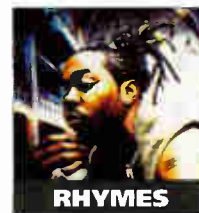

## Still A Place For Gut Instinct

For many PDs, programming music has become more of a science and less of an art. With the greater availability of research—even in the smallest markets—more reliable charts with the advent of Broadcast Data Systems, programmers need only hit a key on their computers to see what songs have the greatest familiarity or flip to the back pages of *Airplay Monitor* to see which song has the most increase in spins.

But even with these valuable tools, there are some PDs who still find a place on their stations for gut instinct, often leading the way on playing the songs that become the biggest hits in their format.

### LL Gets 'Better' With Age

Despite one of the longest, most consistent careers in rap, it has taken LL Cool J 10 years to get a No. 1 airplay record. And it was only six spins away from not happening. The veteran rapper's "Luv U Better" (Def Jam/IDJMG) dethrones Missy "Misdemeanor" Elliott's "Work It" (the Gold Mind/Elektra/EEG), which still gains spins, trailing LL by a mere six plays. There hasn't been such a small spin difference since Aug. 7, 1999, when "So Anxious" by Ginuwine led "Bills, Bills, Bills" by Destiny's Child by only four spins.

LL Cool J has reached No. 1 on the *Airplay Monitor* rap chart in the past. "Hey Lover" held that crown for 11 weeks, beginning in November 1995, followed by six chart-topping weeks in August 1996 with "Loungin." But his breakthrough record and biggest hit until now, 1987's "I Need Love," only reached No. 3 on the *Billboard* R&B Airplay chart at the time.

*Billboard Bulletin* reports that New Edition has signed to Sean "P. Diddy" Combs' Bad Boy Records and plans to release a new album in spring 2003. The current lineup of the former teen-pop quintet comprises Ricky Bell, Michael Bivins, Ronnie DeVoe, Johnny Gill, and Ralph Tresvant. Original member Bobby Brown chose not to take part in the project. Bad Boy, which terminated its joint venture with Arista in June, is still seeking a distribution deal.

### Cox Severs Ties With Indies

Cox Radio has become the first major group to officially dismantle its relationships with independent promoters. Cox issued a statement Oct. 18 that "at the expiration of its current agreements with independent promoters, Cox Radio will deal directly with record companies at all of its radio stations."

In a statement, Cox president/CEO Robert Neil says, "The record companies have expressed a desire to work directly with the stations, and we are granting them their wish. It is our hope that the record industry will show their commitment by forging even stronger ties with our stations."

The stations affected are R&B WBHJ Birmingham, Ala.; top 40s WBTS (the Beat) Atlanta; WHZT Greenville, S.C.; KTHH Houston; KXME Honolulu; WPYM Miami; WBLI Long Island, N.Y.; WPYO Orlando, Fla.; and KCJZ San Antonio; AC KRTR Honolulu; album outlets WBAB Long Island and KRTQ Tulsa, Okla.; and modern rockers WDYL Richmond, Va., and WSUN Tampa, Fla. No other Cox stations have exclusivity deals with indies. The *Los Angeles Times* reports that the deals were worth an estimated \$1 million per year.

Clear Channel, meanwhile, says it does not have any plans to follow Cox's lead by cutting ties with indies, according to *The Hollywood Reporter*. The company says it addressed the indie issue more than a year ago by barring its 1,200 stations from keeping the money promoters pay, funneling it instead into corporate coffers. In so doing, CC spokesperson Pam Taylor says, "We've removed the possibility of any implication of impropriety."

Meanwhile, an Infinity spokesperson tells *Airplay Monitor* that it has no exclusivity deals and will continue to deal with independent promoters as part of its "open door policy... We would certainly work with [indies] as we work with the labels."

Emmis Communications president of radio Rick Cummings says, "I don't anticipate anything will change at the moment. We enjoy good, above-board relationships with those promoters who have been our partners, and we do see value created." That said, Cummings notes that indie deals are fairly new to Emmis and says, "I've asked the managers what their take on it is. I don't expect an answer like Cox, but we'll see."

And the *Times* reports that Cumulus Media CEO Lew Dickey says, "We have total confidence in the system as it's set up. We are comfortable with it."

### POWER 106 TO DISCLOSE SHEIST TIES

Meanwhile, the *Los Angeles Times* reports that Emmis' KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles has decided to disclose on-air the connection between rapper Shade Sheist, APD Damion Young—who produced Sheist's current project—and Emmis, which has a stake in Sheist's imprint, Baby Ree Entertainment. After an Oct. 16 story in which the *Times* highlighted the disproportionate airplay for Sheist's "Money Owners" (380 times, "nearly triple the amount of the 30 other stations across the nation that aired it"), and subsequent tracks from the project, Cummings told the paper, "We're going to air disclosure if it makes people feel better. We don't have to. We see this as an extra effort to try and separate church and state for the audience." Cummings also noted in both stories that Young was not allowed to discuss Sheist in the station's music meetings, as advised by the station's lawyers, and noted that Sheist's current single was a top 10 research record for KPWR.

### ACROSS THE POND

British rock AC Virgin Radio, which several weeks ago announced a ban on even mentioning teen-pop acts, has now done the same with rap and R&B, which it refers to on its Web site as "processed crap," according to Britain's *The Guardian* newspaper. In response to the predictable outrage from Britain's R&B community, PD Paul Jackson tells the paper, "To say we are racist is nonsense. There are plenty of black artists on our playlists, like Lenny Kravitz and Jimi Hendrix."

American-style ultra-high rotations have come to traditionally more conservative European radio and not without controversy. *Airplay Monitor* sister publication *Music & Media* reports that French R&B outlet Ado FM and sister top 40 network Vibration are spinning their powers 120 times per week. That's well ahead of the fastest competitor, top 40 Voltage FM Paris, at 70 spins. The new rotations have come under attack from France's version of the RIAA, whose director is concerned that "this sort of rotation can devalue a song that's overplayed [and create] less space for other artists. It's a dangerous precedent [and] very harmful to musical diversity."

### BUSINESS: PERRY'S GOT MORE FOR TERRY

Perry Broadcasting picks up five more stations in Oklahoma: country KRPT Anadarko, top 40 KDDQ-FM Comanche, N/T KXCD and country KKEN Duncan, and N/T KXCA Lawton. The company already owns KJMM and R&B oldies

### Expo Turns A Little 'Funny' In J'ville

KGTO Tulsa, KVSP Oklahoma City, KJMZ and R&B oldies KKRX Lawton, and has an LMA with ethnic-brokered KEBC Oklahoma City. OM/PD Terry Monday will add oversight of all the new stations in the company. Perry Publishing also owns newspaper *The Black Chronicle* in Tulsa.

After a second attempt to persuade the FCC to reduce its fine at WBOT (Hot 97.7) Boston, Radio One gets the \$21,500 fine reduced by more than half, to \$9,200. The fine was originally levied against the station for failing to produce its public file for an FCC field agent, as well as EAS violations. Radio One proved that it did indeed keep a public file, but that the person helping the agent was not aware of it.

### PROGRAMMING: HOT 107.1 PUT ON ICE

Former WPHI Philadelphia PD/morning man Anthony "Luscious Ice" Harris resurfaces at KXHT (Hot 107.1) Memphis as OM/morning host. He'll also oversee triple-A sister WMPS (the Pig). Boogalo Boyer remains PD at Hot 107.1.

Radio One-owned adult R&B WDMK Detroit segues to R&B oldies. A similar move is expected at co-owned WILD Boston. Back in Detroit, WDTJ (105.9 Jamz) moves mixer DJ Zap to late nights to host *Sexin' Next to the Radio*, replacing Earl McKinney.

Former gospel WAOK-AM Atlanta veteran personality Connie Flint takes on PD/afternoon duties at crosstown gospel WPZE (Praise 97.5), while Melissa Summers, last APD/middayer at rival adult R&B WALR (Kiss 104.1), joins for mornings. They replace Larry Young, who exited earlier this year... In other gospel news, WALT Meridian, Miss., flips to N/T.

WAMO-FM Pittsburgh has moved its transmitter closer into the city, increasing coverage of the market.

Michael Newman is now consulting WKPO Madison, Wis.

### PEOPLE: TAYLOR'S HOT, NOT WILD

Rhythmic top 40 KYLD (Wild 94.9) San Francisco middayer Rene Taylor, who had been doing the show via voice-tracking, opts instead to concentrate on her duties on-air at her home station, adult R&B KHHT (Hot 92.3 Jamz) Los Angeles. She's replaced at KYLD by P/T Dreena Gonzalez.

Adult R&B KMJM (Majic 105.1) St. Louis taps Darrel Eason for nights, replacing Brian Anthony, now in Eason's former morning gig on jazz rival WSSM. Eason will also assist PD Eric Mychaels and OM Chuck Atkins in the programming department. Eason previously worked at KMJM as a weekend personality.

WCDX Richmond, Va., realigns its lineup now that former night jock Zulu has crossed the street to handle nights for rival WBTJ (the Beat). Big Nat and DJ Foot, aka the Bad Boyz, take on nights. The rest of the lineup features Russ Parr in mornings, Talus Knight in middays, PD Terry Foxx in afternoons, and Rosetta Divine in late nights.

### OUR CONDOLENCES

Kenneth "Lady K" Pruitt, 46, the original host of WQQK Nashville's Quiet Storm in the early '80s, died Oct. 13 of unknown causes. Pruitt was known for her advice segment "Ask Kennetha." During her tenure on the Quiet Storm, the program was the No. 1-rated night show in Nashville.

Washington, D.C., veteran talk host Ernest White Jr., 54, died Oct. 14. White was best-known for his black talk program *Crosstalk*, heard on noncommercial WUDC (Jazz 90) before the station was sold in 1997. *The Washington Post* reports that White contracted AIDS, then became homeless in the mid-'90s.

CELEBRATING THE PROGRAMMERS WHO LEAD THE WAY

## HOW LEADERS CONFIRM THEIR GUT INSTINCT

In its Airplay Leaders salute, *Airplay Monitor* recognizes programmers who have a history of finding early, then playing heavily, the most records that go on to become top 20—and sometimes top 10—records in their format. In order to do this, they need to have a certain gut instinct on music and the ability to make autonomous decisions.

But in today's research-driven radio, can you rely on gut alone? How do you gauge when you were right about stepping out on a song? And how far will you go in playing it before expecting some sort of callout results?

Of the Airplay Leaders we spoke with in both the R&B/hip-hop and adult R&B formats, many said that initial listener response like requests and sales were enough to confirm their gut. But others felt that callout was the only real test.

Brian Douglas, OM of WJMH (102 Jamz) Greensboro, N.C., says, "I look at the requests we get in the first two to three weeks playing a song. Eighty percent of the time, if you get great phones, you can expect good callout. There's only a few records that don't request well that eventually end up researching later on."

Karen Vaughn, MD/middayer at adult R&B WHQT (Hot 105) Miami, says, "When I play a new record and the listeners are calling before the song even goes off the air, then I feel we made the right call."

But for Hot 105 PD Derrick Brown, the real acid test is still "two to three weeks later when the callout has a huge number, [then I know] we were right. There are always exceptions to the rule. With Anne Nesby's 'Put It on Paper,' I didn't need any other confirmation. As soon as I heard it, I knew. We even grew to 44 spins in one week, and we never give any record that many spins."

Victor Starr, PD of WZMX (Hot 93.7) Hartford, Conn., feels it's usually the gut records "that you get the instant phones on. But I still wait three to four weeks to see what the research tells me." And in terms of how often he will bang it before the research, Starr says that "if it's an unknown artist, maybe 15 spins per week. But if it's a huge artist for us, like Jay-Z, Jennifer Lopez, or Fat Joe, we might play it every hour at the top of the hour the first day. That's to let everyone know we have it and to get immediate phones. We actually encourage listeners to call in and let us know what they think of the song. So, with a superstar artist, the first week it might get as many as 50-60 spins."

Tracy Cloherty, VP of programming for Emmis New York and PD of WQHT (Hot 97), says, "We define a hit differently than a record label. For us, a hit record is one that researches well in our callout." But, she adds, "that doesn't mean that record will sell a lot of albums. There are many records that have been huge callout records but have not translated into huge

sales, much to the record labels' chagrin."

Some stations are still entirely reliant on the old mainstays of sales and requests. Dave Dickinson, PD of adult R&B WHUR Washington, D.C., says, "When I hear comments and start getting calls from listeners wanting to know where they can buy the song, then I know I was right." But, he adds, "you have to listen closely to what they're asking. Sometimes I get calls from retailers who tell me customers are asking about a record, but they don't know what album it's on. For example, we're playing the Rashan Patterson, which is on the Steve Harvey compilation, and most people wouldn't know that. I feel if people are going out of their way to find a record in the stores, then it was a good choice to play."

Boogaloo Boyer, PD of KXHT (Hot 107.9) Memphis, doesn't have callout research. But he knows he was right on a song "when the clubs are killing it. I'm a DJ, and when I play that record I had a gut feel on, I'm looking to see if they feel it on the dancefloor. There are even some records I haven't started playing yet that the clubs force me on, like the 504 Boyz. Before I was even ready to play it on Hot, I played it at the club. When I saw everyone on the dancefloor singing every word, I knew."

### TEST IT THE FIRST WEEK?

How fast will our Airplay Leaders move up a song on requests alone? And how many spins do they feel they need before they can get a good read in callout? The answers vary from format to region.

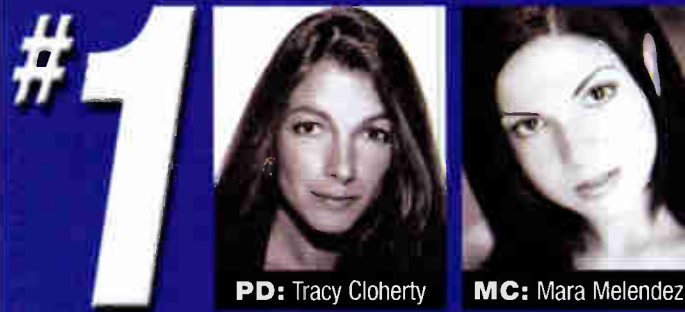
Douglas says that for his station, "I can give up to 50 spins a week, based on good requests alone. But, a record will rarely make it into power without first performing in research." That's true even for the records he says are no-brainers. "With Nelly's 'Dilemma,' we knew it was a hit, but I wanted to see the research to determine how much the audience wanted to hear it and for how long. You still need to protect it from other new or marginal mid-chart-type records."

Although labels are rarely happy to hear this, Douglas will start callout as soon as "the first week, especially if we're hitting it 50 times . . . Often, I'll see as much as 90% familiarity by the end of that week."

Cloherty says, "We don't usually put a record into callout until it has at least 100 spins—anything less and it's just not familiar enough to the audience. Once it's in our callout, we'll keep it there for two to three weeks to see if it will perform. Some records do take longer to perform and, at times, we have actually dropped records that had to be put back into rotation at a later time."

Starr points out that callout may be more important for those songs on which you don't have a gut feel or big phones. "Even if a song isn't getting phones, I'll put it into research . . . Not every record can be a 'Dilemma' or 'Work It.' Sometimes you have songs like Musiq's 'donthchange' that are very

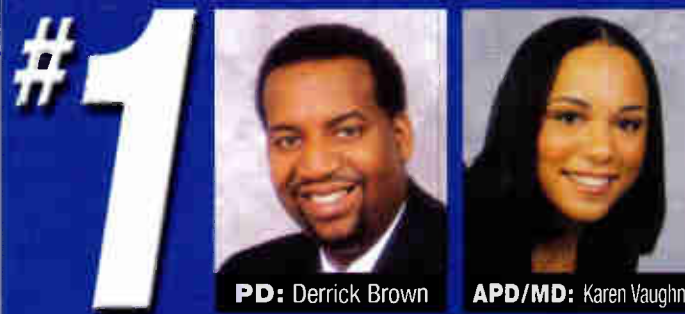

sive request-wise but end up No. 1 in callout for three months. They tend to be your midtempo and ballads and not usually the records you bang."

Boyer says that at KXHT, "I might give a song 60 spins the first week in a 'power new' position. That way, it's still protected. After that, it might take as little as two weeks to get into power—that's the fastest I've seen recently, with Nelly's 'Air Force Ones.'"

In his market, Boyer continues, it's easy to expect a quick response on hits. "I've never seen a city as reactive as Memphis, especially on the Southern and Memphis artists. There are a lot of records that work nationally that don't get over here and vice versa. So we have to pay attention to that."

On the adult R&B side, Brown says, "we can't get a fair idea in research without at least 100 spins—and I don't mean 100

overnight spins. It's rare that we would put a record into power without first researching it," although he adds that he can safely predict how some artists "with the core Hot 105 sound" will perform in research, such as "Musiq, Maxwell, Angie Stone, and now Syleena Johnson."

Dickinson says moving up a record "is a natural progression. I can't say it takes a set number of spins or weeks before I'll put it in power. It's just a feel for the song and the artist."

### KNOWING WHEN TO SAY 'WHEN'

How do the Airplay Leaders know when it's time to hang up their hats on that song they thought would be a smash but didn't pan out?

Douglas is the quickest to pull a record. "I doubt we would ever go more than two

## LEADING THE WAY ON BREAKING HITS

Welcome to *Airplay Monitor's* fourth annual Airplay Leaders issue, as we honor those programmers and stations that have led the way on breaking hits. For the past 12 months, Airplay Monitor has kept tabs on the current Airplay Leaders in each of our formats via the weekly Airplay Leaderboard. Here's how a station

qualifies as an Airplay Leader:

Each week, songs on the Monitor charts achieve Airpower status—indicating that a song is becoming a consensus hit—by cracking the top 20 in audience and detections in the same week (the song must be bulleted in both charts). The Airplay Leader is the first station to play an Airpower title 150 times (100 times in rhythmic top 40, AC, adult R&B, active rock, and heritage rock). The Airplay Leaderboard ranks stations by the number of times they were identified as Airplay Leaders.

If more than one station was an Airplay Leader on a title in a given week, all get equal credit toward the Airplay Leaderboard, regardless of which station reached the 150-detection plateau first. The final ranking covers Airpower titles from the Sept. 7, 2001, issue through the Sept. 13, 2002, issue. Ties in rank below No. 1 were broken by computing the average peak position

for all Airpower titles for which that station was an Airplay Leader, so that the stations that started the biggest hits finished higher.

Of the 10 formats measured, we have one 2001 leader earning back-to-back titles: active rock KRXQ Sacramento, Calif. This is the second year that the only repeat leader is from Sacramento. Last year, KYMX won its second straight AC crown, but its streak is snapped in 2002 as WLTW New York and WDEF Chattanooga, Tenn., tied for first. Three stations earn a second nonconsecutive No. 1 Airplay Leader title: rhythmic top 40 KXME Honolulu (prior champ in 2000), crossover and R&B/hip-hop WQHT New York (1999), and modern rock KWOD Sacramento, Calif. (2000).

WDRQ Detroit and KEYE (K102) Minneapolis top the mainstream top 40 and country leaderboards, respectively, making those the only formats to have a different leader in each of the four years of our spotlight. Among the top five ranking stations in each format, 60% did not make the cut in 2001's spotlight—giving us a fresh batch of programmers and stations to honor.

Congratulations to all our Airplay Leaders for providing songs and artists with a platform to become national successes. Meanwhile, we've already started our next Airplay Leader measurement period with the Sept. 20 issue, the results of which can be found in the Power Playlist section for each format. We look forward to seeing your station at the top of our 2003 Airplay Leaderboard.

weeks—and sometimes it has been less—if the song isn't getting any response in call-out or requests," he says, adding that with superstar artists, the expectations are even greater "if they have all the setup, the hype, and the buzz and video play as well, then they have everything it takes. If it still isn't getting calls, it probably never will."

Starr says, "At the first sign of negative feedback in your research, you should drop it. I mean, people saying they hate it or 'It sucks.' Now, I've never seen that since being here, but it could happen." But he adds that if it's a big artist with some strong history in the market, he might give it more time. "Like with the Fat Joe 'Crush Tonight.' It's a little slow right now, and I expected it to have much bigger phones, but we had the same experience [with] Joe's 'We Thuggin'." It didn't catch on until several weeks into the project."

Boyer says simply, "I'll give it at least 100-150 spins before I pull it."

Cloherly adds that you have to keep in

mind that "there are some records that we really love and may be big in the clubs or on mix tapes but they just don't appeal to the masses. If it doesn't test in our callout, eventually it's off the air. When you only play 40 current records, you can't afford to keep a song in rotation when it isn't working—there are just too many other songs that deserve a chance."

But Brown argues that "it still depends on the artist. Remy Shand is a good example. It never really tested well or got a lot of requests, but he just fit the sound of Hot 105. We stuck by it, and even now we play it about five times a week as a recurrent. Jill Scott's last song was the same way. Sometimes I have to ask myself, 'Why isn't it testing? Could it be the hook selection?'"

Dickinson adds, "If we're hitting a record 20-30 times per week, which is a lot for us, and we're still not seeing any sales or requests, then I might have to suck it up and pull it. If I'm wrong, they'll be quick to tell me they want it back on."
