Nightmare On 34th Street As Holiday Concert Wars Ensnare Labels Again

Once again, it's time to recapture that childlike holiday spirit while listening to colorful phone calls from irate programmers and frustrated promotion executives. Stations are busily planning competing "Damn-Near Acoustic, Semi-Boneless, Barbecue Fest Extravaganza And Shindig-O-Rama On Ice" holiday shows and demanding free acts. Labels are again forced to choose which station will be less annoyed after the smoke clears. And as label executives note, the problem is getting worse instead of better.

Negotiations for these shows have left many label executives—many of whom would only discuss the issue if their names weren't used—claiming that "this is the worst thing I've ever had to deal with." The word "nightmare" was also used more than once, along with some actual swear words. The holiday concert wars pit mod-

ern rock stations vs. top 40s, modern rock stations vs. album rock stations, and their respective label promotion departments against one another. Already, the intramural rivalries have started with suburban New York rock outlet WRGX (X107) scooping top 40 WHITZ (Z100) by announcing the lineup for Z100's Jingle Ball early and giving away tickets. Meanwhile, rocker WAXQ (Q104)'s holiday show is scheduled the same day as Z100's bash.

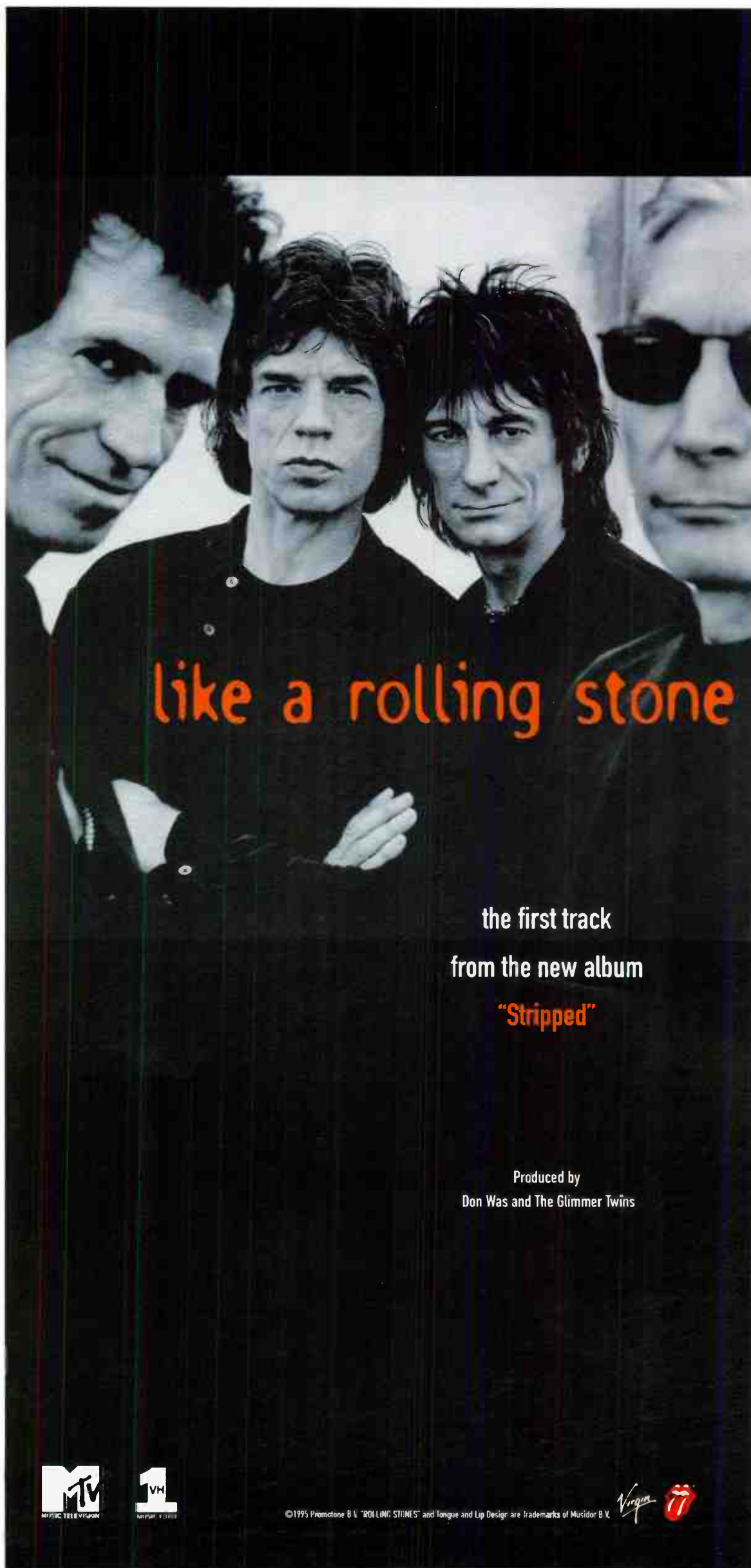
"I have good relationships with a lot of modern rock and top 40 PDs, many in the same markets," says one label's VP of promotion. "If I can't help both of them, then I won't help either one, which means instead of one PD being pissed off at me, I'll have two."

REASONS TO BE FEARFUL

Intramural fighting isn't the only reason labels hate holiday shows. Among the others:

Format Definitions And Selective Amnesia

Throughout the format-classification controversy, an argument that occasionally resurfaces is that **WPGC-FM** Washington, D.C., or **KMEL** San Francisco are not only "top 40 for their markets," but are in the '60s, '70s, and early '80s tradition of top 40 in those markets. Allegedly, **KFRC** San Francisco, Detroit's **CKLW** and **WDRQ**, and the original **WPGC-FM** always leaned R&B to a degree that obscured the boundaries between the formats. That's how some folks remember it. Let's go to the tape. Here's **WPGC** from August 1971: **Partridge Family**, "I Woke Up In Love This Morning"; **Isley Brothers**, "Love The One You're With"; **Beatles**, "Eleanor Rigby"; **Three Dog Night**, "Liar"; **Diana Ross**, "Surrender"; **Moody Blues**, "The Story In Your Eyes"; **Bob Dylan**, "Rainy Day Women #12 & 35"; **Glass Bottle**, "I Ain't Got Time Anymore"; and **the Who**, "Won't Get Fooled Again."

Here's **CKLW** in June 1973: **Rolling Stones**, "19th Nervous Breakdown"; **O'Jays**, "Time To Get Down"; **Fortunes**, "You've Got Your Troubles"; **Billy Preston**, "Will It Go 'Round In Circles"; **Tony Joe White**, "Polk Salad Annie"; **George Harrison**, "Give Me Love (Give Me Peace On Earth)"; **Johnnie Taylor**, "I Believe In You"; **Bloodstone**, "Natural High"; **Elton John**, "Daniel"; **Barry White**, "I'm Gonna Love You Just A Little More Baby"; **the Animals**, "House Of The Rising Sun"; **New York City**, "I'm Doin' Fine Now"; and **the Monkees**, "A Little Bit Me, A Little Bit You."

Here's **WDRQ** in August 1973 under PD **Jerry Clifton**: **Gilbert O' Sullivan**, "Get Down"; **Elton John**, "Daniel"; **Osmonds**, "Yo-Yo"; **Maureen McGovern**, "The Morning After"; **Rolling Stones**, "Brown Sugar"; **Ronnie Dyson**, "Just Don't Want To Be Lonely"; **Loggins & Messina**, "Your Mama Don't Dance"; **Michael Jackson**, "Ben"; **Jim Croce**, "Bad Bad Leroy Brown"; **Main Ingredient**, "Everybody Plays The Fool"; **Spinners**, "I'll Be Around"; **Grand Funk Railroad**, "Closer To Home"; and **Isley Brothers**, "That Lady."

And **KFRC** from January 1982 under PD **Gerry Cagle**: **Kool & the Gang**, "Take My Heart"; **Olivia Newton-John**, "Xanadu"; **Devo**, "Beautiful World"; **Allman Brothers Band**, "Ramblin' Man"; **Rod Stewart**, "Passion"; **Lindsey Buckingham**, "Trouble"; **Carl Carlton**, "She's A Bad Mama Jama"; **Diana Ross**, "Why Do Fools Fall In Love"; **Quincy Jones**, "Just Once"; **Beach Boys**, "Come Go With Me"; and **the Hollies**, "Long Cool Woman In A Black Dress."

The tale of the tape is unambiguous: **KFRC**, the most aggressive station of its era on R&B, is less than 50% R&B. **WPGC**, **WDRQ**, and even **CKLW**—while aggressive on some records that didn't cross nationally—are all more pop/rock-driven than we remember.

Now, a recent midday sample of **KMEL**: **Xscape**, "Who Can I Run To"; **Frost**, "East Side Rendezvous"; **Groove Theory**, "Tell Me"; **Prince Markie D.**, "Typical Reasons (Swing My Way)"; **Mariah Carey**, "Fantasy"; **Dove Shack**, "Summertime In The LBC"; **Notorious B.I.G.**, "One More Chance"; **Whitney Houston**, "Exhale"; **Dr. Dre**, "Keep Their Heads Ringin'"; and **D'Angelo**, "Brown Sugar."

Or **WPGC-FM** at night: **KRS-ONE**, "MC's Act Like They Don't Know"; **R. Kelly**, "You Remind Me Of Something"; **Mary J. Blige**, "I'm Goin' Down"; **Northeast Groovers**, "Booty Call"; **Whitney Houston**, "Exhale"; **Jackie The Bear**, "For Real"; **Tha Dogg Pound**, "Respect"; **Monica**, "Before You Walk Out Of My Life"; **Immature**, "Feel The Funk"; **Total**, "No One Else"; **Mariah Carey**, "Fantasy"; and **Immature**, "We Got It."

Because mainstream top 40 once worked in

Washington, Detroit, and San Francisco doesn't guarantee that it would work there today. And merely disproving that an R&B-leaning station from 20 years ago is the same as a primarily R&B-based station of today will hardly settle the format controversy. But let's not rewrite history. The most extreme of today's crossover outlets are based almost entirely in rap and R&B. Their predecessors were not.

During the '60s and '70s, top 40 was easy to define, even in heavily ethnic markets. The confusion began in the early '80s, when AM top 40 collapsed in markets where there was no FM top 40. Top 40 PDs went elsewhere and took their formatics with them. In an era when nobody knew if there'd ever be mainstream top 40 again, the idea that AC or album rock or R&B might be the new top 40 seemed credible. While few people would now argue that **WBLS** New York played R&B in the early '80s or that **KUPD** Phoenix was a rock station or that **KRBE** Houston was AC, those stations disputed it fervently at the time. With the top 40 revival of 1982-83, the issue went on hiatus for several years.

Back to **CKLW**: It added R&B records because those records had some appeal beyond the R&B audience. **WHYT** Detroit, until its change to modern rock, fought R&B rival **WJLB** head on for many of the same listeners. When **WHYT** added an R&B record—often before **WJLB**—it did so to reach R&B partisans. Having a record on **CKLW** meant that other top 40s at least looked at it. **WHYT** MD **Mark Jackson** did a great job, but having a song on **WHYT** often proved only that it was a hit on **WHYT**, as evidenced by all the records that went no further (i.e., "Your Mama's On Crack Rock" by **Disco Rick & the Dogs**).

There are stations that still add R&B records or modern rock records after they're proven hits in those formats and before other mainstream top 40s. **KIIS** Los Angeles or **WNVZ** (Z104) Norfolk, Va., add R&B records about the time **CKLW** would have added them. Many of the stations in dispute add such records out of the box, because they're looking for them to be R&B hits, not mass-appeal hits.

It's understandable that labels would want to keep such standards in the mix. They put spins on the board right away. But such stations—even when they all play the same record—aren't always a reliable indicator of songs that have the strength to cross. Other PDs—even those at the poppier rhythm-crossover outlets—don't see **KRS-ONE** on the playlists of **WPGC** or **WQHT** (Hot 97) New York and say, "Maybe I need to acknowledge that record," even if they do. They say, "Oh, that's just Hot 97 and **WPGC** again."

Ultimately, one wonders if more records might cross if PDs watched the R&B stations in their markets, instead of looking only at **WPGC** and **KMEL**. It would also make most musical genres seem more stable. R&B radio has never been stronger. R&B still sells in huge quantities, yet some top 40 PDs no longer consider R&B a factor, because many of the crossover stations they had been trained to watch evaporated. The same will ultimately happen to many modern-leaning top 40s. Top 40 PDs will still have modern rock stations to look at, but they'll believe those stations have little of value for them. In reality, only the stations that watch what's going on in their own markets can truly do "top 40 for their market."

STATION BREAK: **KDLE** (Power 93.9) Wichita, Kan., becomes a top 40/crossover reporter bringing that panel to 33 stations. **WPLY** (Y100) Philadelphia moves to modern rock; the top 40/mainstream panel is now 81 stations. Also, **KFRR** Fresno, Calif., should have been shown as going 3.1-3.4 12-plus in last week's summer Arbitron ratings.

WLUM's Sinicropi At War; San Diego In Flux

An update on the page 1 concert-wars story: **WLUM** (New Rock 102.1) Milwaukee GM **Steve Sinicropi**, complaining of a lack of support from labels has deliberately slowed his station's music down, adding only one record in recent weeks. "Labels should prepare for a long Arctic winter," Sinicropi announced.

With the addition of hot AC fave "Lump," **KFMB-FM** (Star 100.7) San Diego moves into the top 40/adult modern rock turf occupied by **KYSR** (Star 98.7) Los Angeles. Elsewhere in the market, **KECR** which planned to simulcast **WFLZ** Tampa, Fla., until pending owner **Jacor** decided what to do with the station, has become **KHTS** but is currently simulcasting the soft AC format of **WFLZ**'s duopoly partner, **WDUV**.

Howard Stern is now heard in Pittsburgh on modern rock outlet **WXDX** (the X), replacing **Steve Frankenberry** (his real name), who moves to nights. Stern debuted Tuesday (7), the day his new book, "Miss America" was published. Crosstown **WBZZ** (B94) inks **Heidi Stern** from nights at **WEDJ** Charlotte, N.C., for middays. Assistant PD **David Edgar** moves from middays to afternoons through the end of the year. And **Blake Thunder** from crosstown **WWRB** is the new p.m. driver on AC **WVTY** (Variety 96.1).

In other modern rock news, **WIBF** Philadelphia breaks from the **WDRE** Underground Network to go local this week as "Philly's modern rock," as opposed to crosstown **WPLY** (Y100), "Philadelphia's new rock." PD **Jim McGuinn** will do afternoons.

After experimenting with some pop product over the last few months, and with its new call-out research system in place, dance-leaning **KMXV** (Mix 93.3) Kansas City continues to broaden to top 40/mainstream with **Take That**, **Alanis Morissette**, and **Blues Traveler** in power rotation; **Toad The Wet Sprocket** and **Hootie & the Blowfish** tracks are also added this week.

Acting **WDJX** Louisville PD **J.J. Dulling** exits for the PD slot at classic rock **WGFX** Nashville, replacing **David Moore**, now at '70s rock **WOCT** (the Colt) Baltimore.

At **KJMZ** (94.1 Jamz) Las Vegas PD **Jay Stone** exits a week after the station's call change from **KXTZ**. The new lineup has **Chase** going from middays to mornings and part-timer **Frankie D.** doing middays temporarily. **MC Scrappy** is interim PD/afternoons, and latest acquisition **Kid Stevenz** is MD/nights.

Sean "Hollywood" Hamilton exits the morning team at **KGGI** Riverside, Calif.

WVSR (Super 102) Charleston, W. Va.,

VP/GM Tom Collins exits after six years. **Robert Thaler** returns to radio as the new GM.

Lee Cagle from **WEZB** (B97) New Orleans is the new MD at **KWMX** (Mix 107.3) Denver.

WHHY (Live 101.9) Montgomery, Ala., PD **Jimmy Steel** moves to **WKBQ** (Q104) St. Louis for nights. Night jock **Rikk Idol** moves to afternoons; **Kenny Knight** goes to middays.

With **WBBM-FM** (B96) Chicago APD/morning-show producer **Ric Towers** exit last week, former music coordinator **Jeff Andrews** will handle producer duties.

At **KHQT** (Hot 97.7) San Jose, Calif., now a simulcast triple-A outlet with **KFOG** San Francisco, the Hot 97.7 era officially ends with a call-letter flip to **KFFG**.

WRHT New Bern N.C., PD **Ryan Walker** has reportedly been given two weeks notice. The station refuses comment.

KWNZ Reno, Nev., moves toward top 40/rhythm. Morning host **Tom Jeffries** exits for Phoenix. **Monica J.**, is handling mornings solo while **KWNZ** looks for a sidekick.

Former **WZEE** (Z104) Madison, Wis., morning host **Johnny Danger** goes to court Nov. 10 over his contract with the station. **Danger** and partner **Cheryl Kaye** have exited for mornings at **KQKQ** (Sweet 98) Omaha, Neb. P/T **Jesse James** is mornings for now.

Chicago radio legend **Fred Winston** is now doing weekends at **WPNT** (FM100).

Scott Free from **WOVV** (Star 95.5) West Palm Beach, Fla., is the new morning man at top 40/rhythm **WZJM** (Jammin' 92.3) Cleveland, replacing **Johnny D.**

WAEB-FM (B104) Allentown, Pa., promotions/marketing/research director **Maggie McAleer** adds MD stripes, replacing **Joe Friday**, who segues to **WYXR** Philadelphia.








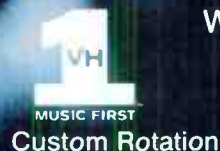

World Radio History

With Station Wars And Free Shows, Christmas Means Conflict Again

more airplay. As one label's VP of promotion notes, "Many radio stations don't truly support the record in advance of the artist's appearance, causing the artist and the label to become concerned. Why [does the artist] have to go there and perform if the host station isn't really supporting the record? The artist obviously has some name value for the station to want [him or her], so in turn, the artist and the label expect to see significant support to help increase awareness and to sell records.

"I see stations constantly using our artists, basically treating them like whores, and then they wonder why those artists become leery. Radio will end up causing damage to labels' artist rosters with their increased demands."

● Stations want stars. "The labels would like to be able to expose a new band, but radio wants us to deliver a name band, usually someone who could conceivably be shared across format boundaries. That's when the trouble usually starts," says Warner Bros. national promotion director Dave Lombardi, who was in a meeting on the concert wars issue when contacted for this story. Another label's VP says, "Many stations we deal with want our A-list artists or noth-

ing... Offering them two B-list artists won't make up for it."

● It isn't the right showcase. Some label executives wonder if it's worth spending money for their acts to perform in a 20,000-seat venue with 10 other acts just to play three songs. "That usually ends up helping the station far more than the individual artist," says Columbia Records' senior VP of promotion Jerry Blair. Most agree it's usually better to play a small venue on a smaller bill and play a longer set. "It makes [the artist] the focal point and exposes more of the album," Blair says. After a recent Z100 Presidents Of The United States Of America show, featuring Hum and Tripping Daisy, Columbia saw an immediate 25% increase in CD sales.

YOU NEVER GIVE US YOUR MONEY

Blair has seen his share of the Christmas spirit in action. "Many stations think that because it's Christmas, they expect something is owed to them. While we've always supported radio stations, many of our artists have the chance to tour and actually make money, rather than do a lot of free radio appearances."

One solution, according to Blair, is for stations to pick up more of the artist's expenses than just ground transportation and hotel trade. "Many stations use the excuse, 'It's a benefit show,' but if they're charging any kind of admission, they should ante up some additional financial and marketing support, including possibly running free spots," Blair says.

STILL MAKES SENSE?

Despite his concerns, Blair believes that "if the artist is available and it's cost-effective, we should be supportive. Xscape just did WPGC-FM Washington, D.C.'s Monster Bash, and now they're powering two of the group's singles." However, because of ever-tightening budgets, Blair adds, "We need to be more selective when choosing the proper station to showcase our artists. Every situation must be analyzed on an individual basis to try to avoid the inevitable pissing matches."

Then again, as one weary label executive

put it, "I'm thinking about sending all of our artists to Europe until after the New Year, so I don't have to deal with this headache again."

Not coincidentally, some hot modern rock artists are already out of the holiday fray. Want Foo Fighters, the Presidents, or Alanis Morissette for your gig? You're probably out of luck. Due to "prior commitments," those acts will be mostly unavailable for the holiday hoopla. Morissette, in particular, is touring smaller venues Nov. 15-Dec. 15, although she will play shows for KROQ Los Angeles and Z100's Jingle Ball Dec. 15, along with Blues Traveler, the Dave Matthews Band, Natalie Merchant, Soul Asylum, Collective Soul, and the Goo Goo Dolls.

If labels do take a hard line on shows this year, other stations probably won't fare as well as KROQ and Z100. "It's not just a ratings game," says one label VP. "You know that if stations like KROQ and Z100 get behind an artist, they can make a difference. Again, it's all about moving product and who can put bodies in seats."

MODERN STILL PREFERRED?

Judging from some comments, there will also still be a preference shown to modern rock outlets, despite album rock radio's campaign for label attention. As one label VP notes, "The modern rockers seem to have a greater immediate impact on record sales, plus they're more aggressive with their marketing campaigns."

"At the end of the day, it still puts us in a no-win situation. The games between radio and our artist puts us right in the middle of the radio wars, and that can only jeopardize our artists."

PROMOTERS FIGHT BACK

There are reports that one major concert promoter held meetings with various label executives recently to seek a moratorium on free shows. Promoters have an obvious interest in halting such shows, and many label reps reportedly felt this would be a good opportunity to get off the hook with radio, so it was hoped that this sentiment would spread, perhaps via an informal concert-promoters network, whereby future station events could be coordinated through regular concert-promotion channels.

Y100 ANTES UP

So how are stations reacting? WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia pays for artists for its second Y100 Holiday Hootenanny. PD Garrett Michaels says, "In cases like this, we try not to act like a radio station. Instead, we act like a concert promoter. We use the record labels as a starting point, but we also go through artist management, as well as the booking agencies."

"We do negotiate to pay the artists a little less than one of their standard gigs, because our show is a fund-raiser for charity," says Michaels. "We give away every ticket, and, in the spirit of giving, we ask all ticket holders to bring food for the Greater Philly Food Bank."

The record labels have little or no problem with Y100's policy. "It certainly opens more doors to us," adds Michaels. "We know what it costs to put a band on the road. Most of them are giving up paid gigs to be here, and we want to help them offset their costs." It also helps that "if our competition asks a label how we got a certain artist, they're told we hired them."

"It may mean we'll have a fewer key chains to hand out, but we feel these shows are strong image statements for this radio station."

By contrast, Sean Demery, MD of WNNX (99X) Atlanta, says, "We avoid Christmas shows like the plague." The station does other, larger benefits during the year for nontraditional holidays, like Chinese New Year, when the intense clamoring for artist appearances isn't as heavy. (99X is doing a food-bank benefit on Nov. 26 featuring Soul Asylum, Elastica, and Loud Lucy. Admission is \$3.99 and three cans of food.)

PROGRAMMER PROFILE

OM Vazquez Manages Crossover Z90 Amid San Diego's Melting Pot

XHTZ (Z90) San Diego OM Lisa Vazquez had the rare thrill of cutting her radio teeth during the infamous Phoenix radio wars of the late '80s. She worked for Jay Stevens at the late KOY-FM (Y95) as a promotion assistant when Steve Smith, Michelle Santosuosso, Kevin Weatherly, and Guy Zapoleon were all in the market.

After learning from some of the best in the business, Vazquez moved to rhythm-crossover Z90 as promotions director for Rick Thomas, another Phoenix vet, during his second stint at the station. Around the time Thomas was replaced by Steve Wall, rival XHRM, the market's only R&B station, flipped to modern rock; Z90 was then very dancy, which didn't sit well with many disenfranchised XHRM listeners.

When Wall left, owner Victor Diaz relied primarily on his internal brain trust. "At the time, Victor had dropped consultant Jerry Clifton



and used very little outside help," says Vazquez. "He trusted me and, in fact, had offered me the PD position numerous times, but I kept turning it down. I was reluctant to leave promotions and was afraid to fall on my face in front of the entire industry."

"I didn't know enough about the intricacies and the politics of this business. I also wasn't part of any clique. I didn't want to be thought of as the rookie, that if things happened to go well, people would chalk it up to beginner's luck or rationalize any success to the fact we had no direct competition at the time."

Vazquez eventually took the gig, and, as expected, the reaction was immediate and brutal. "Other station's sales people asked our sales staff, 'Hey, I hear they just named Z90's bus driver PD. What the hell is going on over there?'"

Fast forward to the summer 1995 book. Nearing Vazquez's second anniversary as PD, Z90 is No. 1 in San Diego with its highest numbers ever, up 5.1-6.8 12-plus and up nearly two shares from a year ago. "It's taken almost all that time to overcome the pre-existing reputation of the station as hip but hardcore," Vazquez says. Today, "San Diego is not as hip as people might think in terms of underground music. The ghetto here is not the same as the ghetto in Los Angeles. Two years ago, we would have played stuff like Snoop Doggy Dogg all day, but today I feel the station has now matured... and we, in turn, have prospered financially."

With creative marketing and careful day-

parting, Vazquez says, "We're not thought of as that 'Mexican station' anymore." Although Z90 primarily targeted Hispanics at one time, Vazquez says, it now targets 18-34, regardless of race. "Since there is no urban outlet here, I like to think we're educating some of the African-American listeners to accept such artists as Fun Factory, L.A.D., Tribe, Lil' Suzie, etc. We also want to bring the available white listeners into this melting pot we're trying to create. We want to let them know it's OK to listen to us."

Z90's new slogan is "Your Dance Music Station," which, Vazquez says, "covers a lot of ground. You can dance to Hootie & the Blowfish, Snoop Doggy Dogg, New Order, even Sheryl Crow. We like to feel we're educating the listeners to the fact that there is a whole world outside their own culture."

Here's a sample hour of Z90: Groove Theory, "Tell Me"; the artist formerly known as Prince, "Gold"; Junior M.A.F.I.A., "I Need You Tonight"; D'Angelo, "Cruisin'"; Los Del Rio, "Macarena"; Rodney O & Joe Cooley, "U Don't Hear Me Tho'"; Blahzay Blahzay, "Danger"; Diana King, "Love Triangle"; L.L. Cool J, "Hey Lover"; Silk, "Hooked On You"; Adina Howard, "Freak Like Me"; and Selena, "I Could Fall In Love."

Promotions were Vazquez's first love, and she has an active interest in Z90's street presence. "We like to think the music carries the station. But without a strong promotional team, headed by Monchai Pugnaew, Z90 wouldn't be where it is today. If Planet Hollywood is having an event, they now come to us," she says. "We do more movie premieres and show up at more events than ever before. We like to go to places where people wouldn't readily expect us."

"We have two street [busses] and a gigantic tractor-trailer vehicle on order, like the one KHS in L.A. has. That will be ready in a few weeks." Z90 also has five station vans that are constantly on the road. "If Victor Diaz drives into the parking lot and sees a van sitting there idle, you better believe someone's gonna hear about it." The station has a detailed weekly vehicle appearance schedule, broken down hour by hour. Z90 has seven people on promotion staff, not including the jocks.

Vazquez sees a wealth of promotional opportunities next year, when the Republican National Convention comes to town. Z90 and Bob Dole make strange bedfellows, but Vazquez plans to seize the moment to improve voter registration, regardless of party. "We want to target the 18-24's who don't vote. My goal is to show them that they can really make a difference."

As a female programmer, Vazquez feels she makes a difference in a traditionally male-dominated business. "Jeff Nelson knows that if he initially hates a record, he'd better let me listen to it as well. I try to listen to Z90 as listener first, more than a programmer... Even if I didn't work here anymore, Z90 would still be my first choice for listening." **KEVIN CARTER**
