DX-wise, have moved up to Pacific Feights, quite a way from antemn village. Jury-rigged the famed Van Voorhees loop antenna, and seems to be very directional indeed, since with accurate aim, can drop even Honolulu's most powerful station from peaking down toda 7 on the meter. KPOA changed to KKAA-650 as of $7 / 1$, and as of this writing (7/17) they will quit ANing. KULA-690 is off at 6 a.m. EST daily, after having stopped ANing.
