## Programmers Go Back To School To Hone Management And People Skills

With the unprecedented flurry of buying, selling, and consolidation in radio, many PDs and other managers are taking self-improvement courses to make themselves more valuable.

"Continuing education is no longer a luxury. It's now a necessity in this ever-narrowing radio world," says consultant Guy Zapoleon. "The future managers will have to be time experts, spiritual team leaders, and 'resource ninjas.' Great PDs have to have an innate talent for programming, but more of our jobs will be based on our ability to manage and inspire the people we work with."

WDCG (G105) Raleigh, N.C., OM Brian Burns agrees: "People management is not a natural skill; it's a learned skill that takes practice to perfect," he says. "There's a big difference between being a great PD and a great manager. In the old days, the best DJs became PDs. Sure, they understood the mechanics of programming, but not the mechanics of people management."

To help perfect their people skills, G105's previous owner, Prism Radio

Partners, sent its managers to Pyramid Resources, a management consulting firm run by former G105 GM D.J. Mitsch.

"The purpose of this 'coaching' was to improve our interpersonal relationships and people skills in order to get the most out of the relationship," Burns says. The course "helped sensitize me to my actions and reactions, which, in turn, helped me mature as a manager. I'm now more aware of the long-term ramifications of my decisions, rather than rushing to get something off the desk and move on to something I'm more comfortable with."

Radio people, both managers and subordinates, tend to be creative and emotional. One of the skills that Mitsch taught Burns was the "charge neutral theory," where the emotion is factored out of people management decisions. "Whether you're a parent or a manager, it's important not to attack the person; instead, you confront the person's behavior," says Burns, who tackled even subconscious personal ticks like hand gestures, eye contact, and tone of voice.

Zapoleon and many of his peers speak highly of a program called Cen-

## Odyssey Adds Two From Chicago 'Burbs

**B**ig week for Capstar, which expands its station count to 229 as it picks up Gulfstar Communications in an all-stock transaction that will create a company valued at more than \$1 billion. Gulfstar properties now to go under the Capstar umbrella include album **KNCN** Corpus Christi, Texas; classic rock **KLFX** Killeen, Texas; album **KKEG**/classic rock **KKZQ** Fayetteville, Ark.; album **KFMX** Lubbock, Texas; classic rock **KBRQ** Waco, Texas; classic rock **KTSR** Bryan, Texas; and classic rock **KDAG** Four Corners, N.M. Capstar also picks up classic rock **WMFX** Columbia, S.C., which it then deals to Clear Channel. Capstar also picks up Ameron Broadcasting's Birmingham, Ala., outlets. Former Osborn Communications president/CEO **Frank Osborn** is now chairman of Southern Star and Atlantic Star Communications, two of the new station groups within Capstar.

In what is becoming a pattern for the company, Odyssey Communications has picked up two suburban Chicago stations, ethnic **WVX** and AC **WJDK**, from Douglas Broadcasting and DMR Media, respectively, in a deal valued at \$10.6 million. Both stations reside at the 103.1 frequency, reflecting the station's same-frequency trimulcasts in New York and Los Angeles.

Modern **WRLG** (Thunder 94) Nashville's parent, Tuned-In Broadcasting, picks up country **WDBL-FM** and flips it to the second simulcast partner of **WRLG**. It joins **WRLG**'s previous simulcast partner, **WYYB**.

Jacor deals four stations, including modern **WXZZ** (Z103) Lexington, Ky., to JS Communications. Meanwhile, classic rock **KIGN** Cheyenne, Wyo., joins the Jacor family as part of a four-station purchase from Magic City Media valued at \$5.5 million.

Modern **WDOX** Atlantic City, N.J., is sold to Equity Communications for \$500,000, pairing it with crosstown top 40 **WAYV**.

### MANAGEMENT: BENDER EXPANDS ROLE

With SFX now closed on its purchase of Indianapolis album **WFBQ** and modern **WRZX**, as well as N/T **WNDE**, **WFBQ** OM **Marty Bender** becomes OM of all three properties.

Effective this week, **WARQ** Columbia, S.C., is re-added to the mainstream rock panel after an absence due to technical problems. There are now 102 mainstream reporters.



ter Sales Strategies (CSS) taught by Tampa, Fla.-based NewCity Associates. "It was the most important class I took as a PD," says Zapoleon of the invitation-only course that boasts a lengthy waiting list. "In addition to teaching you what your sales staff goes through, it teaches you how to think strategically, and it teaches you about establishing value—certainly something we have to do when we go out into the lonely consulting field." The course also demonstrates a "Client Needs Analysis," Zapoleon explains. "Before selling them something, we need to find out what the customers' needs are, something we ought to think about from a PD/listener perspective."

WNCI Columbus, Ohio, is a CSS client station. GM Dave Robbins, a longtime advocate of auxiliary employee-enrichment programs, found the course especially helpful in his transition from programming to the corner office. Although many seminars are targeted to sales, Robbins found universal themes that could be applied to any management experience.

Bob Neumann, PD of Nationwide rocker WMMS Cleveland, was knee-deep in a two-day brainstorming seminar at the time this article was written. "These courses are more important now than ever before, because programmers are now juggling more duties in many cases," he says.

### NEVER TOO LATE TO LEARN

Shakes, now a consultant with Alan Burns & Associates, took a seminar by the American Management Assn. (AMA), a nonprofit professional organization that surveys the workplace and offers seminars and networking opportunities.

"With all of the changes in radio ownership structure, they also offer a course devoted to learning to deal with change, working with sales, dealing with personnel issues, installing various systems, database marketing, working with the Internet, etc.," Shakes says. "I also learned a lot about marketing, positioning, and strategic planning—skills that are universal."

Lynn J. Johnston, managing director of AMA, says radio is just now learning what many other in-

dustries already know. "There used to be a career track for a lot of people, and that track is now being turned on its head because of many things now happening in the marketplace, one of which is more conglomerate-type industries, like these four- or five-station clusters in one market," she says.

While a three-day management seminar doesn't come cheap (plan on anywhere from \$1,000 and up), Shakes says taking that first step will create a solid foundation and help jump-start any future educational efforts.

"We have to think of it as an investment in ourselves," he says. Many seminar graduates say that any money spent will come back tenfold after wielding your newfound skills.

"Any PD can benefit even by taking a course in basic computer skills, management, or public speaking at a local community college," Shakes adds, "if for no other reason than to experience real people in real-life situations once a week. A college campus is a great place to observe your 18-24 and 18-34 demos up close."

### INCREASE YOUR RESALE VALUE

Johnston sees employee training programs as a key strategy for any employer. AMA does an annual survey of downsizing and found "companies let go a certain amount of people as they downsized, but then they hired as many or more back," she says, describing a common scenario. "[The company says], 'The people we have don't have the skills we need, so we'll go outside and hire those skills.'" The key to that equation before any downsizing is done is, "Maybe you shouldn't be letting those people go; maybe you should be training them."

"You have to know how the other side of the operation works," WMMS' Neumann agrees. "And you have to know something about business. The days of a PD just picking cool tunes and managing jocks is over. That's where some extra business training or education comes in to play, because they can teach you management skills, dealing with people, and make you more sensitive to the bottom line."

### Kiss Tour Opens Door For Outhouse

Bill Latas has been having a great time for the past three weeks. Latas co-founded **Outhouse** with drummer **Shawn Poores** two years ago after eking out an existence in Los Angeles as touring members of a band called **Naked Soul**. Within the past month, Outhouse has released its major-label debut and is now opening arena shows for one of the most successful bands in history. "There is no better word than surreal," laughs Latas about touring with childhood heroes **Kiss**. "They're why I'm in a rock 'n' roll band. When I was playing air guitar in my bedroom at 10 years old, I was picturing myself playing at an arena in front of thousands of people every night."

Having left Kansas City in tandem for the West Coast in 1991, Latas and Poores spent the better part of 3½ years getting experience backing bands and gigging. By the end of that time, they determined that "it just wasn't happening at all" for them and sought the relative simplicity of being able to get in a van and play gigs regularly, rather than a paltry two gigs a month in L.A. Upon returning home, they enlisted junior high classmate **Brad Gaddy** to play bass and formed Outhouse in 1994. Touring the Midwest regularly, Outhouse began to pick up supporters along the way, culminating with Mercury signing the trio following an SXSW appearance in '96.

On its Mercury debut, "Welcome," Outhouse delivers energetic, power-chord rock akin to the **Goo Goo Dolls** school of **Paul Westerberg** worship. "At 15, I wanted to be **Randy Rhoads**. Westerberg changed all that," says Latas. "His honesty hit me like a ton of bricks." While Latas' power pop songs are heavy enough to fall into the **Stone Temple Pilots** melodic grunge bag, he tries to avoid the brooding nature of most of the protagonists in that genre. The congenial album title, he says, was chosen because "we're a friendly band. We're aggressive and loud, but we'd like to think there's hope. All this negativity, I'm so tired of it. We just thought, 'Why not make this an approachable thing?'"

In the meantime, Outhouse will return to the club circuit, followed by various radio festival appearances in May. While the band members will be out dragging their amps across the country, what does Latas make of all this talk about the impending electronic movement becoming the next big wave? "I think people are talking more than they listen," says the guitarist, who admits he does like the new **Tricky** and **Chemical Brothers** records. "It will take a few more years to develop. I think it's like people talking about the Internet five years ago. Of course, it will be around, but I don't think it's gonna take over rock 'n' roll. I mean, c'mon," he says with a laugh. "Is this big giant synthesizer gonna come and eat my Marshall? No, I don't think so."

## ROCK GODZ

### Ryan Adds KISW Station Manager Duties As Entercom Builds Its Seattle Rock Wall

Six months into his tenure as PD of album KISW Seattle, Clark Ryan has added station manager stripes, as he continues to helm one-third of the Entercom rock wall. The winter 1997 12-plus Arbitron has KISW up 3.8-4.7 for fourth place in the market. Modern sister KNDD (the End) is sixth, rising 3.7-4.6, and triple-A sister KMTI bumps up 3.3-3.8 for 13th place.

Since his arrival in November and Phil Manning's in January, the two have pulled apart the rabid pit bulls that were KISW and KNDD. Before Entercom purchased them, "they were dire enemies that were going head to head after exactly the same audience," says Ryan. KISW "was in a fight to the death with KNDD to be younger, harder, faster on new music, more into being the Seattle-scene street radio station for the 18- to 24-year-old male."

Ryan's approach to KISW has been, "changing its focus somewhat from a very young male

great example in my mind, as minor as it is, is that the radio station was doing four traffic reports per hour in p.m. drive," Ryan says. "We cut that back to two and saved ourselves two minutes that we could play another record. Simple things like that [are a part of] focusing the radio station."

In mornings, when Bob Rivers' "Twisted Radio" presides, "we've actually gone the other way," Ryan says. "One of the things that the station was doing was making sure that it was music-intensive in morning drive. Again, KNDD is music-intensive, and it was the 'don't blink' [mentality]. It's 'Let's go toe to toe' . . . The morning show was underachieving. And I don't mean that they were doing a poor job. I mean the expectations were lower, and the opportunity was smaller. So we've expanded the opportunity and said, 'OK, instead of eight records an hour, we're going to play five, maybe six, depending on the material that we've got.'"

KISW's station-imagining voice was changed after 12 years. "Certainly 12 years of voice work on a heritage station is not a bad thing," Ryan concedes. But he adds that the previous voice "didn't feel right to me . . . I just thought, 'How are we going to illustrate the change on this radio station?' I thought the quickest, most efficient way to illustrate that was to change voices."

When it comes to attention-getting, Ryan is especially proud of the KISW World Wide Web site. Ryan credits promotion director Gus Swanson with making the site both a value-added tool and moneymaker. Swanson "put together a rock-'n'-roll scavenger hunt," Ryan explains. "There were icons from a number of clients. You had to click on the icons and go into their Web sites to find the clue that you needed to bring back to the scavenger hunt. We were able to show the value and go out and charge a number of people some money to be involved in the scavenger hunt, and it was wildly successful. The station made money. The clients were pleased as can be [since] they could track the number of hits."

Ryan insists on integrating the site to on-air programming to gain the full impact. "The coolest thing about a Web site right now is the high-tech imaging of the radio station," whether or not listeners log on. If the station promotes an online Ozzy Osbourne chat session, "it's the kind of thing that you would hear and say, whether you're going to stop what you're doing and go to the chat room and chat with Ozzy or not . . . 'Wow. My radio station is so big and so cool that they've got Ozzy in the chat room while they're doing this and that. Wow. They must really be on the cutting edge.' And that's the important element . . . It's not the number of people that tune into your site, it's the number of people that think your radio station is multidimensional and bigger than life."

approach to more of a 25-44 male radio station . . . and with that came some natural growth for the station. The End was in a similar situation when Phil Manning came in in January and said, 'I'm going to try to make it a little bit more mainstream. I'm going to try to broaden the appeal of the radio station.' And I think the natural result of that is an increase in ratings. It's far too early for us to clearly understand the larger picture of 'Have we got the End focused in an area where both KNDD and KISW are not direct competitors, sharing every listener that they have? Are we to that point yet?' I think the jury remains out."

Here's a sample hour on KISW: Pearl Jam, "Jeremy"; Foreigner, "Jukebox Hero"; Queensryche, "Sign Of The Times"; Led Zeppelin, "Rock And Roll"; Gruntruck, "Shot"; Van Halen, "I'll Wait"; Screaming Trees, "Butterfly"; ZZ Top, "Pearl Necklace"; Live, "Freaks"; AC/DC, "Ride Or"; and Offspring, "Gone Away."

Talk on the station was also scrutinized. "A


