## Your Radio Awards Ballot Is Due



### • TOP 40 TOPICS •

**B**ased on sound alone, one could have expected "Tell Me When" and "In The House Of Stone And Light" to be instant callout smashes—if not necessarily sales hits—and expected "Creep" and "When I Come Around" to be songs that active listeners demanded, but not callout hits. That it happened in reverse suggests the following about top 40 listeners:

• Adult tastes have changed. That won't surprise anybody who saw KHM Houston redefine the top 40/adult format in 1990, then watched WPL New York and KALC Denver rock even harder. But anybody who was 18 at the time of Tone-Loc's "Wild Thing" is now 25-plus, and anybody who was 30 back then is now out of demo for top 40. We've often viewed the resurgence of hot AC as mainstream top 40 failing to protect its adults, but it may just be the case that this is a rite of passage and adults aren't meant to stay here anyway. Consider the fact that with its terrific presell at top 40/adult radio, "House Of Stone" should have had instant familiarity to top 40's upper demos, but it's been a slow build, which suggests that a 30-year-old hot AC listener has different tastes and expectations from a 29-year-old top 40 listener. There are records that have worked in both formats, but they're not always the records one might have expected—"I Know," "You Gotta Be," and the Hootie & the Blowfish singles, among them.

• Top 40 PDs may have a problem with uptempo R&B owing to the alleged hip-hop backlash, but listeners do not. "Creep," "Candy Rain," "If You Love Me," and their ilk are more melodic than the uptempo R&B of the early '90s. If Joe Public's "Live & Learn," built on a Public Enemy sample, tested well in 1992, than callout-smash status for "Creep" should surprise nobody. (Besides, if Zapp and the S.O.S. Band had a hard time crossing over in 1980 because of the backlash against "Take Me Home" by Cher and other pop disco from the year before, one suspects Adina Howard is suffering for the sins of Vanilla Ice, but that's another column.)

It's not true yet that moms and daughters agree on every record again, or that every edgy record does great through age 29. ("House Of Stone" does well 25-plus in some places; "When I Come Around" is only now kicking in with some 30-year-olds.) But there are still mainstream top 40 PDs playing "Next Time I Fall," when any top 40 PD really determined to superserve a 29-year-old—always a dicey strategy—could probably do so without going so soft that the 18-year-olds catch on.


