

Capitol have released the single "What Now My Love" by Gilbert Becaud, the composer, on the eve of his opening at Comedie Canadienne in Montreal. This version is done in English and has already been picked by many GMP stations. Tickets to his concert were apparently sold out weeks in advance. Capitol have re-released the Christmas giant of last year, "Honky The Christmas Goose" by Johnny Bower and Barry Allen's "Hurry Santa Hurry". Sonny James has a newie for Christmas, "Barefoot Santa Claus". Wayne Newton has a Christmas album, "Songs For A Merry Christmas". The Lettermen have a solid sing-a-long offering of "For Christmas This Year". Lou Rawls could just make it this time with his "You Can Bring Me All Your Heartaches". His previous releases were slow movers but he finally made it into the 20's with his "Love Is A Hurtin" Thing". His album "Soulin" is selling well.

Frank Swain of Caravan sends news of the re-release of the Jackie Shane single "Any Other Way". It's on the Sue label, distributed by Trans World out of Montreal and handled in

Ontario by Caravan.

Grace Bundy of MacKay Records sent along a copy of the Jupiter single "Hey Friend Say Friend" by Donald Lautrec. This is the song that was winner of the Expo songfest and was written by Stephane Venne. The flip is the French version "Un Jour, Un Jour".

Columbia's Bob Martin has just completed the production supervision of one of the biggest sessions undertaken by Little Caesar and The Consuls. Release has been skedded for the first of the new year. The Winnipeg group The Luvin' Kind have been having fantastic sales action on their single "That Jungle Sun". Ron Waddell at CKDM in Dauphin realized the potential of this disc and made it his "pick". One of the strongest Christmas entries from Columbia is Barbra Striesand's "Silent Night Ave Maria". Simon and Garfunkle's "Silent Night, 7 O'clock News" has not been skedded for release as a single.

Reports from Ottawa have it that despite the cover by Roger Miller of "Heartbreak Hotel", the Scoundrelz are selling like a number one hit. Their Red Leaf single is also picking up chart listings across the country. The Chamber of Commerce, North Pole, Canada have a very strong side in "Jingle Bells". The flip of this Red Leaf entry is "Silent Night".

Dee and The Yeomen are beginning to reap the benefit of their British European Airways sponsored Western Canada trip. Their Reo single "In A Minute Or Two" is getting good action across the country. The boys were apparently a little upset that the tour didn't in-

clude the Maritimes where they have received good support on previous releases, but plans are now underway for them to move into the Eastern provinces for a series of appearances.

"I will keep writing about this until you people see fit to print it. The biggest problem the Canadian record industry has got to face is that our sights are too low. We seem to think that if a record is comparable to other Canadian releases, it should automatically become a hit in Canada. Not so. We are not the ones to decide. It's the people who buy the records. What everyone seems to be forgetting is this. Radio stations (especially 24 hour Top 40 outlets) are in a competitive situation with shorter playlists than a lot of people realize. Every record on that playlist is there for a purpose. It's either a hit, or definately will be. It's wonderful to be in a smaller market with no competition and a chance to be able to play some records just for the sake of exposure, but when it's your 'bread and butter' you have to be damn sure. Competition is the key word. Let's raise our sights. You're not only in competition with other Canadian records, you're in the running with the best they have to offer from Los Angeles, New York, Nashville, England, etc. You are competing with the best in the world. If Canadian records are going to break that international barrier, the majority are going to have to be a lot better. So come on, there's plenty of guys like me who are prepared to help you make it."

The American sound became big because the Americans believed in themselves, likewise the British explosion. The Canadian music industry is only asking for the chance to compete. There is no necessity to fanfare a Canadian production. Tight playlists afford an opportunity to the unknown American and British artist, why then can't the same opportunity exist for the Canadian artist? Many stations should ask themselves what records are they playing that have not been manipulated onto their charts by a far greater power. Who knows exactly why these hits ever get played in the first place.)


