Sensitive '90s PDs Are Willing To Break The Old Rules, Sometimes

Remember all that stuff you were taught at the beginning of your career? One thought per set, keep the station moving forward, don't dig in the powers, only open the mike at specific points on the clock, don't back-sell one song and front-sell the next, blah, blah, blah.

Well, we're in the all-new, no-hype, anti-DJ '90s, and it's possible to hear major-market top 40s interrupting their music sweeps for listener phone calls, opening breaks with something other than call letters, or segueing records into commercials—things that would've had the format gurus of the '70s and '80s hot-lining a jock within seconds.

So are today's jock rules revolutionary and groundbreaking? Or have PDs truly become their parents, still teaching the same old tried-and-true chestnuts they were taught in the late '50s?

The answer seems to be that, in theory, most PDs are a lot less rigid, but not all yesterday's basics have been tossed out.

"I look at the rules of radio as an 'Old Testament/New Testament' thing," says WBZZ (B94) Pittsburgh OM Keith Clark. "Way back when, we were taught to abide by the letter of the law. There were rules that weren't supposed to be broken for reasons we didn't question.

"Many of the old principles still work, but today's audience is more sophisticated," Clark adds. "They have more entertainment choices, and they use radio much differently than they did years ago. Some of the old top 40 rules can still be applied 'in spirit,' but strict adherence to them is fading," he says.

"Many of those old rules made sense if you thought in terms of rigid listening habits like 'quarter hours' or 'top to bottom of the hour,' but that's old-school radio and TV thinking, back

CD Radio and American Mobile Radio are the two auction winners for satellite DAB licenses, following last week's withdrawal of **Smashing Pumpkins/Metallica** manager **Cliff Burnstein's** Primosphere and Digital Satellite Broadcasting Corp. CD Radio bid \$83 million for its license. American Mobile bid \$90 million.

With Cox Radio closing on the acquisition of New-City Communications, NewCity president **Dick Ferguson** becomes VP/COO. **WSB/WJZF** Atlanta VP/GM **Marc Morgan** and **WEZN** (Star 99.9) Bridgeport, Conn., VP/GM **James T. Morley** are named senior group VPs. Adult R&B/AC **WHQT/WFLC** Miami VP/GM **Robert Green** gets group VP stripes and will oversee Cox's Louisville, Ky., and Dayton, Ohio, stations. **WCFB** (Star 94.5) Orlando, Fla., VP/GM **Richard Reis** is also named group VP. Former **WJHM** (102 Jamz) Orlando morning co-host **Jo Jo** is the new p.m. driver at **WCFB**.

American Radio Systems closes on its purchase of EZ Communications.

N/T **KPIX** San Francisco GM **Blaise Howard** is the new GM at AC **WBEB** (B101) Philadelphia, replacing **Meg DeLone**.

Wayne Leland is the new GM at **WFHN** (Fun 107) New Bedford, Mass. He was GM of Commodore's Danbury, Conn., stations.

PROGRAMMING: BALIS' NEW STRIPES

Emmis Broadcasting promotes album **KSHE** St. Louis PD **Rick Balis** to the newly created position of director of programming for Emmis St. Louis, overseeing **KSHE**, modern AC **WALC** (Alice 104), and country **WKXX**. Balis will retain his day-to-day PD duties at **KSHE**; there will be separate PDs at the other two properties.

Jefferson-Pilot taps **Mark Feather** to program **KQKS** (KS107.5) Denver. Feather, who replaces **Dan Bowen**, was PD of **KQKS** until early '96, when he signed on crosstown **KJMN**, which went Spanish last December.

Classic rock **KRRW** Dallas drops the Arrow handle for soft AC as **B97.9**.

After two years as smooth jazz, **WJSZ** Buffalo, N.Y., goes modern AC as Alice 92.9. PD **Steve Weirsman**, who stayed on through **WJSZ's** previous change from hot AC to jazz, remains PD.

After a brief crossover stint, **WMYK** (the Beat) Norfolk, Va., made a sharp left last week, dropping most of its dance titles and billing itself as "Your hip-hop station." Also exiting rhythmic top 40 after a brief stint is **KZRQ** (Star 105) Albuquerque, N.M., which assumes the jazz format of sister **KRZN**, which will in turn flip to simulcast adult standards with **KIVA-AM**.

Longtime AC **KRNO** Reno, Nev., PD **Larry Irons** has exited. Former **KHTC** Phoenix APD/morning man **Alan Cook** replaces him.

Five weeks after being added as corporate image director, Nassau Broadcasting ups **Rob Walker** to PD of adult top 40 **WJLK** (94.3 the Point) Monmouth/Ocean, N.J., replacing **Gary Guida**. Morning co-host **Mike Benson** also exits, replaced by **Doug O'Brien**, who transfers from AC duopoly partner **WOBM**.

Country **WDXD** Daytona Beach, Fla., flips to top 40 as **WVYB** (the Vibe) under **Taft Moore**, OM of modern sister **WKRO**.

Country **WJKK** Jackson, Miss., flips to Jones Satellite Network soft AC as **Luv 98**.

The Eagle Group's **Matt Hudson** and **John Fischer** rejoin **Roger Wimmer** at his new Wimmer-Hudson Research & Development.

KTMT (Power 93) Medford, Ore., becomes rhythmic "Beat 93." P.m. driver **Toni Cruise** goes to MD/mornings, replacing **Mark and Brian**. **Steve Hall** returns to radio for afternoons.

KMEL San Francisco jocks **Sway** and **King Tech** are upped to the newly created positions of music consultants for the station.

WJMN (Jam'n 94.5) Boston middayer **Mike McGowan** exits. Call 617-979-0917.

'Please Play That Song About Mghphamopph'

When country made its move into the stratosphere in the late '80s, one of its frequent selling points was that you could understand the lyrics. The implication was that you couldn't understand rap lyrics, although since a lot of people complained about rap lyrics, one wonders if they were just assuming that there was something inherently objectionable about them, sort of like "Louie Louie" for the '90s.

In 1993, the modern rock revolution came to top 40, and instead of just assuming that today's hit lyrics were angry and nihilistic, suddenly we knew. Still, programmers were happy to have lyrics that you could understand and sing along with, even if walking in Times Square singing "I'm a loser, baby/so why don't you kill me?" raised the frightening possibility that somebody might take you up on it. Despite this, I enjoyed singing along again. For most of '95, my co-workers could read my moods and knew to avoid me based on whether I was walking the halls singing "woah-oh/it was goooood living with you" or the line from "Plowed" by **Sponge** about a world of human wreckage. Many tended to avoid anyone wandering the halls singing, but I digress.

With top 40 lyrics being audible again, country stations had to make do with a 12 share in most markets instead of the 18 share to which they'd become accustomed. Life was great, although I felt strange wandering the streets of New York singing "I could never be your woman." Even in Times Square, some folks felt compelled to stop me and say that they'd never asked me to be their woman in the first place. And even if they were gender confused, they liked to think they could do better.

"I Want You" was the first record to dent the "lyrics-you-understand" thing—unless you were on speed—but at least you could follow the chorus. Eventually, I was able to decipher the lyrics, and all my friends told me I looked great. Then "Mmmmbop" came along with the hardest-to-decipher lyrics since "What's The Frequency Ken-

neth." At first, I believed the lyric would turn out to be either, "I put my hand upon your hip/when I dip/you dip/we dip," or "With the light out/it's less dangerous/Here we are now/entertain us." Now, we've obtained the real lyrics, which appear below as a public service.

"Mmmmbop" isn't the only evidence that being able to understand the lyrics may not be so important after all. **Crush's** "Jellyhead" has a key line about the '80s British group **Bros** that means little to most Americans and another one about **the Prodigy** that didn't mean much here until recently. It's said women pay more attention to lyrics than men, but women made "Jellyhead" huge for the stations that played it.

Then again, we don't just have lyrics that are hard to understand at the moment, we have titles that you can't even verbalize, particularly **Crystal Waters's** "Say . . . If You Feel Alright," although I've heard one enterprising (or inattentive) air-talent deal with that by just reading the title straight, as if there were no group cheer between the words "say" and "if." There are also titles that can be, but are not, fully verbalized. I refer to the titles that somehow got changed when they got remade. **Keith Sweat's** "Just A Touch" was **Slave's** "Just A Touch Of Love." **Roberta Flack's** "Killing Me Softly With His Song" became "Killing Me Softly" for **Al B. Sure!** and **the Fugees**, thus reinforcing that nihilistic hip-hop stereotype. Country, too. **Tracy Byrd's** "Don't Take Her, She's All I've Got" was just "She's All I've Got" as an early '70s country and R&B hit.

Maybe the acts involved threw their 45s away and recorded these songs from memory years later. Maybe it stems from the post-hip-hop ethos in which lyrics and titles are frequently altered to form a quasi-new composition, until the publishing company complains, which is how **Method Man's** "All I Need" became "I'll Be There For You/You're All I Need To Get By." Some top 40 PDs avoided that record because they were afraid of hip-hop. Others just didn't have time to type the cart label.



New Artists Are Coming Home

This installment should wrap up my multipart look at 1996's new-artist crop (I think this is part 23, although it may just seem that way). So far I've tallied the new artists who charted for the first time in '96, looking at the formats on which they broke and from which they crossed over and into, the labels that broke them, and so forth—all quantitative stuff, basically.

This time, I want to venture into the qualitative realm, tracking how the '96 new-artist crop performed on the charts. For starters, I looked at the 103 new artists for the year and the chart peaks for their breakthrough records in the format they originally broke in. (I followed through to '97 to date for late-'96 debuts. If an artist broke the same week in more than one format, I used the highest peak achieved.) Formats covered were top 40 mainstream, rhythm-crossover, and adult; mainstream and modern rock; and triple-A (which is only 20 positions, so that skews the results a little bit obviously; anything that charted triple-A went top 20, and it's accordingly a bit easier to hit top 10, top five, and No. 1).

- 61% of 1996's new artists reached the top 20 in their first charted format with their debut song.
- 32%, just under one-third, hit the top 10.
- 19%, just under one-fifth, hit the top five.
- 8% went all the way to No. 1.

I don't have comparable figures from previous years, but these seem like impressive and encouraging statistics for the impact of new artists and labels' ability to follow through on them.

Next, I counted the number of new artists who crossed to another format. This figure includes a few acts that broke in '95 but crossed over to a new format in '96; the total was 54. Of those, half (27) crossed over to more than one format.

Then I looked at those 54 artists to see how well they did in the formats they crossed over to, as opposed to their original format. Because there were so many artists who crossed over to more than one format, the figures can't be expressed as percentages, since some artists reached the top 10 in three separate formats, and each one counted. Still, the results again seem encouraging: Out of the 54 new artists who crossed over, there were

- 54 top 20 chart peaks;
- 30 top 10 chart peaks;

- 15 top five chart peaks;
- Seven No. 1 chart peaks.

If you added the figures from the chart peaks in the original formats with the peaks in the formats they crossed over to, the '96 new-artist roster (plus the handful of '95 graduates who crossed anew in '96) accounted for

- 117 top 20 records;
- 63 top 10 records;
- 35 top five records;
- 15 No. 1 records.

And that would seem to be a very impressive showing indeed.

Here's an honor roll of the new artists that hit No. 1 in 1996 (or early '97).

In their original formats: **Tracy Bonham** (Island) in modern, **Jewel** (Atlantic) in triple-A, **Primitive Radio Gods** (Columbia) in modern, **the Why Store** (MCA) in triple-A, **Donna Lewis** (Atlantic) in adult top 40, **eels** (Dreamworks/Geffen) in modern, **Duncan Sheik** (Atlantic) in triple-A, and **Sublime** (MCA) in modern. (That's four moderns, three triple-As, and one adult top 40, if you're counting formats.) Also, it should be noted that **the Wallflowers** (Interscope) peaked at No. 2 in triple-A, and their second track went to No. 1 there.

As crossovers: **dog's eye view** (Columbia) in triple-A, **Dishwalla** (A&M) in modern, **the Fugees** (Columbia) in top 40/rhythm and top 40/mainstream, **Primitive Radio Gods** (Columbia) in triple-A, **Donna Lewis** (Atlantic) in top 40/mainstream, and **the Cardigans** (Mercury) in top 40/mainstream.

New artists that did significantly better as crossovers than in the format they originally broke in include **Amber** (No. 14 in top 40/rhythm, No. 7 in top 40/mainstream), **Merrill Bainbridge** (No. 8 in adult top 40, No. 2 in top 40/mainstream), **Fiona Apple** (Work) (No. 36 in adult top 40, No. 12 in triple-A), **Son Volt** (WB) (No. 25 at modern, No. 10 in mainstream rock), and most dramatically, **dog's eye view** (Columbia) (No. 18 in mainstream rock, No. 1 in triple-A).

A note of correction: the crossover success of **Joe** to top 40/rhythm was credited to Mercury, but should have been credited to Island.

when programs were produced in segments that began and ended at specific times during the hour."

The old rule about playing a power at the top and bottom of the hour is a prime example, Clark says. "We were taught that new people are coming to the station at :00 and :30. That's not how people use most music stations in the '90s. They tune in and out of your station repeatedly during the day, seldom ever giving thought to what time it is. The new thinking is to play your powers in a position during the hour where you closely associate your strongest music to your strongest positioner. Marry the two so the audience hears your station imager and associates your power songs with that imager. That may still fall at the top of the hour but for a different reason than in 1972."

RULES ARE MADE TO BREAK

"I give my jocks the rules as they are: No two of anything back to back, don't stop the flow of music, use your intros effectively, don't swap music, etc.," says KYLD (Wild 107) San Francisco PD Michael Martin. "Then I tell them to look at those rules, understand the reason for them, then throw them away. This is entertainment, and entertainers break 'the rules' to get the message across in their own way. Hopefully, you're hiring jocks for personality, not their ability to read liners and follow a clock."

WKRQ (Q102) PD Jimmy Steal agrees. "It all depends on the abilities of the jock and how he sells something," he says. "I've heard alleged personalities that couldn't convince me to stay tuned for the world premiere of the new Madonna record."

WPRO-FM Providence, R.I., PD Chris Shebel doesn't impose a bunch of rules, other than "say the calls and the names of the songs," he says. "The only rule he has posted says, 'Radio is fun.'"

"Rules are meant to be creatively broken," Shebel says. "People do things differently. I feel that rules are good primarily for beginners because it teaches them discipline."

Then there was KALC (Alice 106) Denver, which helped popularize much of today's anti-radio thinking when it signed on in the early '90s. Former MD Jim Lawson, now APD of AC sister KIMN, says, "When I first arrived at Alice, [then-owner] Frank Wood taught us to unlearn every rule we had learned about radio. Alice was designed to be a non-radio-programmed station. Anything traditional, we don't do it. Any and all radio-based ideas were quickly shot down."

The move to nontraditional formats came at a time when many of the '80s jocks who had, in some cases, only been allowed to do four breaks an hour finally became the PDs. Most of the PDs interviewed for this story have some horror story about the minutiae they learned growing up in the biz.

"A PD I worked for always insisted that if we were playing a record that was more than 10 years old, we shouldn't say the year it came out, because that would make the listeners feel old," says WPLJ New York VP of programming Tom Cuddy. Also, in a quest for those elusive quarter hours, jocks breaking anywhere near :15 or :45 were told never to give the exact time. "If you're within a few minutes either way, we were taught to say 'it's 20 past or 10 before the hour.'"

"I was taught to never say the temperature if that number corresponds to your competitor's dial position," WAPE Jacksonville, Fla., PD Cat Thomas says. And if the temperature was close enough to your own dial position, go ahead and make it so."

"I was always drilled about the way I delivered the weather," WNCI Columbus, Ohio, PD John Dimick recalls. "I would get yelled at if I ever said, 'Right now, the current temperature outside is 67 degrees under partly cloudy skies.' The PD would say, 'Of course it's the current temp, it's not from three hours ago; the listeners know it's the outside temperature, and there's only one sky, not skies.'"

Anybody who's endured that sort of critique session probably had a flashback during the scene in "Private Parts" in which Stern is lectured about

how to deliver "W-NNN-B-C" New York's calls. Then again, WAPE's Thomas notes that Stern's PD "did that because they were in the middle of a heated battle with W-AAA-B-C."

FORM FOLLOWS FUNCTION

Indeed, many of the PDs interviewed for this story still felt that some of the basic rules were there for a reason. "Whenever a station I've worked begins to slip for whatever reason, the first question I ask myself is, what basic rules have we violated?" says WNCI Columbus, Ohio, PD John Dimick.

"I have a great deal of respect for the way

WNCI sticks to the basics," says KRQQ Tucson, Ariz., PD Tim Richards. "They're a classic example of how to win in Arbitron by saying their calls as many times as tastefully possible. [After all], repetition is recall."

"As long as Arbitron judges success by how many times someone writes down your call letters, I believe in keeping everything simple," WITZ (Z100) New York PD Tom Poleman adds. "During the last few months, while we reintroduce the station, we've benefited by using early rules to sell the reasons why Z100 satisfies those basic listener needs."

One rule that doesn't make the cut is the one about never playing two female artists back to back. "That one is null and void when eight of our top 10 records are by female artists," says Poleman.

Otherwise, many of the guidelines today's PDs supply to their jocks aren't that different from the rules of yesterday. WZEE (Z104) Madison, Wis., PD John "Woody" Harrison tells his PDs to be as succinct as possible and that "structure brings order—Plan your talk-set out . . . Know how you're going to get into your set, what you're going to say, and how you're going to get out of it. I also have a very structured format clock so the jocks have little else to think about except their content," he says.

"Don't billboard an upcoming artist that the average person isn't yet familiar with," adds WAPE's Thomas, using this handy rule of thumb: "At that moment, would you use that artist on a station billboard or in your TV spot?"

"Don't ever slam a song. Every song you play is somebody's favorite," Thomas says. "When you slam a song, to the listeners, you're only slamming yourself," notes Harrison.

"Don't [say], 'Here's Celine Dion for Jacksonville,'" adds Thomas. Instead, personalize the request: "Here's Celine for Judy at Hair Affair."

USE THE LISTENER'S OWN WORDS

One place where today's PDs do tend to differ from their predecessors is on liner cards, which most now expect to be paraphrased, not read verbatim. As Thomas tells his jocks, "You may read this liner card verbatim only if you have failed to prepare adequately."

"I tell my jocks to pick a topic and tell it to 'Lisa,' who's standing across the counter from them," says KYLD's Martin. "Don't make a speech; just tell 'Lisa' that this concert is gonna be the bomb, and you're gonna be home crying if you don't get your ass on the phone and win some damn tickets."

"Speak the language, live the demo, or at least surround yourself with people in that demo and let 'em feed you," he adds. "Remember, those interns are smarter and more valuable than you think."

"Bend the rules, break the rules, make them work for you. As long as your listener hears great music, cool promotions, and an element of fun on the air, and they know what station they're listening to, what's the damn problem?"

MONITOR PROFILE

Ed Lover & Dr. Dre: They're Back And They're Nationwide Again, Via Syndication

Ed Lover and Doctor Dre are going national again. The pair, best-known for their seven-year stint as hosts of the groundbreaking "Yo! MTV Raps" show and for three years as the top-rated morning hosts of WQHT (Hot 97) New York, will be rolling out their morning-show antics across the country this month, thanks to a new syndication deal with SJS Entertainment.

"What we're trying to do is use radio to our advantage," says Dre. "We're still associated with MTV no matter what—we go back every year and do 'Spring Break'—but we don't have that everyday exposure that MTV allowed us. Radio only allows us to be on in the New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut area . . . so most of the country knows us as, 'Weren't you the guys on MTV?' So we're trying to use radio to the best of our ability to bring us back to that national level of exposure that we had."

According to the New York-bred duo, plans to take their show into syndication were unfolding since they first took to the mikes at Hot 97 in November 1994. At the time, both were new to commercial radio, but not new to the audience. In addition to hosting "Yo!" from '89 to

the studio straight from whatever club he'd been frequenting.

Hot 97's Smith says, "I saw the incredible in-grown comedic ability of Dre and Ed Lover—they're a perfect duo—so we started to work every day on developing a morning show. Ed and Dre are very talented. It was very exciting for me. They didn't come with preconceived ideas of what works in other markets." Currently, the morning show features co-host Lisa G., Kirt Flirt, and executive producer Al Berry. Smith also cites the work of Wayne Mayo, the show's first producer, now working next door at WRKS, who helped develop a lot of the show's hallmarks. The program is "one of things I've been involved with in my career that I'm most proud of," Smith notes.

"I love the guys—they've done great work for me," he adds. "I don't think they should be narrowcast. I think the music is very hit-oriented, the show is very funny. I think any kind of rhythmic and urban-leaning market should consider it. I don't think there any morning show targeting 18-34 in syndication that has the sizzle this one has."

Similarly, while they may be a fixture at Hot 97, billed as the station "where hip-hop lives," both Dre and Ed bristle at any notion that the show is strictly hip-hop in flavor, especially as they prepare to launch it across the country.

"We're a universal morning show," says Dre. "We walked into MTV and reinvented MTV, we came over to Hot 97 and reinvented radio, and that's what's going to happen here. So let's not limit ourselves to being called a hip-hop morning show or a hip this or hip that, no disrespect to the different genres, but we're trying to take ourselves to a different level . . . Hip-hop isn't just one pigeonholed thing, it's a mixture of cultures, sounds, attitudes, and that's what makes the show so universal."

"Yesterday morning we had Dan Aykroyd, Jean Claude Van Damme, and the comedian Margaret Cho on the show," adds Ed. "We had Tito Puente, Tommy Davidson, George Benson, Roy Ayers, and Whoopi Goldberg on last week. Dre and I are not hip-hop kids. We're both intelligent black men who went to school, and we got something to say, and we know all music types. I can talk to Roy Ayers about music he didn't even know I knew about just as well as I can talk to the Wu-Tang Clan."

As for the issue of a national show's ability to meet the needs of individual communities across the country, Ed and Dre feel they have another advantage—they came from the screen. "Ed and I get around the country. We've been to so many different cities . . . We know the people pretty well because we have been out there, and they communicate with us very well. And with communications being what it is and today's technology, it should be a breeze," says Dre, adding that the show will have an 800 number, one that was used on the two-hour Notorious B.I.G. special the pair recently did that was picked up in 60 markets. "This is not two guys coming into the market trying to start a morning show to get picked up. This is two guys who have been on TV for years who also happen to do radio now coming into your marketplace."

In addition to syndicating their radio show, the duo is keeping busy with other projects, individually and in tandem. Talks are under way for an early-evening talk show; Dre continues to produce artists; Ed makes appearances on Comedy Central's "Daily Show" and Bertice Berry's "USA Live"; and the two continue to co-host the monthly "Hot 97 Phat Comedy Series" at New York's Caroline's Comedy Club. The pair expect to do a national standup tour after syndication plans are completed. **JANINE COVENEY**

'95, the pair had starred in the 1993 comedy film "Who's The Man?" And Dre, who was a popular hip-hop producer who had been the DJ for the Beastie Boys' Licensed to Ill tour in 1987, had been one of the architects for "The Operating Room," the first hip-hop radio show at Adelphi University's WBAU Long Island, N.Y., in 1983.

Though operating in some of the same circles in the late '80s, the two didn't meet until they auditioned for MTV. Lover, who was raised in the same Hollis, Queens, neighborhood as Run-D.M.C., was more musically oriented, rapping in parks and eventually becoming part of the Funktion Freaks, which evolved into the group No Face. He discovered Live Squad, which was eventually signed to Tommy Boy. Dre had been part of a hip-hop crew called Original Concept since 1977, and after Adelphi, where he collaborated with Chuck D, Flava Flav, Hank Shocklee, and Bill Stephney, he began writing songs for Run-D.M.C. and producing Original Concept.

After their co-hosting duties at MTV, Lover and Dre were approached by then-Hot 97 MD Paco Lopez and PD Steve Smith, who thought that their screen personas—enhanced by their appearance in "Who's The Man?"—would translate well to the broadcast booth. Radio was a frontier they hadn't conquered, and Lover was initially reluctant about the change in lifestyle: "[Manager Charles Stettler] said it was a good opportunity to do radio because you need something to do in the interim, and Dre said, 'Yeah, I'm down.' I said, 'Fuck no, because I ain't getting up at 4 o'clock in the morning to do no damn radio!'" Laughing, he admits that for the first three months he frequently showed up in




