I have been fooling around with wave traps, as I have been doing for quite some time, for I have quite a bit of trouble with VFBM-2260, less than a mile from hera, and VIBC1070, about eight miles from here. With my newest wave traps, using a 1751 antenna pointed toward WrBih, I can got them dom to about S-2, which is far better than I have ever done befare. I can get IIIBC jown to about $51-2$ and null any other station in town or angwhere. Thile TFBM 1260 is nulled to $\mathrm{S}-2$, I can get VCAU-1210 at S-9, which proves that it tunes fairly sharp. Anyboly else having trouble with nearby atations might find these wave traps of considerebie help. I use a set of two traps, mounted on a plastic sheet which is mounted in an aluninum case, about $10^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime} x^{\prime \prime} 4^{\prime \prime}$. I use a $15-365 \mathrm{mmf}$. condensoss in parallel with two Miller $\# 2001$ antenna coils, which I believe are the best coile available, since they have the highest "Q". It is important to plate the coils in a "T" formation, the coils bing as far apart as possible. The condensors whould be mounted in the creter of tise plastic sheet, and contolled with long, insulated handies. This is vital to prevent body capacitance. These traps are very difficult to tune but vith practice it can be done. placing a $5-15$ (approximate) maf. condenser in parellel with the main capacitors provides much easier toning. 73s, Roger Williams - 52 Coppersmith Food - Letittown, New York
