to score the company a hat trick with the best-selling album at retail for Christmas.

Burger added that the Christmas season should boost Sony's market share in the UK. "A few years back, we had a 10% market share. Last year, our market share rose to 16% and this year we are already 1.5% ahead of last year's figure. Our domestic roster has never been stronger," enthused

Burger, naming the recent success of the Manic Street Preachers' *This Is My Truth Tell Me Yours*, B*Witched, whose debut album sold three million units worldwide, Jamiroquai's *Synkronized* (three million units and counting). He also praised Sony's

association with indie labels such as Andy McDonald's Independent, which scored a No.1 UK album with Travis' *The Man Who*, and former Warner UK chairman Rob Dickins' new label Instant Karma, which will deliver new acts next year.

Both Dickins and McDonald were present at the convention, alongside Sony executives from Germany, Japan, France and South Africa.

Sony's line-up includes new albums from Leftfield, The Lightning Seeds, Merz, Thunderbugs, Apollo 440, and B*Witched's follow-up album. International acts include Céline Dion, Mariah Carey, BabyFace, Wyclef, and Will Smith. "We have more than 20 major albums to compete in the charts," said Burger.

Burger also revealed plans to open a MiniDisc-only retail store located on the ground floor of Sony's building in London. The shop, MiniDisc.com, would be the first of its kind in Europe and is to stock a full range of MiniDisc pre-recorded software at full price. It will sell Sony's repertoire on MiniDisc as well as products from other record companies. It is understood the shop will not sell hardware. "It will be a fantastic showcase for this technology," promised Burger.

EMAP, Capital win digital radio contest

LONDON — In the only UK digital radio licence to be contested to date, CE Digital—a joint application by the EMAP and Capital radio groups—has won the battle for London's digital multiplex.

CE Digital proposes to broadcast eight existing London commercial services (Capital FM, Capital Gold, Kiss 100, Magic 105.4, News Direct, Xfm, Sunrise Radio and LBC). In addition, Capital Radio will provide a new (as yet unnamed) Hot AC station.

The award, made by UK regulator the Radio Authority, is being seen as a vote for London's existing radio order, given that other multiplex bidders were proposing more new services for the capital.

"The strength of tried and tested brands will drive the take-up of digital radios in London," says EMAP Radio chief executive Tim Schoonmaker. "They provide a foundation of quality services which will give confidence to the new medium, and cross-promotion on London's favourite stations will help to establish digital radio quickly." Adds Capital Radio group chief executive David Mansfield: "If digital radio is to be successful, it must be backed by companies with stability and financial firepower."

The unsuccessful bidders were MXR Digital (a joint ven-

ture between Chrysalis Radio and Border Radio) and Switchdigital, which united Talk Radio and Virgin Radio. However, the Radio Authority is set to advertise two more London multiplex licences.

EMAP Radio is also celebrating the award of the South Yorkshire digital multiplex, for which it was the sole applicant. London-based services Kiss 100 and Xfm will join existing local stations Hallam FM, Magic AM, Classic Gold, BBC Radio Sheffield and Trax FM on that multiplex, with an additional new AC service.

Meanwhile, "Continuous Cool Country" (3C) will be coming to in Scotland following the award of the Glasgow digital multiplex licence to

D-day for Danes

COPENHAGEN — Should they stay or should they go? Cable operator Tele Danmark sent 520,000 ballots to Danish households on August 18 asking listeners to vote on which broadcasters should remain on cable.

The DKK 6 million (euros 810,000) exercise last week garnered a response from 41% of Danish households, which voted The Voice's radio station top and its sister product, Voice Pop, third. The result follows The Voice's boosted audience share from 5.8% in the last quarter to 6.3% in this quarter (M&M, August 28, 1999).

"We have once again shown that The Voice is the strongest product on

the Danish radio scene. The fact that our new product, The Voice Pop, won third place proves that the Danes feel confident that The Voice delivers products of prime quality," says Eric Hansen, MD of The Voice.

Broadcasters spent a total of DKK 35 million (euros 4.7m) in campaigning for their survival in the poll, which saw support for many German stations in southern Jutland, close to the border. NRJ managed to stay on the airwaves, although MTC's Swedish Power Hit Radio did not.

BMG radio promoter Daniel Vangsgaard comments: "The results don't really mean much. The stations I work with are still there, so now I guess I'll see what the new ones have to offer."

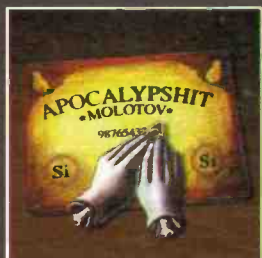

Mushroom hits the dance floor

London-based indie Mushroom, home to Garbage, Ash and Peter Dinklage, is set to burst into the dance arena with Paul Oakenfold's Perfecto label and sister imprint 48k.

Founded by UK club DJ Oakenfold 10 years ago, Perfecto has earned a reputation in the UK for quality commercial dance releases. First distributed by BMG and then by East West Records, Perfecto signed a licensing deal with the News Corp.-owned Mushroom at the start of 1999.

"Our goals are to deliver one-off hit records following the success of [Perfecto act] the Dope Smugglaz' *The Word* and *Double Double Dutch* in the short term and to develop two to three album artists over the next 18 months," Mushroom MD Korda Marshall says. The company also wants to expand Perfecto's fanbase in continental Europe and Asia and to break Oakenfold's label in the US, where it will be distributed by Warner Music's Sire imprint.

In the rest of the world Perfecto and 48k are distributed by BMG Entertainment, through Mushroom's global licensing deal with the company. Upcoming singles releases include Planet Perfecto (*Bullet In The Gun*) and Skip Raiders (*Another Day*), both on Perfecto, as well as Deception (*On The Dancefloor*) and Aida (*Far & Away*) on 48k.

Perfecto's first album release will be an as-

yet-untitled export-only compilation for the international market due out at Christmas. A full album by the Dope Smugglaz is slated for release in March 2000.

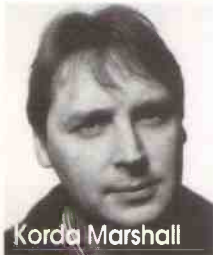
"Perfecto has always been about album artists, while I see 48k competing with commercial dance labels such as EMI's Positiva and Universal's Manifesto," says Oakenfold.

Mushroom head of international Mirelle Davis sees Oakenfold as the best ambassador for Perfecto and 48k, both in the public and in the eyes of licensing partner BMG. "Paul has a higher profile than the label at present," she comments. "My reputation as a DJ is definitely key to the image of the labels," Oakenfold drily agrees.

This month he starts a new residency at London's latest super club Home and on October 1 he embarks on a UK college tour. "I will also put my label's acts on the net every month with a live webcast from the Perfecto night at Home," promises Oakenfold.

Marshall hints at more alliances in the dance arena. "Mushroom will have an aggressive A&R policy over the next two years," he says, adding that as part of News Corp., "we have the means to buy labels to complement our business."

Looking further ahead, Mushroom might soon expand outside its core label business. Marshall would not confirm any plans at press-time but comments: "I'm looking forward to the technological development that will offer new outlets for our music. There is an obvious synergy between a small, creative label like Mushroom and a media concern such as News International."

Appointed by the Danish Ministry of Cultural Affairs as a figurehead, Norby will play 11 gigs at the top jazz clubs of New York City as part of a programme that counts no less than 85 events between September 9 to November 1.

Her current album *Queen Of Bad Excuses* (Blue Note), released in Denmark on August 30, will be featured heavily during the campaign.

"We've already received advance orders for 6,000 units," says EMI-Medley exploitation manager Mette Fjeldsted. The album will be released in October in Australia and Japan, where Norby enjoys a strong cult following.

The album is spiced with latin rhythms, touches of soft rock and faux-African phrasing.

Six of the 12 tracks were recorded live in the studio, and all but two of them were penned by Norby. "I tried to follow my intuition," she says. "I took the traditional jazz sound, wove in modern lyrics about social observations and did something a bit different."

Norby cut her first jazz album on Blue Note in 1995 and followed it up with the benchmark *My Corner Of The Sky* a year later. The latter contained a version of David Bowie's *Life On Mars*, which Bowie himself highly praised. The two sets together sold more than 130,000 units worldwide.

Norby broke through with a jazz-rock fusion act called Frontline, and later teamed up with Nina Forsberg to form One Two, one of the hottest names in Danish jazz-rock in the late 1980s.

Since opting for a more purist approach in the '90s, she has shared stages with Cassandra Wilson and Ray Charles.

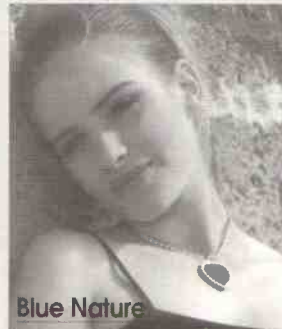

STRING SOUP

A plaintive garage vocal and an orchestral bouillabaisse of filtered strings 'n' brass are the main ingredients of Vision's *Wastin Time* (Cleveland City/UK). The vocal hook, backed up Chic-esque string sweeps, is wistful but undeniably gets under the skin. Definite pop potential from this mutant discoid number with strong boogie feel.

TRANCETANIC

Having already sold 200,000 copies in Germany and just out in the UK, Blue Nature's *A Life So Changed* (Superstar/Germany) is a trance version of the theme from the film *Titanic*. On familiarity alone this one will tweak a few heartstrings and please some programmers.

ORIGINALS

Zaragozan group John Landis Fans are one of Spain's true originals. Formed in 1983, the group are pioneers both in music and in their legendary live performances that combine cabaret, psychedelia and audience interaction. New album *Songs For The Frozen Latitudes* (Cosmosound/Spain) mixes dub, house, funk, techno and jazz. Well worth a listen.

ANOTHER TIME AROUND

Shawn Christopher's 1992 classic *Don't Lose The Magic* (4 Play/USA) sees a second outing with new mixes by Eric Kupper, Stonebridge and Dave Aude. The track has already appeared in mixes by David Morales and Todd Terry but Aude's vocal mix updates the song beautifully.

LATIN CUBAN LINK UP

The compilation series *For Films*, from Hamburg-based Freibank Musikverlage, is now on its fourth edition. This new release shows the changing face of Freibank's artists.

"I wanted the compilation to reflect that our repertoire has come a long way from the dark, gothic style of the '80s," says Klaus Maeck, who compiles the series.

"I also want to try and influence the scene in Germany where latin and Cuban music are becoming more popular."

Maeck is currently putting together a compilation called *Electro Latino* that will reflect the new sound. Due out next spring, it will include material from Señor Coconut, previously known as Atom Heart, one of the early tech/house stars now based in Santiago de Chile. "Since he moved there his music has changed a lot," says Maeck. "In a general sense, it's important for the future of electronica that Cuban and latin music cross over."

The distinctive Voice of Denmark

Danish commercial CHR station The Voice, based in Copenhagen and also broadcasting to Aarhus and Odense, celebrated its 15th anniversary this year. *Charles Ferro* investigates the philosophy of a station which has changed the face of radio in Denmark.

As the bells of Copenhagen's city hall tolled at noon on June 8, 1984, the state of radio in Denmark was destined to change forever. It was the day The Voice took to the airwaves as the country's first legal commercial radio station.

The Voice pioneered format-based radio in Denmark, creating a consistent sound that owed much to US radio. Its basic philosophy is to play the best music from the '90s and the '80s, and to be the first on the air with new music.

"When listeners turn on The Voice, they immediately know what they're getting," says Simon Junker, creative director at music consultancy Music-Matters.



Adds Junker: "The most interesting factor has been the way they have branded the station. It is highly visible in other media, through events, and so activates listeners. The Voice's constant development of both programming and marketing has been of great interest to

labels and advertisers as well as to others in the radio industry."

Personality appeal

Another Voice innovation has been that of the personality presenter. Back in 1984, the idea of DJs doing any more than presenting songs and telling the time was unheard of in Denmark. What immediately struck listeners about The Voice was how its presenters were given a much freer rein compared to their counterparts

at public broadcaster Danmarks Radio. As a result, Voice DJs began to establish names for themselves, and a number of them moved on to TV, to other radio stations or careers in entertainment.

In the early '90s The Voice became even more aggressive with a new personality morning show called Happy & Co., based on the US Morning Zoo idea pioneered by New York's Z100. "The first ratings showed we went back by 30%, but within six months

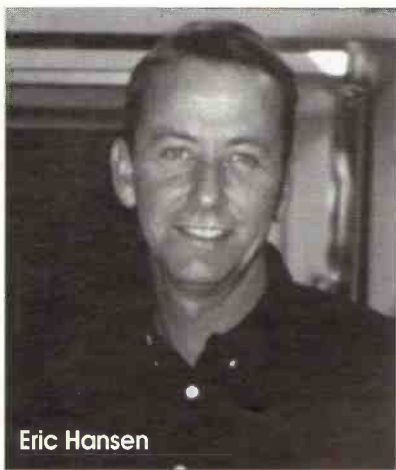

the ratings were up 317%,” says the show’s first presenter, “Happy” Hans van Rijn, who was appointed joint programme director alongside Eik Frederiksen in 1998. “We were giving the Danes something different,” he recalls, “although they needed a bit of time to find out if they liked it.”

Programming innovations

The morning show was subsequently rebranded the Kaos Krew, and Van Rijn has recently handed the mike over to Marlene Steinhaur so that he can concentrate full-time on his programming duties.

Notoriously outrageous in its approach, the Kaos Krew show has, in the past year, given away a breast-enhancement operations to listeners and has featured couples having sex live on air. “We take chances,” admits Van Rijn.

In another promotional stunt, the Kaos Krew last year urged its listeners to ring a competing call-in show on public CHR station P3 and win a Dkr 2,000 (euros 14,860) if they managed to say, on-air: “The Voice is Denmark’s number one hit radio station.”

After several successes, the P3 presenters hit back by allowing listeners 15 minutes to call in and broadcast the strap-line, in an attempt to cost The Voice dearly. “But we got on TV and into all the newspapers, something money can’t buy,” says Van Rijn.

However, the Kaos Krew’s controversial activities have proved less popular outside of the Copenhagen market. As a result, Odense now has its own morning show and Aarhus will soon follow suit. “We have to

sound local and be local,” Rijn says. “That’s how we believe we can win in these areas.”

The Voice is now Denmark’s most-listened to commercial radio station, chalking up a 6.3% share in the second quarter of this year (M&M, August 28) in the official Gallup ratings. DR’s P3 remains the overall market leader among the national music networks, with a 27.7% share of listening, but The Voice has a stronger listener base in the 18-34 target group than P3.

As recently as the fourth quarter of 1998, The Voice’s share was at 4.5%, but significant numbers of new listeners were added after it began terrestrial broadcasting in Aarhus, Denmark’s second largest city. “Our prime ambition is to reach the whole country,” says managing director Eric Hansen. “We are hoping that stations can be established in Esbjerg and Aalborg, the third and fourth largest cities. Aarhus was a textbook example of how to launch a radio station. ANR [the existing station whose frequency The Voice took over] had 43,000 daily listeners, but four weeks after the launch that figure was boosted to 108,000.”

The big family

A major turning point in the development of The Voice was the purchase of a majority stake in the station by the Luxembourg-based Scandinavian Broadcasting System (SBS) in 1994. The injection of this fresh capital and know-how enabled investment in technology and training. “As a member of a larger family, we can stay at the leading edge of radio trends in the

US and UK, and keep abreast of technological advances," explains Hansen.

The group's next project is to launch a Hot AC station, Voice Pop on October 1, targeting an older audience. In this context, it has to be noted that the term "pop" in Danish means popular in the true generic sense of the word rather than the teen music genre. The station is hoping its slightly older demographic will open the door to new advertisers.

There is certainly room in the market for an AC approach—Denmark has lagged behind the rest of Europe in the evolution of radio, and with few exceptions, formats have not been clearly defined. Smaller local commercial stations tend to mix hits from various genres, or programme specialist shows in a particular time slot for a specific age groups or musical tastes.

However, Clear Channel's national Soft AC station Radio 2 (which until very recently was confined to broadcasting on cable) has the advantage of being the first station to enter the adult arena. "It's a new market that's sprouting for adult listeners," notes Jakob Sorensen, radio promoter at EMI-Medley. "It's interesting for some of our products, and it will be fascinating to see who wins the battle."

Going for firsts

However, in the past The Voice has not achieved success by merely following the crowd. As programme director

But the secret involves more than simply being first. Frederiksen, a modest man with a golden ear, is an omnivorous absorber of information. "Eik has his finger on the pulse, he surfs the net, subscribes to all the trades, and knows what's going on in Denmark and internationally," says Sony's radio promoter for international repertoire Björn Bengtsson. "If Eik likes something, he'll try it," adds Universal radio promotions manager Laust Pedersson.

Being first certainly involves keeping ears open beyond Danish borders. Voice personnel often return from holidays with a hot record which has not yet been released in Denmark. As a

result, it's not unusual for the station to call a label and request a record well before its scheduled release, effectively becoming an indirect part of the launch apparatus.

The Voice was playing Alanis Morissette long before *Jagged Little Pill* was officially released in Denmark, and played Shania Twain more than a year ago. "Several years ago Eik encountered some music done by an unknown Canadian woman who was having problems breaking through in Europe," relates Eric Hansen. "He listened to some songs and ran with it. That was Celine Dion, long before she became a star."

The Frederiksen philosophy

hear the top five [chart records] today, and also the top five of the future, because our format features a lot of new music," says Frederiksen, who adds that "labels know the reach of The Voice. If we add a song as our Power Play, then they can evaluate fairly well how many records will be sold, or how many concert tickets will be sold. We both understand that we can't live without each other."

Record labels appear to support Frederiksen's assessment. "The Voice is powerful radio," says Edel promotions manager Jan Wagner Holm. "They're provocative and they hit the target."

"The station means a lot for breaking an act," agrees Sony local act radio promoter Anders Brienholt. "If

they’re behind it, they’re behind it 100%.” His Sony colleague Bengtsson goes further: “If we get a new single and evaluate where it should premiere, in many situations we choose The Voice.”

New medium venture

In a further extension of its activities, The Voice is also considering launching a music TV channel. Denmark has virtually no music TV at present. MTV broadcasts from studios in Sweden and leans toward domestic artists in that country, while public

channel TV2 recently cancelled Puls, considered to be the main TV outlet for music.

“If anybody can roll out a music TV station, it’s us,” says Hansen, who reveals he is talking with various existing TV channels which may be able to provide some kind of a window for The Voice. “We’ve been contacted by a number of TV stations that wanted to film the morning team [Kaos Krew], because their antics are often very visual.”

Such a deal would aim to get viewers used to the concept of music TV in

time for the next scheduled cable TV poll in Denmark—The Voice’s proposals for a full-time music channel on cable failed to secure the necessary votes in a vote held last month.

“Surveys show that very few Danes watch television in the morning, and the selection of local programming is limited. There is great potential for it. The secret for TV will be local subject matter,” Hansen asserts.

Labels report that they are ready for a local music TV channel. It would be able to put faces to Danish acts, especially new ones. There are high hopes that it would create a Danish

video market.

“MTV Nordic is so Swedish, it’s important to have a player at home,” says Jakob Sørensen, radio promoter at EMI-Medley. “It would be fantastic to have Voice TV. We don’t have too many outlets now,” agrees Camille Torp at Virgin special marketing.

“Existing music TV channels are too predictable,” contends Hansen. “You can’t ask people to watch a pre-recorded show that’s 10 days old. It’s impersonal. We can do it better,” he concludes. “Doing it better was what the Voice first aimed at 15 years ago.”

In contemporary pop culture only Metallica rocks harder than Northern Ireland's finest. Lead singer Andy Cairns and bass man Michael McKeegan formed the band in 1990. Fuelled by raw power and small town angst they lead their band to the very top only to watch their fortunes dwindle when their label A&M crumbled last year. Now signed to Steve Tannett's Ark 21 label for the world and distributed, yet again, by Universal Therapy? are kicking down doors with *Suicide Pact*, their toughest album



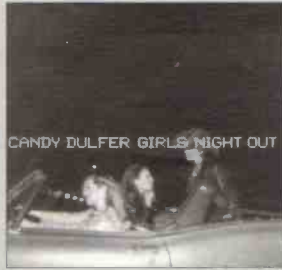
since 1992's *Pleasuredeath*. Listen to Cairns venting his anger about sectarianism on the menacingly quiet *God Kicks* and witness the band tear the roof off rockers like *Wall Of Mouths*, *Jam Jar Jail* and *Little Tongues First*. This is class material interpreted with fervour and craftsmanship. The sound on the album is heavily 70's influenced-right down to the six-minute instrumental hard rock jam called *Big Cave In*. Despite

the references, however, this no nostalgic trip down memory lane but aural excitement for the jaded generation.

Dutch girl about town Dulfer blows the title theme in the new Robert Altman movie *Cookie's Fortune* which will be released across Europe this month. The road movie style alto sax/dobro duel between Dulfer and the Eurythmics' Dave Stewart is called *Cookie* and rounds off an album of jazz funk calling up the spirit of the golden era of the genre in the 70's. Boosting Dulfer's funk factor on eight of the album's 13 tracks are two of James Brown's original *Famous Flames*, Fred Wesley on trombone and Alfred "Peewee" Ellis on tenorsax. The overall vibe of the largely instrumental *Girls Night Out* suits the lounge better than the dancefloor, however. *Cookie* is the obvious single here but Dulfer's vocals on the R&B flavoured title track and the next single *What Does It Take*, a cover of the old Motown classic featuring Jonathan Butler on vocals and guitar, are worth checking out.

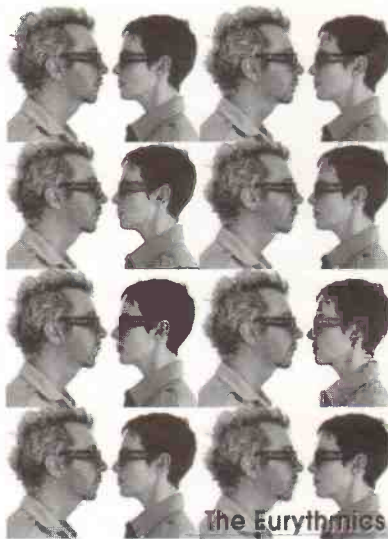

On the air

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

The European Radio Top 50 chart this week is still influenced by big summer hits, but is peppered with new autumn releases.

Moloko shoots up from last week's 20 to number 10 with their '70s disco-inspired *Sing It Back* (Echo). (See artist story on page 3). At the top, *Summer Son* by Texas (Mercury) refuses to be eclipsed, and after four consecutive weeks at the top of the airplay chart, only TLC's *Unpretty* (LaFace/Arista) at number two and *Blue* by Eiffel 65 (Bliss Co.) at number three, threaten the Scots' success.



The Eurythmics' new album *Peace* (RCA) is due to be released in Europe at the end of October. The first single from the album, *I Saved The World Today* (RCA), goes straight in at number 21—the highest new entry in this week's airplay chart. Rainer Gruhn, music director at Berlin's AC/talk station Hundert 6, is enthusiastic about the track: "Being an old Eurythmics fan, as well as enjoying their solo material, I think their comeback is great. Their fans are ecstatic—The Eurythmics back together is everything they've been dreaming of! The track as a mid-tempo, timeless pop song is perfect for radio."

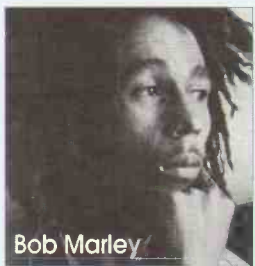
Hundert 6's programming consists of 52% speech and 48% music, aimed at 20-50 year olds. "Our favourites at the moment are Simply Red's *Ain't That A Lot Of Love* (East West), Chris De Burgh's *When I Think Of You* (A&M), and *Different Roads* by Joe Cocker (EMI)." Gruhn has a hot tip for other AC stations: "American country artist Wrechia Ford's *You Let Me Live* (BME) is an easy, soothing song which is very suitable for the cold, dark autumn. It's going to be big!"

The second highest new entry at number 30 is American band Lyte Funky Ones' *Summer Girls* (Logic/Arista), taken from their recently released eponymous debut album. A boy band with a difference, the three members write most of their own songs. Just below them on the chart, Backstreet Boys have a new entry at 33 with *Larger Than Life*, their follow-up single to *I Want It That Way* (both Jive). Judging by the success of the latter, the boy band will again dominate Europe's airwaves.

Also a newcomer on this week's European Radio Top 50 is Funkstar De Luxe's remix of Bob Marley's *Sun Is Shining* (Edel) at 36. Other new entries are Britney Spears' *You Drive Me Crazy* (Jive) at 39, Everything But The Girl's *Five Fantoms* (EMI) at 48, and finally Phats & Small's 99 remix of the Earth, Wind & Fire track *September* (INcredible) at number 50.

This has been Ricky Martin's summer all over Europe, and the latin singer is releasing a follow up to *Living La Vida Loca* (Columbia), still on the airplay chart at 29 after 21 weeks. His new single, *She's All I Ever Had* (Columbia), is a strong contender for next week's European Radio Top 50.

NRJ launches European e-division

stakes in several European Internet start-up ventures close to our brand."

NRJ is currently recruiting e-NRJ's 10-strong team, including a managing director. Weill declines to reveal the total investment the group is forecasting, but hints that: "although Internet activities will represent an important part of our business, the investment is small compared to the overall scale of the group." Start-up costs will be limited, as e-NRJ will not invest in cash, but instead make contra-deals with relevant companies.

As part of e-NRJ, a dedicated unit named NRJ Direct will deal with music and video downloads. NRJ plans to sell both current hits played on the network and its own products, signed to its NRJ Music label.

Weill says NRJ plans to move fast

in offering downloads. "As record companies are becoming more aware of the huge potential of downloading music, there will be more activity in this area," he forecasts.

Another e-NRJ subsidiary is the electronic commerce site staravenue.com which already sells CDs, and will sell DVDs and CD-Roms in the near future. Other brands which sit comfortably with NRJ's are also being scrutinised for strategic partnerships. "We will announce a string of deals within a couple of weeks," reveals Weill.

In France, the group aims to launch 40 web sites targeting 40 key cities under NRJ.net.city. The latter will use the news-gathering resources of NRJ's 120-strong pool of journalists, and will sell advertising

through its 300-strong sales force.

e-NRJ will also take control NRJ's local websites in the eight other European countries where the company also operates (Belgium, Austria, Switzerland, Germany, Sweden, Norway, Denmark and Finland). The umbrella site is Njr.com.

In addition, NRJ plans to launch web TV during the Techno Parade in Paris on 18 September, and intends to use the Internet to synergise with its radio programmes. Says NRJ group programme manager Christophe Sabot: "We will complement what goes out on air with what goes out on the net. For instance, an extensive Will Smith interview might not interest the majority of listeners, but can be enjoyed by thousands of his fans who can access it on our web site."

Moloko Sings It Back to radio

speed," he tells Music & Media.

With added bounce, *Sing It Back* became the unofficial dancefloor anthem at the Miami Winter Music Conference in March this year.

"*Sing It Back* came out of the blue," recalls Bernd Albrecht, music programmer at dance/alt.rock station ORB Fritz in Potsdam, Germany. "I had always thought of Moloko as a band that toys with trip hop, but *Sing It Back* is a great sing-along tune for all formats. We alternate between Boris' radio edit and the more recent Supermarket mix by Can 7 on Peppermint Jam which is maybe a touch more leftfield and more in line with the tastes of our core listeners."

"It's such a fantastic song," enthuses Dlugosch. "The original just falls short of house speed which is why I wanted to do the remix." When Dlugosch phoned Echo, the label had already commissioned some mixes

and US licensee Warner Brothers had asked Todd Terry, so funds were running low. "I did the mix for free," reveals Dlugosch. "The deal is that Roisin will sing on my next single."

Alex Myers, international marketing manager at London-based indie Echo confirms that "Miami kicked the song into life." In most European territories the record was released on August 16—an unusually long delay for a hot dance record. Myers comments: "Our phones did not stop ringing after the Winter Music conference, but we had reached the end of our licensing deal with Universal, so it took a while to sort things out."

Sing It Back is now licensed to German indie Peppermint Jam—which, in turn, is licensed to edel records—for most of Europe. In France, the track is handled by Scorpio and, in the UK, Echo product is distributed by Pinnacle.

Hamburg-based edel product man-

ager Heiko Beck comments: "*Sing It Back* broke on the club circuit. Then radio picked it up and we sold 30,000 CD singles with no marketing." In its third week on the German singles charts, the track jumps from 65 to 59. "This will bring us a C-rotation on [music TV channel] Viva," predicts Beck. "With a Top 60 record we can think about starting a TV campaign."

Echo decided not to re-launch the *Doctor* album on the strength of *Sing It Back*. "We are between albums," explains Myers. "We'd rather focus on the new Moloko album which is scheduled for the first quarter of 2000." *Doctor* was never actually released in the US and Warner decided to wait for the next album instead.

The new album will include Dlugosch's remix of *Sing It Back*, confirms Myers. A first single from the third Moloko album is also expected to be released in early 2000.

en over by Charlie Dimont, who becomes CEO of EMI Europe, responsible for EMI Recorded Music operations in Europe. These include EMI, manufacturing and distribution and other businesses. Dimont is currently senior VP of EMI International, with responsibilities for Latin America and south east Asia. His replacement has not yet been announced.

However, Dimont's brief will not include Virgin operations in Europe. Current Virgin UK chairman Paul Conroy, and Emmanuel de Buretel, president of Virgin France and president of Virgin Continental Europe, will continue to report directly to Berry.

MD at Metro FM/Newcastle. Also on the move from Metro is programmer Sean Marley, who will now programme Liverpool's Radio City 96.7 and Magic 1548.

Marley replaces Paul Jordan

in Liverpool, who—despite being recently named as CRCA Programmer of the Year following major audience gains at Radio City—returns to the smaller Preston and Blackpool market, where

he will programme Rock FM and Magic 999. Previous Rock FM (and former Kiss 100/London) programmer Mark Matthews will remain at EMAP Radio "working on digital radio licence applications."

Mel Booth moves from MD at Viking FM/Hull to the same position at Metro FM. His replacement at Viking is Sue Timson, who formerly headed up Radio City's sales team. Meanwhile, Sean Marley's replacement in the Metro FM programming department is Tony McKenzie, who joins from Sheffield's Hallam FM. The Hallam programmer's position has yet to be filled—Schoonmaker says the position will be advertised to internal and external candidates.

Schoonmaker explains that EMAP Radio's policy is to regularly rotate its senior management to prevent executives and stations from becoming stale—hence moves to different stations within the group should not necessarily be viewed as promotions or demotions. "Great people constantly need fresh challenges," says Schoonmaker, who says the strategy is commonplace at top blue-chip companies such as Unilever and IBM. "It keeps careers moving and makes people more flexible, and—within the context of the consistent brands we now have at EMAP Radio—the stations benefit from new perspectives."

Singh's OK, agree Mercury judges

LONDON — Asian dance guru Talvin Singh has scooped the 1999 Technics Mercury Music Prize—the UK music critics' award—for his debut solo album *OK* (Island).

Simon Frith, chairman of the judges, announced the award in London on September 7 after what he described as "an acrimonious decision-making process."

The jury of media and music industry representatives picked *OK* from a shortlist of 12 albums which included the Manic Street Preachers' *This Is My Truth Tell Me Yours* (Epic), Blur's *13* (Parlophone/EMI), The Chemical Brothers' *Surrender* (Virgin), Faithless' *Sunday 8pm* (Cheeky), and Underworld's *Beaucoup Fish* (V2).

The show was hosted by presenter and pianist Jools Holland and featured live performances by Singh, along with nominees Denys Baptiste, Beth Orton, Black Star Liner and Kate Rusby.

Public CHR station BBC Radio 1 and TV channel BBC2 remained as the main media partners for the 1999 Mercury Music Prize, and broadcast the show on the Tuesday night. Other broadcasters included UK TV stations Channel 4 and GMTV, and 104.9 Xfm/London (alt.rock), and Chrysalis Radio's Galaxy dance network.

The award, which carries £20,000 prize money, is organised in association with trade bodies British Phonographic Industry (BPI) and British Association Of Record Dealers (BARD).

Platinum Europe for Modern Talking

LONDON — German Eurodance duo Modern Talking have qualified for a Platinum Europe Award for their album *Alone* (BMG), according to statistics published by the IFPI in London on September 7.



To qualify for a Platinum Europe Award an album must sell over one million copies in Europe. Other albums which met this criterion during the month of August included the Red Hot Chili Peppers' *Californication* (Warner Bros), *Americana* (Columbia) from US alternative rockers The Offspring and *Savoir Aimer* (Universal) from French singer Florent Pagny both reach double platinum status.

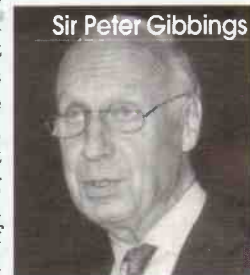

Hotline

Chairman of the UK's Radio Authority (RA), Sir Peter Gibbings, has said that Oxford alternative music station Oxygen 107.9 displayed "a shocking disrespect for its listeners" when, on March 15 this year, it pretended during its broadcasts that the date was actually March 8, and doctored the output accordingly. Reason being was that, following a complaint about breach of format, the RA had requested logging tapes from Oxygen for March 8, which the station was unable to provide. So, in an attempt to avoid a fine, Oxygen sent the RA tapes of its March 15 output masquerading as a week earlier. However, the RA rumbled the scam and has fined Oxygen a record-equalling £20,000 (euro 33,200), and has shortened its licence term by two years—the first time it has imposed such a sanction on a station.

Incidentally, it could be even tougher to try to deceive the RA in future—Hotline hears that the former boss of British intelligence service MI5, Stella Rimington, is set to be a candidate to replace Gibbings as RA chairman when he steps down next year.

German indie edel's second stock offering has netted the company euro 102 million—the new shares went on sale with a price of euro 58.50 on September 8. In presentations to investors edel CEO Michael Haentjes indicated that the company will press ahead with its plans for acquisition targets in the US.

The official French Victoires music awards might still be in a state of limbo, but NRJ is finally launching its own awards show. The NRJ Music Awards will take place on 22 January in Cannes during MIDEM, and will be simulcast on NRJ and leading commercial TV channel TF1. There will be around 12 categories covering domestic and international repertoire.

Sony Music UK chairman Paul Burger announced during the company's convention in Bournemouth last week that he will soon be appointing two new senior executives: an MD of Sony ATV publishing operations to replace Blair McDonald (appointed MD of Columbia UK), and a head of the company's Internet businesses. Burger told Hotline that he expects both execs to be named "within the next four weeks."

And still with the UK music biz, Ian Hanson, executive VP of EMI Records Group UK & Ireland, has been given responsibility for EMI's global infrastructure project, which will look at the group's long-term operations and investments.

Bruno Gérentes, chief executive of BMG France, has re-signed Laurent Voulzy. Voulzy was courted by both Sony and Virgin and his new deal with BMG is viewed as a sign that the French affiliate is now capable of attracting leading artists again.

Swedish CHR network NRJ is closing its programming departments at its stations in Gothenburg and Malmo. The quota of eight hours locally produced content will in future be met by broadcasting local opt-outs from the network's headquarters in Stockholm.

Finally, Hotline hears that Holly Diener is tipped to replace Sarah Silver, who departed for BMG a few weeks ago, as VP marketing Columbia at Sony Music Europe. Diener worked for several years at EMI France, where she was in charge of international repertoire.

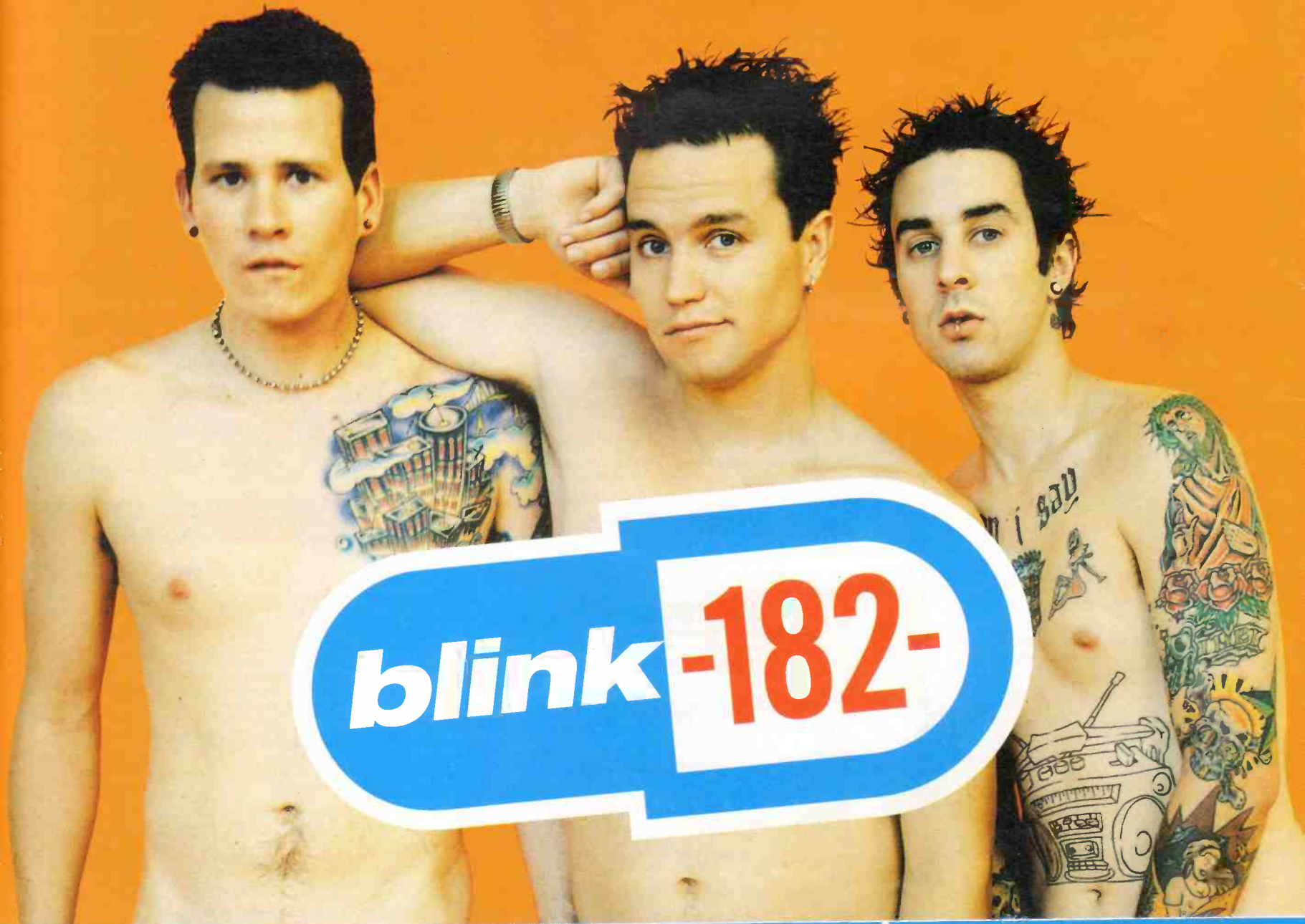
