## Buying Competition Raises Profit Potential, Reduces Fun Of Radio?

Amid the flurry of post-Telecom Act acquisitions have been several instances in which one company buys its in-format competition to eliminate it. Within the past month, that's happened to three modern stations alone.

In Pittsburgh, Secret agreed to buy Entercom's modern WNRQ (the Revolution), which was in direct competition with its modern WDX (the X) and album WDV. Secret ended the Revolution, switching it to jazz AC Jane 1. And Benchmark's consolidation created opportunities for two moderns to buy their competitors in Richmond, Va., and Norfolk, Va. Not to mention Paxson's pending changes in Orlando, Fla., which will probably

not leave its current mainstream and modern rock properties as close to each other as they are now.

Doesn't buying your competition to close it take the fun out of broadcasting? And if one company controls a certain format, particularly in medium or small markets, will stations become mediocre without challengers? And with job security a big "if" in today's climate, will attracting a good staff be harder?

For ABS President Ken Brown, whose WBZU Richmond is deciding what else to do with rival WYGO, this is not simply an issue of buying the competition. "That's just the given," Brown says. In an era of buy or be bought, purchasing the competition is "the side-story. I was buying spectrum. I've got half the non-ethnic FMs [in Richmond]." *Continued on page 5*



## Alice To Alice; Stern Enters 31st Market

**L**ongtime album outlet KRQR San Francisco flips to modern AC as Alice 97.3. KRQR's change prompted a letter from Secret Communications, owner of KALC (Alice 106) Denver, threatening legal action unless KRQR sends "one large case of mushrooms from the Bay Area" and reads "A Whack On The Side Of The Head," a book about stimulating the imagination. Here's a sample hour of the new Alice (or will it be "Maude" by the time you read this?): **Gin Blossoms**, "Found Out About You"; **Alanis Morissette**, "Ironic"; **Eurythmics**, "Sweet Dreams"; **Red Hot Chili Peppers**, "Under The Bridge"; **Dave Matthews Band**; "Too Much"; **U2**, "Pride (In The Name Of Love)"; **Cranberries**, "Dreams"; **Smashing Pumpkins**, "1979"; **Naked Eyes**, "Always Something There To Remind Me"; **Seal**, "Don't Cry"; **the Cure**, "Just Like Heaven"; and **Chris Isaak**, "Wicked Game."

With **Howard Stern** spokespeople looking to earn the syndicated morning show three dozen markets within the next two months, album **WBUZ** Toledo, Ohio, becomes affiliate No. 31, moving **Dan Bozyk** to middays and sending former middayer **Bill Steele** to overnights. Meanwhile, **WEZB** New Orleans drops Stern this week as a result of its flip to hot AC.

PD **Sherman Cohen** is out at triple-A **KUPR** San Diego, with former crosstown modern **XETRA** (91X) San Diego PD **Mike Halloran** stepping in July 1. He'll also take on the p.m. drive shift being vacated by station vet **Ron Lane**, who exits for a position at Pacific Recorders. GM **Jeff Chandler** says the station will still focus on 30- to 40-year-olds, but with a slightly different approach and a new handle incorporating the station's 95.7 frequency.

Modern rock **WPLY** (Y100) Philadelphia PD **John Knapp** exits. APD/MD **Chuck Tisa** is named PD. Despite reports elsewhere that WPLY will return to top 40, Tisa says Y100 will remain a hit-driven modern outlet. He's looking for an MD and creative-services director.

Westinghouse CEO **Michael H. Jordan** has recommended to the company's board of directors that they separate the broadcasting and industrial arms of the conglomerate. They hope to research and design a plan for smooth transition in the fourth quarter of this year.

Clear Channel's purchase of modern **WENZ** Cleveland meant an expansion of not only PD **Bob Neumann's** duties (Rock Airplay Monitor, June 7) but also those of Clear Channel Metroplex VP/GM **Walt Tiburski**, who is expanding his oversight of **WNCX/WERE** to include WENZ. Former WENZ GM **Steve Legerski** becomes marketing and operations director for Clear Channel's Cleveland properties.

PD **Wes Erickson** exits **CKIK** Calgary, Alberta. No replacement has been named.

Bonneville International ups executive VP/COO **Bruce Reese** to president/CEO.

Paxson Communications continues its Sunshine State shopping spree, adding talk **WTKS** to its six Orlando, Fla., properties, which includes rock signals **WDIZ** and **WJRR**. In other Paxson news, VP of programming **Alan Mason** gets senior VP stripes, as **John Frost** assumes the VP of programming post. Mason's group programming assistant **Mary Franco** continues doing some project work while concentrating on getting a PD job. In Orlando, **WDIZ** and **WJRR** are now simulcasting. The two stations are scheduled to break off again next Monday with **WJRR** trading its modern sound for "active" mainstream. **WDIZ** will unveil its new format then, too. A Paxson spokesperson was emphatic that the new **WDIZ** would be neither country nor an all-female staffed station, despite reports elsewhere.

Album **WIZN** Burlington, Vt., parent Burlington Broadcasters has inked an agreement to LMA AC **WGFB** by midsummer.

Oting Broadcasting splits its Louisville, Ky.,

rock duopoly, modern **WXNU**/album **WQMF**, dealing the former to Cox Broadcasting. Cox already owns two Louisville stations: classic rock **WRVI** and oldies **WRKA**.

Dame Media acquires six Utica, N.Y., stations including album **WOUR**. Three Eagles picks up Radio One's properties, including classic rock **KNET** Lincoln, Neb. Three Eagles president/COO **Gary Buchanan** is now GM of **KNET**/nostalgia **KMEM**.

The Cromwell Group, parent to Decatur's country **WYDS** and AC **WEJT**, has LMA'd classic rock **WZNX** in anticipation of a purchase of the station. **WYDS/WEJT** GM **Joel Fletcher** expands his duties to include **WZNX**, which programs a locally originated morning show before tapping SMN's classic rock feed the rest of the day.

Modern **KFBI** (Extreme Radio) Las Vegas' new lineup has modern **WXDX** Pittsburgh swing jock **Erin O'Malley** in middays, mainstream **KRZQ** Reno, Nev., jock **Rip Ewing** in p.m. drive, and **WXEG** (the Edge) Dayton, Ohio, jock **Jim Allen** in nights.

**Rich Bryan** leaves his job programming Westwood One's rock format to become APD/middayer at album **KILO** Colorado Springs, Colo., moving midday jock **Dirk Kirkland** to afternoons. That covers all the responsibilities of recently exited **Chopper Harrison** (now at album **WYSP** Philadelphia) but for his MD duties, which will be split by Bryan and PD **Rich Hawk**.

Triple-A **WXRV** Boston MD **Mike Mullaney** trades nights for mornings, displacing morning man **Jerry Wood** to overnights. Overnighter **Manny Glin** is in nights on a trial basis.

Album **KBPI** Denver promotion director **Shawna Moran** is named marketing director for **XETRA**, replacing **Dawn Gallagher**, who exits. Moran will work with new promotions coordinator **Gary Clapp**, who steps up to **Robin Rockwell's** old post from the promotions assistant spot. Also at the station, P/T weekend/swing jock **Chris Muckley** is now music coordinator, with **Trever Trent** joining in weekends from overnights at classic rock **KZOZ** San Luis Obispo, Calif.

**WUOY** Wilmington, N.C., exits oldies for album under station manager **Chuck Sullivan**. Modern **KZON** Phoenix weekender **Laura Smith** signs on for APD/MD/afternoons. Mornings are covered by syndicated "John Boy & Billy" feed. The rest of the shifts are automated.

Seventies oldies **WARO** Fort Myers, Fla., weekend jock **Dave Nizer** becomes night jock, filling the slot acting PD **Mike Allen** left when he assumed the afternoon drive shift.

**WFXS** Chattanooga, Tenn., is in the process of dropping the latter half of its hybrid talk/classic rock format. The station is being sold to Allur and is expected to go all talk effective June 24.

Market veteran **Cory the Kid** returns to Ocean City, Md., after a brief stint in Norfolk, Va. He joins classic rock **WLFX** for mornings.

Album **KEZO** Tucson, Ariz., VP/GM **Laury Browning** is named a Journal Broadcast Group VP and has been elected to the company's board of directors.

Triple-A **WMVY** Martha's Vineyard, Mass., promotion director **Lisa Traxler** migrates to Denver for promotion/marketing director duties at **KXPK** (the Peak). **WVAY** Keene, Vt., MD/middayer **Shawn Taylor** replaces Traxler and will handle p.m. drive. Radio vet **Ken Alexander** returns to the air as news director of **WMVY**. He'd previously worked with Monitor Radio in Boston and ABC Radio News.

The Peak adds two P/Ts: **Bob Swisher**, formerly of **KAZY** Denver and most recently doing voice work in Colorado Springs, Colo., and **Chuck Woodford**, who had previously hosted mornings and nights at crosstown triple-A **KBCO**.

MD/middayer **Scott Catey** returns to album **KZOQ** Missoula, Mont., sending former middayer **John Wahl** to P/T. Overnight jock **Kenna Hoyer** and night host **Jeff Haley** swap shifts.

### Label Gods Find Primitive Radio Gods

An air-traffic controller resides in lonely, behind-the-scenes obscurity, rarely subject to the accolades pilots get; but when the machine jams, they're quick to hear about their shortcomings. As a Federal Aviation Administration employee, **Primitive Radio Gods' Chris O'Connor** had the thankless task of handling all the arrivals and departures out of Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) in demanding eight-hour shifts, with gear that belonged in a museum, not a control tower. "You have this monochrome, 40-year-old radarscope that's always breaking down. The frequencies are always screwed up. Some of the stuff is so old that they have to get guys who have retired from the FAA to come in and fix it. And then they can't get the parts because they haven't been manufactured in decades. It's a joke, man," says O'Connor. "You're basically working for people who've never heard the word 'positive reinforcement.' You're expected to be brilliant all the time, and when you're not, they fuckin' throw the hammer down. When you are, nobody says anything."

So when he received a call about his music from Columbia (U.K.) executive **Kip Crones** while on a half-hour break at LAX, one might think it came as a welcome respite from the job. But O'Connor reacted with manufactured pessimism. "I told him, 'Hey, I'm just this guy, I'm working, it's just this thing I did,'" says O'Connor with a laugh at his own skepticism. The trouble was that O'Connor wasn't green to the record industry. His former Ventura/Santa Barbara, Calif.-area band **the I-Rails** put out four indie records from 1987 to 1990 and received similar calls. "I was disillusioned with the music business," says O'Connor. "We had a publishing deal and a big-time L.A. lawyer. The I-Rails were a good band. I figured if I was ever going to 'make it in the music business,' it would be with them. So when we broke up, I figured it was over."

Crones had received O'Connor's demo through a talent rep at Fiction who played it for an A&R rep at Columbia in New York who then played it for him. He expressed his desire to release the record in the U.K. O'Connor, however, had just settled into a "real job" and put to sleep his dreams of rock stardom. But the \$1,000 home recording done in his spare time had opened the door to a record deal.

"Rocket," the Columbia debut album for Primitive Radio Gods, was recorded five years ago in a friend's garage. O'Connor wrote, performed, and produced the tracks himself. The recording, in which he used a collection of sampled instruments and a drum sequencer, is a departure from his work with a power pop band. He cites **Hank Shocklee's** production of **Public Enemy** as inspiration in developing his own style. That influence is evident on "Standing Outside A Phone Booth." The title comes from a **Bruce Cockburn** song of a similar name, and the song uses a **B.B. King** vocal sample, an old R&B drum loop, standup bass, and sound samples to achieve the track's vibe.

After receiving little interest at the time from labels, O'Connor worked at LAX and rearranged his priorities, spending his leisure time learning martial arts, catching up on reading, and sharpening his pool skills at the local bars—completely avoiding music and TV. It didn't last long, however, and like any true musician, the music bug just couldn't be stomped out. "I started reaching for the guitar again and writing songs, and I thought, 'Well, shit. I've got "Rocket"—I might as well make up some CDs, mail it out to college radio, and start a little label.'"

Amos can be seen on a new "MTV Unplugged" debuting June 26, and on June 28, she'll perform live on "The Tonight Show" . . . Epitaph will release its first enhanced CD in conjunction with Transworld, publishers of Skateboarding, SNOWboarding, and Warp magazines, Aug. 6. "Bored Generation" will feature clips from **the Beastie Boys** and **Offspring** and unreleased tracks from **Rancid** and **NOFX**. The CD also contains skateboarding trends and tricks . . . A new **Counting Crows** album, titled "Recovering The Satellites," is set to drop in August. The follow-up to 1993's six-time platinum debut, "August And Everything After," is being produced by **Gil Norton** . . . **Helmet** has finished mixing its third set for Interscope, "Airtaste," scheduled to drop in September. It was recorded at Sunset Sound and produced by Helmet and **Dave Sardy** of **Barkmarket**. Look for Helmet's cover of **Bjork's** "Army Of Me" for the surf benefit album "MOM: Music For Our Mother Ocean" on Surfdog/Interscope Records, which will be released July 2. The set will include new songs and covers by **Pearl Jam**, **Jewel**, **Silverchair**, **No Doubt**, and **Seven Mary Three**. Proceeds will go to Surfriider, an organization dedicated to preserving oceans and beaches . . . A company called Chaotica will present the Organic '96 festival at Snow Valley Resort in San Bernardino (Calif.) National Forest June 22-23. The event seeks to join the sounds of techno and rave with the outdoor experience of hiking trails and mountainscapes. The lineup includes **the Orb**, **Orbital**, **the Chemical Brothers**, **Underworld**, **Meat Beat Manifesto**, and **Zion Trail**.

In the winter '95 Arbitrons, the two modern stations seemed to be spiraling down together. WBZU was slightly ahead with its 4.0-3.5 12-plus showing compared to WVG0's 3.3-3.0 drop.

Says Brown, "In an under-radioed market, there's no reason to have two modern rockers." He sees the modern sparring between ABS and Benchmark as futile. "Nobody was winning, but I had the big country [WKHK] and they had [classic hits] WLEE [which was part of the deal] trying to get off the ground." With WKHK feeding the ABS war chest, Brown saw the next move as one of purchasing, not programming.

Modern WROX (the X) Norfolk picked up WKOC from Benchmark and immediately re-aimed it at crosstown album WNOR. WROX PD Perry Stone, now also programming WKOC, says the station will take the classic-driven approach WNOR recently abandoned.

Secret's Frank Wood says, "In today's battlefield, the accepted wisdom is that we're going to end up with super-clusters." If that's the case, Wood says, buying your competitor "is probably a fairly quick way of settling an annoying and expensive competition."

In Pittsburgh, Secret elected to change the Revolution's format, despite its having higher numbers than the X. Wood says, "The decision there was a lot more complicated and complex" than buying one's competition. "We looked at keeping WNRQ and switching the X." However, Wood says, the final decision had more to do with how Secret's three-way deal with Entercom and Nationwide was structured. In the time between LMAing a station and final FCC approval, there's a possibility that "something could go wrong in there," Wood says. "If the thing never closed, Entercom gets their radio stations back. Had we kept WNRQ going and taken the X into smooth jazz and then we had to give WNRQ back, it would have been a disaster to our long-term interests." Meaning eliminating competition for the X as well as removing any threat to the company's heritage rocker WDVE. "We were not going to allow anyone to be on that flank of WDVE." If the company hadn't decided to act on the side of caution, Wood says, it may have kept the Revolution, as "it was a hit in the ratings [and] because it had a bigger signal longer."

### NEW WORLD ORDER

Is this strategy the wave of the future? Wood doesn't think so. "You don't have the opportunity to do that in practice very often . . . You do it when you can, because if you can do something profitable with that signal and bolster your own interests, it makes a lot of sense."

Brown compares the terrain today to one of those glass-enclosed scenes with the fake snow. You used to be able to see the house, pine trees, and Santa Claus, but now the Telecom Act has come and shaken everything up. "It's a blizzard right now, and people are trying to find their way. It's standard operating procedure for Proctor & Gamble or Anheuser Busch. We have to learn how to do that."

### DIVERSITY? REALLY?

Since the passage of the Telecom Act, there's been a debate as to whether the "company town" programming that most observers see on the horizon will hurt or help quality.

Wood says, "It tends to increase diversity. In both Cincinnati, where Jacor [made a similar move with a rival classic rocker], and in Pittsburgh, where we did it, it led to a jazz station which hadn't been there before. So you get a different audience being served."

But will a lack of in-format competition lead a station down a passive path? "I don't think that we look at it that way, because we think we're at war with the rest of the market anyway," Wood says. "If we have all the modern

rock listeners on a radio station, then I'm going to want to skew it toward sweeping other people in. Good operators are going to do that. You're not going to let them stagnate. You don't want to let somebody else jump in. There's still too many signals."

Benchmark general partner Bruce Spector was on the selling end of the recent modern deals in Norfolk and Richmond. He sees consolidation as "strengthening," giving those stations more resources and eventually bolstering radio as a whole to draw revenue from other media. "Radio will get stronger, and the programming will get better."

WDVE/WXDX's Gene Romano says that in Pittsburgh, "we have candidates that can always go after our piece of the pie. Any intelligent company is going to make sure they have the very best people-created radio at the local level. We have become more energized and focus on long- and short-term goals and how we can build the X into a great radio station."

Benchmark's Spector doesn't think it's so simple as eliminating the competition by purchasing them. He says, "If there's an economic reason to compete with your station, if there's a business opportunity there, someone will take it. You can't just eliminate the competition by buying it," because as long as being the second station in a format is viable, that format is liable to pop up at another station in the market.

Regarding his decision to sell, Spector says, "If you're in a market, you have to be in a dominant position or you have to get out. We looked at the market and our position. We bought turnaround stations in Richmond and Norfolk, stations at the bottom of the market. As an investment, we did extremely well, but we ended up without a dominant station. It's tough to be a major player without a dominant station. You can't do it with a fringe station."

### STAFF INFECTION

As for the staffers caught at the other end of these changes, "I tried as much as possible to balance the emotions and the reality," says former WNRQ PD Phil Manning. "At first was the hurt of the time you put into developing what you thought was a class-A product and a potential franchise." Manning says that while he understands the business advantages of the current climate, "some very good people are being penalized." In Pittsburgh, however, many former Revolution staffers have landed new positions already. MD Booker Madison is doing late nights at WXRK (K-Rock) New York and p.m. driver Ali Castellini is now MD/p.m. host at the X. And Manning adds that executives at Entercom and Secret have offered him help in his job search.

Wood says that what many perceive as an unstable environment hasn't hurt attracting new staff to Secret's stations. "This is going to settle down. We don't like playing musical chairs just for the game . . . Bright people we're trying to hire understand that."

Manning says that from now on, "When I go on a job interview, I will be interviewing the GM more than the GM will be interviewing me. In fact, I would like to talk to the owner if possible."

Romano adds that while today's environment lends itself to any company being in play, "there are only a handful of companies [in which] there is a good chance that you're not going to be eaten. How do you keep people? You have to deal with the issue with each individual explaining as much as you can about your company and its vision . . . The only guarantee in our business is that the best people will always have a job."

WROX/WKOC's Stone says that now more than ever, air talent are not so much concerned with market size as they are with the quality and stability of the company.

Romano agrees: "That aspect has changed dramatically in the last year and a half. It's become a major issue with most jocks looking to move to another company."

# ROCK GODZ

## KBCO's O'Connor Inherits Dispirited Triple-A And Raises Morale And Share

**K**BCO Denver was the country's premier triple-A station until PD Doug Clifton exited to team with former KBCO brain trust, Ray Skibitsky, John Bradley, and David Rahn, to launch rival KXPK (the Peak). The Peak's modern/triple-A hybrid seemed to take the wind out of KBCO's sails.

When Mike O'Connor became PD of KBCO, all ears were tuned to what his first step might be. Not exactly a member of the Birkenstock set, he'd spent the previous year guiding Jacobs-consulted modern KTEG (the Edge) Albuquerque, N.M., after piloting Infinity's classic rock stalwart WZGC (Z93) Atlanta for the first half of the '90s.

Huddling with consultant Gary Wall and Nova Marketing researcher Mark Ramsey, O'Connor concluded, "KBCO is over: The only way to get back into the game is to go young-end modern and use Howard Stern as a wedge

"Nothingman"; 10,000 Maniacs, "These Are Days"; Eric Clapton, "Layla"; Melissa Etheridge, "Ain't It Heavy"; Tragically Hip, "Ahead By A Century"; and Joe Walsh, "Life's Been Good."

O'Connor says that although "several triple-A PDs have a problem with contests and production and doing a lot of radio basics," KBCO stretched beyond music to fight the Peak. "We're fairly production-intensive and have contest elements that probably would've been blasphemy two or three years ago."

First, he turned to the standard Thursday trip promo, renaming it World Class Adventures. Over six months, KBCO, backed with \$250,000 in TV, sent listeners to see such acts as Eric Clapton, the Dave Matthews Band, Sheryl Crow, and the Rolling Stones in Amsterdam, Indonesia, Costa Rica, and elsewhere.

Phase two was taking back the image KBCO created with its "Studio C" series. The station had made a franchise of inviting artists for on-air discussion and performances, turning the shows into a series of successful CDs. The Peak co-opted that quickly, O'Connor says.

Instead of "beat[ing] our chest about how 'Studio C' has been here longer," O'Connor says, KBCO focused on the eighth anniversary of "Studio C," airing highlights from its library, issuing a greatest-hits CD, and holding a free concert.

Two other KBCO events that O'Connor felt the need to preserve were the kinetic sculpture challenge and the cardboard derby. The kinetic sculpture challenge draws tens of thousands to watch a pageant of hand-crafted, people-powered vehicles (decorated like parade floats) designed to traverse land, mud, and water. The cardboard derby is similar, but for it, listeners enter cardboard sleds designed around any theme they want for a downhill race during Boulder's ski season.

Tracking its revival from the summer of '95, KBCO has risen 3.2-4.2-4.2 12-plus, while the Peak has steadily fallen 5.2-4.2-3.6. "I'll say our return has been about doing better radio for our demo," says O'Connor, who is not ready to rest on his laurels. He sees Denver as a trend-to-trend battle, with a new classic hits outlet threatening to siphon off KBCO's high end and maybe replacing the Peak as its nemesis.

"The Peak reminds me a lot of a classic rock station," O'Connor says. "You sign on, you live on your music, and then you'd better evolve. You better put some other elements there."

Relying on the music is pointless in a market in which O'Connor hears "a lot of musical sameness among four or five radio stations. This triple-A music gets co-opted too quickly. It's hard to be unique and different using [it]. Our mission is not to live up to the industry's definition of triple-A. It's to try to figure KBCO out. KBCO is a work in progress."

KBCO's 18-year history in the format gives O'Connor a mandate to be musically different, as he explains. "The minute we start caving in to a center is the kiss of death for us. Musical mistakes are not hugely punishable, because the idea that we run the gamut of sound is an important marketing principle."

Jacor is set to buy KBCO and, given its penchant for acquisitions, begs the question as to whether KBCO and the Peak may become siblings. O'Connor is reluctant to address this issue due to pending FTC investigation of Jacor. But he says, "One would speculate that there will be a company controlling the rock game in town, and one way or another, they'll do it, whether it's surrounding and conquering the enemy or acquiring them."

to blast out anyone who might be dabbling in the format."

Ready to change the face of KBCO with Stern (and likely send half the audience into coronary arrest), O'Connor saw the light.

"People who had been at the station for years were screaming at us not to blow up the equity in KBCO," says O'Connor. "Howard would probably work great in Denver. Howard on KBCO would not work well at all. The great Satan would have come to Boulder, Colo."

Back at the drawing board, O'Connor found a guiding theme in the book, "New Positioning In The '90s": "Whatever you have been defined as in your customers' minds is what you must be. That's your only opportunity."

Bypassing the "what is triple-A?" question, O'Connor and company dug deeper to answer "what is KBCO?" and found the elements of KBCO's success were the "stylistically broad, diverse and . . . large spectrum of music that came from gold/modern, classic rock, some new stuff, reggae, and blues."

O'Connor believed KBCO could plumb the depths of library material and find new music using the same litmus test of quality, under the positioning statement "world class rock." People in the market were asked what "world class rock" meant. O'Connor says, "Three things came back: It wouldn't be limited to one style, would incorporate the best of different genres, and would be the best rock songs from a wide time span. When you marry that expectation with how people in Boulder defined KBCO, the same three qualities came up."
