So I can't see a $2 \mathrm{kc} / \mathrm{s}$. error going unnoticed. $95 \%$ of Canadian stations don't $\mathrm{f} / \mathrm{c}$ because they are contimuously monitored as to programming and frequency. The only one $I$ know of is CJOR-600. Something that may be of interest to you is why there are fewer stations per city in Canada than in in compartively same dize U.S. cities. The DoT figures an area can get saturated so it comes to a state when two or three make all the money and a couple others might just make it financially. There are something like 20 in the Devver area and two of them occupy $85 \%$ of the audience and that leaves $15 \%$ for the other 18! That is why EXXI went off according to an item in Canadian Broadcaster. This is why the station was refused for Dartmouth. The audience is now splif eight ways -CBHT CJCH CHNS CBH CKBW CKCL CJCH-tV CHSJ. If CJCH-TV makes out OK then Dartmouth will most likely get the go-ahead. Programming is watched quite strongly here also. When a license is applied for it has to be proven a station will contribute somet ing to the education and thinking. It shofld inform, sive views and entertain. If a station does not do this it will usually be denied any demands made by it. CKOY Ottawa applied for 50 kw . It was denied mo tly because of its stereotyped jukedox programing. CKGM has been taken a very dim view of as far as the officials and DXers are concerned; something like WKBV WPTR etc. isn't looked upon too highly by the authroties here mainly because all they tum out 24 hours a day is inspired jingles, "Top 40 " and don't contribute to the betterment of a community, unless it's money for them. Shappen the selectivity with your $Q$ multiplier or crystal control and tune 1 ke/off 1340 and turn on your BFO adjustine it so it will produce the most audible tone while beating on the 1 kc . tone. If the station is running MCW IDs the rest is easy as you can cppy the code or tape it and send it in.
