Does New Fab Four Cut Have A Place At Top 40 Radio In '95?

They changed the face of rock-'n-roll forever. But what is the Beatles' place on radio in 1995?


That will be the multimillion-dollar question for Capitol Records next week when it releases "Free As A Bird," the first new Beatles single in more than 25 years.

"Free As A Bird," a much-publicized unreleased John Lennon track to which the surviving three Beatles added vocals, is the lead single of the 60-track double CD "The Beatles Anthology Volume 1." It'll be delivered to stations via satellite at 10:45 p.m., Sunday (19), after airing on ABC-TV as part of a three-night special. On Monday (20), Capitol will hand-service the CD to select stations. There'll be a complete servicing by Tuesday (21).

On Tuesday, Capitol senior director of national promotion Jeffrey Blalock says, Capitol will actively work the new Beatles track to "AC, album rock, triple-A, pop, classic rock, and oldies stations." A massive media blitz, which includes a radio campaign for the ABC special, extensive news coverage (including a *Newsweek* cover story), label-sponsored viewing parties, and other promotions precede the release. A commercial single will be released Dec. 12.

Even with all that groundwork in place, Blalock says that working the single is "an uncharted situation. There are a lot of variables." Not the least of which is the extent to which top 40 radio will be willing to break format, as it did when "Twist And Shout" became a hit again in 1986. While most of today's alternative

How The 'Damn' Broke For Reaction Records

Sophie B. Hawkins' first single, "Damn I Wish I Was Your Lover," spent 21 weeks on the Billboard Hot 100 Singles chart. Hawkins' current single, "As I Lay Me Down," took longer than that just to chart and another 19 weeks to reach No. 3 on the top 40/mainstream chart.

Hawkins' first single was broken by KRBE Houston, a cutting-edge top 40 station that obtained a prerelease cassette and made it a hit before its release date. Hawkins' current single was broken by WTKI Milwaukee and WTMX Chicago, which held onto it well after a lot of stations had forgotten it was even out there.

Hawkins' first single was an immediate reaction record. Hawkins' current single could have died, because of the fact that it didn't react immediately and that the single before it, "Right Beside You," had not reacted right away either.

Goes to show how much things change in three years. This year will go down as the year of songs that took a year to break, from "As I Lay Me Down" to **Everything But The Girl's** "Missing" to Hootie & the Blowfish's "Hold My Hand" (which, to be fair, only took six months). From "Carnival" to "Roll To Me" to "December," the mainstream chart is full of records that not everybody heard right away—records so durable that they make the Energizer bunny look like an Epstein-Barr victim.

There aren't a lot of current hits that break right away—the two **Alanis Morissette** hits; first singles from established artists, such as **Ace Of Base**, **Mariah Carey**, and **Janet Jackson**; and perhaps "Name" by **the Goo Goo Dolls**, if you don't count the fact that it sat on an album for a while. Only a few other current songs have generated immediate reaction: "Gangsta's Paradise" (again, if you don't count the several weeks it moved slowly before "Dangerous Minds" was released) and "Lump" are the only ones that come to mind.

What has changed the most over three years are PDs' expectations. Once top 40/mainstream stations decided to play some pop/rock records again, they've been willing to wait longer for those songs to develop. Three years ago, it was inconceivable that anybody would have given a **Del Amitri** record the better part of four months to kick in. Now, one wonders if "Always The Last To Know" would have been just as big as "Roll To Me" if radio had been willing to invest the same time and energy in it three years ago.

PDs no longer want love at first sight. In fact, they are wary of it. Since the term "reac-

tion record" has become nearly synonymous with rap or R&B crossovers, which PDs believe are entirely responsible for the format's decline (conveniently overlooking other factors that may be involved), PDs, perversely, feel a little safer around anything that doesn't do too well right away.

The resurgence of call-out has protected most records for six to eight weeks, even if they don't get immediate sales or phones, because PDs know not to expect call-out in a shorter period of time. In many cases, the lag is even longer, because the smaller-market stations most likely to break a pop/rock record often aren't the ones who can afford call-out. So "Hold My Hand," for example, had to work its way up through the ranks, then come home in the majors, to be proved legit. And that process took a while.

Another factor is the advent of monitored airplay. Because of call-out, records not only stay on the radio longer, they stay on the charts and in a PD's consciousness longer. Now that records aren't expected to implode immediately, they aren't expected to explode immediately either.

Then there is the decline of the PD or MD as superstar. In the brat-pack days of the early '90s, then KRBE PD **Steve Wyrostok**'s support gave Hawkins, for example, immediate credibility, especially since he'd already done the same for **Jane Child** as MD of **WAPW** (Power 99) Atlanta. Later, Wyrostok's Power 99 successor, **Lee Chesnut**, was busy breaking **Chris Isaak**. Now there are few top 40 PDs whose support immediately guarantees a record credibility. KROQ Los Angeles' **Kevin Weatherly** is an exception, but he's still one format removed from top 40.

The irony here is that there are folks who could have told you about today's hits nine months ago. **WPOW** (Power 96) Miami found "Missing" the first time. In any given week, it finds at least one or two records that aren't yet hits anywhere else. That should have made more PDs curious enough to search out "Missing." Instead, most wrote it off as just another Miami aberration. WTKI finds a lot of records, too, but these days it reports to the top 40/adult side, so it's off the radar for many PDs.

It's nice to see Hawkins and **Everything But The Girl** with hit records. It's nice to know that Columbia and Atlantic have been willing to stick with them for so long. Top 40 needs its balance records, but it needs its sleeper hits, too. It also needs some reaction records to make the subtle ones stick out, and one hopes that playing records that people like right away hasn't somehow become a bad thing.

Arbitron Gives Credit Where Credit Is Due


As its problems with the fall book continue, Arbitron has agreed to credit client stations in four markets where diaries were mistargeted. The company will refund to clients in Buffalo, N.Y., Milwaukee, Dallas, and Albuquerque, N.M., the amount they would have spent for October, November, and December Arbitrrends. Those credits will not include the fall book itself, according to Arbitron VP/communications Thom Mocarsky.

This action follows problems in seven markets, including Fresno, Calif., where 40% of the metro was not sampled in Phase 1, causing the deletion of that phase from the fall book. In its place, Arbitron is allocating a sample covering the last eight weeks of the survey, so that the

Phase 2 release, covering November and December, will contain the full Fresno sample target (1470 diaries). In six other markets, sample targets in high-density ethnic areas and the rest of the counties were transposed.

Despite the decision to rebate unhappy clients, Mocarsky says, the difference between the intended and the actual in-tab was small. In Buffalo, the first trend's return was 15.5% African-American and 84% other, compared with a market composition of 10.1% African-American and 89.9% other, well within the range that can be handled by sample balancing. In Dallas, Mocarsky says, the trend was 15% Hispanic, 12.8% African-American, and 72.2% other, compared to a market composition of 14.1% Hispanic, 13.5% African-American, and 72.4% other.

Rahe & Larry D. Exit WXXL; Violets Settle

This week's big surprise was the sudden departure of **WXXL** (XL 106.7) Orlando, Fla., GM **Randy Rahe** and MD/account executive **Larry D.** amid a ton of rumors. No replacements were named. No explanation was offered by the station.

At **KDLE** (Power 93.9) Wichita, Kan., owners **Gary** and **Viola Violet** reassumed control of the station after settling a dispute with former lessee **David Brace**; the format returns to R&B from top 40/rhythm. Assistant GM **Bruce Adamek** is upped to GM. **A.J. Jones** reclaims MD duties. At press time, **Greg Williams** was still in place but was, according to the Violets, asking to be let out of his contract. KDLE has applied for the calls **KDGS** (the Dog).

WMXQ/WAPI Birmingham, Ala., VP/GM **Bernie Barker** is leaving after 14 years (and three owners). **Davis Hawkins** will assume GM duties for those stations, as well as LMA partners **WZRR/WJOX**. Barker will exit prior to the end of the year.

Cleveland radio veteran **Gary Dee**, often considered the first shock jock, died Friday (10) of heart failure. He was 60.

KLYV (K-Live 105) Dubuque, Iowa, PD **Alain Fee** is the new PD at modern rocker **WGRD** Grand Rapids, Mich., replacing **Alex Tear** . . . Oldies **WODL** Birmingham, Ala., loses **Brad Ellis** to Critical Mass Media.

WSN (Sunny 107.9) Charlotte, N.C., midday host **Diane Tracy** exits for morning co-host duties at **WKCI** (KC101) New Haven, Conn.

WSNY (Sunny 95) Columbus, Ohio, morning host **Bob Simpson** exits.

WKSS (Kiss 95.7) Hartford, Conn., morning talent **Gary Craig** has decided not to renew his contract after three years with the station. Former **WHTZ** (Z100) New York morning talent **Ross Brittain** is handling the gig until further notice.

KHOM New Orleans morning man **Famous Amos** exits. PD **Bill Thorman** covers mornings and middays for now. Also in New Orleans, as **WEZB** (B97) finishes its transition from top 40 to news/talk, Bourbon Street stripper **Gio** joins the station for the nightly "Pas-

sion Show." With her addition, the station has music overnights and weekends only.

KQHT Grand Forks, N.D., discharges long-time PD **Jay Murphy** and the entire air staff, as a format search is undertaken. The station is running jockless top 40, but GM **Jeff Hoberg** says the format will change. The interim PD is **Brian Rivers** from LMA partner classic rocker **KJKJ** (KJ108). Hoberg is looking for all shifts.

WAPE (Power 95) Jacksonville, Fla., loses night jock **Brad Stone** to the morning show at **WEDJ** (the Edge) Charlotte, N.C., replacing syndicated show "Matty In The Morning." WAPE PD **Cat Thomas** needs T&Rs from potential night rockers . . . MD/night jock **Wild Bill Cherry** exits **KKXX** Bakersfield, Calif.

WFHN (Fun 107) New Bedford, Mass., loses midday guy **Neil White** to production/swing at AC **WBMX** (Mix 98.5) Boston . . . FM driver **the Real Deal Mike Neal** exits after five months at top 40/adult **KALC** (Alice 106) Denver; he can be reached at 303-892-8893 . . . **KJYO** (KJ103) Oklahoma City has nights open. Dylan has left the building.

WQSL Wilmington, N.C., GM **Bill Hennes** is reunited with former **WBXX** (B95) Battle Creek, Mich., MD/night jock **Eric "the Fly" Davis**, who runs a mobile DJ business in Long Island, N.Y. Davis has been named APD/nights.

WJET Erie, Pa., overnight jock **Jim Bean** is leaving for med school. Weekender **Dave Leroy** fills the shift . . . Former **KHIH** Denver PD **Jaime Kartak** is the new APD at top 40/adult **WTMX** Chicago, replacing **Brian Kelly** . . . **KQKS** (KS104) Denver weekender **Brandon Scott** segues to **KFTZ** Idaho Falls, Idaho, as nights/production director.

Former **WZEE** (Z104) Madison, Wis., morning guy **Johnny Danger** passed the first of his former employer's legal attempts to hold him to his contract and has started at **KQQK** Omaha, Neb.

PROGRAMMER PROFILE

PD Dawson Kix It Into Gear, And WWKX Has Providence Dancing Again

We're playing what sells and what rings the phones."

That's how Joe Dawson describes his mission as PD of WWKX (Kix 106) Providence, R.I. It's a job that Dawson carries out with 1,100 watts of music power or, as he notes, "the equivalent of one large hair dryer," but Kix reaches more people than the average household appliance. In the summer Arbitrums, Kix was up 3.9-4.3 12-plus, while heritage top 40 rival WPRO-FM was off 7.2-6.3.

Dawson arrived in Providence from KLYV Dubuque, Iowa, in February. His KLYV stint followed a string of notable station stops, including two at WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago, where he was initially hired by Mike Joseph for 1982's "Hot Hits" launch. Dawson worked there for Buddy Scott and Dave Shakes and then broke into programming with oldies KVOX Fargo, N.D., and the late WBXX (B95) Battle Creek, Mich., under GM Bill Hennes.

"Fantasy"; Seal, "Kiss From A Rose"; and Da Brat, "Fa All Y'All."

KIX plays its power records 90 times a week, Dawson says. "We look specifically for reaction records. It's the kiss of death when a record guy says, 'Play this for five weeks, and it'll test.' I should live so long. If I had a big-ass AC signal, then maybe I'd look at it."

Dawson uses Comquest, a research system marketed, coincidentally, by Garry Mitchell. "It helps us identify our P1 listeners and hot zips, and we can conduct music surveys via touch-tone phone," says Dawson. "We can drive 150-200 connects in one night using only three people. It's like having 12 people doing research."

As for how much emphasis Dawson, who is particularly aggressive on new music, puts on research, he says, "You still have to use your head. You have to decide who's programming this radio station, me or some lady working at Luscious Lane Candies in Cranston, R.I.?"

"I see a lot of PDs who are afraid to program their stations. They just take raw research data right off the paper and translate that into rotations. You have to use all the information available to you from the phones, the clubs, retail sales, and call-out."

"We actually use our ears," he says. "If a record sounds good, and we like it, we'll give it 30 spins a week to see if the public likes it."

As for just who that public is, the WWKX sales office is located in Pawtucket, R.I., its tower is in the city of license, Woonsocket, R.I., the studios are just over the state line in Attleboro, Mass., and the Kix stationary proudly bears a Providence P.O. box. To keep the air staff focused on the target market, Dawson has posted a sign outside the control room that says, "You're walking into downtown Providence."

To better serve the ever-expanding Kix neighborhood, the station uses a large, boxy-looking vehicle, the Kix Meat Truck, for constant remotes. Besides the usual station star parties, Kix is as likely to show up at a Dunkin' Donuts to hand out stickers and doughnuts, while broadcasting live through the shop's drive-through mike.

Dawson recently hired Bill Keeler for mornings, along with sidekick B.B. Good, replacing the no-longer-syndicated "Matty In The Morning" show. "It's a very proactive morning show, followed by a personality-driven radio station," he says. Morning producer Anthony Pepe (aka "Danger Boy") earned his nickname recently when he donned a police flak jacket and let a cop shoot him with a .45 caliber revolver.

Dawson has taken on some additional administrative duties lately, as a result of GM Gene Lombardi's position being eliminated. GSM Joe Lembo and Dawson are currently dividing GM duties and report directly to Back Bay Broadcasting's Peter Crawford. They do so as new WPRO-FM PD Chris Shebel joins to rescue that station from an uncharacteristic low.


Dawson and Shebel worked together in 1979-82 at the late WXGT (92X) Columbus, Ohio. Shebel also worked at WLS Chicago when Dawson was across the street at B96. "Chris and I have similar backgrounds," says Dawson, who consulted WLXR La Crosse, Wis., for about a year when Shebel was PD. They have similar tastes in music, too. Shebel, who is coming into a station that leans adult, has long been an advocate of dance music, while Dawson will always be known as the PD who brought dance records like "Yolanda" to Dubuque.

"Chris is a friend," says Dawson. "Hopefully, he'll continue to chase his demos, I'll chase mine, and we'll both enjoy mutual success."

crossover acts owe some debt to the Beatles, "Free As A Bird" is less likely to sound like "Fantasy," "Gangsta's Paradise," or "Beautiful Life" than, well, a Beatles record.

So how are mainstream and adult top 40 responding? With nobody having heard the single yet, reaction runs the gamut, with some PDs willing to find a place for the record—if only as a morning-show novelty—because of its historic significance and the magnitude of the pre-release publicity, and others feeling that a new Beatles single is more appropriate for oldies and classic rock stations.

WAPE (Power 95) Jacksonville, Fla., PD Cat Thomas had the most elaborate plans of any PD contacted by Top 40 Airplay Monitor. Because the original WAPE-AM sponsored the Beatles when they first arrived in Jacksonville in 1964, "there's obviously a lot of tradition with the Beatles and WAPE," Thomas says. The local ABC affiliate is planning a documentary about the 1964 show and will actually broadcast WAPE's debut of the song live on Sunday night.

Asked if today's WAPE audience is conscious

of the current Beatles blitz, Thomas says, "If they're not conscious of the Beatles, they must be unconscious. With all the hoopla that's surrounding [the single], it transcends the format to me."

"IT'S A MEDIA EVENT"

Here's a sampling of reaction from other top 40 programmers:

- Jim Reitz, PD of rhythmic-leaning WFHN (Fun 107) New Bedford, Mass.: "It's a media event, so it's something you can't ignore. Our target listener probably isn't a big Beatles fan, but even without having heard it, I still think it's going to be a viable top 40 song, because it's [part of] such a media event. So I don't know exactly what capacity we'll use it in, but I'm sure we will."

- Tom Poleman, PD, KRBE Houston: "It's hard to say if the Beatles are still going to have an impact on our listeners. But whenever you have a major network involved, the curiosity is probably there. Since KRBE is a pop-culture radio station, we'll probably want to have some talk about it on the morning show the next day. Beyond that, it's up to the listeners."

- Andy Shane, MD, WHTZ (Z100) New York, asked what the Beatles mean to an alternative-leaning station's audience: "Right now, they mean more to PDs and MDs. I think [PD Steve Kingston] and I are looking forward to hearing it more than our listeners are. There is going to be a segment of the audience that will be dying to hear it, but for our target, it's going to be limited . . . If anything, we'd showcase it on the morning show."

- Charlie Quinn, PD, WYHY (Y107) Nashville: "For my radio station, an oldie is 1985. That's reaching really deep, so the '60s? Forget it . . . I probably will give it to the morning guys and have them do a single bit in which they play a few select Beatles cuts one morning, and that will be the extent of my promoting it."

- Bill Thorman, PD, KHOM (Mix 104.1)

New Orleans: "I'll really have to see if it has a younger appeal. We were oldies for so long, I hate to do anything that relates to oldies. I'm not even sure if our listeners know that the Beatles were Paul McCartney's first band. Personally, I'm glad to see it . . . but I'm not sure how it can benefit me greatly."

THE OLDIES CONNECTION

Even some of the PDs who still deal with oldies directly, either through oldies duopoly partners or as a larger-than-usual part of their format, are cautious. WKRZ Wilkes-Barre, Pa., PD Ken Medek does a Saturday night oldies show that goes back to the '50s, but he says that he doesn't get many calls for the Beatles. "Even on our oldies show, we've gotten away from that," he says. "We just rammed it down people's throats for so long."

Scott Hamilton, OM for WIIH (Live 101.9) Montgomery, Ala., notes that WXFX, the duopoly partner he oversees, just segued from classic to mainstream rock and "no longer plays as much in the Beatles/CCR category" outside special programming. But, he adds, "if this causes a resurgence in the Beatles, we'll have to support them."

Neil Sharpe, PD at WJET Erie, Pa., which has an oldies duopoly partner, WFGO (Froggy 94), is planning on concentrating the bulk of his efforts there. "One nice thing is that we have an ABC-TV affiliate in our building, so we're doing a lot of cross-promotions between TV and our oldies station. We're also tying the oldies station in with the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and have Beatles T-shirts with our logos. As far as the new stuff, we may dabble with it a little as a morning-show-type thing on WJET."

TOP 40/ADULT SAYS YES

At top 40/adult stations, a keystone of Capitol's strategy for the record, reaction was almost uniformly favorable, even given the format's increasingly hard edge.

ABC flagship WPLJ New York—the successor to AM top 40 WABC—which, during Beatlemania, billed itself as "W-A-Beatle-C"—was planning a preview party at the Harley Davidson Cafe with a Beatles tribute band for the Wednesday (15) before the broadcast. WPLJ assistant PD/MD Mike Preston says, "We'll certainly play it, although it's kind of hard to know what kind of commitment we'll have."

"If you're a station that targets 25-34 adults, there's certainly some relevance. If stations don't have a problem playing a new record from Elton John or the Rolling Stones or somebody else who's been around forever, what's the difference? So many stations in this format are song-driven now that if the song is good, it speaks for itself."

WKDD Akron, Ohio, PD Chuck Collins is in a market with two different ABC affiliates. He notes that "they're promoting this thing like crazy." Collins believes that "most of the buzz I'm getting is industry" and that "there's been so many other remakes and reissues in the last year, I don't know if people realize there's a new Beatles song." But he adds, "We certainly are going to be there, because it's a huge event."

At KALC (Alice 106) Denver, another cutting-edge top 40/adult station, MD Jim Lawson plans to play one Beatles cut an hour next Monday and give away anthology CDs. KALC's duopoly partner, '70s oldies outlet KIMN will also pump up the '70s solo material from the various Beatles and plans to break format to add some '60s Beatles classics to its library.

One dissenter on the top 40/adult side is KHMX (Mix 96.5) Houston PD Pat Paxton, who says, "I'm not planning on doing much with the new single . . . I don't see our crowd breaking down the door to get at it."

Even in England, radio reaction to the forthcoming single is mixed. One programmer, contacted for a similar story, told Top 40 Airplay Monitor's British sister publication, Music Monitor, "We'll probably look upon it in the same way as the Beach Boys' 'Kokomo' . . . That was also a 'new' release but was still, essentially, a '60s record."

K.C. "Drive To Revive" Restores Drug House

October was National Drug Awareness Month. So KMXV (Mix 93.3) Kansas City decided to take a stand against the proliferation of crack houses by teaming with neighborhood residents—utilizing COMBAT (a community-backed antidrug tax)—for the Drive to Revive, a citywide campaign to take back the neighborhoods.

The first goal of the campaign was to acquire a condemned drug house, restore it using listener donations, and donate the house back to the community. KMXV promotions director Karen Menke says that the parties looked long and hard before settling on a house. They wanted a house in a good area with an active neighborhood association that would help in the renovation process and oversee the final disposition of the house. The house chosen, in Menke's words, was located in a "proud area of town, full of longtime residents and old-world charm. Basically, it was a bad apple on a good tree." The former drug house was located on the same corner as a school-bus stop, across the street from two churches, and on the same block as a museum.

With the financial support of listeners, the house was purchased for \$18,000 and is being renovated to its original, historic state. Upon completion of the project, the house will be donated to the neighborhood association, which will sell it and use the funds to further improve the area or to acquire another project house.

On Oct. 25, KMXV's morning show jocks Dainy and the Barber and midday jock Kelly Urich fielded phone calls detailing real-life stories of drug-house problems in Kansas City. For two days, the station solicited donations from the public to kick off the campaign. Special phone banks were set up and manned by station personnel. Credit-card donations and pledges were accepted, and a bank account was set up to accommodate the funds.

Two days later, Mix broadcast all its jock shifts live from the selected house and invited listeners

to stop by for a tour of the once-beautiful home that had fallen victim to disrepair and the ravages of the drug trade. Police officers, who had shut down the house, guided the morning show on a walk-through. Local contractors, suppliers, and other businesses were invited to join the project on a volunteer basis. To date, KMXV has collected more than \$15,000 cash and more than \$50,000 in donated supplies and labor to cover landscaping, floor replacement, paint, carpentry, home security, etc.

The station continues to run Drive to Revive promos and updates to maintain listener interest in the project. Menke adds that this promotion will continue until the house is fully restored and given back to the community.

The association hopes to have the principal renovation work done by Christmas, when it plans to throw a huge block party to celebrate the completion of this project and, they hope, the birth of more community projects like it.






