For any considering an "automatic" monitoring setup such as I utilize, I might present the following "consumer's report" on two time switches that I use. First, a 24 hour, 15 minute period, AEMCO. This is very versatile giving you any combination of 15 minute recarding periods that you wish; either continudusly, or in breaks, 15 minutes or more apart. Two drawbacks to this unit are first, some degree of inaccuracy as to time "on" switch trips; varies over one minute on occasions; secondly, no manual "off-on" operation. Different models of this switch may provide for this. Now to the 24 hour TORK switch, giving operations of $5-55$ minutes once an hdur. This clock is highly accurate (to within five seconds) and has manal "off-on" switch, but being only "once an hour" operation, is not as versatile as the Aemco. Examplanary settings I might use: AENCO, 15 minute periods beginning at $1,1: 30,2,2: 30,3,3: 30,4,4: 30$ and $5 \mathrm{a}, \mathrm{m}$. , or say 1 to $1: 45,2$ to $2: 45$, and 15 minute periods at $3,3: 30$ and 4 ( m 11 depending, of courser on tape time available). On the TORK, 45 mimute periode at 1,2 , 3, and 4 a.m., or 15 minute pertods at $1,2,3,4$, and 5 a.m. As a practice $I$ set all my clocks six minutes fast to give me periods commencing six minutes before tine setting time, i.e., la.m. actually starts at l2:54 a.m., etc. Happy New Year, all! The old theory about daytime reception is sort of being disporved at my experimental receiving station here. According to age-old theory in the daytime only the ground wave is prevalent which would tend to give fairly constant reception. For example, wCKY-1530 at noon troday would be S-9 as it was at 10 a.m. and will be at 2 p.m. as it was two weeks ago and will be two weeks from now, etc. This is not true on weaker daytime signals like the two above, WJJD-1160, WKBW-1520 WMEX-1510 etc. I believe there is a pattern for this and will report regularly as to my progress in this field, hi. The key to DX is the antenna. This location is fabulous for DX so there is every opportanity for a good antenna. Several engineering books make mention of the "Beveaage" antenia which is merely a long wire elevated 10-201 about the ground, half to several wave-lengths long and terminated in a resistive load equal to the characteristic impedance of the antenna itsedf. This terminating load makes the antenna non-resonant and can be used successfully over a wide range of fifferent wave lengths. Also it give the Eeverage antenna its characteristic which appeals most to me; it is very directional with maximum signal along the wire from the end away from the receiver. A directional antenna is most useful here to take advantage of the great daytime DX. With same it may be ponsible to get WWON/WOCB-1240 which will now be 1,000 watts days. Bor nighttime DX the antenna does not seem to be very critical. For example on a $35^{i}$ vertical inere I have gotten KFWB-980 and for me that is quite good. In just about two weeks of steady DXing here I have logged close to 200 . Will have partial daytime list next week. I am still enjoying my happiest years in Uncle Sam's wo nderful Navy in great and fabulous Norfolk, Va.! Everyting here for me is BCE DX, commanications and electronics. DX in my apre time. 73 s to all.

For some time now there has been a decrease in the interest of radio stations. located in the LA countries, in replying to reception reports from DXers living in the United States. The list is steadily growing on the number of LA stations who won't verify regardless of the number of reports that a DXer sends them. I realize that many U.S. stations are guilty of the same thing but you have half a chance as the lainguage is in our favor whereas with the LAs it isn't. Now, just what are we U.S. DXers goins to do to improve our percentage of replies? When I think of the number of IRCs I've sent out of the U.S. I wonder if this isn't a lost cause. Also, another thought is: when we use certain standard expressions, sentences and phrases in the Spanish Letter Forms to the various Spanish speaking countries are we insulting the intelligenca of the se people who run these radio stations as many times I find that many many words are not spelled the same on replies as written to the station on our reports. Surely there is an answer to this problem. Due to lack of veries from LA stations we have many DXers who won't go into the field of Foreign DX and actually you can't blame them. I rm now proposing several items which I think would be very helpful if it could be handled. First, I suggest that one of the members of eitner the NRC or NNRC contact some of the members of Legation of Spanish speaking countries, located in Washington or possibly in New York (United Nations) and find out if we are using the "right approach" when writing to these stations. Secondy, should we abolish sendins IRCs and send stamps instead (I believe we have a stamp exchange). Thirdly, should we stop writing in Spanish and send all reports in English? Should we stop sending PP cards which is actually forcing an issae and perhaps making the people at these radio stations feel "inferior" to their big American Cousins? I assure you members that there isn't any personal criticism towards any DXer in the above. I'm just wondering if there isn't an answer to the verifying of LA stations at a higher percentage than at present.
