RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED), AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Highlight of the evening was the 2 tenor-sax giants working out on the Ammons-Stitt piece - "Blues Up & Down." There was literally no way Hubbard could follow the exultant energy that was generated by Griffin and Gordon. Hubbard's set was not displeasing, concentrating mostly on material from "Super-Blue", Freddie's playing while technically excellent didn't catch fire, possibly the rhythm section needs to get better acquainted.

AN OPEN LETTER TO THE FOLKS AT ARB

ARB is not merely the rating service, it is a radio fact of life, a given. In commercial radio you live, flounder or die by the reckoning of the great Beltsville computer. As the number one service of its type, ARB takes lots of abuse. It is in a king-of-the-mountain situation. Some of the criticism is fair and some unfair.

It is hard to argue, for example, that there is a better rating service around, that anyone else is more accurate. However, that is not to say that ARB is as accurate as is possible.

Since the company is top dog, it has a responsibility to the industries it services to invest the resources necessary to finish the job, to accurately count heads. It seems that moves to correct the imbalances have been tentative at best.

If an accurate sampling were taken in cities with substantial college populations the numbers would change radically. Boston is the city which is most obvious as regards college population, but it is not alone. It is hard to imagine that the true relationship between 18-24 year old listenership and other age groups has even been approximated there.

We will do nothing more than mention that many other cities would show quite different numbers if black people were accurately canvassed. That is part of the same issue.

The point is that ARB is in a position to not merely paint a vaguely accurate picture of listenership, but ARB has the opportunity to stretch out toward real accuracy. They should do it so that they fulfill the claim of being the best rating service possible, for no other reason.

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Trevor Rabin/Chrysalis CHR 1196 (The standards for hard rock are high if you conjure the potency of early Led Zeppelin, for example. That is why much of the current crop measures mediocrity. Trevor Rabin shows us some of the stuff it takes to transcend averageness. Consistently good songwriting and controlled power playmanship do it. The fact that he played all of the instruments except drums is cute.)
- John Scofield/LIVE/Inner City 3022 (Scofield falls in line behind Pat Martino. He mixes cool sounds with post-Trane runs. The texture is always smooth but, the pattern is sometimes pretty flashy.)
- Gene Simmons/Casablanca NBLP-7120 (That the backbone of Kiss would make as many references to The Beatles is a notable point. Mostly Gene Simmons generates the rock muscle that has made him such a marketable item.)
- Phoebe Snow/AGAINST THE GRAIN/Columbia JC 35456 (Great players and good songs, maybe the best total collection Phoebe has had, overwhelm the incredible Phoebe Snow voice. It gets arranged and mixed into the larger soup stock cutting down its individuality. That worked for Leo Sayer maybe, Phoebe Snow will benefit from moderated style too.)
- Buddy Spicher/ME & MY HEROES/Flying Fish FF-065 (We are all aware of the swing influence on country music because of Texas swing. This Lp contains a Nashville crossbred which mixes swing with bluegrass. Buddy's jam is delightful.)
- Paul Stanley/Casablanca NBLP 7123 (Everybody expects the worst. That works to the advantage of Paul Stanley's disarmingly solid rock album. Hard, no compromises, rock music with some decent material needs to make no apology.)
- 10cc/BLOODY TOURISTS/Polydor PD 1-6161 (With a few missing cc's the music of 10cc is somewhat less potent than it has been. The dosage deficiency seems to affect the buoyancy of their presentation most. Their music isn't jumping off the record as it did. Songs still have interesting twists.)
- Ralph Towner/BATIK/ECM 1-1121 (There have been jokes made about how many times "Icarus" has been recorded. However, its staying power is a testament to the strength of a great melody. This album, while it is skillful, presents atherial music for the inner self rather than the liberated spirit.)
- Triumph/ROCK & ROLL MACHINE/RCA AFL 1-2982 (Previously reviewed as an import. Virtually every aspect of Triumph's music has been heard before done by other groups. A competent band, they write their own material and still create little that is new. This release combines the two Canadian Lp's into one by taking essentially the strongest stuff from the first Lp.)
- Various Artists/PHILADELPHIA FOLK FESTIVAL - 1977/Flying Fish FF-064 (This venerable, old festival is finally documented again after 17 years. A nice thing about this Lp is that it touches base with many of the festival's participants famous and unknown. No one gets more than a track since there were so many notable performances.)
- Various Artists/VOLUNTEER JAM III & IV/Epic EZ 35368 (If the barside rock 'n' roll of the South makes you move, this is the only place to be. Centered around Charlie Daniels, the Lp includes members of The Marshall Tucker Band, Sea Level, Wet Willie, Willie Nelson, among others, and positively exhilarated performances. Sonic qualities aren't the best.)
- James Walsh Gypsy Band/RCA AFL 1-2914 (A vibrant presentation highlights an album weakened by mostly empty lyric sentiment. Merely passable melodies at least hold up their end of the total responsibility. They get by.)
- Grover Washington, Jr./REED SEED/Motown M 7-910RI (Virtually all of the tempos are moderate creating an easy bed on which Grover's choosen and original melodies can float. It could be background music except that the soloing is too interesting and tasty. Low-key contemporary jazz.)
- Yes/TORMATO/Atlantic SD 19202 (Champions of pretense, one still must admit that they stuff their songs with some dynamic excitement. They are not as good as players or writers or arrangers as they are given credit. But, together Yes has the discipline to get it done better than most. What you come out appreciating is their tough-mindedness, their determination to make their music work.)
- Zwol/EMI America SW-17005 (When he's good he's very good. The front of each side is notably stronger than the back of each side. Which means that Walter's Lp has high points but, that it doesn't have depth. The first two tracks on both sides are Merit Plus tracks.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Axis/IT'S A CIRCUS WORLD/RCA AFL 1-2950 (With proper thrust Axis makes its entry into the hard rock forum. But, their songs drag through the thick bottomy sound with little life of their own.)
- The Beach Boys/M.I.U. ALBUM/Brother-Reprise MSK 2268 (Fragile and tentative. The Beach Boys sound as if collapse is imminent. They are left as the ghost of themselves, drained of their former vitality. Still, you root for them. Brian has been pushed up and out to the executive producer position.)

UNDISTINGUISHED ALBUMS

(In our opinion, below standard Lp's except where noted.)

- Fairchild/Flight FR 1706 (A struggle. Before you can discuss their antiquated rock style, the unperfected writing of Tom Riopelle and Mark Enstad needs comment. The band sounds just plain immature. They were recorded too early. Write: 1704 W. Lake St., Minneapolis, Mn. 55408.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Moe Bandy/LOVE IS WHAT LIFE'S ALL ABOUT/Columbia KC 35534 (A clear country baritone and absolutely round songs are a combination which comes up infrequently. The duo has to be respected even if it bends toward a pop sound. Moe is the kind of artist who makes you wonder why good country music isn't accepted universally.)
- Maynard Ferguson/CARNIVAL/Columbia JC 35480 (The volatile Ferguson big band persists. Even with synthesizers and an electric bass it is indomitable. A new Slide Hampton arrangement of "Stella By Starlight" returns to the old book. The band fires on all cylinders.)
- Gonzalez/SHIPWRECKED/Capitol SW-11855 (This is a very talented band which truly sounds shipwrecked. Conceptually they haven't decided who they want to be. Sweetened R&B or show band or rock band, they are all of them and yet none of them. The first track is the only possibility.)
- Milt Jackson, Count Basie & The Big Band/VOL. I/Pablo 2310-822 (Basie's big bands have always been able to prance delicately while other big band's career through their charts. That ability befits the Basie piano style and is perfectly suited to the vibes. A top-notch performance. Easy.)
- Hank Jones/TIPTOE TAPDANCE/Galaxy GXY-5108 (The solo piano work of Hank Jones is warm, reflective and melancholy. His choice of material is old songs, songs which he has lived with for a long time.)
- Bob Mover/Vanguard VSD 79408 (A traditional jazz context is sometimes the launching pad for Bob's saxophone explorations. At times they stretch into true adventures in post-Trane jazz.)
- Pockets/TAKE IT ON UP/Columbia JC 35384 (Pockets is a standard quality funky R&B band which might not call attention to itself. But, buried in side 2, so no one would notice, is a super fusion tune called "Sphinx" which is worth an extra effort.)
- Rare Earth/GRAND SLAM/Prodigal P 7-10027 R1 (By dropping any attempts at writing for themselves, Rare Earth has been able to make their best album. Even back to their first Lp, material was a problem. Their performance was always big and spirited. This Lp takes advantage of strengths while eliminating their weaknesses. In the process the arranging has moved them to the fringes, at the pop frontier. "When A Man Loves A Woman" and "I Wish It Would Rain" are possibilities.)
- The Lew Tabackin Quartet/DUAL NATURE/Inner City 1028 (The tenor side is not as benign as the flute side, which leads off. A major criticism of the Lp is its lack of integration, rarely is either the bass or piano even acknowledged. This is strictly Tabackin blowing with Shelly Manne following along. Meanwhile, the melodies aren't of everlasting quality.)
- Joe Venuti/JAZZ VIOLIN/Vanguard VSD 79405 (Joe Venuti is an old man now but, he swings with the best of them. He burns on "Sweet Sue." Smooth.)
- Johnny Guitar Watson/GIANT/DJM 19 (Through the high quality funky disco comes the Watson's blues feel. A real winner is his "You Can Stay.." and his "Gangster Of Love" is good too. A little Slyness, mixed with Hendrixness colors his work positively. Johnny is equally grounded in rock, disco and R&B.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Weather Report/MR. GONE/ARC-Columbia JC 35358 (Mr. Gone is another example of the individually honed sound of Weather Report. They have to work to keep all of their ideas sane. This album remains fairly musical in spite of its complexities.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Richard T. Bear/RED HOT & BLUE/RCA AFL 1-2927 (His rough-out voice and his attitude are immediately attractive while the back alley rockin' arrangements feel like New Orleans. After the fine "Sunshine Hotel" Richard's tunes settle into a pattern closer to average. Check out the two contributions from the outside.)

The Bliss Band/DINNER WITH RAOUL/Columbia JC 35511 (There is something about Paul Bliss' writing or the arrangements which bend off in weird directions. A feeling that much more could be gotten out of these tunes leads to faulty arrangements as the problem. A decent Lp could have been better.)

Blue Oyster Cult/SOME ENCHANTED EVENING/Columbia JC 35563 (To their credit the Cult combination of power and melody doesn't get sold out to pure power in the live situation. Fair sound quality is gotten off the stage.)

Willie Bobo/HELL OF AN ACT TO FOLLOW/Columbia JC 35374 (Stick to the instrumentals. They are hot, Latin jazz constructions which move radio actively. The songs, on the other hand, are of a different fabric - sort of wash 'n' wear. Split 50/50.)

Jim Capaldi/DAUGHTER OF THE NIGHT/RSO RS 1-3037 (The Jim Capaldi album starts after the first three tracks which, no doubt, will be the singles. A different producer was brought in to get the Top 40 stroke down. That which reflects the true Capaldi, written and produced by Jim, has a more organic, rock feel to them. Snappy play and rough edges keep it streetwise and moving. Good songs too.)

Valerie Carter/WILD CHILD/ARC-Columbia JC 35084 (The Wild Child title is not followed through in the oh so standard presentation. Arrangements go strictly by the book and come out sounding like a very slick version of a hundred other albums. Valerie Carter's vocal ability and personal warmth has to do all of the pulling. The songs are pretty good.)

Ray Charles/LOVE & PEACE/Atlantic SD 19199 (As performers get older they tend to move to the middle of the road, to mellow. A taut Ray Charles release counters that trend with authority. A couple tracks on each side land on solid musical turf.)

Chicago/HOT STREETS/Columbia FC 35512 (Finally, they ran out of numbers. They haven't run out of those performance skills which have sustained them for years. Their passable songs remain passable.)

Billy Cobham/SIMPLICITY OF EXPRESSION - DEPTH OF THOUGHT/Columbia JC 35457 (Implied by the dual title is the dual essence of this Lp. Jazz songs and mild fusion instrumentals divide the time. The songs are melodically average at best while the instrumentals are better by a few percentage points. This approach loses focus and, therefore, intensity.)

Bruce Cockburn/FURTHER ADVENTURES/Island ILPS 9528 (Canada seems to produce two types - hard rockers or plaintive folk singers. Bruce is the latter, along with Dan Hill. His low-key style requires color to be added to the arrangements. This Lp approaches that problem by the use of heavy accents which act as punctuation. The writing is pretty good but go for the up-tempo tunes.)

Crackin'/SPECIAL TOUCH/Warner Bros. 3235 (Nothing changes. Crackin' songs might be a millisecond better than before but, that doesn't matter much. Again, it is their strong playing and great sonic clarity which make them listenable.)

Peter Criss/Casablanca NBLP 7122 (Though it sounds like an album held together by the producer, Vini Poncia, it is held together. And with the outside material, Peter's album is dominated by worthy tunes. Pretty good.)

Devo/ARE WE NOT MEN?/Warner Bros. BSK 3239 (New faves, Devo pound out a message of defiance in music as well as words. Their cut short phrases imply that they don't want to waste themselves on us silly frips. Eno's production fits them well.)

Dragon/ARE YOU OLD ENOUGH/Portrait JR 35554 (Whistle the crystalline recording quality. Dragon songs are nothing special, though they are passable. Choppy rhythm works against the flow.)

Bryan Ferry/THE BRIDE STRIPPED BARE/Atlantic SD 19205 (Style and an attitude were always the major lines of demarcation dividing Bryan from the others. Here he works with Waddy Wachtel and Rick Marotta trading his flare for their steadiness. It works to the degree that the songs hold up. Great original use of strings.)

Ace Frehley/Casablanca NBLP 7121 (Rarely does a power rocker have the opportunity to play with the best players he can find under ideal conditions. That is the opportunity Ace Frehley has and it makes his Lp come alive. A couple good songs.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

Jan Garbarek/PLACES/ECM 1-1118 (Places is somewhat more cerebral and spacious than other Garbarek involvements. All the players are excellent, one expects nothing less. Melodies of a more memorable kind are required to equate with the technical excellence.)

Ray Wylie Hubbard/OFF THE WALL/Lone Star L-4603 ("Redneck Mother" starts Ray's album with his hit song. Thereafter, things settle down to earth. Good songs and a dipole country-rock setting move comfortably. Solid.)

Jaroslav/CHECKIN' IN/Columbia JC 35537 (Jaroslav demonstrates that he has broad musical tastes. But, he hasn't made an album. Instead he has a collection of tracks, some are fun, some are jazzy and some are just plain pop music. His lyric, "You Want It And We'll Give It To You" does not express an artistic point of view. Pick and choose.)

Waylon Jennings/I'VE ALWAYS BEEN CRAZY/RCA AFL 1-2979 (Waylon Jennings is such a charismatic person, so forceful. He dominates this whole recording and everything in it. These aren't the best songs he has written but his production is about the most careful in recent memory. The tempos and attitude seem to be down 85% of the Lp's time.)

Jerry-Kelly/SOMEBODY ELSE'S DREAM/Epic JE 35452 (The Jerry-Kelly combination generates that been-there-before feeling. Some good songs, dual guitars and nice harmonies do it. They are held back by a well played but very standard back-up style. Too many others fit their description.)

Dr. John/CITY LIGHTS/Horizon SP-732 (Talented barroom characters are so picturesque. Dr. John has a life membership in that club. Here he suffers from the lack of his own New Orleans style musicians. The kind who move with an uninhibited rollicking feeling, just the feeling missing from this album. When it does get going things pop.)

Steve Kuhn/NON-FICTION/ECM 1-1124 (Steve Kuhn's music moves out. It spotlights Steve Slagle's fine saxophone and flute work while giving Kuhn plenty of time to drive the point home. Non-Fiction is for real.)

Neil Larsen/JUNGLE FEVER/Horizon SP-733 (A fairly mellow keyboard sound fronts some spunky rhythm for a pleasing jazz album. The Lp starts with an intensified brew called "Sadder Samba." In it Larsen's keyboard becomes Santana. Other heated numbers include "Windsong," "Last Tango In Paris" and the title track.)

Ronnie Laws/FLAME/United Artists UA-LA 881-H (Cool, controlled, electric smooth-aid. Ronnie Laws is grooved and oh so West Coast. Neat melodies fit into the easy sway of Flame.)

Mylon LeFevre/LOVE RUSTLER/Warner Bros. BSK 3216 (Armed with a magazine of well chosen songs Mylon and producer Jerry Crutchfield chase it again. Mylon has the talent and the energy. Here he drives these tunes relentless.)

Famey Lewis/LEGACY/Columbia JC 35483 (Turn to side two for the bite sized rhythm and melody tracks. They are cast in traditional Ramsey Lewis fashion, though they rely lots on keyboard synthesizers of one sort or another. Side one is a symphony jazz piece of uncommon quality. It should not be overlooked but, it fits more into the area of special programming.)

Lucifer's Friend/GOOD TIME WARRIOR/Elektra 6E-159 (A white-hot presentation, with the classic rock voice of Mike Starrs out front, sells Lucifer's Friend. Their material adds little to the rock lexicon, energy is their game.)

Mike Mandel/SKY MUSIC/Vanguard VSD-79409 (Mike is a contemporary jazzier who has to be recognized. He is able, when he chooses, to create great intensity and powerful statements with his electronic instruments. The first track, "Pyramids" says it best.)

Herbie Mann/SUNBELT/Atlantic SD 19204 (Through the many Mann machinations the flute and rhythm have been a constant. Sunbelt restates that case emphatically. Cool latin.)

Mark-Almond/OTHER PEOPLES ROOMS/Horizon SP-730 (The thing about Mark-Almond is that they create an aura with their music. Those whispered voices make an intimate experience out of a mass medium. Good material is enlivened and enhanced by the performance it gets. Individually counts.)

Geoff Muldaur & Amos Garrett/Flying Fish FF-061 (Taking us beyond the basics Geoff and Amos demonstrate that oft stated but, little actualized proverb, that all music is one. They draw from many sources including the classics and still get a unified folk-blues album as a result.)

Network/NIGHTWORK/Epic JE 35476 (Nightwork moves Network into the center of rockwork. They make the adjustment without apparent labor as they negotiate a smooth transition. A few notable tunes and a boy soprano lead the way. Solid.)

Tom Paxton/HEROES/Vanguard VSD-79411 (If you are an old folksy you will feel very comfortable with this Tom Paxton Lp. It is filled with tunes both humorous and historic. Easy.)

(These records, which, in our opinion, deserve special mention because they come closest to perfecting their musical genre regardless of progressive radio application.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Herb Alpert & Hugh Masekela/MAIN EVENT-LIVE/A&M SP 4727 (Though the album medium tends to filter out excitement - overtones, enough of the magic of this duo has been captured to elevate the Lp. Super tunes get a marvelous ride on the talents of some under-recognized players. Hot jazz.)

Baby Grand/ANCIENT MEDICINE/Arista AB 4200 (Confident, Baby Grand goes for the brass ring with a powerful performance of winning songs. Strength in virtually every area.)

Pete Christlieb-Warne Marsh Quintet/APOGEE/Warner Bros. BSK 3236 (These saxophone duets are the most fun to come out of jazz in years. They are special, not because Becker & Fagen produced them but, because the production has so much vitality in it. Traditional jazz with something extra.)

Jimmy Cliff/GIVE THANKX/Warner Bros. BSK 3240 (Beyond reggae. Though Give Thankx is very rhythmical, most of it isn't pure reggae rhythm. Jimmy moves his extraordinary voice into the mainstream with good but not especially great songs. His vocal on "You Left Me Standing By The Door" is a killer.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Gong/EXPRESSO II/Arista AB 4204 (As long as they stick to instrumentals, which they do on Expresso II, Gong is a potent band. Jazz and rock and avant moves reside together in flowful melodies. An exhilarating violin solo in "Boring" is anything but.)

Levon Helm/ABC AA-1089 (A swinging solo album by Levon Helm brings enough of the spirit of The Band to open the door. Yet, it has plenty of its own character to leave the gates wide open for its own sake - Levon goes nine for nine in quality tracks.)

Don Lange/NATURAL BORN HEATHEN/Flying Fish FF 060 (If Don Lange had a mind to broaden his audience WITHOUT selling out, he could harden the rock side of his folk-rock style. With songs as good as his and his matching voice, Don would then move into the center space of the rock world. By God, this heathen has talent.)

Linda Ronstadt/LIVING IN THE U.S.A./Asylum 6E-155 (Linda's albums are rarely boring because there is so much going on, even in a spare recording like this one. You can go to school on Linda's phrasing or on the dynamic arrangements or marvel at the variety of the song choices and their quality. Or you can just tear up when she sings "Oh Baby Baby." This Lp contains four or five great readings.)

David Rose/DISTANCE BETWEEN DREAMS/Inner City 1058 (David Rose is a trained musician who plays a serious brand of jazz. His violin crosses the line from classical motifs to jazz with an easy stroke of the bow. His superior music is rarely injected with joyousness.)

Sea Level/ON THE EDGE/Capricorn CPN 0212 (You might think that a band which draws elements from such diversified musical schools would never pull it together. Sea Level successfully unite a marvelous, Southern, syncopated rhythm, the song format jazz, jazz-fusion and rock. Fine melodies fill a terrific, tight album.)

Small Faces/78 IN THE SHADE/Atlantic SD 19171 (What more can you ask? A spirited presentation of songs which celebrate the singable hook, a sense of humor and a social conscious. Top rank all the way.)
