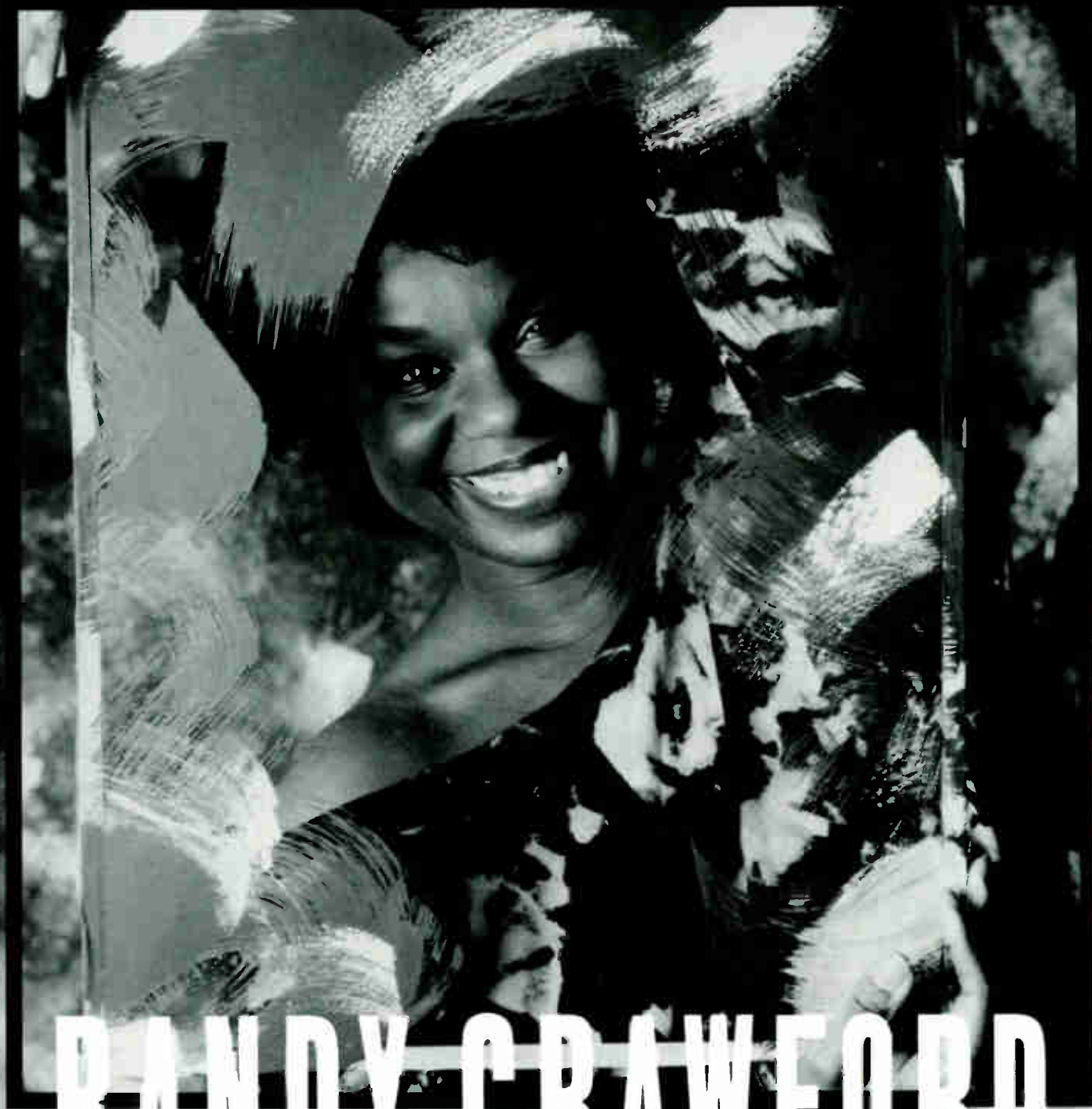

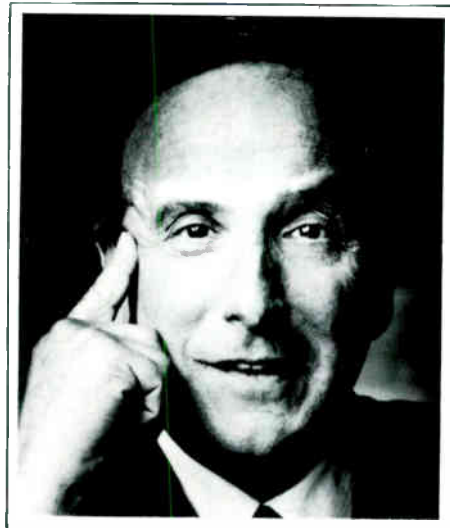

COMMENTARY

IS RADIO TOO CONSERVATIVE

The following is an excerpt from an address presented by Davis, President of Arista Records, at the recent Music Business Symposium in Los Angeles.

There are large and vital areas of modern music that are being disenfranchised by all radio formats which, it seems to me, have made arbitrary and narrow decisions about what listeners will and will not accept. And because of those decisions, record companies become more and more cautious about what types of music get recorded.

Is there a creative void? I don't think so. Because on black radio, where there is still an openness to the new, there has been an explosion of new talent and revitalized talent. It's no accident that Prince—who was once booed off the stage by the rock fans at a Stones concert, due, at least in part, because rock radio is so segregated that its listeners have little tolerance for black performers - has inherited the mantle of both Elvis Presley and Bob Dylan, with the ability to both outrage and provoke. And you will hear more sharp, pointed social commentary in one track by Run-DMC

than you will in a random hour of most AOR programming.

Not that black radio doesn't have blind spots of its own. As we approach Black History Month, it's important to note that there are whole sections of the black music tradition that have been just as exiled from black radio as the poet-laureates have been kept off black radio.

The music comes from blues, soul and jazz, but you won't hear southern soul music. And jazz has been relegated to the isolation of "Quiet Storm" programming.

It wasn't always this way and both white and black stations have to share the blame. Something has been lost over the past ten years or so, an ability to move freely between different styles of music without running into the strong arm of musical border patrol.

Just so we don't let Top 40 radio get off the hook so easily, gloating about its liberal open-door policy, it should also be pointed out that a disturbing tendency has been taking place on that end of the dial as well.

Has anyone noticed that the only way to get a straight [no reference to sexual orientation intended] pop ballad on the radio is if it is sung by a black artist?

Candidly, I doubt very much if Whitney's "Saving All My Love For You" would have gotten a fraction of the attention it did if it were performed by a white singer.

If it's one thing we need now, it's to be even more adventurous, take more chances. If a record company is going to take on the economic burden of launching a new artist, it'd be nice to know that, at least, the airwaves will be open to something new. Nobody's asking for guarantees, just a fair shot, so talent that has a right to be heard has a chance to be heard.

I think we are now on the threshold of exciting, new music. We can either succumb to a state of complacency, or break down the barriers that now exist. The choice rests with us.

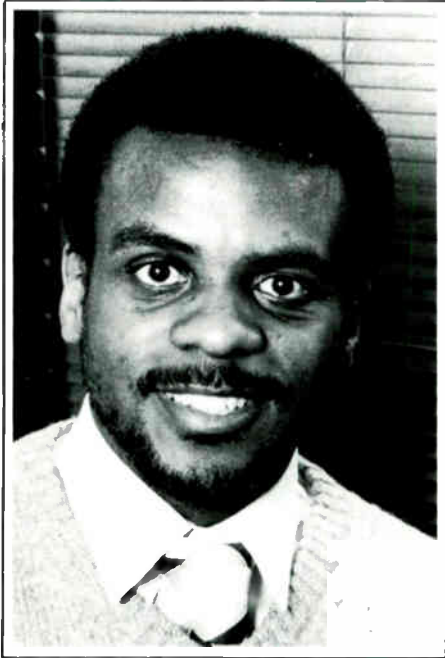

BUGGS MOVES TO WBLS-FM

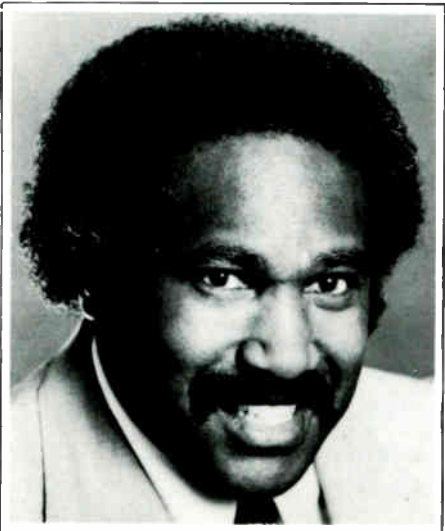

Buggs replaces Maye James at the Inner City outlet, where he worked previously from 1974-76. He also had a brief stint at Philadelphia's WUSL-FM ("Power 99").

Robin Washington has been selected to fill the Music Director's post vacated by Buggs. She has worked as an assistant programmer at both KISS and WOR-AM.

GRIFFEY TO RECEIVE SERVICE AWARD



Los Angeles: Dick Griffey, Chairman of the Board of Solar Records, will receive

the USC Ebonics Support Group's Outstanding Community Service Award. The organization assists black and other minority students attending the University of Southern California.

Griffey, a longtime supporter of black business, education and a political activist on behalf of civil rights, will deliver the keynote address at USC's Annual Awards Dinner for Ebonics on June 11th.

KDAY SOLD IN \$600 MILLION DEAL

Los Angeles: Rollins Broadcasting of Atlanta, GA, has announced the sale of KDAY, its urban outlet here, as part of a \$600 million "stock options" deal.

Heritage Broadcasting (a Des Moines, IA-based cable concern) has purchased all of Rollins' radio and television properties, along with its outdoor billboard advertising companies.

The deal is expected to be finalized within six months. According to Heritage officials, there will be no changes in management at the station.

LITTLE JOINS BRE AS SOUTHEAST REPORTER

Los Angeles: BRE publisher Sidney Miller has announced the selection of Jacksonville, FL-based broadcast vet Marc Little to serve as a correspondent covering the Southeast.

According to Little, his column will be based on "input from programmers and music directors, along with anyone else who is doing anything in Southeast radio."

Miller commented: "I have been looking for many years to get the Southeast to become more active with BRE and now the search is over. Little has been an active booster of black radio in that area and I feel his journalistic abilities will give the Southeast the exposure it deserves."

Little's background includes a stint as Operations Manager at WPDQ/Jacksonville. He is currently the president of Urban Media Consultants, a full-service public relations and advertising agency.

MURPHY FORMS TV CO., SIGNS PARAMOUNT AGREEMENT

Los Angeles: Eddie Murphy has formed his own television production company, as part of a long-term exclusive agreement with Paramount Network Television. He will be involved in the development of dramatic and comedy series, telefilms and TV specials.

According to John S. Pike, executive vp of network television for Paramount, Murphy "has established himself as a major force in every facet of entertainment."

The comedian/actor is currently completing his starring role in Paramount's theatrical film, "The Golden Child."

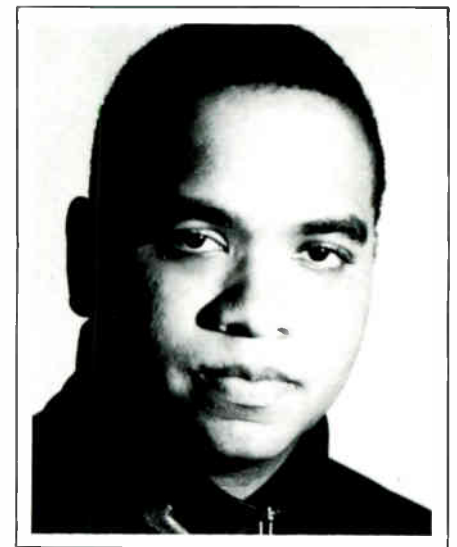
KGFJ SATELLITE MOVE PROMPTS UNION NEGOTIATION

As reported earlier, KGFJ is scheduled to begin broadcasting the Satellite Music Network's "Heart and Soul" format on June 1.

While air personnel will be affected by this move, there are no reported changes slated for the sales staff.

Commenting on Stephney's appointment, Russell Simmons, President of Def Jam, said: "[He] has the right mix of street knowledge and industry savvy to be valuable to the label."

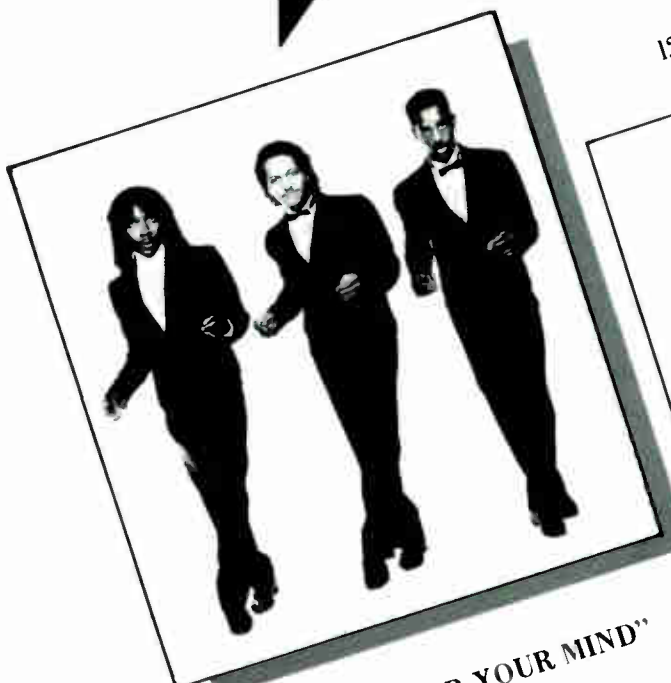

THE FAT BOYS



Shooting Up The Charts At Sutra

Contributor Judy B. Hutson is a New York-based journalist who now works as a publicist for the Fat Boys' management and promotion firm, Tin Pan Apple, Inc. The Fat Boys have become one of the biggest success stories in the world of rap and achieved mainstream acclaim on an international basis thanks to catchy hit records [like their current single, "Sex Machine"] and a distinctive media image that is built on full-bodied fun and boundary-crossing charm.

Though they are heavyweights in terms of commercial success and fame, it's Judy Hutson's belief - from an "insider's perspective"-that the Boys are as unaffected and down-to-earth as they were in their pre-hit records. The following article is her humorous account of what it's been like working with the three biggest household names of hip hop/rap:

"Big and Beautiful" not only describes the Fat Boys' latest album. It also describes the Fat Boys themselves.

The first time I saw the Fat Boys was early in their career performing at an outdoor stadium in Mt. Vernon, N.Y. Three fat teenagers came onstage and performed what quickly became their first hit single, "Fat Boys." They wowed the audience and the crowd went especially wild when those three rotund kids performed their graceful [but comic] dance

steps. I couldn't believe how agile they were! I knew at this time that they were special and could make it in the business.

My enthusiasm for the group led to an assignment to interview them for People. During that interview, which their parents attended, they were perfect angels. Later, when I started working with them, I met the real Fat Boys. On last year's Fresh Fest tour, they were responsible for endless practical jokes.

Once they tricked Jimmy, our tour coordinator, by snitching all the hinges from his briefcase—a fatal discovery that Jimmy made when it suddenly flew apart during his rush through an airport baggage check. But that's only the half of it. Everytime we would roll into another city, Kool Rock-ski [a chronic prankster] would tell every man he met—from bellhops and skycaps to waiters—that I thought the guy was "sexy" and wanted to meet him. From hotel to hotel I would get these strange smirks from the personnel. It was often pretty touchy when I'd attempt to deny Kool's claims - especially when he would flash me his typical Cheshire cat smile over some unsuspecting bellhop's shoulder!

And talk about generosity! During a recent "Miami Vice" shoot, Prince Markie Dee and I went shopping for the required wardrobe. It was like pulling teeth to get him to stay in one place and choose the right clothing. But afterwards,

he still treated me to bags of Neiman Marcus candy and a sumptuous meal at Wendy's.

Although they have only been in the business for three years, I've watched them mature not only as people but as performers. Though still in their teens, they can work a stage at a small club as well as a 15,000 circus audience at Madison Square Garden. And in an interview situation - whether it's with Rolling Stone, network television or a small town reporter - they are the very picture of cool assurance. Still, maturity doesn't prevent them from shooting spitballs at the cameraman while the interviewer isn't looking.

The Fat Boys have already met and worked with some of the biggest stars in the industry. They will star in their second movie this fall and Fat Boys clothing, toys and even a TV series are in the works. Pretty heady stuff, but they all still live at home in houses they bought for their parents. And you can still find them cruising in their cars in their old neighborhood...just "chillin'" with their friends.

Undoubtedly, the Fat Boys are big, both in size and accomplishments. They've got two gold records, one movie, numerous music awards, television appearances and commercials to their credit, but it's those winning personalities that really make them beautiful!

CABLE CHANNELS HEATING UP THEIR INVOLVEMENT WITH MUSIC-VARIETY, MUSIC VIDEO SHOWS

Although there has been considerable attrition among broadcast music video programs [and music variety programs in general] during the first half of 1986, cable TV is remaining the staunch supporter of this kind of programming.

Leading the way, of course, is MTV and VH-1 along with Black Entertainment Television's [BET] "Video Soul and "Video Vibrations."

But Home Box Office's [HBO] Cinemax is stepping up its involvement on two fronts.

"Maxtrax," a monthly, half-hour music video show featuring a chirping robot named Max Headroom, returns to the cable signal during May, June and July.

Among those artists and videos featured during the May and June segments include Grace Jones and her "Love Is The Drug" video and "Rise" by Public Image Ltd.

Another Cinemax entry into original programming is "Cinemax Sessions," a series designed to take the viewer backstage to jam sessions by artists such as Fats Domino, Ray Charles, Jerry Lee

Lewis and Ron Wood.

Scheduled to premiere in July, the first segment of this musical showcase program will feature Fats Domino and



friends, including Charles, Lewis and Wood of the Rolling Stones.

Taping of the program will take place June 5 in Domino's hometown of New Orleans.

"Ain't That A Shame," "Blueberry Hill" and "The Fat Man" are among the tunes to be spotlighted during Domino's segment.

WASHINGTON UPDATE

How the white fellows get the sweetest deals..last week we promised to tell you why white stations entrepreneurs looking for stations to buy seem to wind up with the nicest deals for black programmed outlets. Here's why: blacks don't **know** about the deals.

Sometimes such white owners do genuinely try to seek out black buyers. They have one problem, usually of their own making, however: The most logical person to buy the station might be the station's own sales director or program director. The sales director is almost always white. The program director is usually black - but probably never had a chance to learn the business of entrepreneurship.

The owner never bothered to think ahead and train the program director to run the radio stations. Too often, the program director didn't think to get the training either. Reason: 20 years ago, he or she probably never dreamed of actually owning anything more significant than a house or a car. Frequently the station will have a black announcer smart enough to run any station. We all know such a person. Maybe the announcer has been there 20 years. He made \$200 a week in 1966 - big money then - but lost

favor with the youth as he outgrew them. Now he's still making \$200 a week. Someday he'll be put out to pasture with no marketable skill. He could have been an entrepreneur, but to the station owner he was never more than "a piece of talent."

Why don't black group owners - many of whom are very well known - hear about the really nice deals? Don't the brokers call them? Some brokers do. There's one black broker [out of 90] and maybe a dozen who keep in touch with black group owners with some regularity. However, many brokers have yet to reach the point where they automatically think of blacks as potential station owners. They call their usual network of white-owned station groups and collect their 5%.

Some brokers have other reasons not to call blacks. Example: the buyer might prefer to deal only with other whites. Pretextual reason: "All blacks know each other. If the jocks see a black station owner parading through the station they'll know it's for sale and leave." Another: "Blacks can't keep a secret from other blacks. If I tell a black entrepreneur that the station's for sale, he'll call his friends on the staff the next day

and cut the station out from under me." Still another [from a "liberal," this time]: "We all know how hard it is for blacks to get loans, what with racism and all. So I just can't take the chance that a black station owner won't get financing and stick me with the station. It's safer for me to go to whites, who can always get the money."

Of course some stations aren't even sold by brokers. If you don't play golf with the owner, you don't have a chance at doing the deal. Other than wishing for a law banning racism, here's what you can do about this:

[1] Start playing golf with the station owner. If you don't play golf, learn the game. Or get a boat and take him out on it. Join organizations he belongs to. Have him over for dinner once in a while.

[2] Call several brokers every month. Make sure they know you have money - if you do. If you don't, act like you do, then go get some.

[3] Have your best white friend look for a station for you, especially if he's a broadcaster, lawyer or broker. That's not as silly as it sounds. Remember how you bought your first house?

STATION BREAK

BYRON PITTS, P.D. WIGO/ATLANTA: PROGRAMMING BLACK, NOT URBAN

In some markets, whether they be considered "urban" or "secondary," it is only important to have a distinct identity,



whether in the musical or ethnic sense.

At WIGO in Atlanta, program director Byron Pitts, prefers both.

Noting that the station is an AMer and that the majority population in this dynamic southern city is black, Pitts claims that many of the marketing tactics employed by black-oriented stations, often referred to in this era as "urban," aren't necessary at WIGO.

"Just about all urban stations have to program to white audiences," Pitts told BRE recently, "but AM stations can't do

the same things that most urban [FMers] can.

"We don't have to play to white audiences in Atlanta to get numbers; we also don't have to worry about offending anybody."

Pitts maintains this attitude despite ranking 23rd in the Atlanta market with a 1.5 ARBitron rating.

The station's programming base consists of acts such as New Edition, B.B. King, Cherrelle and Alexander O'Neal, Prince, Yarbrough & Peoples and Five Star.

"I don't actively go out and seek records from acts such as Madonna and Culture Club," he said, adding, "there are enough stations in town that must play the music to get to their specific audience."

Pitts said that WIGO goes after a "higher demographic," mainly the 25-40 crowd. "But we don't totally ignore the younger demographics," he continued, noting that the station programs rap from seven to midnight on the weekends.

Pitts observed that market competitor V-103 "goes after yuppies," but that WIGO's audience is the 'basic black' community.

"We have full news, public affairs and sports programming," Pitts said, "and it's all directed to the black community in Atlanta."

"About 85 percent of the news, public affairs and sports is aimed at the Atlanta

[black] community," he added, further saying, "the remaining 15 percent is national news but geared toward regional interests."

Pitts said that news director Marsha Bryant offers up heavy doses of community news, with frequent followups and expert actualities on current events. As an example, Pitts noted the station's coverage of the current fervor over the killing of elderly women in Atlanta.

Balancing out all of the doom-and-gloom news, WIGO also concentrates on the 'good news'- with uplifting weekend gospel shows. Gospel is programmed each Saturday from 5:00A.M. to 10:00A.M. and on Sundays from 5:00A.M. to 3:00P.M.

According to Pitts, "The unique thing in Atlanta is that you can get back to black programming."

The Buffalo, NY native has some basis for comparison, having come from that area's rich tradition of radio, including the airwaves of WUFO.

"I got into radio right after graduating from high school," Pitts explains. His first job was as a part-timer at WUFO.

Pitts has also worked for stations such as KKDA in Dallas and KDKO in Denver - experience which, he says, has given him a very useful perspective on urban radio.

"I almost always had to take into consideration an audience beyond the core," he said.

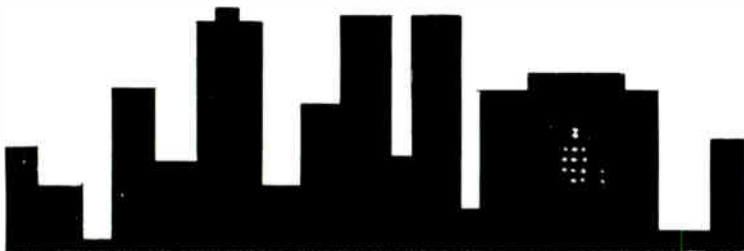

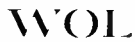

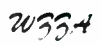

HENNESSY JAZZ TALENT HUNT HEATS UP IN SEMI-FINALS IN THREE CITIES

As of April 1, more than 400 cassette entries had been received by officials of the Jazz Search.

That bulky group has been trimmed to a mere nine, with three each from the participating cities, New York, Chicago, and Los Angeles.

The nine semi-finalists are vying for the winning spot which will permit the act to perform at the 1986 Playboy Jazz Festival at the Hollywood Bowl and to record a master quality demo tape from Cranberry Records.

Throughout the screening process, semifinal and final round, entrants have been and will be judged on the basis of creative jazz playing and/or singing; technique; and overall sound.

The semi-final rounds were held concurrently on May 14th in the three cities.

The New York semi-final performances were held at Gotham's Playboy Club and featured the Stephen Hall Quartet, the Bob Weller Septet and the Irene Rosnes Quintet.

Irene Rosnes and her Quintet won the New York competition. Among the New York judges were former Weather Report drummer Peter Erskine, Columbia Records jazz chieftain Dr. George Butler and bassist Milt Hinton.

Chicago's semi-final competition was also held at the Playboy Club in Lincoln Park and hosted by local news anchorman Harry Porterfield. The Kendrick Gueno Quintet, a final round competitor last year, returned to competition at the Chitown event along with vocalist Ida McBeth and her quintet and the Gregory Shearer Quintet.

It was Ida McBeth and her vocalese interpretations that won. Judges for the event included jazz writer Harriett Choice, jazz musician Bunky Green and jazz educator Larry Kovak.

The John Gross Trio, Slow Burn and Terra Nova were the three competitors at the Los Angeles Playboy Club, site of southern California's semi-final round of the Hennessey

competition.

The quartet vocals of Terra Nova wooed the Los Angeles audience.

The winner will join Herbie Hancock, B.B. King, the Maynard Ferguson Orchestra and Nina Simone, among others, on stage during the Sunday segment of the festival.

Saturday will offer a cornucopia of music during the afternoon, evening and midnight cabaret sessions.

The afternoon lineup-features Terrence Blanchard, Donald Harrison and Mulgrew Miller in a set; the Kevin Eubanks Quartet and the Jerri Allen Octet.
