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Frankie Goes to Hollywood invades North America

The first sound is the air-raid siren while a piano can be heard in the background. Then a classical-influenced build-up. Suddenly, a voice strangely similar to U.S. President Reagan enters. What's all the controversy? Well, relax. It's only a further sign that Frankie Goes to Hollywood is invading North America.

Currently Frankie is one of the most talked about acts by record buyers on the streets of probably every major North American city. Why such a fuss over yet another new music group?

Already Frankie made waves in Canada with their first release on Island Records entitled Relax. Although some stations preferred not to air it because of its lyrical content, the single still sold reasonably well, partly through word of mouth.

Soon word came yet of another new single from this British group that comes from Liverpool. The song is called Two Tribes. Already the video has been banned by the BBC. The reason — too violent. But politically, Two Tribes is a very touchy song. It takes a direct stab at the U.S. and Soviet arms race.

The video contains actors playing President Reagan and Soviet President Chernenko fighting it out in a sand pit while on-lookers watch on. Some taunt the two men to strike one another. The video was directed by exlocc members Kevin Godley and Lol Creme.

Two Tribes, which starts with the eerie sound of an air-raid siren, entered the British charts at #1. Not that Frankie had been first to achieve this. Duran Duran did the same only last year. But then Relax, formerly #1, edged its way back up the chart to #2.

Now Frankie held the #1 and #2 positions on the British chart. The Beatles did this twice. So did John Lennon and Elvis Presley. However the song then attained the largest advance order on a single since the Beatles.

At least 500,000 copies of Two Tribes had been sold in eight days. By now, Relax had gone onto become one of the biggest selling singles in the history of rock. Two Tribes could surpass this after holding the #1 spot on the British charts for nine weeks.

In Canada the anti-war song is also rocketing up charts across the country although many were first hesitant towards the first single. Both a 7" and 12" version of Two Tribes has been released by Island through MCA. A video of the song is also available, but has been labelled restricted by the Ontario Censor Board.

The band's first domestic release, to be entitled Welcome To The Pleasure Dome, is expected to be released in Canada sometime in October. Trevor Horn, a former member of Yes and the Buggles who also produced Two Tribes and Relax, is expected to produce the LP. The album is to be a double set.

Meanwhile, Island Records Canada has revealed that Frankie is expected to play Canadian dates on their tour sometime before Christmas.

Frankie is comprised of Holly Johnson, Paul Rutherford, Mark O'Toole, Brian Nash and Peter Gill. Already many have noticed the irony of another Liverpool group equaling records set by another Liverpool band,




The Beatles.

While Two Tribes has become the fastestselling British single of the 80's, the band can't understand why some are so edgy over the video.

"You only have to switch on the television news every night to see bodies of people who have been blasted and killed all over the world," said O'Toole.

"Predictably, the BBC rejected it (Two Tribes video) as being too violent. Seemingly it's okay to show people getting blown to bits on the news, but not okay to see something like this. The song is about the total futility of war, and was written during the time of the Falklands conflict." - P.M.

Cockburn's Stealing Fire LP hits gold

Toronto: Stealing Fire, Bruce Cockburn's latest True North album, has just surpassed the gold mark in Canada fueled by the success of his current single, Lovers In A Dangerous Time.

Cockburn, who just completed a tour of Western Canada after winding through the East, recently became one of the biggest draws in the history of the Ontario Place Forum drawing 30,000 in two nights. The doors reportedly had to be shut at 7 pm to prevent further fans from entering.

True North reports the current single has become his fastest seller since Wondering Where The Lions Are. The label also revealed that the singer-songwriter's new LP has become his most commercially accepted in the U.S. so far.

Both U.S. and German dates are in the works for Cockburn. Currently his album is available in Canada, the U.S., Italy, Australia, Germany and England. The guitarist is scheduled to play the Greenbelt Festival in England August 25.

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simply had to answer one question about the band, and the other about the prize - a Harley-Davidson XR-1000 motorbike.

There were three prizes in the retailer contest of \$1,000, \$750 and \$500. With CBS supplying the point-of-purchase material, the stores had to come up with the best displays, photograph it, and send them to CBS.

Vices was produced by Spencer Proffer who also produced the successful heavy metal group Quiet Riot. Proffer reportedly personally picked Kick Axe as his follow up to **Ouiet Riot.**

RPM recently spoke to George Criston, lead vocalist of the group. Why the move to Vancouver?

"The Regina club scene is not the biggest, so Vancouver was the next closest big city. The club scene is much more steady in Vancouver."

Criston said Proffer allowed a lot of freedom in the studio during the recording of the LP.

"Spencer's a genius at bringing out the best in musicians. He knows when you're good and bad. We went in with one direction and he intensified it. He brought us to our peak."

Kick Axe has recently been touring opening for Judas Preist in the U.S. One of their songs appears on the Up The Creek soundtrack and Black Sabbath is expected to record four of the bands songs for their next LP.

English material pushes Iglesias audience higher

Toronto: The audience of superstar male vocalist Julio Iglesias is continuing to grow with the release of more and more English material from the popular singer.

CBS Records, which currently has a national campaign on Iglesias that focuses especially in the markets of his recent Canadian dates, is just releasing the latest LP from the singer, 1100 Bel Air Place.

The album, which is to ship platinum, marks the singer's first English LP. The current campaign has included catalogue posters, an Iglesias poster, header cards, cassette holders and even TV buys.

Along with Willie Nelson, Iglesias captured a smash with the song To All The Girls I've Loved Before. The single is well over platinum. Now, in a duet with former Supremes member Diana Ross, Iglesias appears to have another hit with All Of You. Even the rock-oriented image-conscious CHUM-AM has charted the single. A video is now available of the song.

"Iglesias is really happening now," said Charlie Camilleri of CBS Records Canada. "He's always been important in the Quebec market, but the fact that he's doing English material has made him more marketable here. To All The Girls I've Loved Before is still selling and now we have All Of You. His demographics just keep getting wider and larger."

While in Toronto, Iglesias was presented with gold and platinum for To All The Girls, platinum for his album Pour Toi, gold for the LP Sentimental and gold for the album Julio. In addition, CBS recently released four Italian albums from the singer in Canada.

Jack Feeney pulls through

Toronto: Jack Feeney, President of Sunbury/Dunbar Music Canada, who was recently admitted to the intensive care unit of Oakville-Trafalgar Memorial Hospital suffering from chest pains, is reported to be recovering well.

RCA and Sunbury/Dunbar announced they were happy to report that Mr. Feeney has responded well to treatment and is feeling much improved. Further tests are to be conducted to determine the exact cause of the il-Iness.

The office of Sunbury/Dunbar thanks those who have sent get well greetings, but have respectfully requested that no flowers be sent since Feeney has an allergy to them. The hospital is located on Reynolds Street in Oakville.

Feeney, who began working with RCA in 1952, helped establish RCA Canada's A&R department and music publishing companies. He began with Sunbury/Dunbar in 1969.

Here at Canadore Radio we receive charts from all over the country, and most stations have an equal mix of "adult" and "acid rock". Let's face it, the two are not really compatible when it comes to programming. Few stations can program to the teeny-boppers and the "over 35 crowd" these days. We, for one, depend on RPM to supply us with a good Top 30 (or even Top 50) list of Adult Contemporary songs, and of that 50 list, we'd like to see at least fifteen with the MAPL logo beside them. After all, if the CRTC requires 30% Cancon, it might as well be reflected on the charts of a national magazine, right?





New Fixx album gets boost from national contest

Toronto: Along with an extensive national campaign, MCA Records Canada are supporting the new Fixx album Phantoms with a major national consumer/retailer contest.

Even before the release of Phantoms, stations across the country aired the recent Fixx song Deeper And Deeper, one of the highlighted tracks on the Streets Of Fire soundtrack, another MCA release.

Radio aired the track although the song did not appear on a 7" disc. But now the company has released the first Fixx single from the album called Our We Ourselves, which also comes in a picture sleeve. The B-side of the single contains Deeper And Deeper. However, the cut does not appear on the new Fixx LP.

One copy of the new Fixx LP contains a secret message. To win the tickets, the purchaser has to phone MCA by Nov. 10, with some proof of purchase.


The retail contest involves the best Fixx display by a store. With MCA providing the in-store material, the retailer simply has to send a photo of the display to their regional MCA office.



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

Frank has also released an album by Anne, titled Endlessly. Anne's product, by the way, is fourparts Cancon, with Anne and her husband Roger doing all the writing. The session was produced by Peter Berring at Vancouver's Little Mountain Sound. Distribution is handled by J.C. Enterprises in Markham, Ontario, and Emerson Short in Vancouver.

MacIntyre off with album

Harold MacIntyre, packing fairs, clubs and one nighter dates throughout the Maritimes, looks very good with his new Audiograph album, The Horse And The Rider, and this time there's enough Cancon to choke a horse. Too Much Woman, written by producer Larry Coad, has been taken as a single. MacIntyre's manager David Peever is giving a hefty promo push behind both the single and album, and of course, he now has Larry Broderick doing road work for him. With this release, MacIntyre has chalked up 14 singles, four albums and one video, which makes Harold MacIntyre and Area Code 705, one very important country band to keep an eye on.

Mary Bailey has a new single



now have a distribution agreement with RCA in Canada) and Rhonda Hart." Both acts are booked for a variety of showcases in the U.S. including D.J. Week in Nashville. The C-Weed Band has been nominated as Group of the Year for this year's ACME Awards and Hart has been nominated as Female Vocalist of the Year.

Capitol's cassette facility streamlined for growth

Toronto: In his capacity as Director of Manufacturing, Hugh Wiets is currently supervising the relocation of Capitol Records' cassette manufacturing facility - a move made possible by the July shutdown of Capitol's pressing plant for LPs, an indication of the sales gains cassettes have made in the marketplace of the '80s.

"When the volume was there, it was a cost effective situation," Wiets explains. "Our best year was 1981, when we did 7.5 million 12" units. Unfortunately, the volume had been declining to the point where the operation just wasn't viable. Fortunately for Capitol, there had been a good relationship with the plant personnel and the establishment of a "placement agency" internally went a long way to making the best of the situation. I know that under the circumstances the company did the best that it could." CBS currently presses all Capitol product.

Born in Belgium, Wiets came to Canada in 1954. An amateur musician, he worked days in a bank for a couple of years, and then started his career in the music business with Quality in 1966. Moving to Capitol in 1970, Wiets' first job at the label was in an inventory control capacity at the company's 8-track tape plant.

Capitol's cassette operation was "about 50% moved" when RPM spoke with Wiets recently, and he anticipated that the job would be completed by Sept. 1 of this year.

"This will certainly ease our future future expansion," Wiets explains. "Cassette growth has been remarkable into the '80s; we'll have a new tape duplicating room, as well as a new QC (quality control) facility."

Asked in the course of the conversation about CDs, Wiets ponders the question for a few seconds. "I don't think that the compact discs have had the impact that they were expected to have," he offers. "CDs initially had a positive image but I wonder if people are taking a second look. The cost of the software has to come down (CDs sell for as high as \$30 in some markets), and the companies will have to figure out how to crack the auto market."

Asked about Capitol's cassette product currently, Wiets replies: "In the early '80s, we analyzed and upgraded our product. We now have 60 people working in the tape plant, so our methods are labour intensive. Improvements in areas such as mastering, internal electronics, plastics, and QC have put us in a position where we can offer the marketplace a substantially improved product. Computerized QC has made for a consistently objective approach in our system."

Wiets' conclusion, as a result? "We believe that we currently market one of the best cassette products available."


