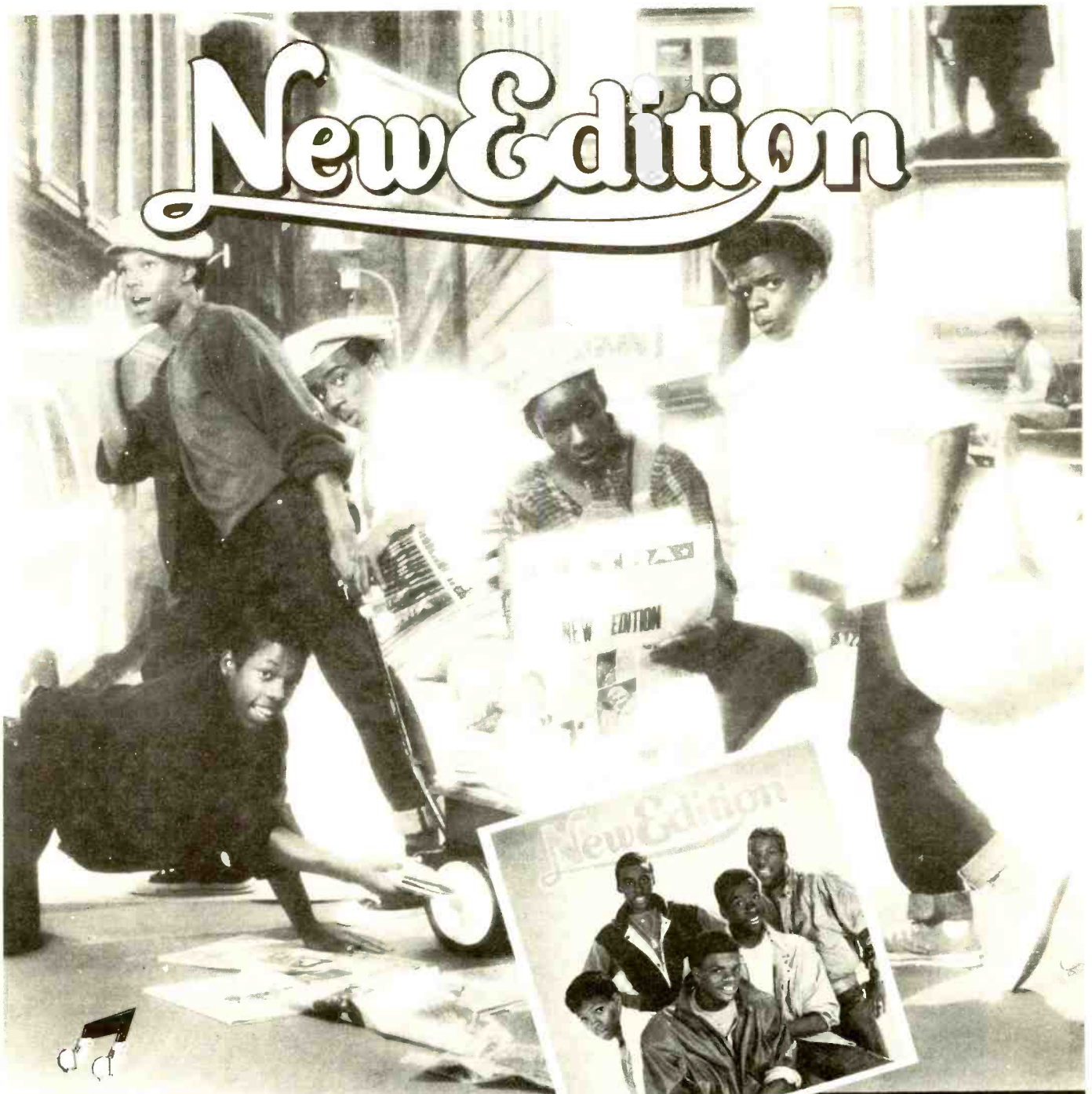

## ANALYSIS

What a week for the Windy City! The Cubs seem headed for the World Series and CHICAGO edges out STEVIE WONDER at number one. But only a very few points separate these two. CHICAGO charts top 5 with 190 reporters, while STEVIE WONDER pulls in 168 stations in the same category. JOHN CAFFERTY grows in Hit Factor from 75% to 85%, with plenty of growth indicated by the current wave of activity. Please note a correction on last week's Hit Factor for BILLY OCEAN. Rather than 6% it should have read 66%, making an excellent gain this week to 82%. A growing list of stations are also mentioning it as one of the three most requested songs. ELTON JOHN's progress inside the top twenty is documented by one of the week's key Hit Factor jumps from 43% to 67%. MICHAEL RIVERS, WMR-RUMFORD, ME takes it 21-15, TOM CUDDY, WPRO-PROVIDENCE, RI 21-16, SMOKEY RIVERS, WAVA-Washington, DC 22-18, LEE ADAMS, WHSY-HATTIESBURG, MS, 25-14, etc. DeYOUNG has made consistently big moves from the day it debuted on the Top Forty back on September 14th. WHAM! is headed straight for the top 10 real fast. This immediate favorite with most programmers now boasts 21 top ten listings and moves that are very strong...21-13 WLKI/FM-ANGOLA, IN., 27-18 Z100-NEW YORK, 30-19 WPLJ-NEW YORK, 26-16 KPUR-AMARILLO, 26-17 14K/92K-TULSA illustrate the trend in every region. The week's biggest move shouldn't be any big surprise. PRINCE's "Purple Rain" is easily the most asked for single

and the chart jumps confirm its strength. In only five short weeks it already has a Hit Factor of 40%. A couple of CERTIFIED entries in late August have begun to generate big chart growth. DIANA ROSS, who climbs 5 places into the top twenty and BILLY IDOL. Last week's CERTIFIED titles blast through, as HALL & OATES is now top 25 and COREY HART debuts at #39. SHEENA EASTON, TINA TURNER and CHAKA are a trio of winners who were holding, waiting for the coast to clear and here they come. EASTON makes a massive climb in Hit Factor from 19% to a whopping 45%. LIONEL RICHIE's "Penny Lover" leads the way in overall chart points at this early stage, but CYNDI LAUPER pulls ahead in airplay, with her total 213 against RICHIE's 192. BRUCE STEVENS, WBBQ-AUGUSTA mentions big sales activity for the EVERLY BROTHERS. His internal research has shown a 20-point increase over the last two weeks. Probably the earliest "Record To Watch" listing in the last several years is this week's title by FRANKIE GOES TO HOLLYWOOD. "Two Tribes" got a brief mention in last week's "Analysis" but now deserves more. Canada's been hip to it for months where NEVIN GRANT at CKOC-HAMILTON, Ontario lists it #7. Helped by Album and Alternative's play, it gets added this week at KIIS/FM-LOS ANGELES, KMEL-SAN FRANCISCO, WCCG-HARTFORD, CT, KIOK/FM-TRI-CITIES, WA, WPST-TRENTON, and KFBD-WAYNESVILLE, MO. Listener response is noted as immediate.

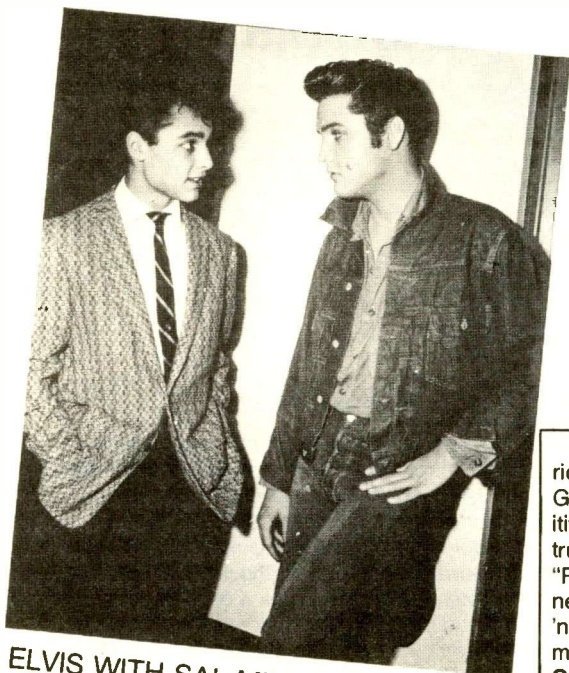

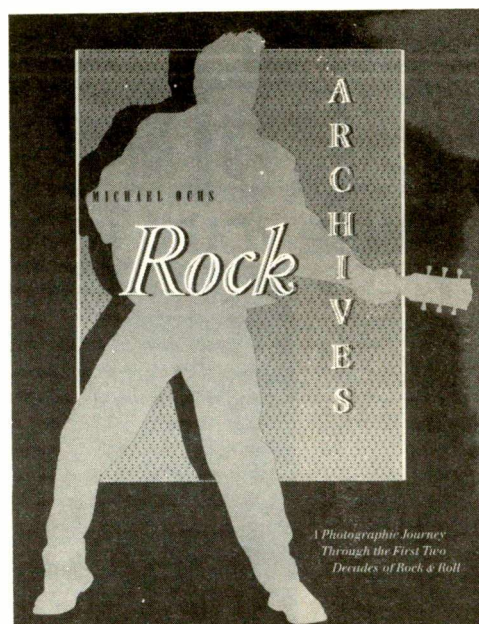

Enough has been *written* about rock's rich history to fill a house the size of Graceland. Now, for the first time a definitive photo history is being issued that is truly the finest I have ever seen. Titled "Rock Archives," this photographic journey through the first two decades of rock 'n' roll was compiled by the nation's foremost authority on Rock History, **Michael Ochs**. You've most likely seen some of the Michael Ochs archives in movies, various television productions and other media which have used the invaluable photos and memorabilia he's collected.

Talking with Michael, I explored the origins of this fascinating book which is *impossible* to put aside. "The idea," says Michael, "was fairly recent. I always wanted to do a book like this, but never had really pursued it. I have placed some photos in other books, magazines, and films sharing them that way, and once I had the deal for a *good* book all the pressure on me turned it into a *great* book." Why great? Ochs says he came across a lot of "11th hour finds. Finding photographers I could represent, and finding stuff even I didn't know existed."

Like fellow collectors who do this on a much smaller scale, once Michael started searching for records in the late 60's he caught the fever and couldn't stop. "I started collecting records seriously in '69 when I was at Columbia Records. I came out here (West Coast) with 100 records—period. My 100 favorites, and when I tried to find one I didn't have it drove me crazy. Then I said I didn't want just this one, I

want everything I had as a kid. So as I was building up the record collection I noticed that Columbia was throwing away some key photos and I said wait a minute . . . these photos can become as rare as the records. So I began documenting everything. The program books from concerts, the photos, the records, the sheet music. I wanted to recreate what I lived through. To explain **Gene Vincent** to someone, you need more than just the records, you need to see him in action!"

Michael credits various photographers such as **James J. Kriegsmann** for rare photos that defy description. Kriegsmann, for example, has been shooting photos for 50 years, starting with Sinatra in the early 30's and he's still working. He was the largest studio photographer in New York. Ochs is the first person in 50 years to go through his file cabinets and discover the treasures among them. Wait 'til you see the **Joan Rivers**, **Levon Helms** before **The Band** (with the Hawks), **Tom & Jerry (Simon & Garfunkel)** and other amazing photos. Michael also met **Don Paulsen**, who worked for the teen magazines in the 60's and captured priceless photos taken at venues like New York's *Apollo Theater* backstage as **Smokey Robinson** sang "*My Girl*" to the Temptations for the first time.

With so much material to choose from, Michael's unenviable task was insuring a proper balance between publicity shots, backstage pics, concert photos, etc. My first thought when glancing at "Rock Archives," was how in the world could anyone track down all this stuff? Ochs

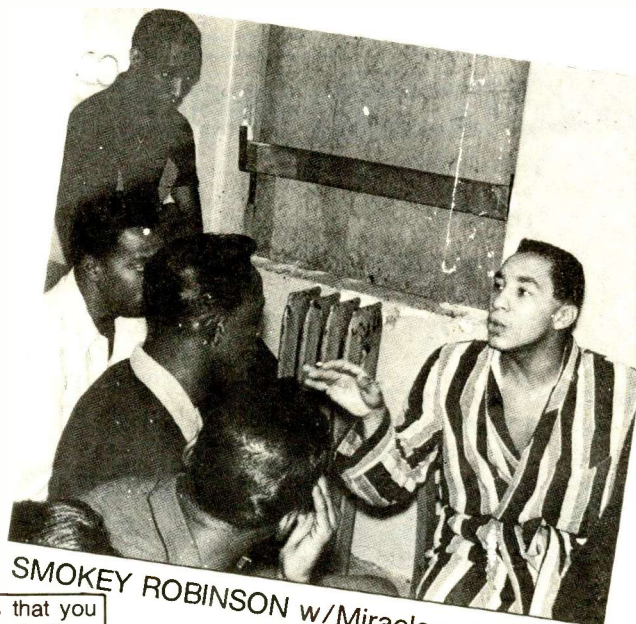


**STEVIE WONDER w/JACKIE WILSON**

admits it happened fairly quickly. "I contacted everybody I knew who had photos and through those connections, things progressed geometrically. One lead would prompt another and so on and within a month I was on my way. I even bought out two collections, one from Peter Kanze and the Ralph Gleason collection." Simple love of this project and Michael's dedication to its success brought everyone together to make sure nothing was missing.

Thinking it impossible to pick out gems from among this masterpiece, I nevertheless asked Ochs to name just a few that immediately came to mind. "One of my favorites," he said, "was the picture with Elvis Presley and Sal Mineo that defines 50's cool better than any other shot I've ever seen. The picture of Smokey Robinson & The Miracles backstage at the Apollo, with Smokey singing "My Girl" to the Temptations for the first time, is incredible just due to the enormity of someone being there to capture that historic moment. Levon Helms & The Hawks before he joined The Band, Tom & Jerry (Simon & Garfunkel), Sam Cooke & The Soulsters ..." well, you get the idea.

Ochs is quick to emphasize that "the music is the bottom line. Your gut level reaction to the music itself is immediate. Your second reaction, or at least mine, always was ... "geez, Wilbert Harrison sounds so good on that record ... I wonder what he looked like at the time? ... what kind of a guy was he? What was he like on stage?" and hopefully the photos catch that. The reason I always hated

rock books, for example, was that you really couldn't convince someone to like a Jackie Wilson by just writing about Jackie Wilson. But if you like him already, this will augment your appreciation of the music, similar to getting a booklet in the album you buy.

In this age of slick TV shows like "Solid Gold" and Videos via MTV, artists have no problem being seen as well as heard. But during rock's early years, it wasn't taken seriously and the bulk of acts never had access to television or film. Michael notes that the purpose of "Rock Archives" is to give these pioneers and others that access they've been denied for so many years. If by now you've gotten the impression that I've totally flipped over this nearly 400 page marvel, you're right! The old saying "a picture is worth a thousand words" is given new meaning by "Rock Archives." Michael Ochs likes to think of his book as a record album ... "you can play it from front to back and get the whole concept, or play it single by single ... i.e., The Motown section, The Rockabilly section, whatever your favorite would be. To me it's like twelve hit singles in a concept album."

"Rock Archives" is being shipped as we go to print with this story and officially goes on sale to the public October 12th. It will retail for \$35.00 hardcover, \$16.95 paperback—published by Doubleday & Company, New York. Thanks, Michael Ochs, for sharing this treasure with all of us. Check it out as soon as you can. You won't be disappointed. ■

## ANALYSIS

The Roger, Ingram and Carnes record is the strongest number five record I've ever seen, so you can imagine how strong the top four are. The Branigan is nearing its peak but benefits from more fatigued records on both sides. The action is in the middle third of the chart. Eight consecutive underlines, all poised for single digit status. As a matter of fact fifteen out of sixteen have lines. I fully expect Hall & Oates and Lionel Richie to make at least ten point jumps next week and I wouldn't be surprized if Paul McCartney and Al Jarreau have Gavin numbers in A/C next week along with Cyndi Lauper (the Lucy Ricardo of the 80's). This week's A/C Record To Watch, SEA OF LOVE by the Honeydrippers is a remake of the Phil Phillips hit from the summer of 1959. The Honeydrippers are Jimmy Page and Robert Plant from Led Zepplin, along with Nile Rodgers and Jeff Beck, mostly though it's Robert Plant.

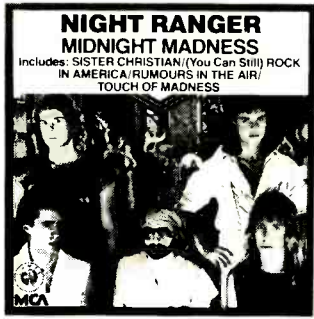

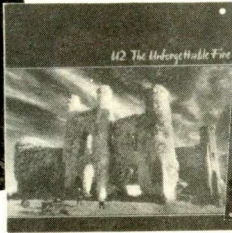

Valotte-JULIAN LENNON (Atlantic) As rock n roll lusters into its third decade, we're bound to see a younger generation continuing to carry the traditional torch. "Valotte", JULIAN LENNON's first single, is a pondering ballad asking questions amidst a state of tranquil observation. It's a beautiful piece finely constructed by producer PHIL RAMONE.

"Two Tribes"-FRANKIE GOES TO HOLLYWOOD (Island) After a couple of extended mixes floating about, whizbang producer TREVOR HORN has created a special US edit that sums things up at 3:20. Third and final warning. This record will be huge.

Howling At The Moon/Daytime Dilemma-RAMONES (Sire) Start with side two because if you do, you'll hear "Howling At The Moon" (produced by EURYTHMIC DAVE STEWART) into JOEY RAMONE's "Daytime Dilemma". Both trax are the true standouts. The remainder'll rock the shingles off the doghouse in traditional backyard RAMONES grandlore.

So Fine/Love Cools Down/Lullabye Drive-MARC ANTHONY THOMPSON (Warner Bros.) Stunningly recorded, MARC ANTHONY THOMPSON is both elusive on the cover and in the grooves. His music is multi-formatted and excellent. Spend some time with this one. "Love Cools Down" is a trip with a hip harp solo midpoint. PEYTON MAYS told me about the cover shot. "Hey MARC, there's something on your shoe!" CLICK.

Had A Dream-ROGER HODGSON (A&M) Roger was obviously one of the whimsical voices of SUPERTRAMP. "Had A Dream" will be the uptempo favorite off of ROGER's new solo LP. Album Radio is already embracing the single.

Tenderness/Hot You're Cool/Never You Done That/General Public GENERAL PUBLIC. The difference between GENERAL PUBLIC and THE ENGLISH BEAT is a bigger sound and bigger songs. By abandoning THE BEAT, WAKELIN and ROGER generates the freshness of GENERAL PUBLIC that outweighs any risk--especially since RANKING ROGER's vocals are the identifiable success quotient of both bands. Also gone is much of the early dance ska style that in a way trivialized and pigeon-holed THE BEAT's past accomplishments in the eyes of radio. GENERAL PUBLIC may be only debuting, but they'll be starting this band with more power and lots of retail ground work and drawing power already laid. Don't underestimate them. Top Forty, look out.

This Is Mine/Sunset Now/And That's No Lie-HEAVEN 17 (Arista/Virgin) HEAVEN 17 makes brainy music that may at first seem synthetic, but in actuality is quite remarkable. The instrumentation swells dramatically, while an unlikely blend of Marxism and glamour coagulates. Remember that HEAVEN 17 played a key role in revitalizing TINA TURNER's comeback. The new material is full of odd twists and sudden turns, topped with layer and layers of vocals. "And That's No Lie", at ten minutes, is a lengthy but engaging concept.

Big In Japan-ALPHAVILLE (Atlantic) ALPHAVILLE, before it was a group recording an international hit record, was a sci-fi detective movie by JEAN-LUC GODARD starring EDDIE CONSTANTINE as LEMMY CAUTION. "Big In Japan" is a catchy synth pop piece straddling the Top Forty border. Like the THOMPSON TWINS, the record could be a good contemporary-sounding image record.

A dogfight at the top, ladies and gents. BOWIE stays number, U2 debuts at two, THE FIXX's secondary cuts are getting stronger, and SPRINGSTEEN's single has peaked Top Ten this week over in Top Forty. Another single may revive him Top Three. Some hot debuts this week besides U2 include TEACHERS, HALL & OATES, and the inimitable HONEYDRIPPERS. Speaking of the 'DRIPPERS, it seems the original intention was total anonymity as to who performed, but some how word got out about BECK, PAGE, and NILE RODGER's participation. Word on the street is that swingin' PAUL SCHAFFER was involved. Producer NAGETRE backwards spells AHMET ERTEGAN, R&B master. Just down the hall, the JULIAN

LENNON LP lurks-forward towards a mid-October release. The promotion has been cautious and low key so that the talent does the real talking. Even further down the same hallowed halls, PHIL COLLINS' "In The Air Tonight" is enjoying a revival due to a television preview for MIAMI VICE, which may be the story of LABOR SECRETARY RAY DONOVAN taking an \$8 million subway ride south... IT HADDA HAPPEN DEPT... Finally a song named "Party In My Pants" has been unleashed. Singer/songwriter TOM ROBINSON has recorded a cool cover of STEELY DAN's "Rikki Don't Lose That Number" due out soon. Also included will be a new version of "War Baby" which is a one-in-a-million stunned-in-love song... Over half the chart is underlined this week, which reflects the influx of lots of good new product. Movers include healthy entries like SURVIVOR, RICKIE LEE JONES, RED ROCKERS, ZEBRA, and TOMMY SHAW, KISS, JETHRO TULL, ROGER HODGSON, and MOLLY HATCHET... The big chill throughout Album Radio seems to be Top Forty and what's going on, how to compete, how to stay on top. Never fear, dear GAVIN reader because all you have to do is read through the other formats and check out that TOP FORTY chart. It doesn't hurt to know just what's climbing and what's not. After All, a hit is a hit and a stiff is a stiff in almost any language or format. I always feel funny taking TOP FORTY reports seeing certain losing records being dropped TOP FORTY and seeing them lingering on Album Radio rotations. That's why you need a multi-format trade. Look to the left at Alternative Action and to the right at Top Forty and you'll never be surprised. Is it only on my album or what? With PRINCEMANIA still strong, why not try "Computer Blues" on side one. It's still the hippest track prominently featured as a rock tune in the film.

Next week's leading candidates for GAVIN CERTIFIED include BOWIE, the dB'S, and swift moving AZTEC CAMERA (an eleven point "jump". Check out the B side to the 12").

GENERAL PUBLIC debuts at #19, with many stations still adding it. DAVE & ROGER should waste no time moving to the top 10.

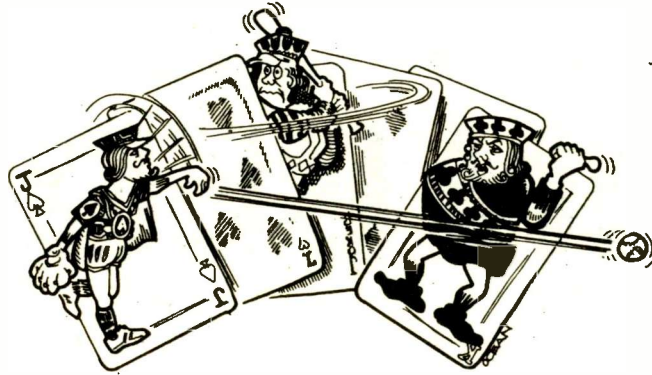

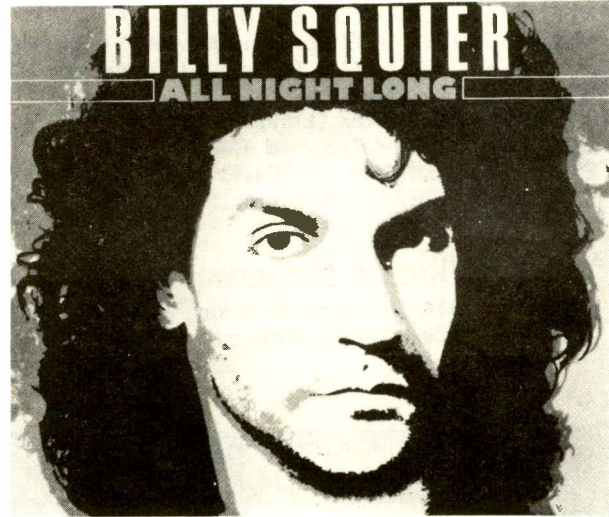

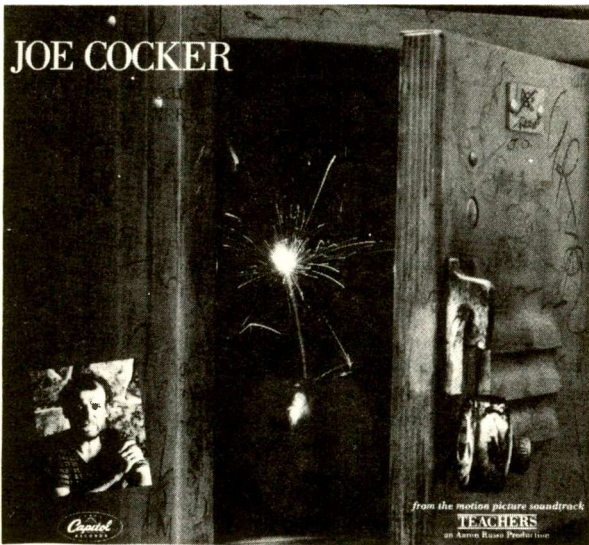

**ANALYSIS**

CHAKA KHAN wasted no time overtaking everyone else to achieve her number one this week, even with all the talent lined up ahead of her. NEW EDITION, crossing over big this week in Top 40, with a lot of zeal this week, looks like CK's biggest competitor, along with DIANA ROSS and REBBIE JACKSON. Biggest gainer award this week goes to TEDDY PENDERGRASS, a surprise to some because of the slow start it had. The movie's success seems to have given it a boost right when it needed it the most, about the 3rd or 4th week after its release. Another record to fit that category of slow start and big take-off is the NUANCE, which jumps 27-18 this week. Highest debut on the chart is the WHODINI, which turns out to be a two-sided surprise for Arista. "Friends" was released as the A side and began its success early, while "5 Minutes of Funk" was getting

attention too. Then "Funk" side started pulling listener phone response where it was being played and that resulted in chart numbers from our stations for both sides, either together at the same number or appearing in two different places. APOLLONIA 6 continues to receive attention from the movie success and some stations have reported big requests for it because of the additional movie attention. Result: debuts on our chart at #27 and becomes CERTIFIED! ISLEY, JASPER, ISLEY is our most added single this week. I'm told that it's the Isley Brothers of 1973's younger members, Ernie Isley, Chris Jasper and Marvin Isley who have changed their name to this new version. The sound, though very familiar, should do well on its own merit, regardless of which Isleys they are. A nice surprise for AL JARREAU is the POP CROSSOVER award, which indicates big interest in the Top 40 AND A/C departments. A/C reports a whopping 65 adds this week alone and Top 40 registers 29 adds for the first week of its release!

PERSONAL PICKS

VALOTTE-Julian Lennon (Atlantic) All children of superstars who enter the same business are both blessed and cursed. The pressures of living up to the family name and accomplishments of their parents are all too well known. Julian makes his debut and no excuses are necessary. This remarkably beautiful record, produced by Phil Ramone, puts the world on notice that here is a tremendous talent who will make it on his own merit. But the obvious and striking similarities of John and Julian's vocal styles can't be ignored. Shivers, chills, goosebumps, whatever...I get 'em all while listening to a young man we've just begun to hear about. Go get 'em Julian, you're a winner. By the way, VALOTTE is pronounced VAL-AW-T, and is the city in France that houses the studio where the LP was recorded.

TWO TRIBES-Frankie Goes To Hollywood (Island) One of those rare instances where a "Record To Watch" will also be listed on the picks page. Some well respected programmers aren't hesitating, and this pick is probably more to underscore the importance of this side. It already has the distinction of being one of the biggest selling records in British music history. Whether or not you agree with the subject matter (anti-nuclear, anti-establishment) it has already proved its widespread appeal. Could be very very big!

TEARS-John Waite (EMI) Nope, this ex-Baby is not simply a one hit wonder. Though it'll be very tough to match the staying power of his last monster number one hit, don't be surprised to see this one come close. A dynamic performer who turns up the energy level this time around.

BIG IN JAPAN-Alphaville (Atlantic) Ok, I wouldn't play this in Detroit, but...for everyone else here's a real catchy release that nearly slipped by. Judging by the group photo on the picture sleeve and the synth/pop style, I'd count on a hip video to make it stand out even more. Does this mean Lee Lococca will take me out of his will?

EDGE OF A DREAM-Joe Cocker (Capitol) Has much of the same quality (not melody) of "Up Where We Belong". Cocker turns in a dramatic performance on this theme from the movie "Teachers". Much of the records' magnetism is in the chorus.

I've said it before and now again, Chaka is a singer's singer - capable of explosive blasts of souled-out, stark-raving, incantatious and/or smokey, blushing, seductive mantrap music. Her songs are tactful and tactile with an aural feel of unmistakable commitment to the "word" and its relationship to its appointed groove. The first single, I FEEL FOR YOU, with its wrap-up opener from Grandmaster Melle Mel, uncorks the bubbly. The absolutely brilliant studio effects throughout the LP and many of the finest musicians on both coasts ensure its place in the pile of this year's finest. Before KIIS/FM it was rare for a music station in LOTUSLAND to get more than a 5. I would like to have owned the blank tape concession in L.A. the week of the NAB/NRBA Convention 'cause everyone and his G.M. were airchecking DEES and crew, hoping to lift an idea or, worse yet, steal the format. As most will find out, it's as much an attitude as anything else. It's also a successful mix of people, both on and off the air. An aircheck of KIIS/FM is always going to be an entertaining experience but it's not likely to yield its magic formula. In talking to even KIIS/FM's most staunch competition you would sense real admiration for what has been and is being accomplished. For the near future the battle is for #2 and if I know the crew at KIIS/FM that battie won't include KIIS/FM. There doesn't appear to be anyone rolling over and playing dead. No dinosaurs there.

For those of you interested in our continuing computer saga, this week marked the first week our Top 40 research was done on our "hot" new HP-3000 system. For most of us it was our first experience with a big system. Getting used to the keyboards, screens, commands and codes was and still is a bit overwhelming but the end result is better and even more accurate information with which to construct our charts and analyze the current world of popular music.

In the next few weeks we'll be putting all our other formats on-line. A lot of thought and careful preparation has gone into this system along with nearly \$100,000.

If you hear us refer to GRIP in the future it is not a command but rather the acronym for GAVIN RESEARCH INFORMATION PROCESSOR. GRIP is user-friendly and likes good music almost as much as you and I do. Ron Fell
