## Frighteningly True Stories Of Contest Winners From Hell

Contesting raises the profile of a station, helps brand call letters, provides value-added opportunities for advertisers, and, one hopes, boosts ratings. It also opens a station to characters of questionable character. Monitor asked stations to go into their problem-winner files (which at least one promotion director literally maintains) and recall America's least-wanted winners.

At album WEBN Cincinnati, PD Michael Walter recalls the listener who won a five-city Van Halen concert tour: "We never did find out if he made it to any of the shows, but we did get a city-by-city damage report from the hotels as he went along. His penchant for flinging used condoms around the rooms seems to be his legacy. Oh, and he didn't have a credit card to help secure anything along the way, so our Warner Bros. rep had to use his."

Walter also tells of a recent winner of a trip to see Metallica in Chicago. Was he happy with his prize? Maybe, but who could tell? He only called to "bitch that we were pronouncing his name wrong when congratulating him," Walter says.

### KISS OFF

Album WDHA Morristown, N.J., promotion director Eddie Lee Roth recalls last year's Kiss flyaway to L.A. "For whatever reason, they canceled a couple of West Coast dates, and of course one of them was the date that [the winner] was scheduled to attend," Roth says. "I tried to hook him up with another trip, unsuccessfully. Any Kiss product that came within arms reach of me, I sent him." But nothing appeased him. Then Kiss came to town.

"I set him up with a pair of pretty good seats. His reaction was, 'Where are my front rows? When can I meet them?' I told him that these were the best seats I had access to, and they were not doing any meet-and-greets this time around. He said, 'Thanks, but no thanks.' I left the tickets for him anyway, and he did come and pick them up. I then got a call from him saying that he sold the tickets to a friend and that he'll be waiting for a call from me next time Kiss comes around. I hope this is their last tour."

### THE LEMON GUY

When you work in promotions at album KRAB/top 40 KKXX Bakersfield, Calif., there's one phrase that strikes fear when uttered at a remote: "Omigod, it's the Lemon Guy."

Promotion director Robin Pechota says the Lemon Guy was initially merely annoying, showing up at remotes all the time, that sort of thing. The issue came to a head when he showed up at a remote that KKXX was doing at a local Nissan dealer. "We were serving pizza and Coca-Cola," says Pechota. "He showed up with his wife and kids and was friendly. He got some food and signed up for whatever we were giving away. Twenty minutes later, we see three or four salespeople chasing this guy out in the lot. He had taken his bottle of Coke and shook it up and sprayed it all over the cars." They chased him away with threats of calling the police.

But that wasn't the last they saw of the listener, who drove up in a beat-up old Nissan that he parked in front of the dealer and emptied a bag of lemons on. He proceeded to tell every-

### Van Horne Defamation Suit Moves Forward

## Chancellor Not Negligent in Mancow Hiring

The Chicago Sun-Times reports that the Illinois Supreme Court has ruled that Chancellor can't be charged with negligence for employing morning man **Mancow Muller**. The case stems from a defamation lawsuit filed by Chicago Bear **Keith Van Horne** against Mancow, his former news anchor **Irma Blanco**, his former employer **WRCX**, and Chancellor. In addition to the more than \$5 million in damages Van Horne seeks, he charged that Chancellor, then Evergreen, was negligent in hiring Mancow since they knew he had a history of controversial on-air stunts. Justice **Michael Bilandic** ruled that if he'd upheld the negligence claim, "such a holding would have [had] an inevitable chilling effect on free speech, as media employers would be reluctant to hire controversial broadcaster[s] or reporters."

All this stems from a November 1994 broadcast after Mancow encountered Van Horne, who was working at a sister outlet, in the halls of the station. Mancow claims that Van Horne had threatened to kill him, and the morning man went on-air and allegedly called the football player "psychotic," "an extremely violent individual," and "a Charles Manson who works out." The defamation part of the case will now go forward.

Also in the Windy City, The Chicago Sun-Times confirms that talk **WCKG** Chicago p.m. driver **Steve Dahl** will return on-air in Detroit via a syndicated feed on album sister **WKRK**. And the Chicago Tribune reports that another **WCKG** jock, **Jonathon Brandmeier**, whose show is picked up from talk **KLSX** L.A., is in talks with Beach Cities Broadcasting about further syndicated opportunities.

### BUSINESS: EXPANDING DUTIES

Classic rock **WAXQ** (Q104.3) New York GM **Kathy Stinehour** expands her duties to include recent adult top 40-to-R&B oldies convert **WBIX**.

Journal Broadcast Group executive VP for radio **Carl Gardner** is elected president for the group's radio stations.

At Jones Radio Network, VP of programming **Phil Barry** is upped to VP/GM. Also, **Michael Henderson** is upped to VP of affiliate sales, and **Karen Barich** is promoted to VP of finance. Jones Radio Network will shut down its Rock Alternative format as of Dec. 31.

Classic rock outlet **WESP** Dothan, Ala., changes hands from Signal Enterprises to Gulf South Communications in a \$1.4 million deal. **WESP** GM **Jaine Bush** becomes GSM, and **Tom Nebel**, GM of Gulf South country sister **WDJR**, picks up GM duties over **WESP**.

The Hollywood Reporter reports that Taylor Made Golf is inking a deal with the newly formed CBS Plus cross-media sales unit. The deal gives Taylor Made access to CBS' TV network, TV stations, Infinity Radio,

and TDI outdoor media. If it sounds reminiscent of a recent deal CBS did with Pennzoil, you're right. This is the first deal put together under the CBS Plus aegis, though.

### FORMATS: ROCKIN' AGAIN

Triple-A **WOBR** Elizabeth City, N.C., returns to album rock under new PD **Lonnie Napier**, also PD of R&B oldies sister **WKJS**. Napier replaces **Jim Herring**, now with Capstar's Richmond, Va. stations, including modern AC **WMXB**. The syndicated **John Boy** and **Billy** replace Herring in mornings.

### PROGRAMMING: A RICH OM

Album **KSEZ** Sioux City, Iowa, OM/middayer **Rich Randall** comes off the air to become OM over **KSEZ** and its four sisters. PD/mornings **Tom Stevens** gets middays, and **Greg McCullough** returns to the station after a year's sabbatical.

### SYNDICATION: U.S. BLUES

"The House Of Blues Radio Hour," recently dropped from Westwood One, has been picked up by United Stations. It will also carry "The House Of Blues Breaks." **NBG** Radio Network has its new "Rock Around The World" program set for a Jan. 4 debut. The series draws on a library of 200 shows, featuring interviews and performances from the '70s, that spotlight the likes of **Bob Dylan** and **David Bowie**.

### PEOPLE: PROUD MARY ROLLS

Former **WRVW** (the River) Nashville a.m. host "Proud" **Mary Glenn Lassister** goes to classic rock sister **WNRQ** (the Rock) for afternoons.

Modern adult **WKZL** Winston-Salem, N.C., morning co-host **Chris Kelly** moves to classic rock sister **WKRR**, teaming with the station's **Chris Demm** as **Two Guys Named Chris**. The pair replace the syndicated **John Boy** and **Billy**, who are expected to move to country rival **WHSL**. This means that **WKZL** PD **Jeff McHugh** needs a co-host for **Jack Murphy**, who just signed a multi-year renewal with **WKZL** for mornings.

Modern adult **KMRX** Tulsa, Okla., morning host **Jill Gleason** exits, replaced by P/T **Morgan**. Night jock **Mark Owens** moves to afternoons, as **Dina Fletcher** exits. **Evan** returns to radio for nights.

Modern **WBTZ** Burlington, Vt., production director/nights **Matt Grasso** takes mornings following the recent departure of **Kyle Smith**. **Ben Wiggins** joins for nights from P/T at album sister **WIZN**. Meanwhile, **WIZN** picks up a new producer for its **Howard Stern** feed: **Riley Ray Chiorando** from P/T at album **WNEW** New York.

Modern adult **KXTE** (Extreme Radio) Las Vegas P/T **Fletch** joins modern **KROX** Austin, Texas, for nights. That moves MD **Brad "the Whipping Boy" Hastings** to afternoons.

Modern adult **WQSH** (She 93) Louisville, Ky., PD **Karen Rite** has brought in **Nikki Lilli** from album sister **WQMF** for middays.

## Warner 'Slides' Into Back-To-Back No. 1's

**CHART ACTION:** The **Goo Goo Dolls'** "Slide" nudges **R.E.M.'s** "Daysleeper" out of the No. 1 slot at triple-A, marking the first time in that chart's existence that a label has had back-to-back No. 1's. Warner Bros. also holds the distinction of being the only label to hold the No. 1 and No. 2 triple-A slots simultaneously.

The **Black Crowes'** "Kickin' My Heart Around" (American/Columbia) and **Jonny Lang's** "Still Rainin'" (A&M) tie for the No. 1 spot at heritage rock. Monitor's tie-breaking procedure is to give the song being played on more stations the higher position, putting the Crowes at the top of the chart for a third week.

**Lenny Kravitz's** "Fly Away" (Virgin) is the fourth song to spend 10 or more weeks atop the rock audience chart this year. It leads the **Goo Goo Dolls'** "Slide" by more than 8.8 million listeners, a gap of over 27%. The first song in the history of the rock audience chart to spend 10 or more weeks at No. 1 was **Bush's** "Swallowed," from November 1996 through January 1997.

**Sugar Ray's** "Every Morning" (Lava/Atlantic) easily outpaces the band's breakthrough hit, "Fly," moving into the modern rock top 10 in its second week on the chart. "Fly" debuted in June 1997, hitting the modern rock top 10 in its fourth chart week and going to No. 1 in its sixth week.

Who says pay-for-play is a dead issue? Stations may not be bolstering their bottom line

with it, but they continue to use the concept in fund-raisers. Album **WXTB** (98 Rock) Tampa, Fla., recently held its sixth annual Pay-for-Play weekend, benefiting an area orphanage. The event ran from noon on Friday to 9 p.m. Sunday. A \$25 minimum bid got your request on the air. PD **Brad Hardin** says his favorite segue of the weekend was **Gwar** into the **Beatles'** "Something." There were also tunes from **George Strait**, **Frank Sinatra**, and **Will Smith**, among others, and "lots of metal. Lots of Maiden," says **Hardin**. Between paid requests and auctioned items—a signed **B.B. King** "Lucille" guitar went for \$6,500—the station raised more than \$75,000, bringing its six-year total of funds raised to more than \$400,000.

Album **KISW** Seattle has its Rock Radiothon pay-for-requests fund-raiser set for Jan. 15, benefiting the **Make-a-Wish** Foundation.

## MONITOR PROFILE

### Wellington Builds On Both Sterns' 'Extreme' Success At KXTE Las Vegas

Detroit native Dave Wellington spent 2½ years at album WRIF Detroit—most recently as APD—until he engaged in a sort of PD exchange program with Mike Stern three months ago. Wellington took the helm of modern KXTE (Extreme Radio) Las Vegas from Stern, as the latter programmer brought Extreme Radio to Detroit as PD of WKRK.

When Wellington arrived, KXTE already had a strong morning performer in Howard Stern and had just lost its chief rival, KEDG. The next chapter, he says, is building the other elements of the station to increase its profile with listeners. "We just have to have some more benchmark promotions with the radio station. The problem in the market is we're not a 17-year heritage station. When you've only been on the air for a couple of years, you don't get that, 'Oh, yeah. We know them,'" Wellington says.

To that end, "what we're doing now is making Extreme a household name," says Wellington. "They know the image, but it's an ongoing process in a market like Las Vegas . . . At any

and shower curtains. "But instead of calling it a 'Psycho' weekend and really turning it into 'We've become a movie radio station for the weekend,' it's a momma's boy weekend. It's all how you set it up."

While Wellington says he was fortunate to come into a winning station, he was also taking over a team that had been working together since the station's inception. He took great care "to make that transition real smooth, as opposed to coming in and changing things, because I had certain systems, and the way that we did things at 'RIF worked well," he says. "To come in and implement those systems for my . . . comfort would have been a big mistake."

After 2½ years operating across the street from Howard Stern in Detroit, one of the first thoughts Wellington had about the Vegas job was, "This is great," he says. "In some markets where Howard's been on, it caps out, but the show is still growing. We just got another trend in the other day, and 12-plus he went from a 9.3-9.7 . . . And the nice thing is we have ratings after Howard as well."

Wellington does spend part of his day sending the Stern show items to keep it apprised of what's going on in Vegas. "One of the best things that you can do is feed them as much info as you can," he says. "I'm just running to the fax machine all the time, giving them stories about Vegas, but it's much better being on this side of the fence."

Having Stern is a great benefit, but building a strong air-talent bench is tough. "We're in the middle of a desert, and the next closest town is eight hours away. It's not like when you're in Detroit, and you have the Grand Rapids and the Flints and the Ann Arbors to pull from, where people will drive 2½ hours to do a weekend shift just because it's a great station. Here, they've got to drive through Death Valley," Wellington says. "You do whatever you have to do to find them . . ."

Wellington says Extreme's musical position has shifted slightly since its 1996 launch. Rage Against The Machine, Tool, and White Zombie were "probably going to be more spice, and the grunge stuff was going to be more of what drives the radio station, but we found that the grunge was kind of fading off and becoming more gold, and the harder new stuff, the Tools of the world, really drove the music image of the radio station."

Here's a sample hour on KXTE: Nirvana, "Heart-Shaped Box"; Monster Magnet, "Powertrip"; Rage Against The Machine, "Ghost Of Tom Joad"; 311, "Transistor"; Offspring, "Pretty Fly (For A White Guy)"; Rob Zombie, "Living Dead Girl"; Jane's Addiction, "Stop"; Beastie Boys, "Intergalactic"; Sevendust, "Bitch"; Green Day, "When I Come Around"; Marilyn Manson, "I Don't Like The Drugs"; and Tool, "Aenema."

Losing a head-on competitor in the Edge briefly tempted Wellington to broaden the station. "But the greatest thing is we've carved out this niche called Extreme Radio. The worst thing is we've carved out this niche called Extreme Radio," Wellington jokes. "We're so well-defined musically in who we are, and we're so focused, that if you change that focus, you blow off the core, and we're not willing to do that."

"One of the things that people say is that Extreme Radio is kind of new. It's not really. We signed on in April of '96. We've fairly well proved that we can be a ratings winner and a revenue winner as well, and I think you'll see more radio stations like this pop up" in markets where modern outlets have been forced to go poppier, which "leaves the male harder end of alternative wide open," he says.

point in time, there are so many people moving into Vegas and people moving out of Vegas that you constantly have to market. And CBS [understands] that." On top of that is the struggle to have one's marketing noticed in a market where "there's billboards everywhere. There's TV everywhere. There's lights," he says. "This is like the entertainment capital. There's so much going on [that] to get noticed you really have to stamp your foot in the ground."

"A lot of radio stations are event-driven," Wellington adds. "They don't have a music image. Their personalities are OK, but they survive on the events that they do. Extreme Radio relies on more than that. We've survived on our personalities and our music, which has gotten us really far. Now I want to put together some big events." That means a slate of station shows, including the station's third annual spring show, a possible fall concert in '99, and a holiday show Dec. 14.

In addition, Extreme is wrapping up a major fall promotion, which Wellington describes as "win your height in CDs and drink your weight in beer. It ties in the music image to the radio station, and, tell me, what 18- to 34-year-old guy doesn't like to drink beer?" In keeping with the Extreme concept, the station calls its trip giveaways "Radical Sabbaticals," which come around early in the year. These travel packages range from mountain climbing to kayaking the Colorado River to skydiving.

The production department is relied on heavily to stage and present everything. "Those promos are very elaborate, and they paint the picture," Wellington says. "We give just as much attention to a bar promo as we do maybe a fall promotion promo . . . One of the challenges is, How do we do something and do it different?"

As an example, Wellington points to the premiere of the recently remade film "Psycho." The station did a weekend promo around the event—giving away soundtracks

one Nissans are lemons. The dealers surrounded the guy with cars until the police arrived to arrest him.

He's still seen at remotes and recently crashed a Halloween party, where, Pechota says, "He grabbed this fake leg and walked around hitting people with it."

Lest you think KRAB listeners are any better-behaved, Pechota recalls a recent giveaway where the winner got a block of tickets to the Garbage show and transportation by station vehicle. The problem was that the winner's party was trashed when the station vehicle came by at 4 p.m. to pick it up. The grand-prize winner got into a fight with her boyfriend at the show; he left and walked home. She continued to drink heavily the rest of the show, and the group ended the evening puking out of the station vehicle on their way home.

### EVERY VOTE COUNTS

Modern WXRK New York PD Steve Kingston recalls his early days at crosstown top 40 WHITZ (Z100). He'd arranged to launch the new Def Leppard album with a school-spirit contest. The winning institution turned out to be a small private Catholic girls' school, but the station had rented a larger venue in anticipation of a much larger student body, so the station quietly notified the second-place school they could join the festivities. A week away from the big concert, a third school called, claiming it had in fact been the winner and threatened to call the media and make a big stink. Working with a major accounting firm, the station did a recount and found that an entire crate of mail had been omitted from the initial count and that the school, which had ranked fifth, was indeed first.

Now with three schools set to attend, the venue had to be changed and the equipment and band rerouted. While the concert eventually went on that Memorial Day weekend for all three schools, Kingston found himself in Florida, where, in a move seemingly symbolic of the chaos up North, a bird voided itself upon him.

### HALLOWEEN HORROR STORY

Modern WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia was working with two area haunted houses for Halloween, which included the station posting on its World Wide Web site the dates that the houses would be open. Unfortunately, no one bothered to tell the station that for one week the houses were closed to the public to accommodate pre-booked private tours. Even more unfortunate was that no one told the mother who brought 15 kids in her van to one of the houses and found it closed.

"She not only demands free tickets for all 15 people but reimbursement for mileage and compensation for her time," promotion director Kelly Gross says. Gross almost got off with offering the woman a pair of tickets for her and her husband, but then she continued that she wanted VIP treatment, didn't want to wait in line, and so forth.

Gross also remembers the five-day Hawaii trip that included tickets for the Natalie Merchant show there. The winner called to say the dates were inconvenient, and she wondered if they could change the concert date.

### POLITICALLY INCORRECT GIVEAWAY

No one in these enlightened times would even think of giving away a gun, but Jacor national director of N/T programming Gabe Hobbs recalls that in the early '80s, then top 40 WKDQ Evansville, Ind., was giving away a fantasy-prize package.

"One of the sponsors was a sporting-goods store," says Hobbs. "One of the prizes was a hunting rifle. [I] wasn't comfortable with it to begin with, but what the hell." Afternoon jock Ron Lane asked the winner, "So what are you gonna do with your new rifle?" Says Hobbs, "The response, serious as a heart attack, [was,] 'I'm gonna go shoot my bitch.'"

(WKDQ rescinded its rifle offer to that listener, but Lane, now PD of country WRBQ Tampa, Fla., recalls being at the same station when a local man killed a family of four and had WKDQ stickers all over his truck when he was captured.)

### HERE PIGGY, PIGGY

Every promotion department has its roster of "contest pigs" who collect again and again and again. And just as duopoly has changed other aspects of station life, promotion directors are finding a new perspective on this phenomenon. Greater Detroit Radio Group director of marketing Heidi Kramer met a WRIF winner on the station's package tour to Maui, Hawaii. Later, at a Goo Goo Dolls show for modern sister WXDG, Kramer saw the same winner. "The funny thing is when you run into these guys and they know you by your first name," Kramer says. She's also seen her winner at the VIP tent for an event held by classic rock sister WCSX. While many stations have 30-day rules, "You can't stop them from calling in to other radio stations in the cluster," Kramer says.

And when concert pigs grow up, some pursue the more lucrative route of lawsuits. Modern WNNX (99X) Atlanta assistant promotion director Mike Kee recalls the morning show's "What would you do for Rolling Stones tickets?" contest. One listener, a frequent 99X winner, offered to come to the station and, covered with goggles and protective gear, let people spit in his face. The day after the show the local paper ran a photo of the listener in the front row at the Stones show holding a sign that read, "You'll never believe what I did for these seats."

And then came the call. The winner said he was having trouble sleeping, was suffering from anxiety attacks, all stemming from the degrading parking-lot encounter with spittle he himself had devised and volunteered for. As he started talking about calling a lawyer, the station did manage to talk him out of bringing suit.

## Punk Prodigy Does Double Duty

The bumper sticker guitarist/singer **Gizz Butt** might choose for the **Janus Stark** tour bus cover, "My Other Band Is **Prodigy**." If anything, the association with the popular international electronic act has served to overshadow the longstanding commitment to punk rock he's seeing through with Janus Stark's U.S. debut, "Great Cigar Adventure."



Janus Stark: Pinch, Gizz Butt, Shop

Even before a 15-year-old Gizz joined drummer **Pinch's** band the **English Dogs**, he played in a band called the **Destructors** and one night shared the stage and some amps with legendary hardcore band **Bad Brains**. With the English Dogs, the guitarist released seven albums of hardcore punk between 1983 and 1994. Janus Stark represents a subtle change in direction from those days, purveying more of a loud, bristling punk-influenced rock'n'roll than pure punk.

Gizz says when the American punk-pop revolution struck in California four years ago, he avoided the arguments that the latest wave didn't embody what punk was really about. "It made me think that the raw guitar music still did have a place," he says. "I heard all this arguing going around, and I thought, 'Oh god, so what? Who cares?' ... I was more interested in the fact that some kid is going to be the same age I was when I first got into punk, and they're just going to hear the sound, and it's the sound that begins the ball rolling. It's the sound that creates the electrical charge needed for the enthusiasm to actually be created within this small person. That's what they needed, that's what I needed, and that's what I got."

Janus Stark and Prodigy represent the different poles of their common member's brain—punk and hard rock. It's measured best when Gizz talks about the two most influential concerts he attended—**Bad Brains** and **Stone Temple Pilots**. The former gave him a "massive buzz ... You know when you get that kind of gut feeling of being supercharged by something that you see—an experience that doesn't happen very often. I don't have that feeling much these days," says Gizz, adding that a recent **Foo Fighters** show had the same effect. Perhaps more revealing is that he thought STP was "one of the best bands I'd ever seen. I remember having a pint of beer in my hand and just running toward the stage screaming and launching the beer; just screaming and dancing to the band." Now that's punk rock.

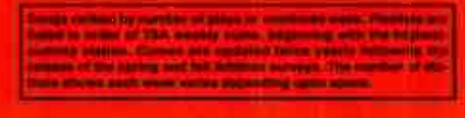

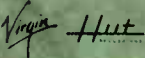
