

**•ROCK ROUNDUP•**

WHEN LOOKING OVER the year-end charts, I enjoy recollecting the initial assessments of colleagues and myself about the commercial potential of records released during the year. Last year, the charts were dominated by Offspring, Green Day, Stone Temple Pilots, and Soundgarden, but this year the hits were a bit different in scope. The mainstream and modern formats continued to evolve, and they incorporated more diverse sounds in '95 than in '94.

Of the year's biggest hits, I remember few being regarded in the industry as across-the-board successes upon release. Certainly, those who referred to some of the year's hits as "Soundkindergarten" or "the Wilson Phillips of alternative" have had to concede the popularity of these records, but few outside of some programmers who had the foresight to get behind a few new acts could have anticipated the enormous commercial success that some of them achieved. Who would have predicted that White Zombie would score a top 10 modern rock hit or that Blues Traveler and the Dave Matthews Band would become part of the fabric of rock radio? Consider the surprise debuts (Hootie & the Blowfish, Alanis Morissette, Silverchair, Sponge), the strong follow-up efforts (Live, Collective Soul), and the solid perennials (Pearl Jam, R.E.M., Tom Petty). Rock radio continued to evolve, and some of you predicted just how. The year-end results appear on the following two pages.

IN NO PARTICULAR ORDER, my personal favorites of '95:

- Albums: Gene, "Olympian"; Foo Fighters; Smashing Pumpkins, "Mellon Collie And The Infinite Sadness"; Soul Asylum, "Let Your Dim Light Shine"; Oasis, "(What's The Story) Morning Glory?"; the Jayhawks, "Tomorrow The Green Grass"; Royal Trux, "Thank You"; and the Beau Hunks, "Play The Original Little Rascals Music."

- Charted singles: "A Girl Like You," "Bullet With Butterfly Wings," "This Is A Call," "Time Bomb," "Got Me Wrong," "Starseed," "Perry Mason," "Army Of Me," "She Don't Use Jelly," "Last Goodbye," "Live Forever," "Sour Times," "River Of Deceit," and "It's Good To Be King."

- Concerts: Terence Trent D'Arby at Irving Plaza; Oasis, Bjork, and Ozzy at Roseland; Drivin' N' Cryin' at Wetlands; Gene at Mercury Lounge; Bad Brains at Avalon; Plant & Page at Madison Square Garden; Soul Asylum and the Jayhawks at Tramps and House of Blues; Squirrel Nut Zippers at Fez; Shudder To Think at the Mercury Lounge; Stone Roses at Webster Hall; Victoria Williams at Town Hall; Joe Jackson at the Beacon Theatre, and the Beatles' "Anthology" on TV.

## M A I N S T R E A M R O C K

### Mainstream Rock And Modern Rock Met At Radio In 1995

Collective Soul proved that 1994's "Shine" wasn't a fluke, as it garnered the No. 1 mainstream rock track honors for a second straight year, with "December." This marks the first time an act has had the No. 1 mainstream rock track in consecutive years. Only 11 tracks reached the pinnacle during 1995, all but two for three weeks or more. The longest stays at No. 1 were enjoyed by "December" (9 weeks), "Lightning Crashes" by Live (10 weeks), and Pearl Jam's "Better Man" (8 weeks).

Live was the top act of the year, with two year-end top 10 tracks, "Lightning Crashes" at No. 2 and "All Over You" at No. 7. For the second year in a row, Pearl Jam had the most charted tracks, with seven.

As the mainstream and modern formats converge musically, 21 songs ended up on both year-end charts, up from 15 a year ago. Also, many of the songs on each chart had an impact at both formats. The highest-ranked format-exclusive tracks were Brother Cane's "And Fools Shine On" at No. 5 on the mainstream chart and "Say It Ain't So" by Weezer at No. 14 on the modern rock chart.

A trend that gained momentum in 1995 was that of certain hard-rockin' tracks starting at mainstream and crossing over to modern. Among those with the most success were "Possum Kingdom" by the Toadies and "Plowed" by Sponge.

Year-end rankings represent the total number of plays received by each title, artist, and label for the 1995 Airplay Monitor year. This covers the issues dated Nov. 25, 1994, through Nov. 17, 1995.



### Silverchair Sits Atop Modern Rock's Throne For 1995

Not since **Midnight Oil** had back-to-back No. 1 singles in 1990 have the Aussies produced a chart-topping modern rock artist. This year, the young tykes in **Silverchair** helped put the Southern Hemisphere back on the musical map by taking the trophy for No. 1 modern rock track of the year. While "Tomorrow" had the most spins for any charted modern rock record this year and was No. 1 for three weeks, it wasn't the longest running No. 1 for the year. That honor went to **Live's** "Lightning Crashes," with nine weeks at the pinnacle, followed by **Green Day's** "When I Come Around," which topped the charts for seven weeks.

As had been the case for most of the year, the tremendous amount of shared records leaves few records to distinguish the modern rock format. This year, more than half of the top rock artists were shared by the mainstream and modern formats on the year-end charts. Curiously, the top mainstream chart, not the modern one, included **Soul Asylum**, **Nirvana**, **Soundgarden**, and **Stone Temple Pilots**. Out of the 20 top modern rock artists listed, **Natalie Merchant** was the only artist who didn't have a track on the mainstream chart.

Also of note are the 70 songs that made the top 10 on the modern rock tracks chart this year; only 17 of those were exclusive to modern, the majority of which were by women or woman-led acts, including **Hole**, **PJ Harvey**, **Portishead**, **Liz Phair**, and **Letters To Cleo**, furthering the idea that female artists represent some of the defining sound that differentiates the formats. Other modern-only top 10 tracks through the year were from the **Flaming Lips**, **Rancid**, **Adam Ant**, and **Edwyn Collins**.






