## Summer Movie Soundtracks Rock Traditional A&R, Promo Channels

You've seen the movie, now hear the soundtrack. This summer, labels are investing more and more energy into that latter proposition and, in doing so, drastically altering the A&R and promotion process.

Even before "Titanic" sailed into history, the industry had taken notice of the success of the "Reality Bites" and "The Last Action Hero" soundtracks, especially when the latter performed better than the movie itself. This summer, soundtracks from "Godzilla," "Can't Hardly Wait," "The X-Files," and others are vying for PDs' attention. As Maverick head of promotion Terry Anzaldo says, "The soundtrack business is very lucrative right now."

Elektra senior VP of promotion Greg Thompson sees a definite change in the atmosphere surrounding soundtracks. This change has made for a "greater sophistication in the kind of soundtracks that are being put out and the thought process put into it by the film company. It's a natural marriage of two industries. The active moviegoer is also an active music consumer. The stakes are higher, and the promotion department responds to the needs of the company."

One key change is the addition of


a new partner in the promotion mix. When a blockbuster movie comes to town, the studio's hype machine serves as a dynamic backdrop for a promotion push. With two "X-Files" soundtracks coming out on Elektra, Thompson says, "there's millions and millions of dollars tied into the promotion and marketing. It's a huge TV show with a huge audience. And that audience is a potential buyer." Add music from Filter and Foo Fighters, for instance, and a radio station can reach fans of the show and fans of the band.

"They respond to the fact that if Filter is an artist that they've already seen value in, and it's tied to this multimillion-dollar rollout, their audience is going to want to be a part of the event, Thompson continues." He can point the radio station to the movie tie-in or the artist tie-in. And at radio, fans of Filter can be brought in the door to "The X-Files" movie, and "X-Files" fanatics may find a new band. "It's a win-win," says Thompson.

Epic has the "Godzilla" soundtrack, and it was the job of Scott Douglas to bring rock radio the unique collaboration between Jimmy Page and Puff Daddy. Having a giant green lizard as a promotion partner didn't hurt. For Douglas, "it was



## Payola Charges Levelled At Latin Label

**B**illboard's **Ramiro Burr** and **John Lannert** report that federal investigators are looking into allegations of illegal payments to radio stations by record distributors in the U.S. Latin music industry. Investigators began serving subpoenas June 3 to record distributors and radio stations in the Los Angeles area.

According to a June 4 Los Angeles Times story, the investigation centers on allegations of payola by Fonovisa, considered the dominant independent label in Latin music. The Times story indicated the probe may expand to other Latin labels—and perhaps the entire music industry.

The investigation began seven months ago when lawyers representing Fonovisa contacted the U.S. Justice Department to report improprieties within the label's own radio promotion department. Several radio stations, mostly in L.A. but also throughout California and Arizona, reportedly took cash to play records. There have been no arrests in the probe, which includes the participation of the Justice Department and the Internal Revenue Service. Representatives of both declined to comment.

In a prepared statement, Grupo Televisa acknowledged that its Fonovisa record division "had made certain promotional payments in apparent violation of applicable laws." Televisa further stated that it reported these activities to the U.S. government and "is cooperating fully with the Department of Justice and other agencies."

### BUSINESS: CBS CLOSES ON ARS

With the closing of the CBS/ARS sale, the three ARS co-CEOs—**Don Bouloukos**, **John Gehron**, and **David Pearlman**—assume those duties for CBS.

Album **KEGL** Dallas has received a \$2,000 indecency fine from the FCC for material aired on the **Howard Stern** morning show in 1993.

At Capstar's Gulfstar Communications, regional VP, southern Texas, **Ron Rogers** is named executive director of Capstar's community service program. Ex-SFX Broadcasting Southwest regional VP **Dusty Black** inherits Roger's old role as regional VP for Gulfstar. And **John King** is upped from GM of classic rock **WLAC-FM** Nashville and its sisters to president of Capstar's new operating division in the Southeast Atlantic area. Replacing him is **Dick Williams**, former GM of classic rock **KIHT** St. Louis.

Album **WHJY** Providence, R.I., GM **Jim Corwin** exits, replaced by **Bud Parris** from **WSRS** Worcester, Mass.

Jones Radio Network parent Jones International Networks Ltd. picks up MediaAmerica, the largest independent marketer of national radio programs in the U.S. MediaAmerica founders **Gary Schonfeld** and **Ron Hartenbaum** will maintain their New York base and get executive posts in Jones International Networks as co-CEOs of radio operations, overseeing all advertising sales and programming.

### FORMATS: KOME SEE ABOUT US

While the modern **KOME** San Jose, Calif., programming duo of **Ron Nenni** and **Jay Taylor** are now installed at modern **KITS** San Francisco, **KOME** music coordinator **Jeanette Grigorevic** has been handed the reins of power for the next several weeks before the station begins simulcasting classic rock as **KUFX**. She is entertaining future opportunities at 510-487-2665. Afternoon host **Shark** and night jock **Jason Hurst** remain at the station as board ops during the transition.

The Chicago Tribune reports that classic rock **WLUP** (the Loop) is now using the "Classic rock that really rocks" handle popularized by **WLAC-FM** Nashville, **WWBR** Detroit, and others. It's the first time **WLUP** has officially called itself

classic rock within the industry. Meanwhile, **WLAC-FM** gets new calls **WNRQ**.

Longtime modern outlet **KEDG** (the Edge) Las Vegas exits the format, opting for an adult R&B approach as 103.5 Kiss-FM. **KEDG**'s rock staff will stay on through the transition.

Classic hits **KKRH** Portland, Ore., flips to hot AC as **Rosey 105**, with GM **Tom Baker** and PD **Chris Miller** retaining their respective posts.

The M Street Daily reports that AC **KXIL** Sanger, Texas, has picked up a simulcast of triple-A **KKZN** Dallas. And while we're in the Lone Star state, **KITE** Kerville drops AC for ABC's classic rock feed.

Noncommercial triple-A **KRTM** Escondido, Calif., will exit the format for Christian programming under its new owner July 5. GM/PD **Mark Evans**, production director **Jeff Waddleton**, and MD **Travis Holland** are hoping to move en masse to a new facility. Check in with them via Evans' home number, 909-695-9651.

### PROGRAMMING: GORMAN EXITS WKRK

Album **WKRK** Detroit PD **John Gorman** exits, along with director of marketing **Jim Marchyshyn** and programming assistant **Matt Surrena**.

With Chancellor now in possession of album **WWDC-FM** (DC101) Washington, D.C., **KLOL** Houston PD **Michael Hughes** is spending time in the nation's capital, overseeing the programming and helping set new goals for the station. Longtime DC101 VP of programming

**Dave Brown** remains in place.

Album **WRXK** Fort Myers, Fla., PD **Matt Mangas** exits. Contact him at 941-458-8795.

Modern **KKDM** Des Moines, Iowa, OM/mid-dayer **Lee Konfrst** will exit the station later this summer, to relocate in Chicago.

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## 'Blue On Black' Ties Heritage Record

**T**he **Kenny Wayne Shepherd Band** holds down the No. 1 slot at heritage rock for a 16th week (14 consecutive) with "Blue On Black," tying the Rock Airplay Monitor record set by **Days Of The New's** "Touch, Peel and Stand." "Touch" spent 16 weeks atop both the mainstream and active rock charts.

**Stabbing Westward's** "Save Yourself" moves 9-5 at mainstream rock, giving the band its first top five mainstream rock track. Previous entries "What Do I Have To Do" and "Shame" each peaked at No. 7. "Save" holds at No. 2 at active rock for a third straight week. Look for the group's U.S. tour to continue despite drummer **Andy Kubiszewski's** broken collarbone. The band will utilize the talents of former **Nine Inch Nails** drummer **Chris Vrenna** and **Killing Joke's** **Geoff Dugmore**.

Having never charted at modern rock prior to this year, Canada's **Barenaked Ladies** make their second appearance on the modern rock chart. "One Week" debuts at No. 25 with 902 detections on a total of 60 stations.

Former A&M promo head **Rick Stone** joins **Jeff McClusky & Associates** as senior VP/GM of West Coast operations . . . After a stint at **Crave Records**, **Lisa Wolfe** returns to her previous post as VP of promotion at **Columbia**, effective July 1 . . . **Razor & Tie** officially names former **Profile** sales and marketing manager **Sebouh Yegparian** senior director of sales and marketing . . . Modern **KNRX** Kansas City PD **John Lenac** joins **TVT Records** as Southeast regional . . . Hollywood director of national promotion **Frank Murry** joins **Pellegrino Entertainment/S.I.N.** as VP of promotion, effective July 6.



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### Monster Magnet: Come On, Hump The Couch

Monster Magnet's new album, "Powertrip," was completed out of a sense of duty, says Dave Wyndorf, the group's guitarist/singer/songwriter/producer. While compiling material for Monster Magnet's third A&M album, Wyndorf's A&R rep suggested that he scan the radio dial. "What I heard was not rock. I heard a lot of cool music, clever stuff, but I didn't hear anything that sounded anywhere near fun. I heard frat music and ska," says Wyndorf. "I was thinking, 'What the hell's going on?' The only rock I can remember hearing was Blur and Marilyn Manson. It pissed me off." The solution was simple. "Somebody's has got to come in here with a pair of leather pants and breathe fire on these people."

Monster Magnet has remained true to its original vision of loud, hallucinogenic sci-fi hard rock since 1990. "The one big rule in Monster Magnet has been to really try and do it our way, because I don't think I could do it any other way," Wyndorf says. "I'm not this much of a craftsman to design something toward radio or toward mass acceptance."

"Powertrip" delivers the psychedelic space rock the band is known for but in a more stripped down and visceral way. Wyndorf says that he wanted "now more than ever just to write a straight-ahead rock-out-with-your-cock-out kind of record. So I went to Vegas."

That town's tawdriness was a wellspring of inspiration for Wyndorf. "I sat there with a TV turned down, but on, and wrote a song a day," says the singer/guitarist. Then he carted big pictures of vehicular explosions and naked women into the studio. "All the kinds of stuff that you would imagine would go into a testosterone kind of thing—and a lot of sarcasm and cynicism at the same time."

All these elements are vividly at work in the video for "Space Lord," a song Wyndorf wrote about a surreal three-week experience of debauchery with a dominatrix in her New Orleans pad. The title was a name he had been given by someone in the Northern European rock press and that was co-opted by his temporary mistress for some sinister role-playing.

The band flew out to Las Vegas and filmed a tongue-in-cheek clip that juxtaposes the members of Monster Magnet in dim light as dour-faced, burdened rockers with a completely over-the-top, gaudy rock star scene in which they're surrounded by groping dancers on the Vegas strip.

Wyndorf says wearing pimp suits and driving around in cool black cars like hip-hop guys was an idea that suited them perfectly. "I could either fight this and try to be Fellini and make some sort of grand statement—which will probably not make it to MTV anyway—or I could do what would be in the spirit of this record, which is 'attack, attack, attack, and hump couches,' and that meant rap." Marilyn Manson member and friend of the band Twigg Ramirez makes a cameo appearance in the clip.

The world of fantasy depicted in the video reflects Wyndorf's lifelong penchant for such forms of escape. One of eight children born to a family of meager means, playing army, superheroes, and reading comic books engaged Wyndorf's imagination until he discovered "rock 'n' roll, pot, and punk" in his teens. Seeing the Ramones and being influenced by his older brother's affinity for "anything that was wicked," which included Black Sabbath, Hawkwind, and the Stooges, became the blueprint for his musical direction. "We avoided anything that was happy, like Rod Stewart," recalls Wyndorf. But it was also his fascination with American pop culture that informed Monster Magnet. His bedroom—which served as the perfect hangout spot for the stoner kids in the neighborhood—"had huge posters of King Kong, Godzilla, spaceships crashing into the ground, pinups, pictures of favorite movies, and some kind of psychotic, drug-induced scrawl on the walls," recalls the singer.

Monster Magnet is a collision of these sci-fi and horror film images and stoned hallucinations with the punk and metal bands that influenced Wyndorf. But for the Space Lord himself, there's only one litmus test for this strange brew. "If I can't hump a couch to this music, then it's not good."

about encouraging radio to take advantage of the hype. If the movie company was willing to spend billions, why not tie into it and take advantage of it until the hype goes away. And that's what happened," resulting in a "huge phone record with huge response."

While the promotion effort may seem to come and go based solely on the movie's opening week, the actual life span of these soundtracks has grown threefold. Maverick's Anzaldo says that the "Jackie Brown" soundtrack did well when the movie was out, but "with the video release coming out, we expect another bump in sales and then another bump when the movie goes to cable."

And it's not simply the advance buzz that a label can plug into when a soundtrack and movie first hit theaters. "We get to share marketing dollars with the film companies," says Anzaldo. "After you put a game plan together with a film company, you can fall back on their marketing dollars. [When working with] a company as aggressive as Maverick, we'll roll out a record hot and heavy. But if you have the support of the film company, you can fall back on that and get yourself in the mind-set of a phase two and spend dollars after the film has gone away. That's when the record company can really start selling the release."

Looking to the second and third lives, "if you're really able to strategize with the film company, a soundtrack can also drive a film, particularly when it comes back out on video or the cable outlets," says Anzaldo.

The flip side is the movie company leans on the promotion team as well. Universal VP/GM Steve Leeds says, "One of the dynamics is the movie companies want the sizzle and up-front sell" that a soundtrack can deliver. But radio and a label are not likely to see real progress until farther down the line on a project, after a movie opens. "So there's always the friction between the movie and the need for us to sell something that's successful."

### DEPTH OF FIELD

Epic's Scott Douglas says, "It's a completely different dynamic than a regular album. Whereas with a traditional artist a station might say their sound doesn't fit the station, with a soundtrack, you have different artists that appeal to a wider range of rock stations. You can work several singles at once."

Anzaldo points to his days at RCA, when he worked the successful soundtrack to "Reality Bites," as an example of strength through variety. "We were everywhere," he says. "We were at hot AC. We were at triple-A. We took an old U2 track and took it to No. 1 at modern."

That variety can bring a political mess along with it. At least one promotion executive describes running a gantlet of trying to get bands for a soundtrack, then getting singles rights for those contributions. Finally, once you've cleared those mine fields, having multiple labels with possibly conflicting agendas converge during the promotion life of the record can be another headache.

"That's always a tricky equation," says Elektra's Thompson, who has his promotion force behind a single from Capitol band Foo Fighters. "But in this particular circumstance it's working great." Elektra can work toward moving the soundtrack in stores, and "it's a benefit to Capitol, because Foo Fighters is a precious artist to their roster," adds Thompson.

But what about Alanis Morissette? Anzaldo says that radio has been asking him every week when the next Morissette album is due. Doubtless her non-industry fans are wondering the same thing. So when they hear "Uninvited" on the radio, how does radio present it? That, says Leeds, is another problem. "The consumer's going to be confused and look for the new Alanis Morissette album in stores," he says. "It's a marketing challenge. It's an issue of trying to get the radio broadcasters to back-announce not just that it's Alanis Morissette, but that it's Alanis Morissette from the 'City Of Angels' soundtrack. It's one thing to try and get radio to back-announce. It's another to get

them to back-announce with the origin of the song. I don't think radio feels any sense of obligation there."

### A&R IN TECHNICOLOR

In the May 20 issue of the Hollywood Reporter, speaking about "The X-Files" soundtrack, Elektra Entertainment Group chairman/CEO Sylvia Rhone said, "I could sign eight bands for [the cost of] one \$4 million soundtrack. It is a considerable decision process."

So, is the label love affair with the soundtrack taking away from artist development? "The shifting of resources is undeniable," says Epic's Douglas, "but at the same time you have the ability to put developing bands on a soundtrack and take advantage of the momentum from the already-established artists."

After RCA's success with "Reality Bites" (and the launch of Lisa Loeb's career—for another label), the label had a shift in focus. "RCA's philosophy has leaned more toward breaking bands through full-length projects. That's not to say that soundtracks are not viable; it just wasn't in our philosophy over the past couple of years," says VP of rock promotion Dave Loncaio.

At Elektra, which is trying to break Feeder by including "High" on the "Can't Hardly Wait" soundtrack, Thompson—asked about Rhone's comments—notes that even with resources committed to a soundtrack, if the company recoups that through sales, "it gives the company more money to develop artists. There's only upside."

But Maverick's Anzaldo is not so sure. "If you're paying \$4 million just to put the soundtrack out, that's a very difficult proposition to

recoup. For the most part, soundtracks are just like records put out by artists. The law of averages for successes are low." But he sees why so much money is being thrown around. "It's very competitive out there . . . Even a hit movie doesn't drive a soundtrack if there's not a hit song on the soundtrack."

Leeds, who agrees that soundtracks still need hit songs to sell, compares them with the compilation albums that do so well in Europe and Canada. He says, "The cost of assembling those soundtracks is very expensive. It's become a cash-cow source for artists to take a non-LP track and license it." And as labels fight each other for marquee artists to fill soundtracks, "it has gotten very pricey lately," he says. And he adds that those heavy-hitting artists won't necessarily obscure the up-and-comers. "It might be a good way to launch an artist's career if you get a hit song on a soundtrack to a hit movie. Smart people will figure out a way to use it to break artists . . . On the urban side, it has helped break and develop new artists."

In the final analysis, soundtracks are as much a part of the big picture of a label as any other album. "There's pressure on every project, and each record has its own budget and bottom line to be profitable," says Anzaldo. "The difference is, when you put out an album, you're at least in it for artist development."

## MONITOR PROFILE

### PD Troy Hanson Elbows Lazer 103 To Top Of Crowded Des Moines Market

For only his second programming job, Troy Hanson was handed the keys of KAZR (Lazer 103) Des Moines, Iowa, in August '96, just weeks after the triple-A station had flipped to active rock. Since his arrival, he has managed to elbow his way to the top of what, despite being market No. 88, is a crowded rock market.

KAZR arrived in the market in the midst of a two-year rock land rush, on the heels of modern KKDM and classic hits KKKQ (98 Rock). All three were making a run at heritage rock Goliath KGGO. "KGGO had owned the rock image in this market for 18-plus years," Hanson says. "It was a 16- to 18-share radio station at some points in time. They were winning by default, if you will. When KKDM came into the market . . . they definitely gave 'GGO a good hit on the lower end." But Hanson says that KKDM was too unfocused, which kept some listeners in the KGGO camp.

On the other side was KKKQ. "It was an au-

tomated station, and it was very apparent, so it really only took a very small chunk out of 'GGO," says Hanson. Then KKKQ picked up the Bob and Tom syndicated show. "That helped [them] gain some momentum and propelled them past 'GGO both 12-plus, 25-54, and in mornings in particular."

Of 98 Rock, he says, "they're doing that great job of polishing off the upper end, while I'm scooping up the 18-34 demo in terms of taking 'GGO out." In the winter Arbitron, KAZR notched a 7.9 12-plus, good for third in the market. KKKQ had a 5.1, KGGO was down to a 4.8, and KKDM was resting at a 3.9.

Hanson says KGGO first tried to react to KAZR's arrival by trying to make "more of that 'best of the old, best of the new' and hang right there with us. I remember a time they were playing 'Possum Kingdom' at 9 in the morning, [but] they have totally abandoned trying to compete with us on a new-music level. Their idea of a new tune these days is John Fogerty."

Hanson first took aim at KKDM, which he considered the most vulnerable competitor because of its "unfocused music policy . . . We made light of the fact that they were a station that played dance music and alternative music. We would make comments like, 'Isn't it funny what some stations are calling rock these days?' And then play the La Bouche song." He used drops from the famous scene in Animal House in which John Belushi imitates a zit. After hearing Belushi say, "Guess what I am now?" the audience would hear dance music and Belushi saying, "I'm a zit, get it?," a reference to KKDM's nickname, the Dot.

Now Hanson's gunning for KGGO. "We take an old Bob Seger record and go, 'Twenty years ago, 'Still the same'; 15 years ago, 'Still the same'; even today, 'Still the same,'" Hanson says.

Musically, Hanson calls KAZR "an alternative, grunge-leaning radio station that isn't afraid to

play Guns N' Roses. We're top-heavy in terms of our Alice In Chains and Pearl Jam and Soundgarden and that's OK for us in this market. While others are saying, 'No, grunge is dead,' people really never got a chance to taste grunge here, because they were being stuck with Bob Seger 24 hours a day."

And while they will highlight library material from Led Zeppelin, Aerosmith, and Van Halen, he says they're cautious in their positioning of such tracks. "'Unchained' by Van Halen rocks, but it also rocked 15 years ago for KGGO, so we don't want to glorify the fact that we're your cutting-edge station and then go into 'Unchained' by Van Halen," says Hanson.

Here's a sample hour on KAZR: Foo Fighters, "My Hero"; Queensryche, "Empire"; Offspring, "Self Esteem"; Judas Priest, "Breaking The Law"; Smashing Pumpkins, "Ava Adore"; Motley Crue, "Wild Side"; Stone Temple Pilots, "Big Bang Baby"; Metallica, "Fade To Black"; Living Colour, "Cult Of Personality"; Pearl Jam, "Even Flow"; Van Halen, "Fire In The Hole"; and Creed, "My Own Prison."

Hanson sees KAZR as claiming the new music franchise in the market. "As the market shakes out and 'GGO is moving back to that classic rock image that they want to try and protect and KKDM is continuing to lose more and more focus with each week of adds, it's allowing me to, in a sense, be more expansive on my playlists in terms of taking chances on newer music without abandoning my own focus," Hanson says.

Hanson looks to the labels for help in breaking acts by concentrating more on quality of product than quantity. "There's just too many record companies putting out too much stuff. There's not enough room on a playlist to support all these bands . . . I feel like I'm adding the record one week, and then I'm being hounded, 'Where are the spins? I need some spins.' I can't give you spins. I've got too many damn records here. I'm continually having to add records, and then four weeks into a project I'm having to leave it, because I've got to add more records. And I never got a chance to give that record week four, that chance it needed to gain familiarity and depth."

"If you can't get something enough spins, you're not going to get a good gauge of what it's going to do research-wise. And if you can't get a good gauge from something from a research perspective, why are you bothering to play something?" he asks.

Beyond the music, Hanson says the other pillar of his station's success is its syndicated morning show. "We picked up Mancow [Muller] May 22, 1997, and that was the day that this radio station took itself to the next level. He did wonders for the station in terms of ratings and revenue."

Hanson notes that Muller is able to give KAZR a lot of localized attention. The station is sending two winners to Chicago to see a Muller show as part of its big spring promotion. And he or his cohorts visit regularly for station events. "We had Mancow here back in December for Mancow's Jingle Ball, and it sold out in 15 minutes," says Hanson. And the station's summer concert will be Mancow's Lazer Luau.

"Mancow has been a lot more accessible than, say, Howard Stern would be," says Hanson, who adds that Stern's too busy with New York, L.A., and Chicago to worry about Des Moines. "Mancow has been much more receptive with his affiliates in terms of getting out to see them. Granted, he doesn't have the 40 stations Stern has. I would like to see him get more affiliates, just to help spread that. I want Mancow to do well. If Mancow does well, we do well."


