Modern Rock Again Moving At Nice Clip According To Monitor National Arbitrons

Modern rock radio, a format whose growth had slowed to a crawl over the last six months, is again moving at a nice clip in Airplay Monitor's exclusive national Arbitron ratings numbers. Modern is up 3.9-4.4 12-plus for the winter '96 book, while album rock stays flat at a 7.7, suggesting that most of modern's growth took place this time at the expense of top 40, which posts its worst numbers ever. Classic rock, despite the widely circulated rumors of its demise, is up slightly, 3.4-3.6, and shows a rise in stations, as '70s outlets segue into the format.

With top 40 tanking, album rock was able to overtake that format and move from sixth to fifth place nationally. The study, which combines national radio listening by format for Arbitron's 94 continuously mea-

sured markets, shows news/talk radio still in first place, but down 16.9-16.5 12-plus. That's still ahead of the 15.5 share the format had in the summer before the O.J. verdict.

As for the increasingly hip AC format, it rebounded from seven consecutive down books, up 14.1-15.0 to tie the shares that the format posted in winter '95. AC was followed by No. 3 country, which had its lowest national share since the Gulf War, down 12.1-11.0. No. 4 R&B, which posted its third consecutive up book, 9.8-10.7, to tie its best-ever numbers from spring '92. No. 5 album rock (7.7), and No. 6 top 40, which was down 8.8-7.2 for its worst-ever numbers in the seven years of the survey.

Modern rock (1.4) also appeared in the top 10, while classic rock was No. 11.

Dahl Joins WCKG; Benchmark Moves

Longtime market vet **Steve Dahl**, most recently with Evergreen's all-sports **WMVP** Chicago, is joining crosstown classic rock **WCKG** for afternoons, effective July 8. No word on whether **Howard Stern** moves from **WJJD-AM** to **WCKG**, as expected, until Infinity can LMA the station. That won't happen until Infinity closes on its pending Granum purchase and trades those stations to Cox to complete the deal.

Benchmark cashes out of Richmond, Va., dealing modern **WVGO** and classic hits **WLEE** to **ABS** for \$14.5 million. The stations are being brokered by **ABS**, with closing expected in the fourth quarter. Benchmark GM **John Crowley** and **WVGO** PD **Bill Glasser** exit. APD **Kevin Matthews** becomes a P/T **ABS** employee. **ABS** director of sales **Kenneth Albritton** is named station manager over the new purchases, with crosstown **ABS** modern **WBZU** PD **John Alkire** handling **WVGO** as well. Regarding future format changes, **ABS** president **Ken Brown** says Coleman Research will do a perceptual study in the market, and he expects "results in a couple of weeks."

Clear Channel, which owns 21% of Heftel Broadcasting, buys the rest for \$275 million.

Entercom VP Research & Programming **Joel Reish** has joined Cox Broadcasting's Denver-based research firm, The Eagle Group, as VP Research. Reish will work out of the company's Atlanta office.

Album **WXLP** Davenport, Iowa, parent Connoisseur picks up two more stations in the Quad Cities, **AC WGEN-AM** and **AC/sports WGEN-FM**, for \$850,000 from Coleman Broadcasting.

Trumper Communications picks up album **KZRR**/album **KZSS**/classic rock **KLSK** Albuquerque, N.M., from Twin Peaks Radio, a unit of River City Broadcasting. The LMA kicks in June 17. Earlier this year, Trumper agreed to buy the market's modern **KTEG**/classic hits **KHTZ**/Radio Ahhs affiliate **KDZZ**. Look for Trumper to "consolidate these rock stations under common management."

As part of a complicated three-way megapoly format swap, country **WKKW** Morgantown, W.Va., moves from 106.5 to the 97.9 frequency that is currently top 40 **WFGM**. **WKKW**'s frequency will be taken over by new classic rock outlet **WFBY** (the Bureau), which is named in honor of the FBI's nearby fingerprint facility. **WFBY** will use the syndicated **John-Boy** and **Billy** show in mornings. Meanwhile, '70s oldies **WSSN** will pick up the top 40 format.

In the wake of Entercom's purchase of album **KISW** Seattle, GM **Dave Samp** and PD **Steve Young** exit. **KMTT** GM **Michael Donovan** adds **KISW** duties. **KISW** will be consulted by Jacobs Media, which will handle duties for **KMTT** and modern sister **KNDD** (the End). **KMTT** consultant **Dennis Constantine** exits.

Album **WROQ** Greenville/Spartanburg, S.C. GM **Bob Bellin** will head to Cleveland for the modern **WMMS** GM seat when new owner Nationwide takes control. Back at **WROQ**, **SFX** is picking up the station, pairing it with country **WSSL** and **AC WMYI**. **Barbara Allen** will expand her GM duties at **WSSL/WMYI** to include **WROQ** once **Bellin** exits.

Paxson started its LMA of **WDIZ** June 1, moving PD **Dick Sheetz** to **WJRR** and sports sister **WQTM**. **Katherine Brown** picks up PD/morning duties at **WDIZ**. **Brown** most recently co-hosted mornings at former country **WYNY** New York, and she's done work in the album and classic rock formats. While **WJRR** is slated to remain rock, research is being conducted on the future of the **WDIZ** frequency. Expect a June 18 announcement. **WMGF** Orlando, Fla., GSM **Deborah Magnuson** moves to **WDIZ** for the same position.

Album **WMMR** Philadelphia PD **Joe Bonadonna** is part of the team steering sister **WNEW** New York until the newly refocused classic-leam-

ing station hires a new full-time PD to replace **Ted Edwards**, who exited recently.

Mainstream **WCMF** Rochester, N.Y., names classic rock **WZLX** Boston APD **Harry Jacobs** PD, replacing **Stan Main**, now OM at **ARS** Austin, Texas, triopoly. At **WZLX**, **George Taylor Morris** is named APD.

Modern **WENZ** (the End) Cleveland PD **Rick "Rocco" Bennett** relinquishes programming duties to concentrate on his a.m. drive shift. Sister classic rock **WNCX** PD **Bob Neumann** adds PD duties for the End.

Longtime **CHUM-AM-FM** Toronto PD **Ross Davies** is upped to VP of radio programming for the **CHUM** Group, including **CIMX** (89X) Detroit. Top 40 **CKZZ** (Z95.3) Vancouver PD **Brad Phillips** is the new PD in Toronto. Meanwhile, with Standard closing on Z95.3, album **CJAY** Calgary, Alberta, GM **Gary Russell** transfers to the Z95.3 post. Replacing **Russell** will be veteran PD **Pat Holliday** of top 40/adult **CJFM** Montreal.

Modern **WQBK** (the Edge) Albany, N.Y., PD/p.m. driver **Dan Binder** and MD/middayer **Kelli McNamara** flip shifts.

KDGE (the Edge) Dallas MD **Jay Michaels** segues to top 40 **KRBE** Houston for similar duties.

Album **WHJY** Providence, R.I., ups evening host **Jeff Charles** to p.m. drive, replacing **Carolyn Fox**. The station is looking for a new night jock.

Norfolk, Va., properties album **WNOR** and classic rock **WAFX** picks up two refugees of recent crosstown flip **WKOC**, **Colin Campbell** and **Howard Fawcett**, as promotion directors. They will work under the direction of marketing director **Lisa Namerow**. **Campbell** had been in the **WKOC** promo department; **Fawcett** most recently did sales at **WKOC**. Meanwhile the changes at **WKOC** continue with '70s **WCOF** Tampa, Fla., and former **WNOR** jock **Amy Newman** landing middays and, as reported here last week, **WPLY** (Y100) Philadelphia's **Zach Martin** gets the official nod for nights.

Album **WRDU** Raleigh, N.C., night jock **Jimmy Lloyd** (aka **Danger Boy**) acquires MD stripes.

Capitol Broadcasting has closed on its purchase of recent classic hits convert **WRKH** Mobile, Ala., and installed market veteran **Jeff Cautz** in the GM seat and expanded the duties of crosstown country **WDWG** PD **Jim Mahanny** to include **WRKH**.

Veteran Chicago-area air talent **Scott Touhy** signs on for morning co-host duties at triple-A **WYKT** Joliet, Ill., joining **Mike Tomano**. **Touhy** previously worked on **John Landecker's** morning show at oldies **WJMK** Chicago and most recently hosted a late-night talk show at spanish **WONX** Chicago.

Lillian Afonso leaves afternoons at classic rock **WPNH** Plymouth, N.H., for MD/nights at album **WHDQ** Claremont, N.H. Back at **WPNH**, evening jock **Derek Lavoy** segues to afternoons, with P/T **Rae Lee Goldman** and **Benson Goodwin** splitting the night shift. The former holds the slot on Mondays, with **Benson** taking it on for the balance of the week.

Oldies **WCBS-FM** New York director of marketing, promotions, and public relations **Ted Kelly** gets the national profile title of director of marketing and promotion for **CBS Radio Networks**.

Classic hits **WEGQ** Boston morning man **Gary Craig** resurfaces, as expected, at top 40/adult **WTIC-FM** Hartford, Conn., for mornings; no replacement has been named.

Modern **KOME** San Jose, Calif., reggae host **King Raffi** moves to modern **KITS** (Live 105) San Francisco for P/T and to host "Reggae Sound System."

Album **WDZR** Detroit GM **Bob Schutt** is headed for Fort Wayne, Ind., where he'll take the GM seat of album **WBYP**.

Album **KLBJ** Austin PD/p.m. driver **Jeff Carroll** gives up his air shift; night jock **Johnny Walker** replaces him.

Radio Giffords' Next Stop?; Whigged Out

KATHIE LEE GIFFORD'S crusade against sweatshops got me thinking. First, who believes that she never heard of sweatshops? Isn't she in broadcasting? Second, but unrelated, will she ever shut up?

As discussed in the March 29 issue of *Airplay Monitor*, radio's "new blood" is more interested in doling out triple-cheese pies at **Pizza Hut** for \$7.50 an hour than playing the hits and talking dirty for \$5 an hour. It's a wonder that **Frank Gifford** hasn't burst into some station with an envelope filled with three **Franklins** to assist the underpaid, exploited boss jocks. That would be interesting.

"Hey aren't you **Frank Gifford**, star of **Monday Night Football** and husband of **Kathie Lee** and father of **Cassidy** and **Cody**?"

"Why yes I am, Mr. Boss Jock," **Gifford** replies. "I'm here to compensate you for years of hitting posts, doing the weather in 30 seconds or less, and dealing with listeners asking the magical question 'Did I win?' over and over again. Not to mention those draconian working conditions, especially at that country station in **Kansas**."

"Hey, *himosabe*, that's g-r-r-e-a-t!" Our boss jock takes a few moments to calculate what he believes is fair compensation. "Hmmm. Wet T-

shirt nights the club owner wouldn't pay me for; all those Christmas Eve overnight shifts, all that trade I was promised but never got." After crunching the numbers, the boss jock exclaims, "I'm rich!" He looks at the former **New York Giant** and says, "OK, **Frank**, hit me. It's gotta be over a million dollars. Void where prohibited by law."

Gifford laughs. "No, son. \$300." He pauses and adds with glee, "New bills, too!"

The boss jock thinks for a moment, contemplates the smaller amount, and asks, "Off the books?"

IF YOU GET TO SEE the **Afghan Whigs** on tour, you may be lucky enough to catch **Satchel** member **Sean Smith** on background vocals. No, he's not **Wavy Gravy**, just an incredible simulation and worth seeking out. Peace, brother.

DUE TO POPULAR demand, our **Metallica** vs. the **Cure** tally at modern rock will now include total spins (since the release of "Until It Sleeps") as well as weekly spins. This week, **Metallica** puts 820 spins on the board for a total of 2,037, while the **Cure** rakes in 1,072 for a lump sum of 2,698.

Revolution Adds Two; Langton's New Post

It's official from **Revolution Records**: **Gary Poole** takes over rock radio promotion, and **Gary Richards** handles alternative promotion. **Poole**, a radio veteran of **Los Angeles**, **Houston**, and **San Jose, Calif.**, was most recently director of rock, alternative, and triple-A promotion at **Discovery**. **Richards**, who will continue to manage the band **God Lives Underwater**, has had stints at **RCA**, **American**, and **EastWest**.

That spot has been open since **Lynn Oakes** was promoted to associate director of alternative promotion at the beginning of the year.

Epic promotes **Lori L. Lambert** to senior director of marketing. The six-year label veteran was most recently director of marketing.

Caroline Records' radio promo department adds **Jeff Sperber** as college radio guru and **Mark Wagner** as head of commercial radio promotion.

MORE FUN IN THE MODERN WORLD

Modern rock had been growing modestly over the past nine months, up a few tenths of a share point at a time. This was its biggest single book since winter '95. With album rock flat at 8.4, —its average share for the past year or so— the implication is that the war between album and modern has pretty much shaken out, with modern now cannibalizing top 40.

Modern was up 3.4-3.8 in mornings, 3.5-3.7 in middays, 4.4-4.9 in afternoons, and 5.4-6.6 in nights. In the demos, it was up 10.2-12.6 in teens, 7.3-7.9 in 18-34, and 3.4-3.8 in 25-54. The 1/2-share rise among teens means that since the summer of '94, teens have continued to surpass 18-34 as modern's best demo, despite modern's attempt to portray itself as an 18-34 format without a lot of teens. (Before album rock sales departments get any ideas about using this article to sell against modern, by the way, album stations have nearly a 9 share in teens without cultivating them (8.4-8.7), only half a point behind its 25-54 number (9.1-9.2)).

Album rock was essentially flat in most other dayparts and demos, including mornings (in which it held at 8.4), middays (held at 7.8), afternoons (8.0-8.1), and nights (flat at 7.3). In 18-34, it was off slightly 13.5-13.4. After a bad fall book, album rock seems to have leveled again at a slightly lower point than last winter's 8.1 share 12-plus.

As for the number of album rock stations showing up in Arbitron's continuous-measurement markets this time, the count was down 173-163 while modern's count was off '96-'91, suggesting for once that modern's growth actually took place with existing stations instead of new sign-ons. Modern has lost several large-market outlets in recent weeks due to new duopoly pairings. If that continues through the spring, it could impact modern's overall shares down the line.

LONG LIVE (CLASSIC) ROCK

Classic rock, despite the rumors of its demise and the highly publicized loss of WXRK New York during the winter book, was up by six stations, 73-79. As some longtime classic rock stations tire of playing "Long Time" (and "More Than A Feeling"), other stations are filling the gap by switching from '70s pop to classic rock or classic hits. And that doesn't include most of the Arrow stations that Airplay Monitor has always counted as classic rock. With '70s stations continuing to segue to classic hits (i.e., WMGK Philadelphia) or ankle the format altogether, classic rock's

growth could continue through the spring, just based on the number of stations bringing their existing audience with them.

Classic rock, which usually operates in the 3- to 4-share range, inched up 3.4-3.6 after falling 3.7-3.5-3.4 in the past two books. It posed its best 35-64 numbers since spring '93, up 3.5-3.8. Its individual dayparts were 4.0-4.1 in mornings, 3.5-3.8 in middays, 3.3-3.5 in afternoons, and 2.5-2.7 in nights. It was up 4.7-5.0 in 18-34 and 4.7-5.0 in 25-54.

GOOD NEWS FOR AC

As for album and modern rock's newest cause for concern, AC, it's finally starting to look as if hot AC's increasingly modern flavor was a good idea after all. This winter, AC rebounded from its seventh consecutive down book last fall to its shares of a year ago.

Notably, AC was a little ahead of where it was this time a year ago among men and 25-54 adults; and a share ahead of its winter '95 showing in 18-34. It was a few tenths off from its share a year ago among women and in 35-64. This suggests that the more modern-based AC format is responding as one would expect, making the format slightly younger and more male, and that AC is where many upper demos are going for their hit of Blues Traveler and Hootie & the Blowfish.

Both AC and modern seem to be taking big bites out of top 40. Although there are no figures from top 40's early '80s doldrums for comparison, the format's numbers are certainly at their lowest point in the seven years of national measurement. Top 40's 7.2 share is less than half of the 15.9 share it began with in spring '89. In other sobering stats: The format is down 2 shares from its 9.2 share of a year ago; it lost 1.6 shares this time, which is its largest single-book drop ever; it was down 8.2-6.5 in mornings, 6.9-5.9 in middays, 9.7-7.8 in evenings, and 12.5-10.0 nights. It was off 13.1-10.9 in 18-34, 6.8-5.8 in 25-54, and 4.1-3.5 in 35-64.

Does that mean top 40 should or will pay greater attention to rock radio? To some extent, top 40's problems may stem from paying too much attention to rock radio. Modern's 18-34 gains are significant, but not as large as AC or R&B's top 40 gains. And with many mainstream top 40s having dropped both R&B and softer pop records, the implication is that top 40 is courting modern fans (who may or may not be interested) at the expense of other listeners.

ROCK GODZ

Z-Rock PD Bevilacqua Programs Mainstream Rock Against Tough Motor City Competition

WDZR (Z-Rock) Detroit PD Joe Bevilacqua programs a hard-rockin' mainstream outlet in a city where five other stations lay claim to some end of the rock spectrum. On the left are modern CIMX (89X), WHYT (the Planet), and triple-AC/DC (the River). On the right are classic rock WCSX and album WRIF. And it was a seven-way battle until WLLZ went jazz.

As for WDZR's place, Bevilacqua says that while it started as an affiliate of ABC's Z-Rock four years ago, "when the network made the move to a modern rock approach a couple of years ago, [we] felt that . . . the niche we had carved for ourselves—a male-oriented harder-edged radio station—would serve us better than being the third modern rocker in Detroit."

In the topsy-turvy post-Telecom Act world, are the station's new operators, Syndicated Communications, committed to the station's

mainstream act." The PD says such a band as the Refreshments, which WDZR plays, is "a mainstream band and has done well for [us] . . . I don't like the whiney, wimpy sound of alternative bands. That's not the station's image." Smashing Pumpkins could fall into that category, but they're a core band for WDZR, which passed on "1979" but "went right to Zero," a more forceful record that worked well. I felt '1979' was too introspective for the station."

Newer harder-edged music does the best for WDZR, Bevilacqua says. "I'd like to think we're the AC/DC station, but RIF has 25 years of playing AC/DC behind them." WDZR's library falls on the hard side of mainstream, with titles from Van Halen, Aerosmith, and "the bands that have been around for 10 years that keep [us] going."

On the air, Bevilacqua "encourages the personalities to run their own show and be themselves. If that means doing bits between songs, their opinions on what's going on . . . I encourage it. It makes the station different. We're all sharing Bush and Soundgarden. There's got to be a reason to come to this radio station."

Here's a sample 6 p.m. hour on WDZR: Pearl Jam, "Even Flow"; Gravity Kills, "Guilty"; AC/DC, "Shoot To Thrill"; Nirvana, "The Man Who Sold The World"; Filter, "Hey Man Nice Shot"; Stone Temple Pilots, "Interstate Love Song"; Aerosmith, "Livin' On The Edge"; Deftones, "Bored"; Rage Against The Machine, "Bulls On Parade"; Bush, "Everything Zen"; Red Hot Chili Peppers, "My Friends"; Pink Floyd, "Comfortably Numb"; and Jerry Cantrell, "Leave Me Alone."

Bevilacqua says that WDZR won't play new music for its own sake. "We just feel that good hard music sells, and it brings in ratings." For WDZR, that hasn't translated into huge numbers (its winter '96 12-plus Arbitron share went 1.3-1.4), but, he adds, "the station is run so lean, we don't have the promotional dollars that the bigger companies have."

"We're in the same boat as five other radio stations, all hanging around a 2 share 12-plus," Bevilacqua says. Z-Rock has "decent 18-34 numbers, with our best numbers [among] 18-34 males. With WLLZ out of the format, there's actually enough money in the format for everybody, if you place it correctly." Enter into the equation educating the sales staff and advertisers about the radio station, including such specifics as "why new bands like White Zombie bring in advertisers" and listeners are "business people with disposable income who haven't retained brand loyalty yet."

WDZR's birthday concert featuring Steve Vai was aired on the Internet. While most of the 10,000 hits the show received online were not from Detroit, the PD says, "the press we got for doing the first Internet broadcast from Detroit served us well . . . It was a great imaging tool for us that didn't cost a lot." **JOHN LOSCALZO**

rock format? "I would like to say yes, but I really don't know. I haven't had any contact [with them] . . . The station has made money since [GM] Bob Schutt and I have been here. We've been in the black for three years." Bevilacqua claims that WDZR has convinced advertisers that its audience is worth spending money on. Advertisers, he says, are "asking" for such features as the station's recent "Metallicathon."

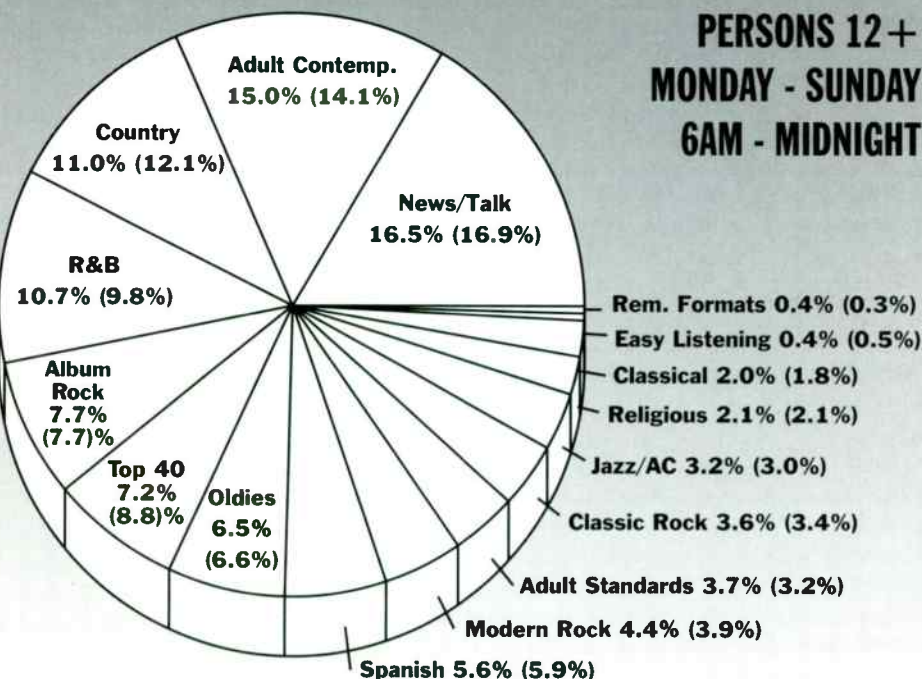
"I think there's a perception that the black-T-shirt-wearing longhairs are still listening to this station," says Bevilacqua. "Over the past couple of years, I think we've changed that." WDZR's commitment to playing new artists helped bring about that change. Now, Bevilacqua says, the station has "an active audience who buy records."

Bevilacqua adds that Detroit had been "one of the last markets to break new music" and that Z-Rock's contribution has been forcing "the tighter-formatted stations to open up a little sooner than they probably would've before . . . The station was the first to break bands like White Zombie, Type O Negative, Sponge, Tool and now . . . Korn and Rage Against The Machine."

He describes the station as "a hybrid between an AOR and a modern. I wouldn't call Korn a

Solution A.D. Emerges From Pocono Retreat

In their glory years of the '50s and '60s, Pennsylvania's Pocono Mountains were regarded as one of the Northeast's great romantic hideaways. You can still find the heart-shaped bathtubs, but the area's novelty attraction has gone the route of the drive-in movie theater: It's this less-than-fashionable surrounding that spawned **Solution A.D.**, which has just released its major-label debut, "Happily Ever After" on TAG. While the Poconos have never been a hotbed for original rock bands, the ambition to play music for a living kept the members of Solution A.D. going. "We all basically failed out of college. We've always done this; it's always been a priority," explains **Toby Costa**, the group's lead singer/guitarist/songwriter.

College was the turning point in Costa's career. During a brief stay at the University of Texas on a tennis scholarship, he quickly discovered that his time spent writing songs and playing guitar far exceeded his time reading books and playing tennis. He left school but instead of being met with disappointment upon returning home, his mother provided encouragement for her son's vision. "She was smart enough to give me the room to go. She's always been that way," Costa says.



Getting an original band together in Costa's neck of the woods, however, required more-than-average determination. With few clubs to play, bands had to adhere to the covers-only policy of the area's tourist-driven music scene. Costa says, "We went against the grain as much as possible,"

though they did play covers. "We did a version of 'Rock Lobster' when we had our keyboard player that we were legendary for. It was kind of a **Ramones** version that people loved."

Solution A.D. formed in 1990 and a short time later trekked to nearby New York and Philadelphia, where crowds are more receptive to new music. Gigs at New York's CBGB resulted in **Live** guitarist **Chad Taylor** hearing a tape of the band and becoming interested in producing them.

Live and Solution A.D. are both from Pennsylvania and share the same manager, but Costa believes the Live association only tells part of the story. "As far as a similarity or a connection to them would go, the fact that we're both pretty sincere about the way we approach the music and the writing [is it]. Chad would always use the word 'earnest' when he'd describe Live's music, and I think we have that same element. [But] we have another side to us that they don't have, which is that we can get a little more tongue-in-cheek, sarcastic . . . they're stereotyped as more of a message-type band."

Costa says, "I like self-bashing type [writers] like **Morrissey** or **Mark Eitzel**. Kind of pessimistic, almost self-pity in a way. I think that's cool." The lyric for "Salty And Sweet," a paean to his wife, was inspired by an ice-cream sundae with peanuts—two flavors that might not seem to work together. "My wife is definitely a lot different than I am. She's not someone who I would have met in my travels as a musician. She's not really a clubgoer type of person; she's a real homebody and a mom. She inspires me with the realness of the whole thing. [She's] the opposite of someone who's got purple hair, knows every band. I'd rather have someone who would be opposite."

This summer, he'll get his share of colored hair when Solution A.D. appears at various radio festival shows. Among them are **KISF** Kansas City Friday (7), **KTEG** Albuquerque, N.M. (June 8), **KWOD** Sacramento, Calif. (June 13), **XHRM** San Diego (June 16), and **KTCL** Denver (June 22). In between, the band will play club dates in support of **Super Deluxe**.

So what are Costa's expectations now that he's on a major label? "Having the record in a store in Texas so my brother can buy it and be all excited [is] something that I've been working toward for a long time. It's almost like you do it for [your family] . . . In a way, the process is so long that by the time you actually get there, the edge is taken off a little bit, whereas your family can walk in a record store and buy it and be like, 'Oh my God.' You know, that's just amazing."
