# RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Gloria Mundi/I, INDIVIDUAL/RCA PL 25157 (Gloria Mundi is a band, not a woman. They are punk dramatists using daring arrangements to grab attention. It works well in a diabolical way. Merit.)

Ian Gomm/SUMMER HOLIDAY/Albion ALBG 100 (Though his songs say very little, Ian's tunes flow effortlessly. He has the pop music groove internalized. A pinch of style would put him across. Merit.)

- Dave Mattson/LEAD ME HOME/Myrrh MSB-6611 (Mellow folk rock is the format for Dave's songs. Pleasant songs they are too. Mattson teaches a lesson to all Jesus music people, the music comes first, the message second.)
- Ron Mesing/NO MINORS ALLOWED/Flying Fish FF-067 (Pure country dobro pickin'. Mostly instrumental, the LP moves gracefully with upbeat versions of lots of good songs. The vocals whine with authenticity.)
- James Montgomery/DUCE FEVER/Waterhouse 5 (His stance on the back cover implies his rock 'n' roll attitude correctly. James Montgomery borrows black music ideas to invest his music with the right feel. A hot accompaniment punctuates it. Write: 807 Hennepin Ave., Minneapolis, Minn. 55403.)
- Patrick Moraz/Charisma CA 1-2201 (As he explains, this music represents the continuous struggle between the primitive and the civilized. It pits electronic and acoustic instruments against each other. A lofty idea is developed fairly well melodically. It could have used a drum kit to drive it. Distributed by Polydor.)
- No Slack/Mercury SRM 1-3749 (No Slack is a terrific name for a hard rock band. This band works closer to moderate. Say-nothing songwriting holds a hot rhythmic section back.)
- Parliament/MOTOR BOOTY AFFAIR/Casablanca NESP 7125 (If Frank Zappa had been black he would have been George Clinton. The multileveled funk-rock-humor of his music is easily as brilliant as credited to Z. This LP isn't always as melodious as it could have been.)
- Various Artists/NO WAVE/A&M SP-4738 (No Wave is a sampler of new things from A&M. Some of it is available in one form or another. But, 50 or 60 percent is completely new. Naturally, the sampler isn't going to have weak material on it.)
- The Werewolves/SHTP OF POOLS/RCA AFL 1-3079 (Projecting a winning personality is important anytime. The Werewolves make a science of it. You may not like all of their songs but their barroom, raucousness can't fail to move you.)
- Lenny White/STREAMLINE/Elektra EA-164 (All drummer-lead LP's are suspect at the start. Lenny has delivered some rather musical LP's so he gets by a little easier. This LP is filled with intense rhythm and fair melodic resolution.)

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Lol Creme & Kevin Godley/L/Polydor PD 1-6177 (Previously reviewed as an import. Preoccupied with technique, L is beautifully recorded and performed. However, the tunes are fragmented. They seem expedient when nothing else is. Zappa would never get trapped in this musical corner. The instrumental "Foreign Accent" is superior.)
- Glad/Myrrh MSB-6603 (These Christian musicians fail to write spiritual music. Their songs are barely passable. Performance is their ace in the hole. Sad.)
- The Leopards/KANSAS CITY SLICKERS/Moon 300 (Encouragement. It is only the production which is amateurish. The Leopards do their job, filling these grooves with good tunes and tremendous enthusiasm. "She's more fifties than a Chevy" is a sample. They need the Weserkely touch. Write: Box 4001, Kansas City, Kansas 66104.)

## UNDISTINGUISHED ALBUMS

(In our opinion, below standard LPs except where noted.)

- Salvation Air Force/STRANGERS IN A STRANGE LAND/Myrrh MSB-6612 (Some Jesus rockers are able to get their message across without banging you over the head. Here the message is the medium. And the music just doesn't make it.)

## FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Pepper Adams/REFLECTORY/Muse MR 5182 (Reflectory is a decent album because each of the elements, taken individually, is. Still, there are many times when the album doesn't project the feel of a unit playing together.)
- Toshiko Miyoshi - Lew Tabackin Big Band/KOCUN/RCA AFL 1-3019 (A regular feature of this band is its disciplined play. The ideas are generally standard big band formulations. However, here the title track adds a touch of Japanese spice for extra interest.)
- Bar-Kays/LIGHT OF LIFE/Mercury SRM 1-3732 (Though the Bar-Kays may be a straight R&B act, they are a top-drawer group. Some of what they do is too good to ignore. Listen to things like "Give It Up" and "I'll Dance.")
- Walter Bishop, Jr./CUBICLE/Muse MR 5151 (A steamy rhythm flows throughout Walter's new album. It gives the good tunes a kick. They drive convincingly as the many soloists pick up the spirit.)

## FRINGE ALBUMS CONTINUED

- The Joe Brooks Group/Atlantic SD 19206 ("You Light Up My Life" is only the tip of the saccarine Joe Brooks iceberg. It is not that the songs are sappy, they are not, it is the way he hears the songs. Pop with a capital P.)
- Neil Diamond/YOU DON'T BRING ME FLOWERS/Columbia FC 35625 (One has to support the work of quality pop rock artists such as Neil Diamond. Every heart and mind he occupies stands in opposition to the schlockers. The only hole in Neil's style is that it has hardly evolved in years. He sustains his audience by avoiding overexposure rather than by growing in his style.)
- Bill Evans Trio/CROSSCURRENTS/Fantasy F-9568 (Characteristicly bouyant music, with a touch of class, describes this and other Bill Evans Lps. The saxophone duet by Lee Konitz and Warne Marsh which intros "Night & Day" is quite a moment.)
- Bill Hardman/HOME/Muse MR 5152 (The liner notes are as interesting as the music. A sense of Hardman's bitterness comes through as he derides young players who lack roots. Of course, older players who haven't evolved beyond their roots are the other, unmentioned, side of the coin. A solid be-bop album comes out in the end.)
- Bob James/TOUCHDOWN/Tappan Zee JC 35594 (Think of Bob James the same way as you think of Deodato. Both are arrangers who have an inclination toward jazz, but not a commitment. Touchdown is music for a hip elevator.)
- Sam Jones/SOMETHING IN COMMON/Muse MR 5149 (The three piece horn section, anchored by venerable Blue Mitchell and Slide Hampton, gives Sam's LP the feeling of a small big band. Yet, it retains the resiliency of a combo. Good show.)
- Don Patterson/WHY NOT../Muse MR 5148 (Why Not generates a cozy little jam which has an upbeat, swinging quality throughout. Comfortable is a good word to describe the jazzy Don Patterson music.)
- Cal Tjader/MURACAN/Crystal Clear CCS 8003 (Only four tunes fit on this 12", direct-disc, 45 rpm LP. Obviously the sound quality is as promised, crystal clear. Cal Tjader's music is worthy of this recording process too. The essence of West Coast jazz, Tjader's music always features good songs and sensuous rhythm.)
- Various Artists/SOUNDTRACK - THE WILD GESE/A&M SP 4730 (Stuck inside of this standard movie-music album is the film's theme written and sung by Joan Armstrading. A little further along on side one is the worthy rock instrumental "Dance With Death.")

## SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

- R. Crumb & The Cheap Suit Serenaders/NUMBER THREE/Blue Goose 2025 (Old music - from before the great Depression - recreated by this group of whiz-bangs is fun. R. Crumb and P.D.Q. Bach phone each other daily.)
- Jon Hassell/EARTHQUAKE ISLAND/Tomato TOM-7019 (Without a firm melodic grip Jon leads us into a spaced form of jazz-disco. It has an atherial quality to it. But, without the melodic hook it tends to go away like a puff of smoke.)
- Cathal McConnell/ON LOUGH ERNE'S SHORE/Flying Fish FF-058 (You may remember McConnell from The Boys Of The Lough. He is a brilliant traditionalist. This LP opens with a haunting flute version of "The Dark Woman Of The Glen." Beautiful music.)
- Vangelis/BEAUBOURG/RCA AFL 1-3020 (Previously reviewed as an import. Vangelis goes off the deep end. Or at least out in deep space. Beaubourg is an eery exploration into keyboard abstraction. Not too musical. Obscure.)
- Various Artists/PACIFIC STEEL CO./Pacific Arts PAC 7-121 (If you like steel guitar, this is the place. Somehow, Al Perkins managed to make a steel album which isn't background music. His compadres include Sneaky Pete and Red Rhodes. Good tunes and good pickin'.)

### STRONGLY MERITORIOUS

(We feel that these Lp's have an extra edge.)

Jim Morrison - The Doors/AN AMERICAN PRAYER/Elektra 5E-502 (A wonderful album because it approaches audio art and dares to take a rock consciousness seriously. It is not all playable because of language and because poetry doesn't easily fit. Listen to that band to hear what we are often missing today.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Blues Brothers/BRIEFCASE FULL OF BLUES/Atlantic SD 19217 (The humor and the love for the original blues form oozes from these grooves. And the band is great. They support Joliet Jake's vocals in an important way because they really only approximate the blues feeling. Fun.)

Cooder Browne/Lone Star L-4604 (Their power, Western-country sound is especially appealing. Pretty good songs would benefit from a stronger lead voice. Still, too much is too good.)

Jean-Michel Jarre/EQUINOXE/Polydor PD 1-6175 (Jarre is a populizer. He joins a very select group of musicians who have been able to take electronically generated music to the masses. As Equinoxe attests, he does it with lovely rhythms and stimulating melodies. The electronics may be new, but the formula is eternally old.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Cat Stevens/BACK TO EARTH/A&M SP-4735 (His sense of drama and organization is unusual. The drama is tempered and the structure purposeful. They never get in the way of the songs. Good tunes and a lot of class.)

### MERIT ALBUMS

Paul Clark/CHANGE IN THE WIND/Seed PSR-007 (A passable songwriter, Paul's rock gets its biggest boost from Curt Bartlett's guitar. Christian rock is an odd species, but a flourishing one. Write: Box 2112, Shawnee Mission, Kan. 66201.)

Terry Clark/WELCOME/Good News GNR 8107 (Using top dog studio players, like the Picaro brothers, gives Terry a solid base. His Jesus rock is set up well and delivered in admirable style. Distributed by Myrrh, Waco, Texas.)

Alice Cooper/FROM THE INSIDE/Warner Bros. BSK 3263 (There used to be a time when Cooper's music was humorous but things have improved. Now songs like "From The Inside" and "How You Gonna See Me Now" cannot be easily set aside. Alice and Bernie make a nice couple.)

Chick Corea/SECRET AGENT/Polydor PD 1-6176 (Instrumentally Chick's ensemble music is good, though not as adventurous as music he has created in the past. On the other hand, the songs are uncomfortable and forced. The hot rhythms are best.)

Stanley Cowell/TALKIN' 'BOUT LOVE/Galaxy GXY-5111 (Musically rousing, Cowell places it somewhere between R&B, jazz and gospel. The most involving of these tunes are positioned at the front of each side and they turn out to be the same song in instrumental and vocal versions.)

Cathy Fink & Duck Donald/Flying Fish PF-053 (With humor and an obvious love for folk music, Cathy and Duck win you over. They play spiritedly and with skill. Fun for true folk devotees.)

Steve Mann/ELEPHANT SONGS & COW COW BLUES/Blue Goose 2024 (Steve Mann is a folky's folky. Essentially he is a guitarist with a strong blues base. He sings enough to get by. Here he's working alone. The recording quality isn't the best. Write: 245 Waverly Place, New York, N.Y. 10014.)
