# HART-65 TRANSMITTER

**O**VER TWELVE YEARS AGO, the author wrote about a Novice transmitter with an input of 22-26 watts which cost about \$20 to build.\* Several months ago a 1967 version of this single-tube transmitter was constructed. Through the use of a modern tube, the power input can be raised to 65 watts—but the construction cost remains just about the same—\$20! Here is a Novice transmitter for 40 or 80 meters that is easy to build and provides just about the “mostest” for the very “leastest” investment.
