TIMELY PROMOTION FROM FM/KVI

FM/KVI-Seattle has a new Fall/Winter promotion that promises to "deflate inflation," or at least put a dent in it through the month of December. The contest unfolds in six different phases, each a contest in itself but all falling under the "Deflate Inflation" umbrella. HOW NOT TO APPLY FOR A JOB

Paul Kero, P.D. of KATE/KCPI-Albert Lea, Minn., shares with us a most unusual job application. The applicant describes himself as self-employed, and lists his previous occupations successively as a "naturalist" who "lived in the woods," a "professional walker," a "preacher/monk" and a "genius" who "invented."

P.D. Notebook

(by Eric Norberg, KEX-Portland)

The FCC "sponsor identification rule" requires that the sponsor of an announcement or program (including religious programs on Sunday morning) be identified in the broadcast. Seems simple! But there are a lot of pitfalls, and the FCC hands out big fines when it stumbles across a violation. Let's see if you know all the things that can get you into trouble!

For one thing, the same sponsor should be on the announcement, on the log, and on the contract. You'd be surprised how often a salesperson will write up a contract with one sponsor name, it goes on the log as something else, and a different sponsor name is on the spot. That's a violation. The sponsor is the person or organization actually buying the spot; a D/B/A is OK as long as it's shown as that on the contract.

A well-known product name is acceptable as sponsor identification (like Tide detergent or Crest toothpaste), but a new product just being introduced should usually carry the name of the maker as sponsor, in the spot. Generic names are not acceptable as sponsor identification, however, no matter how well known! "Milk", for example. "Milk" is never enough sponsor identification in a spot for milk!

The FCC demands that the sponsor name not only be present in a spot or program, but that it be clear to the audience that the sponsor name actually is the sponsor. For example, suppose you run a spot paid for by RCA records, for the new Paul Anka album, in which a long tag mentions the stores where the album can be bought. The spot will refer to the "new RCA album by Paul Anka", but the store tags will most likely leave the listener with the impression that the stores are the sponsor. (A similar problem arises when Universal Pictures buys a schedule for a movie, and tags the spot with the theaters where the movie is showing.) In that event, a line must be added specifically identifying the sponsor.

That brings up a type of spot which is fairly new to me, but which I've seen a lot of lately - and which I hear cause numerous violations of this rule on radio stations. It has been common in the past for producer groups to buy spots for their product (milk, avocados, peaches, etc.), and then provide tapes or live copy which does not contain any sponsor identification line at all. Presumably you're catching those -- aren't you? But now manufacturers seem to be buying spots to plug their product at certain stores, as part of their deal with the stores to stock the product, and increasingly they are turning these spots over to the stores! That means it sounds like a spot for the store, including mention of in-store specials on products unrelated to the sponsor's product, but though it sounds like a spot for Safeway, a manufacturer is paying for it! (For example, in Portland recently, a spot that a national sponsor was buying for a supermarket made no mention of any of the sponsor's products; the supermarket used the entire spot plugging unrelated products!)

The FCC requires that you not just identify a sponsor...but the sponsor. And it's not something the sponsor is responsible for; you are. The only party who can get in trouble for this is the station. And since the program director is usually held responsible by the general manager for seeing that the station is adhering to the FCC rules in matters like this, guess who gets fired when the fine is handed down? Your sales department may get very irritated with you for your hard-nosed vigilance in policing this and similar rules, but it is your responsibility. (If it isn't, at your station, make sure there is a written policy on file that says whose responsibility it is, or it'll be yours when the fine comes down!)

Albums of the Week Reviewed by Ron Fell

"52ND ST."-Billy Joel (Columbia) You might have expected more on the heels of the multi-platinum "The Stranger" yet four cuts, MY LIFE, UNTIL THE NIGHT, HONESTY, and ROSALINA'S EYES are the kind of material "Best of" albums are made of. Joel is, and has been for many years, one of the finest writer/performers on record.

"Thoroughfare Gap"-Stephen Stills (Columbia) Just when you think he's going to stud he surprises ya with a wire to wire winner like this. "Thoroughfare Gap" recalls earlier glory years with spirit and lust. CAN'T GET NO BOOTY, NOT FADE AWAY, WE WILL GO ON, THOROUGHFARE GAP, MIDNIGHT RIDER.

"Single Man"-Elton John (MCA) Elton and Bernie Taupin have gone their separate ways with Elton teaming up with Gary Osborne for some fine, fresh songs. I DON'T CARE and PART-TIME LOVE may be the album's highlights but for pure and simple melody nothing can top SONG FOR GUY. Also: GEORGIA, MADNESS and RETURN TO PARADISE.

"Inner Secrets"-Santana (Columbia) Greg Walker is critical to this album's success. Producers Lambert and Potter downplay the Latin instrumental signature usually associated with the band, while Walker's belting out soulful vocals over unusually conventional tracks. Yet the album has just enough Santana salsa to make contact with long time Santana fans. WELL ALL RIGHT, DEALER/SPANISH ROSE, ONE CHAIN, STORMY, LIFE IS A LADY/HOLIDAY.
