## Veteran Broadcasters Find The Secret To Eternal Freshness

"I've been doing this for over 27 years," country KNIX Phoenix VP/general program manager Larry Daniels says. "Some days, it seems like 50 years. On other days, it's like I started yesterday."

Even so, Daniels still thinks his job is "kind of neat," which is one reason why he and other veteran programmers (and some on-air personalities) surveyed by Airplay Monitor have continued to be successful and avoided ending up in a creative rut, despite long stretches at a single station. Other suggestions: constantly freshening your station, within reason, and relying on outside input from your staff or networking buddies.

"You constantly have to look in the mirror and reinvent yourself," top 40 WFLY Albany, N.Y., OM Mike Morgan says. "We ask if we're still relevant and entertaining and if we're changing every day. It's not like you sign on and stay the way you started. Radio is a growing process; you have to change year to year to maintain freshness."

KIIS Los Angeles morning legend Rick Dees says, "I try to re-create an entirely new morning show every year. But there's no formula to doing that. You either know how or you don't. It's like asking Michael Jordan how he knows when to shoot the fall-away jumper. He just does it. I've been lucky in that I always seem to know what and when to change."

### CHANGE FROM WITHIN

One obvious way to freshen up the station is to use new sweepers, jingles, and liners. Promotions and contests, even basic ones, can also be revamped to come off as new and exciting. "We've given away dozens of cars over the eight years I've been here, but by running a 'live in it and win it' contest in a mall, which attracted heavy media coverage for a good month, we generated the most excitement ever," WFLY's Morgan asserts.


"You just try to have fun with various things and take nothing for granted," says R&B KPRS Kansas City OM/PD Sam Weaver. "Each time we get close to the money [spring and fall] books, I start going right over things again—sprucing up contests, what's on the air, syndicated programming. That's motivation for me because it's fun."

"All you're doing is retuning," he continues. "Don't tinker just for the sake of tinkering. Ask yourself if what you're doing is actually improving something."

Country WSOC Charlotte, N.C., PD Paul Johnson says, "Every three to four years, we try to retool our approach. Having programmed since 1975, I have the benefit of pulling up something I used many years ago but is now brand new again."

KNIX's Daniels also changes his work schedule to stay fresh. "Every once in a while, I'll change my schedule to prevent a rut," he says. "Being a



## Clear Channel, Jacor Put 20 On Block

To satisfy Department of Justice requirements surrounding their merger, Clear Channel and Jacor have announced the spinoff of 20 stations in five markets, including Cleveland's album WNCX and modern WENZ; triple-A WHPT Tampa, Fla.; classic rock WBGB Jacksonville, Fla.; Louisville, Ky.'s modern WLRS and classic rock WSFR; and classic rock WING-FM Dayton, Ohio.

Citadel Communications is picking up 16 radio stations from Wicks Broadcast Group, for \$77 million, including classic rock WAAL Binghamton, N.Y.

### PROGRAMMING: A HOLIDAY CARROL

Album KLB Austin, Texas, OM/PD Jeff Carroll picks up OM duties at sister triple-A KGSR. The new responsibilities mean that Carroll will drop his afternoon shift. Incidentally, Carroll and KGSR PD Jody Denberg worked together at KLB when Denberg was Carroll's MD.

Former MTV VP of programming Ken Benson finally has an official title for his long-pending job at Chancellor: programming and operations specialist. Initially, he'll be based in Denver, lending his talents to modern rocker KXPK (the Peak), modern adult KALC (Alice 106), AC KIMN, and their sister stations.

Album KEZO Omaha, Neb., acting PD/MD/middayer Bruce Patrick is named PD. That job has been vacant since before the death of cluster programmer Doug Sorensen.

Classic rock KRKO Oklahoma City PD Jeff Couch adds those duties at sister AC KMGL.

### BUSINESS: SWEEPING SATELLITE DEVELOPMENTS

Billboard Bulletin reports that XM Satellite Radio has pacted with Alpine, Pioneer, and Sharp to manufacture and distribute satellite-capable radios and audio systems. The radios will offer AM, FM, and XM radio capability. CD and tape players will also be available on the systems.

SW Networks VP of engineering and new technology Mark Kalman joins the growing staff at XM rival CD Radio as VP national broadcast studio, overseeing the facility that will originate the 100 channels of original digital programming to be fed via satellite.

Heritage Media Corp. founder and former Radio Group president Paul Fiddick joins Motorola subsidiary RadioWave.com as vice chairman and member of the board of the ISP.

### FORMATS: ROCK OUTLETS NEARLY TRIPLE SINCE 1989

M Street has released its 10-year analysis of format trends in commercial radio. Rock radio, in all its various permutations, has shown dramatic growth from a 1989 count of 365 stations in a universe of 9,254 to 868 stations out of 10,394 in 1998. That's a 137% increase over 10 years. Of total stations, rock had a 3.9% share in 1989 and posted an 8.4% this year.

The University of Colorado launches non-commercial AM KVCU Denver with a free-form/modern format.

M Street reports that KSOB Dell Rapids, S.D., signs on as classic rock the Renegade.

### PEOPLE: DOINGS IN DENVER

Jones Satellite Radio Network's Doug Clifton returns to local Denver radio as APD on classic rock KKHK (the Hawk). He'll be on the air from noon to 3 p.m., preceded by LaLaine, who also joins from Jones for 9 a.m.-noon. Clifton previously programmed triple-A KBCO and modern KXPK (the Peak). The latter station has picked up Howard Stern for mornings. Ironically, Stern looked bound for KKHK only a few months ago.

Modern KFMZ (the Buzz) Columbia, Mo., salesperson Tara joins similarly formatted WKQX (Q101) Chicago as part of the Mancow morning team. Meanwhile, modern KNRX Kansas City is no longer carrying the syndicated Mancow in mornings.

## Big Staff Changes At Warner Bros.

PERSONNEL FILE: Warner Bros. let go of approximately 45 employees Nov. 20. Among those exiting are executive VP of A&R Ted Templeman, senior VP of marketing Jon Leshay, and senior VP of A&R Karin Berg.

550 Music adds former A&M promo man Fred Shade for Philadelphia regional duties, former WEND Charlotte, N.C., MD Rick Brewer in Washington, D.C., and former Jeff McClusky & Associates staffer Marina Parrera in Denver.

Billboard Bulletin reports that Columbia Records Group is set to launch a new label early next year. It will draw its roster from other imprints in the Columbia family and will have its own promotion and marketing staffers.

CHART WATCH: Metallica's "Turn The Page" (Elektra/EEG) has the highest number of spins per week at both active and mainstream rock for 1998.

"Lullaby" (SMG/Columbia) is both Shawn Mullins' first appearance and first No. 1 on the modern adult chart.

Cake earns its first No. 1 at modern rock with "Never There" (Capricorn/Mercury). Last week's No. 1 song, Lenny Kravitz's "Fly Away" (Virgin), still has the highest audience of any modern rock title this week.

The Fly's "Got You (Where I Want You)" (Delicious Vinyl/Trauma) has earned a bullet for 16 weeks in a row, tying Eve 6 for consecutive bulleted weeks in 1998.

WXLE Albany, N.Y., is removed from the triple-A panel, following the completion of its evolution to adult top 40. There are now 22 triple-A reporting stations.

Veteran morning man J.C. Corcoran exits album KSD St. Louis.

Modern KLYY (Y107) Los Angeles morning man Chris Hardwick exits to concentrate on his TV show. Similarly, crosstown album KLOS afternoon host Garth Kemp exits to concentrate on his other job—weatherman on KLOS' sister TV station.

Modern WBTZ Burlington, Vt., morning man Kyle Smith joins noncommercial triple-A WYEP Pittsburgh for mornings.

Look for album WBYR Fort Wayne, Ind., APD/MD Roxanne McVay to join her former boss John Rozz at album WRXK Fort Myers, Fla., where she will be APD/MD/middays, replacing the recently exited Susan Stone.

Album WXVO Knoxville, Tenn., picks up John Yuhas for mornings from afternoons at country sister WIVK. Yuhas' arrival allows Matt Anthony to concentrate full time on his production director duties.

Album WZZL Paducah, Ky., picks up the syndicated Bob and Tom morning show as Scott Turner exits the station. Also, afternoon

host Beth Clark drops back to P/T as Stone Michaels signs on for afternoons.

Modern adult outlet WBMX Boston P/T Kelly joins classic rock outlet WZMX Hartford, Conn., for nights.

Modern WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia overnighter Monkeyboy exits for swing/production/promotion at top 40 WDRQ Detroit, where he's evolved to the name Clark Kent.

Meanwhile, back at WPLY, Andy Gradel joins for P/T. He's a veteran of Asbury Park, N.J., stations album WRAT and modern WHTG.

Modern adult WQSH Louisville taps Jason Davis from crosstown WDJX for nights.

Triple-A WXRT Chicago middayer Terri Hemmert celebrates 25 years at the station with a Dec. 10 broadcast from the Museum of Broadcast Communications, according to the Chicago Sun Times. The paper also reports that their pop music critic Jim DeRogatis and Tribune rock critic Greg Kot will host a new music talk show on WXRT starting next year.

big baseball fan, a couple times a year I go on a baseball trip with a few industry buddies to beautiful ballparks like Fenway and Wrigley Field."

The "all work and no play . . ." attitude also goes for KNIX's entire staff. In fact, station employees have access to an in-house exercise and weight room. "I'm not talking about a glorified closet; this is a big, professional room," Daniels notes. "Plus, we have a trainer who works with them. It helps a lot of people, although to be honest I probably use it less than anyone else, which I admit is ridiculous."

Album rock WCCC Hartford, Conn., PD/p.m. driver Michael Picozzi uses creativity to keep everyone on his or her creative toes. "It's a great big chess game," he says. "It stays fresh because I can watch TV and say, 'That's a good idea,' and be able to use it the next day. I regularly sit with my staff and ask them, 'What did you do last night?' That's how we come up with new ideas and then carry them out."

Country WAMZ Louisville, Ky., PD Coyote Calhoun credits his on-air work as a way to stay fresh. "For the past 18-plus years, I've always been on the air," he says. "And during the big books, I've been out at appearances for at least two hours a day. I also manage a local country music club. Constantly having contact with your listeners is bound to keep you fresh."

KIIS' Dees notes, "Our company does a lot of focus studies, and I've found them to be very useful. I also always welcome others' input, although most of the time I can feel it when something is losing its freshness."

### EYE ON THE OUTSIDE WORLD

Another key to eternal freshness: keeping an eye on what's happening outside the station. "It's a tired phrase, but you've got to get out on the street," WCCC's Picozzi states. "A lot of PDs and jocks say they're 'street,' but they're not. Street isn't talking to a band backstage at a concert; it's talking to the listeners at the concert. You need to know what they're talking about. They're not all beer-swilling morons."

Mainstream R&B WEDR Miami OM/morning host James Thomas says, "I try to keep abreast as to what's going on in the three counties we're broadcasting to and how national news affects them. You can find humor in the news, as well as address serious issues. It's important to provide humor and service to your listeners. Staying in touch with your community and the younger minds always keeps you fresh as to their concerns. Knowing their thoughts and needs will always keep you fresh."

Another great way to stay on point is to look outside your market and format. "It's like a small village. I've worked in every format and enjoy the opportunity to hang with friends in other formats," KPRS' Weaver says. "What they're doing helps motivate me. We start exchanging ideas. I'll air one of their promotions, and people won't figure out where the idea came from."

And if that's not enough, there's your not-so-friendly neighborhood stations. "The fear of my competition kicking my ass motivates me every day," rhythmic top 40 KPWR (Power 102) El Paso, Texas, PD John Candelaria says. "Direct competition gets the juices flowing. Nothing has been handed to me. I'm not the smartest guy in town, and my owner doesn't have big pockets, so I have to find different ways to get the job done."

"I really don't have to avoid complacency, because the competitive landscape is always changing," WAMZ's Calhoun adds. "If you're not fresh and the guy across the street is in your face, you're going to lose your audience. Competition makes for better competitors, and there's a lot more gratification when you win with a competitor around."

"The key is to work at a station in a market that never sleeps, which challenges and rewards you," KNIX's Daniels adds. "Then hire people who have better ideas than you. I learned a lot from people who knew what they were doing and learned what not to do from people who didn't know what they were doing."

The most common answer for preventing routine-itis: hiring the right people and exploiting their talents. "A great staff makes you great," WSOC's Johnson says. "Our staff is very bright. They know what their job is and what entertains their audience."

### THE RIGHT JOB

In the end, it all comes back to the original reason everyone got in this job—a love of music and radio. "I'm still a music fan first," states Dave Frisina, 20-year veteran of album rock WAQX Syracuse, N.Y. "I'm not in it for the business. I go to a show to recharge, and just to catch the buzz of seeing a live band reminds me of what I'm doing. I never take that for granted."

Modern rock WBCN Boston PD Oedipus still hosts "Nocturnal Emissions," the longest-running new-music show in the country. "There's always fresh music to get excited about," he says. "When the music stops exciting me, I'll get out of the business."

KIIS' Dees claims his gig is still so much fun that he'd "love to have it go on forever. Actually, I pegged the number of days left [in his contract] to the number of house payments I have to make," he says with a laugh. "It's the new math. Plain and simple, though, I truly love what I do. I look at each show as putting new topping on the ice cream. I also truly love the money. I've always loved the money, ever since I was 6 years old, selling mistletoe. In a way, I'm still selling it now."

In fact, the biggest key to long-term success in radio may be self-motivation. "It's all a state of mind," rhythmic top 40 WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago MD Erik Bradley asserts. "Sure, the weekly music logs and music calls can get to be the same, but there's so many things to do here, be it working with talent, interacting with artists, or listening to new music. A lot of variety keeps the job fresh and fun."

Album rock WPYX Albany PD John Cooper says, "This is not assembly-line work. Something is always happening in the job. There's always something different going on, be it new technology, new owners, new music, or new personalities. That keeps it fresh."

As WCCC's Picozzi notes, "I get up each and every morning and go, 'They pay me for this? Nice scam.'"

## Touch And Go Asks, 'Would You . . . ?'

We've all probably experienced the teenage awkwardness and insecurity of the school dance. David Lowe, thinking back on his formative days in Birmingham, England, put such an experience in a modern context for Touch And Go's "Would You . . . ?" Lowe says, "I just thought it would be a brilliant idea to come out with a track that asked the question without you really having to say anything."

Up to now, Lowe has made a living composing music for TV commercials, most notably the world-beat accompaniment to a successful British Airways spot in 1992. This April, while writing a South American-sounding piece for a TV program about a round-the-world yacht race, Lowe began experimenting with Brazilian-style motifs and hatched the idea for Touch And Go.

Another TV project contained a nervous-sounding woman trying to pick up a man she finds attractive. The words made Lowe recall being a young man at a dance hall seated rigidly across from the unapproachable girls carousing on the dancefloor together. "It's for people out there like I was in my early years as a bit of a shy individual who didn't have the guts to go up to anybody. You could basically wait until the track came on and then just have a quick nod and a wink at somebody that you fancy and then, presto, everything else would have been said for you. So I thought it would be great to be like a dance track."

Despite having just that dance track in its canon at the moment, Touch And Go is not viewed by its creator as a one-off, faceless studio project destined for Right Said Fred or White Town status. Lowe previously had a solo album called "Dreamcatcher" on Island last year and was working on a new project when "Would You . . . ?" was picked up by British independent Oval. "The whole concept of the thing was to have a live-band feel. We wanted to have a band that could play it, as opposed to having a bunch of session people on the stage that didn't even know each other," he says. The Latin-flavored act is made up of musicians Lowe had worked with on "Dreamcatcher" and other projects, including three women who sing and play a variety of instruments, including drums, keyboards, and violin.

Lowe started his career at a local radio station in Birmingham, where he developed a preference for the media side of the entertainment business. "Studio work and production . . . is much more my thing than playing live," says Lowe. "That was also one of the reasons why I'm not playing in the band at the moment, as it enables me to sort of carry on working here [writing more songs]."

Lowe won't identify the American actress whose voice he sampled from a TV program for the song's hook but offered an interpretation of the emotion conveyed by the music. "I suppose in a way the trumpet is sort of the answer to the question. The girl is nervous asking the question, and of course when you hear a question like that being asked, you just go completely wild basically." Which is just how the guys at the dance hall would have reacted.






