If WFLZ Tampa, Fla., PD B.J. Harris ever wonders who's tying up his listen line at night, it's me, working late. After several years, the one-time "Power Pig," which had begun to sound almost like any other radio station, again may be the most intriguing station in the format.

Part of the reason is the music. While last year's "MTV format" experiments are now just painful memories to the PDs involved, WFLZ is one of the few stations recently to infuse a lot of modern rock into its mix without backing off the R&B reaction records and without much else for adult balance. It's a big city top 40 where you can hear Soul For Real, Nine Inch Nails, and Fun Factory, in that order.

More important, despite Harris' recent claims that WFLZ is less outrageous these days, there's much evidence to the contrary, as can be heard especially in the on-air performances of night jock Bubba The Love Sponge and late-nighter Tom Stevens.

Bubba, which once struck me as a great air name in search of an act, has one now. He talks dirty to teenage girls ("I only play songs for girls with big breasts") and their moms ("You have a 16-year-old? Do you put out? I can"), and occasionally to guys, whom he often calls "bitch." Last Friday night, he offered his retelling of the Easter story, which led to an equal number of complaints and comments like "Usually, I think you're a pig, but I agree with you."

Stevens, like many of the new night jocks in modern rock, is deliberately unslick, like a college jock or a listener. Last time I heard him, he was hosting a "teen drinking party" in the studio. Every now and then, there'd be a signal for either the guys or the girls to remove an item of clothing.

Some of this sounds dubious out of context. Some of it sounds kind of dubious in context. But I'm fascinated by it, more than Howard Stern or anybody else outrageous. Stern's affiliates usually use him as a substitute for any "stationality" of their own; WFLZ is reinventing its legacy for the '90s. More ironically, WFLZ is also appropriating, in a particularly kinky way, the high-profile mantle of WRBQ (Q105), the station it helped chase out of the format, proving that Mason Dixon and Randy Michaels were both right after all. Happy Easter, Bubba.






Top 40 PDs looking over their shoulders at their modern rock competitors should think of the format boom as less a triumph for modern than a triumph for album rock repackaged. To one who has grown up with, and worked in, modern rock when it was a last bastion of hooks and melodies in pop music, what passed for modern rock last fall was almost unrecognizably hard. It was as if the black T-shirt kids who populated "kickass" album rock radio in the early '80s had taken over and chained the real modern rock format in the basement. When modern's ratings declined last fall, it was evident that while the new converts were happy, the stalwarts felt alienated.

Part of modern rock's sea change comes from an attempt by many stations to claim any album rock act without classic rock baggage, even the classic-flavored ones (i.e., Hootie, Black Crowes, etc.), as modern. Some of the hardening of the format is a result of the same PDs who jumped on the hip-hop bandwagon when it was "Bust A Move" and then were stuck with "Dre Day" turning to modern at the time of "Two Princes" and "Come Undone" and—because the hardening was incremental—not noticing that the format was turning *Rancid*, or that they were being held hostage by those core listeners who didn't like hearing any of the same records they heard last week, or that their own power rotations were inching up from 2:45 to 3:30 to 4:30.

Some modern rock PDs see this now, so they're dayparting more and playing more gold. The format itself seems headed for a good winter book, but there's still a gap between the smashes—"When I Come Around," "Self Esteem," "Lightning Crashes," etc.—and everything else. Not only are these the songs in the format with hooks and melodies, but they're also the songs on the albums with hooks and melodies. The fact that they're the songs to have crossed over is self-explanatory. Top 40 PDs who've crossed to modern rock know they should play the format's hits more than other modern rock PDs do, and top 40 PDs who've stayed in top 40 know enough to play hit songs without making listeners sit through expendable records to hear them.


