Classic Rock Boosters Say No 'Funeral For A Friend' Just Yet

After months of highly publicized defections and dire predictions for classic rock, one of that format's pioneers has published a format manifesto contending not only that classic rock is not dying, but that the radio landscape in 1996 is similar to that in 1985-86, when classic rock first exploded.

Classic rock is reeling from the defection of such flagships as WXRK New York—despite its best book in recent memory last fall—and KLSN Los Angeles, as well as the decision by other classic rockers, such as WYSP Philadelphia and KRQR San Francisco, to evolve into mainstream rock. Given the format's longstanding bad rap in the industry (sometimes by its own programmers), the war of attrition with Arrow and other '70s gold or classic hits outlets, many industry observers feel that the format has run its course after a decade or that it will merge with "heritage" mainstream rockers into one format playing '70s, '80s, and '90s music.

Jacobs Media president Fred Jacobs, in his memo to radio, says, "There

have been people walking around with signs for 10 years proclaiming that classic rock is dead. As a result of some of the classic rock stations that have thrown in the towel in the past 12-18 months, [people have] accelerated those dire predictions."

But, Jacobs contends, "conditions today are similar to when classic rock first got going. When you think back to 1985, the emphasis was on hot hits and new music. [What made] the classic rock position so intriguing was that the music really wasn't being exposed at all. The same thing is happening now. The alternative explosion has reached markets like Madison, Wis., and Lansing, Mich., and the number of stations playing Jethro Tull and the Stones and Led Zep have dwindled to just the classic rock station or, in the case of New York City, no one. The lone classic rock station in many markets is knocking down some pretty good ratings."

Jacobs also cites the decision by Arrow outlet WARW Washington, D.C., to reimagine itself as "classic rock" this month as proof "that's where the real opportunity for growth lies." He also



JSN Teams With Paragon To Take Rock Adult National

Jones Satellite Networks is adding a rock alternative feed to its 24-hour formats. The company has formed a strategic alliance with Paragon Research and managing partner **Mike Henry**. He'll work with Jones in crafting a satellite feed that mirrors the adult modern format of Paragon and SBR Radio. Jones VP programming/operations **Phil Barry** hopes to have a PD and staff in place for a May sign-on. Rush T&R to 8250 South Akron St., Suite 205, Englewood, Colo. 80112.

With KNRX (92X) Denver under new ownership, GM **Ron Jameson** exits. Sales director **Fritz Stahmer** takes the post on an interim basis.

Former KGON Portland, Ore., OM **Dick Sheetz** has resurfaced as the PD of WDIZ Orlando, Fla., replacing **Mike Beck**.

Triple-A WMAX Rochester, N.Y., PD **Rick Mackenzie** exits. His duties are being handled for now by MD **Jennifer Vanderslice** and morning host **Mike Rusinko**.

Several weeks after adding a top 40/rhythm format to afternoons, CKEY (Planet 101) Buffalo, N.Y., completes its transition from modern to top 40.

Modern WQXA York, Pa., becomes the latest **Howard Stern** affiliate. Stern kicked off programming at the station Feb. 20 and has slated a press conference for Feb. 23's broadcast. His addition splits the WQXA morning team, **Scott Johnson** and **Michelle Cruz**. Johnson exits. Cruz slides into the p.m. drive shift, moving **Scott McFadden** into middays, and midday host **Claudine DeLorenzo** to the role of local producer for the Stern feed with the addition of some music duties.

As anticipated, classic rock WZGC (Z93) Atlanta has changed its morning Greaseman feed from tape delayed to live. He's teamed, via satellite, with WZGC ND **Marcia Shipley**, who adds her Atlanta-based perspective to the WZGC audience and all Greaseman affiliates. In other syndication news, WLEE Richmond, Va., picks up **John Boy and Billy**. The acquisition moves the **Big Brother Shane** and the morning shift out of the Classic Hits station. WQZQ Nashville will add the **Bob and Tom** show by month's end, coinciding with its power boost to 100,000 watts.

Chicago radio vet **Garry Meier**, last with WLUP Chicago, returned to his old stomping grounds at crosstown N/T WLS-AM Feb. 19, teamed with the station's **Roe Conn** for afternoons. Meier's contract runs for three years; his return to the station is almost 10 years to the date after he and then-partner **Steve Dahl** ended their mid-'80s reign at WLS.

WDRE Long Island, N.Y., picks up KREV Minneapolis APD/midday host **Shelley Miller** as MD/inmorning co-host. Meanwhile, KREV has given APD stripes to p.m. driver **Thorn**, and **Shawn Stewart** picks up MD duties and Miller's noon-3 p.m. slot. Stewart has been station producer for the Spin Radio Network and hosted KREV's Sunday night specialty show "Moonlight Meditations." The 10 a.m.-noon shift has passed from Morgan "Jamie Gumm" Church, who exits, to

production director/specialty show host **Christine Kass**.

In the wake of **Dave Stewart**'s departure for Miami, WARQ Columbia, S.C. MD/afternoon drive host **Susan Groves** has been given interim PD responsibilities. GM **Steve Patterson** is accepting T&R for Stewart's morning shift.

Rick Ashton is the new ND/morning co-host at triple-A KBCO Denver, joining **Kerry Gray**. Ashton previously did mornings for KBCO PD **Mike O'Connor** at KTEG Albuquerque, N.M. Comedy Central addicts will recognize Ashton's name from his Short Attention Span Theater appearances. Meanwhile, **Caroline Corley** has gotten the official nod in nights.

As the station prepares to change hands from Brill Media to Ingstad, KQWB Fargo, N.D., undergoes several changes with **Mike Simmons** leaving MD duties to PD **Dave Howey** for the time being and promotion assistant **Kyle Christensen** being elevated to promotion director. The deal was announced Feb. 20 with Ingstad looking to take control in March.

N/T WFXS Chattanooga, Tenn., is evolving into a talk/rock hybrid. Mornings feature a talk show simulcast on a local cable TV station. Middays is locally originated classic rock, with more talk programming in afternoons. The station is classic rock on weekends and is phasing out syndicated talk programming at night in favor of automated classic rock 8 p.m.-5 a.m.

San Bernardino, Calif., modern rocker KCXX will be sharing MD/marketing director **Dwight Arnold** with its N/T AM, KCKC, now that he has been named OM for both stations. Arnold's first order of business at KCXX will be replacing night jock **Mark Mendoza**, headed to KLOS Los Angeles part-time.

KLPQ Little Rock, Ark., chose Valentine's Day to drop classic for simulcasting sports programming on FM sister station KBBL (the Ball). KLPQ PD **Nicole Bear** will remain. Afternoon driver **Steve Medley** exits.

Modern WJRR Orlando, Fla., night jock **Sideshow Dan** adds AMD duties.

Album WPLR New Haven, Conn., taps overnighter **Glenn Dimenstein** for its vacant night slot ... WJXQ (Q106) Lansing, Mich.'s overnight shift has been taken by **Jennifer Taylor**, most recently doing P/T work at country duopoly partner WBHR.

Modern KJEE Santa Barbara, Calif., turned to intern **Brad "the Surf Dude"** to fill its morning show opening.

Modern WLUM Milwaukee promotion director/morning sidekick **Brian Erwin** has exited the station, leaving GM **Steve Sinicropi** with PD and promotion seats to fill ... Modern WKOC Norfolk, Va., taps 18-year radio vet **Jason McCrae** as production director. McCrae was most recently doing freelance voice work.

KDGE Dallas puts its promotion department to the test with its forthcoming charity event called, appropriately enough, Charity. It's a rave and benefit and will be plugged into the Internet. The March 2 event will benefit Edge Children's Charities as it celebrates the fifth anniversary of the station's Saturday night mix show. Not only will the event be broadcast live on the station 10 p.m.-4 a.m., but the Edge World Wide Web site will carry the audio live. The event will also include a bank of computer terminals at the club for cyberchat. KDGE has been "broadcasting" live on the Web for about a month. Breaker 1-9, All You Internet Good Buddies, Watch Your Web Sites

NET GAINS: One programming guru I know thinks the Internet is the CB radio of the '90s, which is true to a certain extent. It's a trendy way to communicate, just like the CB was in its heyday; however, no one has risen to the level of **C.W. McCall** by writing an ode to it. I'm waiting for a band like **No Doubt** to seize the opportunity.

The issue of what radio stations should be doing on the Net has been beaten to a pulp in the last year. And now, with every mental patient in the world creating a personal World Wide Web page, the challenge of creating a site that's interesting and fresh is tougher than ever.

Imagine if everybody in your market had a decent FM transmitter and a really cool CD collection. That's what the Internet is like. Everyone is on an equal technical footing. Even the bells and whistles, like RealAudio, are accessible to the masses. A very basic version of their server is available free to Web-page designers, which puts the same tools you have in the hands of virtually anyone with a computer and a clue.

What makes you as a radio station different from Joey the Wacky Webmaster sitting in his basement is your expertise in communications. Knowing how to serve your listeners in a palatable, mainstream manner will, one hopes, pull you ahead of the hobbyists. Check out the Web sites of **KROQ** Los Angeles, **WMMS** and

WENZ Cleveland, and **KPIG** Monterey, Calif., for some ideas. Their sites not only inform people about the station but provide interesting links to other places on the Net.

The Internet is a good tool for radio to use, but programmers and sales weasels shouldn't get all hot and bothered about it. In order to create a respectable site, you need a staff with the time and energy to keep it current. As anyone who's been in radio for more than five minutes knows, that's not easy. And in the current climate of takeover mania, personnel are going to be stretched to the max doing their jobs and the jobs of the other 15 people who have been eliminated, thereby making the maintenance of Web pages more difficult. Not being updated is the main problem with many of the lame sites I've come across. Hitting a Web page and reading about Christmas promotions three months after the fact is not my idea of a good time.

But that shouldn't scare you from the Net. A simple E-mail address gives your listeners access to your station through the Web. Many of the programmers I've spoken to have cited E-mail as another tool to gauge listener response, in addition to request lines and bricks through the station window. It's cheap, and responding to E-mail from your end is a lot easier than maintaining a Web site. Even I have an E-mail address (loscalzo@pipeline.com).





Gravity Kills Finds Success In Procrastination

If TVT act Gravity Kills were a football team, it would be the underdog whose backup quarterback scores the win without any game preparation.

The band's story begins with three friends attempting to place a song on a KPNT St. Louis compilation. Having had months to work on the song, but waiting until just two days before the submission deadline to find a singer, bassist/drummer Kurt Derns asked his cousin Jeff Scheel in Dallas to fly to St. Louis to finish the song. Scheel came through. "I worked my day job on Thursday and flew up Thursday evening," he says. "I walked into the studio, and they had 'Guilty' as a piece of music, no lyrical ideas, no melodic ideas. They just said, 'Here it is.'"

Spurred by the combination of a reunion of former high school mates and all-night studio accessibility afforded them by keyboardist Doug Firley's having worked there doing jingles, Scheel delivered the performance that helped "Guilty" become KPNT's most requested song of 1995 and subsequently got the band signed to TVT last July. It's also one of two vocal tracks—"Blame" is the other—the band kept from its original demos when it went to Battery Studios in New York to record the album.

After just making the Friday 5 p.m. deadline for the compilation and being notified that their song was selected for it, the musicians decided to form a group. "We thought, 'Well, maybe we're onto something, let's talk about getting a band together!'" And just like a superstitious athlete who adheres to the same pregame rituals used on the day of a major victory, Gravity Kills agreed to "sort of continue to work the way 'Guilty' came together"—Scheel works out the vocals after the band completes the music.

The results can be found on the band's self-titled debut, which is scheduled for a March 5 release nationally, including a special midnight release at Streetside Records in St. Louis. Gravity Kills' first appearance on record after the KPNT sampler was a demo version of "Goodbye" on the platinum-certified "Mortal Kombat" soundtrack. "Guilty" was released commercially last week—it also appeared on the "Seven" soundtrack—as an hourlong CD maxi-single featuring nine remixes and a bonus track. Rocky Morton, creator of "Max Headroom" and director of clips by Foo Fighters and Talking Heads, was enlisted for the video.

The band, which didn't exist two years ago, is rapidly becoming acquainted with touring life. It is currently on the road with labelmates Sister Machine Gun through April and will appear at some spring radio festivals to be announced. About the band's surprise success, Scheel says, "We feel extremely fortunate [because] that kind of stuff doesn't happen everyday, and we had absolutely no reason to believe it would happen to any of us."

Scheel concedes that the song probably has completely different meanings to each member but offers his own interpretation of "Guilty." Regardless of your background, Scheel says, "people are constantly trying to tear you down and recreate you in their own image of what you're supposed to be or how you're supposed to conduct yourself. 'Guilty' was an acknowledgement of that, but at the same time it was an acknowledgement that I do the same thing to people."

Whigs Set To Climb Ladder

Before recording tracks for their second Elektra release, "Black Love," the Afghan Whigs indulged themselves by recording two R&B covers (Barry White's "Can't Get Enough Of Your Love" and Frederick Knight's "Be For Real") for the "Beautiful Girls" soundtrack. Guitarist/singer/songwriter Greg Dulli received co-executive producer credit on the album and the songs recorded were performed live in the movie as well. It also marked the first appearance of new drummer Paul Buchignani in the band.

The Whigs released three independent albums and one EP (all on Sub Pop except the first album) before signing with Elektra and releasing their major-label debut, "Gentlemen," in 1993. That album contained "Debonair," a top 20 modern rock hit in November '93. A Sam Bayer (Nirvana, Smashing Pumpkins, Hole) video has just been completed for the single. Tour plans include a European trip in March followed by a tour of the U.S. with Howlin' Maggie beginning April 8 in Columbus, Ohio. Some of the songs from the album will be performed live by a seven-piece band.

ROAD HAPPENINGS AND SUCH

Here are a couple of highly anticipated tours: Rancid will be going out with Rocket From The Crypt beginning March 15 at Jimmy's in New Orleans. From there they play Memphis; Nashville; Charlotte, N.C.; Charleston, S.C.; Raleigh, N.C.; Baltimore; Harrisburg, Pa.; the Avalon in Boston March 24-25; Asbury Park, N.J.; Roseland in New York March 28-29; Rochester, N.Y.; Pittsburgh; Columbus, Ohio; Cincinnati; Louisville, Ky.; Grand Rapids, Mich.; Chicago; Milwaukee; Minneapolis; Omaha, Neb.; St. Louis; Tulsa, Okla.; Albuquerque, N.M.; and the Palladium in Los Angeles April 17. Tickets will be \$10. Oasis started a sold-out 20-date tour, which began Feb. 23 in Kansas City, and has just completed a video for "Champagne Supernova."

The Cure has 20 tracks completed for an upcoming release, which is slated to ship to radio in mid-April. The street date for the album is May 7.

Ammonia, which is signed to Murmur in Australia, will have its debut album titled "Mint 400" released by Epic March 19.

compares classic rock's performance to Arrow and '70s stations in the top 50 markets, finding that classic rock averaged an adults 25-54 share of 6.2 and an average rank of sixth compared to Arrow's 4.7 share and rank of ninth.

THE EVOLUTION WILL NOT BE

As for the possibility that classic rock and heritage mainstream outlets will merge into one format, Jacobs tells Rock Airplay Monitor, "I think classic rock is its own entity . . . The name classic rock has brand equity; [just] as oldies or country as names communicate a whole genre of music, classic rock now does the same thing."

"One of the problems that classic rock stations have had is an internal marketing problem. What happens is the ratings plateau after a while, and internally some people tire of the format. They want to know, when is this format going to evolve? The answer is it's not going to evolve. It is what it is. The way the format evolves is through nonmusic ways like [oldies KRTI Los Angeles] has evolved over the years."

"For a lot of stations, that wasn't the situation. They lost faith in the format. When the '70s and Arrow stations came on, it was just the impetus that those stations who weren't all that happy with the way things were going needed to go off and do something else."

"At stations where there has been a strong core belief in the format, like WKLI Milwaukee, KQRS Minneapolis, and WCSX Detroit, there isn't time spent talking about the death or the state of the format. All the time spent is on talking about how to make the station more interesting, exciting, and a vital part of the community . . . When you look at the stations that have made the move from classic to something else, most of them are having difficulty in their new homes."

DALLAS REMAINS BULLISH

Tom Glade, VP/GM of classic KZPS Dallas (and modern sister KDGE), has Arrow station KRRW competing against him, but that hasn't made him less bullish on classic rock. "The issue at this point is there is more sharing than we'd like to see in the female demos that like classic rock. This is no different than an AC who gets a direct competitor . . . You've got to hold true to the core elements of your product and defend them to the death. We have equity in a name that people really understand—classic rock. They do not understand what Arrow is."

"Classic rockers who have had troubles are the ones who violated the principles of marketing warfare. They started to shuffle too far away from the core elements that made them good classic rock stations and lost the image that their listeners had of them. The other station [that was] debuting took their audience away, and they panicked." Glade points out that when KRRW signed on, combined shares for classic rock in that market rose. And while the Arrow affected his station initially, "we're back in the top five men 25-54 as the debut and the buzz of the Arrow has worn away." KZPS moved 2.4-3.4 12-plus in the fall Arbs; KRRW moved 2.5-2.7.

Other markets, however, have seen a war of attrition that may drive one station out of the market without improving the other's numbers. In D.C., in WARW's first book competing with the now-defunct WCXR, it scored a 2 share 12-plus. In fall '95, WARW no longer had a classic rock across the street, yet it only posted a 2.1 12-plus. Jacobs blames markets, such as D.C., where total classic rock shares declined on the failure of Arrow stations to expand beyond music.

ARROW GETS MORE CLASSIC

Jacobs also notes that, over time, most Arrow stations began to sound more like their classic rock counterparts. "Many of the novelty-oriented songs that Arrow originally signed on with were all things that classic rock stations had tested over the years and had dropped because of poor performance. When Arrow debuted, hearing some of these songs for the first time in several years triggered that 'oh, wow' reaction from the listener that any new station needs in order to get off the ground."

"As time went on, Arrow stations and '70s stations slowly de-popped themselves because these songs did not score well over time. Ultimately, they began to sound more like what classic rock stations had sounded like for several years."

Other format observers, such as Robert Unmacht of the M Street Journal newsletter, say that both sides of the format have evolved. Unmacht says most "pure" classic rock stations have taken a poppier lean, so that classic rock and classic hits have met in the middle. Unmacht also notes that, despite the pundits' death knells for classic rock, this year's M Street Directory shows 350 classic rock outlets, up from 264 in fall 1994.

Unmacht believes that WARW and other Arrow outlets actually finished their transition to classic rock some time ago, although WARW only recently began using the term "classic rock" with the addition of former WCXR morning man Paul Harris. PD Craig Ashwood says, "We never really were like the other Arrow stations. We've evolved into a classic rock station to the point where it was, 'Let's just call it what we are.'"

WHY D.C. CHANGED

Ashwood thinks his station probably would not have added the classic rock position if WCXR didn't abandon the format. "The reality is that the market changed. [WWDC-FM] made major changes in their music—they no longer play any classic rock. They've become a true modern rock station. They sound great, but they're much different than what we are, and they're now in the same sort of battle as [modern] WHFS."

"[Our] music hasn't changed," Ashwood says, despite listener perception that it has. That in part stems from WARW's revamped presentation and new morning show. WCXR's a.m. drive hosts Paul Harris and Dave "the Predictor" Murray were added at the same time as the classic rock positioner. "The fact we have a real fun, active, classic rock-targeted morning show has created a different sense of platforming for the radio station; it makes the music sound different."

Ashwood doesn't believe all Arrow stations should make the transition to classic rock, pointing to original Arrow KCBS-FM Los Angeles. "Where it's working, it's working great," he says.

WMGK Philadelphia, which began as a '70s pop outlet, is leaning more rock these days, but won't rush into the classic rock position left vacant by WYSF according to PD Dan Michaels. "I don't think developing into a classic rock is the answer for our station. I think the beauty of classic hits is that it doesn't limit itself. Women are less likely to listen to classic rock because of the harder edge of the stuff. We aren't as heavy into Jimi Hendrix, Pink Floyd, Led Zeppelin, and that aspect of [classic]. We are able to incorporate parts of it that were part of album rock at one time but since abandoned, like Carly Simon, Linda Ronstadt, and James Taylor. It's a broader appeal."

GUTHRIE'S TAKE

One format pioneer who isn't sure if there's room for classic rock in every market is Louisville, Ky.-based consultant Gary Guthrie. Guthrie, whose classic hits outlets of the late '80s were, in many ways, the forerunner of the Arrow format, sees classic rock, overall, as "fried. And nonexclusive. You have the oldies stations who are struggling to come into the '70s and leave the Bobby Rydells behind. You've got the album rockers who are still playing some of that stuff and be all things to all people 25-54. You've got the Arrows and '70s, who are riddled with that material."

As for Jacobs' contention that 1996 is like 1986, Guthrie says, "Album rockers just weren't playing this stuff in 1985 or were playing just a moderate amount of it. I see the album rockers of today leaning toward modern and trying to evolve, but they still haven't left the Led Zeppelins and Skynyrd's and Allmans behind. They're certainly playing more than they were in 1986. There are still a lot of grandfathered stations like WDVE Pittsburgh or WFBQ Indianapolis who are straddling the fence and will continue to do so because they're straddling the fence successfully."

ROCK GODZ

WMRQ's John Knapp Proves There's Life Beyond Hair Bands, Gets Philly Job

After minutes of speculation last week, it was WMRQ Hartford, Conn., PD John Knapp who was chosen to fill the programming chair at modern WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia vacated by WHYT Detroit-bound Garrett Michaels. Knapp's appointment is taken as a signal by many that the onetime modern/top 40 hybrid has stepped up its commitment to modern rock. Y100 already leads the market's first modern rocker, WIBF, 3.7 to 1.3 12-plus, despite having been in a virtual dead heat with the then-WDRE Long Island, N.Y., network affiliate a year ago.

Ironically, Knapp served as former WDRE PD Russ Motta's MD at WIYY (98 Rock) Baltimore during that station's 8-share years and the "hair band" explosion of the early '90s. So how did Knapp get from "hair" to there?

"I never looked at WIYY as a hair-band station. We played hit records. They were songs

that were valid, especially in blue-collar markets like Baltimore, Cleveland, and Pittsburgh. We were basically a top 40 station that played rock music. We had high-energy sweepers. Before everybody was talking about John Frost, we had John Reilly, who's now at WBCN Boston, who was doing phenomenal work. We poked fun at ourselves, we played hit records, we sounded like we were at every show, and we were on top of everything. It was good radio.

"In a lot of ways, that's what you've got to do alternative to make it stand. After the novelty of playing the music goes by, after you've got the position, you've got to do other things to be a great station. Like having a good morning show and being well-positioned in the market."

WMRQ's morning team, Jake and Beth, are, Knapp says, "not a yuck-yuck morning show, but there's interaction and there's personality involved. It's worked, and we play a lot of music in the morning."

At Y100, Knapp will have one of Philly's longest-running morning shows leading his team, "Barsky In The Morning." "It's going to be a little different in that everyone knows how good that morning show is in Philly." Will it be a challenge to manage such a well-known entity? Knapp says, "You have special situations when you're dealing with a bigger morning show, but for the most part I want to reassure people that I'm going to be there in terms of guidance and making sure I'm available to give them the tools that they need."

Knapp joined WMRQ shortly after Robert Benjamin, PD of sister station WHFS Washington, D.C., helped sign it on in January 1995. "Robert rolled out the original version of the station without jocks, just production and the tunes. When I got here, we did an auditorium test and fine-tuned it. Robert was there as more of a sounding board for advice if I wanted it, and he would only interact if I asked a question. It was a great dialog between two program directors. He

was a big help in focusing me on the important things on how to win in Hartford."

While WPLY is still considered almost a top 40 station by many in the modern rock community, WMRQ has also been a hit-driven station for much of its tenure. Here's a sample 4 p.m. hour of Hartford station: Matthew Sweet, "Sick Of Myself"; Collective Soul, "The World I Know"; Toadies, "Possum Kingdom"; Pearl Jam, "Dissident"; Natalie Merchant, "Wonder"; Goo Goo Dolls, "Name"; Elastica, "Connection"; R.E.M., "Losing My Religion"; Gin Blossoms, "Follow You Down"; Nirvana, "Smells Like Teen Spirit"; Stone Temple Pilots, "Interstate Love Song"; Spacehog, "In the Meantime"; Spin Doctors, "Two Princes"; No Doubt, "Just A Girl."

In his farewell book at WMRQ, Knapp was up 5.3-5.6 12-plus in the fall '95 Arbitrums and No. 1 18-34 with an 11.9 share. Knapp says, "The thing I'm most proud about is the fact that we tied 12-plus with one of the heritage top 40s in the market, WFIC-FM. 12-plus is the glamour number. I'm more impressed by what we did 18-34 because that was our game plan; our attack strategy was to own that cell . . . It's almost like running for office when you roll out a new station."

Part of that "campaign" includes being active promotionally. "You start off with quarterly events like our Big Day Off, Big Night Out, Jingle Bell Jam, [various] shows we brought into the market, [and the] Shred fest this winter. We're also going to own a ski slope for a weekend. We were very much plugged into what people in Hartford like to do. There aren't many sports teams [here], and the few that are here are very important like [University of Connecticut] basketball and the [NHIL] Whalers. We've come up with promotions around those teams. Also, we try to tie as much as possible into time spent listening promotions, as long as they sound fun on the air."

Knapp was one of the PDs chosen for the panel on dealing with your sales department at the recent Gavin Seminar, held Feb. 8-10 in Atlanta. Since that panel ended abruptly after a half-hour, what else did Knapp have to say about programming/sales relationships in modern?

"The key is you have to have someone who understands the qualitative sell, not just the numbers sell that's involved with this format. When it's done right you can be a major player 18-34, but more importantly you're going to bring a client a group of people that are going to spend money, haven't figured out product preference, and can be sold. That's the perfect kind of person [clients] want—[one] who can be a repeat customer."

"One of the things that this format has to offer is that you have an active young consumer who isn't set in his buying patterns yet. The whole goal of advertising, besides creating brand preference, is to drive traffic. I think one of the greatest things about this format is that we're plugged into a group of people who don't go home at night and necessarily watch TV; they still go out and buy records and shop for clothes, spending a much higher amount of their disposable income than someone who's 30."

Looking ahead to Y100, Knapp says, "My immediate goals are to get to know my staff. I'm inheriting an incredible group of people. If you talk to anyone in Philadelphia, the first thing you hear is what great people [are there] like Dan Lerner and Lynn Bond Bruder. [APD] Chuck Tisa is going to be a very big part of my programming team, along with [consultants] Scott [Shannon] and Mike [Preston]. The next few weeks are going to be as much of a learning process for me as it is for anybody, but it's going to be a great time."

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




