



Clapton and Hendrix are the new wave in blues. The extraordinary guitar talents of Clapton, Hendrix and Bloomfield have inspired not just a craze but a love for modern blues.

On the British and later the world pop scene, the impact made by the Jimi Hendrix Experience the formation of Cream with Eric Clapton, Jack Bruce and Ginger Baker was best summed up by one pop magazine which wrote that it only needed Stevie Winwood (ex-Spencer Davis) to form the perfect British group.

The strongly blues influenced style of Mike Bloomfield's guitar led many American critics into believing that the Butterfield Blues Band had started a whole revival for Chicago Blues

### BUDDY GUY INFLUENCE

And there are more ! Jimmy Page, now with the Yardbirds, Peter Green, ex-Mayalls Bluesbreakers, and of a slightly different lik Steve Cropper, genius guitarist.

Behind so many contemporary blues-inspired guintists, is the legend of Buddy Guy. Guy had strong influences on Mayall, Jeff Beck, and the top two new wave, blues groups on the world pop scene Jimi Hendrix Experience and Cream.

Both groups are trios with guitar, bass guitar and drums. Both Experience and Cream are strongly experimental, but nevertheless, blues-rooted and both are setting trends in Britain and America. But somehaw neither are con-

Clapion admires Hendrix. It's reported that when Jimi Hendrix first Played in London about October, 1966, Clapton came around to listen and wouldn't leave till Hendrix finished.

### HISTORY OF HENDRIX

Hendrix experience as a musician is crusiderable for a 22-year-old. Born in Seattle, the wild-haired, spade guitarist first played with the big Motown singers, the Isley Brothers, but later returned to Nashville. There he joined a touring company featuring some of the best blues and soul men in the States.

What Hendrix learned from B. B. King, the immortal Sam Cooke who was killed in Los Angeies, and Soloman Bourke is incalculable!

Later Jimi toured as guitarist for a Little Richard tour and finally left the West Coast like and Tina in Greenwich Villeau to play for virtually pothing in Greenwich Villeau nothing in Greenwich Village.

The story of how Animal, Chas. Chandler discovered him and brought him to London in September, 1986, has been told too often to repeat.
But by now Hendrix had left soul well behind,
and with the help of drum-e, Mitch Mitchell
(who left Georgie Pame to join him) and 21-year,
old bass guitarist Noel Redding he landstiled into the British pop scene

Their singles like "Hey Joe", and "Purple Haze" received mingled success, but their first L.P. "Are You Experienced" achieved in months what the Yardbirds had tried for years to find. Their second L.P. "Axis-Bold As Love", though consis-tently excellent, technically seems to lack the emotional impact of tracks like "Foxy Lady" and "Will I Live Tomorrow" and the gutsy yet precise

### HENDRIX DIGS CLAPTON

Clapton is idolised by nearly every guitarist in Britain, and many in the other countries. Born in Surrey in 1944, Eric Clapton owed a lot of his

The lacredibly fast action of both these you guitaristst makes the whole scene sound like the gunfight at the O.K. Corrall. Who is the faste guitar? But somehow considering their invention ability, this seems irrelevant.

Let's face it, Eric Clapton and Jimi Hend are the pop blues kings on the British scene.


