Monitor Exclusive: Spring Arbs Show Modern Down, Album Rock Up

Three months ago, when Airplay Monitor looked at Arbitron's national winter numbers, AC radio was up sharply, while top 40, despite the publicity surrounding its resurgence, was flat. That led us to suggest that AC—and adult top 40 in particular—was stealing top 40's thunder, appropriating former country listeners before they could finish the trip back to top 40. At that time, adult top 40 and mainstream top 40 were closer than ever, with top 40 playing relatively little of the rhythmic music that had marked the format's initial ratings rebound.

Now the national Arbitrons for spring are in, and AC, while still the No. 1 music format nationally, is off slightly (15.1-14.9 12-plus). And a more rhythmic top 40, after two disappointing books, is back up 8.2-8.9. Overall, news/talk remains the No. 1 format, off 16.2-16.1 and still receiving surprisingly little help from the presidential scandal. It's followed by No. 2 AC and No. 3 R&B, which was down 11.8-11.7, apparently on the basis of a steep drop at adult R&B outlets.

Country, which was off sharply in the winter, was down only 9.8-9.7 this time, holding fourth place. Top 40 was fifth, followed by album rock (6.8-7.2). Spanish-language radio (up 6.3-6.6, setting a new record), oldies (5.8-5.6), classic rock (4.7-4.8), and modern rock, which was off 4.0-3.8 and finally starting to show signs of its much-publicized decline after more than a year of flat ratings. They were followed by adult standards (3.5-3.4) and jazz (3.2-3.0).

Monitor's exclusive national Arbitron survey, which enters its 10th year this spring, is based on quarterly ratings for Arbitron's continuous-measurement markets.

Here's a rundown of the major formats, in order: News/talk, which was off three-tenths of a share in the winter, slipped another tenth of a share in the spring, despite a news-heavy winter that should have favored the format. N/T was off sharply in middays (17.3-16.4) but got a nice baseball spike at night, up 12.8-15.6. Since the national numbers are often heavily affected by the largest markets, a little credit for that should go to the New York Yankees, whose phenomenal season drove

More Jacor Changes: SLC, SJ, Phoenix

Album **KSJO**/classic rock **KUFX** San Jose, Calif., PD **Dana Jang** exits the Jacor properties. He'll continue consulting with Lund Consultants and is entertaining future full-time offers at 408-866-2015. Jacor's Cincinnati director of FM operations, **Jim Richards**, whose duties include album **WEBN** and classic rock **WOFX**, is leaving the market to oversee programming at **KSJO**, **KUFX**, and the 104.9 frequency, which is currently simulcasting **KUFX** but will be bowing a new format soon as **KLDZ**.

In addition, Jacor picks up **KZSF** San Francisco from Z-Spanish Radio Network for \$16.5 million. The station joins **KZWC** in simulcasting **KSJO** in the 92 Rock Network.

In other Jacor news, Salt Lake City GM **Tom Sly** is upped to VP/market manager (he'll now oversee **KZHT**, **KKAT**, **KURR**, **KODJ**, **KNRS**, and **KALL**). **WMJI** Cleveland GM **Rick Weinkauf** is named GM for **KLOU** and **KSD** St. Louis (where he'll report to **Lee Clear**, who was named St. Louis market manager last week). In addition, veteran programmer **Lee Douglas**—formerly with classic rock **WCKG** Chicago—is named station manager for the Jacor Salt Lake properties.

At recently acquired **KGLQ** Phoenix, currently a classic rocker, **GM Bruce Blevis** and PD **Shaun Holly** exit. Cross-town modern adult **KZZP** GM **Dave Pugh**, PD **Dan Persigehl**, and APD/MD **Dave Cooper** all assume the same duties at **KGLQ**.

BUSINESS: CBS DEALS WITH ENTERCOM

CBS and Entercom finally deal their stations in Boston and Tampa, Fla., to each other. Entercom picks up five CBS Boston properties, including album **WAAF** and classic hits **WEGQ**, for \$140 million. CBS spends \$75 million for two Entercom Tampa properties. The deal brings CBS in line with Justice Department requirements in Boston. Meanwhile, Entercom files with the Securities and Exchange Commission for an initial public stock offering, joining the growing list of radio companies that have gone public.

Bill Betts, GM of Citadel's Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, Pa., properties (including album **WZMT**), will exit by the end of the month. Look for Betts to resurface at Citadel's Allentown, Pa., stations.

Billboard Bulletin reports that SFX Entertainment has purchased concert promoter Cellar Door in a deal valued at \$100 million.

Cellar Door handles concerts in the Southeast and Midwest, with venues from Virginia to Florida, as well as Michigan, Wisconsin, and Ohio. Cellar Door chairman **Jack Boyle** is expected to join **SFX** and run its music group.

Cumulus continues its growth, picking up three new stations in Montgomery, Ala., including album **WXFX**. To correct an item in last week's issue, it's **WXFX** PD **Scott Hamilton** who is headed for **WBVR** Fort Wayne, Ind.

Massachusetts has enacted a law that prevents broadcast employers from requiring employees to agree to non-compete clauses. **AFTRA** was a supporter of the legislation signed by Governor **Paul Cellucci**.

FORMATS: KRAD GOES MODERN

Tired of all the modern rock defections? Album **KRAD** Corpus Christi, Texas, flips to modern under newly named PD **Cory Smith**. **Smith** takes over from the exiting **Kenny Mann** and had been MD at the station. He reports to group PD **Mark McKenzie**, who is based at modern sister **KHLR** Bryan, Texas.

Classic rock **WKSX** Hammond, La., is the newest client of the Research Group's Virtual Radio multi-market automation service.

PROGRAMMING: WELLINGTON TO KXTE

Call it the Detroit/Las Vegas exchange program. A few weeks after modern **KXTE** Las Vegas PD **Mike Stern** was tapped as PD of album **WKRK** Detroit, album rival **WRIF's** APD, **Dave Wellington**, gets the **KXTE** PD seat. **KXTE** MD **Chris Ripley** exchanges the acting-PD role he's filled for the past few weeks for APD stripes. He returns to afternoons.

Album **WZTA**/classic rock **WBGG**/smooth jazz **WLVE** Miami OM **Gregg Steele** becomes regional PD for parent Clear Channel's south Florida properties, extending his reach to the company's Key West properties. So does top 40 **WHYY**/hot AC **WPLL** Miami OM **Rob Roberts**.

One of the most established names in consulting, **Burkhart/Douglas & Associates**, will be completely assimilated into **McVay Media** by Sept. 1. B/D&A president **Greg Gillispie** will be **McVay's** VP of rock and alternative programming.

MTV VP of music programming **Ken Benson** exits. **Benson** expects to return to radio and plans to announce his next career move in a couple of weeks. He will remain at MTV until sometime in September.

PEOPLE: GOLDSTEIN TO APD

Triple-A **KKZN** (the Zone) Dallas ups MD/middays **Abby Goldstein** to APD.

Darian O'Toole, recently departed from mornings at classic rock **WAXQ** (Q104.3) New York, returns to San Francisco for wake-ups at similarly formatted **KSAN**.

Album **WMMS** Cleveland has made some on-air changes. Morning hosts **Darla** and **Corey**, middayer **Craig Dori**, and overnigher **BLF Bash** all exit.

With **Bob** and **Tom** now on mornings at album **WNCD** Youngstown, Ohio, the morning show of PD **Chris Patrick**, **Fred Woak**, **Dana Steel**, and **Butcher** move to afternoons. Afternoon host **Joe Rogers** gets overnights, while overnight host **Terry Williams** will board op for the **Bob** and **Tom** feed.

Following up on last week's report of **Andrew "Dice" Clay** filling in on **Mancow Muller's** morning show on modern **WKQX** (Q101) Chicago, The Chicago Tribune reports that **Clay** is in negotiations to be a regular contributor to the show.

Modern **KLYY** (Y107) Los Angeles P/T **Kat Corbett** is now doing morning news at the station.

Album **WRCX** Chicago P/T **Julio** fills the

At the same time, **Universal** senior VP of promotion **Steve Leeds** will navigate the dicey terrain of "Who Owns What Acts." **KROQ** L.A. VP of programming **Kevin Weatherly**,

MCA senior VP **Nancy Levin**, and **Dave Holmes** of **Netwerk Productions**—management for **Sarah McLachlan** and **Barenaked Ladies**—will be among those discussing what becomes of an act once numerous stations and formats in a market lay claim to it.

New to this year's lineup is the artist panel, on which recording artists from various formats discuss radio from their perspective. **Sugar Ray's** **Mark McGrath** is confirmed for the panel, which runs 3:30-4:45 p.m. Sept. 18.

The Sept. 17 event kicks off the seminar with 36 foursomes participating in a scramble-format tournament across an award-winning desert-style course. The par-72 course is the site of the **PGA's Arizona Classic**.

N2K Restructuring Claims Four Staffers

MUSICAL CHAIRS: With the restructuring of **N2K Encoded Music's** pop/rock department, the following staffers exit: senior VP of promotion **Don Coddington** (212-496-8885), VP of promotion **Susanne White** (718-330-9644), Los Angeles-based national promotion director **Scott Gordon** (310-550-1155), and Atlanta-based national promotion director **Jordan Zucker** (678-475-0627). Former **Curb Northeast** regional **Patrick Milanese** quickly shifts from **N2K** to **Elektra**, handling **Philadelphia** promo duties.

Elektra ups senior director of adult alternative promotion **Lisa Michelson** to VP of adult alternative promotion... Reprise senior VP of A&R/staff producer **Rob Cavallo** joins **Hollywood** as senior VP of A&R... **Sire** promotes **William Marion** to national director of rock and alternative promotion... **Revolution/Giant** local **Bob Smith** joins **Reprise** for Seattle duties.

Arista VP of rock promotion **Paul Brown** exits. Reach him at 212-987-7485. **Elektra** national director of alternative promotion **Pete Rosenblum** will head up **Arista** alternative and rock promotion efforts, effective Aug. 31.

HIT, DROP, AND ROLL: **Eve 6's** "Inside Out" (**RCA**) reclaims the top spot on the modern rock chart this issue, only the fourth act in the past three years to do so. In October 1995, the **Goo Goo Dolls'** "Name" regained the top slot after a layoff of two weeks; **Oasis'** "Wonderwall" and **Third Eye Blind's** "Semi-Charmed Life" both hit, dropped, and reclaimed the No. 1 position in March 1996 and July 1997, respectively.

IT'S A FACT: The **Goo Goo Dolls'** "Iris" (**Warner Sunset/Reprise**) hits its 11th week at the top of the **Rock Audience** chart, marking only the third time that a song has spent 11 weeks or more on top of that chart. **Bush's** "Swallowed" spent 11 weeks in the top slot, and **Marcy Playground's** "Sex And Candy" spent 13... **Chris Isaak** returns to the triple-A chart after a two-year absence, as "Please" (**Reprise**) debuts with **Airpower** status at No. 9. **Isaak** hit the top 10 twice in 1996, with "Go Walking Down There" and "Think Of Tomorrow"... **Marilyn Manson's** "The Dope Show" (**Nothing/Interscope**) is the group's highest-debuting track on the mainstream rock chart, entering at No. 32.

CHANGES AND AN EXPLANATION: Effective this week, **KPOI** Honolulu and **WAQZ** Cincinnati are removed from the modern rock panel. **KICT** Wichita, Kan., moves from the modern rock panel to active and mainstream rock. When **Monitor** adds or removes stations from a panel, we run additional, unpublished charts internally. For this reason, the spin counts in the "last week" column listed for some titles on the modern, mainstream, and active rock charts may not match the number of spins printed last week... There are now 51 active rock, 78 modern rock, and 112 mainstream rock reporters.

Airpower criteria for the modern adult chart has been raised from 500 to 800 detections.

Album **CILQ** (Q107) Toronto middayer **Shirley McQueen** exits for classic rock sister **CFMI** Vancouver while she pursues her acting career. P/T **Joanne Wilder** gets middays. Overnigher **Jeff Chalmers** moves to P/T, and **John Moran**, host of **Q107's** hard rock spe-

cialty show, picks up overnights.

Speaking of **Q107's** morning host, while the rest of the world tunes in to the TV premiere of **Howard Stern's** "Radio Show," **Toronto** viewers will have to wait at least a week while **CITY-TV** screens a number of episodes to make sure it's comfortable with the show.

Classic rock **WFXH** Savannah, Ga., adds the syndicated **Lex and Terry** show to mornings. **Tim Bond** moves to afternoons, sending **Angela Mason** to the previously satellite-programmed midday show.

Following modern **KORB** Davenport, Iowa's shift to a more adult modern format last week, **Dave Levora** moves from nights to afternoons, shifting **Roberto** to middays and middayer **Karla Palmer** to nights.

Constantine Uses His Consulting Perspective To Help Reinvent KINK For New Cume

Dennis Constantine, PD of KINK Portland, Ore., says he enjoyed his three years as a consultant before returning to day-to-day programming last year. As a consultant, "I got to go and be inside a lot of radio stations," he says. "You sit around that table with some of the best, smartest people in the industry, and you discuss radio philosophy and radio theory. They always say, 'The teacher learns from the teaching' . . . Being the consultant, I learned a lot, just because I had a kind of a global perspective on a lot of competitive situations and was part of a lot of brainstorming sessions on how to compete in all these individual situations. It was like going to school for me."

In less than a year at KINK, Constantine has piloted the station to one of its best books in more than two years, up 2.8-4.2 12-plus in the spring. He describes Portland as competitive, with KINK parent CBS, Entercom, and Jacor as the primary players, but not in a nasty way. "There's not a lot of meanness at the stations or even in the community. That's one

"Typical Situation"; Beatles, "Something"; Eric Clapton, "Pilgrim"; Pat Metheny, "Last Train Home"; and Bruce Springsteen, "Leap Of Faith."

Keeping the diversity in the station meant it could keep its longstanding "True to the music" slogan, bolstering it with a "True to the music means" series of liners to associate various elements of KINK with that slogan. "We came up with a lot of defining moments on the radio station that really define what 'true to the music' means. So it was a win-win," Constantine says.

The station has also developed a Don't Grow Up campaign. "It's kind of a calling card for people who are in their 40s and 50s who want to stay young at heart," says Constantine. "Everything has to do with being youthful, which gave us the opportunity then to introduce listeners to some of the new sounds that are out there, [such as] the Cherry Poppin' Daddies and some of the youthful music that fits the mold of the radio station and also points out diversity."

The agency that has helped the station come up with these campaigns is Wieden & Kennedy, the brains behind Nike and Microsoft marketing campaigns. "They're probably one of the premier advertising agencies in the world, and they're based here in Portland," says Constantine. "They are fans of KINK, and KINK was one of their first accounts."

Constantine says that off-air image building his alma mater has been part of his game plan from his years at KBCO Boulder, Colo. "Your radio station's only going to talk to a certain percentage of radio listeners in the market. It's almost like preaching to the choir. But when you can get a message out to people who are not your listeners, they go, 'Wow. That's not my image of what KINK is. I should see if that's something I'd be interested in' . . . When you can get those messages out and effectively touch listeners or potential listeners in that way, it's a big win."

Another KBCO export has been a compilation CD chronicling station visits and performances, now a fixture on many promotional calendars. KINK is using its sales to benefit Portland school music programs, which are being cut for budgetary reasons. "We got very proactive with it and said, 'If we're going to have a slogan that says "True to the music," we're going to support music in all ways,'" Constantine says. Those kids it helps are the children of KINK's core, too. Partnering with the schools provided the fringe benefit that "every kid in the Portland schools took home a flyer at the end of school saying KINK is doing this. They're raising money for the music programs. And all you need to do to help is go buy one of these CDs."

While back on the programming front line on a daily basis, Constantine still consults, which he says suits GM Steve Keeney just fine. "He likes the global perspective that it gives me, so that I don't get too introspective about KINK; I can look at it from a view of an outsider," says Constantine. "I've always approached radio stations that way . . . looking at it from the outside, going, 'OK, now, if I'm a new listener tuning in right now, what do I get? What is the message that I'm getting?' A lot of programmers forget that there are new people that are coming across the dial all the time that you need to keep in mind. You can't take it for granted that they know what it means when you say, "My three songs" coming up next.' What does that mean?"

"I'm always looking at the station from that perspective, and consulting keeps that perspective [in the] forefront, because it reminds me that I need to always stay in that space and not get to the point where I become so ingrained on the inside here that I forget to look at the station as listeners do." **MARC SCHIFFMAN**

thing about Portland. People are friendly here. And so the radio competition in Portland is very friendly, too. I don't have any problem with picking up the phone and calling the PD at the Jacor station, because it's more of a community," he says. "It reminds me of the way radio used to be . . . In a lot of markets it got to be vicious, where it got away from that. We want people to listen to the radio. We want to encourage more listening to radio, not 'We're going to steal listeners from the other guy, and that's how we're going to succeed.'"

Constantine's impression of KINK was it "was lacking a clear focus as to what KINK was. It was resting on the brand name and not necessarily defining what that meant. The problem with that is that people who have listened to KINK for years know what KINK is, but it wasn't inviting to new people, because to them, what's KINK? What does that mean?"

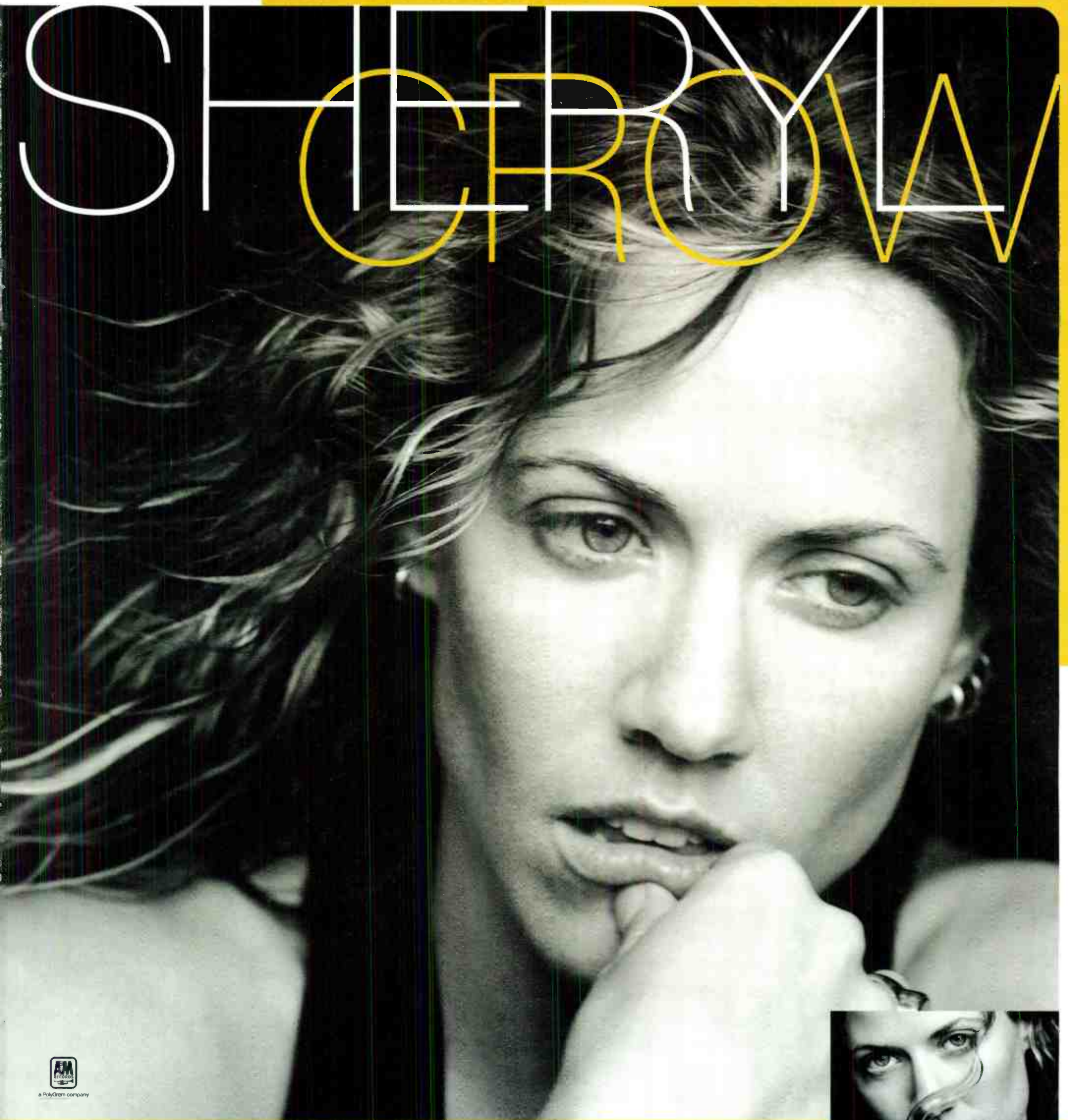
KINK's historically broad musical approach is a double-edged sword. Constantine says, "People know what a country station is. They know what a classic rock station is. They know what a smooth jazz station is, but KINK was not definable musically. We went about finding a clear music definition for the station and giving it more focus."

After extensive research, "I found that vein of music that is the hot button for people, and then we go out from the vein and come back to the vein and go out from the vein and come back to it," says Constantine. That core sound "has to do with the acoustic singer/songwriter. It is based around that . . . Shawn Colvin, Paula Cole, Sarah McLachlan, Bonnie Raitt, Bruce Hornsby, Eric Clapton. It's the '80s and '90s acoustic artist that is our bread and butter."

flagship WABC up 2.2-4.6 during that time.

AC LOSING 18-34 LISTENERS

At a 14.9 share, AC is roughly where it was this time a year ago (when it was at a 14.8). It was down by a tenth or two in most dayparts, except for nights, where it was off 13.1-12.4. Even that, however, was comparable to its numbers as recently as six months ago. AC was off most in the 18-34 demo (16.7-16.2) but relatively stable in 25-54 (17.7-17.5) and 35-64 (17.0-16.9). That would suggest that adult top 40/hot AC stations were probably the ones that got hit this time, rather than their soft or mainstream AC brethren, giving credence to the theory that top 40 is now picking up some of the young adults who were initially opting for adult top 40 or modern adult formats.

Taken as a whole, No. 3 R&B radio is off only a tenth of a share. Most of that is explained by a drop at adult R&B stations, which were off 4.2-3.7 this time. In the winter, adult R&B was stable and smooth jazz rose, while mainstream fell. That led us to believe that the increasingly hip-hop-flavored mainstream format might be running off some of its upper demos. This spring, R&B radio found more uptempo hits it could play, and the result was that mainstream stations nudged forward again. The only daypart where R&B is off by more than a tenth of a share is nights, where it's off 18.7-17.8, again, primarily on the strength of a 5.7-4.9 hit at adult R&B radio. Despite its travails this spring, adult R&B is still at roughly the same level it was during most of '96-'97.

The No. 4 format, country, was off a tenth or two in most dayparts. It rebounded with teens (5.2-5.6) and was flat 35-64 (at an 11.0). It was off 18-34 (9.2-8.6) and 25-54 (10.1-9.7). Country's 18-34 numbers are now at their lowest point since winter '91. Worse, its 25-54 numbers are out of double digits for the first time in the nine-year history of our national survey. The format is now in double digits only in 35-64. In addition, two-thirds of the format's audience is now age 35 or older. It now draws more of its audience from 65-plus listeners (12.6%) than from 18- to 24-year-olds (10.2).

If it seems strange that teens and 35-64s seem to be the demos that are happiest with the format this time, remember that some country consultants are seeing considerable interest in the format's recent oldies-heavy skew from younger listeners, too. Country's female number was flat (a 10.8 share), while its male number was off 9.5-9.3.

By contrast, top 40, after two disappointing books, seems to be back on the road to recovery. The format was up in mornings (7.5-8.0), middays (6.5-7.5, even before the impact of summer vaca-

tion can be fully felt), and afternoons (8.9-9.6). It was flat at night at an 11.8. While the format was off slightly in teens (30.7-30.5), it was up 18-34 (12.4-13.4), 25-54 (6.6-7.4), and 35-64 (4.2-4.6), again suggesting that the growth came from repatriated modern adult or hot AC listeners. Top 40 was up 7.7-8.3 in adult women and 5.3-6.0 in men. The six months in which top 40 was off, by the way, seem to coincide with a period in which dance/pop (something that fueled the format's rebound in early '96) was starting to disappear from mainstream top 40 but hadn't yet been replaced with the R&B crossovers that the format is only finally starting to accept in larger quantities.

ROCK SPRINGS FORWARD

At No. 6, album rock's 6.8-7.2 rise parallels a 6.7-7.0 12-plus rise last spring. Because large-market numbers impact the national numbers so heavily, it probably helped that WNEW New York was again counted as an album rock outlet this spring, after more than a year in classic rock. Album rock was up 18-34 (11.4-12.2) and 25-54 (8.5-9.0). Despite WNEW's defection, classic rock remained in its usual range, meaning that its remaining outlets probably did pretty well. It seems to be getting some help from the ongoing decline of the pop oldies format, as more 25- to 40-year-old listeners decide that a classic rocker, instead, is their oldies station.

As for modern rock, its national numbers had held steady for most of 1997, despite a widely publicized string of station defections and the general perception that the format wasn't as hot as it had been two years previous. Now, you can finally see it trending down, going 4.1-4.0-3.8 over the last six months. Is the modern adult format finally making its impact felt on modern? Well, modern was down sharply with teens (9.5-8.4) but off a little less as the demos get older (7.5-7.2 18-34; 3.9-3.7 25-54; 1.9-1.8 35-64). It was flat with women (at a 2.6) but off with men (4.6-4.4). That its losses were younger and more male would imply modern was hit more heavily by album rock this spring than by modern AC.

Finally, Spanish-language radio, which received a ton of publicity this spring when WSKQ (Mega 97.9) New York tied for that market's top slot, was up nicely nationwide, improving 6.3-6.6 for its highest-ever 12-plus share. That number may heavily reflect WSKQ's success, as well as the addition of a few more 12-plus shares from its new Spanish-language rival WCAA. It also reflects more stations in general. The number of Spanish-language stations that showed in an Arbitron book this spring was 160, up from 145 in the winter.

The Flys Are Stoked On Trauma Debut

Being reared in a family of surfers qualifies as a unique upbringing. And the Flys' singer, Adam Paskowitz, says it imparted some simple truths to him. "The values me and all my brothers carry are that life is super-short. You've got to take it by the balls," says Paskowitz, who is the seventh child in his family. He grew up learning to surf when his father formed the Paskowitz Summer Surf Camp in California's San Onofre State Park, where the family's been based since '72. His 78-year-old father, author of "Surfing And Health," surfs every day. "He always says, 'We die when we stop living.'"

The kindred spirits who have come together to create the Flys' soulful, modern hard rock are a reflection of the singer's family. Paskowitz is a pro surfer, and bass player James Book can usually be found catching waves himself, while drummer Nick Lucero opts for free-falling from airplanes. It's this penchant for extreme sports and living life to the fullest that is conveyed in the title song of the band's forthcoming Trauma debut set, "Holiday Man." Amid a slamming Rage Against The Machine type groove, Paskowitz and younger brother/rapper Joshua team up for provocative street-style rhymes and a classic, melodic Ozzy Osbourne-ish chorus (the imploring refrain is "Why don't you get out and take your chances on a holiday?").

Formed five years ago in Hollywood, the Flys were approached by Delicious Vinyl last year to record with producer Chris Goss (formerly of Masters Of Reality and producer of albums by Scott Weiland and Kyuss). With their inclusion on Trauma's "Disturbing Behavior" soundtrack, the Flys were licensed to Trauma two months ago. Their debut is scheduled for release Aug. 25.

On "Holiday Man," the Flys pursue heavy rock in a contemporary setting. More influenced by funk, hip-hop, and psychedelic rock than Black Sabbath, the band still has a reverence for his Ozness—in fact, Adam Paskowitz designed a vocal processor to enable him to emulate the former Black Sabbath vocalist's voice. But Paskowitz's own introduction to music was through far different channels. The 28-year-old

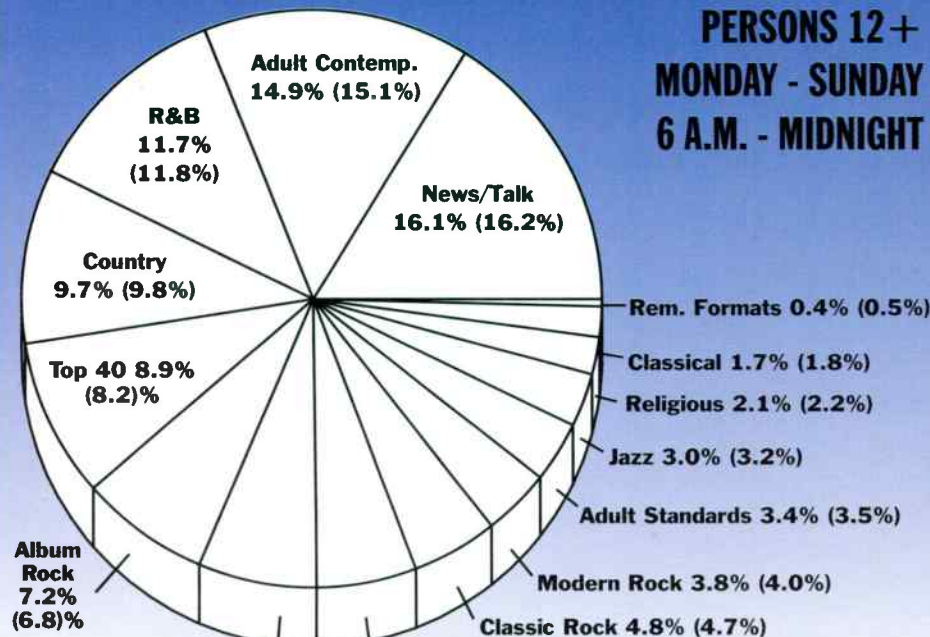
singer names Johnny Mathis, Nat "King" Cole, and Pete Townshend as early influences (the Who's "Won't Get Fooled Again" was an epiphany in his musical development).

One aspect of the Flys' vision that Paskowitz doesn't want misconstrued is his alternative upbringing. Some would correlate a life of "wearing grass skirts" with dropping out. Far from it, says the singer. "My dad's a Stanford graduate [and a] doctor. He's like this maniacal, scientist guru who started surfing all over the world. He wasn't laid-back," explains Paskowitz, who adds that his dad eschewed the prestige of being a medical adviser to the shah of Iran and was involved with the U.S. government's top secret Manhattan Project during World War II and with the development of NASA's space program. Older brother Jonathan is one of the founders of Black Flys Eyewear Co., which invented the wrap-around sunglasses that give the band its name. "Even though it is the ultimate hippie lifestyle, there were 11 of us living in a camper; it was very, very intense. It wasn't the Partridge Family. It was like 'Mosquito Coast' without the backlash."

Paskowitz doesn't know what it's like to be shy about his own convictions, despite how untrendy they may be for the "alternative"-obsessed '90s. Asked what the essence of the Flys would be, he responds, "We're like the homeless James Bond. We are the new face of metal. We're a throwback to Ozzy with short hair, and we're surfers—good surfers. That's what I would say."

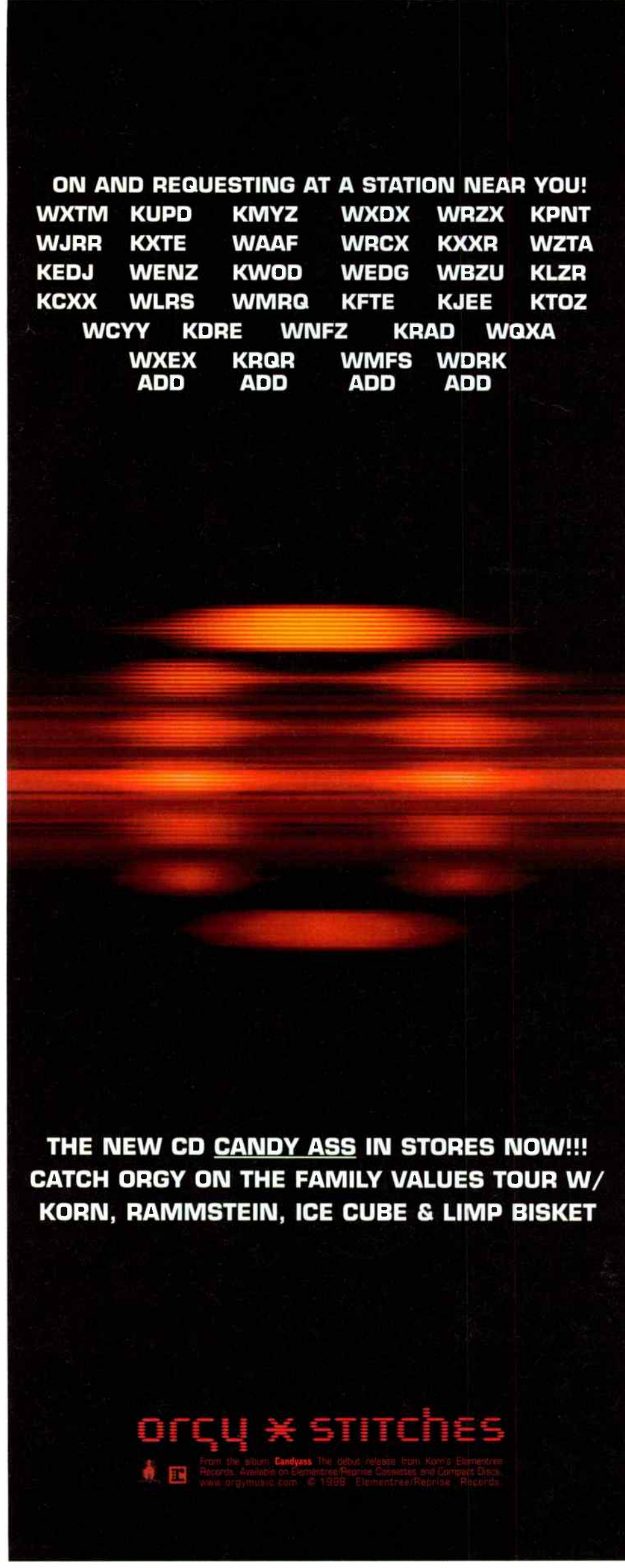
