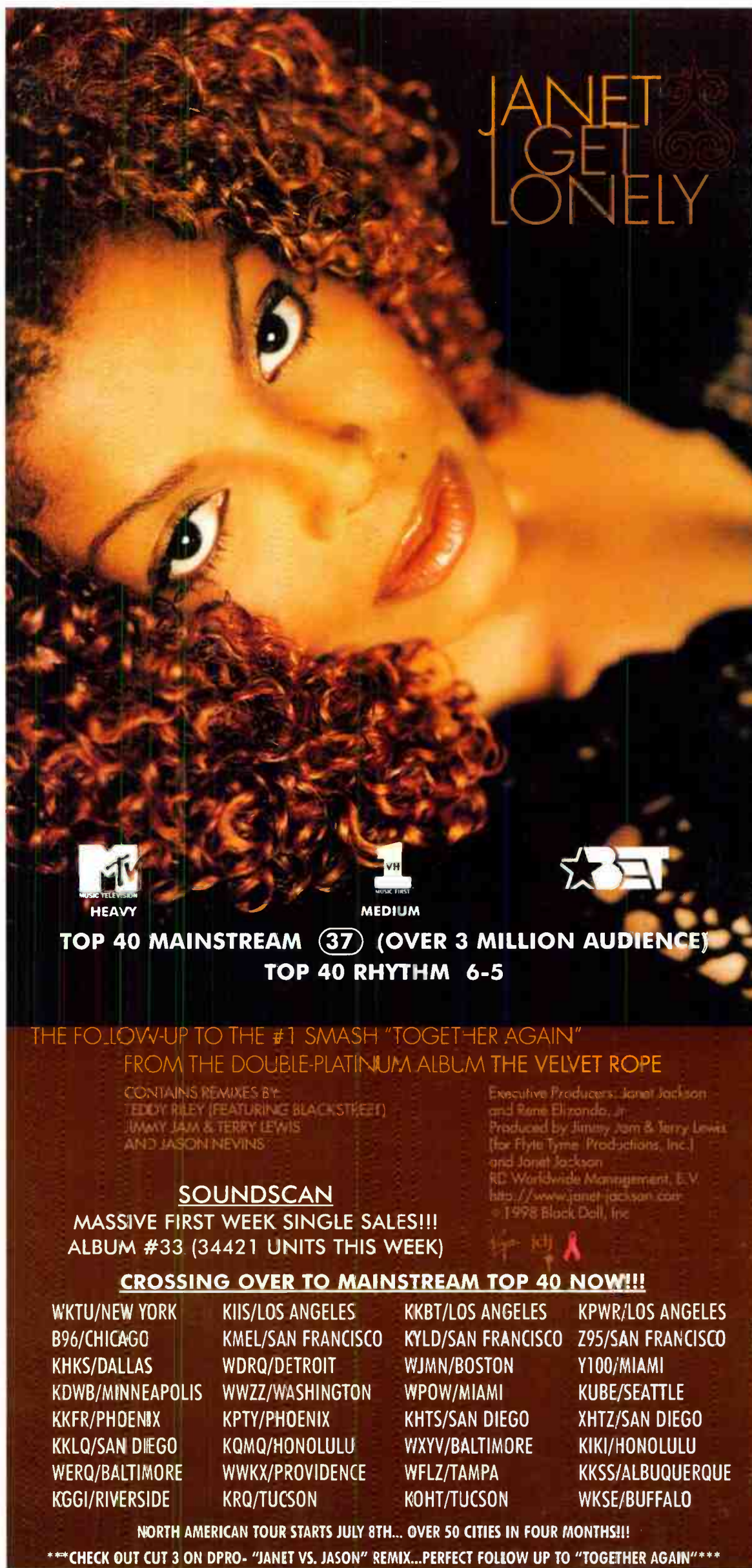

Radio Awards Ballots Are Here!

Included with this issue is the preliminary ballot for the annual Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards. Please take a few minutes to fill it out and return it before June 10. Final ballots listing the nominees will appear in the July 24 issue of Airplay Monitor and in all subscription copies of the Aug. 1 issue of Billboard.

Winners will be announced Sept. 19 at the culmination of the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar, scheduled for Sept. 17-19 at the Pointe Hilton Resort at Tapatío Cliffs in Phoenix.

Several changes have been made to this year's balloting process. Record-label awards make their return for the first time since 1991 with the addition of a label promotion team of the year

award in each of five format categories (country, R&B, rock, rhythmic top 40/mainstream top 40, and AC/adult top 40/modern adult).

Also, several format categories have been expanded. The top 40 category is now split into rhythmic top 40 and mainstream top 40. There are also separate awards for AC and adult top 40/modern adult.

Also, market-size categories have been changed this year from major, medium, and small, to major (markets Nos. 1-25) and secondary (markets No. 26-plus). The eligibility period for nominees is May 1997 to the present.

Jacor Holds 'Virtual Contest' At 9 FMs

First there was virtual radio. Now, the "virtual contest." Jacor's Midwestern hot ACs got a lot of attention recently following the announcement that those stations had run a \$5,000 song-of-the-day contest in tandem, meaning that listeners in nine markets were competing for the daily cash prize. Each of the participating stations—WVX Cleveland; WVMX Cincinnati; WMLX Lexington, Ky.; WMMX Dayton, Ohio; WVOR Rochester, N.Y.; KLYF Des Moines, Iowa; WMLX Lima, Ohio; WMT-FM Cedar Rapids, Iowa; and WMTX Sandusky, Ohio—took place in a daily conference call where each of the stations back-timed their programming so that they would play the song at the exact same time. Listeners called a centralized phone number to win. Posted and on-air rules for the contest made it clear that the promotion was taking place in a number of markets. In other Jacor news, consultant Jay Meyers, who was serving as interim GM of Jacor's Dayton, Ohio, stations, including WMMX and crossover WBTT, joins the group as senior VP.

AC Loves Dion More . . . Than Two Years

ARE YOU AWARE that Celine Dion's "To Love You More," which bows on the adult contemporary chart at No. 26 this issue, has been getting played as a Japanese import for more than two years? The song first appeared on the BDS AC Impact page in Airplay Monitor's Aug. 1, 1997, issue with airplay at five stations, including heavy rotation at WMJQ Buffalo, N.Y.

BACKWARDS BULLETS EXPLAINED: The unusually high number of backwards bullets on the adult top 40 chart—there are backwards bullets at Nos. 5, 7, 26, and 29—can be attributed to the addition of KQMB Salt Lake City, WXXM (Max 95.7) Philadelphia, and KYIS Oklahoma City to that panel (they're also added to the modern adult chart this week). If you have a keen eye, you'll also notice that in this issue the "last week" detection numbers do not correspond with last week's information. When panel changes are made, the previous week's chart is rerun with the new stations so that the chart reflects a consistent panel week-to-week.

Here's where to reach our new reporters: WXXM: PD Chuck Tisa, MD Ali Castellini; 215-482-6000; KYIS: PD/MD Ray Kalusa; 405-848-0100; and KQMB: OM Alan Hague, PD Mark Waldi, MD BJ; 801-524-2600.

Record Leaks Are A Hot Topic Again

There hasn't been much discussion of record leaks lately, possibly because they've been a fact of life at radio for so long. Like a lot of once-hot industry topics, most folks can't really work up the energy to be upset about them anymore.

So there were two surprises at R&B tip-sheet Impact's recent convention, held April 30-May 2 in Reno, Nev. One was that the leak issue was probably the most contentious one at a seminar that also featured candid discussions of pay-for-play, independent exclusivity deals (which are again becoming an issue in R&B radio), and other hot topics. This following some unauthorized pre-release airplay of the new Brandy/Monica duet, "The Boy Is Mine."

R&B PDs were on both the winning and losing ends of the leak battle on that song. WILD Boston PD Rick Anderson, noting that crossover rival WJMN (Jam'n 94.5) had popped the song early, complained that pop reps weren't subject to the same repercussions as an R&B rep if a song leaked. Meanwhile, Radio One VP of programming Steve Hegwood told a panel audience that he'd gone early on the song precisely because of all the times he'd had to hear records early on rival WPGC-FM.

Hegwood ended up in a heated exchange with Def Jam's Kevin Lyles over the new LL Cool J single that ended with Lyles throwing a T-shirt at the programmer (and Springer-esque chants of "Jerry, Jerry" from the crowd), but the continuing animosity that leaks still generate was only one surprise. The other was that after Lyles claimed that many leaks came not from promotion departments but from press departments, by way of their press contacts who received advance copies of a project, another label

rep actually admitted that promotion people were, indeed, often the source of leaks. While that was hardly news to anybody in attendance, it's the first time I've heard a record person admit it in a room full of people.

While leaks go both ways—I was floored a few years ago when a prominent top 40 PD demanded that his R&B rival be moved to top 40 so it would stop getting all those leaks from R&B reps—there's still a perception by R&B folks that leaks happen more often at top 40. And that it's just one more of the unequal tools that R&B reps are forced to work with. (Pop reps will undoubtedly have their own take on this; I'd be especially interested in hearing from anybody who has worked both formats.)

Meanwhile, when one radio person asked the question that inevitably comes up in any discussion on leaks—"who are leaks really hurting?"—a record person shot back with the traditional answer: Leaks happen before a label can get product in the stores. That might have been a valid concern a decade ago, when every song that was worked to radio was released immediately as a single. Today, Sparkle's "Be Careful" is one of the fastest-breaking records in recent memory. Since there's no commercial single planned, that song will be on radio for at least a month before consumers have access to it. The current hits from Vonda Shepard, Natalie Merchant, and Semisonic also had periods when neither a single nor an album was available. And when we're done mulling over those, we can discuss the hit remixes you can't buy. These aren't necessarily bad decisions. They just redefine the age-old dialogue about leaks, unlikely though anybody is to actually end it.

Chuck Tisa Helps New Modern Adult Max 95.7 'Build As It Goes' In Philly

Given the paucity of brand-new frequencies in major markets, it's rare that a new station has to sign on with no pre-existing cume whatsoever. But that's what happened to PD Chuck Tisa, GM Dennis Begley, and consultant Alex DeMers nearly eight months ago, when Greater Media flipped classical WFLN Philadelphia to modern adult WXXM (Max 95.7). The nature of that change guaranteed that most of the awareness of the new station would be among disgruntled classical fans, almost none of whom could be expected to stick around, rather than the 18-49 females in the station's target audience.

Gradually, however, an audience is finding the new station. In the just-released winter Arbitrons, WXXM was up 1.6-2.2 12-plus. It was also up 3.6-4.2 18-34 and 2.3-3.1 18-49. Among 12-plus and 18-34 listeners, it's in a dead heat with Tisa's former employer, WPLY (Y100), a station that Tisa says was not his main target but that nevertheless was first to stake out what would now be recognized as the adult modern turf in the mid-'90s. Max 95.7 becomes a reporter to Airplay Monitor's adult top 40 and modern adult charts this week.

Tisa, who was PD of Y100 until January '97 and is a veteran of now-defunct Philly top 40 WEGX (Eagle 106), got a call in July from DeMers and Greater Media CEO Tom Milewski, who initially tapped him as an in-house consultant. (He became PD officially in January.) By that time, the outline of the station was already in place. WXXM would have a personalized positioner along the lines of much-loved modern adult heroine "Alice," but "Max" was chosen because it was potentially unisex and because of its usage in a number of current product-marketing campaigns. Besides, Tisa asks, "Do you know anybody named Alice?"

Like the Alice stations, WXXM cultivates an "anti-radio" feel. Its only positioner, shown on TV during the fall (and again in the spring) and on billboards, is "Max knows music." When listeners describe the station to Tisa, he says, they usually mention the station's variety. "If people had to classify us as something, they'd probably think of us as a softer modern rock station, because there's just so much of the matchbox 20, Sarah McLachlan, Natalie Merchant, and Tori Amos [type of music] on the station, all of which are modern rock acts but on the softer side."

Notably, Tisa tends to see Max more as an adult-leaning modern (along the lines of former Y100 PD Garrett Michaels' WHYT Detroit) than as a hot AC, meaning that the station avoids Savage Garden, Madonna, Celine Dion, and the other non-modern-image artists now heard on some other modern adult outlets. It also means that WXXM tends to rock harder than some of its compatriots. Everclear's "Everything To Everyone," which only a few modern ACs embraced, remains a top 10 call-out record.

WXXM signed on with a lot of late-'70s/early-

'80s gold at a time when many first-generation modern ACs had already phased it out. There are still about two or three '80s cuts an hour on the station, although some of the more novelty-oriented titles (i.e., "Relax") are gone. Because WXXM needed to build cume, it signed on playing its powers 70 times a week. That's now down to 64-65 spins, but only because weekend public-affairs programming has been added.

Here's a midday monitor of WXXM: Everclear, "Everything To Everyone"; Barenaked Ladies, "Brian Wilson"; Rebekah, "Sin So Well"; Toad The Wet Sprocket, "Walk On The Ocean"; Naked, "Raining On The Sky"; matchbox 20, "Real World"; Peter Gabriel, "Solsbury Hill"; Alanis Morissette, "Uninvited"; Better Than Ezra, "Good"; Sarah McLachlan, "Adia"; and Mighty Mighty Bosstones, "The Impression That I Get."

During Tisa's time at Y100, that station evolved from hot AC to modern-leaning top 40 along the lines of WHITZ (Z100) New York to what might now be considered adult modern. With the departure of crosstown modern WDRE (and the hiring of former WDRE PD Jim McGuinn), Y100 became a more traditional modern outlet but has, like many moderns nationwide, moved back toward the modern adult camp in recent months, according to Tisa, and upped its spin count on some titles. Tisa says he's careful to "try not to focus on [the Max/Y100 situation] as a war. We're supposed to be two different stations. We just focus on what we do, and if they want to chase us, that's fine, because they're blowing off their core. We're just building as we go, so there was no preconceived notion of what we were." That didn't stop WXXM from going on the air with Y100's spring concert lineup before Y100 could announce it, however, something that Tisa says prompted an angry call from Y100's GM.

Because of how the station signed on, Tisa says, Max's listeners "have been coming from everybody, because nobody knew this station existed." That includes active rock WYSP, which competes more closely with Greater Media's mainstream WMMR and classic rock WMGK, but Tisa says that whittling away at WYSP on WMMR's behalf was never one of his goals. And while modern adult outlets have often posted the greatest 12-plus numbers when they were able to cover a mainstream top 40 hole in their markets, Tisa says that he's leaving that job to rival WIOQ (Q102), which recently segued from rhythmic top 40 back toward the center.

Promotionally, Max has stayed away from cash giveaways, which Tisa regards as "kinda radio-ish," in favor of concert flyaway weekends called "On Tour With . . ." in which a listener gets to see Dave Matthews Band and matchbox 20 and Lilith Fair, each at a separate location. The station has also given away a trip to Ireland for the last St. Patrick's Day of the century (for which the winner gets a year to prepare) and is now on the street with four vehicles.

Max's morning show pairs KLYY (Y107) Los Angeles' Chuck Dowd and WARQ Columbia, S.C.'s Jenny Lane, who hadn't previously worked together. Their program, Tisa says, is primarily music-intensive but still works as a morning show on the strength of the personalities involved.

During Tisa's time out of radio, "I caught up on a lot of movies. It was a good chance for me to clear my head." While six months out of the business and another seven months without reporting status tends to prove who your friends are, he says, "A lot of the local people kept in contact. But a few here and there didn't. And funny, I should pop up in the same market."

'Tonight At 9, Only On Fox—It's America's Scariest Station Vans'

me out? Every time I open the glove compartment of our van, there sits a single feminine-hygiene product. The female staffers insist on keeping one in there for emergency use, kind of like a spare tire or safety flare. I keep forgetting it's in there, so it's like a surprise every time I open the damn glove box. Apparently, there's also an unwritten rule that states that the lucky person who actually uses it has to replace it."

Scott Sands, VP of programming for Tralyn Broadcasting, including modern adult WLNF (Live 95) Biloxi, Miss.: "Our night guy, Bubba Boudreaux, keeps leaving his 'Weekly World News Reporter' baseball cap in one of our vans, along with some rave magazine and several dozen empty soda cans. I'm actually driving a station van right now and always keep at least one change of clothes with me [just in case]."

KRBE Houston marketing director Mark Shecterle went out to his vehicles with a clipboard and took inventory: "I found some Huggies diaper wipes; Suave lotion; one roll of paper towels; packing lists; one straw, chewed from both ends; one empty Starbucks Frappuccino bottle, Mocha; one empty Yoo Hoo bottle; one full bottle of Green Tabasco Sauce; one roll of film; the cap to a bottle of cough medicine; assorted nails, thumb-tacks, KRBE CDs, and rubber bands; hunks of Velcro; pens; pencils; bumper stickers; key chains; assorted prizes; gum wrappers; Biore and Hugo Boss samples; and some loose change."

INCREDIBLE INEDIBLES

WKCI (KCI101) New Haven, Conn., PD Kelly Nash started his career at the station in 1989 as the van driver. "I remember finding a pair of wadded-up woman's panties inside the van (robin's-egg blue, as he recalls fondly). "Wrapped inside the panties was a half-eaten cheeseburger," he says. "I'm not sure of the cosmic significance of that, but, judging from the size of those panties, any girl that big shouldn't have had any trouble finishing that cheeseburger."

KBXX (the Box) Houston late-nighter Big Baby Mean Green is nicknamed "the Barbecue-Eating Machine," says promotion director Bobby Z. "I can always count on finding beef or pork bones, picked clean, all over the van floor after one of his binges." Do they become embedded in the lush, cut-pile carpeting? "Hey, we had carpeting at one time, but it all wore off," says Z., who mentions that some Box jocks who happen to roll back to the station very late from a nightclub remote, and, knowing they have to be back at the station in four hours for another gig, often decide to take a little nap in the back of one of the station's twin 1995 vans. "It never fails," says Z. "I'll show up early to get the van ready for a Saturday-morning remote or a Sunday parade, and I'll slide that door open and scare the crap out of both of us. That's not good for anybody."

"One time I found a bunch of loose tobacco in the van ashtray," he adds, theorizing that some party had needed rolling papers for some reason and had emptied the tobacco out of a cigarette and borrowed the paper. "In no way do we condone that type of behavior," he's quick to add.

The most recent van incident involved mystery socks that appeared one sunny day. "These smelly black Nike socks had been in there for about two weeks . . . before I finally threw them out. I had to use a piece of cardboard to pick them up," says a dry-heaving Mr. Z.

THEM CLUB NIGHTS'LL KILL YOU

"I've had to literally hose out the inside of a newly painted van more than once," recalls KISV Bakersfield, Calif., PD Mark Feather, who quickly adds that the incidents happened several years ago at a previous station. The hosing in question, and the spectacular waterfall that followed, was the result of several staffers converting the interior of the van into a personal vomitorium while on the ride home from a nightclub appearance. (Damn bar tab.) "That stuff is going to happen from time to time," says Feather. "As long as the driver hasn't been partying, I'd rather have someone get sick in the van than in front of a bunch of people at a club." Feather's current van contains banners, duct tape, assorted leftover prizes,

bumper stickers, and loose french fries, which are a recurring theme in van lore. "Right now, our van is also full of stale french fries, half-eaten burgers, and other basic trash, including a bunch of CD singles that nobody seems to want," offers KGGI Riverside, Calif., PD Diana Laird.

John Candelaria, PD of KPRR El Paso, Texas, also constantly finds unclaimed fries in the van glove box. "About a year ago, the morning after a nightclub appearance in Mexico, we found a couple of used condoms in the van, which nobody admitted to," he says. "Last week, we found a couple of half-eaten Whataburgers under the seat on the passenger-side seat."

There were both condoms and three White Castle sliders "dating back to Milli Vanilli" in WKDD Akron, Ohio, PD Chuck Collins' station van, which also contained "an old WKDD 'I'll dog' mascot costume with a serious stain in the nether regions, a copy of morning man Matt Patrick's contract, a copy of WKDD's sexual-harassment policy with lewd comments scribbled in the margins, and last year's marketing director—confused, but alive."

KYSR Los Angeles marketing director Robert Lyles found a "lepre-conda, left over from our St. Patrick's promotion. Thank God, it wasn't used." That's probably because he also found the book "I Got Pregnant, You Can Too" in the van.

Gary Robinson, PD of KRUF Shreveport, La.: "In addition to the usual two or three cell phones, we have about seven miles of cable, and a bunch of extension cords. After a recent bar remote, I came upon three toilet plungers and about 20 rolls of toilet paper. My only question was, 'Just exactly what kind of games were they playing?'"

LOVE THAT DAMN DUOPOLY

Ginny Schoggins is promotion director of the Clear Channel Austin, Texas, four-station cluster, including top 40 KHFI. In the age of duopoly, she's discovering firsthand the challenges of keeping her call letters straight. "We now have multiple stations sharing vehicles, so it's more important than ever that we match the proper promotional supplies with the proper station in the proper vehicle. I remember going to a KHFI remote and showing up with a bunch of stadium cups and bumper stickers with the call letters of our oldies station on them," she recalls.

The most challenging van problem, according to Schoggins, is the intermingling of functional and nonfunctional equipment. "If a piece of van equipment needs to be replaced, whether it's a microphone cable, extension cord, or a Walkman battery, I can get the parts with no problem," she says. "However, it seems that no one ever remembers to actually throw out the old part, so that when it comes time to use it, we never know which one is working and which is garbage."

USED-CLOTHING ANNEX

Mike Marino, PD of KKPN Houston: "We found the usual assortment of trash, including Twinkie wrappers, cans of hair-care products, bumper stickers from the competition, cell phones, helium balloons, Valium, Planet T-shirts, as well as competitors' T-shirts (which we collect to wipe off the dipstick, wheels, windows, etc.)."

Jimmy Steal, PD of KDMX (Mix 102.9) Dallas, recently discovered a treasure trove of previously worn T-shirts in the back of his van. "Turns out, they're our competitors' T-shirts given to us by listeners who were eager to trade them in for our new Mix 102.9 T's," he says.

Tony Manero, PD of KKSS Albuquerque, N.M.: "In the last few days, I discovered one double-D white bra, a 'Jurassic Park' hand puppet that makes sound effects, numerous dead 9-volt batteries, and one uneaten ham-and-cheese sandwich, which, by the look of the green fungus, had been in the van since 1995. 'I have not and will not attempt to look in the cabinet under our passenger seat in the back of the van,'" Manero steadfastly insists. "Thank God for interns!"

Last, but virtually least, is John Michaels, program manager of Webcaster NetRadio in Minneapolis. "Sorry I can't help you with your story," he says. "As an Internet network, we only have virtual cyber-vans, and we keep them very clean."

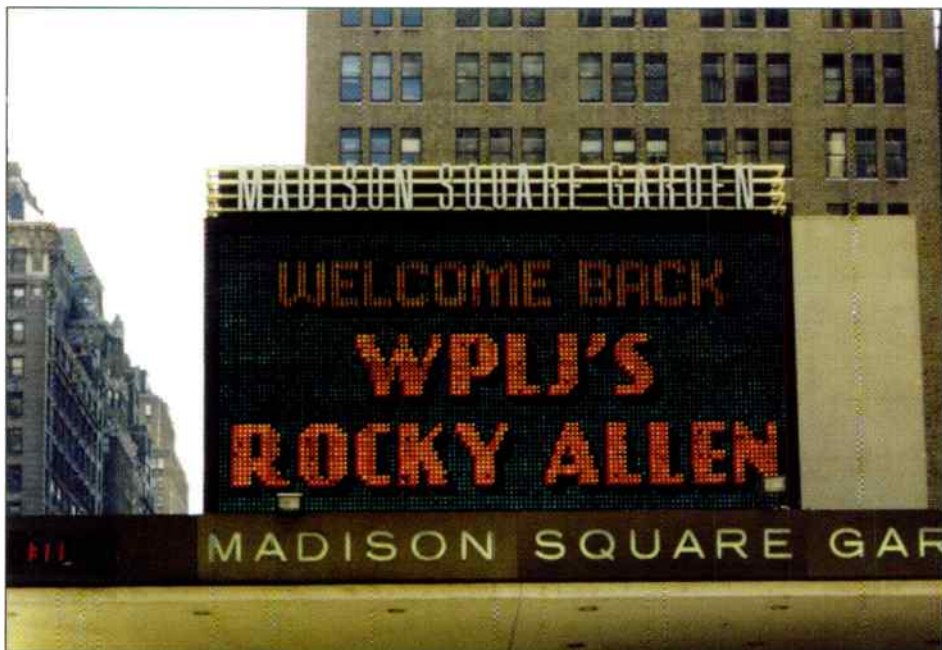
