Nice reports from Hank Holbrook included two shots of his DX den complete with plenty of veries，and one photo included Hank，himself． Both very nice，and approciated here。 Hank reported his stations for the contest，but one puzzles me．Where and who is TJC？Hank also says he hasn＇t been listening too much due to stulying for finals．Hope he does all right in them。

Hank，I＇ll let you know further when I plan to be in your vicinity． Now looks as if it will have to be in Fobruary。

John Brierley says that $D X$ is off due to Japanese stations not coming through．He says they are just about out now，and he hopos they will come back as usual around the ond of February．
