Summer Ratings Season Begins

The first of the Summer 2005 Arbitron ratings were released yesterday. As always, you can get the latest info at www.radioandrecords.com — just click on the “Ratings” tab. Here’s how Country has fared in the first few books. All shares are 12+.

Los Angeles: KZLA moved 1.8-1.9 spring '05-summer '05. It had a 2.1 in summer '04. KZLA ranked No. 22, 12+.

Chicago: WUSN (US99) slipped 3.8-3.5 spring '05-summer '05. It had a 3.2 in summer '04. US99 ranked eighth, 12+. Offering some insight into the numbers, PD **Mike Peterson** noted, “We’re thrilled that not only are we performing at a competitive level 25-54, but we’re doing it consistently. The 25-54 summer share was a 4.1 and No. 4 rank. Since fall '04 we’ve seen great growth in the key demos and prime dayparts and have maintained top five status overall. This staff continues to work very hard to stay focused on what it takes to succeed.”

Wilkes Barre: WGGY & WGGI led the market for the second consecutive book, rising 8.7-9.1, spring-summer, '05. It had a 9.1 in summer '04. WSJR was up 1.5-2.7, spring-summer '05. It had a 3.0 in summer '04. WSJR ranked tenth, 12+.

Hamptons-Riverhead, NY: WWYZ/Hartford, CT was up 3.6-3.8, spring-summer. It posted a 3.7 in summer '04. WWYZ tied for seventh, 12+.

ASCAP Honors Writers, Chesney At Ryman

ASCAP changed its awards format from previous years, moving last night’s 43rd annual Country Music Awards to the Ryman Auditorium. CEO **John LoFrumento** and Senior VP **Connie Bradley** co-hosted the event, which moved to the 27th floor of the BellSouth Tower following the awards presentations. **Rascal Flatts** performed “I Saw the Light,” songwriter **Craig Wiseman** performed “Live Like You Were Dying,” writer **Brett James** sang “When the Sun Goes Down,” **Monty Powell** performed “Days Go By” and Voice of Music Award honoree **Kenny Chesney** performed “I Go Back.” A video performance saw **John Rich** impersonating Gretchen Wilson on “Redneck Woman.”

ASCAP bestowed upon **Kenny Chesney** its ASCAP Voice of Music Award, which is given to recognized artists and songwriters whose music gives people’s lives a voice through song. He joins the select group of **Garth Brooks, George Strait, Diane Warren** and **Amy Grant**, the only four artist-songwriters to have previously received this award.

Our weekly analysis of Country callout research is brought to you by Bullseye President John Hart. Here's a look at some of the biggest stories Hart looks at in next week's issue.

"Montgomery Gentry's 'Something to Be Proud Of' becomes the No. 1 song overall in the sample. Lonestar's 'You're Like Coming Home' enters the top five titles as the No. 3 song, up from No. 8. Gary Allan moves into the top 10, with 'Best I Ever Had' ranking as the No. 10 song for the week, up from No. 13 last week and No. 17 two weeks ago — strong growth. Keith Anderson continues to post solid growth, with 'XXL' ranking as the No. 14 song this week, up from No. 18 last week and No. 21 two weeks back. Heads up for Van Zant, as 'Nobody Gonna Tell Me What to Do' debuts as the No. 26 song."

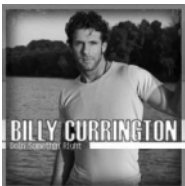
