## Bye Bye 'NY, Evergreen's Got 'The Beat Of New York' On New WKTU

The biggest industry speculation game in recent memory took another turn in market No. 1 Feb. 10 when Evergreen Media—after a week of stunting—finally flipped country WNY New York



to a top 40/rhythm approach, reclaiming the legendary calls of late '70s/early '80s disco powerhouse WKTU. The station is now known as "the new WKTU: The Beat Of New York."

At press time, WKTU, which launched with C+C Music Factory's "Gonna Make You Sweat," was running jockless

and without a permanent PD and MD, although speculation on the PD post continued to point to the Box's Frankie Blue, who was first mentioned in association with the WKTU job when rumors about a WNY change began last July. WKTU's programming is being overseen by Evergreen programming czar Steve Rivers and group consultant Guy Zapoleon. Also, a GM has not been named, although Evergreen has hired Scott Ellberg from Infinity's crosstown WFAN as GSM and KIOI San Francisco GSM John Bassani as director of sales.

Rivers and Evergreen COO Jim de Castro say the company did two separate research studies with Strategic Radio Research and Nova Marketing that indicated a hole for mass-appeal pop/rhythmic music. De Castro says, "WQHT [Hot 97] is too hip-hop and young. WRKS and WBLS are very slow jams and urban. WHTZ [Z100] is rock, and WPLJ is pop/rock. There is a clear hole for a



## Dance Revival, Telecom Bill Dominate Confab

Even though the debut of the new WKTU New York was taking place 1,000 miles away, it was the prevalent topic for top 40 programmers at the 1996 Gavin Seminar in Atlanta, held Feb. 8-10.

The launch of WKTU's top 40/rhythm format spurred predictions of a dance revival by some programmers, the most surprising of whom was WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., MD Albie D., who announced to a top 40 panel audience that he was starting to see top 20 sales on titles from La Bouche and Everything But The Girl, which, he says, are played only in his mix show.

Despite the fact that WPGC is one of the few rhythm/crossover outlets not to re-add pop dance music thus far, Albie D. told the panel, "The audience that was into the 80-100 bpm hip-hop two years ago is saying, 'I'm done. Give me some type of rhythm. Give me some type of tempo.'"

Several minutes later, two L.A. programmers—KIIS APD Tracy Austin and KKBT PD Harold Austin—commented on the greater dance lean at rival KPWR (Power 106) which, KIIS' Austin noted, was "playing a lot more cha-cha records." KKBT's Austin said that KPWR's new interest in the deep house sound meant that his R&B station could again "claim ownership" of R&B artists.

While Harold Austin may want to reclaim ownership of R&B, very few top 40 stations seem inclined in that direction, despite the dance revival. At an earlier consultants panel, Hilton Head Island, S.C.-based consultant Don Kelly noted that records selling in most markets had a "much greater ethnic component" than most top 40 stations wanted to deal with. Kelly also said that while it would be natural for each market to have a rhythmic top 40 and a rock-based top 40, the fact that there was enough revenue for one top 40 in most cities meant that many radio markets were going against the "natural order."

### THE LAND RUSH

If WKTU was the most-discussed topic at Gavin, the Telecommunications Bill, unsurprisingly, was No. 2. Detroit-based consultant Fred Jacobs suggested the pattern already established by duopoly would continue—"just at a more frantic, accelerated pace." Country consultant Rusty Walker repeated one GM's prediction that by 2005, the medium would no longer be known as radio, it would be called "Mel," in honor of Infinity honcho Mel Karmazin. Walker also encouraged PDs to become "demo specialists, not format specialists," in anticipation of having to program more than one format in the megapolis world.

San Diego-based consultant Jerry Clifton, making his appearance on the panel via speakerphone, said that megapolis was potentially "the answer to a [programmer's] dream." Now, Clifton said, one consultant could program not just his station, but everybody else's format also, staggering stopsets at every station for maximum effect, for example.

KYYY Bismarck, N.D., PD Bob Beck was less enthusiastic. The changing ownership climate, he said, meant that his new owners had

just taken the heritage top 40 station to satellite AC. "I'm very fortunate. I still have my job, but it's very tough to let people go," Beck said, which led Brian Philips, PD of modern WNNX (99X) Atlanta, to comment, "These people—because of a bill—are going to be left with satellite radio, and that's awful."

Jefferson Pilot VP programming Don Benson had a more optimistic take on the state of the format, saying that there was better available music for top 40 and that owners were more realistic about the available audience. Targeting 18-34, Benson said, had led to better 25-54 numbers than when stations were targeting 25-plus audiences directly.

Meanwhile, Orlando, Fla.-based consultant Bill Richards noted the increasing similarity between hot AC and mainstream top 40. Those charts once differed by 18 songs; now they differ only by six songs, Richards said. "I think hot ACs are just trying to move top 40 to the left, and we've let them do it." Jacobs then noted that the increased interest by adult top 40 in modern rock would mean "just more coming aggravation" for his modern rock clients.

### OTHER HIGHLIGHTS

Other top 40-related sessions at Gavin included a panel called "Getting Out Of The Concert Business," in which label reps complained about the tendency of stations to demand concert acts and then not support follow-up singles. That led WBBM-FM (B96) PD Todd Cavanah to say that acts for his annual "Bee Bash" were the only thing he requested from labels throughout the year. This, Cavanah said, meant that he didn't feel "like I have to play the fifth single out of the box."

Meanwhile, independent promoter Ric Cooper questioned the overall value of station concerts, pointing out that two major top 40 stations had their worst-ever books during their spring concert promotions. Mercury's Steve Ellis noted that it was often worse for a label to try and give a station an act, then have to say no, than not attempt to do so in the first place.

At a Saturday morning Arbitron panel, new ratings service honcho Pierre Bouvard—asked if the radio service had any intention of using the Internet to augment its diary placement—told the audience that teens, the potential audience for such a move, were already good diary keepers and that "as much hype as you hear about the World Wide Web, you might find only one tenth of the audience using it." But, he added, "clearly this is something we want to watch." That panel, by the way, remained relatively low-key, despite the barrage of recent Arbitron criticism around the industry.

Independent promotion legend Moe Preskell was the recipient of Gavin's first Charlie Minor Lifetime Achievement Award, named for the slain industry veteran. The ailing Preskell was unable to accept in person—his award was picked up by Minor's mother and brother. Other highlights at Gavin included well-received keynotes by Ahmet Ertegun, Olympic gymnast Peter Vidmar, and Rupert Murdoch, who, interviewed by TV's Charlie Rose, probably made the first-ever comments on British Labour Party leader Tony Blair at a music industry convention.

### Frankie Blue's Outta The Box To WKTU

**P**recious moments after page 1 went to print, it was confirmed that **Frankie Blue**, director of programming for the Box, has resigned to become the new PD of Evergreen's new **WKTU** New York. Meanwhile, WKTU taps network TV guy **Don LaFontaine** as station voice, along with **Maureen Rivers**. And the Atlantic City, N.J., oldies station that gave up the WKTU calls becomes **WTNU** and remains "Kool 98.3."

As the post-dereg feeding frenzy continues, SFX has purchased the entire Prism chain for \$105.25 million. Also, the ever-expanding Triathalon chain has purchased **KIOK** Pasco, Wash. Jacor has LM Ned **WVKS** Toledo, Ohio, which it bought from Noble a week ago.

After weeks o'speculation, former **KTHT** Fresno, Calif., PD **Jon Zellner** is the new PD of top 40 **KMXV** (Mix 93.3) Kansas City, replacing **Steve Wall**. Meanwhile, KTHT remains hot AC but drops its rhythmic lean. **WYXR** Philadelphia hasn't dropped its rhythmic lean, but it has added some nonrhythmic titles to the mix for the first time in a year.

**WNTQ** (93Q) Syracuse, N.Y., PD **Dave Edwards** is upped to OM of Pilot Communications. **Tom Mitchell**, from sister **WMME** (92 Moose) Augusta, Maine, is the new PD. MD **Jay Kramer** is handling PD duties at WMME.

Former **WHTZ** (7/100) New York morning

man **John Lander** joins **WBXM** (Mix 98.5) Boston for mornings. Meanwhile, expect Hartford, Conn., morning dyno **Gary Craig** to become permanent morning man at sister '70s outlet **WEGQ** (The Eagle).

**KMEL** San Francisco debuts its new Breakfast Club, featuring late-night mixer **Sway**, midday jock **Lisa Foxx**, and **Victor Zaragoza** from crosstown **KOFY**. **Renel** moves to middays.

PD **Steve Wilson** has exited **WKCI** (KC101) New Haven, Conn.

An Oakland County, Mich., judge has ruled that top 40 adult **WKQI** (Q95) Detroit morning man **Dick Purtan**—who sued to be let out of his contract—is free to leave as of May 12, the one-year anniversary of the merger of Broadcasting Partners and Evergreen Media. The decision is being appealed.

Former **WNKI** Elmira, N.Y., PD **Doug Guyer** joins previous WNKI owners **Vic** and **Van Michael** in a start-up in Cheyenne, Wyo.

As the **WWST/WMYU** Knoxville, Tenn., sale closes from Jacor to Heritage, OM/p.m. driver **Jim Richards** and PD/middays **Todd Shannon** will be staying with Jacor in some capacity.

Amid the format rumors at Nationwide's **AC KVRY** Phoenix, PD **Steve Elliott** will exit within a few weeks. Afternoon jock **Christopher Caldwell** has also left.

**KIIS-FM** Los Angeles morning guy **Rick Dees** inks a new contract to the year 2000.

## TOP 40 TOPICS BY SEAN ROSS

### 'Out With A Bang' Or How To Change Format

**W**hen you count WKTU, WPAT-FM, WXRK (K-Rock), WNEW-FM, and the new, expanded-band AM WJDM, New York radio listeners have heard five format changes since New Year's Day. That's meant a lot of opportunities to contemplate the way in which format changes are handled.

Once, stations tried to sign on sounding like they'd been part of the market forever. The new jocks were in place or, at worst, the old staffers were trying hard to keep their jobs. That's the least-common type of sign-on these days. Stations sign on with extensive stunting or by running jockless for weeks—or months. Many of the new '70s gold stations haven't bothered adding jocks until nine months into the format.

**R**obert Unmacht of The M Street Journal newsletter has compared signing on jockless (and the "help us build your new radio station" stunt that often accompanies it) to a Home Depot opening with empty shelves. ("You told us you wanted chainsaws. So this week, we're adding them.") New megastores need friendly customer-service folks to explain where everything is. In fact, it's the customer service that helps make such stores category-killers.

So why should a radio station be different? Most stations sign on with music that hasn't been completely exposed in the market, yet there's rarely anybody to explain what a station is playing. With all the modern rockers that signed on jockless, one wonders what the folks who weren't modern rock partisans made of all that new music. If a station wants to prove to the rest of the industry how much impact it can have, it had better start affecting record sales right away. And one way to do that is to tell people what they're hearing.

When a station signs on jockless, there's nobody to say, "Thanks for loving us," and calling that station's voice mail to leave a comment isn't the same.

When there are no jocks, there's nobody to explain how to use the station except the station's promo voice. Is that enough? Consider how many listeners no longer believe a radio station's positioning statements. Then consider how few of those positioners are actually delivered by real people whom listeners know and trust.

As for the notion that starting jockless is putting your best foot forward, if your station sounds better without jocks than it does with them, then you've got the wrong jocks.

Some other notes about format changes:

- Don't insult the old listeners or the old format. All the old listeners did wrong was pay your salary for the last few years. Many of them are your new listeners. Many of them are your advertisers. A lot of the new top 40 outlets are former top 40 outlets that switched to hot AC and then spent months trying to differentiate themselves from their predecessor by talking about how bad it used to be. Now they're finding it hard to come back. Gee.

- Chances are that you are not letting listeners build their own radio station. So don't be dishonest about it on the air. It's great to talk about finding out what listeners want and then giving it to them. But chances are you've already done that. And if the listeners had all the answers, why are so many new stations blowing up a previous format that was already heavily researched?

- If you're going to stunt, take advantage of the existing cume and draw people who'll like the new product. Howard Stern's introduction of the new WXRK was a wonderful idea, given the audience he commands. But

Stern used the first hour to play his own favorites, not the station's new format. One wonders how many of Stern's older listeners might have been comfortable with "When I Come Around" but weren't comfortable with *Marilyn Manson*. (Then again, wouldn't a weekend show with an hour of Stern's playlist be great?)

As for smoke-screen formats, or the "different format every day" stunt, why offer folks something they might like if they can't keep it? I've really enjoyed hearing WRX (Rock 103.5) Chicago and KKB (the Beat) Los Angeles simulcast on WNY New York's frequency. But I'm in the industry. Country listeners would've been just as happy with one more week of their favorite music. It's hard enough for listeners to find a new format, figure out what it is, and make their choice without added confusion. How are they to know the real format isn't a stunt, too?

Occasionally, smoke-screen formats have unexpected long-reaching consequences. KNRJ Houston spent a wonderful month as "Alternative 96.5" before debuting its hot AC format and becoming KHM (Mix 96.5). Since there was no modern rock station in Houston at the time, and since KHM was rockin' pretty hard for an AC station, a lot of listeners probably stayed with the new format. Four years later, the *Goo Goo Dolls* are a hot AC act, and many Mix 96.5 partisans are showing little tolerance for other types of music. One wonders if that has anything to do with the type of folks who were there from the beginning.

Finally, a few words about sign-offs. It's an unfortunate aspect of this business that most jocks, whether they're fired or the victims of a format change, don't get to say goodbye to their audience. It's also unfortunate that most jocks, given the opportunity to say goodbye, will demonstrate why so few jocks are allowed to do so.

There have been some great format changes when the old staff got to say goodbye at length. WCFL Chicago's now-famous Larry Lujack sign-off was one. So was the last hour of KHJ Los Angeles, when Robert W. Morgan dragged the needle across a *Doors* record and asked Jim Morrison if he was now exposing himself to God. But few jocks are Lujack or Morgan. And when most other jocks try to pull off the same thing, it usually speaks volumes about why their old station is going away in the first place.

Whitney Allen's last country break on WNY, as part of the syndicated "After Midnite" program, was just fine. She strung three phone calls together from folks who said they'd miss the show. She noted that change in radio is inevitable. She told the listeners that everybody at "After Midnite" expected to be back in New York soon. Then she played "The Dance" by Garth Brooks, which is the "It's So Hard To Say Goodbye To Yesterday" of country songs, and she was gone. It said everything there was to say in about 45 seconds.

The best part about Allen's sign-off was that it took place amid a lot of music. I wanted to hear a few more country cuts before I lost my only country outlet, and I did. Long format changes usually mean a lot of hearts and flowers and not a lot of music. So instead of one last great fling with your soon-to-be ex, you get one last painfully earnest rehash of the relationship's problems. How would you rather spend that last night together?

Of course, we already know that most stations end not with a bang but a whimper. Now, many are signing on that way, too.

rhythm-based, fun, entertaining radio station."

Although WKTU—which migrated to an oldies station in Atlantic City, N.J., after the original WKTU became rock station WXRK in 1985—has calls that connote dance, Rivers says, "the new 'KTU' will have more dimensions to it than just dance. A lot of ballad material tested extremely well, as did the dance classics and many New York regional records. This station will be very well balanced."

Some of the heritage artists that will be heard on the station—according to WXKS-FM (Kiss 108) Boston music coordinator Kid David, currently assisting in the WKTU music department—are Alisha, TKA, Cover Girls, Cynthia, George Lamond, and Donna Summer; as well as current faves Janet Jackson, TLC, Boyz II Men, Brandy, Real McCoy, Mariah Carey, Madonna, and other artists who have fallen through the cracks in New York.

In the first few days of WKTU, power currents seemed to be turning over at 2:30-2:45 intervals. Gold titles ranged from mid-'70s crossover dance ("Get Down Tonight," "Shame," etc.) to late-'80s freestyle (i.e., Company B's "Fascinated" or the Cover Girls' "Because Of You") to such unlikely titles as Bob Marley's "One Love," also a staple of Evergreen's WJMN (Jammin' 94.5) Boston (see Music Monitor, below).

Despite the WKTU calls and the presence of some unusual gold titles in the early days of the station, Rivers says WKTU will be careful when doling out the old-school product. "There will be some, but we don't want it to become overpowering. This is not the old 'KTU' . . . We're deliberately trying not to limit ourselves musically, and we're striving to remain as mass appeal as possible," he adds. Although some format observers have questioned the financial wisdom of blowing up a country station with a 25-54 niche to go top 40/rhythm, Rivers says that "based on our research, the new 'KTU' will have substantial 25-54 appeal."

In terms of presentation, Rivers says, "our goal is make our presentation extremely positive. I know the PDs at our major competitors, WHTZ, WPLJ, and WQHT. They're all outstanding radio stations, but I feel the overall tone of the market seems a little angry right now. This is a good opportunity for us to be a positive, fun, upbeat radio station."

"Once we have the PD set, that person will announce the jock staff. We're looking for '90s communicators who are also entertainers. I want the attitude of the new 'KTU' to recall the old WABC days," he says, "a classic station where the music was great, the jocks were exciting and fun to listen to, and they were proud of the fact that they were on the air in New York City." Until that time, the station is planning to set up microphones at different locations so listeners can audition live on the air:

De Castro adds, "We're really in no hurry. In fact, we'd like to do some additional stunting with current and ex-New York radio personalities taking turns doing the morning show to get us through the Spring book."

### OUT TO LAUNCH

WKTU's launch followed a much-publicized week of simulcasts of other Evergreen properties designed to showcase Evergreen to Wall Street, Madison Avenue, and the record community, according to corporate marketing director Bev Tilden. Besides the simulcast of WRCX Chicago morning man Mancow Muller (see Monitor Profile, right), other stations simulcast included KKBT Los Angeles (featuring a live O.J. Simpson interview), WLUP Chicago, KIOI San Francisco, and WXKS Boston.

Tilden, who recently joined Evergreen after serving as station manager of WEEI Boston and planning the much-admired series of station concerts for WXKS, says Evergreen sought its legendary calls because "the WKTU name was a great place to start. If you talk to most 30- to 40-year-old New Yorkers, they already know those call letters."

WKTU is planning a formal station launch party within the next month, followed by an extensive TV campaign. De Castro adds that the upcoming marketing campaign for 'KTU' will be "very high-brow and high energy. The whole look of the radio station will have a Calvin Klein appearance," he says. "The billboards, the bus cards, and the television [spots] will have a very upscale feel."

### 1,000 MILES AWAY

Ironically, WKTU's debut took place when much of the radio and record industry was more than 1,000 miles away from New York—at the Gavin Seminar, held in Atlanta Feb. 8-10.

Not surprisingly, the new station was a major topic of discussion at various Gavin panels, even before its debut. Consultant Jerry Clifton, who appeared via speakerphone at a consultant's panel, noted that WKTU was debuting in an "atmosphere [that is] a lot different, and time will tell. With Hot 97 being as strong as it is now, and urban being as big as it is, it's going to be a good battle."

Jefferson Pilot group PD Don Benson told the Saturday top 40 awards luncheon that "WKTU is going to come in and get noticed right away," which led to the suggestion by several panelists that top 40 would undergo another dance phase. Notably, Jefferson Pilot's WSTR (Star 94) Atlanta, which plays little current R&B music, was running a lot of the vintage late '80s/early '90s titles that WKTU is also playing from C+C Music Factory and Black Box.

## MONITOR PROFILE

### Mancow Vents Spleen At Stern And Orders Mickey Mantle's Liver On NYC Field Trip

**W**hat drives WRCX (Rock 103.5) Chicago morning man Eric "Mancow" Muller? "Hunger," he says. "I'm afraid of becoming old and poor."

Gee, Muller didn't sound afraid on the air last week, when he spent Monday morning being simulcast on WYNY New York as part of that station's format change. Muller's on-air aggression, including multiple attacks on Howard Stern and a few on everybody else in town, made him the industry's most talked-about air talent and got him the kind of publicity—not all of it positive—that other morning shows take years to achieve.

"I have no fear, and the reason is simple. Early in my career, I got stuck reading liner cards, and there's just no way to do it right. I [did] great interviews with Arnold Schwarzenegger or Bruce Willis, and the PD would spend a half-hour critiquing the way I said the call letters. I tried to please all these PDs, and I got fired anyway . . . I decided, I'm gonna do it my way, and if I get fired, at least I can live with myself." The bottom line, says Muller, is "I fear nothing. I'm a single guy. I have no kids. What do I have to lose?"

Muller's pre-radio career includes pitstops as a

Los Angeles. Muller was subsequently convicted of being a public nuisance, "which seems perfect for me," he says. "I spent 100 hours wearing an orange monkey suit, picking up trash along the freeways. I've paid for my art." (Not completely, though. He's headed back to San Francisco this weekend for further litigation. "I'm thinking about doing call-ins from court," he says.)

Muller credits Evergreen honcho Jim de Castro for giving him his big break in Chicago two years ago. It was there that Muller's feud with Stern started. Muller gets a bit prickly when his approach to morning radio is compared with Stern's, something done by several callers last week. "That just irritates me. If the guy deserved credit, I'd give him credit. A lot of guys inspired me . . . Jeff and Jer, Kidd Kraddick in Dallas, and Rusty Humphries at TM Century. Also, Skid Roadie was a cool rock jock when I was growing up in Kansas City, to name a few."

"I talk about sex, politics, everything. The one thing I don't do is slam people's religion. My dad was dying of cancer last year, and every day Stern was praying to Jesus for my father's death. I have yet to find anyone who can show me the humor in that. John DeBella's wife laid in the ground, and I don't find anything cute about it," he says. Muller cites Stern's new book, which he hasn't read. "He apparently admitted that he has . . . psychological problems. He obviously was not a happy child, and now, everybody has to pay."

Which brings us to his New York assault Feb. 5. How did Muller prep for a New York crowd without ignoring his Chicago base? "I think they forgave me for a day," he says. "I think people in Chicago see me as a brave warrior going into a savage land." Muller wasn't in New York, but Evergreen's staffers hit the Big Apple streets, hard. "They took Chicago and New York pizza out to the streets and had a homeless taste test," he says. "Then they went into Mickey Mantle's restaurant and ordered liver. There was a lot more going on than just Stern-bashing." Of course, "Hard Copy" and CNN were there to cover it.

There continues to be a buzz regarding a possible Muller syndication deal. Muller predicts syndication to both coasts by year's end. "There's nothing wrong with being No. 1 in my target in Chicago," he says. "I think it would take a couple of years, but I could be No. 1 in New York, without question. That's not just ego talking . . . It's all about water-cooler talk. Love me or hate me, everybody in New York talked about Mancow yesterday."

As for the fact that not all the talk was positive, he says, "PDs and industry people . . . don't get me, but real people do, and that's what matters. I don't do my show for the [trades] or PDs."

He means that. There are no aircheck sessions with WRCX PD Dave Richards, whom he affectionately refers to as "Sgt. Dickhead." "I refuse to aircheck," he says. "Listen to my show. Don't roll tape and listen to it in the afternoon, out of context. The vibe is completely different."

Advice for future Mancows? "Don't take a job for money, and don't get caught up in market size; that'll all come. The important thing is go where you can have freedom. It's never been about money or fame for me; it's having a creative outlet."

"This is the greatest business in the world, but so many people get caught up in research and become tied to their laptops. The Internet has also managed to separate us from other people, so there's less and less personal communication. There's nothing instantaneous about TV, and people just read certain chunks out of newspapers, but with radio you actually become somebody's friend. It's the most human art form."

"If a loser like Mancow can get on the radio, you can, too. My show is inclusive, not exclusive. It's designed for everybody, but mostly for men who like talking about pussy." KEVIN CARTER
