**LL COOL J TO APPEAR AT MUSIC BUSINESS CONFAB**







## STEVE MYERS, O.M./P.M., WVAS-FM/MONTGOMERY, ALA: WINNING FAME FOR A COLLEGE STATION

College radio stations are supposed to be places where communications majors, and anyone else who fancies themselves a hot jock, can hone their skills, develop their chops and make mistakes.

But at WVAS-FM, the station established two years ago at Alabama State University in Montgomery, the predominately professional staff is providing the student staffers with invaluable experience and bringing awards to the fold.

Under the direction operations and program manager Steve Myers, who is credited with establishing the station at ASU, WVAS-FM has managed to draw kudos from various organizations, maintain a respectable position each month in the Birch Ratings and earn the respect of students wishing to develop careers in broadcasting.

In March, the station won the United Press International Award for best documentary, investigative for

1985.

Reporter-producer Robert Forbus' five-part documentary series that explored the question: "Is there racial discrimination in the criminal justice system?" was the only non-commercial station to win such an award in UPI's division one markets covering commercial and non-commercial stations in Birmingham, Mobile, Huntsville and Montgomery.

Also in March, at the 8th Annual Black College Radio Convention held in Atlanta, WVAS-FM received the Black College Radio Station of the Year Award.

ASU joined a prestigious list of stations that have won that award including Washington D.C. powerhouse WHUR of Howard University and stations at Clark College and Jackson State University in Jackson, Miss.

Some of the station staffers who have contributed to WVAS-FM's success include: Jackie Kennedy, news and public affairs director; Carol Y. Stephens, music director and on-air talent; and engineer Gerald Wilson.

Although there are 13 paid employees working at WVAS-FM's news and public affairs department, and another

seven student staffers, news and public affairs - according to Myers - constitute only 30% of the station's overall format.

The remaining programming is devoted to a mix of jazz, oldies and contemporary hit music.

"About 60% of our music format is jazz," Myers explained, adding, "another 20% is devoted to oldies and blues and the balance is a mix of contemporary hit album tracks."

He said that Westwood One, the Los Angeles-based syndicator, supplies the station with "The Countdown," which features veteran broadcaster and journalist Walt Love.

Back in the public affairs arena, WVAS-FM also programs "In Black America," a weekly show syndicated by Texas Longhorn Network and featuring John Hanson.

The development of WVAS-FM, which has consistently captured the number seven Birch spot in the Montgomery market of 17 stations and is regularly number five among the 35+ male demographic, pleases Myers.

"It especially pleases me because I got to build a station from the ground up," he commented. "I had never

done that before, and the opportunity to see it grow confirmed that I had learned something over the years."

Myers started in radio in the late '60s in his hometown of Georgetown, S.C. and the South Carolina State University graduate worked at stations in Tuskegee, Atlanta, Chattanooga and Montgomery.

He left the booth to do concert promotions with Taurus Prods., the company behind The Commodores' "Brick House" tour.

Myers was also involved in subsequent Commodores tours, having promoted the act's shows on a market-by-market basis and handling tour merchandising.

His stint in this gig lasted from 1977-82, during which time he also created Studio Incorporated, a firm that handled various promotions, including The Gap Band's "Drop The Bomb" tour.

Myers, who also handled promotions for various college radio stations, was asked to apply for the operations/program manager position at ASU's WVAS-FM by communications and public affairs director John F. Knight, Jr.

The rest as they say is history.

# MELI'SA MORGAN



## Flying Solo To Success

Background singers have a tendency to stay in the background, no matter how talented they may be. But Capitol recording artist Meli'sa (pronounced Me-Lee-Sa) Morgan has been a happy exception to that rule.

"My ultimate goal was always to go solo," said the New York-based vocalist who once toured as a backup vocalist with Chaka Khan and did studio session work for Kashif and Whitney Houston.

"Background singing is something you do for the money, but I always felt I had something more to offer."

Morgan's debut LP, *Do Me Baby*, earned her crossover acclaim thanks to the Prince-penned title track. Produced by Paul Laurence, of Freddie "Rock Me Tonight" Jackson fame, it is an excruciatingly hot cover of a tune that was already pretty hot to begin with.

The idea for Morgan to record it came from Don Grierson, Capitol's VP/A&R Dept., a decision he probably pats himself on the back for daily.

"I liked Prince, but I was never a Prince fanatic," stressed Morgan. "I haven't gotten any personal feedback, but I heard that he really liked the arrangement, and the credit for that goes to Paul."

In describing Paul Laurence's prowess as a producer, she said: "He's wonderful, a real perfectionist. He's the type of person who insists on having lots of tapes to work with, so that he can choose from the best."

Morgan expressed gratification that "Do Me Baby" won her scores of teenage fans: "Maybe I just got them to open their ears to something besides rap! Knowing they enjoyed that record really means a lot to me."

With the exception of the Prince cut, the other seven tracks on her album were composed by Morgan ("I've been writing for at least the last seven or eight years") in collaboration with other composers.

Morgan, who briefly studied music theory at

Julliard, noted: "I find that it's better for me to write with somebody else."

"I especially enjoy working with my partner Lisette Wilson because when you come up with a fresh idea, there's somebody there to pat you on the back. She and I complement each other."

The two collaborated on Morgan's latest single, "Do You Still Love Me," which they wrote and produced together. "I like producing myself because I'm real opinionated. I've got strong ideas on everything from the way I sound to how I want to look and be presented," she said candidly.

"But to do it totally alone? That would be hard because you can't always be objective about your own music. Maurice White is someone I'd like to be produced by one day because I respect his work."

Like many black R&B/Pop singers, Morgan got her start by singing in the local church choir. "And that's where I still have to go to get my spirits reenergized," she admitted.

Her church choir background is something else she has in common with Freddie Jackson - beside sharing Paul Laurence as a chart-

busting producer and Hush Productions as their management company.

Morgan was even Jackson's date at the recent Grammy Awards. "I didn't know I was going to be his date until the last minute. The dress I wore that night was made in one day. It might've all looked planned, but it wasn't."

"It was an honor for me to go with him that night...and he is such a gentleman," she enthused.

When told that a duet between the two of them would seem to guarantee a hit record Morgan agreed. "That does sound like a great idea. But what I'd really like to record is a duet with Freddie for a movie soundtrack."

In evaluating the rapid progress she's made so far in her solo recording career, Morgan observed that "it's been a team effort on the part of me and Hush Productions. People are attracted to the glamour of this business, but I know how much hard work and effort it's taken for me to get to this point in the industry."



## RADIO SUPPORT

A successful move in the ongoing efforts to focus attention on Africa's drought victims was the 14-hour special program done by Pacific owned public radio station WPFW-FM in Washington, D.C.

"Drought of Mind: Famine of the Body," which aired March 30, 1986, covered the causes and effects of the drought in Africa, the ecological and environmental conditions that create severe crop failures, and it suggested solutions from the scientific, research and diplomatic communities.

There were no requests for contributions on the program. It was strictly a news and information forum that was broadcast internationally through the United

States Information Agency, National Black Network, Voice of America and the Nigerian News Agency.

"We didn't think it would be this successful," said



the program's co-host Greg Anderson. With Michael Hag-

bourne, Anderson interviewed scientists and researchers, members of the hunger response community and African diplomats.

Anderson is the weekly host of "African Report" on WPFW. He has been involved with two other successful events, an 18-hour broadcast last September on South African apartheid and a recent Howard University-sponsored forum on the drought in Africa.

"The importance in symbolic terms," according to Anderson, "is that this (most recent) project was undertaken primarily by people of color."

The program was independently done with little outside assistance, he added. "We can look at this as an indication of what we can do when we are able to mobilize around a cause."

He feels that the relationship between Africa and black Americans is undeniable. "We cannot divorce ourselves from the African continent. Africa is the place we came from. It defines us, whether we like it or not."

The program, which took six months to plan ("with little or no budget") was the most extensive news forum to date about African affairs, according to Anderson.

"We hoped it would set a precedent to do similar kinds of programs," he said.

This effort is a good example of the strength of community radio. Or, as Anderson put it: "Black radio is such an influential and powerful medium. It can reach an audience that might be difficult to reach any other way."

### 'GETTING A GRIP' ON TROY JOHNSON

His sound is new and so is his name: Troy Johnson. He's the latest and one of most promising young recording artists on the Kallista/Mo-town label.

In 1983, on the recommendation of H.B. Barnum, Johnson recorded the song "I Must Be Doing Something Right" for the movie "Blame It On Rio" starring Michael Caine.

A few years later, Johnson met songwriter Wardell Potts Jr. while attending a celebrity basketball game in his hometown of San Bernardino (CA). After listening to Johnson's demos, Potts introduced him to Leon Sylvers. Sylvers liked what he heard and quickly signed Johnson to the Kallista roster.

Getting A Grip On Love is Johnson's debut LP for the company. It contains nine tunes which were co-produced by the singer with Sylvers as producer.

In choosing Johnson's first single "It's You" as its recommended black single, one trade referred to him as a "photogenic teen balladeer."

"They think I'm a balladeer because of that single, but when they hear the whole LP, they'll see that I'm both a balladeer and a good up-tempo artist," he said.

Johnson certainly proves his point with "The Wonders of Your Love," a rocking love song written by Leon Sylvers.

Another too-too-serious dance track is "It's My Groove" which Sylvers' other young protege, Lushus Daim, had a hand in co-writing and producing. That track contains the cheeky lines: "I don't know what you've been jammin' to before/Compared to me it must've been a bore."

How's that for confidence? Given his proficiency as a keyboardist, bassist, guitarist and drummer, Johnson's music represents a refreshing change. Missing from his songs are the sexually explicit lyrics found in most of today's recordings.

Having a positive image is very important to the 20-year-old performer. "The style I want to project is young, energetic and sexy, but respectful. Raw energy and clean-cut, but not wimpy," he observed.

If he continues to deliver on that promise, it looks like Troy Johnson is destined for a very bright future.

## Video BRF's

### \$10,000 REWARD OFFERED FOR VIDEO OR FILM OF SAM COOKE'S 'WONDERFUL WORLD'

Rare film or video footage of the late Sam Cooke performing his classic song "Wonderful World" is worth a \$10,000 reward to Allen Klein, president of Abkco Industries and manager of Cooke at the time of his death.

Cooke, who died in 1964, apparently never performed the song on national TV and Klein has been unable to find footage culled from local shows.

The current clamour for the Cooke footage has been inspired by the sharp UK chart rise of the song in recent weeks as a re-release.

The record hit #2 three weeks ago, an event that seemed to coincide with use of "Wonderful World" in a UK Levi's Jeans commercial.

Klein is also preparing a motion picture based on the singer's life and music.

The resurgence of Cooke's music is marked by release of repackaged, remixed and, in some cases, unreleased material by the late crooner.

Last year, the live LP, Sam Cooke Live At The Harlem Square Club, 1963--One Night Stand drew kudos and the recent release of the digitally remastered recordings of Cooke's best known material, Sam Cooke: The Man And His Music, is likely to do the same.

Cooke songs such as "Wonderful World" "Witness" and "You Send Me" have appeared

in recent motion pictures. The Chicago Bear's "The Super Bowl Shuffle," a MPI Home Video release and "Iron Maiden 'Live After Death'," a Sony Video software Company release, were both certified gold during March by the Recording Industry Assn. of America's (RIAA) RIAA/Video division.

"The Super Bowl Shuffle" was also certified platinum. The only other non-theatrical release certified during March was "Wrestlemania," a Coliseum Video release, which achieved platinum.

**VID SHORTS:** Actor Roger Mosely, who just entered the music recording arena with release of his Adventure One Records single "Snake Show," was a recent host on the Black Entertainment Television (BET) program "Video Soul."

Mosely debuted the video to "Snake Show," which the "Magnum P.I." star directed and produced in Hawaii... Bud Schaezel directed the music video "State Of The Heart," the clip depicting the music from Columbia Records artist Philip Bailey's first single culled from the LP, Inside Out, the followup to his Chinese Wall hit.

Shot in Los Angeles, Bailey says that the video is more a performance rather than conceptual clip, because he wanted to highlight the music.

Schaezel has worked on videos for the Manhattan Transfer's Vocalese LP, including the selections "Night In Tunisia" and "Killer Joe."

Motown's JAMES COCHRAN and WBMX's DAISY DAVIS were feted to a gala birthday party last week which attracted a host of out-of-town guests.

Among the out-of-towners were MILLER LONDON, BEN SHEETS and MAURICE WATKINS of Motown Records; DEL RICE, KPRS/Kansas City; BERNARD MILLER, WLUM/Milwaukee; GARY LAW, WLTH/Gary; DANNY SIMS and MICHAEL HENDERSON. Of course, there was a cast of hundreds from Chi-town.

Cochran received many presents and awards, with a special plaque coming from Motown's SKIP MILLER. Daisy and Jimmy, they say that a picture is worth a thousand words. Well, here are a few thousand from your friends.

And congratulations are also in order for one of the guests at the affair, BARBARA PRIETO, the newly appointed music director at WGCI.

In town this week was Columbia recording artist PHILIP BAILEY. Philip was accompanied by Columbia's MIKE BERNARDO, FRANK CHAPLIN and manager JAMIE SHOOP.

The purpose of Philip's visit was to promote his upcoming LP *Inside Out*, to be released this week. In a conversation he talked about the ins and outs of working on a project.

Philip stated that with EWF it would take them about six months to record an LP. Now it takes him about two months. Philip also touched on the diminishing role of the studio recording artist.

He warned that musicians who do not learn the new

state-of-the-art computer equipment find themselves out of work.

Computers have replaced the musician, he feels, because they are generally cheaper and more efficient. The new electronics can duplicate any sound imaginable and once it's stored in the memory, there is absolutely nothing you can't do with the sound.

## Washington Update

### Relative AM Values Rising; Black-owned Deals Difficult...

With two-thirds of Black-programmed radio stations on the AM band, the fact that growth in value of FMs is peaking is welcome news. Analysts consider it unlikely that FM will ever get more than 75% of market share; the current figure is 70%. The FCC effort to speed technical improvements for AMs is one factor; another is impact of docket 80-90 FM drop-ins on already-crowded FM marketplace in markets 40-100.

Turnarounds are still as risky as ever, especially for new entrants with little management experience and no other properties to fall back on in the early lean years of turnaround opera-

tion. Banks generally are refusing to lend to turnaround buyers unless half the deal is equity.

To further protect themselves from station bankruptcies, banks are also refusing to make loans for more than the "stick-value"--the worth of the bar license. This bodes ill for most Black station buyers, few of whom have that much equity or have a group of stations to fall back on.

Of interest to Black buyers in the south and northeast: a great many Black-programmed, white-owned stations, mostly AMs, may be on the block in the next several years. Reason: their original owners put them on the air in the 1950s, ran them as family operations, and are now getting on in

years. However, their kids are 'Yuppies' and don't want to go back to Ohio, Pennsylvania, Louisiana, etc., to run an "ethnic" radio station.

Potential Black radio owners should get to know these families. Some, after years of programming to Blacks and earning a living from Black listeners, might see the wisdom of doing business with a Black purchaser when the time comes to retire... **Job Update: Where to Go to Get into Radio...**

NBMC's EEO Resource Center, which gets job announcements from over 60 group owners, reports difficulty in finding Blacks to send to many perfectly good markets. Reason: everyone says they only want to work in L.A., Chicago, New York,

or in "growth" markets like Orlando, Houston, Dallas, Durham.

Cities Blacks with 0-3 years experience seldom say they want to go to: (1) anyplace cold (Buffalo, Syracuse, Minneapolis, Seattle); (2) anyplace small (Montgomery, Ft. Wayne, Fresno); or (3) anyplace where relatively few Blacks live (Madison; Spokane; Colorado Springs).

If you need a job or know someone who does, it makes good sense to consider these cities. Three reasons: (1) the jobs are there for the asking; (2) stations have EEO requirements and wouldn't be writing to NBMC if they didn't have trouble meeting them; (3) the listeners there need Blacks in media to serve them.

## KAZUMI WATANABE'S MOBO SPLASH PROVIDES CONTEMPORARY EAST-WEST FUSION



Japan has long been a haven for jazz musicians to steadily work, be appreciated and, in the warmest regard, imitated by local artists.

One Japanese artist who has culled the improvisational qualities of this

idiom and fused it with his own sense of R&B, reggae and traditional Japanese music textures is Kazumi Watanabe. Watanabe's *Mobo Splash* LP, his fourth for Gramavision Records (which is distributed by PolyGram Records) is the latest in his rich melange of sound.

The guitarist, who plays a headless six string Steinberg, and various electronic instruments, is a master at mixing American and Japanese musicians in a free-form setting and letting it rip.

His widest U.S. exposure came with the Gramavision release of his *Mobo I* and *Mobo II* albums which featured sessions with players such as bassist Marcus Miller, drummers Steve Jordan and Omar Hakim, saxophonist Michael Brecker and Jamaican "riddim" moguls Sly Dunbar

Poets say you cannot go home again. They say you cannot recapture days of glory past. Perhaps not. But through the efforts of a young man not yet born when we first gathered on West Grand Blvd. at home - Detroit - on a recent weekend it was once again a magical place.

Missed connections and delays had me slipping into my seat as the lights went down and a time warp descended on the city. Echoes of the past emerged as MAURICE KING's voice introduced the overture and JIM WHITE.

As the crowd settled down there was a sprinkling of industryites to be seen (BOOTSIE COLLINS, CBS guys), but mostly it was just Detroiters eager to remember when.

The place was the Fox Theatre (where the Motown Review really played). The show is called "The Detroit Sound Review" and it is the brainchild of Jim White, local record producer and executive producer of the "Stars of Tomorrow" (WJBK-TV, the CBS affiliate in Detroit).

What Jim was striving for was to have the audience leave the theatre feeling that they had actually experienced seeing the superstars of Motown "live." And he succeeded.

All the youthful enthu-

siasm, the boundless energy and raw talent were there. They erupted onstage in amazingly accurate imitations of the SUPREMES, SMOKEY ROBINSON and the MIRACLES (RON BANKS of the DRAMATICS did a sensational Smokey), STEVIE, the FOUR TOPS, the VANDELLAS, GLADYS KNIGHT and the PIPS and others.

Naturally, I was interested to see who would turn up as the TEMPTATIONS. It was the group who recorded as ENCHANTMENT - and didn't they turn the place on its ear?

The show was a happy trip down memory lane. Jim White and the talent he assembled all deserved the hearty cheers they received at the show's end.

A trip to see the show should be approached as a wonderful, if sometimes bittersweet, way of recapturing something gone forever. Both MARVIN and TAMMI are gone, but if you closed your eyes in the darkened theatre, they lived again.

Despite all the volumes that have been written, the TV shows that have been produced and won awards, the historian's dissertations - and being a part of it all - it still makes me stop and wonder in amazement at how much talent there was in that place at that time.

and Robbie Shakespeare.

Of those sessions, Watanabe has said, "With Mobo my musical world was enlarged.

"The small things in life inspire my images: memories, a scene, the people I've met.

"A universe where I have never been will sometimes create new ideas, new compositions," he continued.

Mobo Splash, the follow-up to last year's Mobo Club, also features Brecker, this time with fellow saxophonist David Sanborn and American bassist Gregg Lee.

Japanese drummer Shuichi "Ponta" Murakami and vocalist Ichiko Hasimoto also provide standout performances on the new wax.

The eight tunes on Mobo Splash cover a spectrum of sound which underscores Watanabe's early influences and playing experiences.

Larry Coryell and Jimi Hendrix are listed as influences on Watanabe's style, which he continued to sculpt as a player with artists such as Jaco Pastorius, Lee Ritenour, Harvey Mason, Gary Burton and the group Steps Ahead.


