A cheerful hello to you people in NRC land. An event happened which has widdom in it for those of you who are intentive enough to understand it. It seems that B. Lowe, a local DXer has thrown DX out the window. His sentiments are echoed by all too many young Dxers - "The hobby just got boring". The young people join the Club with the intention to be a top DXer. These fellows for the most part seem to lack percerverence and patience. There are two extremes of DXers. The first is rather lazy and hardly devotes his time to DX (these are as rare as the other extreme). His idea of radio is that it is a dull and unexciting band, but all too many of these fellows put money into a Club expecting to find suddenly that DX is fun, but finds that it is no more fun because he lacks the interest. The other extreme is a DXer who goes insane in logging, and alters his work and school sked to fit his DX as if DX is the all-important element of life. He stays up late at night and sleeps days and repeats this night after night, week after week, and soon finds the stations flowing in fast and furjous. No mistake here, the new boys at DX are like this until DX comes harder and then their overenthusiansm gives way to a deep appreciation and desire for DX. The cveractive, extended overenthusiastic DXer soon finds at the end of the DX season that the DX is no longer coming as much and then loses interest in DX. This interest rarely returns again when the DX season returns. The lazy (exptremely lazy, most people who figure they are lazy are actually the right type of DXer) find that all (he thinks the stations he receives are very good catches due to inexperience and soon gets bored because he is receiving all these "good" catches, and then loses interest. The true DXer will find DXing very educational. It can help him to learn a language, hear about the customs of others, learn quite a bit about the study of WX as this can tie quite heavily with DX, electornics due to his interest in his RX and how it works, and many things too many to mention. From this DX a fellow may become interested in stamp collecting from all the stamps he receives on his envelopes of veries, collecting maps from interest about where these stations originate, etc. I personally feel DX is a universal hobby as you can become interested in so many other hobbies, or can have so (30) many divisions of types of DX.
