RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

A 30" snowfall/blizzard on top of the 22" we got 2 weeks ago, has left the city and coast paralyzed. Travel is still restricted to foot and cross-country ski. As for us, we were off the air for about 20 hours as the inner city lost power due to flood damage at coastal stations. Other communities were similarly affected. Once back on, just before the storm ended, the snow-bound staff and volunteers did such a superb job of amassing vital information that Boston City Hall started referring callers to us. We of course brought quarter-hourly and hourly reports and actualities for the duration of the crisis. I think we have naked city beat for stories and National Guardsmen. Special thanks to Bob Machson and the above-and-beyond-the-call news crew, I'm sure they'd be happy to share the past few days with any masochists out there.

Some positive news comes from our Don't Count Your Chickens Before They Hatch Dept., which shows that in the recent Jan. Mediatrend we posted a 5.6 share and that means OUR trend is up. From a 2.2 in Oct., to a 3.5 in Nov., to a 4.0 in Dec., and now this with a 15.0 share of 18-34's we're rather pleased. An interesting business n' est-ce pas? Love, Sasquatch

still under a State of Emergency proclaimed by the Governor, WCOZ kept it on through it all. There were 2 power blackouts in Boston last week that knocked everybody off the air, except us. We kept on with battery powered mixers and cassette machines playing music while providing disaster information 24 hours a day for a full week. The army and national guard has been patrolling the streets, helping much needed supplies of food and heating oil rolling through town. Still no cars allowed in Boston, a pedestrian's dream in the middle of a nightmare.

It's been one of those radio events that we will never forget... broadcasting by candlelight, sleeping on the floor for a few hours before relieving other exhausted staffers, heating canned stew on bunson burners, and keeping the information coming over the air. Our helicopter, airplane and mobile units gave us eyewitness reports of the devastation and our toll free watt lines kept our shut in listeners feeding back reassuring information to us all.

Add to this the fact that one staff member had his home swept off the beach by hurricane winds and tidal flooding, his personal possessions totally lost, and you have an idea of what Boston has been through... 26 dead, over one billion dollars in damages. But now we rebuild, and let the world know that we continue onward, weary but wise. And glad to be alive.

The February 6th snow storm caught us with myself stuck in Florida, not able to get back. My ass't. P.D. Paul was stuck 20 miles from town, not able to get back in either. M.D. John Duncan, Ilyse Gottlieb (our Promotion Director and former WBRU Program Director) and WAAF mainstay Joe Biedrzycki covered all bases; did all the air shifts, and in communication with myself and Paul by phone, made all music changes, did all the music research, and did all the reports to the trades.

Heavy work and long hours and the station stayed on top of the storm as well - spots were cleared - reports on emergency actions, road conditions, cancellations of functions and general emergency information was broadcast continually. A great combination of music and information - the station never sounded better.

We were one of the few stations in the Boston area to NOT have our transmission interrupted at all during the duration of "The worst snow storm in New England's history." A tip of my hat to my whole staff.

SNOWED IN...that's the state of all Rhode Island as I write this. The accumulation is the most in R.I.'s history, and President J.C. has declared us in a state of emergency. But even though Providence was the city hit hardest by the storm, 'BRU stayed on-the-air for the duration, as other stations temporarily disappeared from the airwaves. Staff from both the programming and news departments chipped in to provide listeners with all the up-to-date information. We had reports from various relief centers throughout the city, as the news staff tramped around on foot or skies, since other forms of transport were impossible. 'BRU provided live remotes from the Brown University Green area, and also live reports from the State House, where we talked with Governor Garrahy and R.I. Civil Defense Director Santo Amato for info on how the city was digging out. Other live hookups included those with the Providence chapter of the Red Cross, phone-ins from Mr. Vibes (outside during the heart of the blizzard), and reports on the Boston situation...thank to the News Dept. of WCAS. We also got updates on what was happening in New York, and New Orleans, where our storm coincided exactly with the festive activities of the Mardi Gras. It's been hectic but fun, and hopefully, things will have returned to normal by the time this hits print.

WRAS has been doing live broadcasts from local Atlanta clubs for several years now, bringing our audience a spectrum of artists from James Talley to UFO, etc. Broadcasting a "name" act, though, has been a problem. We notice stations around the country broadcasting groups like the Beach Boys, Graham Parker, the Dead, and others that are established acts. Very recently, Arlo Guthrie played the Great S.E. Music Hall, a small club that we do most of our broadcasts from. We talked to Harold Leaventhal, Arlo's personal manager, and before the words were out of our mouths, our request to broadcast Arlo was denied. If we had been able to talk to Arlo personally, we probably would have done the broadcast. This "stone-wall" policy used by some promotion men is destructive, to both the artist and the audience. I would like to see these policies stopped, so we can open up music for the public.

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Toshiko Akiyoshi-Lew Tabackin Big Band/INSIGHTS/RCA AFL 1-2678 (Toshiko writes serious big band music and arranges it with authority. It operates from a 50's Kenton blueprint. While it is strong on ensemble integrity it is soft on innovation. Tight.)
- Yvonne Elliman/NIGHT FLIGHT/RSO RS-1-3031 (Everyone roots for Yvonne but, her albums tend to sound like a collection of singles. All of the right players come to lend a hand in this pretty production. Their efforts yield some usable tracks, notably "Lady Of the Silver Spoon.")
- Leon Haywood/DOUBLE MY PLEASURE/MCA 2322 (Leon borrows from everywhere a little Sly, a little disco, but, his songs tend to be pretty round. Add to good tunes only mild doses of sweetness and an album which moves comfortably results.)
- Rupert Holmes/PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS/Private Stock PS 7006 (The hip MOR of Rupert Holmes has class woven throughout it. Albums with which he is associated are dominated by large, creative arrangements. This one is no exception. More than the good songs or playing, they come center stage.)
- Barry Manilow/EVEN NOW/Arista AB 4164 (Whatever feelings Barry Manilow stimulates inside you, his commercial ear has to be admired. It is uncanny though it is often corny. This Lp retreats from some of the excess and improves on the sonic side.)
- Dusty Springfield/IT BEGINS AGAIN/United Artists UA LA 791-H (Dusty has always possessed a soulful charm. She brings that quality with her as It Begins Again. Most of this Lp is produced in a sweet-pop-rock style, but "A Love Like Yours" and "That's The Kind Of Love.." manage to sneak through.)
- Suzanne Stevens/STARDUST LADY/Capitol ST-11717 (Producing a good singer requires the application of taste. Hal Yoergler does the job. He gathers a batch of fine songs and he doesn't permit the arrangements to get overwhelming. Those arrangements, however, do not carry with them an individual personality. Some possibilities lodge on side one.)
- Various Artists/BEATLEMANIA/Arista AL 8501 (Remarkable reproductions of the masters. The quality of the material throughout this two record set reminds us again of a group which has not yet been approached in the depth and breadth of its talent, not by any of the endless "superstars" of today. The Lp also suggests that you play the originals now and then. The guy doing Paul is working right-handed.)

CONCEPTS

SOME QUESTIONS FOR MARSHALL MC LUHAN

Much of the writing of Marshall McLuhan is, at best, elusive. For an expert on the communications process he hasn't made it easy for mere mortals.

One of the master's most enticing thoughts, however, is his hot/cool medium theory. In order to understand the difference between varieties of media, he postulates, that one helpful measure is how much energy the reader, listener or viewer must use to grasp the message being delivered. The more you have to put into it, the hotter is the medium. For example, McLuhan would say that a film of a pantomime would be hotter than a talkie on the basis that the silent film would require more of its viewer's energy than the talkie. The talkie fills in all of the blanks.

To the point, McLuhan assumes that because radio is audio only its nature is hot, as compared say to T.V. It requires vast energies to create, in the imagination, all that is required to fill in the visual half of the radio message.

This assumption about radio was largely developed before the full implementation of format radio. The theory was based on radio programming at a time when it did variety programming in the manner of current T.V. programming. It follows, if you start at that point in radio's development, that lots of imagery had to be generated in the brain of the listener to see the castle or the forest for the trees. (On television you have a set designer to create the forest.) Radio would, therefore, be a hot medium.

Here are the questions for Marshall McLuhan - does format radio, essentially juke box radio which plays music the audience has heard over and over again, remain hot? What energy is required of an audience which mostly uses the medium as background to living? Is it the essential nature of the medium or rather the medium's message which runs hot or cool? Hence the difference between a silent film and a talkie. And finally, if the coolness or hotness of the medium is dependent on its message, does that not call into question the other famous McLuhanism "The Medium is the Message?"

- Gallagher & Lyle/A&M SP-4679 (It is not a lack of acceptable material or performance skill which holds G & L away from success. Like so many soft sound groups before them, they lack a rough edge. With their songs and harmonies the addition of extra bottom and a saw blade saxophone or guitar would send them to the top. For now enjoy the warmth.)
- Hal Galper Quintet/REACH OUT!/Inner City 2067 (When Hal gets rolling he hardly takes time to breathe as the notes tumble relentlessly. The alternative is a rather spacious glide. Each side is accented by a lovely solo piano which looks back into the archives.)
- Garfield/OUT THERE TONIGHT/Capricorn CPN 0193 (A dramatist, Garfield French is reminiscent of an earlier Bowie in some ways. His songs are good and to his credit he is a unique character. Cosmopolitan.)
- Ian Gillan Band/SCARABUS/Island LPs 9511 (Previously reviewed as an import. It is not that they are working a hard rock groove, rather it appears as though they are working at it. There is a sense in which Ian's music sounds forced, his voice is too strained and the beat too exaggerated. But, that's only a feeling.)
- Good Rats/FROM RATS TO RICHES/Passport PB 9825 (Some things never change, Rats' writing has always been borderline, at least, but their driving dedication has never wavered. They remain more insistent than musical this time too. Their best song is buried at the end of side one.)
- Head East/A&M SP-4680 (Brandishing that audacious power-rock fuzz, Head East says Midwest with each song. Yet, it is the songs which represent their real power. There is nothing mental about what they do, it is just solid rock 'n' roll.)
- King Harry/DIVIDED WE STAND/Harvest ST-11753 (Previously reviewed as an import. A solid rock band on all levels. Almost totally self-contained, King Harry is a complete production unit in and of itself. Lead by a big voice they perform a standard brand of rock music with notable care.)
- Lonesome Sundown/BEEN GONE TOO LONG/Joliet 6002 (Organic, Sundown's blues is genuine and current. These are new tunes set in that sticky Louisiana feel. A smidgen of gospel music colors the blues toward pastel. Write: Box 67201, Los Angeles, Ca. 90067.)
- Frank Marino & Mahogany Rush/LIVE/Columbia JC 35257 (Not the most precise live recording ever, but it does represent Marino's undeniable skill as a guitarist. If the band's music is making it, it is because of the guitar. As a singer he is adequate, his vocals don't show the same degree of oneness with the music, especially doing the blues.)
- Bob McBride/HERE TO SING/MCA 2318 (Competence at every level keeps Bob's album listenable at all times. It does not raise it above a pleasantry. So that, while he is good, McBride lacks star quality, he lacks a grabber.)
- Michael Murphy/LONEWOLF/Epic JE 35013 (Lead by a super song called "Paradise Tonight," Michael brings his music back into focus. He hardens the sound, shedding the unnecessary sweeteners, and delivers them with his understated manner. Smooth.)
- Jimmy Owens/HEADIN' HOME/Horizon SP-729 (The disco jazz of Jimmy Owens presents a contextual problem. While the rhythm feel is up to the minute, the Owens' trumpeting is of an earlier time. They almost fit together. If he wants to play in this context he should do something like what Miles Davis did to amplify his horn. The album is not more than melodically O. K.)
- Pere Ubu/THE MODERN DANCE/Blank 001 (The Modern Dance is a new wave response to the avant garde. Embedded within the punkisms are spaced, outside phases which make Pere Ubu less commercially viable but, more interesting. They help to prove the axiom that says today's avant garde is tomorrow's pop music. Semi-musical. Blank Records is the new wave label of Mercury Records. Call Cuff Burnstein at 312-645-6235.)
- Pickins/FIRST TIME AROUND/Ariola America SW 50024 (Their writing ability is tenuous but, their presentation pulls the whole project up. The character of the studio side one (restrained) is quite different from the live side two (loose.) Some more outside material would have helped.)
- Noel Pointer/HOLD-ON/United Artists UA LA 846-H (Whatever Noel does, he does well. His albums have character and substance. The problem is that he can do too much. Hold-On, for example, tends to be disjointed because so many different directions are explored. He would be working closer to the natural flow of the album medium if he would take one idea per Lp and explore it in all its facets. The next album could explore another idea. Noel would be a more potent recording artist without sacrificing character or substance, if he used that approach.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Randy Richards/A&M SP 4678 (Randy asks us to excuse a few blatantly Top 40 songs, some cliched lyrics and adequate melodies. And we do it solely because the album's production saves it. As happens so many times the album sounds better than it is. Side one houses most of the problems.)
- Dutch Robinson/NOTHIN'S GOT ME/United Artists UA-LA 783-G (The tradition is long and distinguished. It is post-war and urban rhythm and blues which Dutch Robinson sings. He finds or writes convincingly. No sellouts to pop forces.)
- Sonny Rollins/EASY LIVING/Milestone M-9080 (Two striking realities come from Easy Living. One is that Sonny has continued to hear new sounds and styles and the other is that his distinctive tone gives his music a very contemporary edge. That tone, of course, is the difference between him and a million other tenor players.)
- Biff Roee/ROAST BEEF/Down Pat DP 3 (Bent Biff Rose returns. From a smoking corner of an obscure bar somewhere Biff strokes the piano and weaves his tales, his word games. At first he is just filling space, then you realize how accomplished he is. Write: 49 Thornton, Venice, Ca. 90291.)
- Pharoah Sanders/LOVE WILL FIND A WAY/Arista AB 4161 (There is some humor in the way Norman Connors has packaged the willing Pharoah Sanders. The humor is that in spite of the rhythmical straight jacket Sanders' saxophone insists on attempted escapes. Suddenly notes burst through like a genie trying to tell someone he's inside the bottle. This Lp will probably triple any previous Pharoah Sanders sales just to confound us progressives. Stick to the second, fourth and seventh tracks.)
- David Spinozza/A&M SP-4677 (David Spinozza has been one of the tastiest studio players for years. On his own album, he shows us all sides of his talent by putting his guitar in several musical settings. Each track works on its own but, they tend to pull against each other when viewed in an album context. "Superstar" is the most involving track.)
- The Suicide Commandos/MAKE A RECORD/Blank 002 (Lots of short songs, so short, that in some cases they seem to end just as they are beginning to go. Not as deadly as their name implies, The Suicide Commandos work in a classic new wave formulation. Fairly musical. Contact: Peter Mensch, 212-399-7940.)
- Sweet/LEVEL HEADED/Capitol SKAO-11744 (Sweet is a rock band with a few thoughtful moves thrown in. They add the kind of style which pulls a group out of the pile. Good songs contribute to the whole.)
- Mary Travers/IT'S IN EVERYONE OF US/Chrysalis CHR 1168 (Together Vini Poncia and Mary have created a crossover record by the use of understatement. A lightly rockin' feel says one thing while the soft sell says another. Neither side of the intensity line is offended. Good song selection.)
- The Tubes/LIVE!/A&M SP-6003 (Tubes tunes are good in the recorded medium but, they could not be expected to have their full impact without the action. Still, this may be the best recording they've made. It retraces their best prior songs in a more playable form and the band has filled out too. Good show.)
- Mal Waldron Quintet with Steve Lacy/ONE-UPMANSHIP/Inner City 3010 (Though the first track tends to be a little spacey, the other two tracks fall into a familiar Waldron pattern. Driving piano develops strong rhythms while interesting chords make up a pleasing melodic base. It's modern but, not obtuse.)
- Wire/PINK FLAG/Harvest ST-11757 (Previously reviewed as an import. With a moderate buzz on, Wire drives their point home. They represent a half step toward sophistication for punkers; harmony background vocals and such. O. K. songs, some of which might cause language problems, help to keep them legit.)
- The Michael Wynn Band/QUEEN OF THE NIGHT/Ariola America SW 50027 (Hard rock which is not hard for the sake of it, is a refreshing concept. Michael Wynn keeps his singing/screaming under control. He is able to do that because both his writing and his guitar speak well for him.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

- (Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)
- Judd/RHYTHM & SPACE/ASI 215 (Judd was not ready to record. Their material needs lots more development time. That point is driven home as the stylus tracks across Tom Williams' "Like Two Rivers." It shows up everything around it.)
- Pentwater/Beef (Weirdness derives from 2 sources. One is below standard recording quality and the other is generated by unmusical writing. Pentwater is capable but they desperately need editing and guidance, in general. They take cues from Zappa & Beefheart of old. Write: 3352 W. Foster, Chicago, Ill. 60625.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

The Dusty Chaps/DOMINO JOE/Capitol ST-11755 (George Hawke is a talented man with his heart in the right place. Dusty Chaps is his brew of Texas swing, Mexicale and humor. Ole Domino Joe is quite a guy. Tune in for his adventures.)

Joe Ely/HONKY TONK MASQUERADE/MCA 2333 (The new country music is like new wave rock music, more a return to basics than something truly new. In both cases, they tend to halt the escalation to MOR in both the country and the rock fields. Joe Ely is a bright light in the new country true grit. Solid performance of solid material.)

No Dice/Capitol ST-11733 (The punk packaging is a mistake because the band isn't punkish. Those who like new wave will feel cheated when they listen while the form's enemies may cheat themselves by missing a strong rock band. They present their music with an economical yet comfortable rockin' flow. But, it is the super writing of Gary Strange which elevates their album beyond the norm. A find.)

Vangelis/SPIRAL/RCA AFL 1-2627

(Previously reviewed as an import. His electronic instrumentals are pleasing and interesting. They use rock and easy listening ideas to yield the Vangelis signature.)

Wha-Koo/BERKSHIRE/ABC AA-1043 (Feeling good from the start, Wha-Koo makes a notable entrance into the rock scene. Down to the last track their material and their presentation is above average.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Beaverteeth/DAM IT/RCA AFL 1-2574

(Distinguished by their rhythm feel Beaverteeth, otherwise, takes a place in a long line of good rockers. They write and perform well but, they provide no hook to make them unique. Just doing it well may not be enough these days.)

Byron Berline & Sundance/LIVE AT

McCABES/Takoma D-1061 (Bluegrass means fun. Especially in a live setting, the music seems to take off in proportion to the audience's involvement. Have another beer.)

Cafe Jacques/ROUND THE BACK/Columbia

JC 35294 (Decent melodies are placed off center on accented rhythms to create the antithesis of funky music or funk inside-out. Produced by Rupert Hine, Cafe Jacques is a stylized, sophisticated rock form. As this brainy stuff goes they are pretty good. The pressing required an extra quarter turn to bring it up to volume.)

Lee Clayton/BORDER AFFAIR/Capitol

ST-11751 (Lee isn't the best singer you've ever heard but, he gets the job done with his little pearls. Impressive writing and rough edged solos highlighted this country rock affair.)

Bruce Cockburn/CIRCLES IN THE STREAM/

True ILTA 9475 (If you need your heart restarted, Cockburn is not the man to call. His music is on the cerebral, folky side of pleasant. Soft-spoken, Bruce's style runs counter to today's rock concentration. Four sides are a lot of sides.)

Russell Da Shiell/ELEVATOR/Epic JE35074

(Economy marks both the writing style and the production style. Da Shiell limits the mistakes by that maneuver and comes up with a restrained but, satisfying rock Lp.)

Dragon/Portrait JR 35068 (Solid in all departments. Dragon is a journeyman rock band without doing anything special. Their level of consistency, track to track, is uncommon.)

First Fire/Tortoise International BYL1-2677

(Nice harmonies and mellow rocking songs mark the first First Fire. While they deliver their material well, the presentation wants for some flair. It is a basic soft rock album.)

Focus/FOCUS CON PROBY/Harvest ST-

11721 (Another case of instrumentalists who cannot write melodies which have to be fitted with lyrics. Even much of this Lp's instrumental work seems somewhat lethargic, though their melodies are O.K. P.J. Proby seems to be out of context.)
