The Light Programme broadcasts from 1:00 a.m. to 6:00p.m., I.S.T.; the Scottish Home Service fram 12:30 a.m. to 5:13 p.m., T. S.T.; and the Third Programe from 12:00 noon to 5:30 p.m., E.S.T. For Greenwich Tite, add six hours. I have heard other stations both on the British Isles and on the continent and in Africa, but I haven't taken any logs. The balance might have been delinquent to one member, while verifyins for others, which leads us to believe that it is after all a matter of proper reporting. It is indeod a good thing as a now season starts to advise ail, when reporting to stam tions, to send a full and adequate report, if you hope for a verification. ris correspondence tiat I have had while conducting this survey sti.. f further points out that in rine cases out of ten reports will be verified. There are vary few stations that will not respond to a good and concise report. This is not a sermon, but merely a bit of advice. Poor, inadequare and guesswork reports hurt the hojby and shouli not be a part of the sciere of things in our hobby. They hurt, so cot's all resolve (conid PG) (Charles Aťurton, conla from P.5) to send the best we can when we ask the stations to do us a favor and send us a verification. This ond will continue to conduct a survey on delimquent stations, so send them in to me as they get to be behind in verifyp ing. Plans are vinder way with an idea to nelp in the nonoverifying problen. I need the cooperabion of all of you in this problem, bat first I must ask that you ail report in the best ethics possible in your originel. reporis. We will take it frem there; we will atterpt a project in public relations with the werst offenders or verifica tions, but it is important to start out on the promise that all of you are sending proper and adequete repcrts to start with.
