Album Views

Some things mellow, some things rocky and some things new and fresh spotlight the current pile of recordings.

Roberta Flack and Stephen Bishop find the mellow, MOR groove. Roberta's LP is tastier because she chooses songs of high quality and presents them in a singularly Flack way. Bishop's effort is really a two or three track album, but as he has shown, Stephen Bishop can write a winner of a song when pushed.

On the rocky side is the Canadian fascination called Heart and the Southern rowdy-rock of Lynyrd Skynyrd.

Heart sounds like Jefferson Airplane much of the time, and they get a good song or two in there, too. It is their vitality which moves listeners more than anything. Meanwhile, the terrific Southern rhythm feel of Lynyrd Skynyrd is the driving force which holds their audience. Tragically, this is their last album.

Then we find the off-beat but most interesting albums.

Dave Edmunds is a seasoned English rocker who brings his considerable rootedness to bear in his music. Lots of solid rock 'n' roll. Peter C. Johnson, an unknown, finds a way to grab attention with a batch of top-notch songs which are set in very original arrangements. Tony Bird finishes the list with some good writing and a strange singing style which requires some getting used to. His South African background bleeds through both his melodies and his lyrics.

It is these oddballs, these truly original talents who are most appealing whether they are commercially viable or not.

P.D. Notebook

(by Eric Norberg, KEX-Portland)

The most important event in the history of FM radio was its invention, by Major Edwin Armstrong, in the 1930's! The next important event would be the decision by the FCC to move the FM band from 42-50 mHz to its present location at 88-108 mHz in 1945. Though this paved the way for today's FM service, it nearly killed it at the start, by obsoleting every receiver built up to that point. I would argue that the third most important event in FM history was when James Gabbert, Gary Gielow, and Ken Warren put KPEN (now K-101, San Francisco) on the air in October of 1957. KPEN found a new way of programming an FM station: With the emphasis on high fidelity, and the assumption that FM was like any other kind of radio, only better. Up till 1957, the number of operating FM stations had declined each year; every year after that the number of stations has increased.

The fourth most important event for FM was the introduction of stereo at the beginning of the 1960's. Stereo demonstrated clearly the superiority of FM, in a way the consumer could immediately recognize. As hi-fi and stereo shifted from an eclectic hobby to a leisure activity found in nearly every home, FM shifted with it as a mass appeal medium, which paved the way for the landslide to FM by the under-30's that began when Tom Donahue invented the progressive rock format at KMPX in 1967.

The 16-25 year olds of ten years ago have grown up with FM and are still listening, though their tastes have diversified, leading to FM's great strength today in all sorts of rock formats. Meantime, the older folks have turned increasingly from AM to FM for background music - the automated FM's have lower overhead than their AM predecessors, and thus fewer commercials and an even more unobtrusive service.

All of this has led many to the gloomy view that AM is doomed to serving an increasingly older audience with non-music formats. The truth of the matter is that AM is actually capable of higher fidelity than FM is! There are two reasons for that. First, when the FM standards were established, it was thought to be a good idea to use a "pre-emphasis curve" - boosting the highs in transmission, with a matching roll-off in the receiver, to reduce hiss and interference on the signal. (The same process is used in making records.) Unfortunately, there was no high fidelity material at the time, and the boost was made three times too big for today's needs. With cymbals and synthesizers and the like, the overall level of sound has to be very low to keep from over-modulating the high frequencies - or else stations have to severely limit, clip, or roll off the highs in order to sound "loud". Most stations take the latter course, even though it sacrifices "high fidelity" to a major degree.

And second, the FM stereo process requires that a 19,000-cycle "pilot tone" be transmitted. This tone not only enables the receiver to reproduce the signal in stereo, but it's what makes the "stereo" light on receivers go on. In order that the boosted high frequency material not interfere with this tone, FM stations have to roll off the highs very sharply above 15,000 cycles. Often the rolloff starts at an even lower frequency.

The AM transmitters don't have a pre-emphasis curve. The sound is transmitted "flat". And though myths persist - even among engineers - that the AM band has a high fidelity limit, restricting audio response to 5,000, 7,500, or 10,000 cycles, it just isn't so! In fact, the only limit imposed by the FCC is that the sound above 15,000 cycles has to be a specified amount below full modulation. That at least puts AM on the same footing as FM; but actually sound levels at those high frequencies in music just naturally occurs at very low levels anyway. Very soft high frequency sounds on FM can overmodulate because of that extreme pre-emphasis curve, but on AM they stay

very soft, in their natural state, and so AM stations really don't need to worry about rolling off the high frequencies above 15,000 cycles either.

AM has been badly hurt by poor receiver design; the worst receiving circuits are usually those found in the AM sections of "high fidelity FM/AM" equipment. The coming of AM stereo will have several advantages for AM that will be of greater benefit for AM than most people now seem to foresee. For one thing, the complexity of the stereo signal will require improved receiver design, with better fidelity and lower distortion. AM, in stereo, will return to equality with stereo FM - and the image of AM as an old-fashioned medium will be dispelled. Then, too, AM stereo will work better in moving vehicles and in canyons and behind mountains - not only because AM signals bend better than FM, but because they are not subject to "multipath distortion" as FM is. (Multipath is the audio equivalent of ghosts on TV; reflections of the signal getting mixed with the signal itself and causing noise and distortion.) FM will continue to have the potential for quieter, more noise-free reception than AM (except near AM transmitters, where the signal is strongest), and FM will not have nighttime fading and interference as AM sometimes does. But FM multipath problems are often more annoying than interference on the AM band, and AM will be capable of much larger usable coverage area per watt than FM in many places in the country.

AM stereo will bring FM much more vigorous and effective competition than AM has in the recent past, which should be good for both bands. AM operators should be preparing now to enter stereo broadcasting, when the FCC picks a system and transmitting equipment becomes available. Preparation not only means building a stereo record library, and installing stereo audio and processing equipment, but it means reducing distortion and maximizing frequency response in the whole audio system, including the transmitter. Modern equipment can far surpass the very minimal standards of the FCC "proof of performance", and when people are listening on high fidelity receivers, it will have to! Most importantly, minimize phase shift in the transmitter and broadband the antenna system as much as possible! The stereo information will probably employ some form of phase modulation...and frequently AM antenna systems have been designed for "high Q" - very efficient at the carrier frequency, but with poor high frequency response. That means that the transmitter may be putting out high fidelity, but the antenna system is rolling it all off. This can often be corrected.

AM stereo works, and AM stations will begin seeing benefits from the system almost from the day it is approved - which the FCC is expected to do before the end of 1979. There are rumors of a few skeptic of AM stereo on the Commission's staff, however, and AM executives would be wise to write to the FCC expressing interest in speedy approval of an AM stereo system now.

"Toto"-Toto (Columbia) The most successful fusion of studio musicians in this decade.

"Comes A Time"-Neil Young (Warner Bros.) This album could almost compete in the same league with the classic "Harvest" LP. Nicolette Larson adds solid vocal harmony to Young's poised leads. GOIN' BACK, COMES A TIME, PEACE OF MIND, HUMAN HIGHWAY, ALREADY ONE, FOUR STRONG WINDS.

"Wet Dream"-Richard Wright (Columbia) He's the second member of Pink Floyd to release a solo album, and should meet with the same positive reception at the Album Radio level as did David Gilmour earlier this year. MEDITERRANEAN C, WAVES, HOLIDAY, DROP IN FROM THE TOP.

"Hot Streets"-Chicago (Columbia) The more things change, the more they stay the same. In Chicago's case there's nothing wrong with that. Donnie Dacus fits nicely into the lead guitarist role replacing the late Terry Kath. ALIVE AGAIN, THE GREATEST LOVE ON EARTH, GONE LONG GONE, AIN'T IT TIME.

"Tormato"-Yes (Atlantic) Their cult may have dwindled in recent years but look for renewed interest with a current tour and tons of Album Radio coming from "Tormato". FUTURE TIMES REJOICE, RELEASE RELEASE, ARRIVING UFO, CIRCUS OF HEAVEN, ON THE SILENT WINGS OF FREEDOM.

"Stealin' Home"-Ian Matthews (Mushroom) Since leaving Fairport Convention, Matthews has been searching for recognition as a solo. Eight years later, with a record company small enough to give him the special attention needed, he should indeed be 'stealin' home.' GIMME AN INCH, DON'T HANG UP YOUR DANCING SHOES, STEALIN' HOME, SHAKE IT, SLIP AWAY.

"Wavelength"-Van Morrison (Warner Bros.) Would you believe it has been eleven years since BROWN EYED GIRL and ten years since "Astral Weeks"? Radio needs a dose of Van Morrison right about now and "Wavelength" is just what the doctor ordered. KINGDOM HALL, NATALIA, WAVELENGTH, SANTA FE- BEAUTIFUL OBSESSION, HUNGRY FOR YOUR LOVE.

I'M EVERY WOMAN-Chaka Khan (Warner Bros.) The track is exciting, the production nicely balanced, and she sings her socks off.

THIS IS LOVE-Paul Anka (RCA) For good music to be good music it must have feeling and it must be well done. Paul Anka brings both of those elements to this ballad, which, incidentally, comes from one of the most overlooked albums on the market, "Listen To Your Heart".
